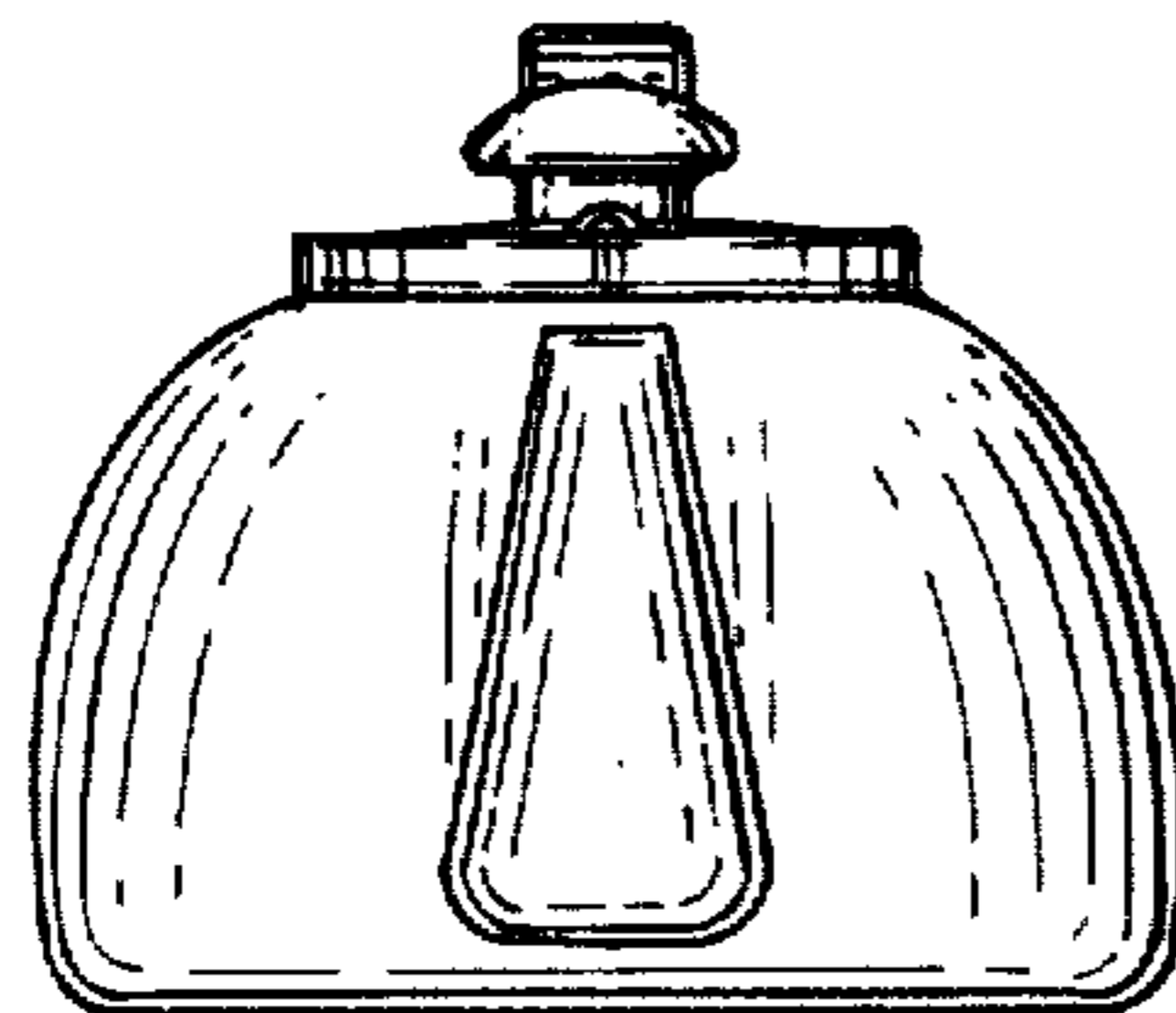
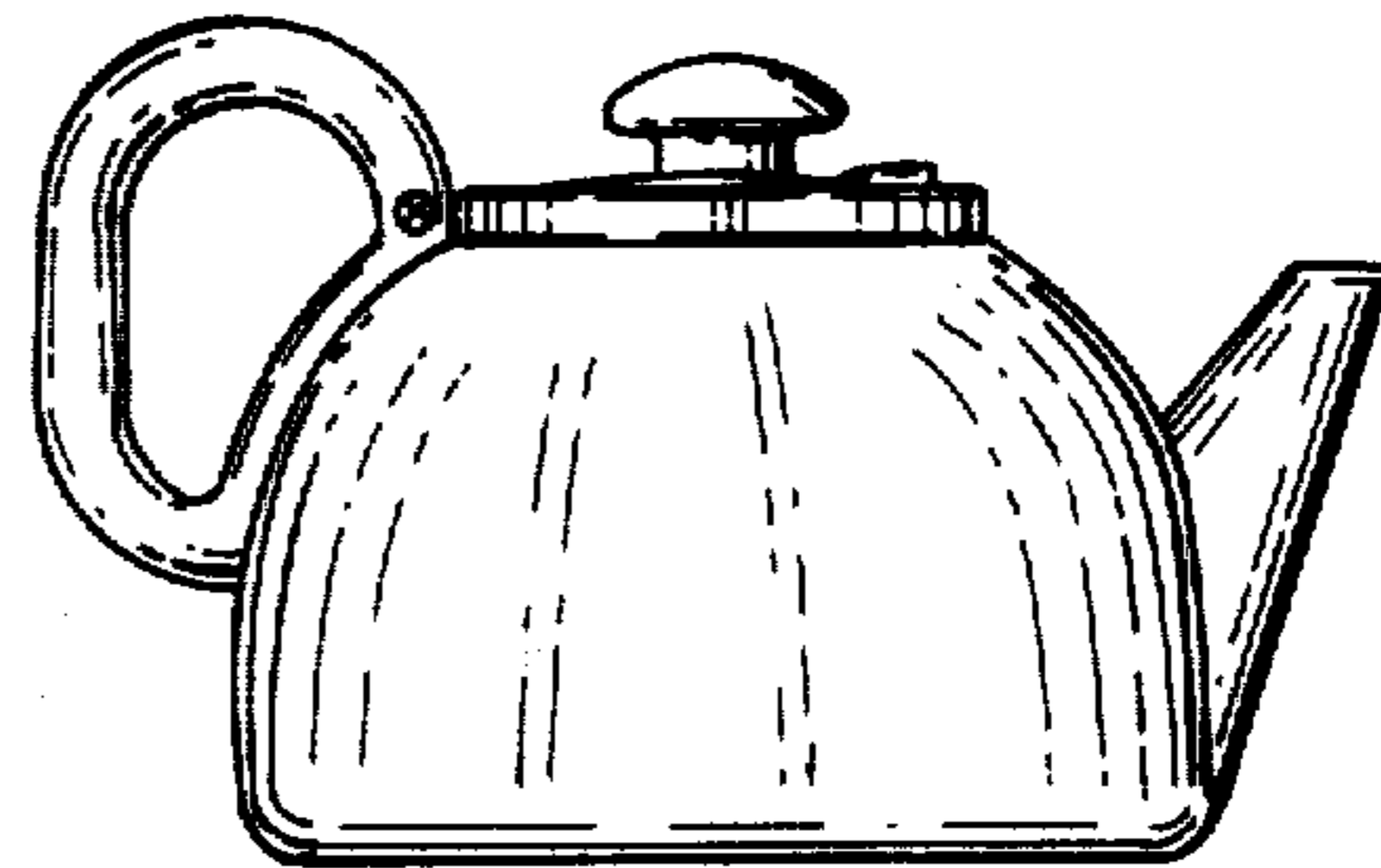
