DESCRIPTION

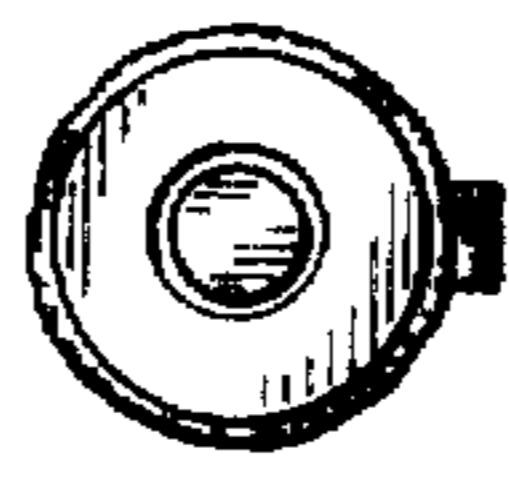

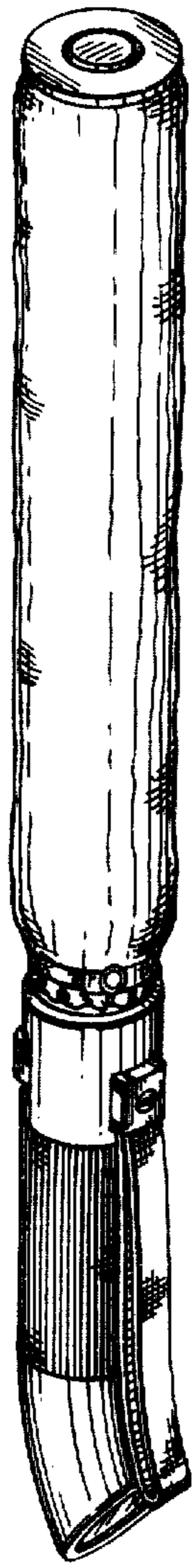
