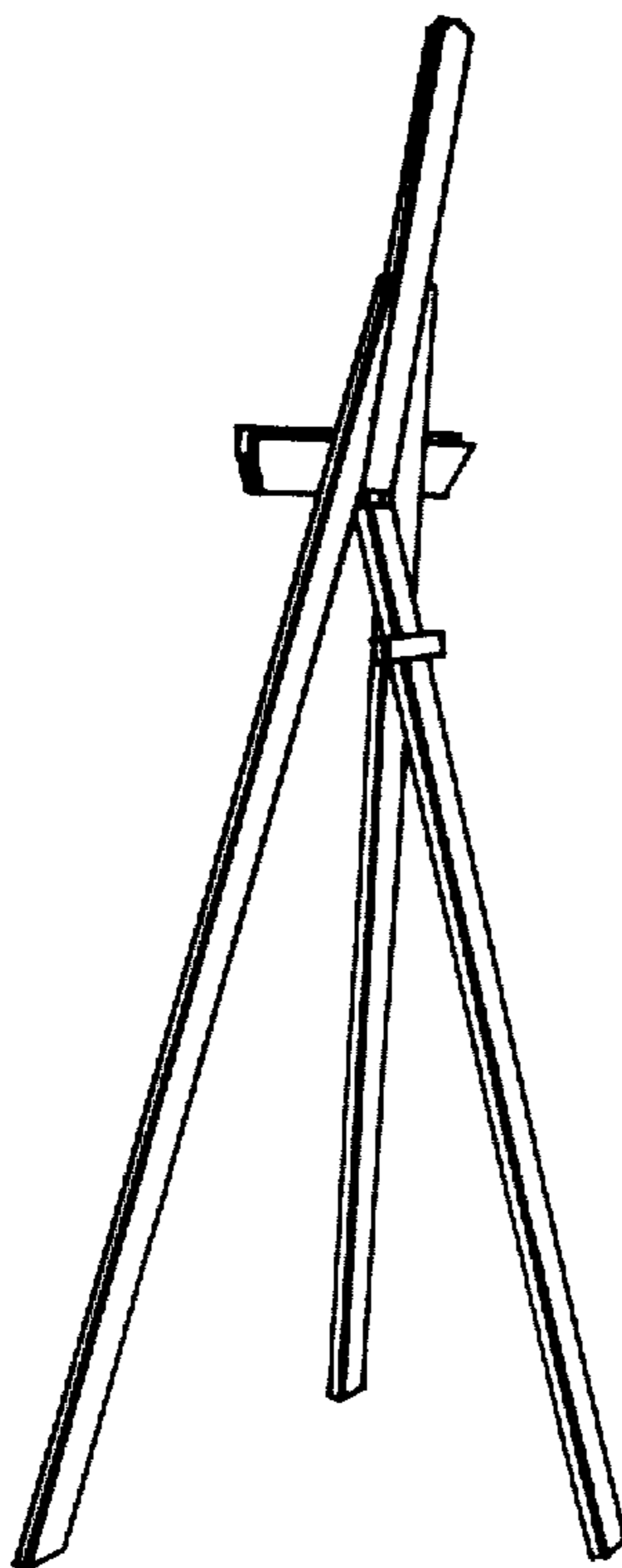

FIG. 2 is a perspective side and rear view.



