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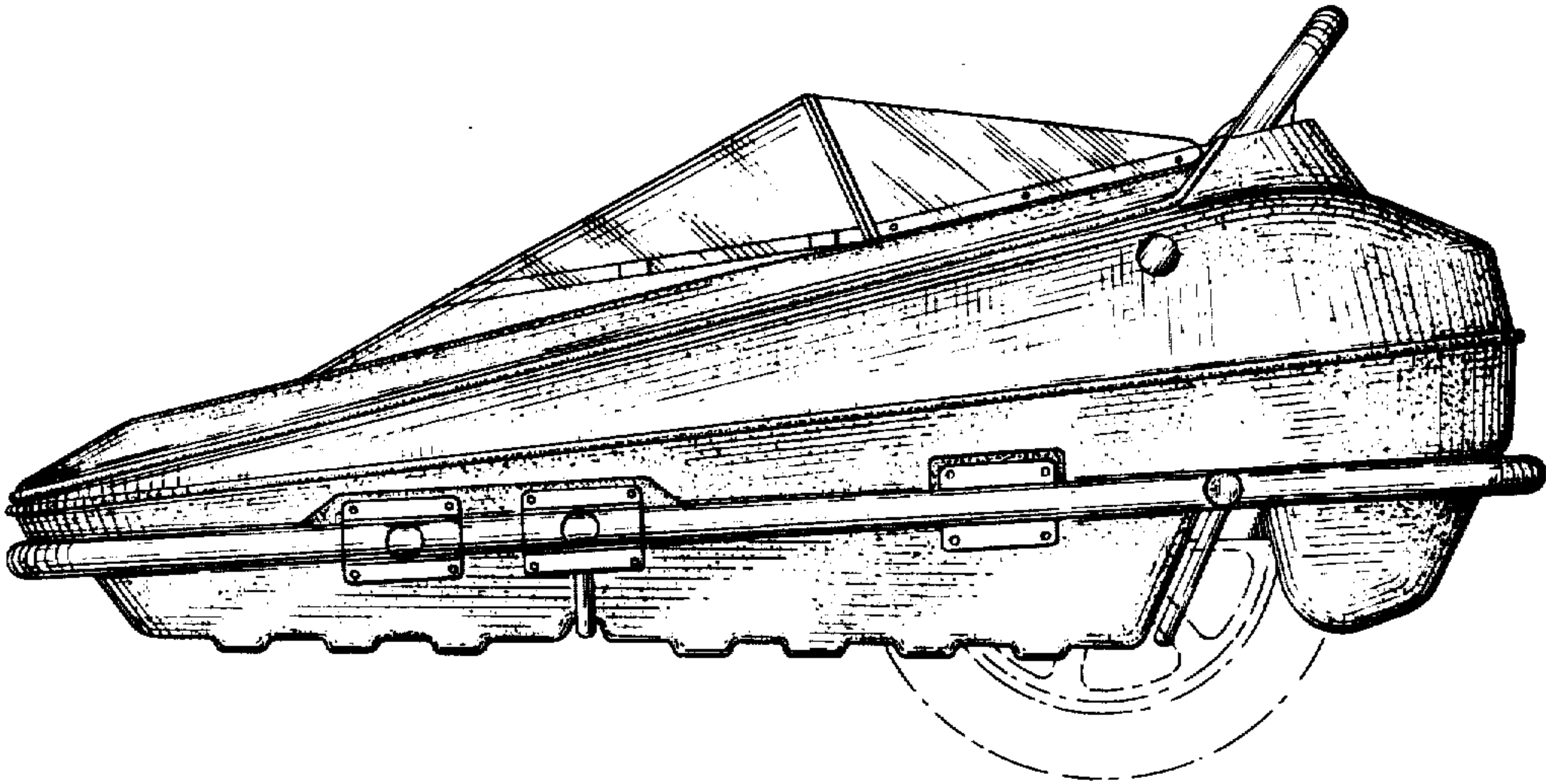

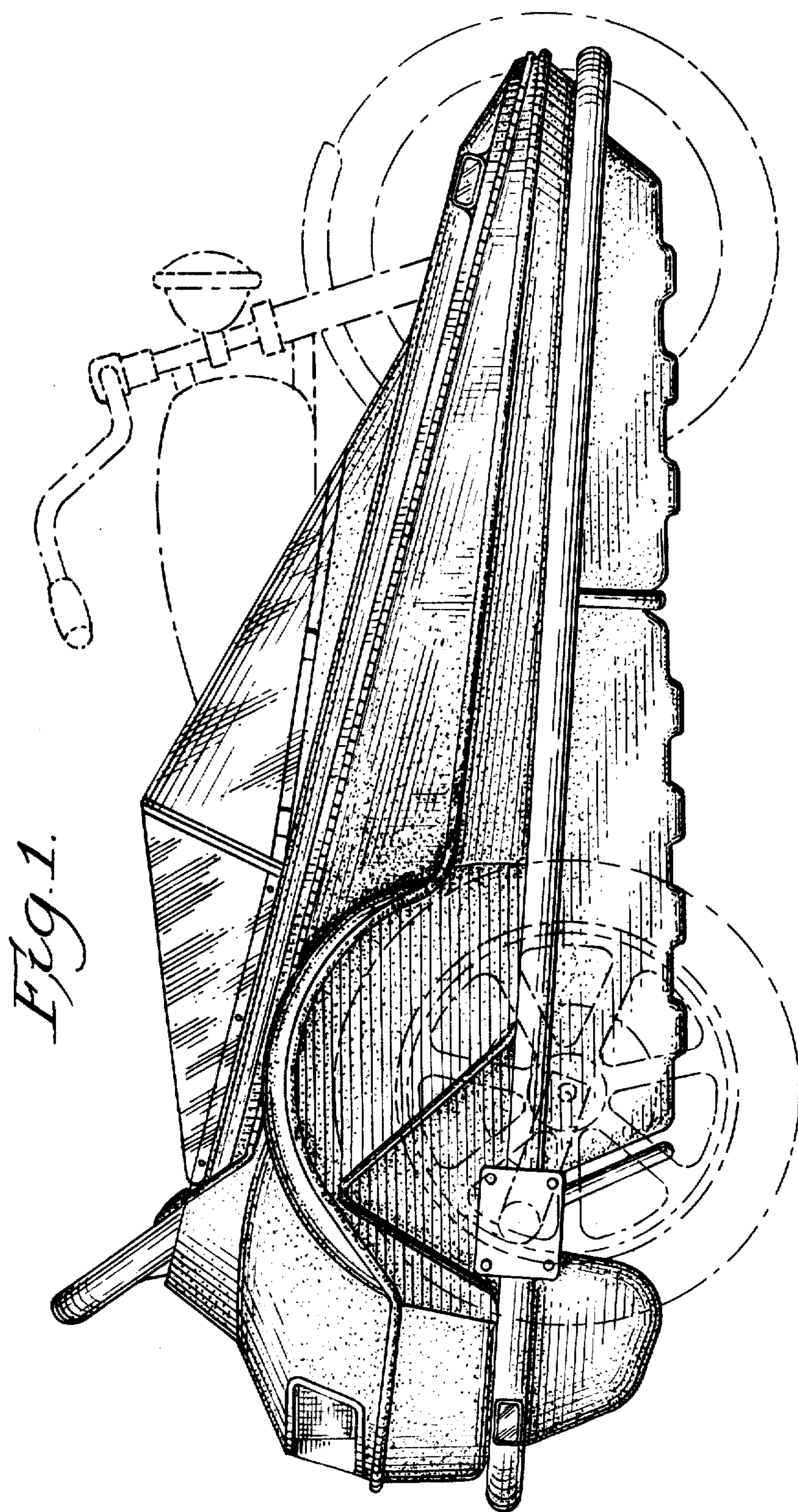
The ornamental design for a motorcycle sidecar, as

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a motorcycle
sidecar showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof.

