FIG. 2 is a an enlarged side elevational view thereof;

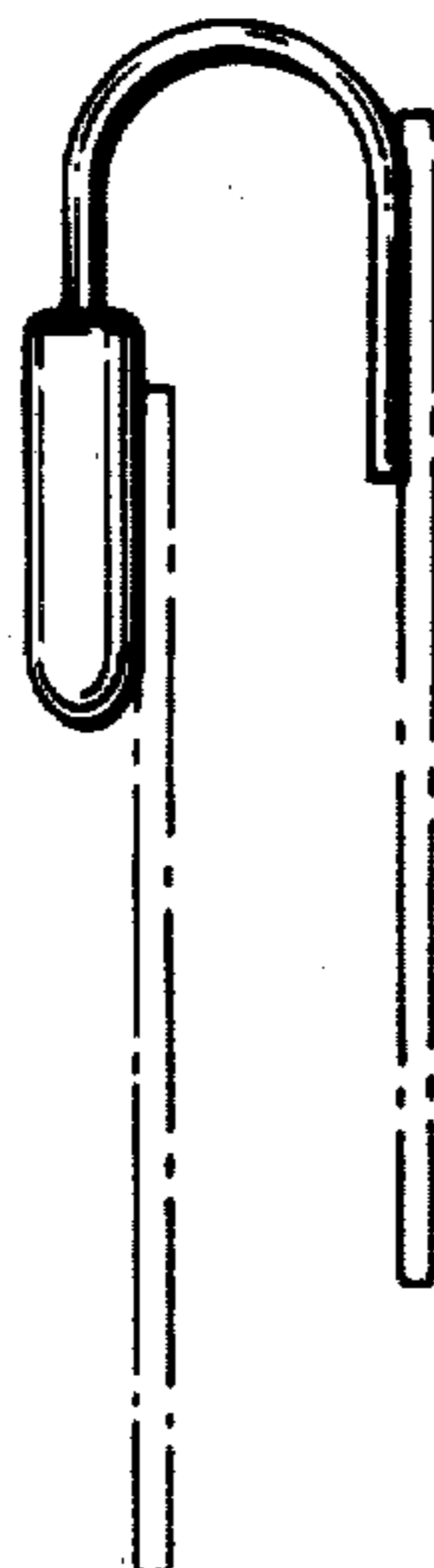
FIG. 3 is a an enlarged top plan view thereof;

The broken line depictions of earring ornaments and a wearer's ear are illustrative of environment only.



