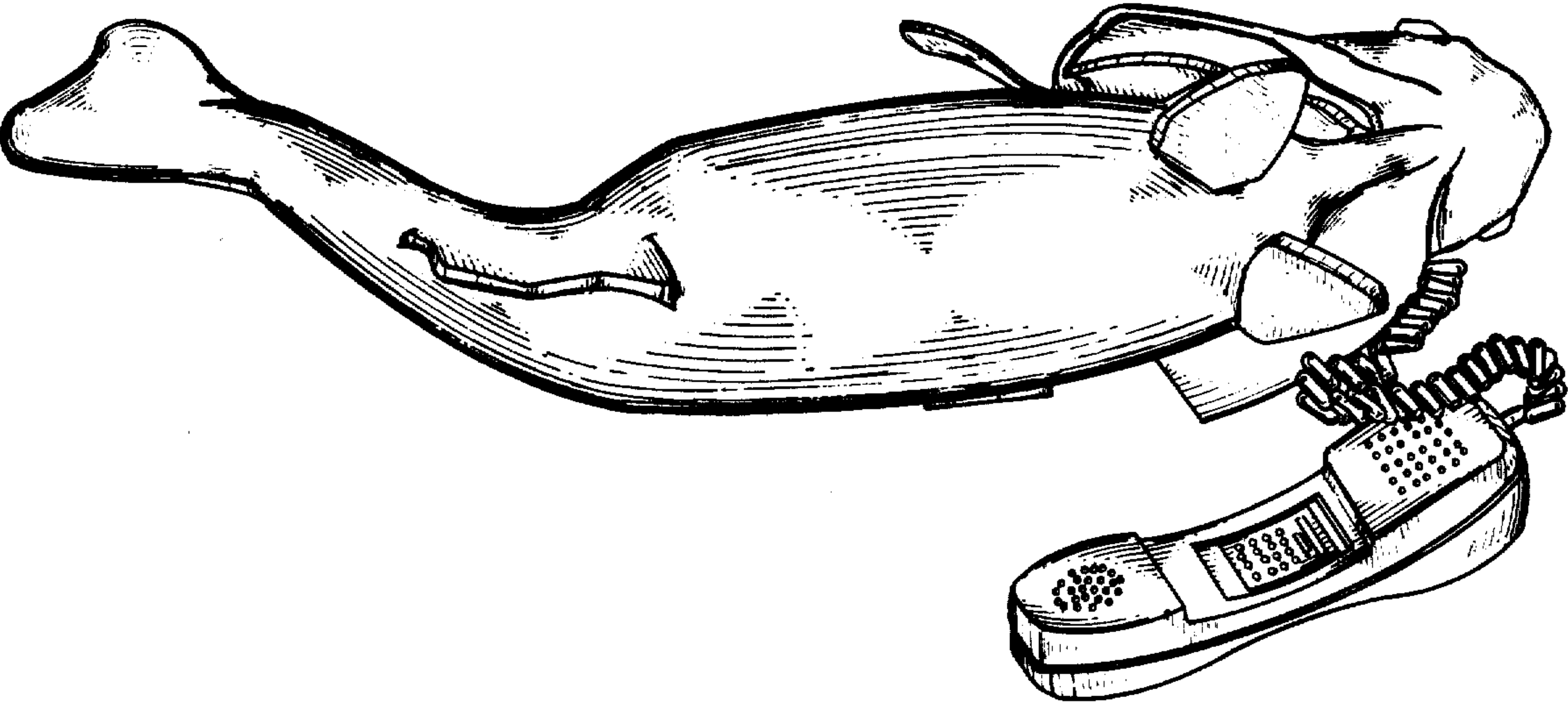

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of a telephone showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top perspective view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom perspective view thereof, with the telephone hand set separated from the base;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevation thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a front elevation thereof.