part of the invention.





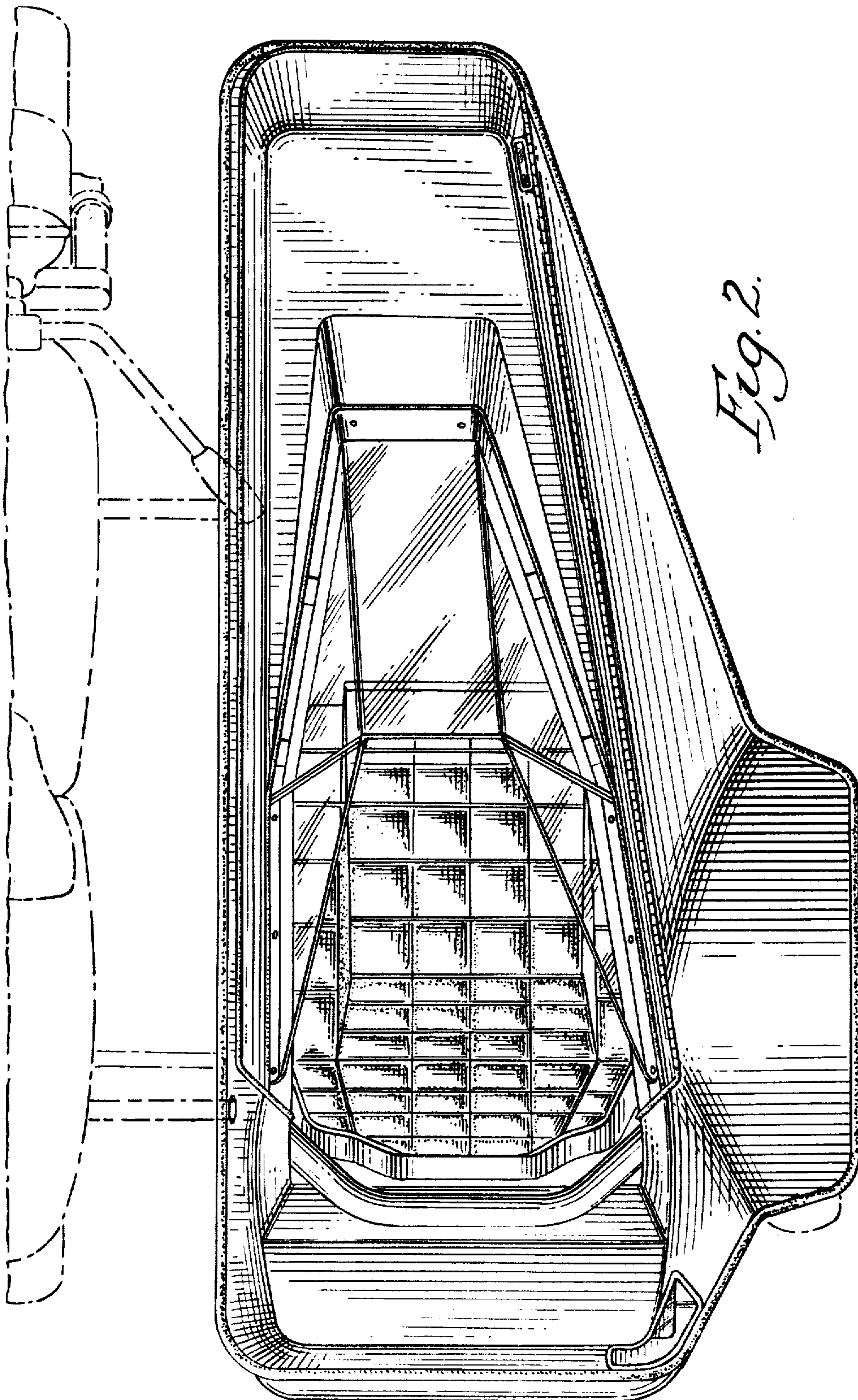

