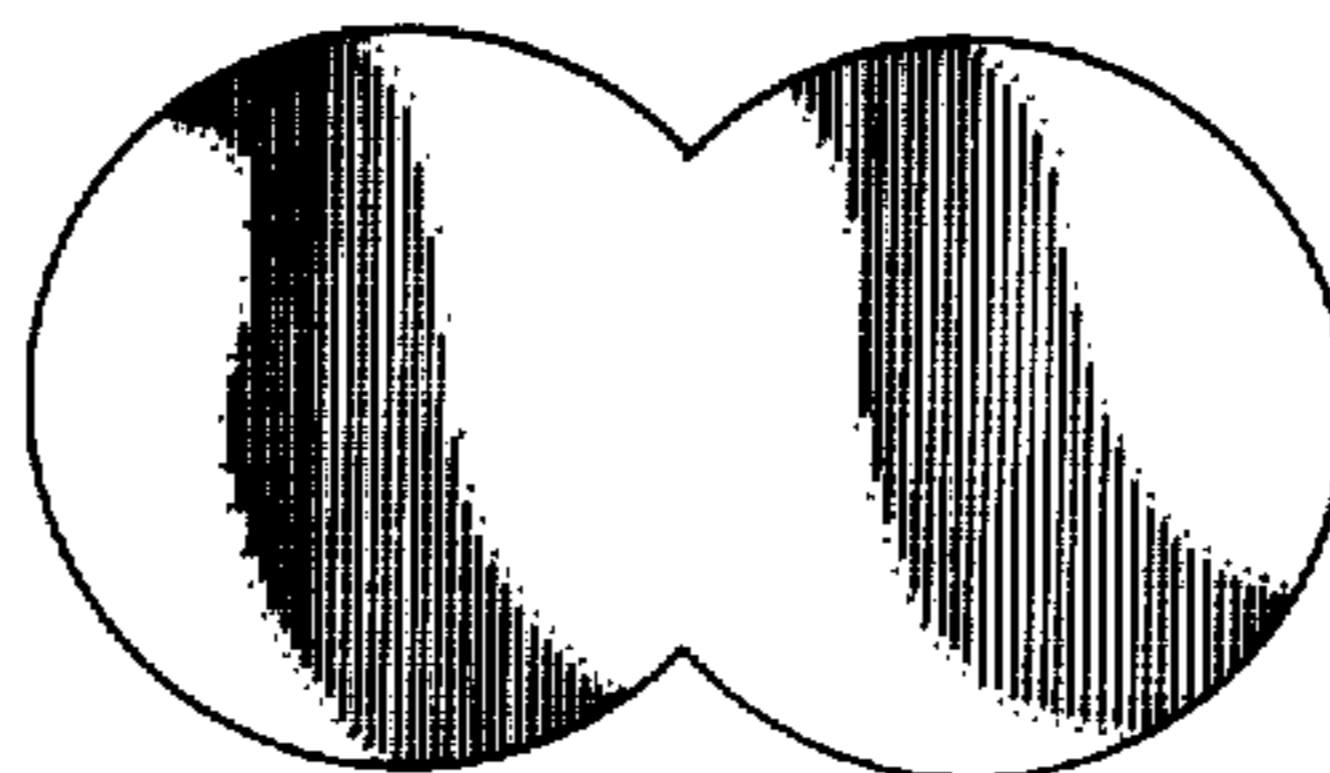
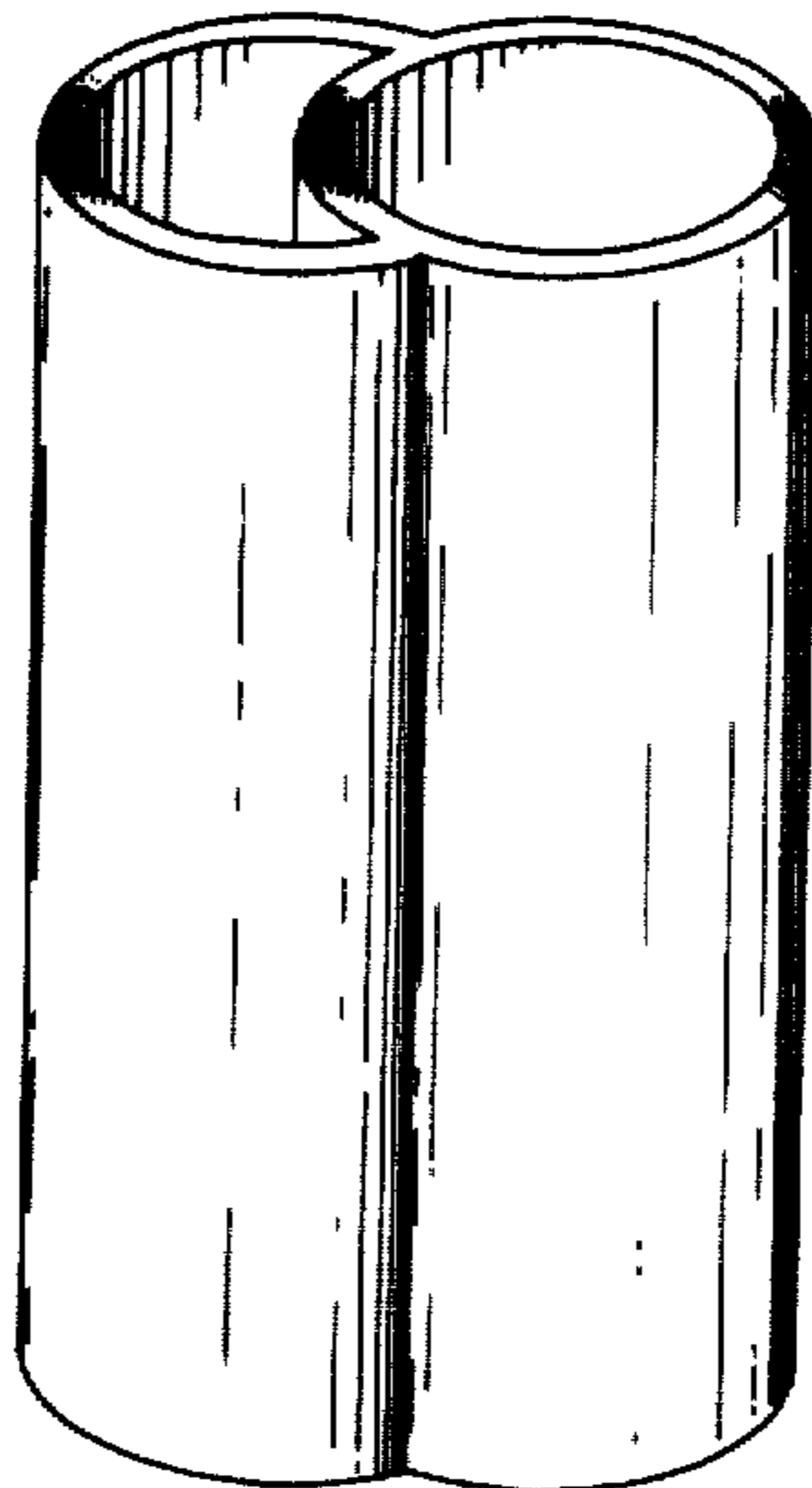

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a