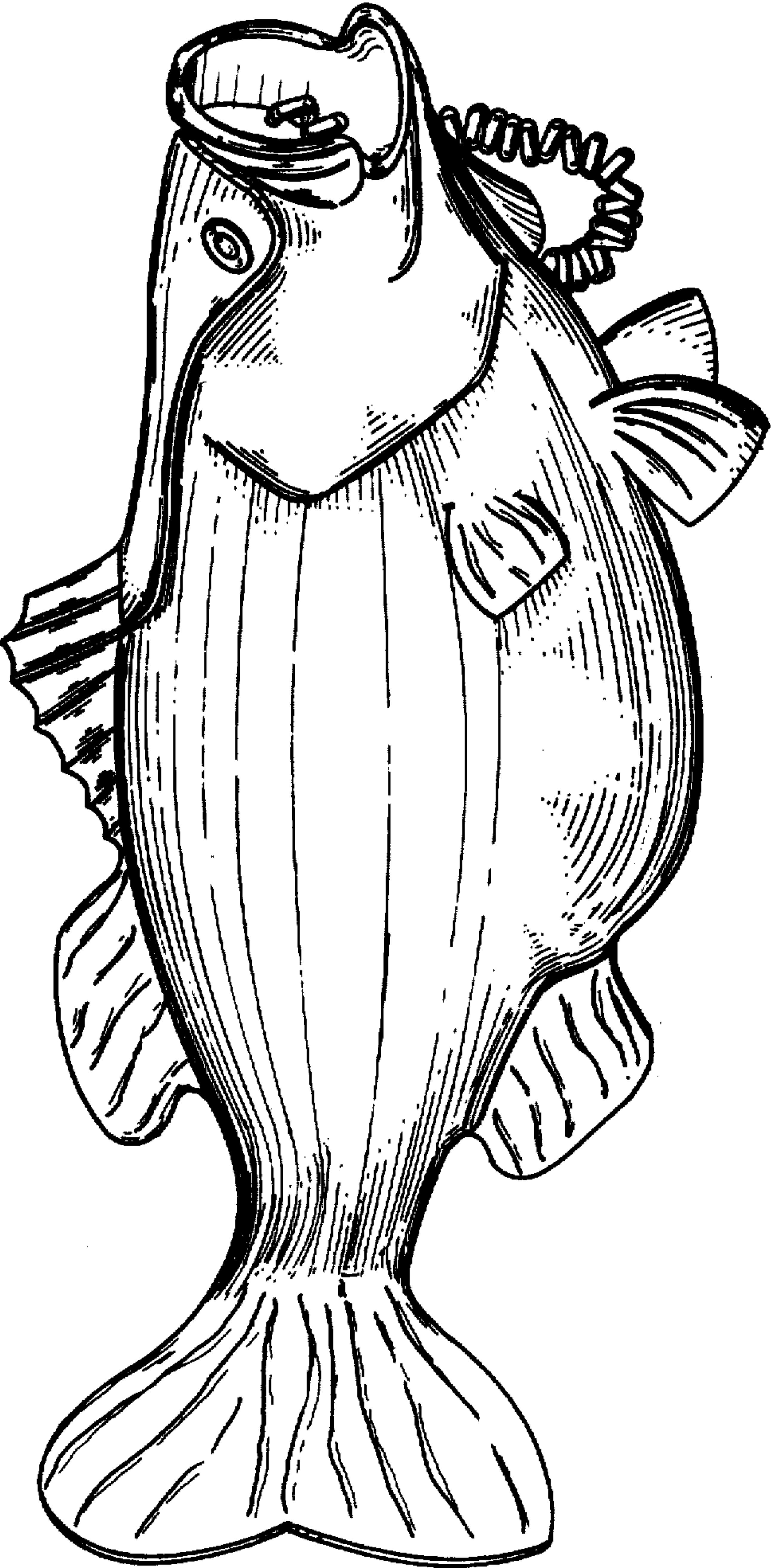