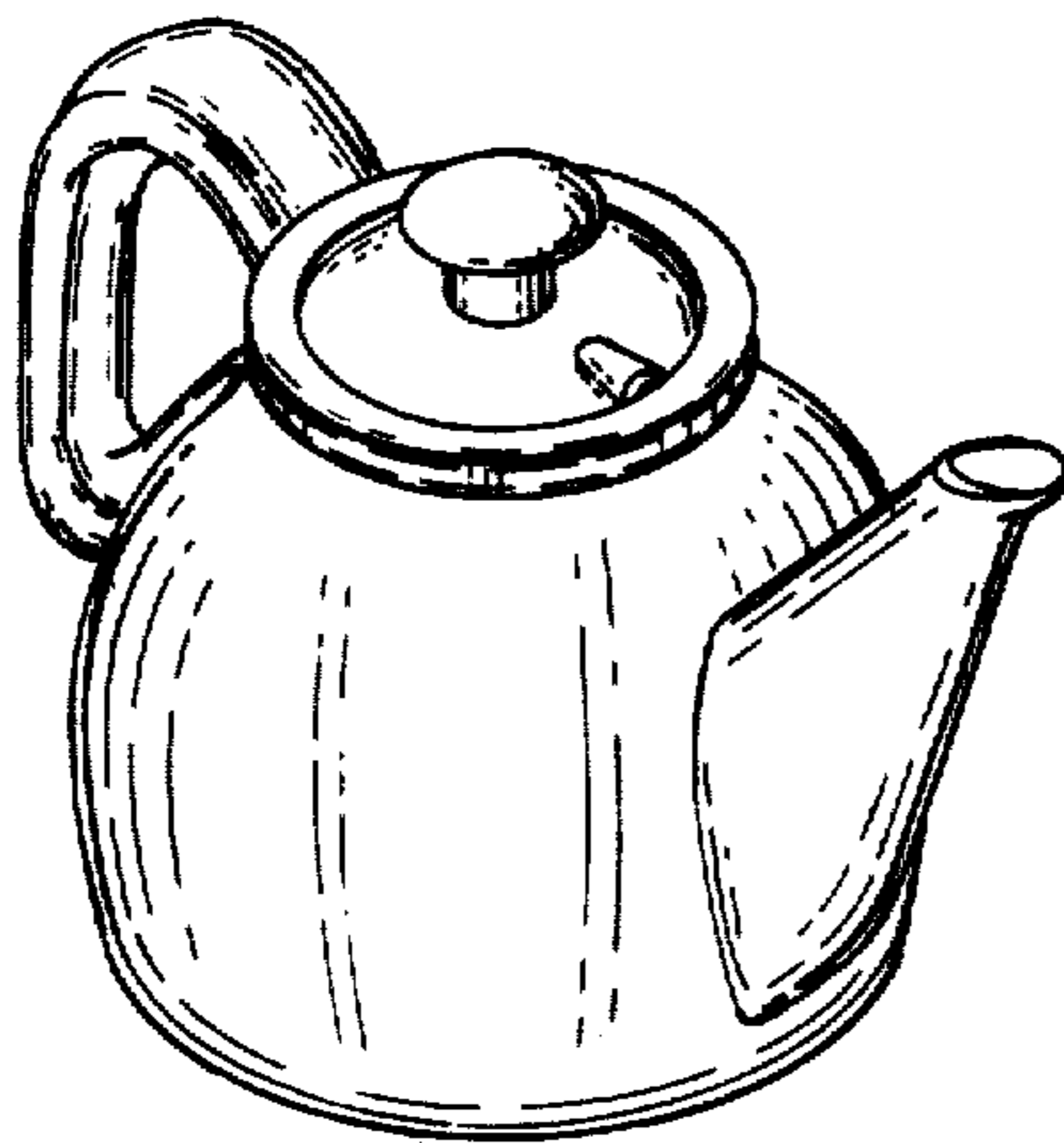

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