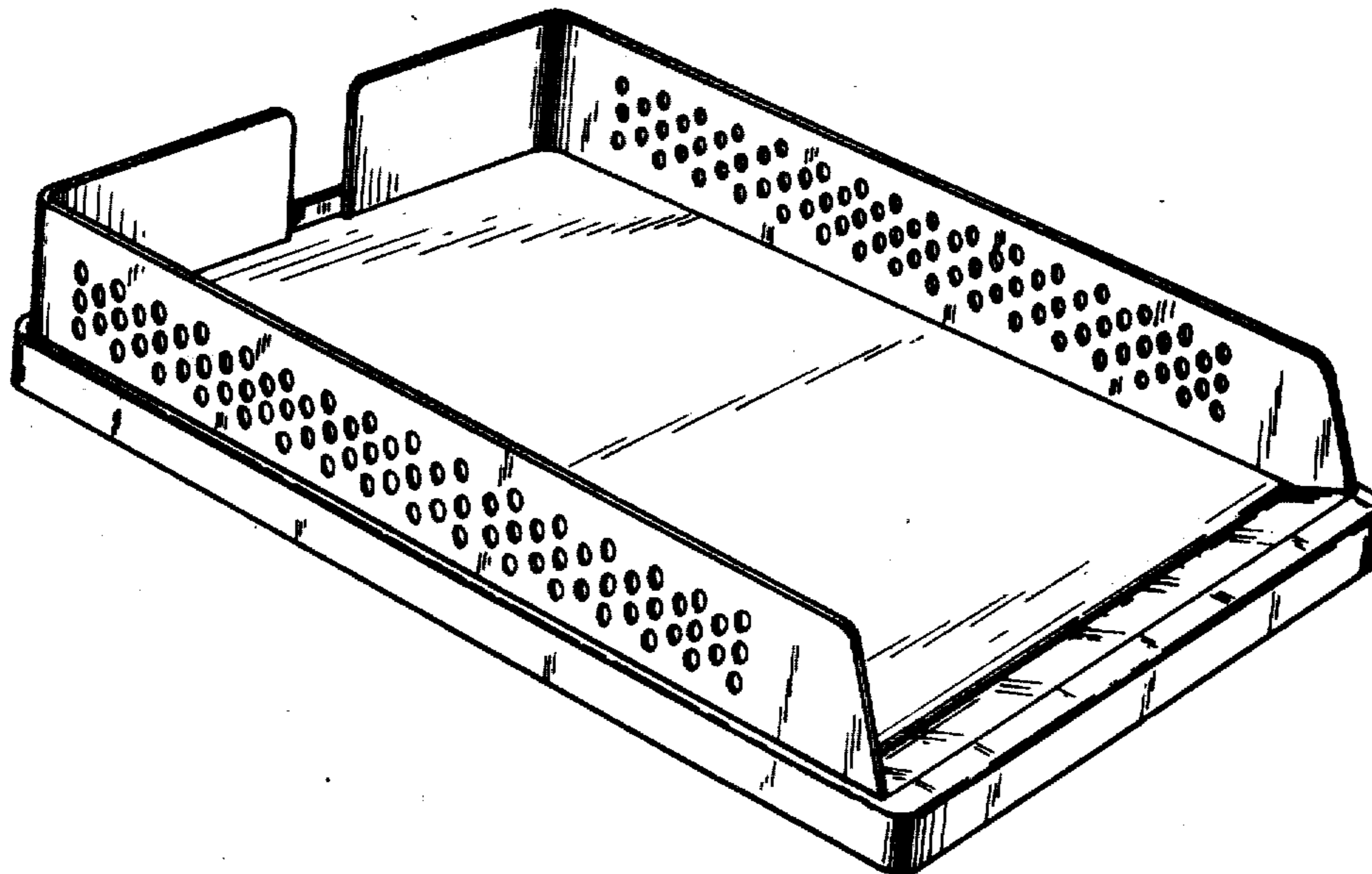

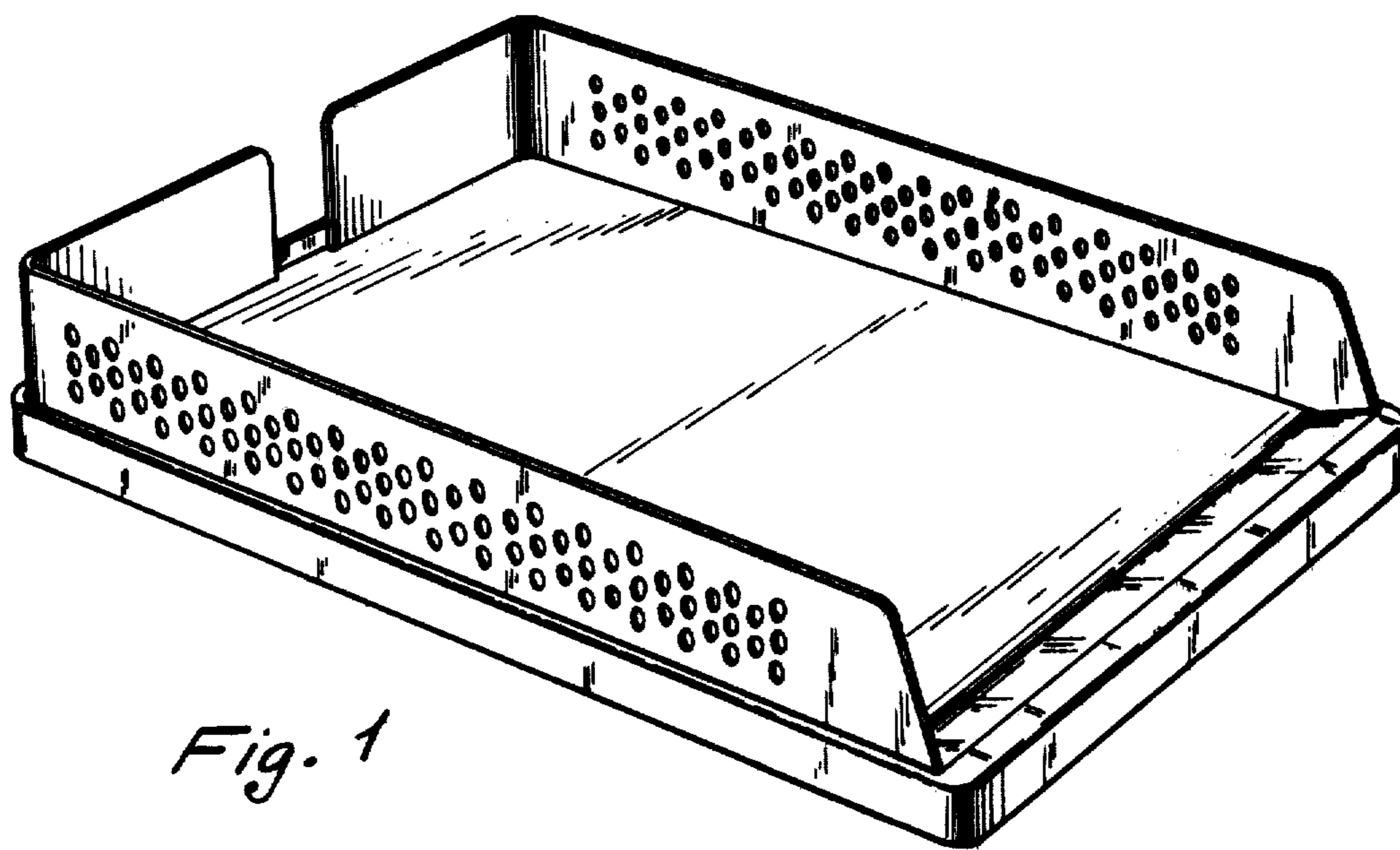

The ornamental design for a mail tray, as shown.