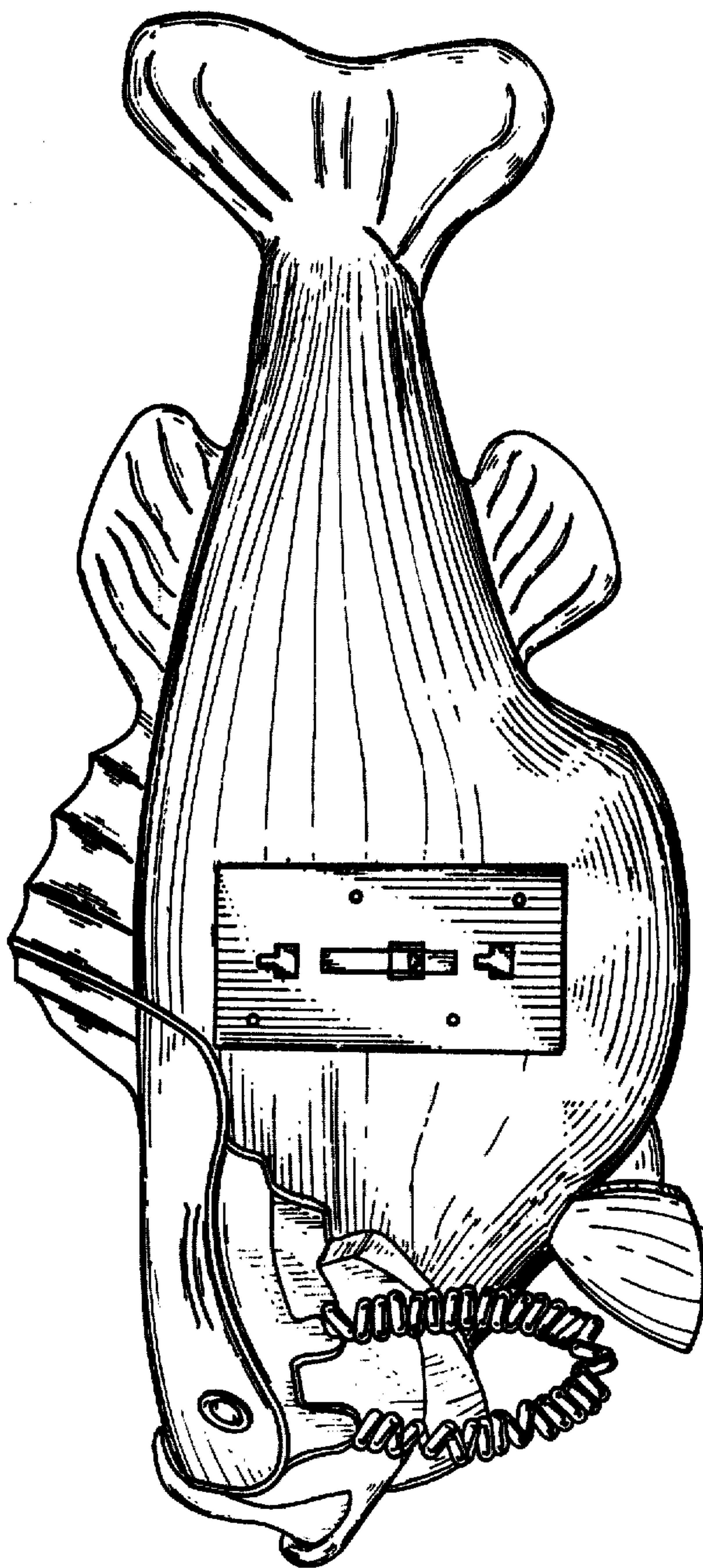

