
DESCRIPTION


FIGS. 1-3 and 5-6 are front perspective views, respectively, of the king, queen, bishop, knight and pawn of a chess set embodying my new design;

FIG. 4 is a front perspective view of the rook of said chess set; the rear view being identical to that shown; and


FIGS. 7-11 are rear perspective views, respectively, of the king, queen, bishop, knight and pawn of said chess set.
