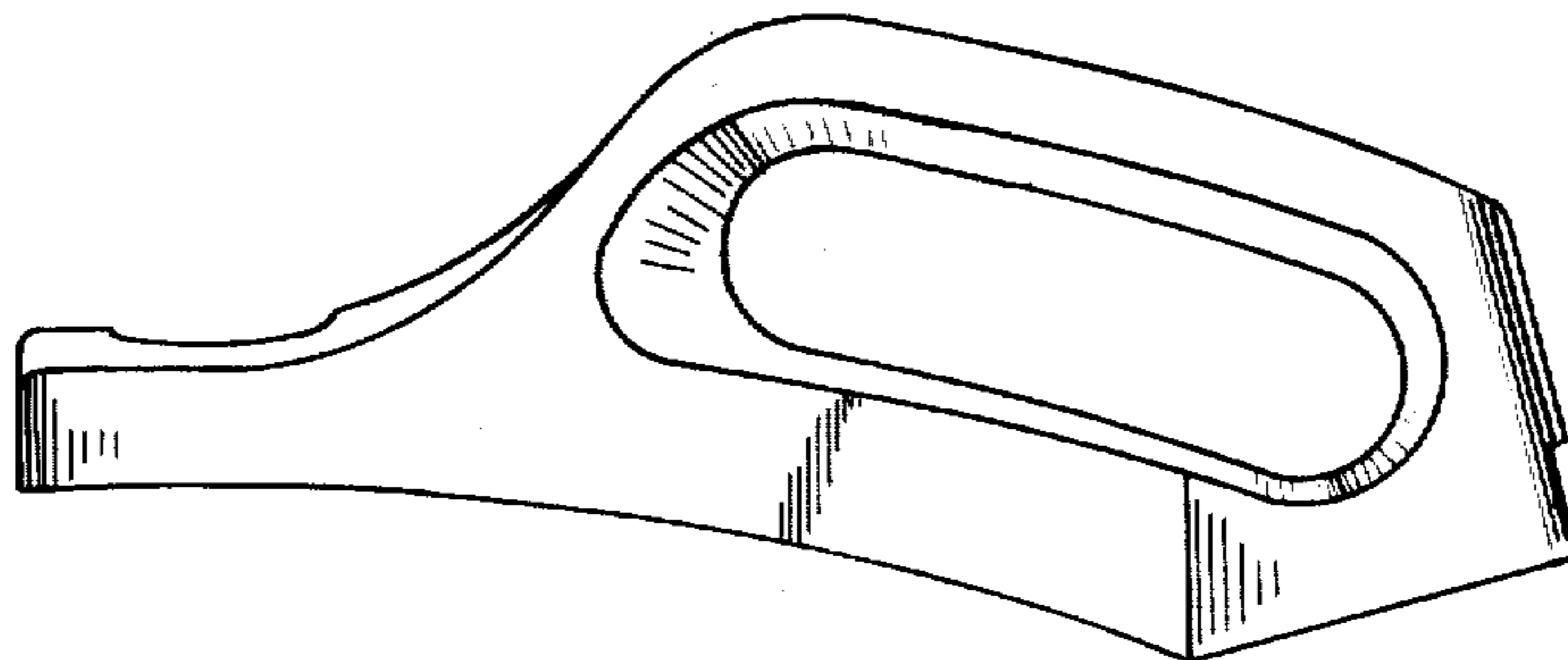
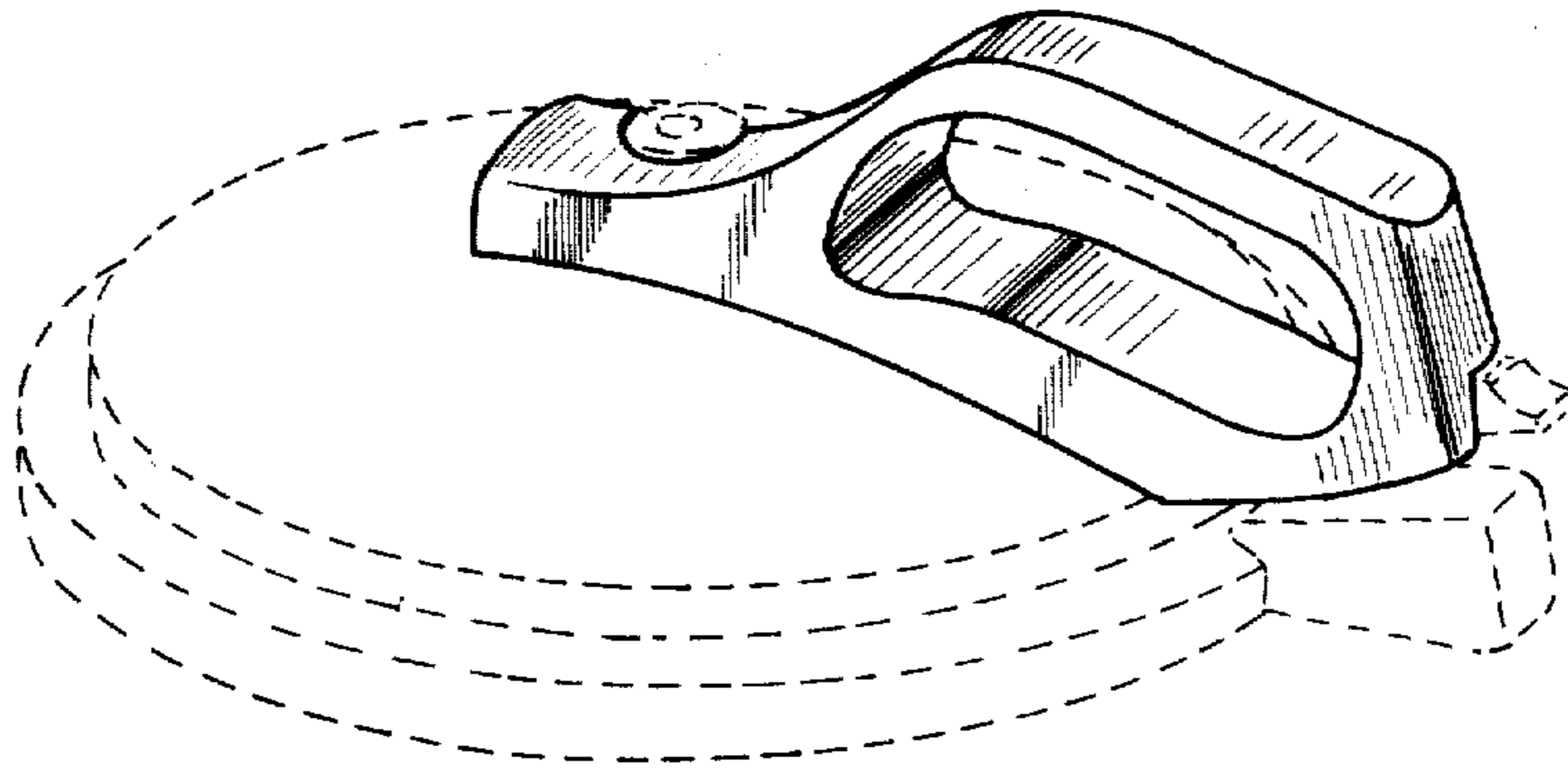
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view is a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right end elevational view thereof.