server for a wine bottle or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top side perspective view of a server for a wine bottle or the like showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, with the rear elevational view being the same;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, with the other side elevational view being the same;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.



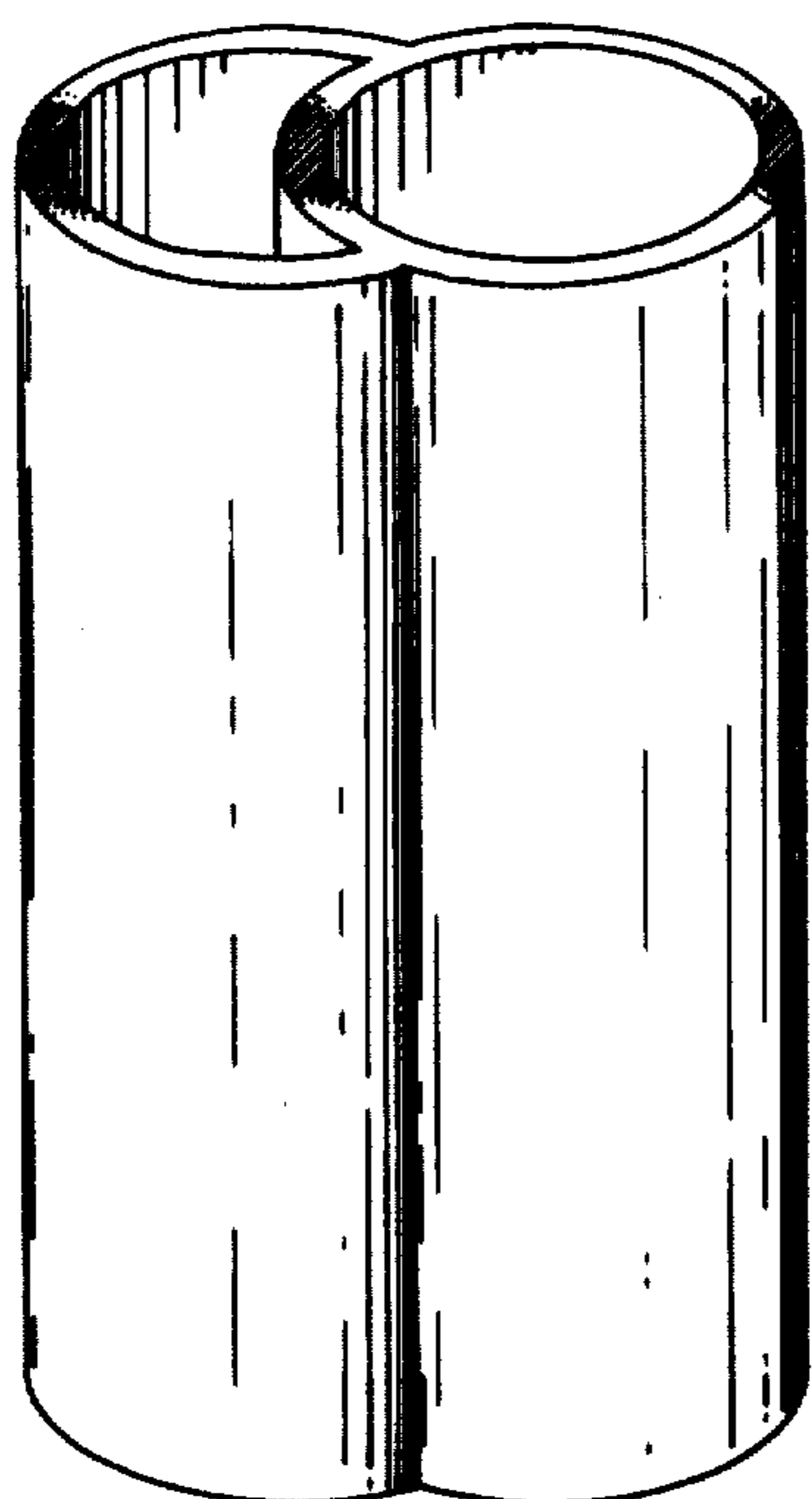

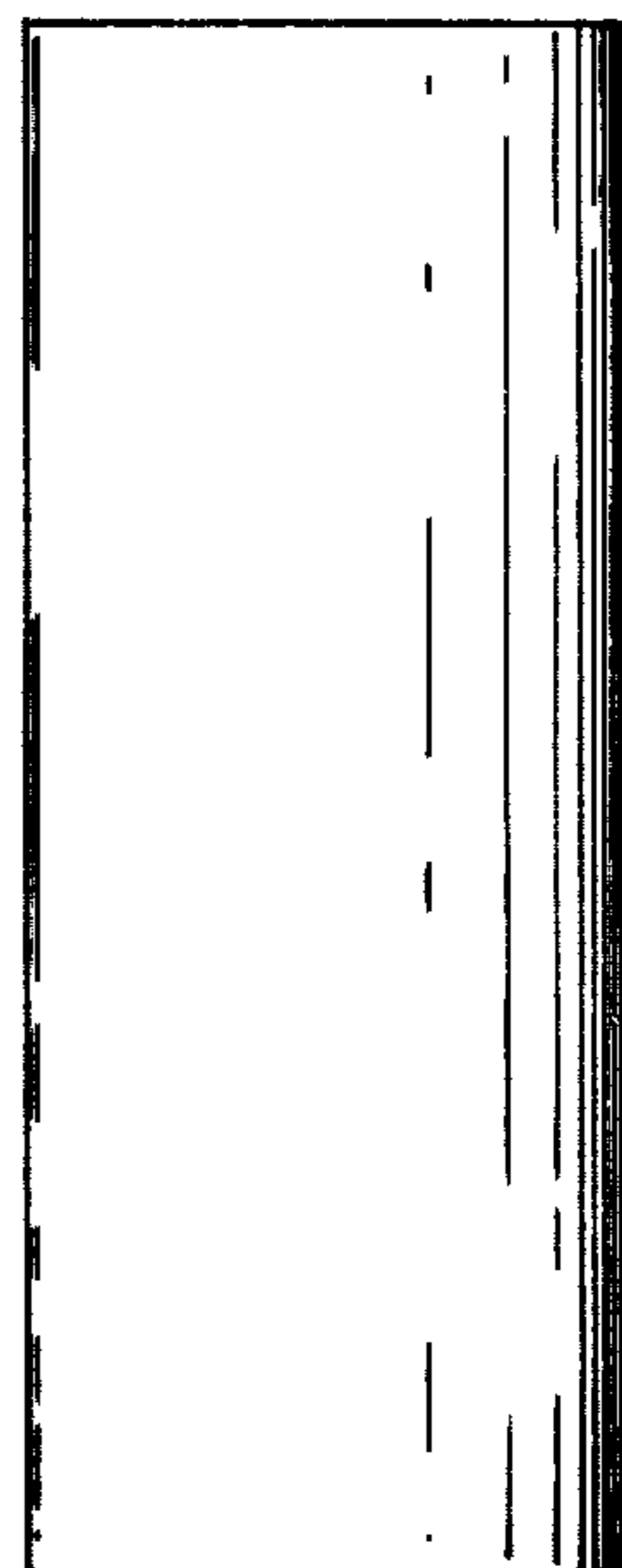

