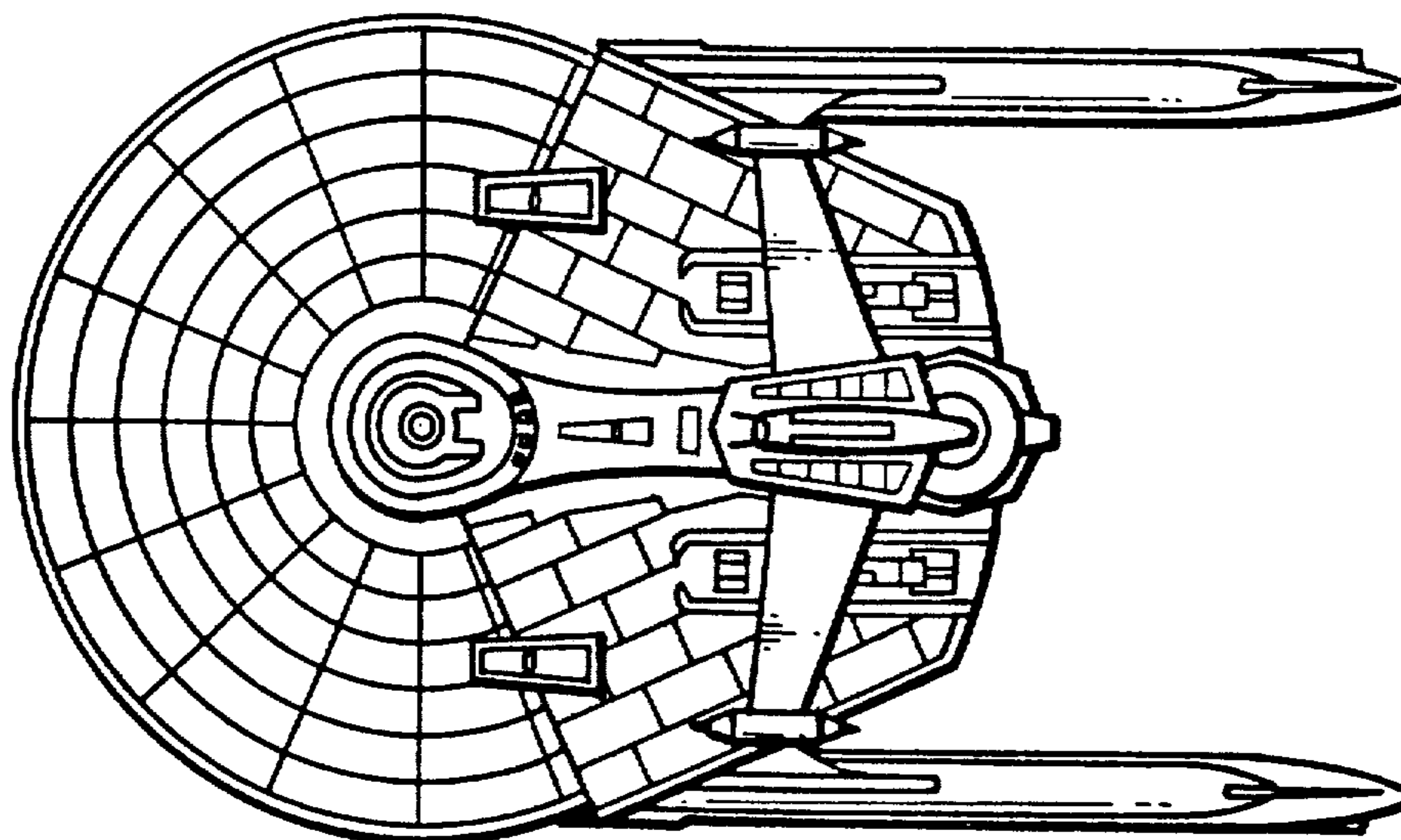

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy spaceship, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a toy spaceship showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



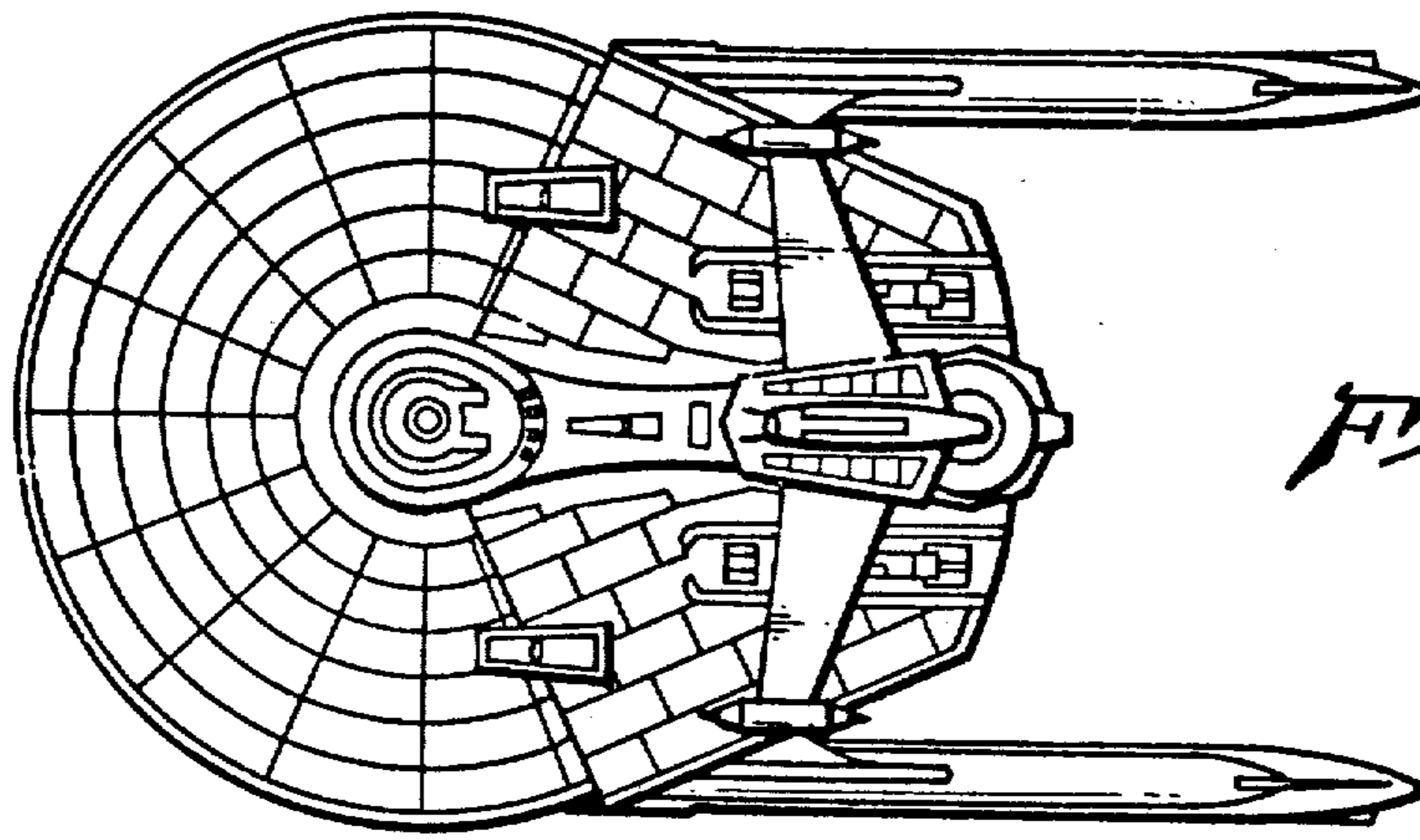

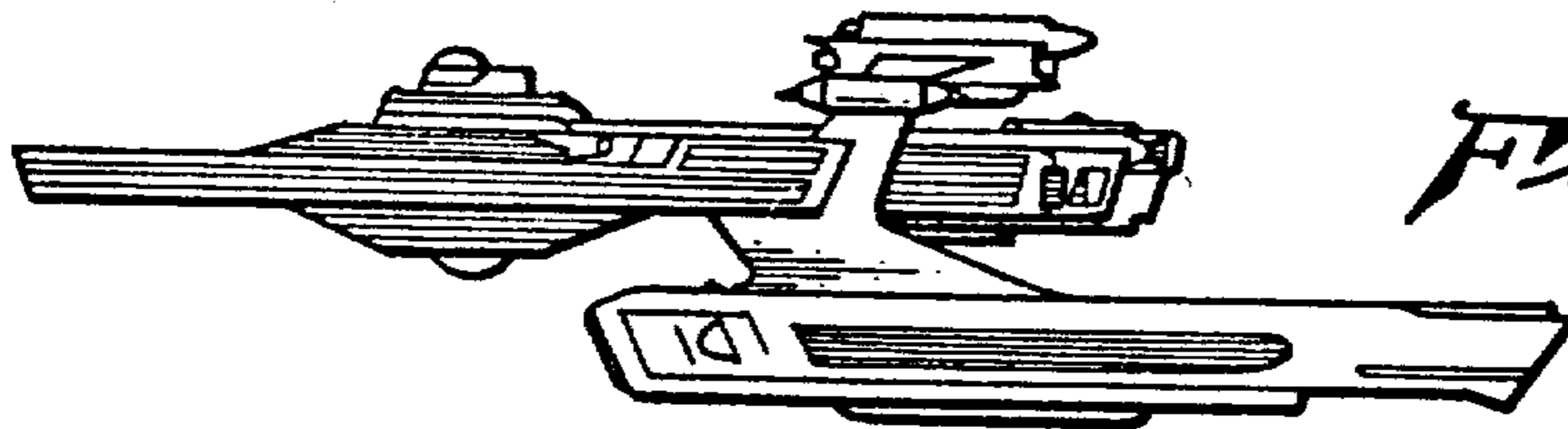