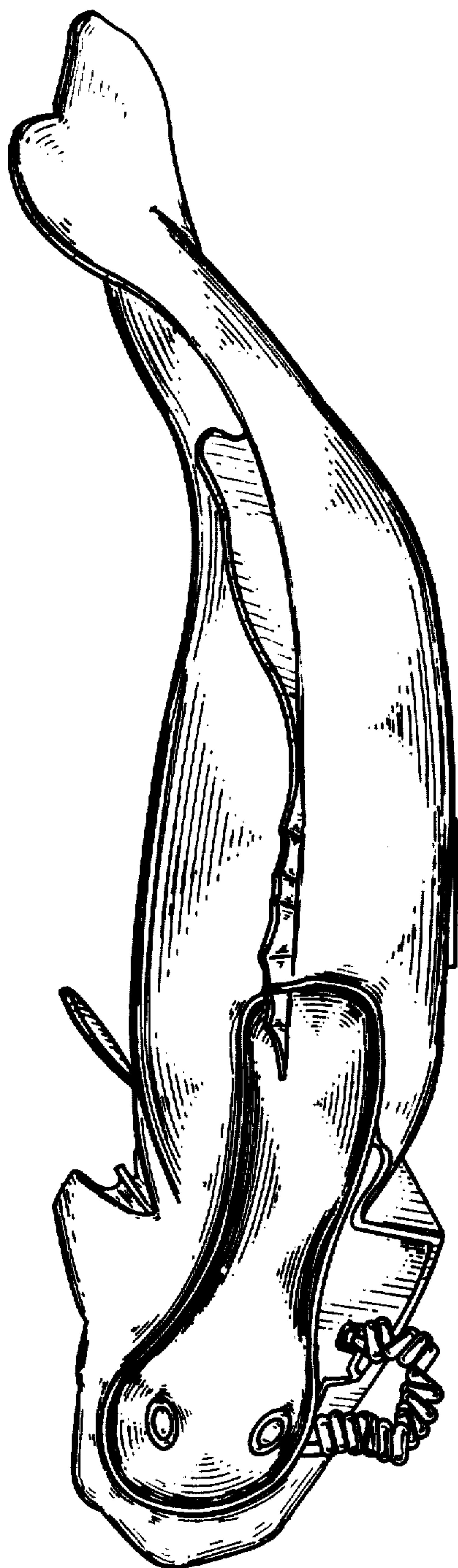

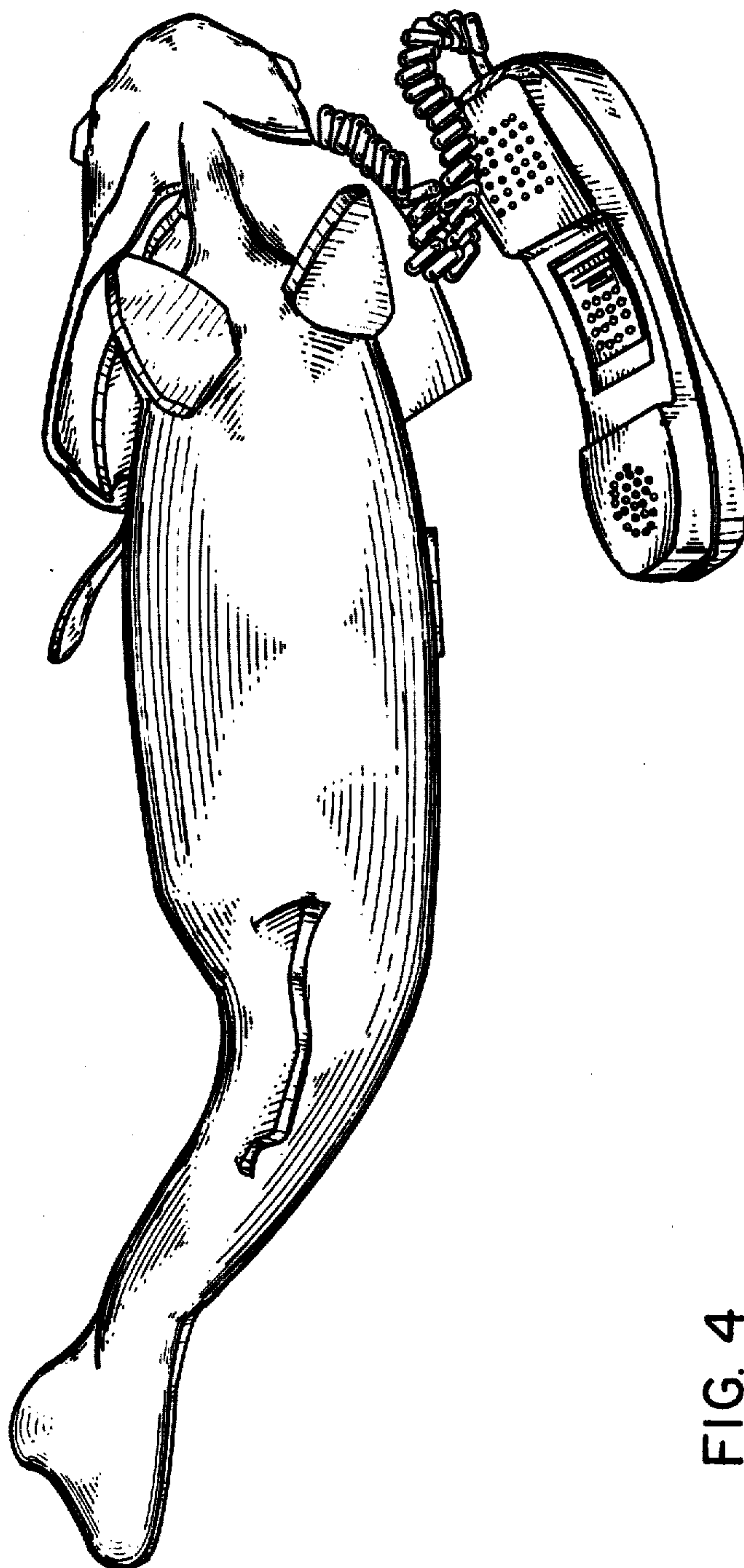

