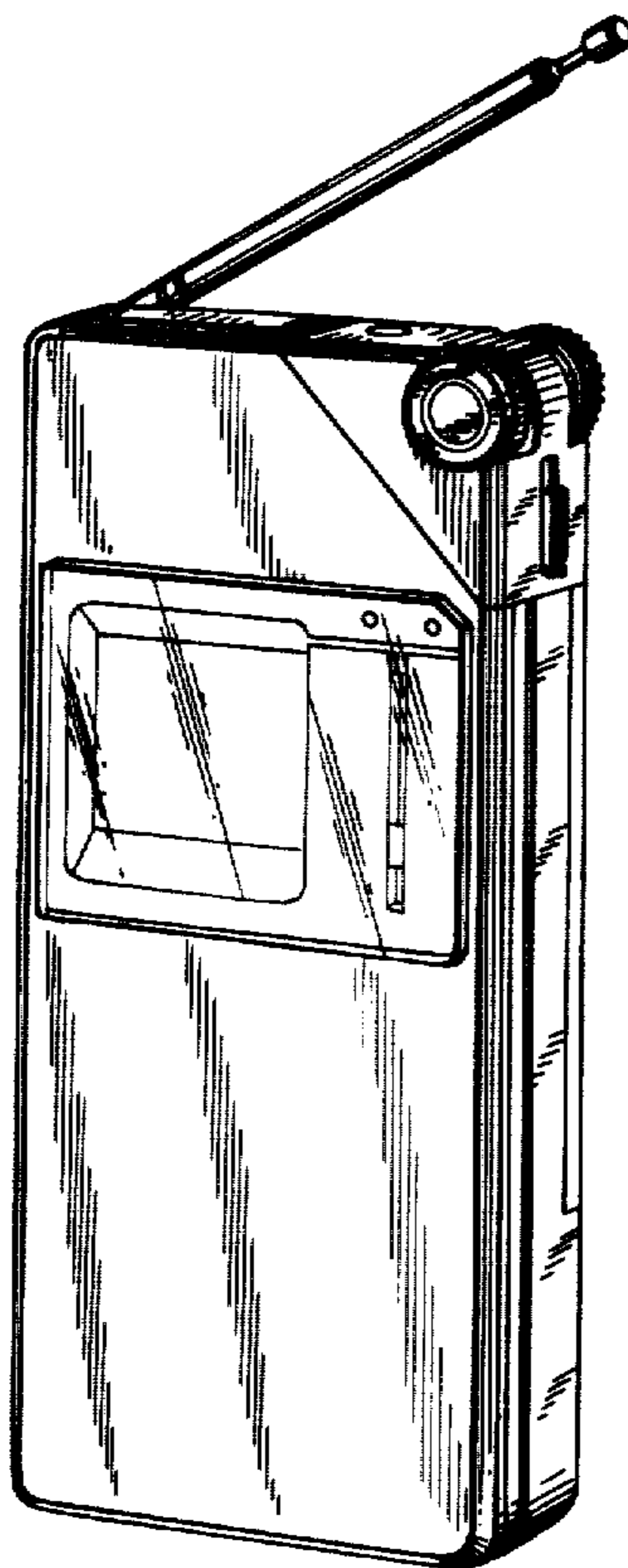

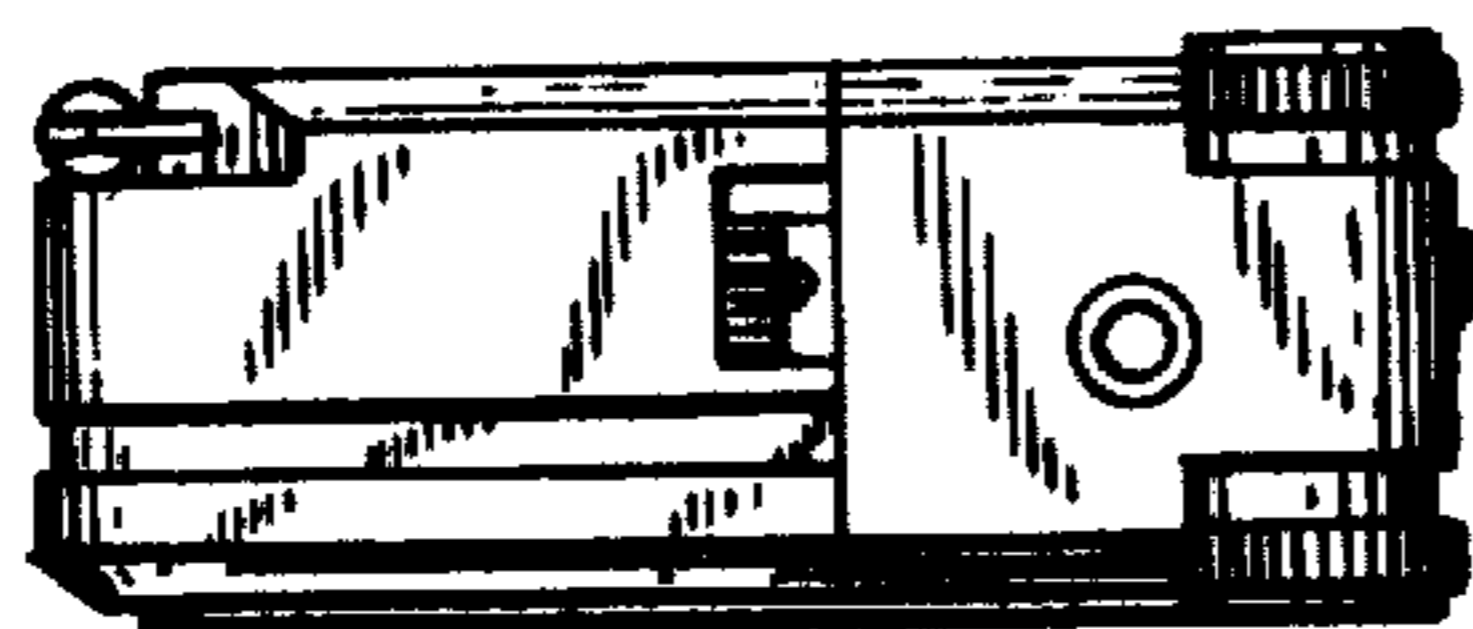
The ornamental design for a television receiver, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