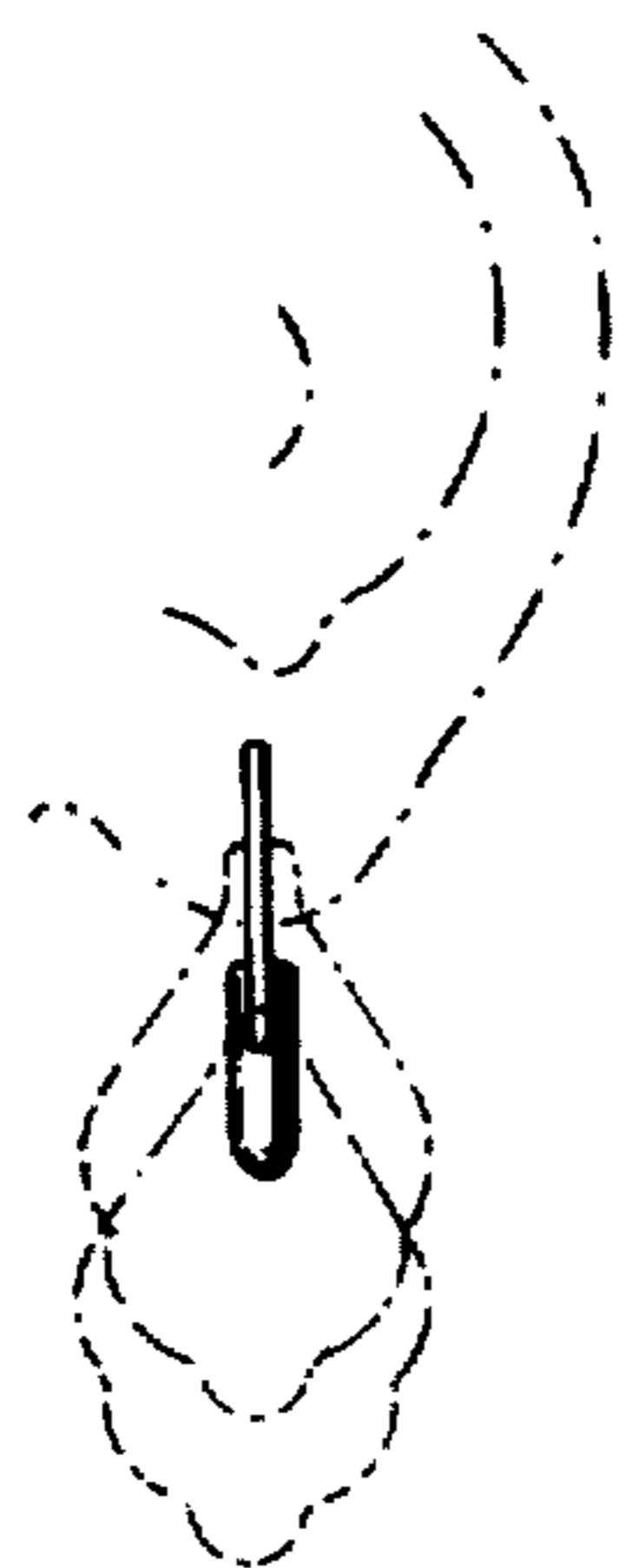

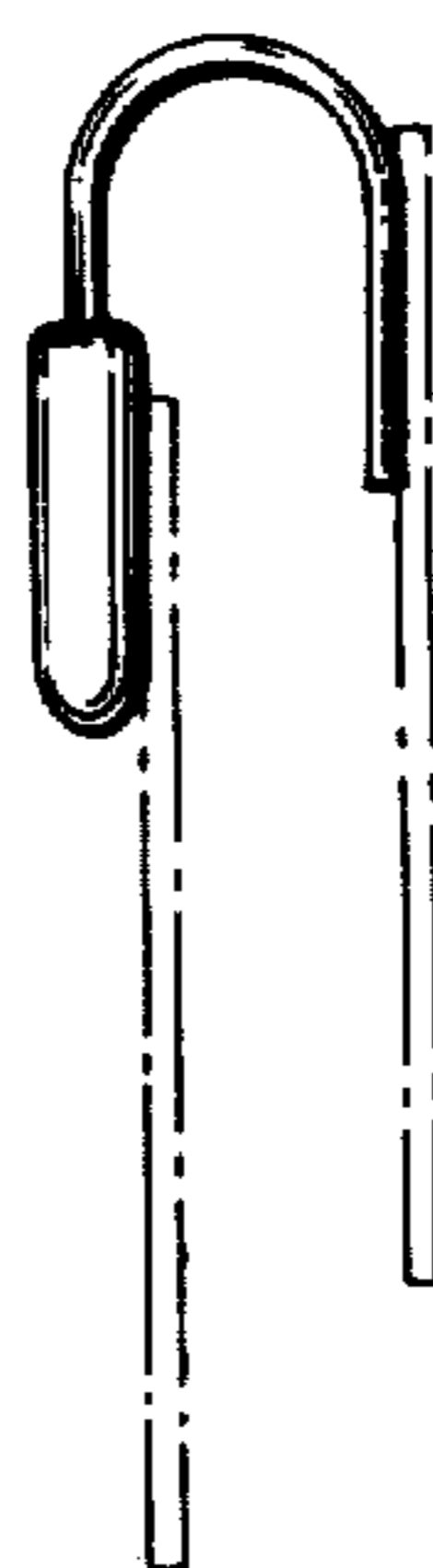

