[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a flexible container for medical liquids, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a flexible container for medical liquids, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevational thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

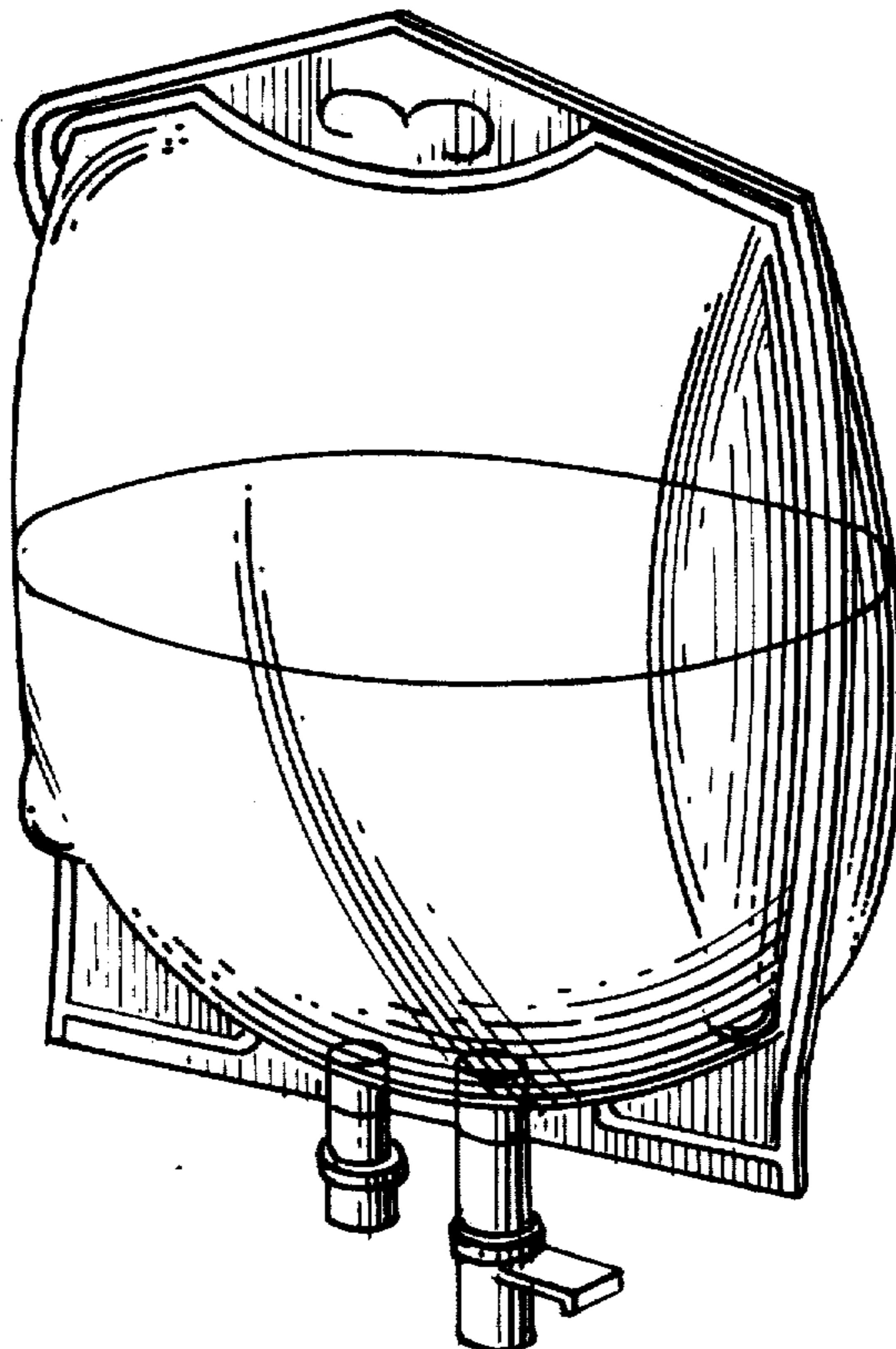

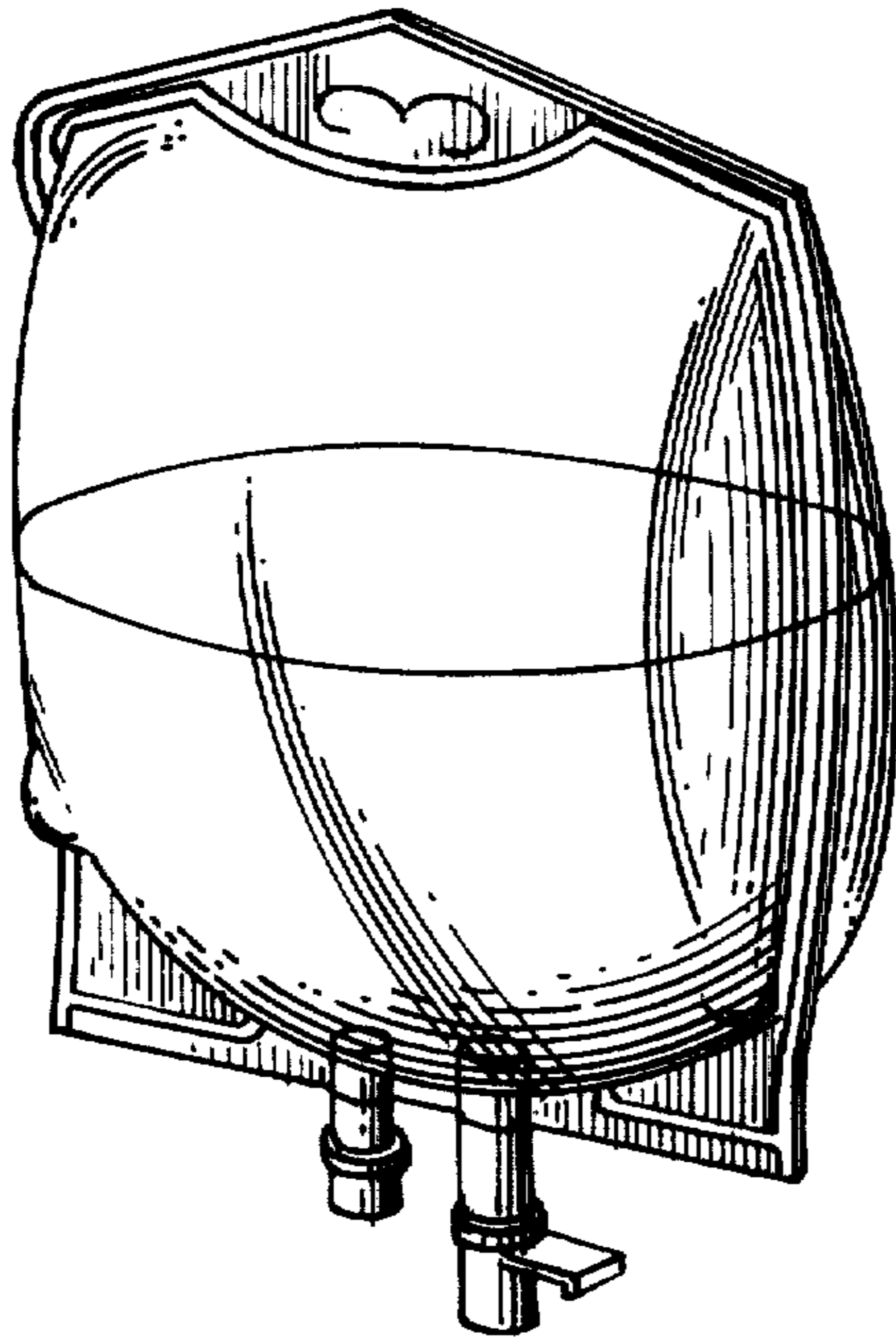

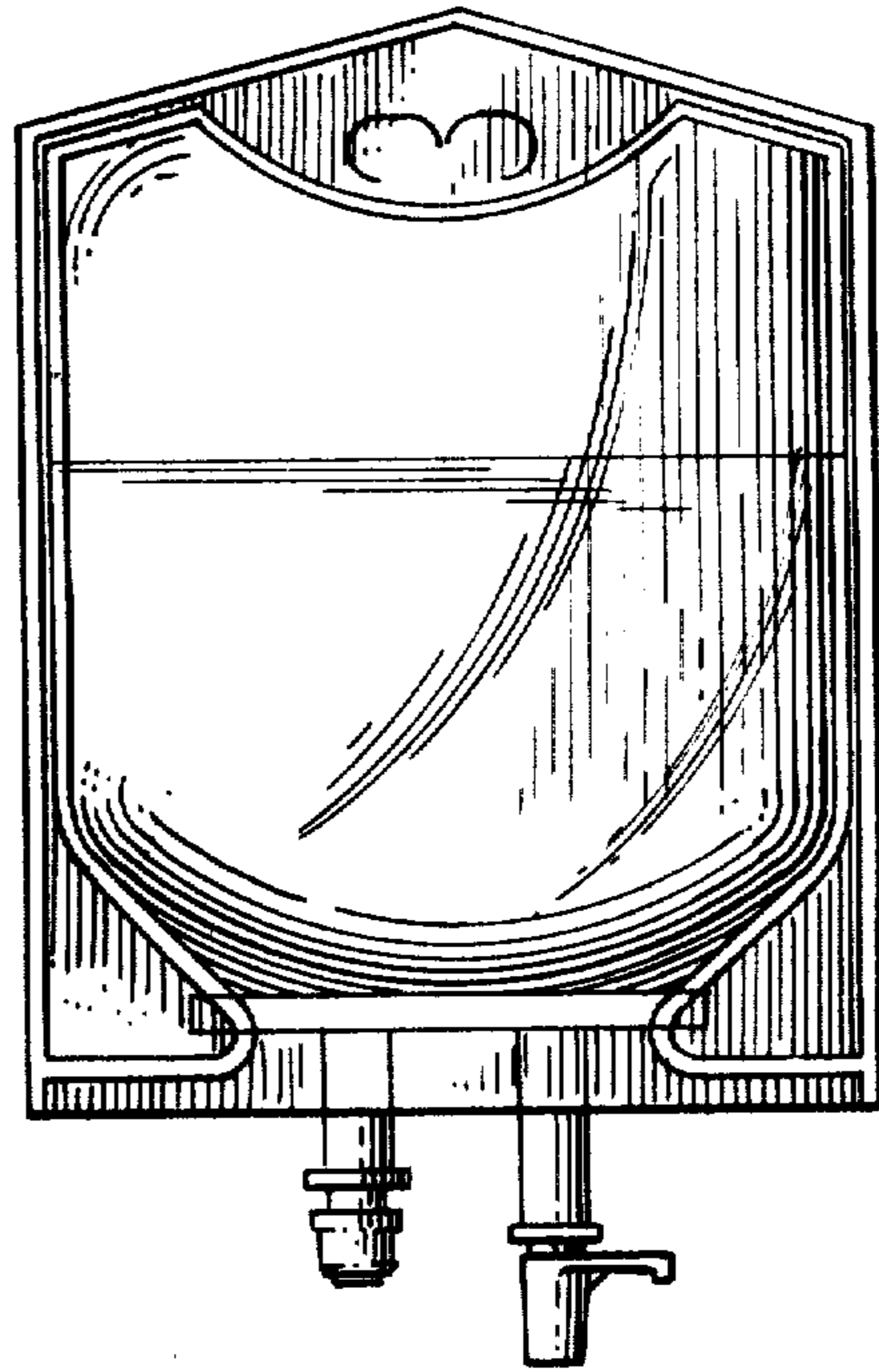

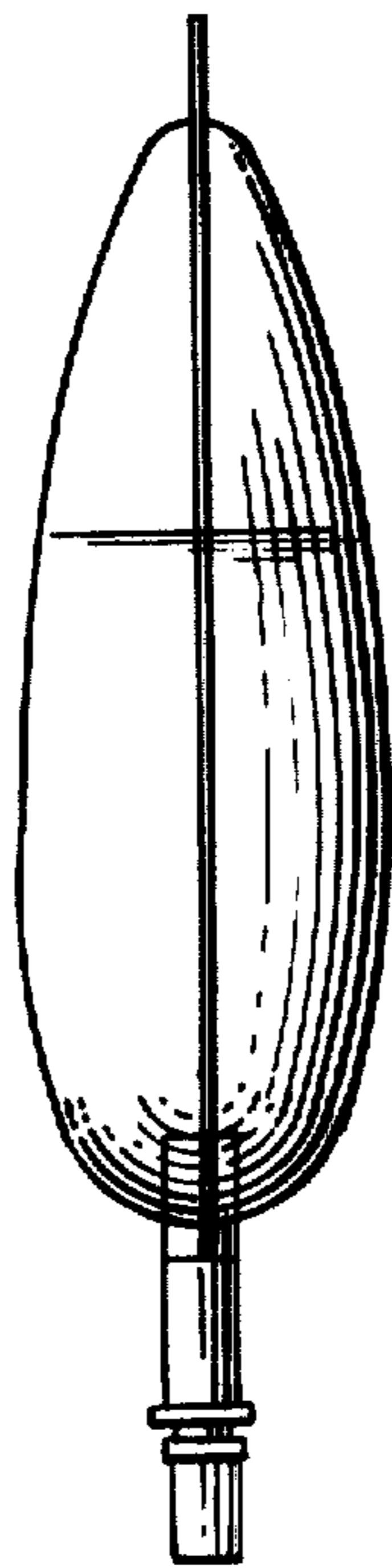