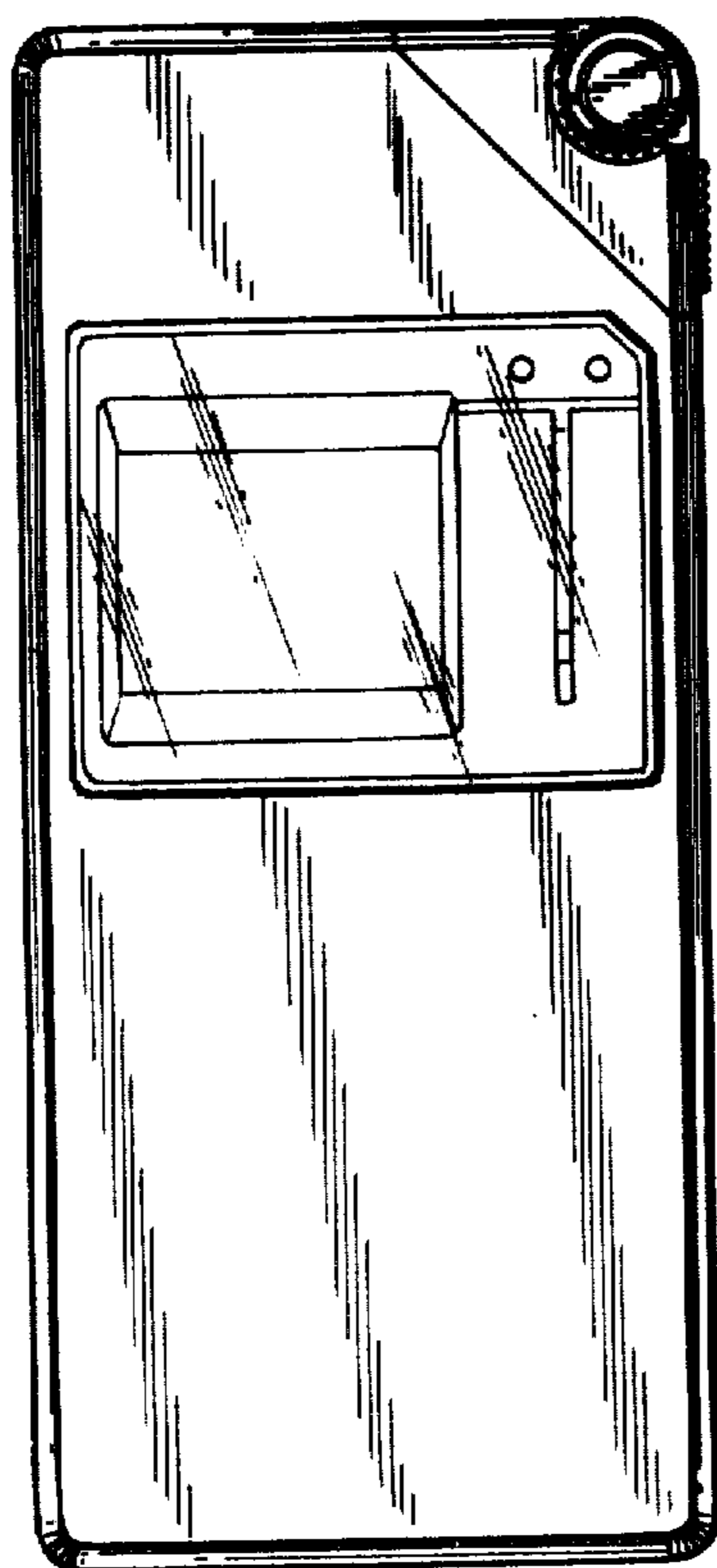
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a television receiver showing my new design;

 FIG. 8 is a view like FIG. 7 with the aerial partially extended.