tea kettle or similar article, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a tea kettle or similar article showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



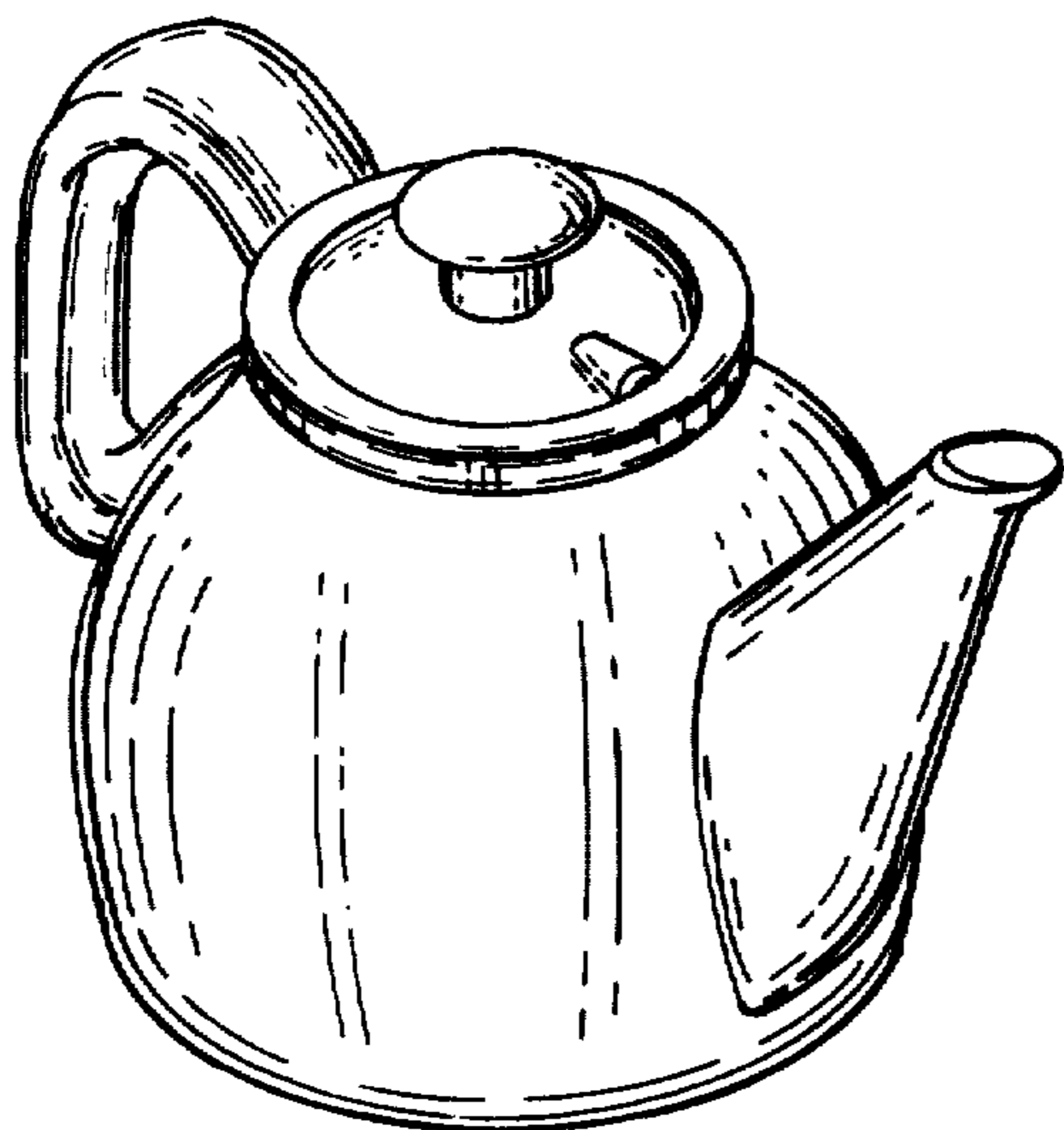