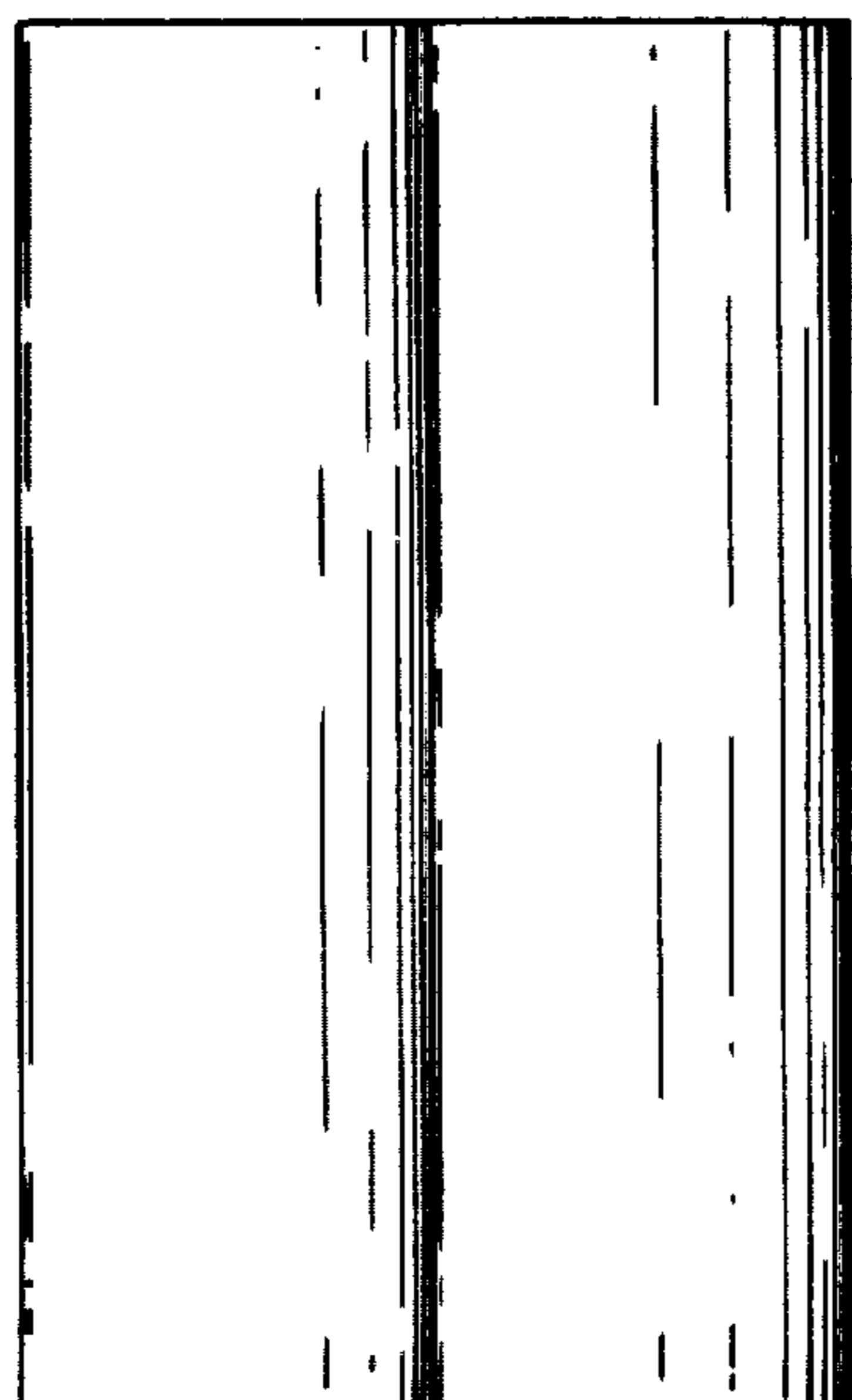

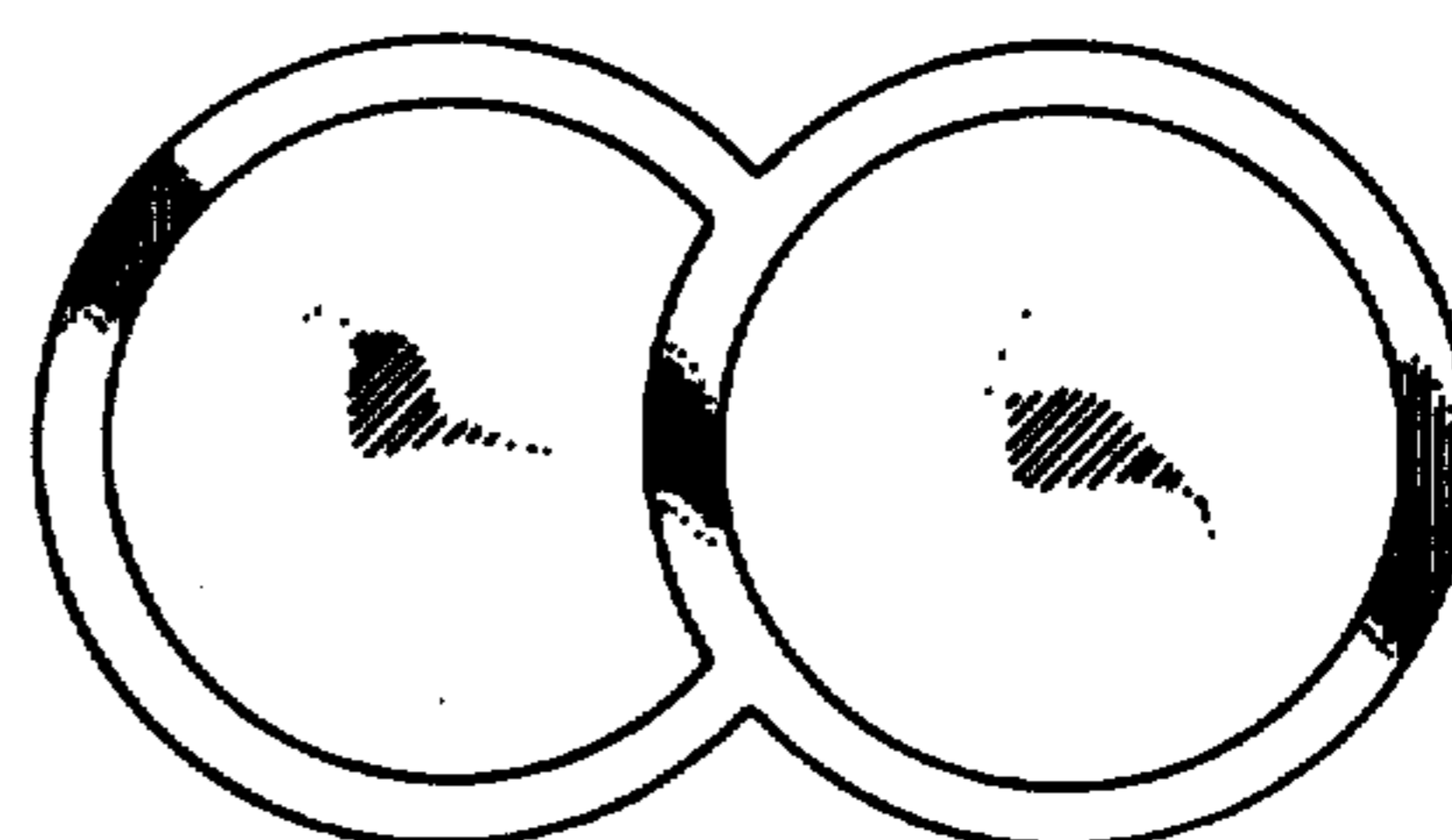

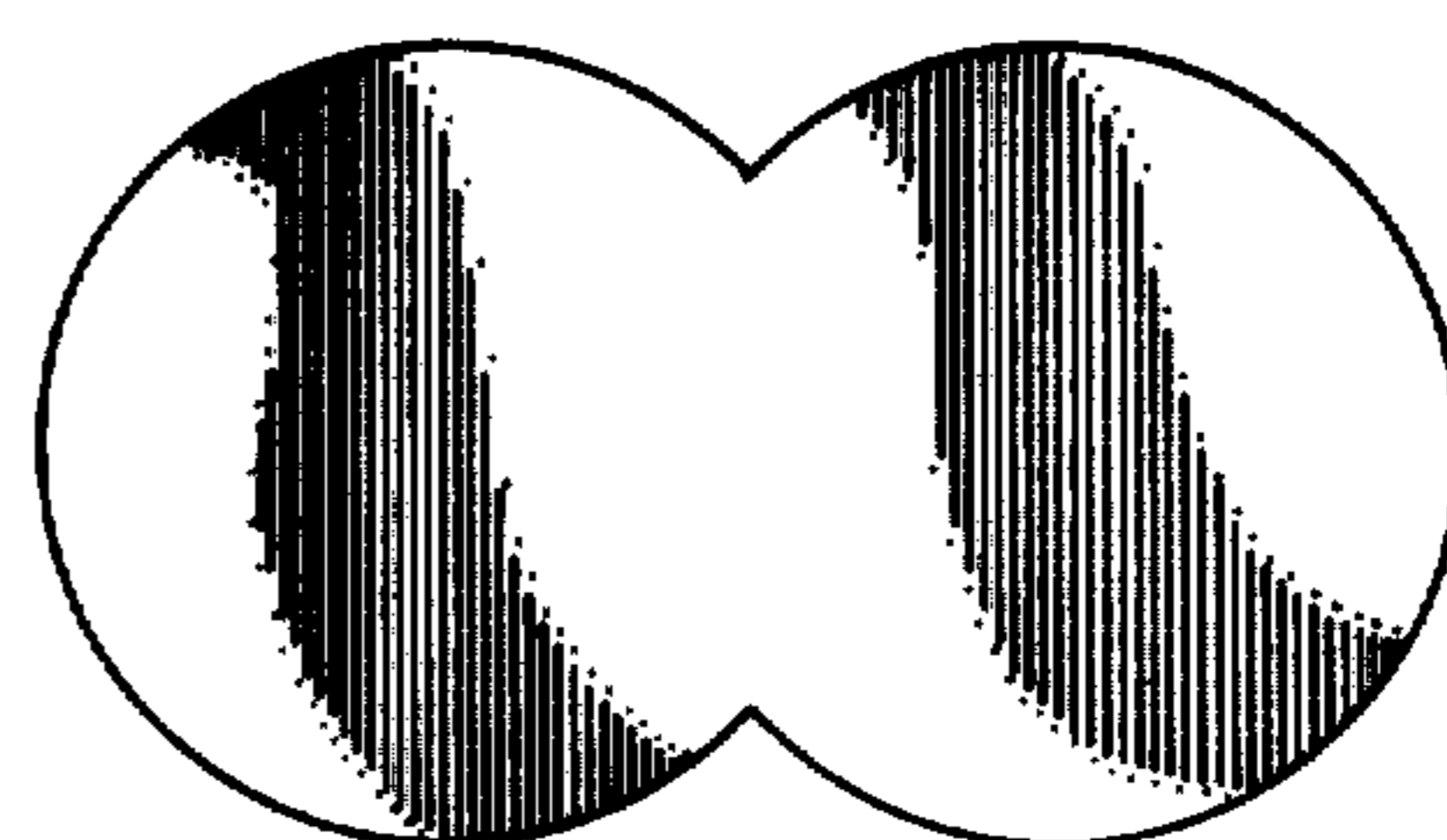
