FIG. 6 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 4, the side opposite being a mirror image thereof.

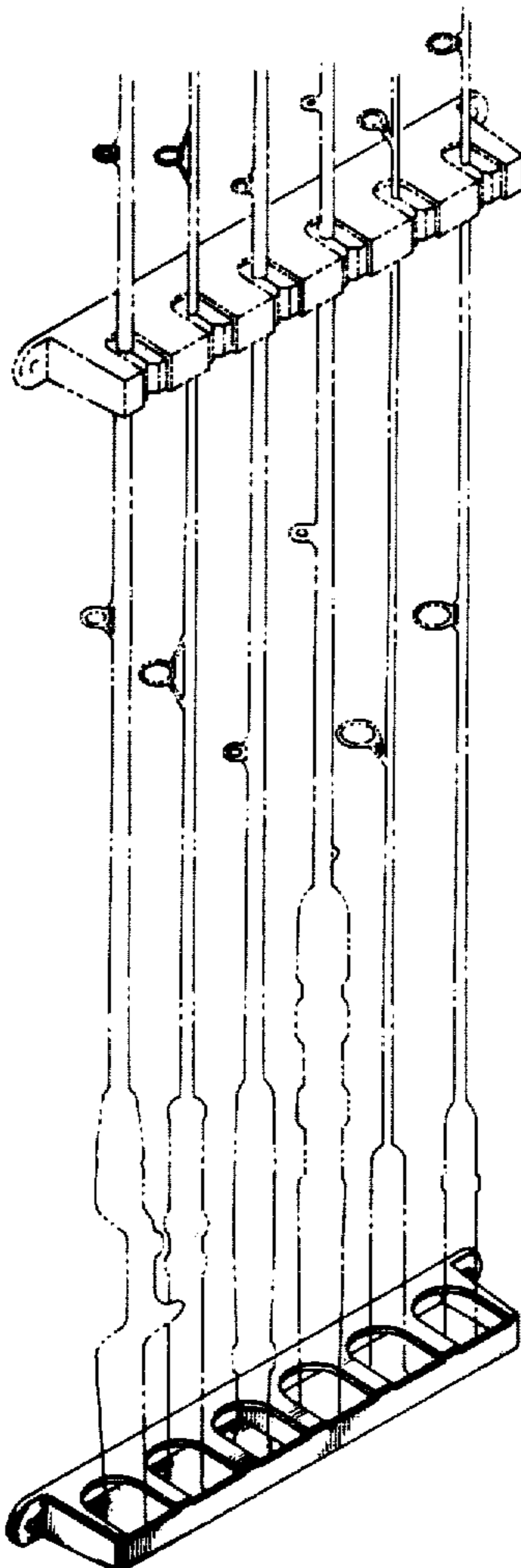

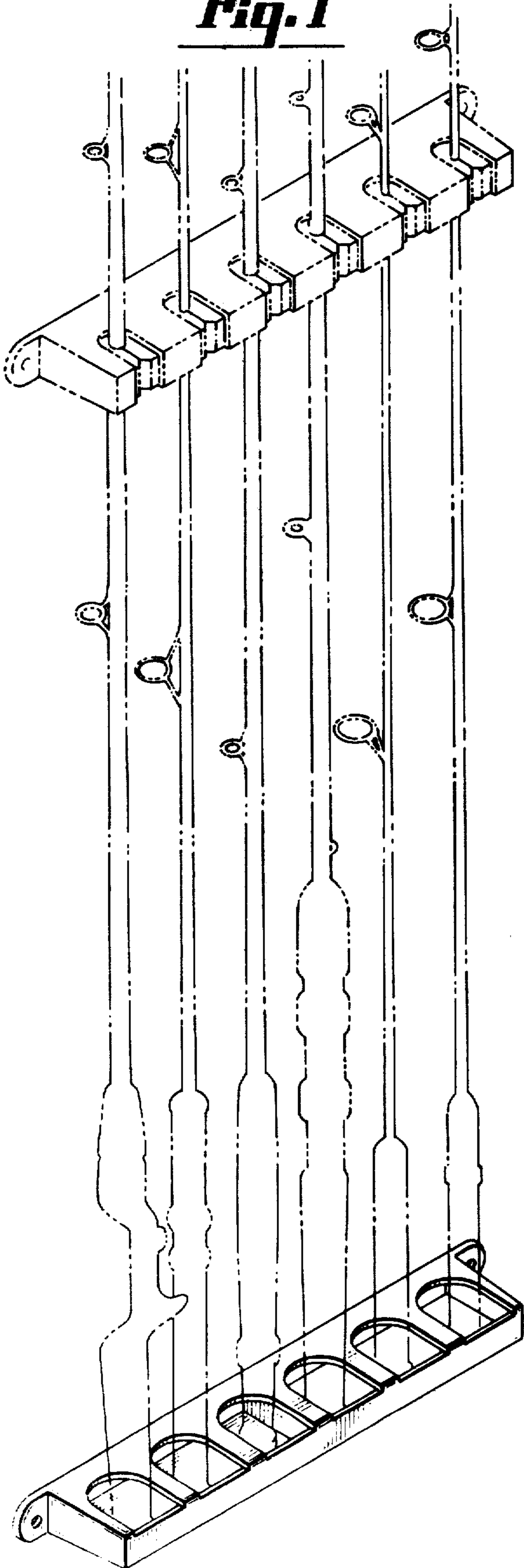

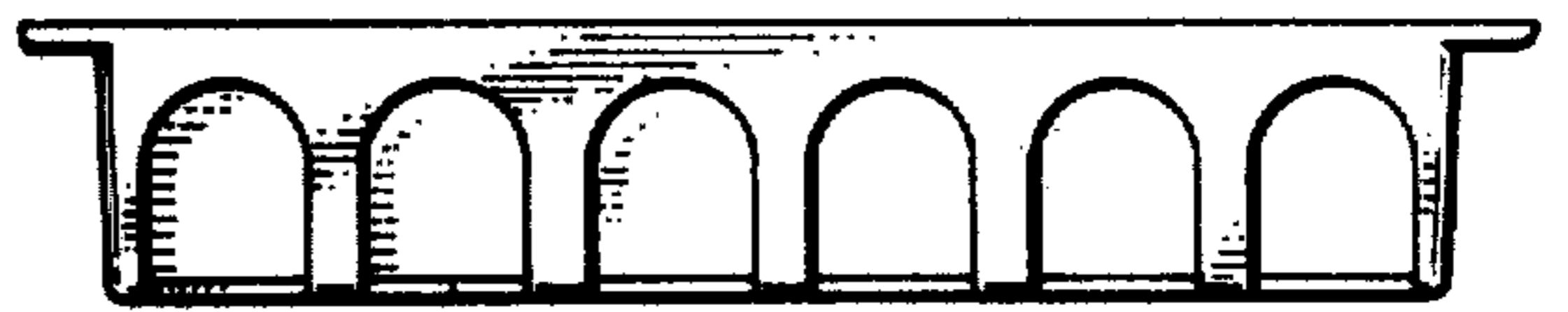
