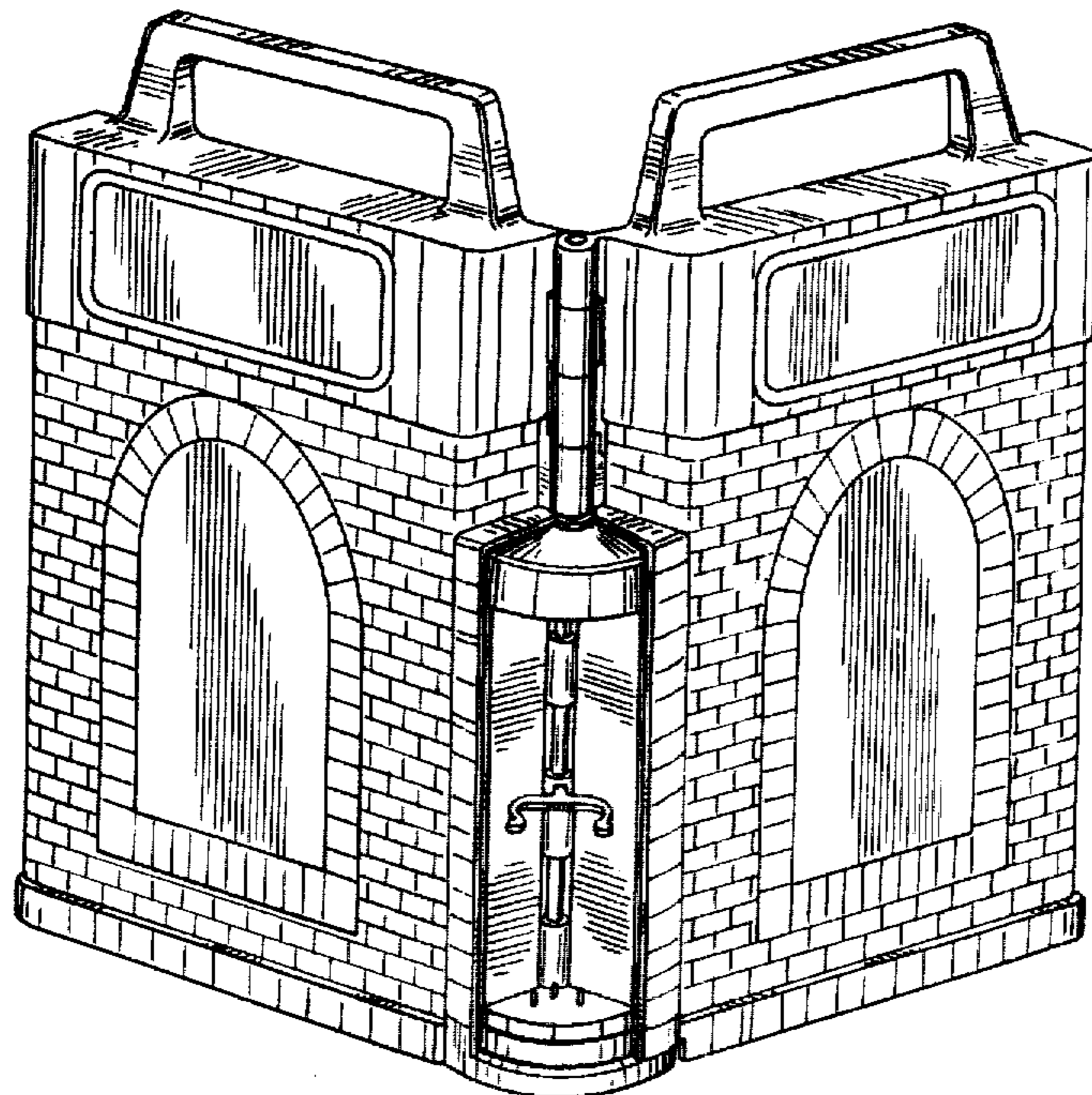

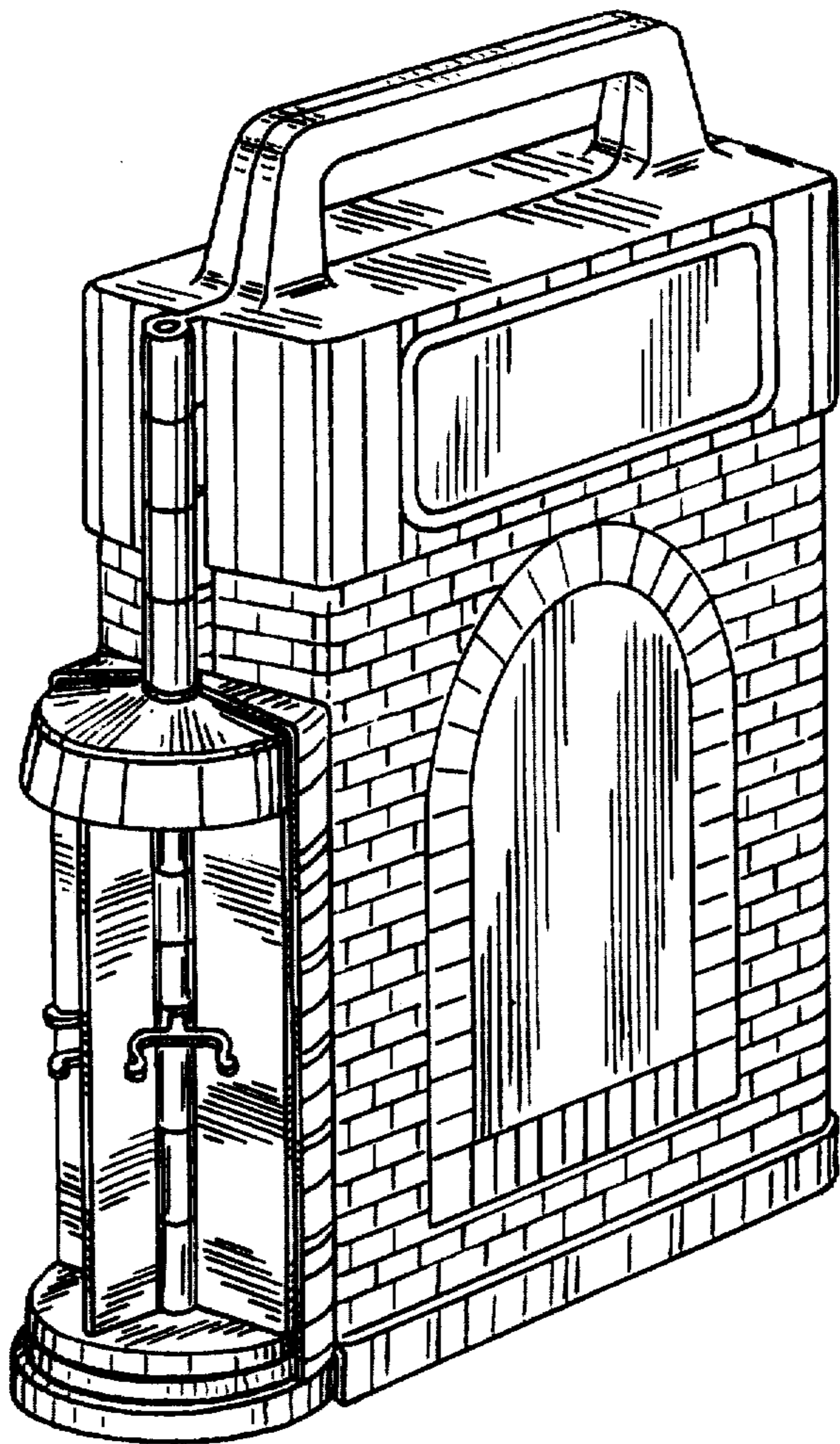
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a carrying case for dolls, substantially as shown and described.

