FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

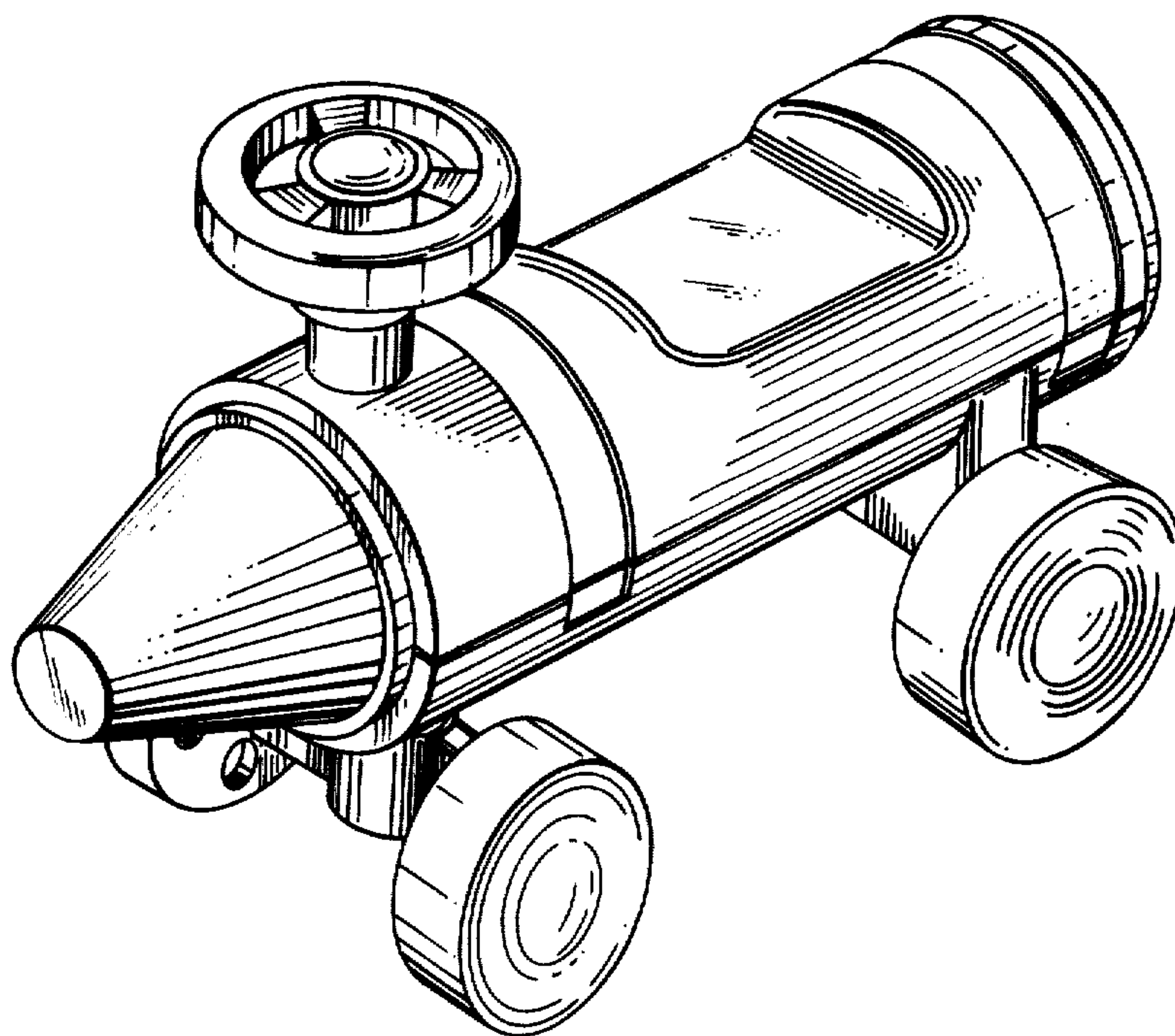
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