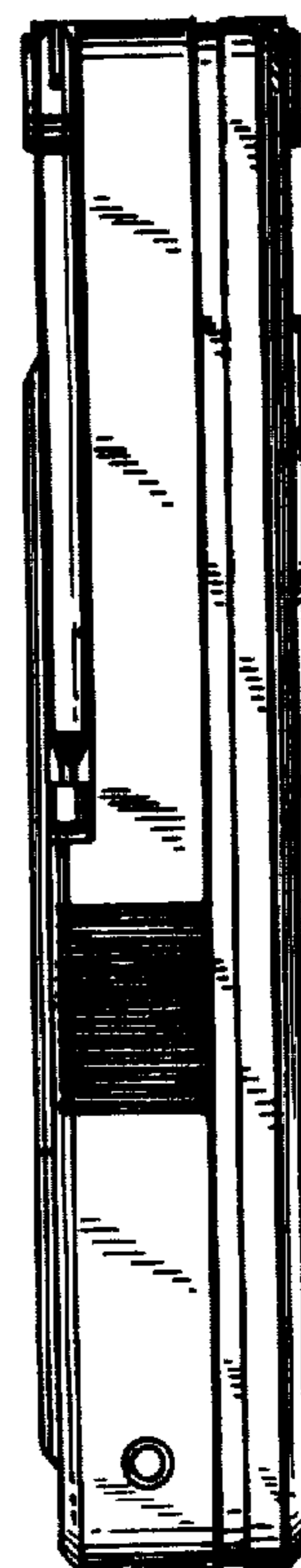