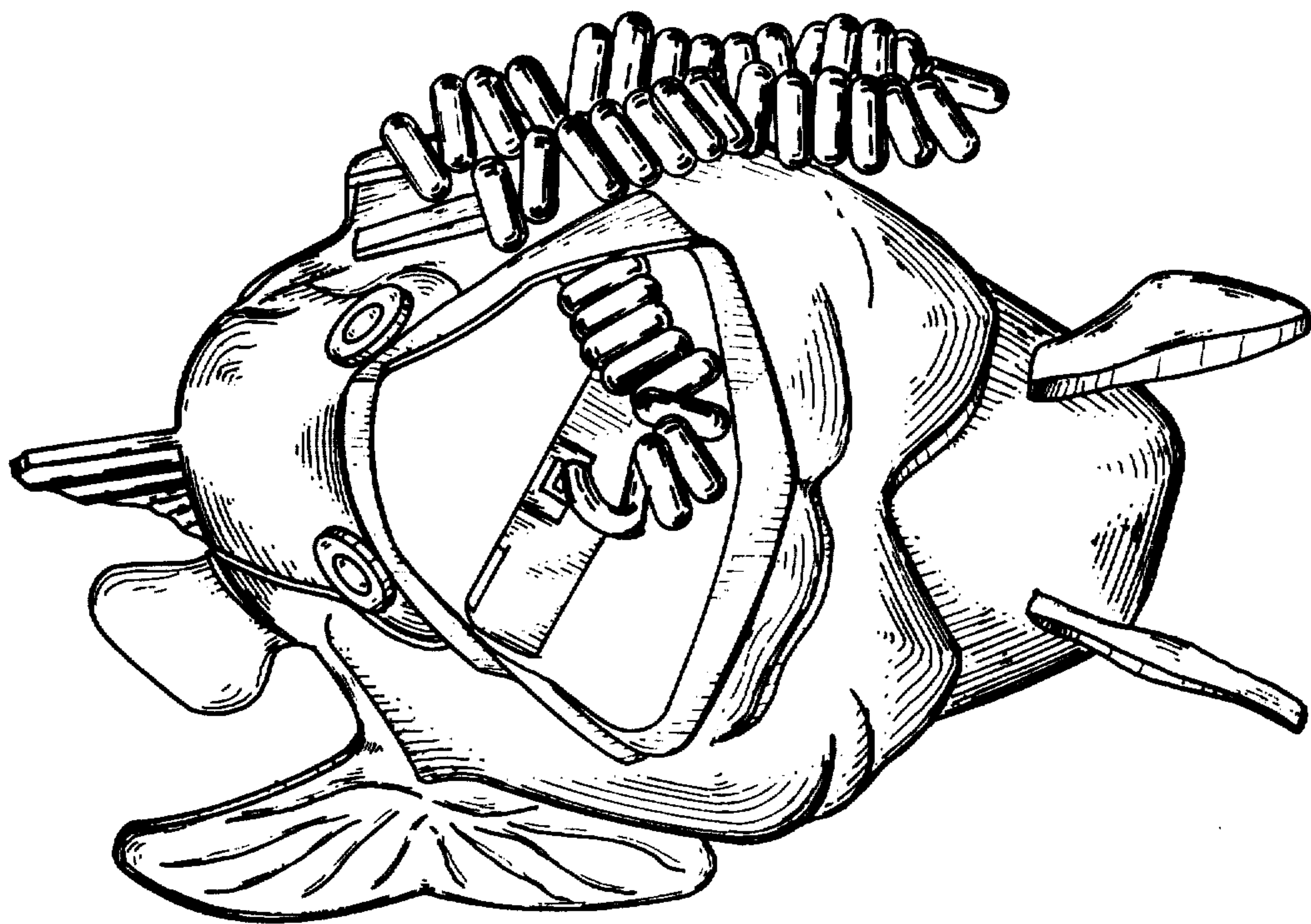