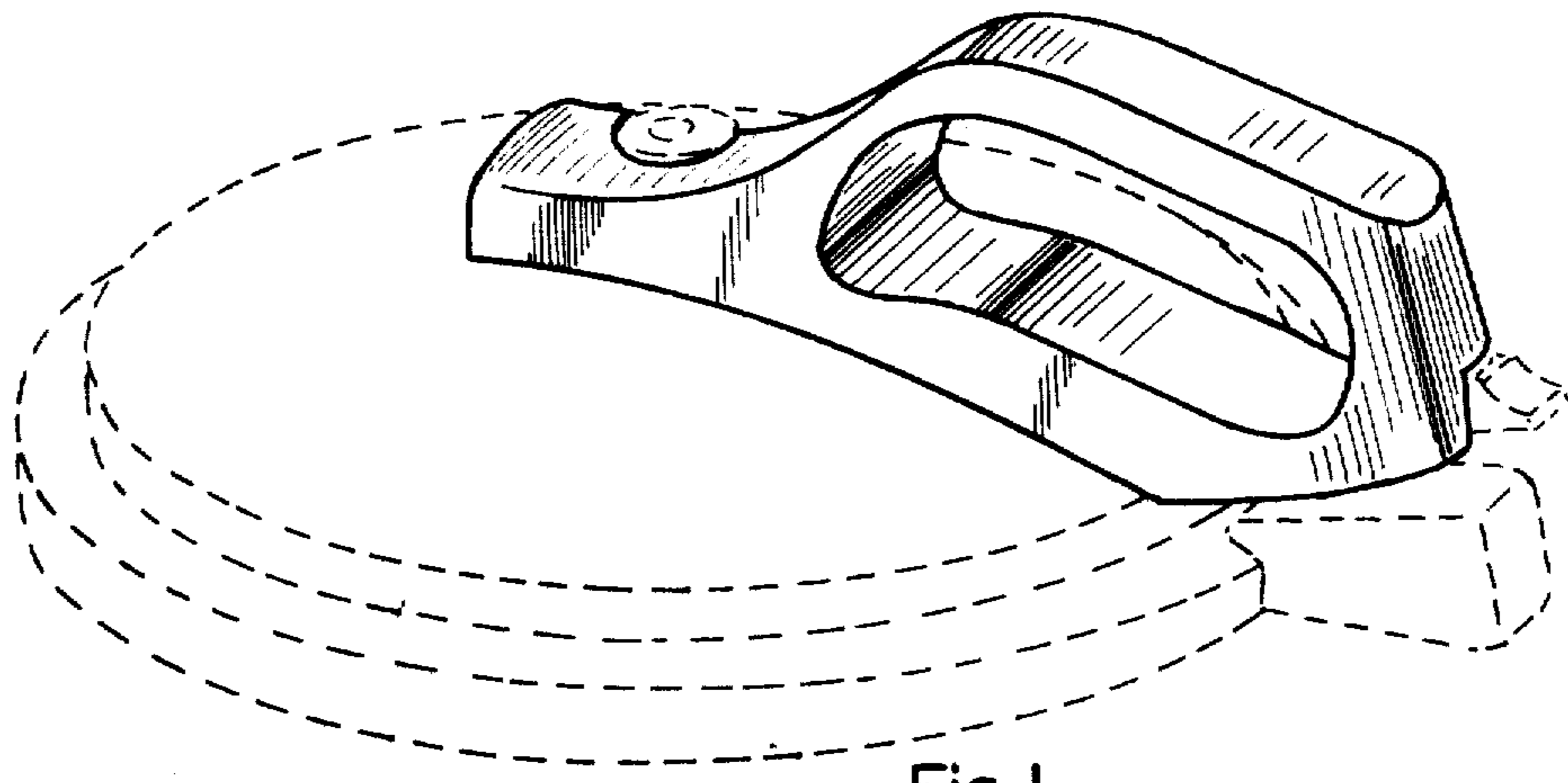