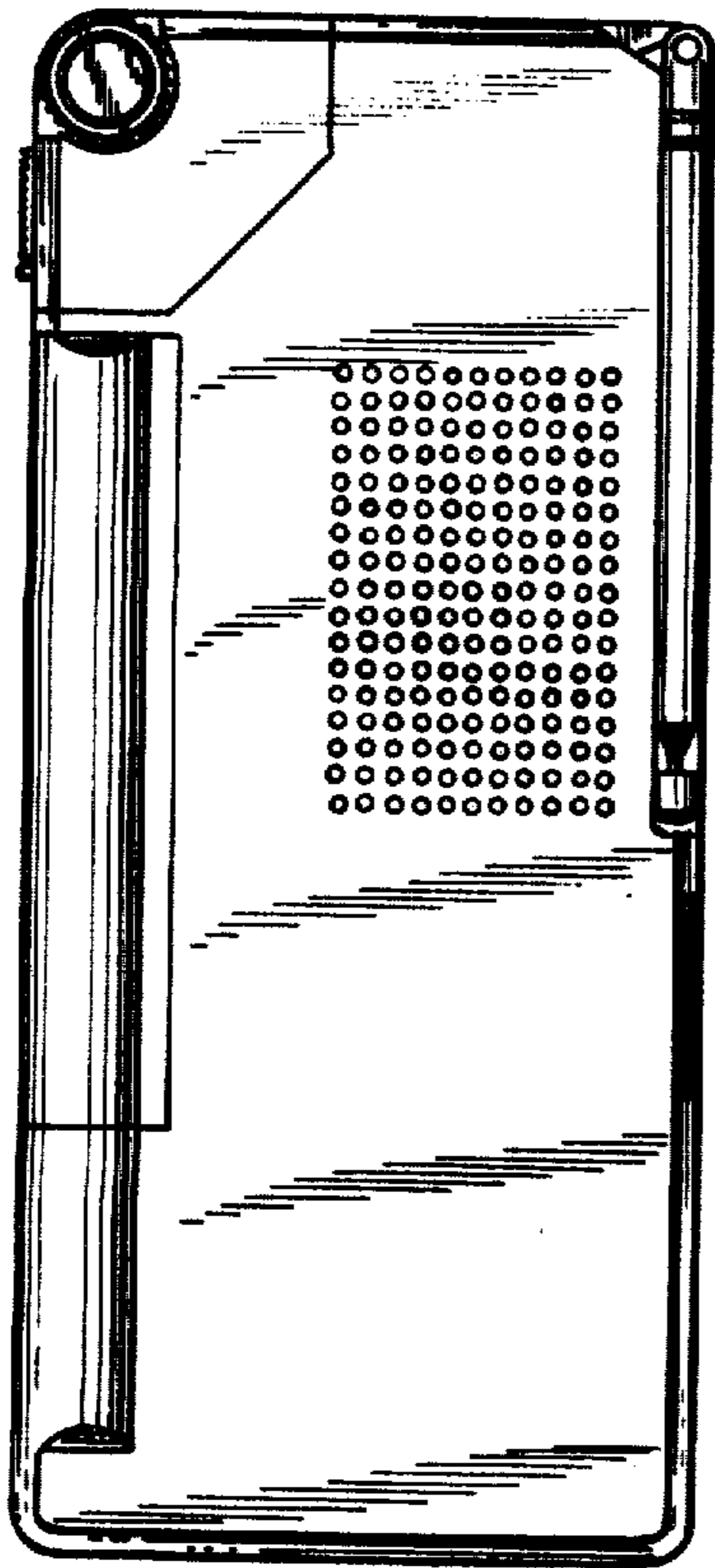

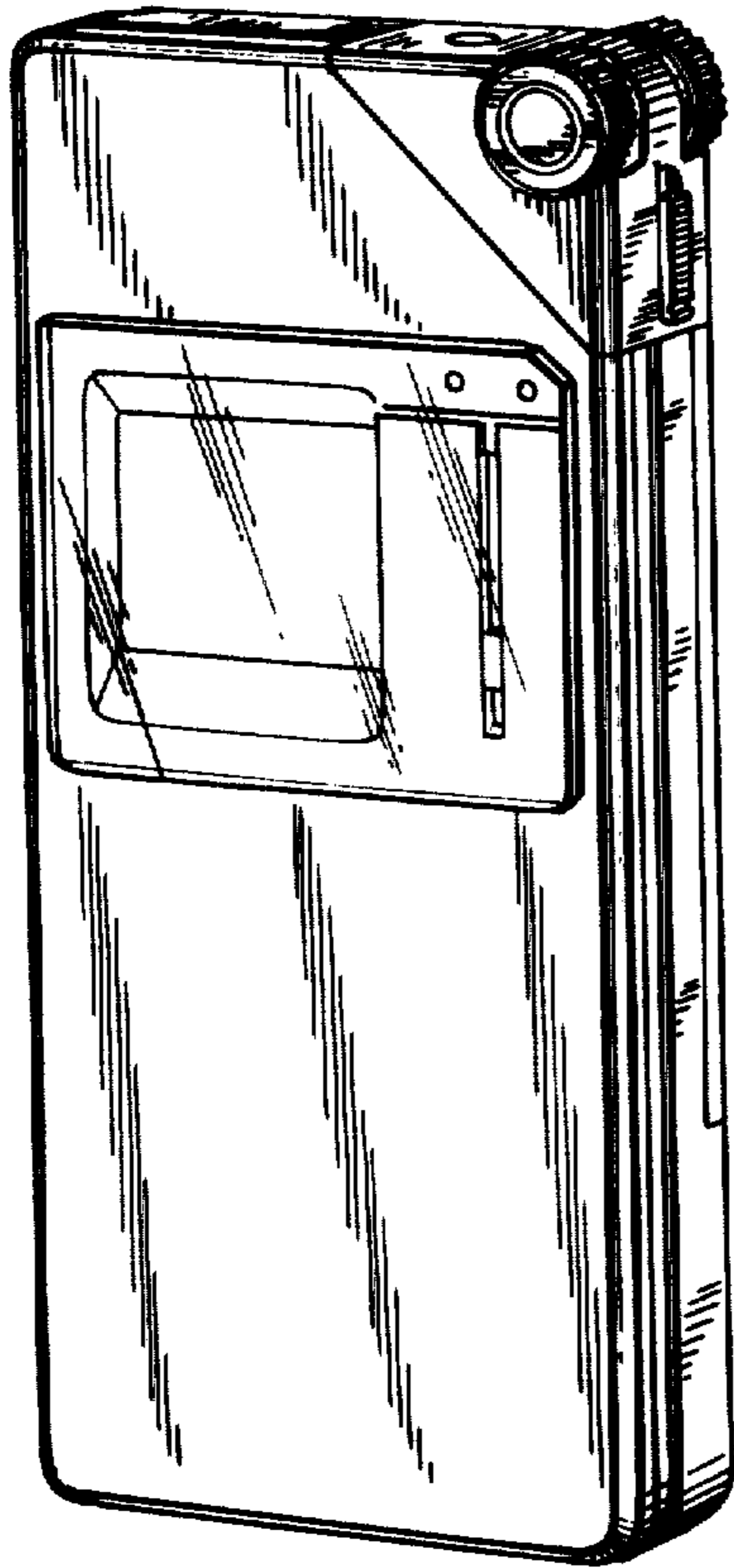