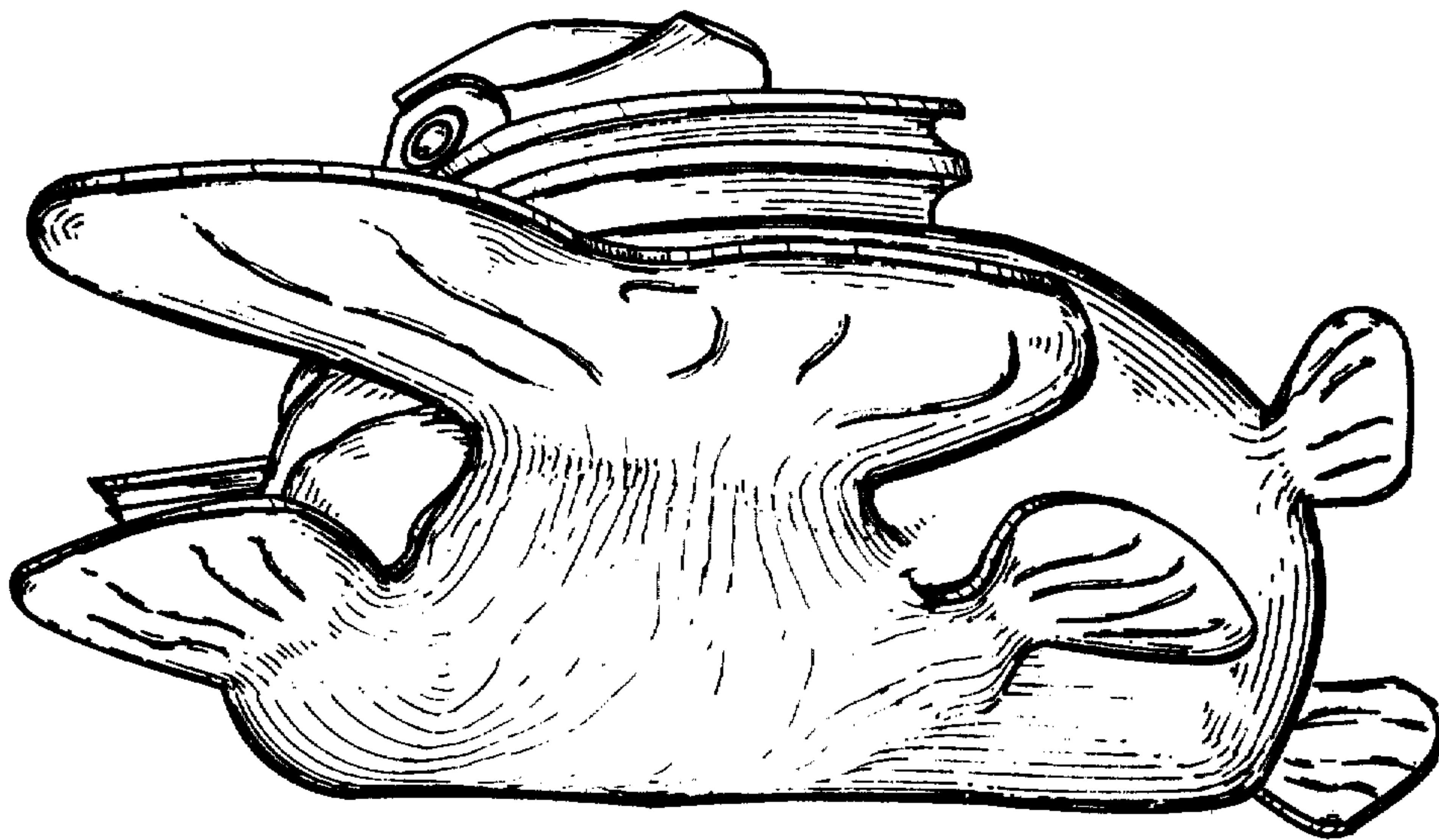