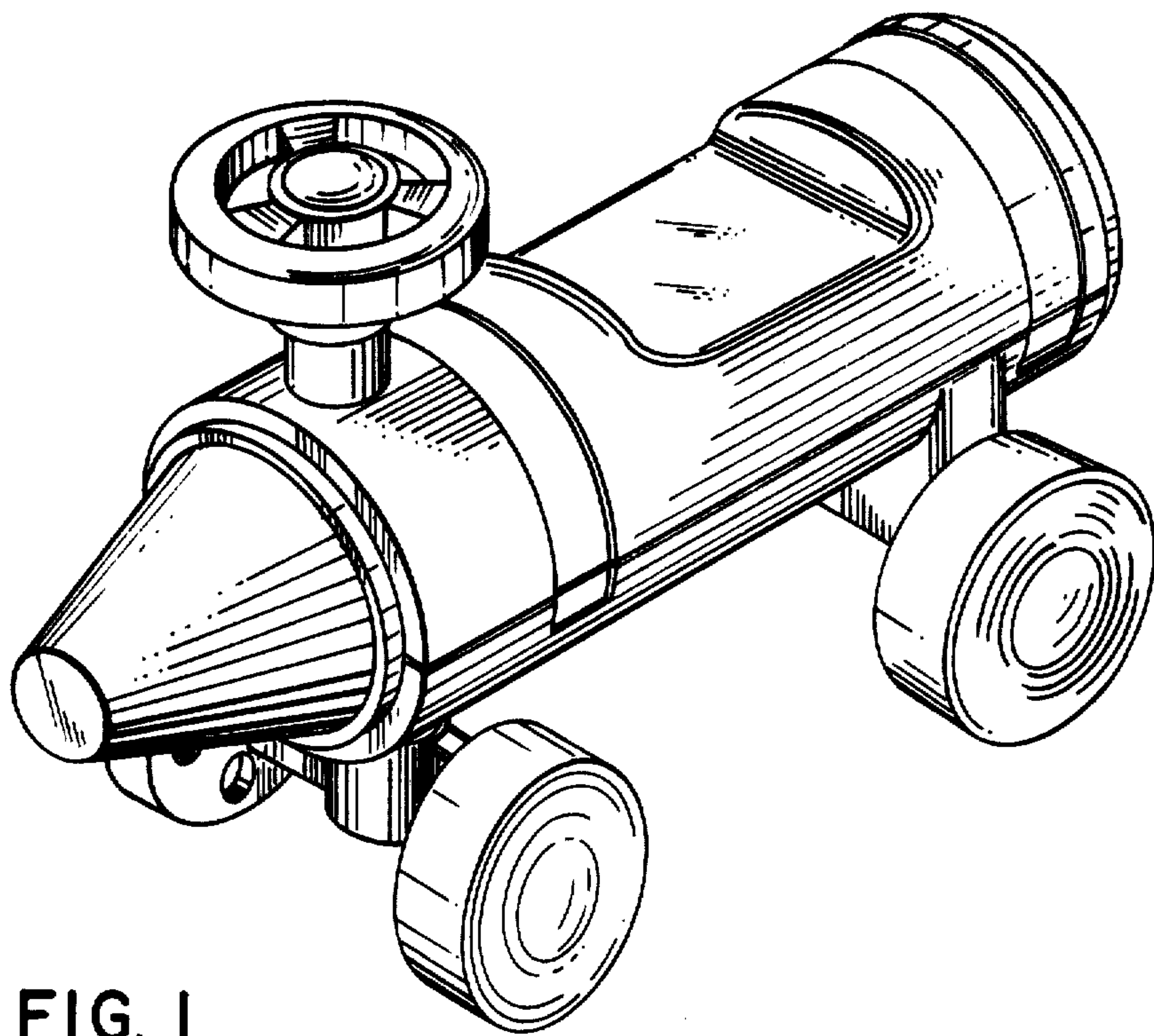