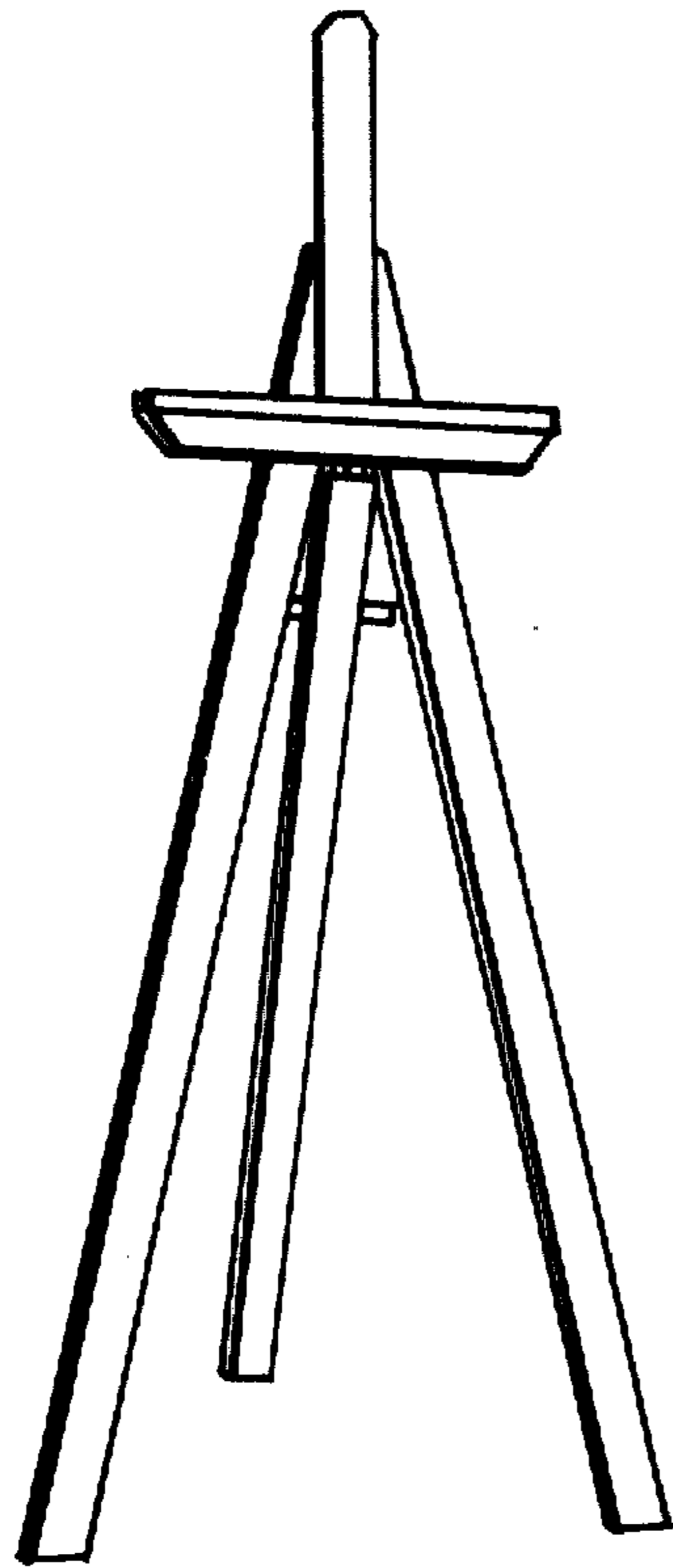

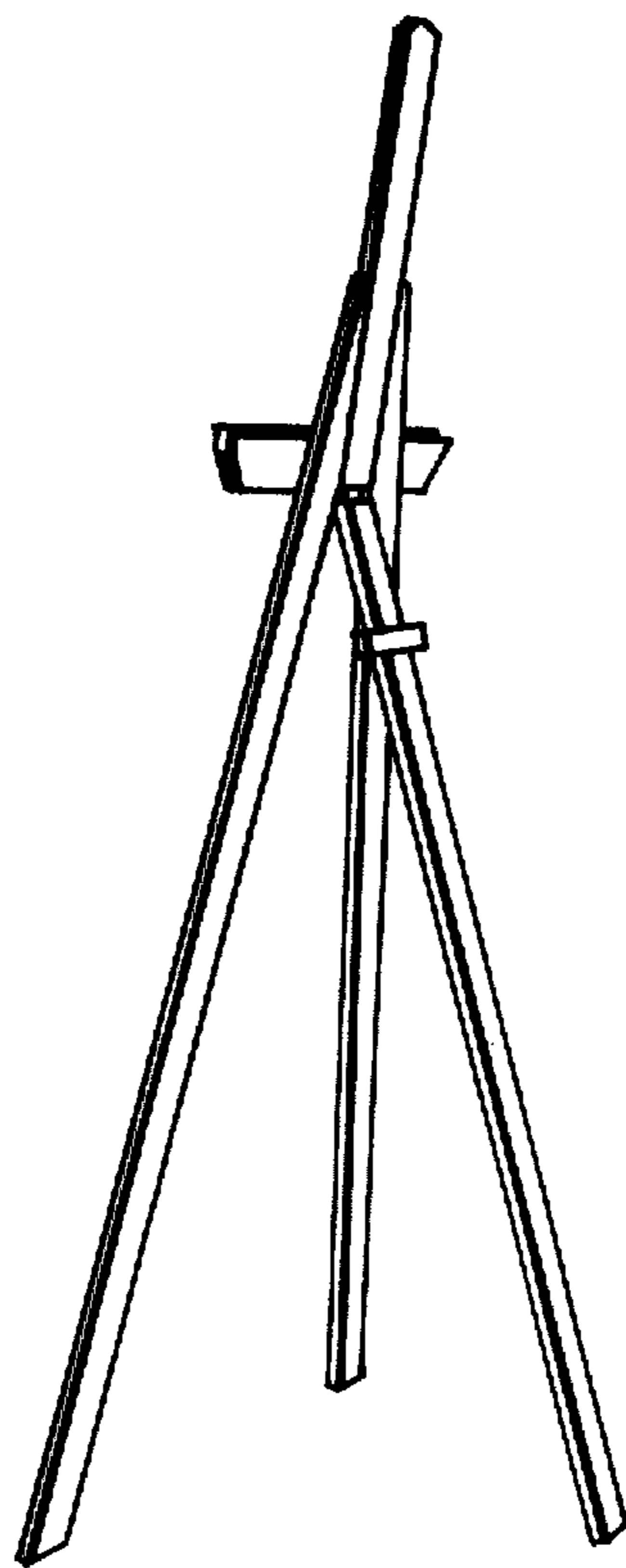