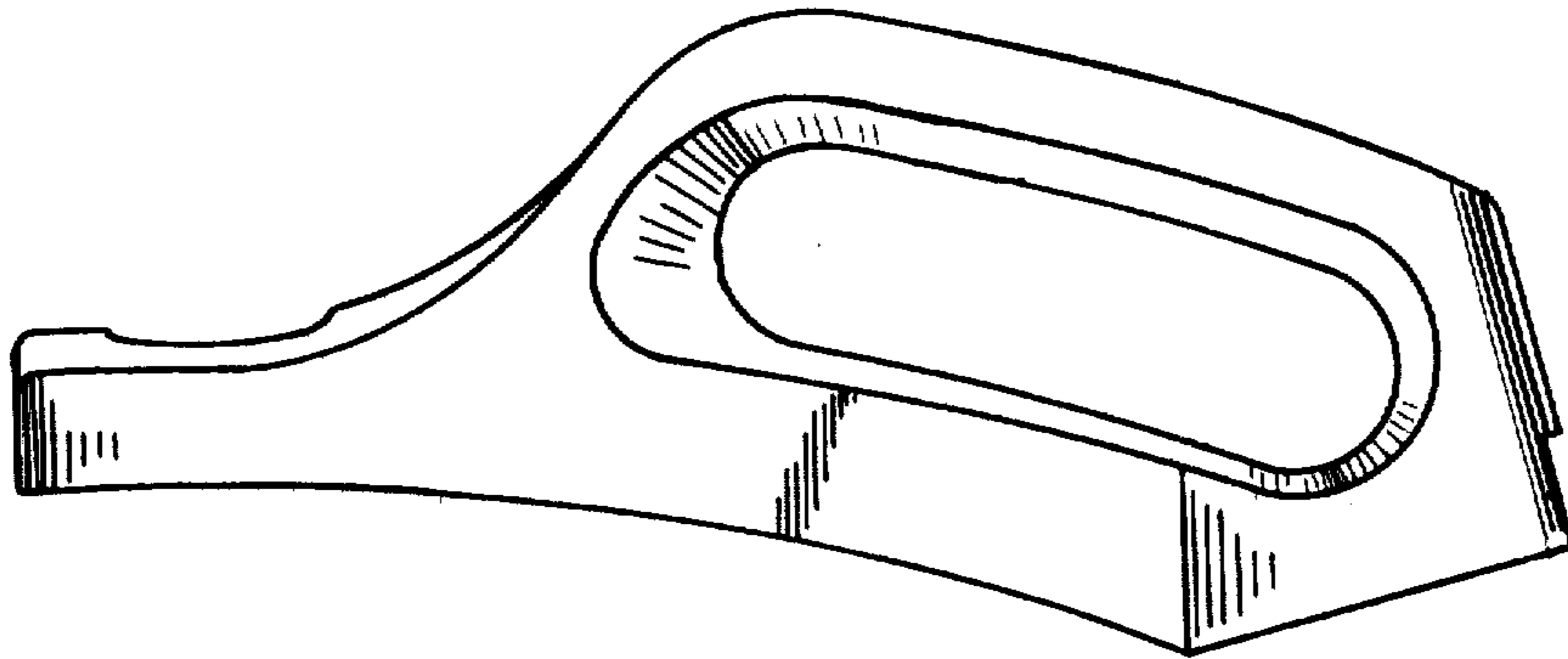