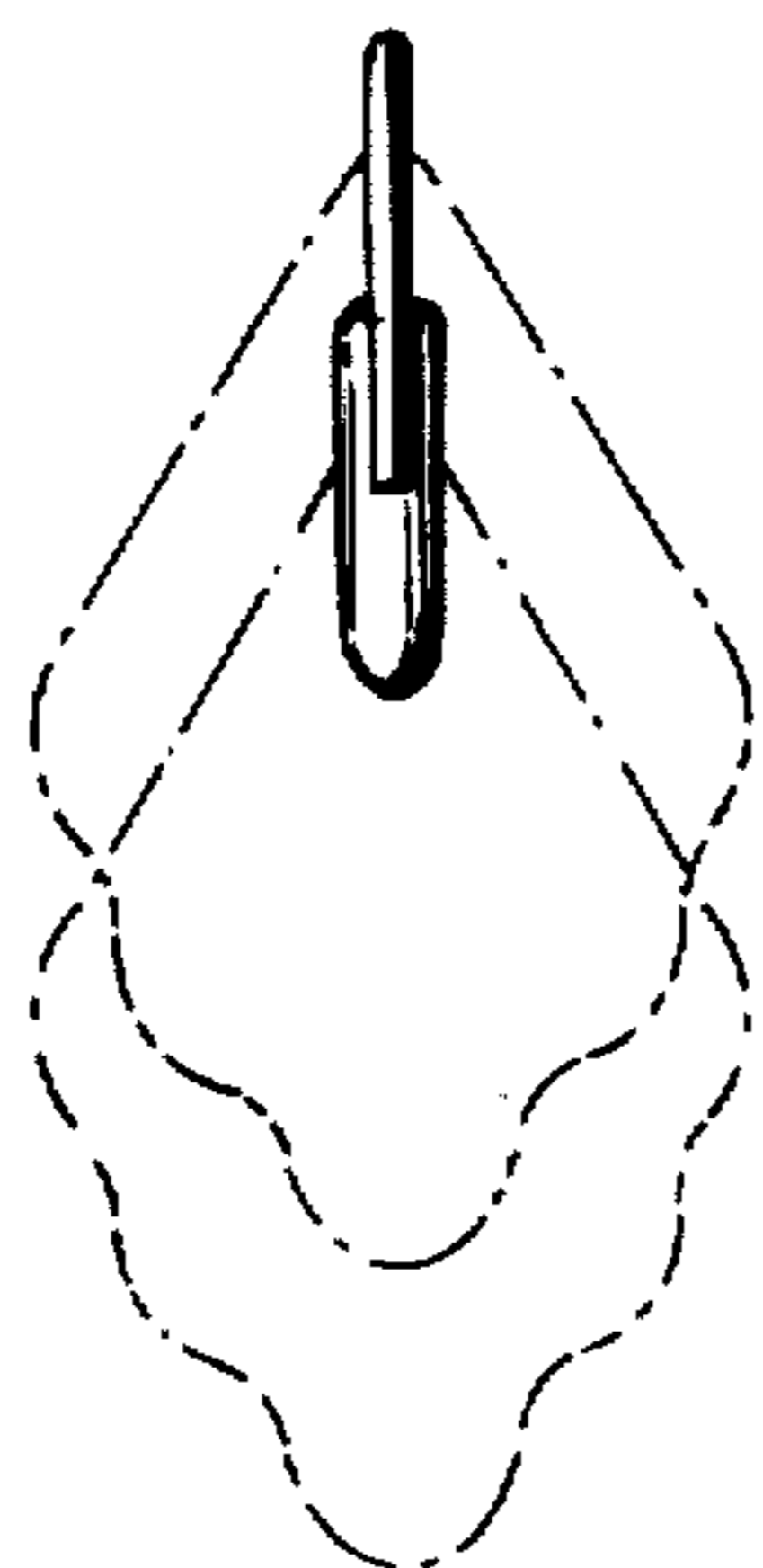