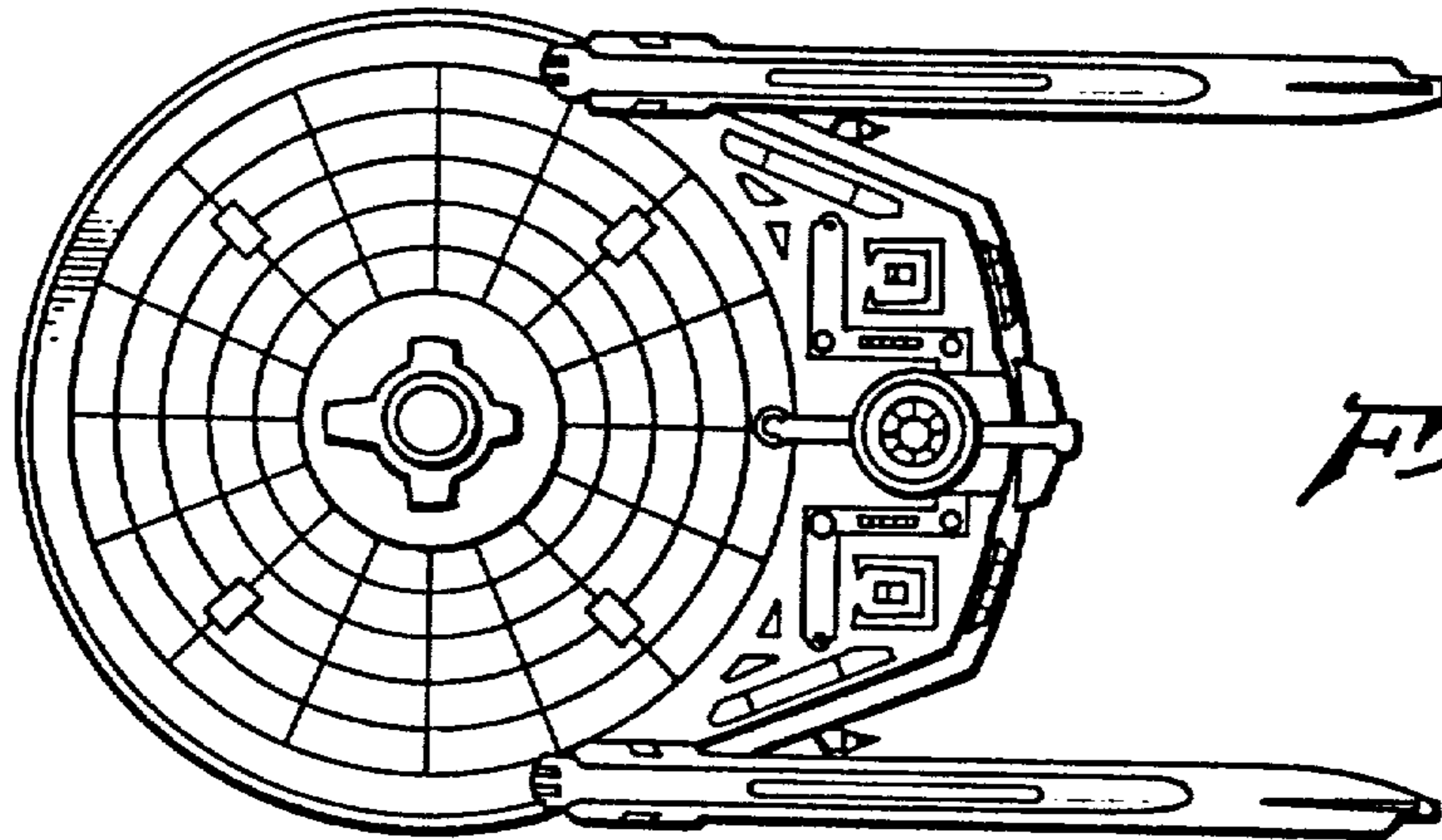

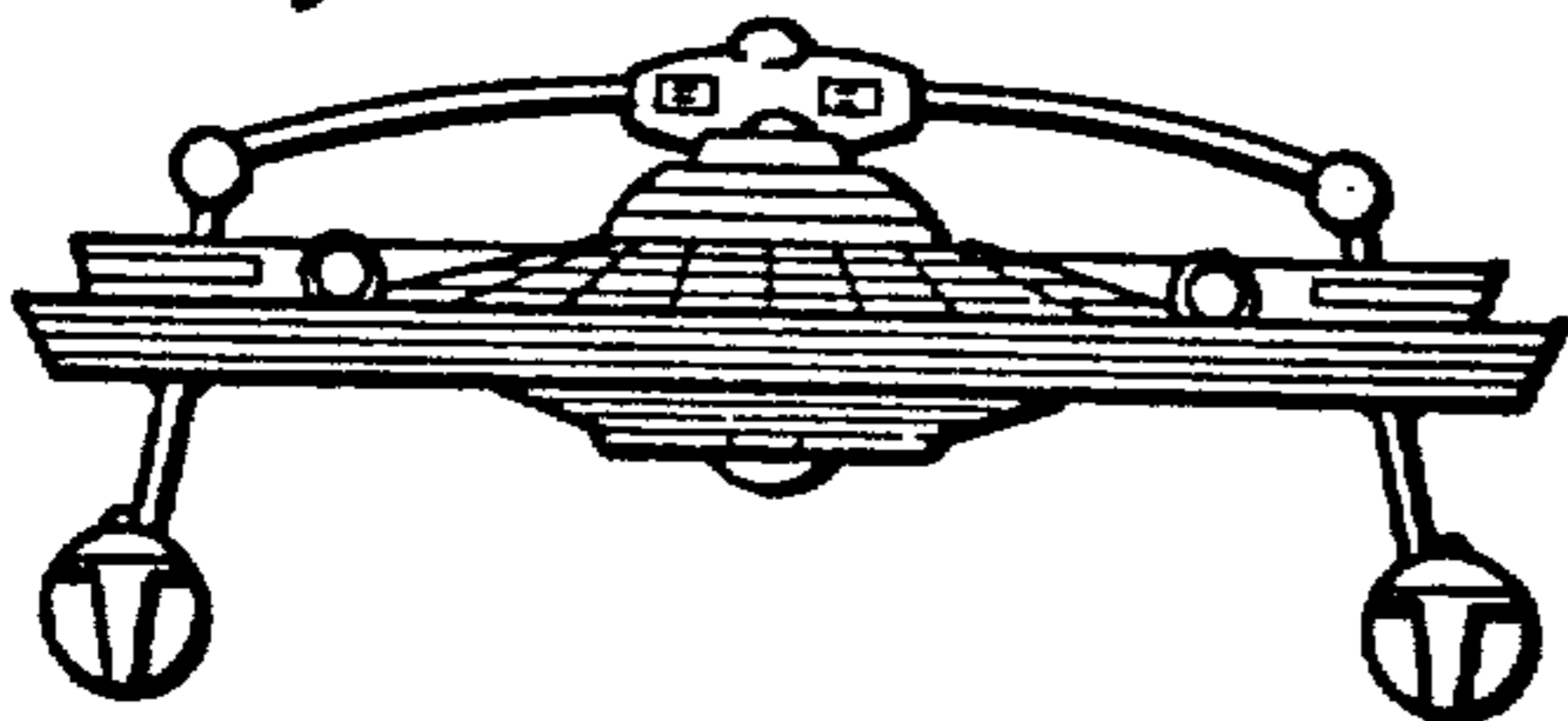