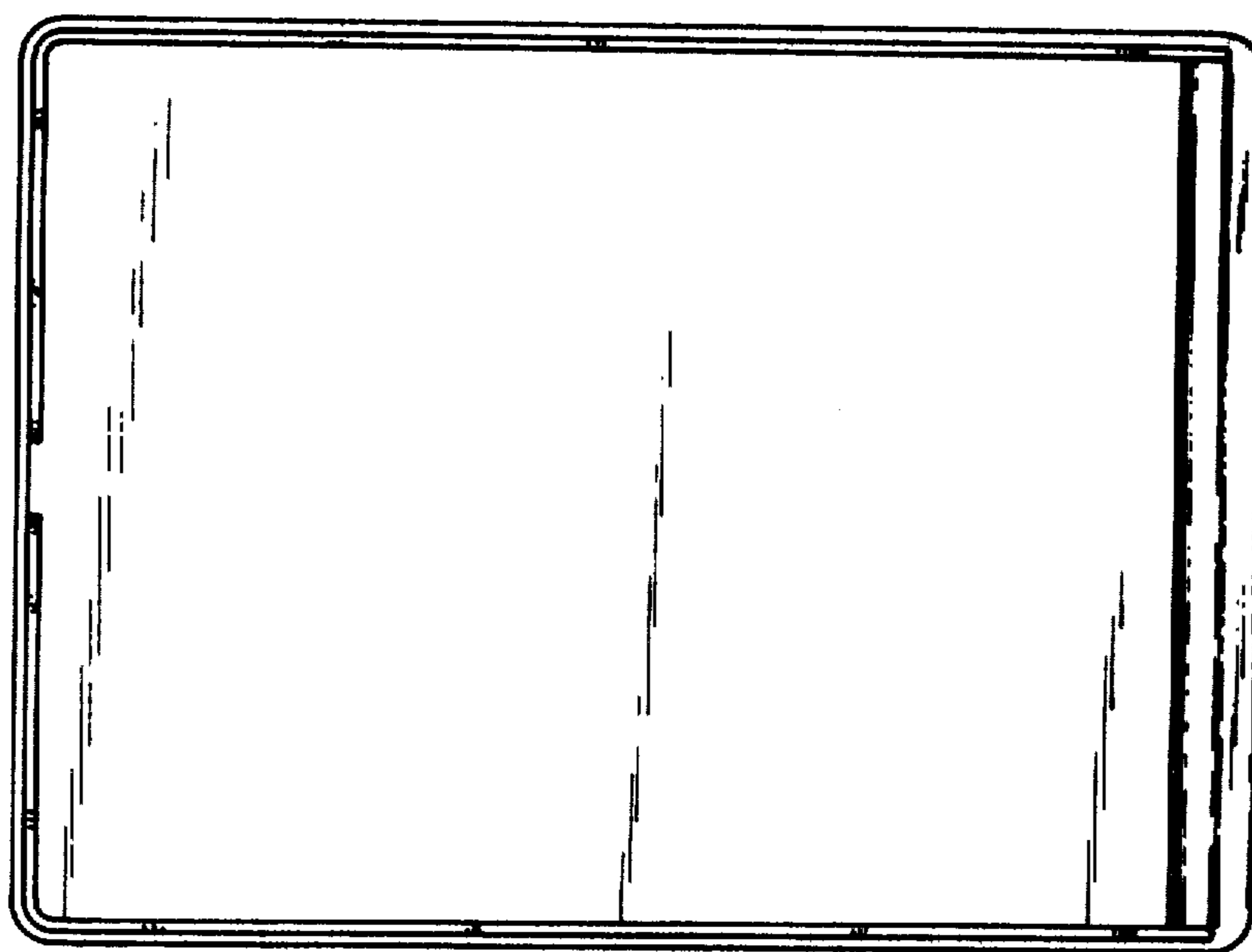
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof.