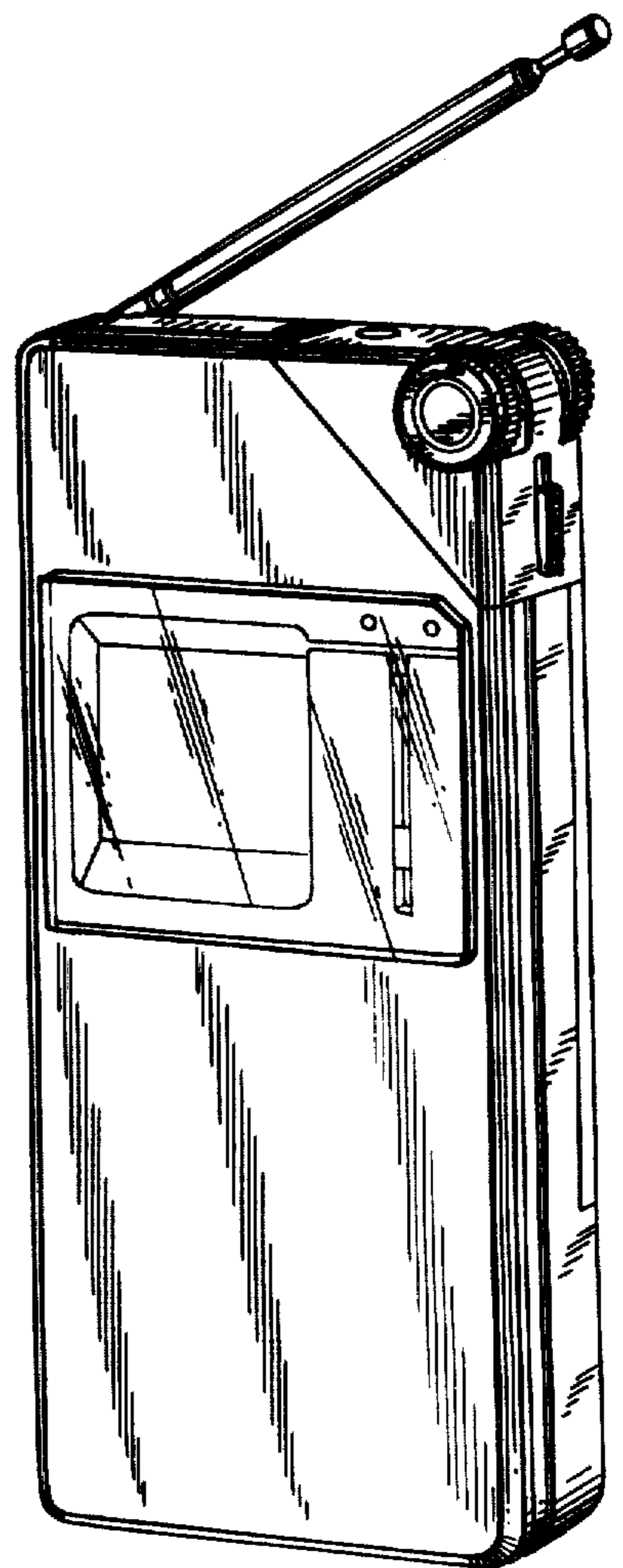