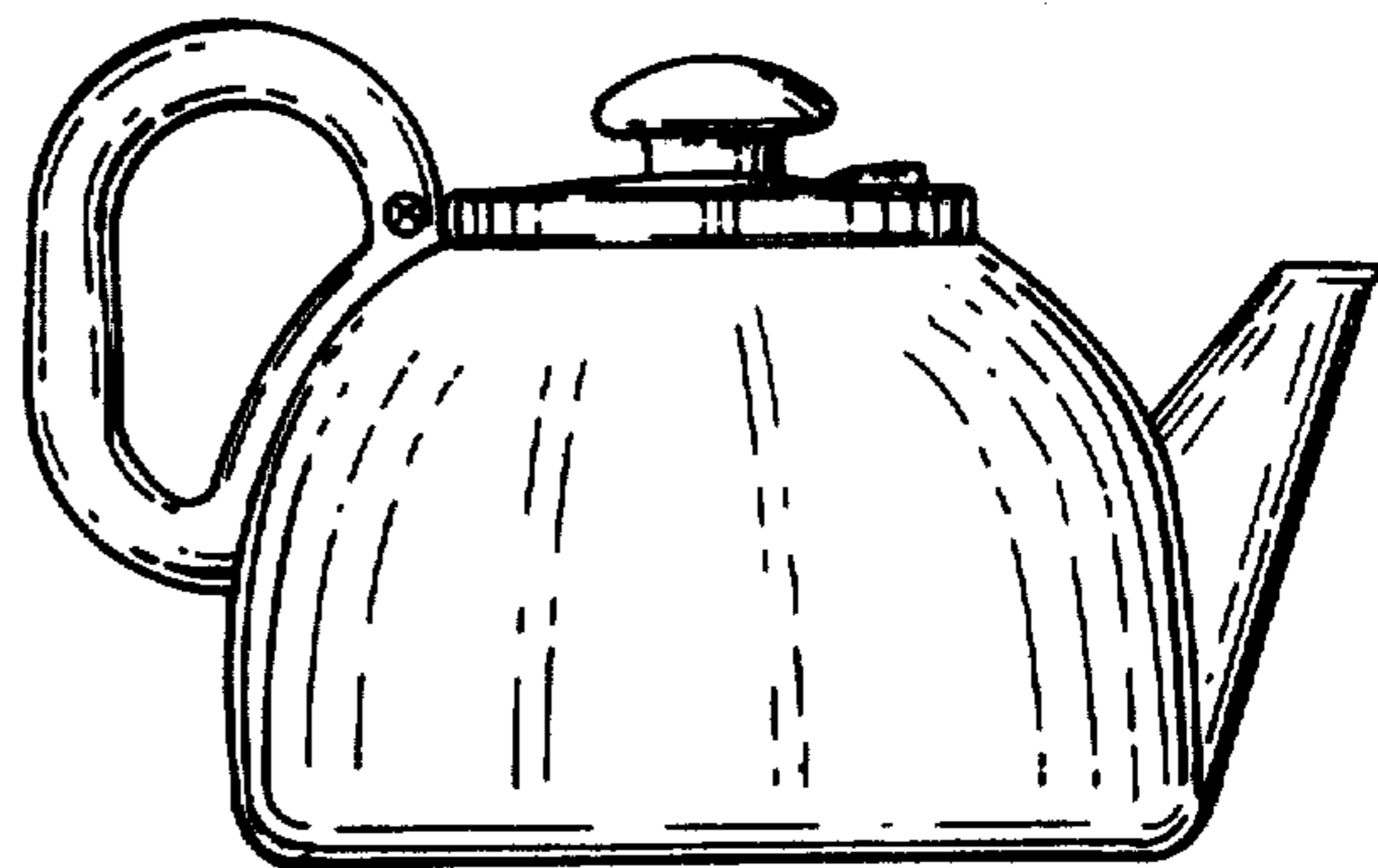