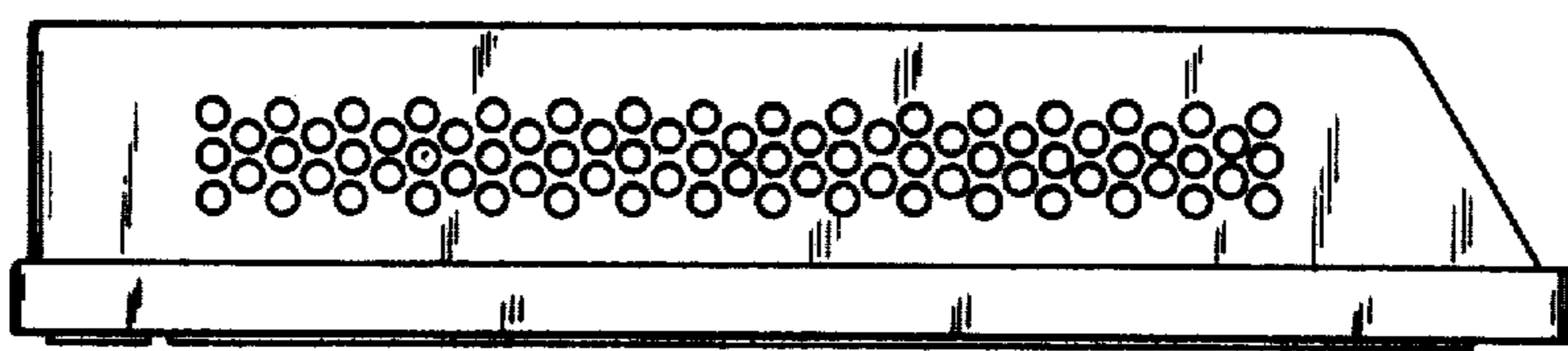




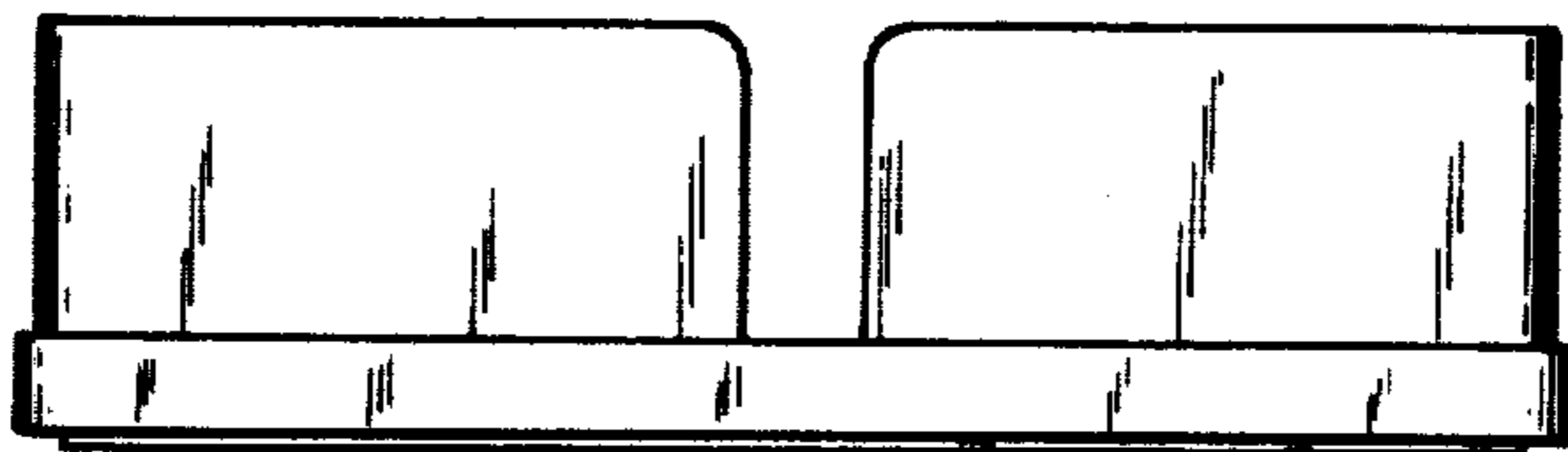

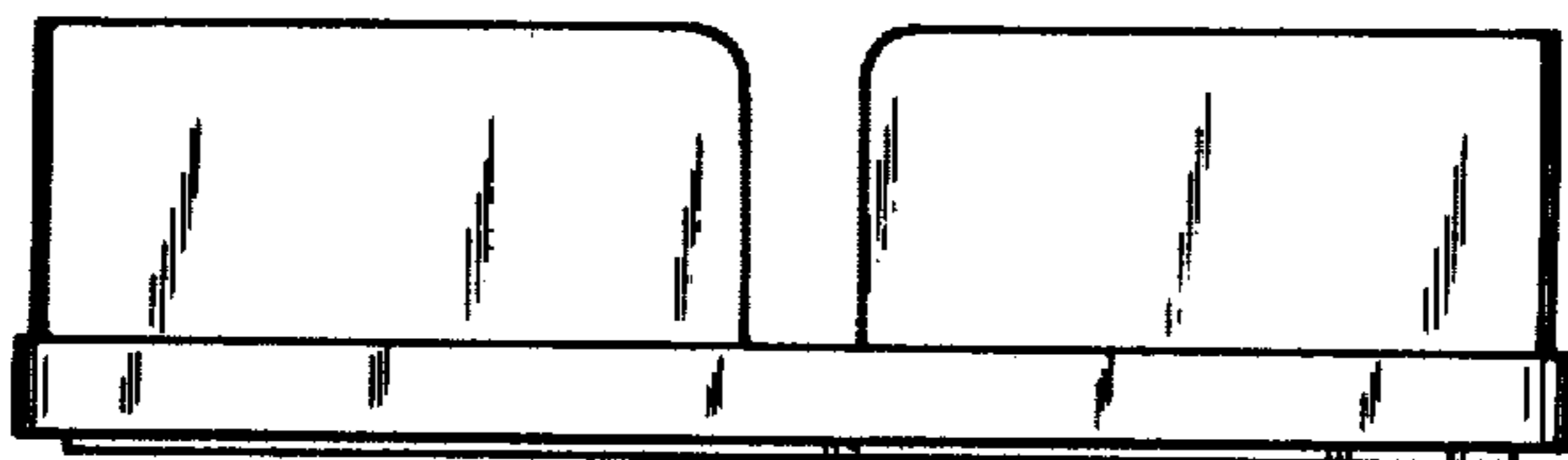