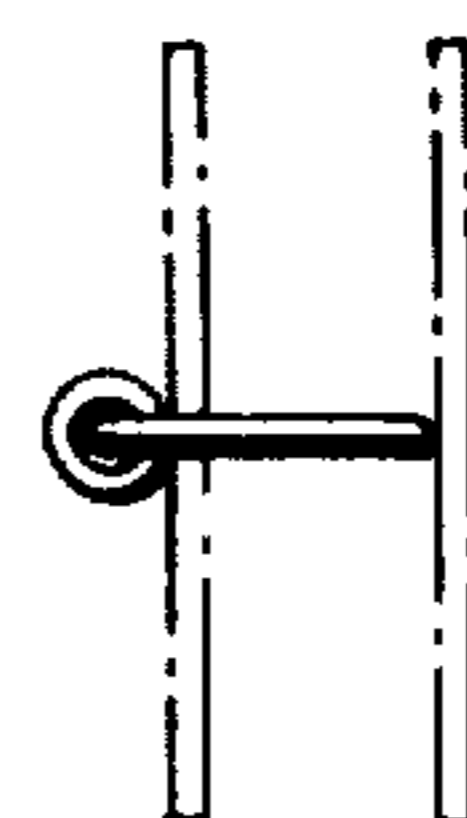

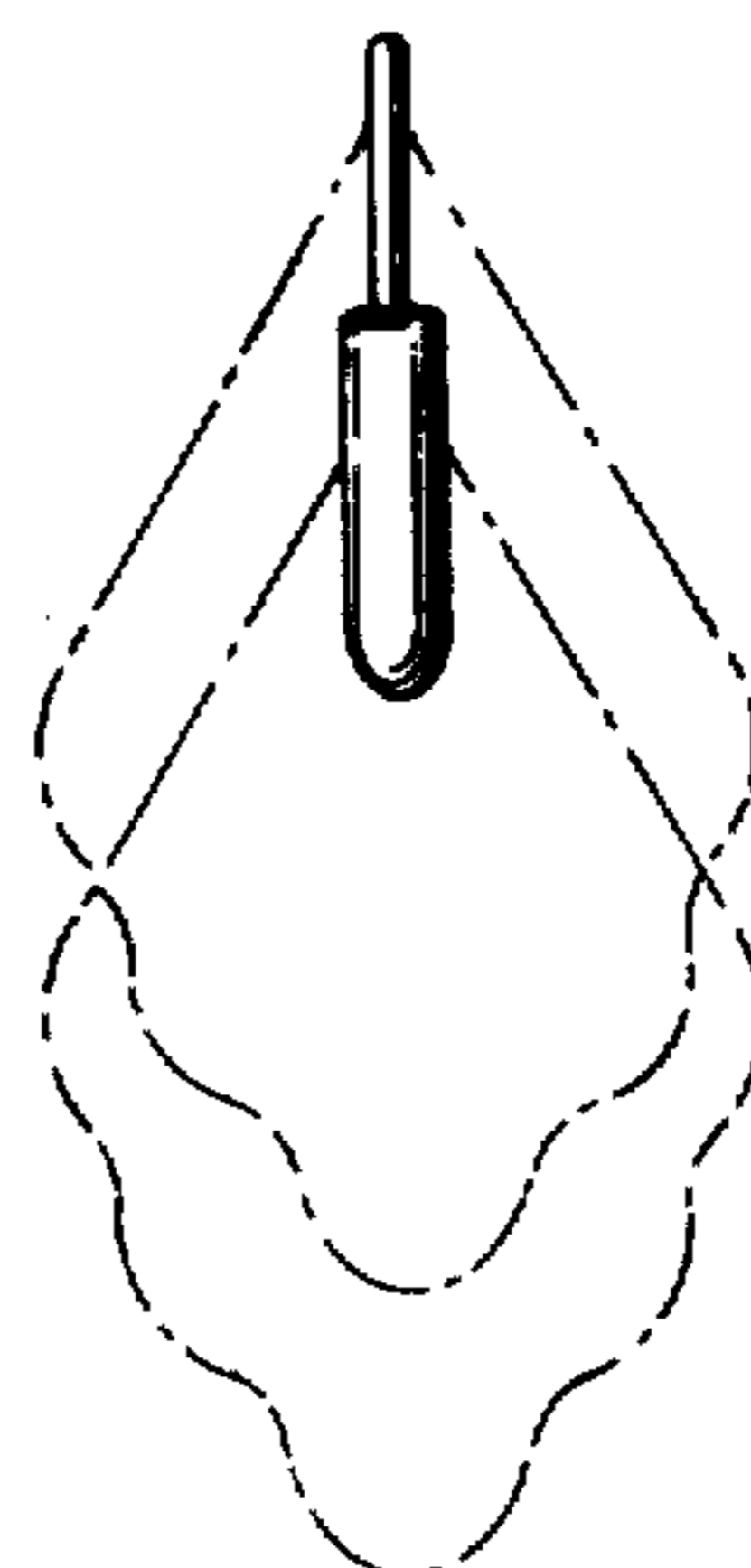