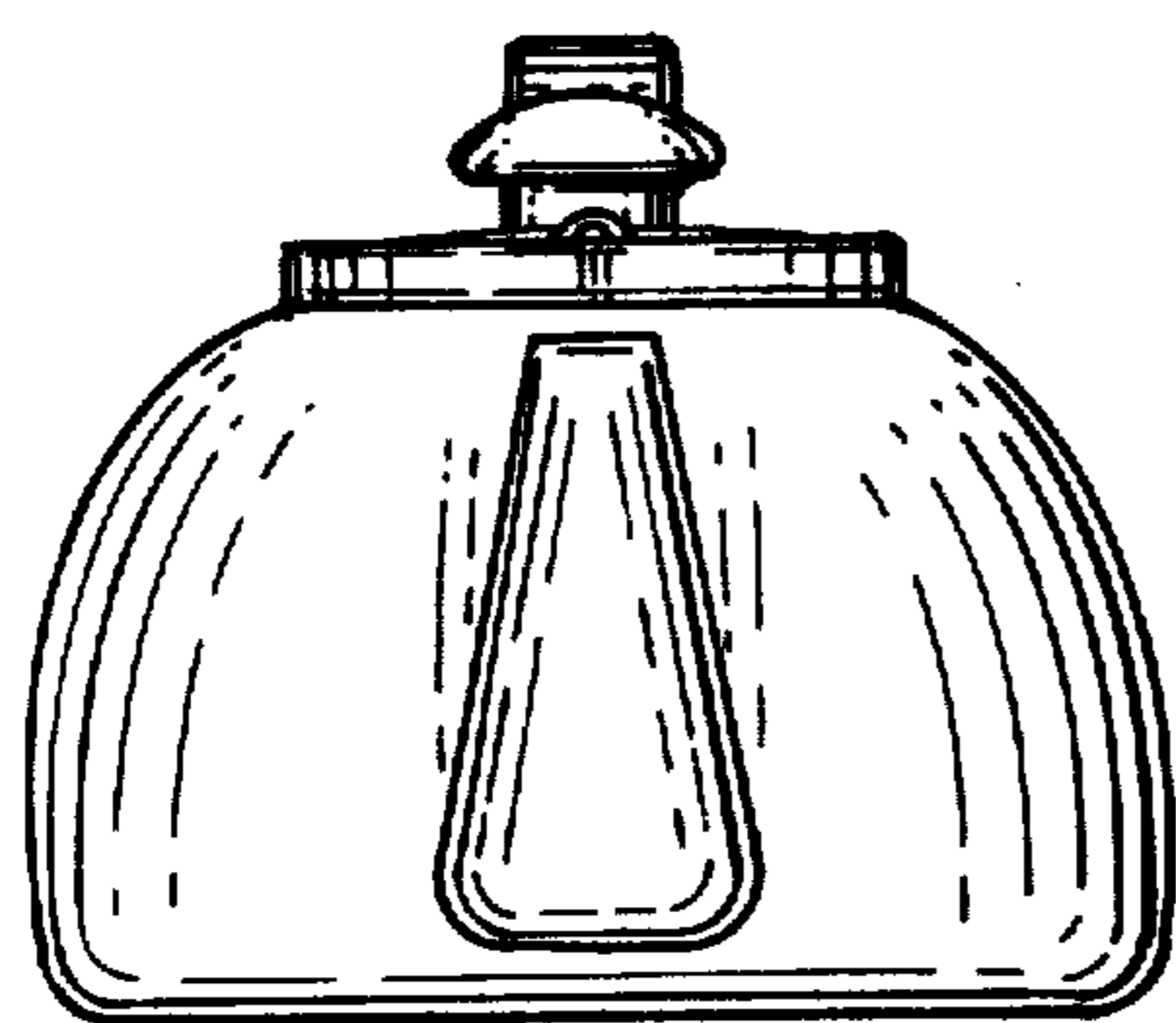

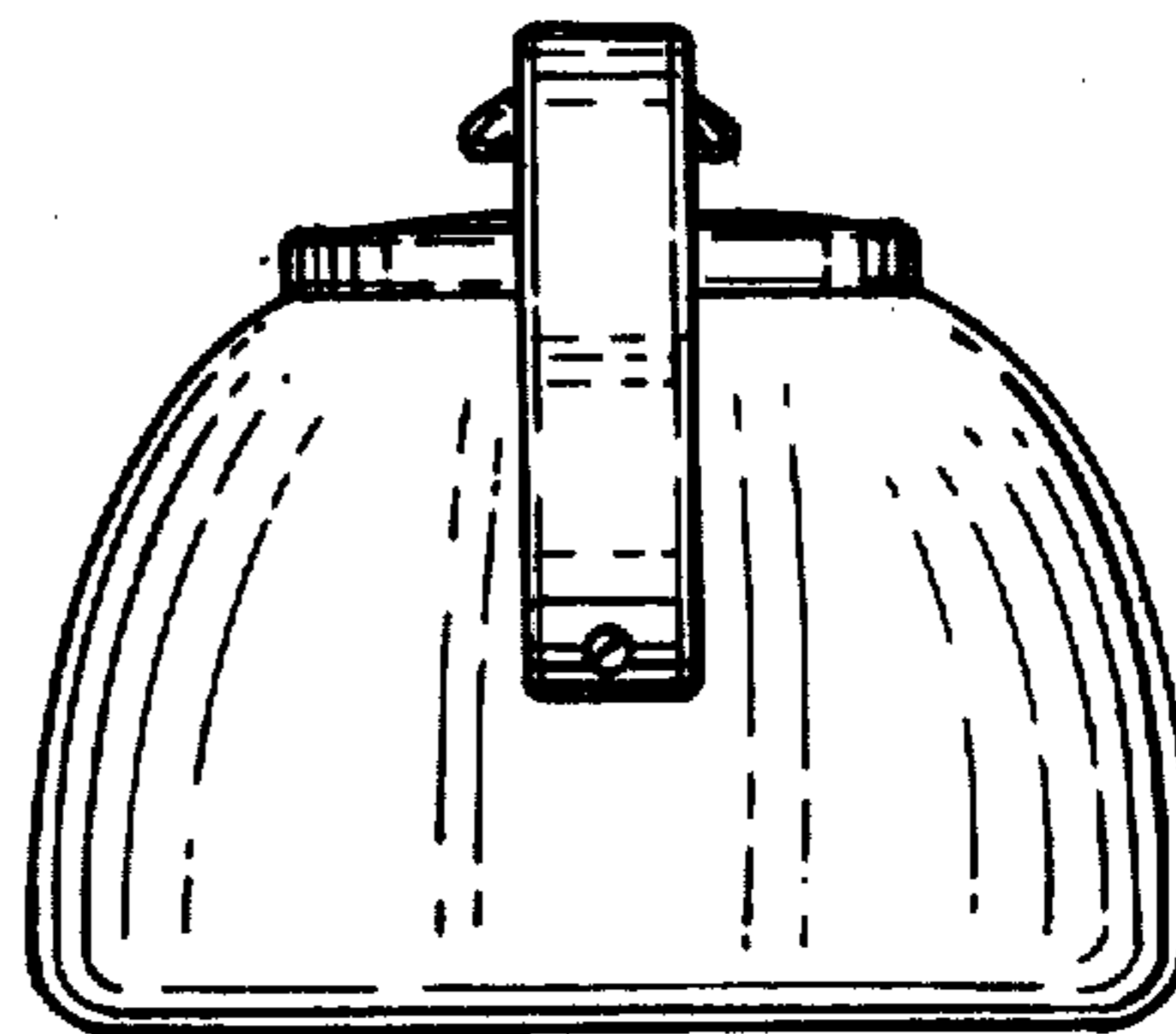