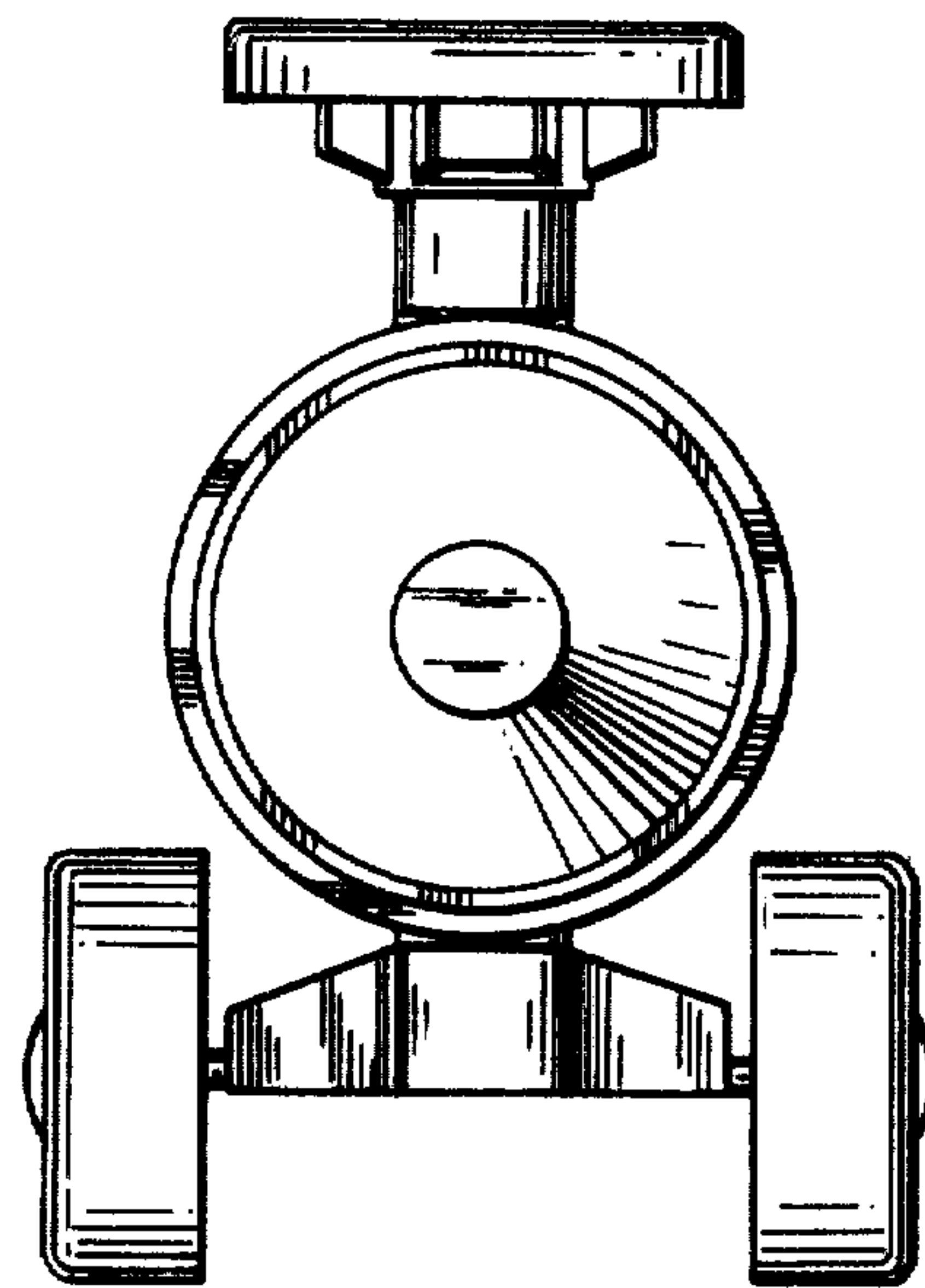