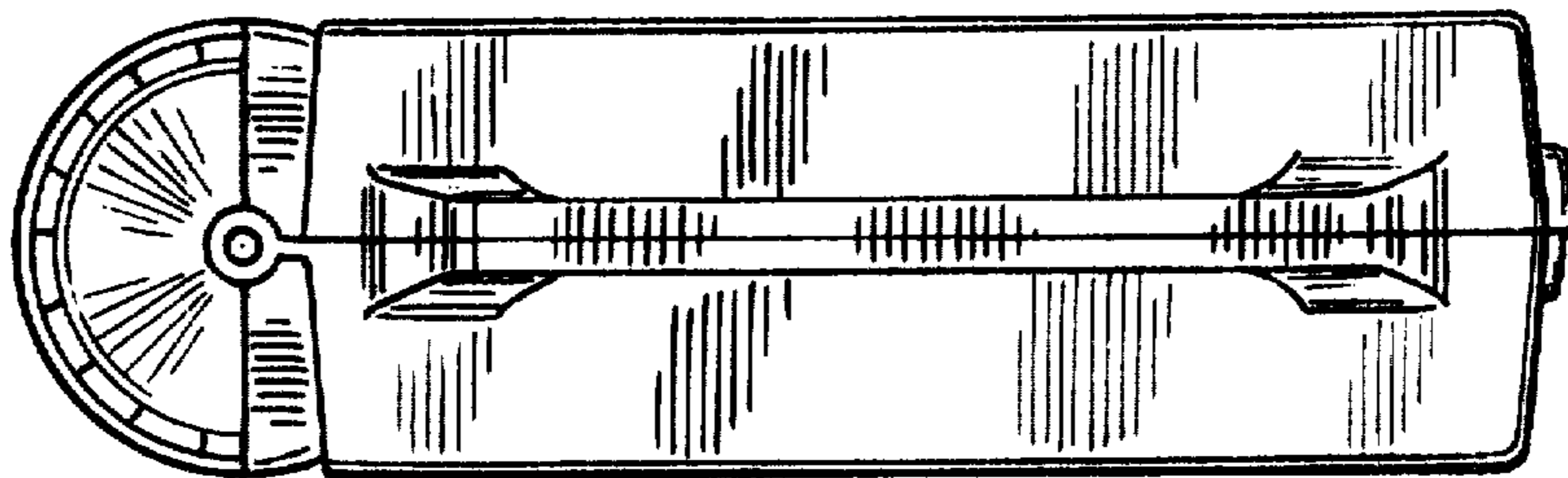
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a carrying case for dolls showing my new design in a closed condition; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, as viewed from the left of FIG. 5; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; the opposite side being substantially a mirror image thereof; FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof, as viewed from the right of FIG. 5; and FIG. 7 is a perspective view which illustrates my new design in an open condition.

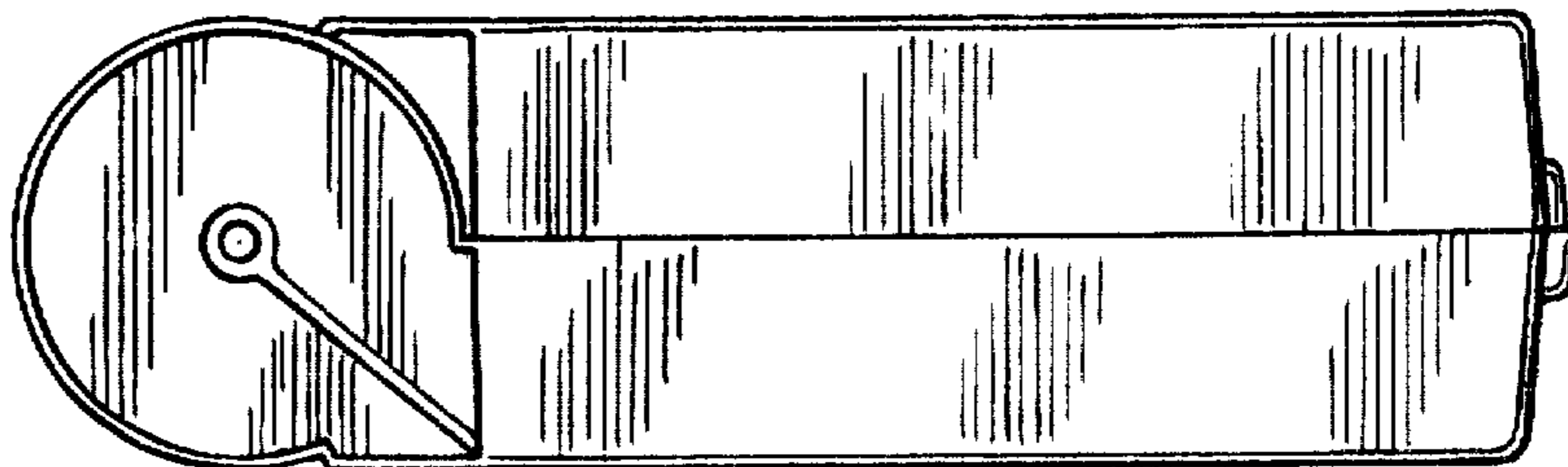

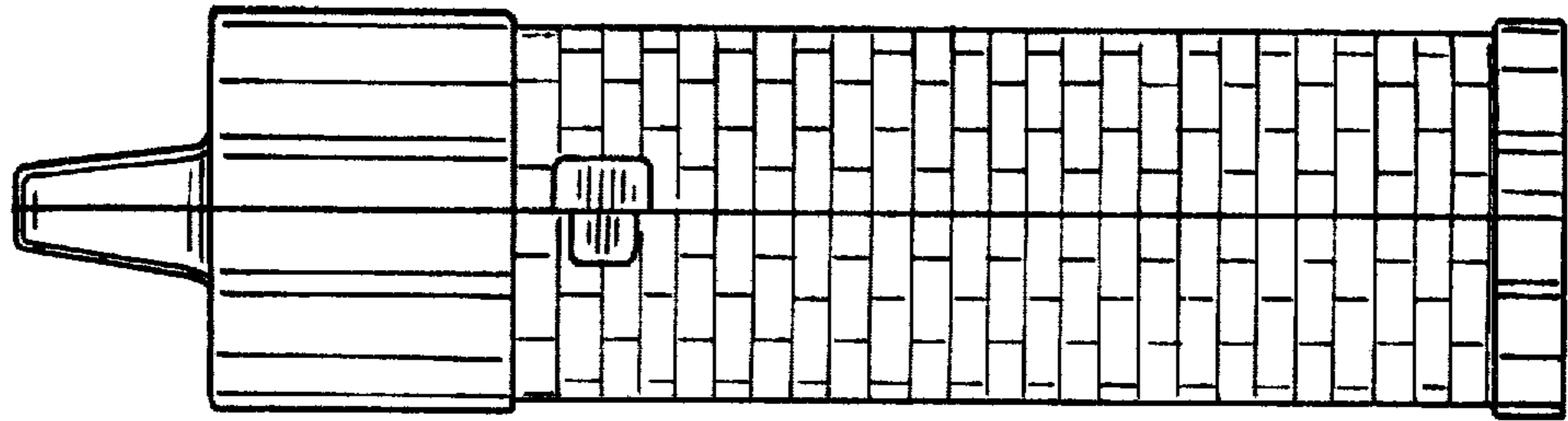

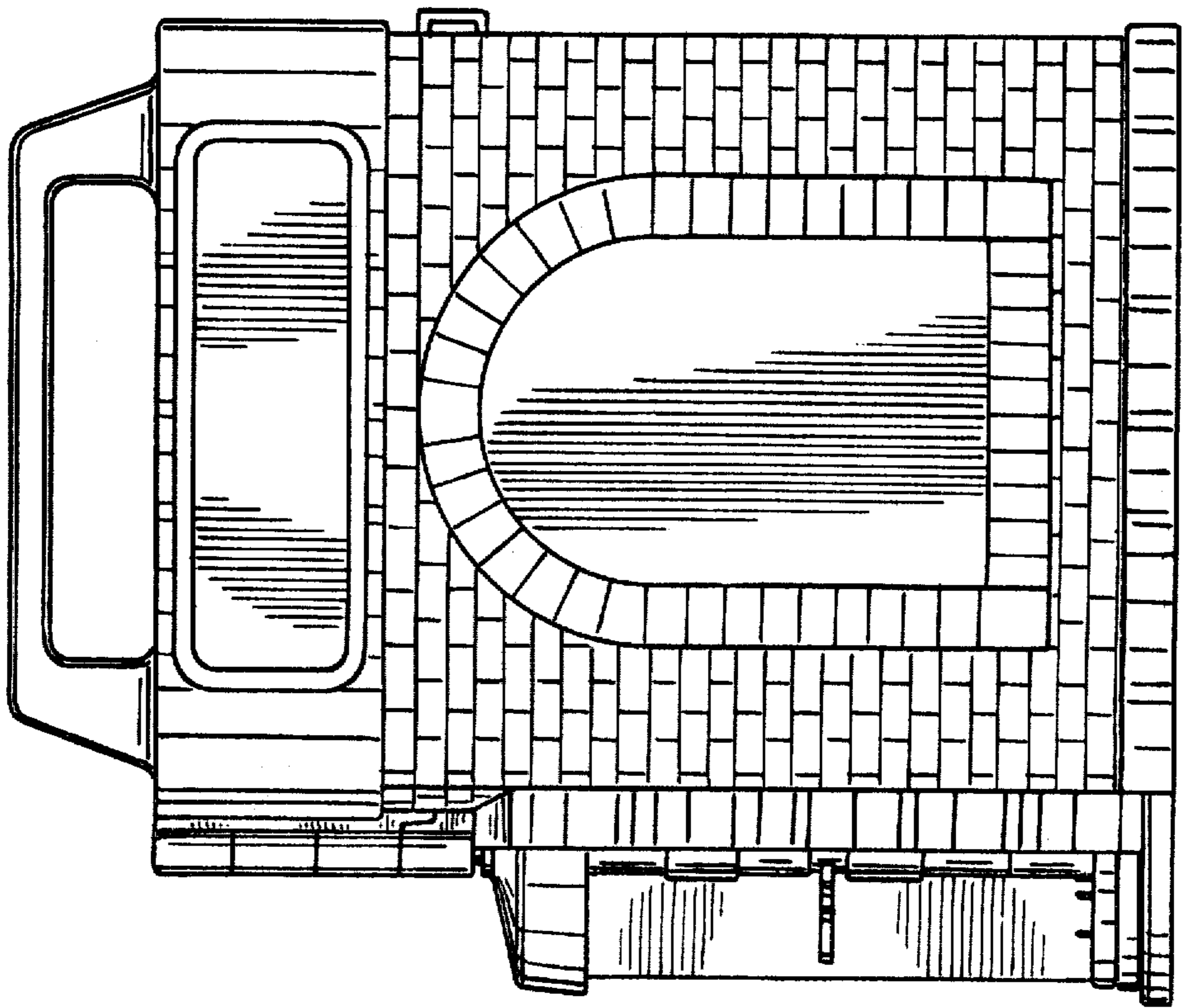

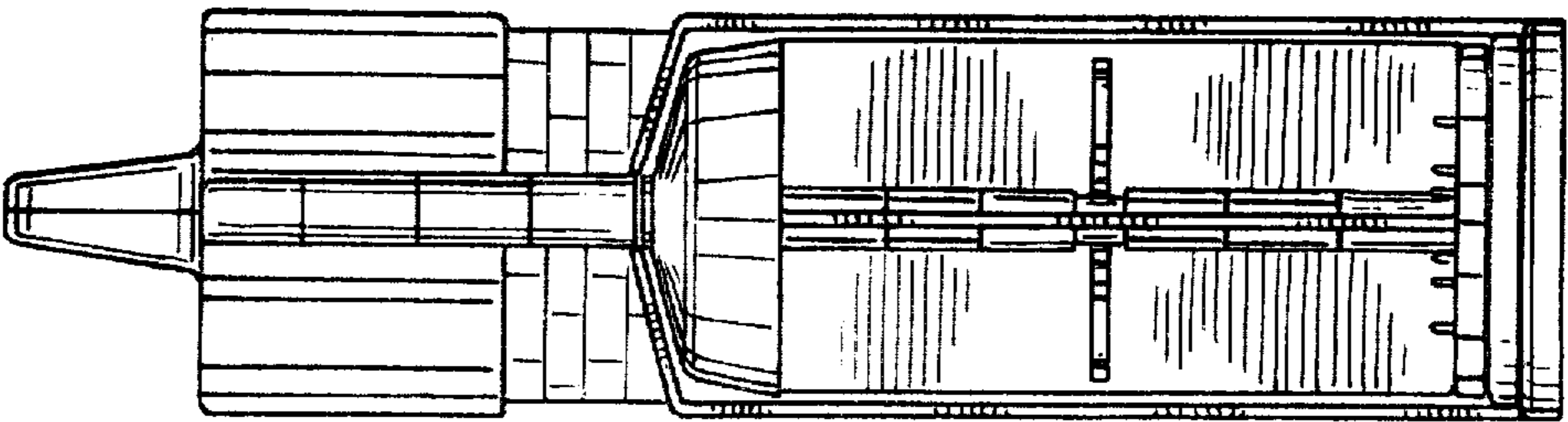
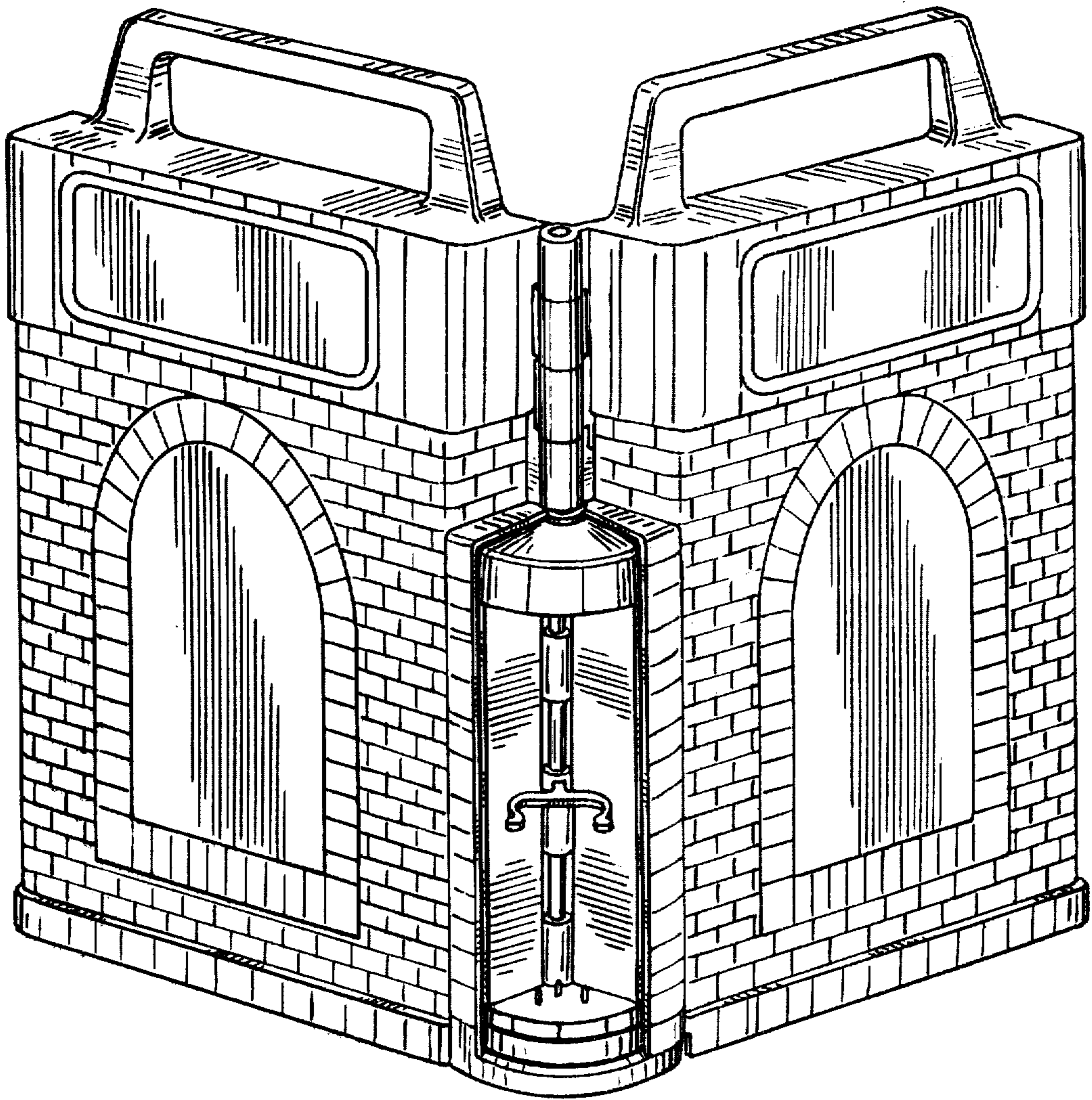