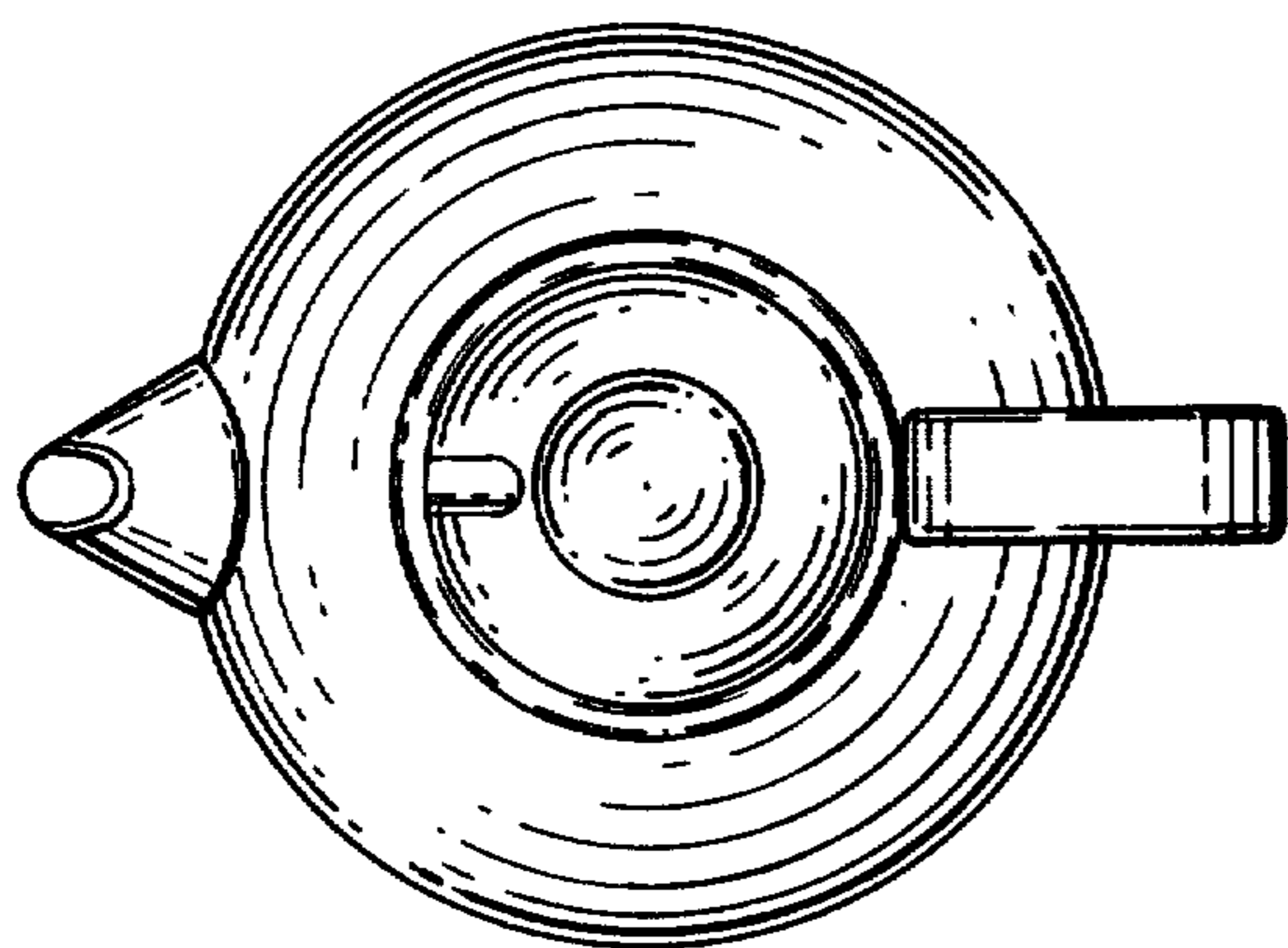

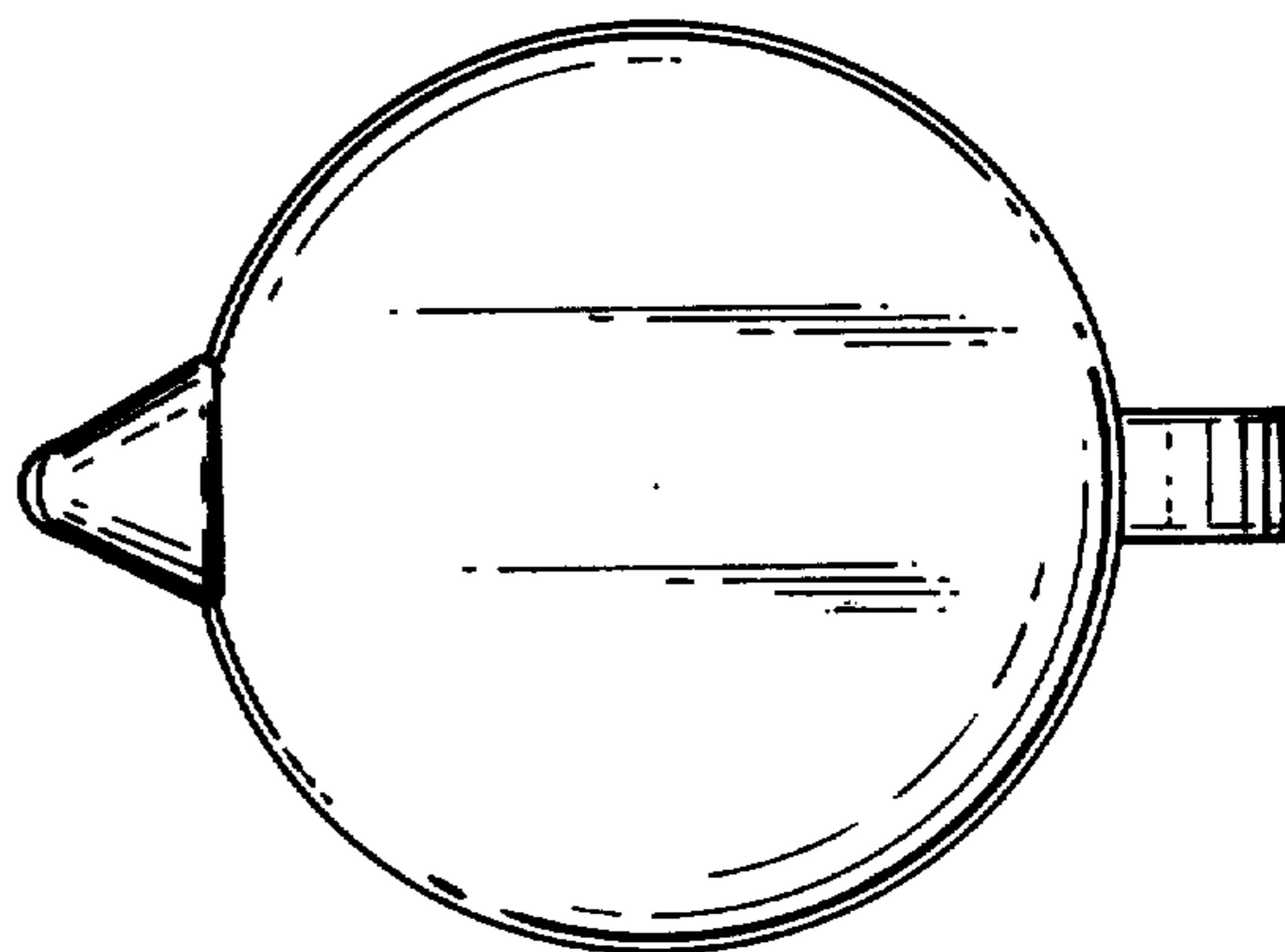