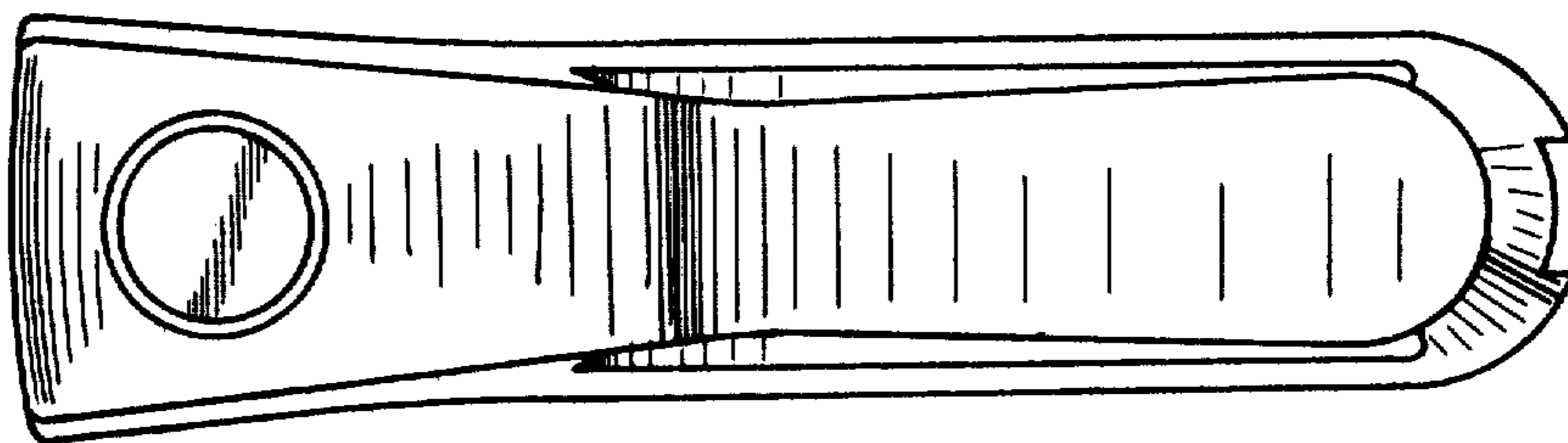

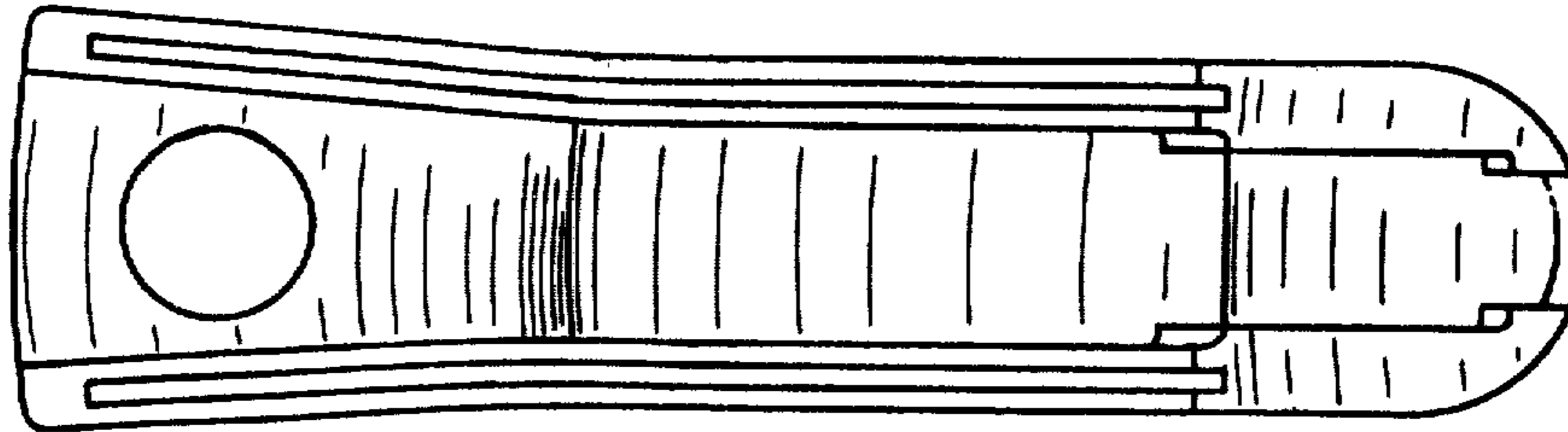