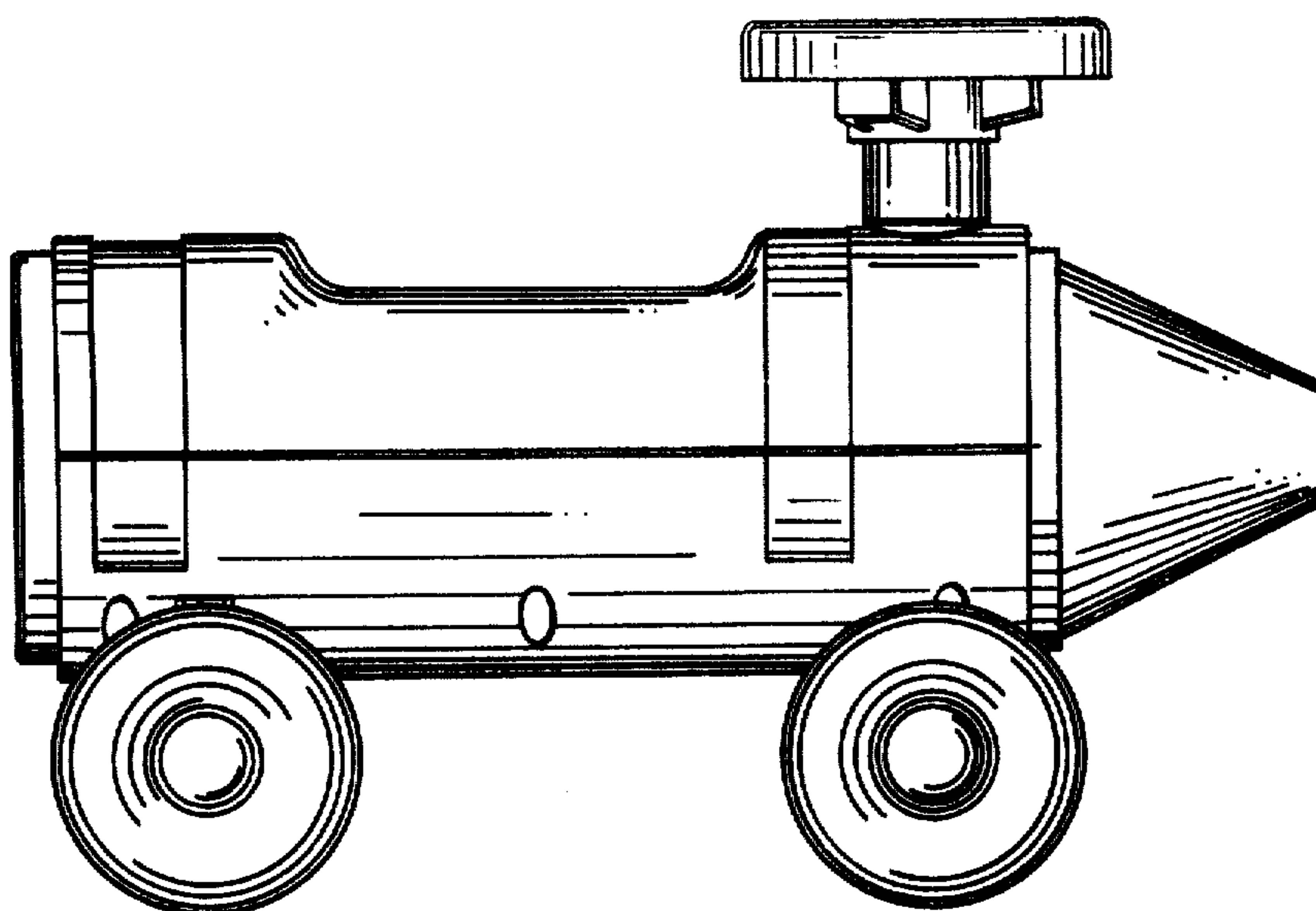

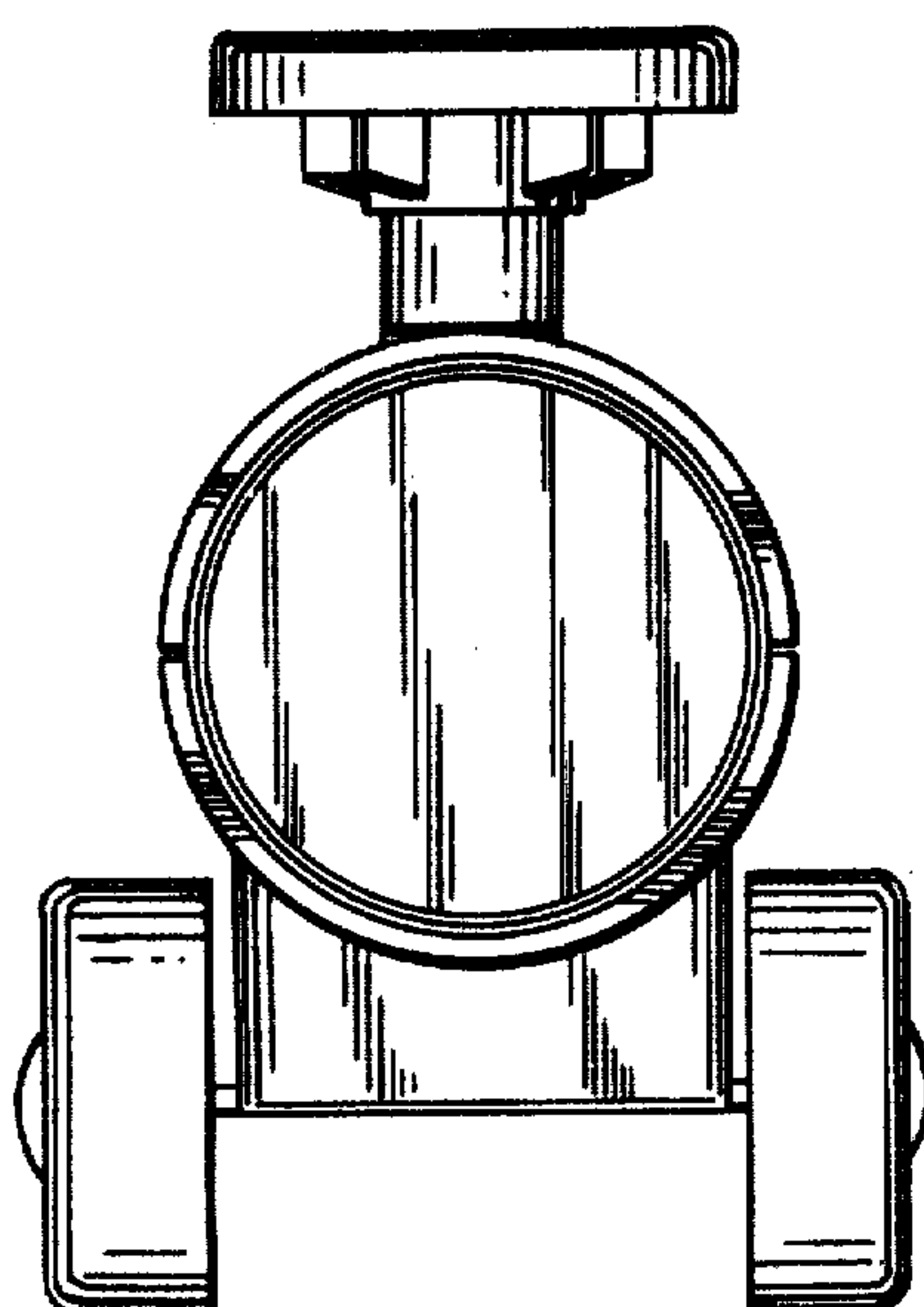
