[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a stackable chair, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevation of a chair embodying my design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The appearance of the side of the stackable chair not shown in the drawing is identical with the appearance of the side shown in FIG. 1.

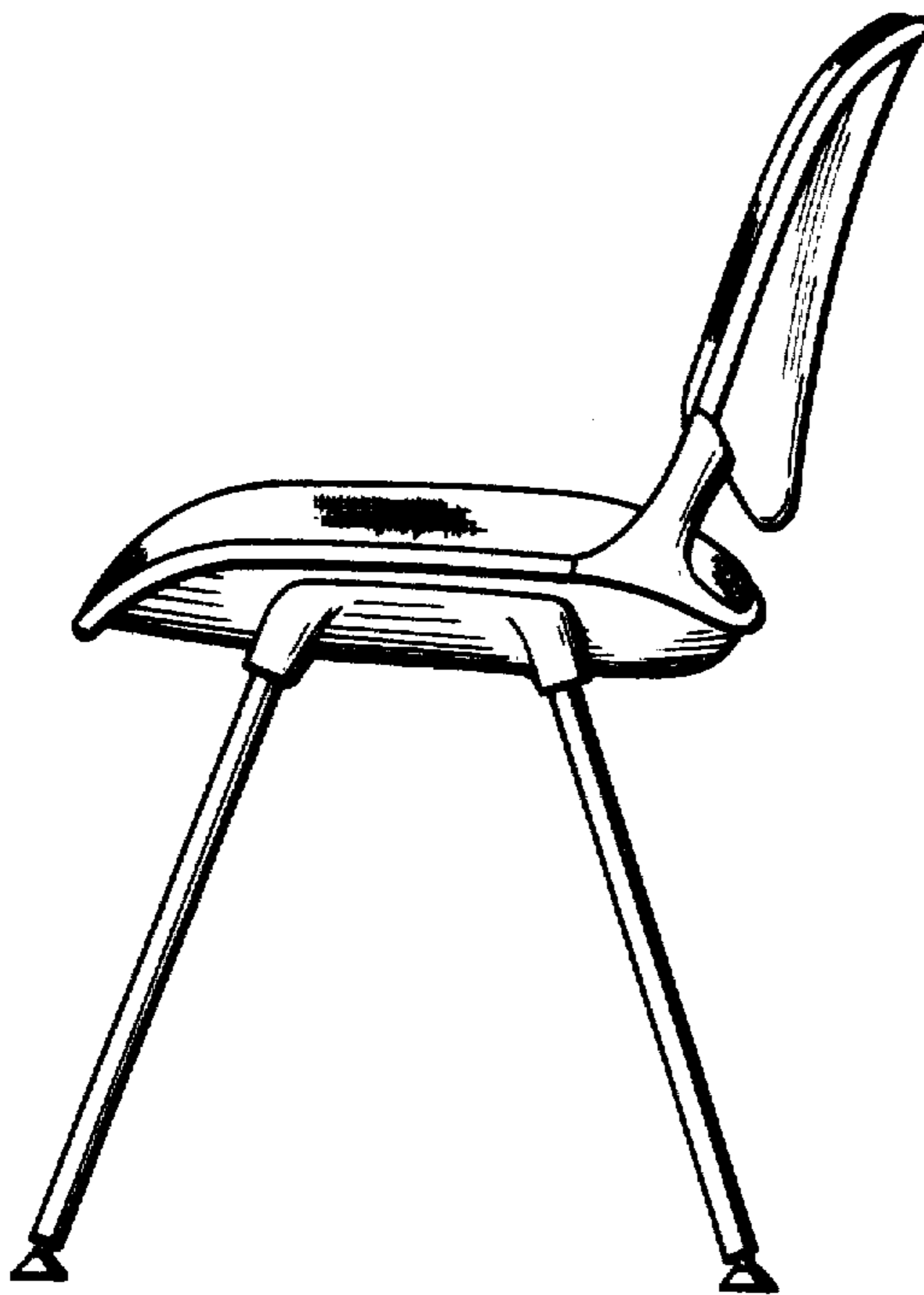

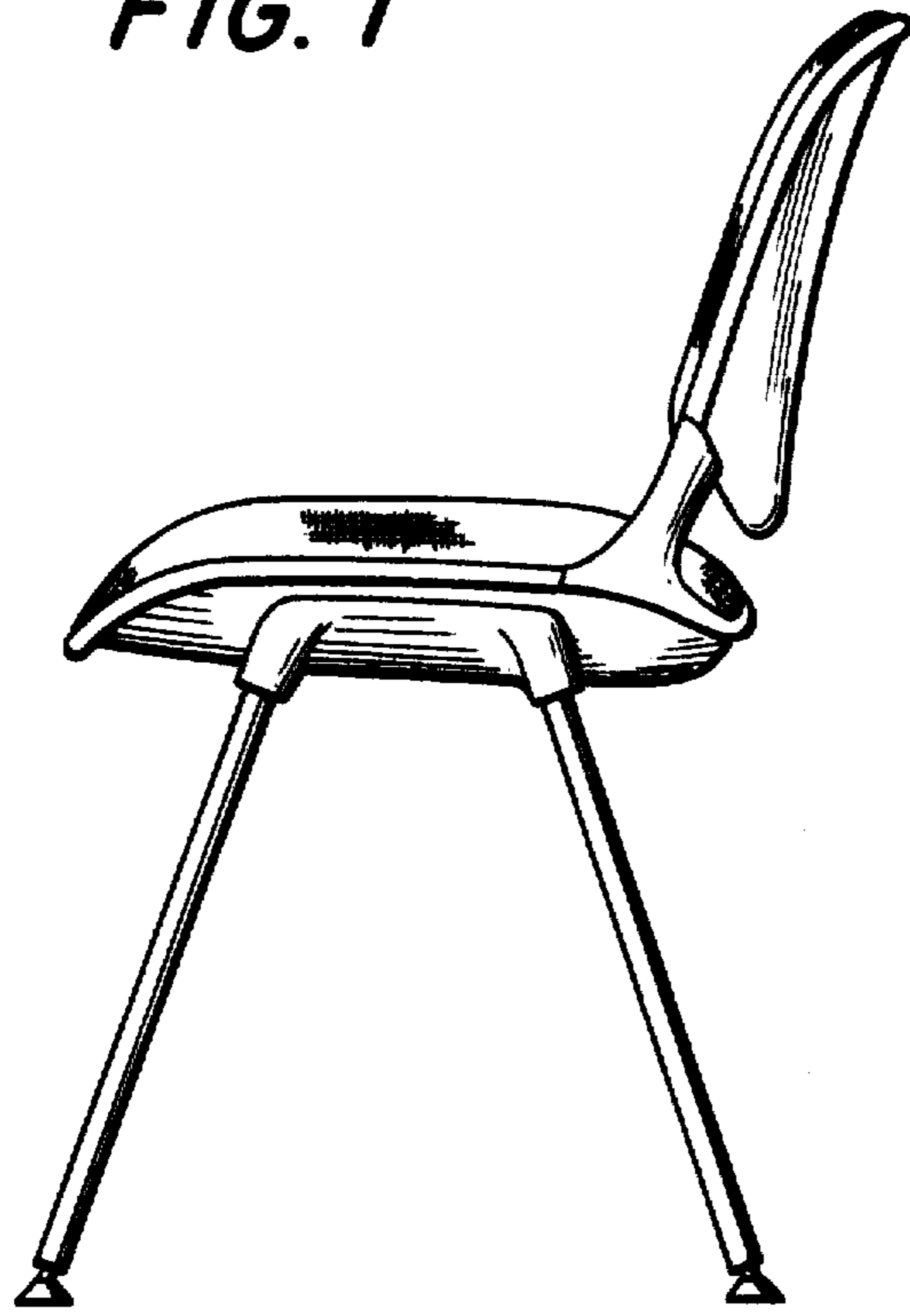