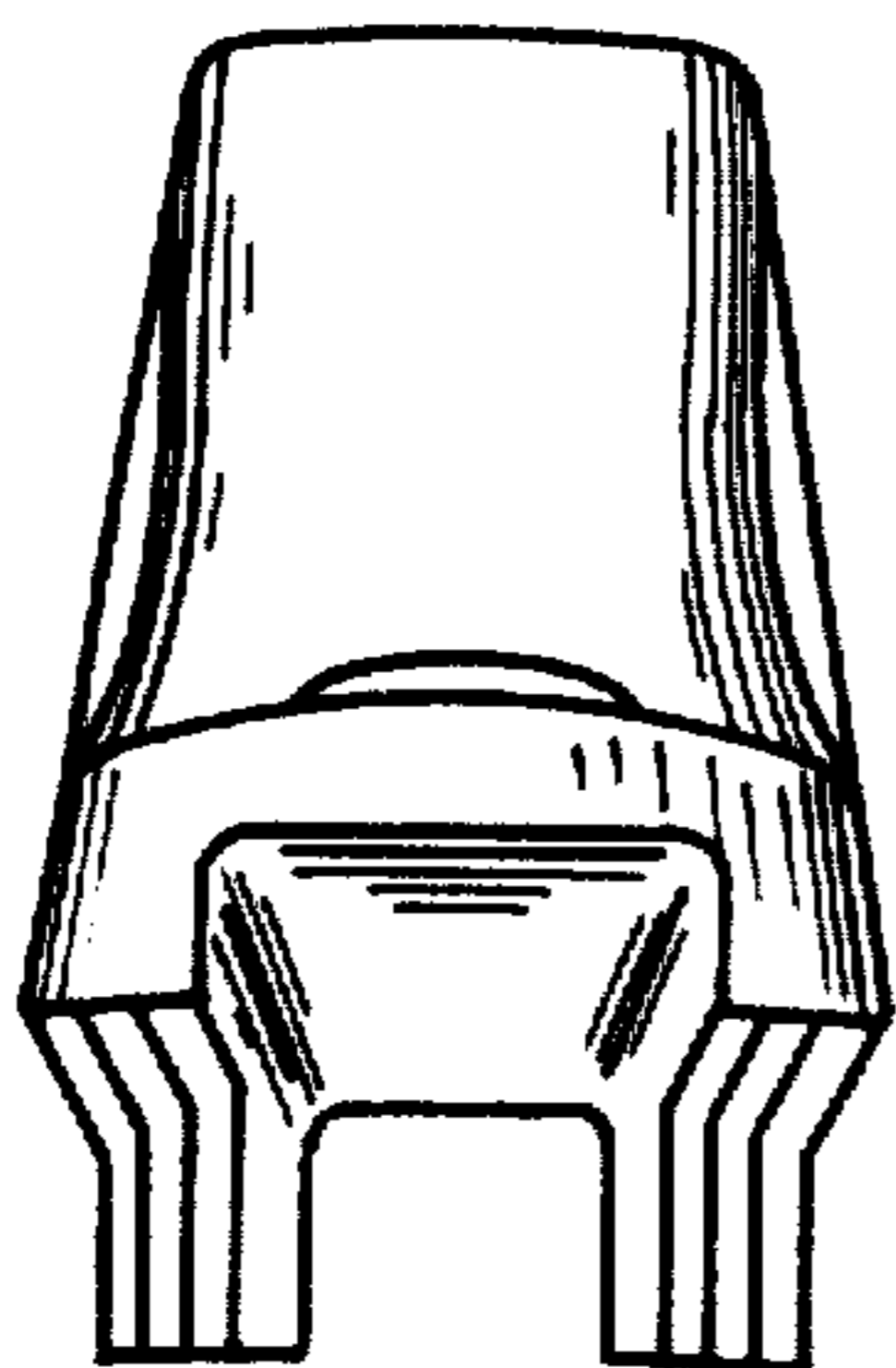