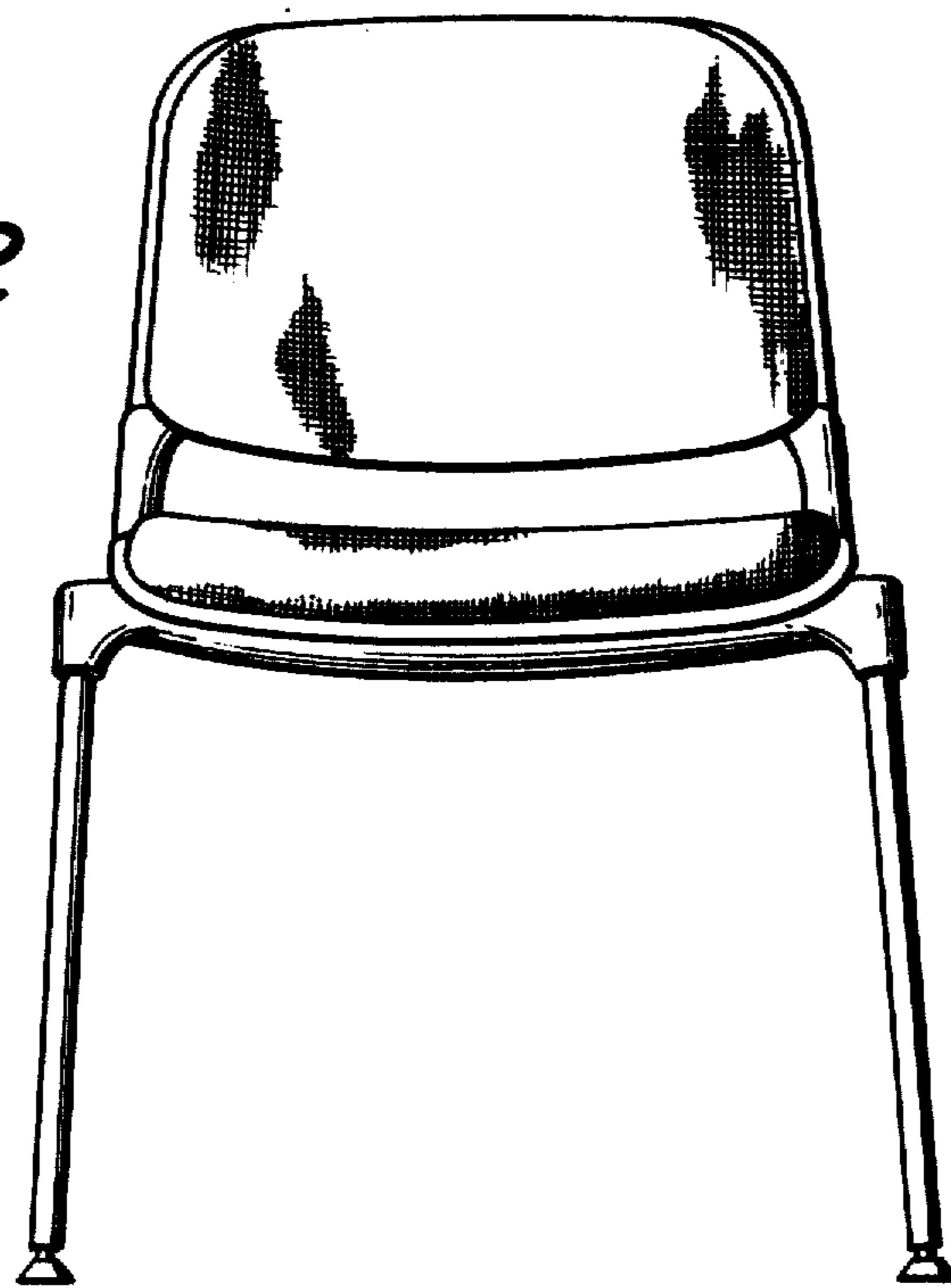

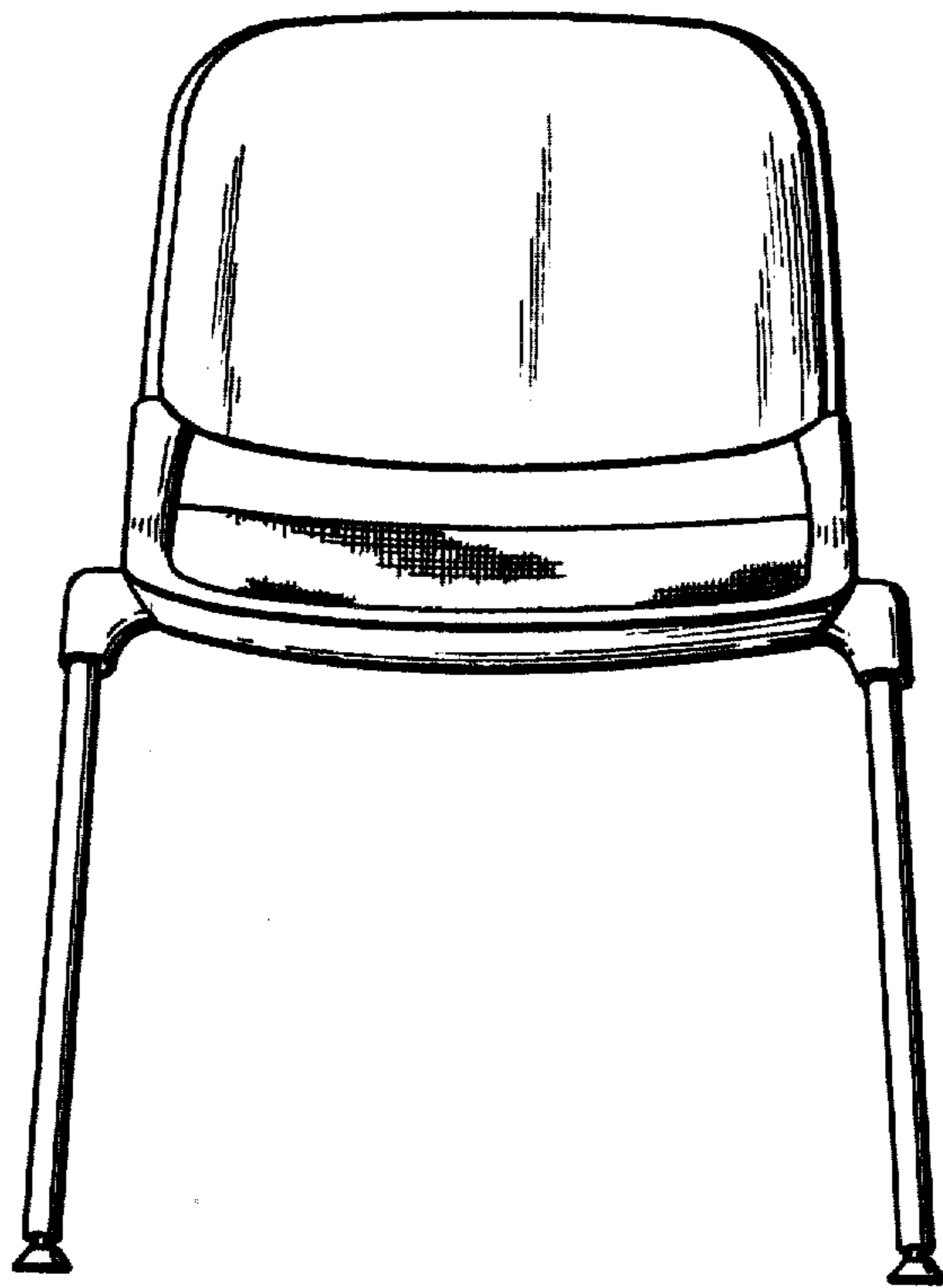

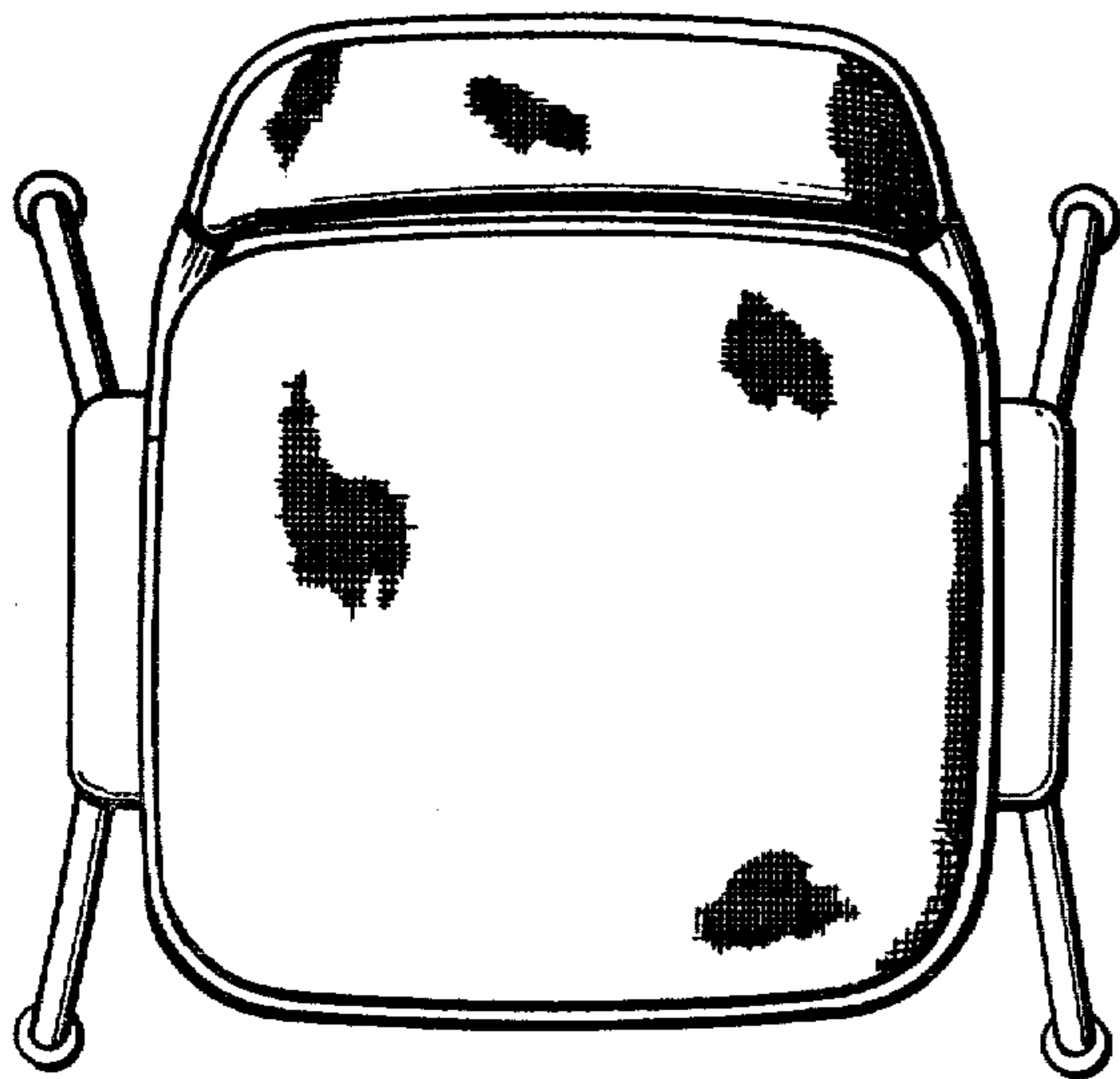