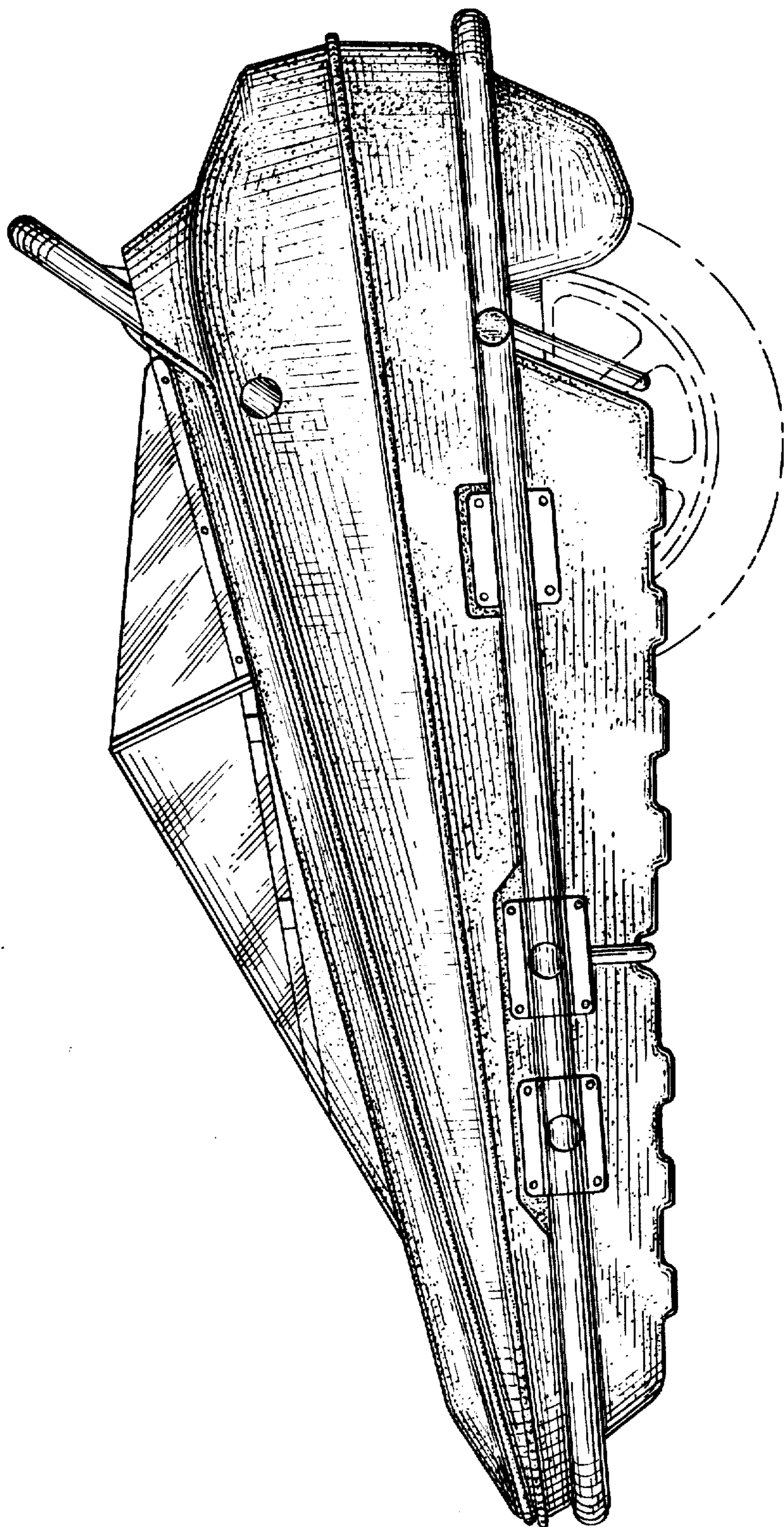

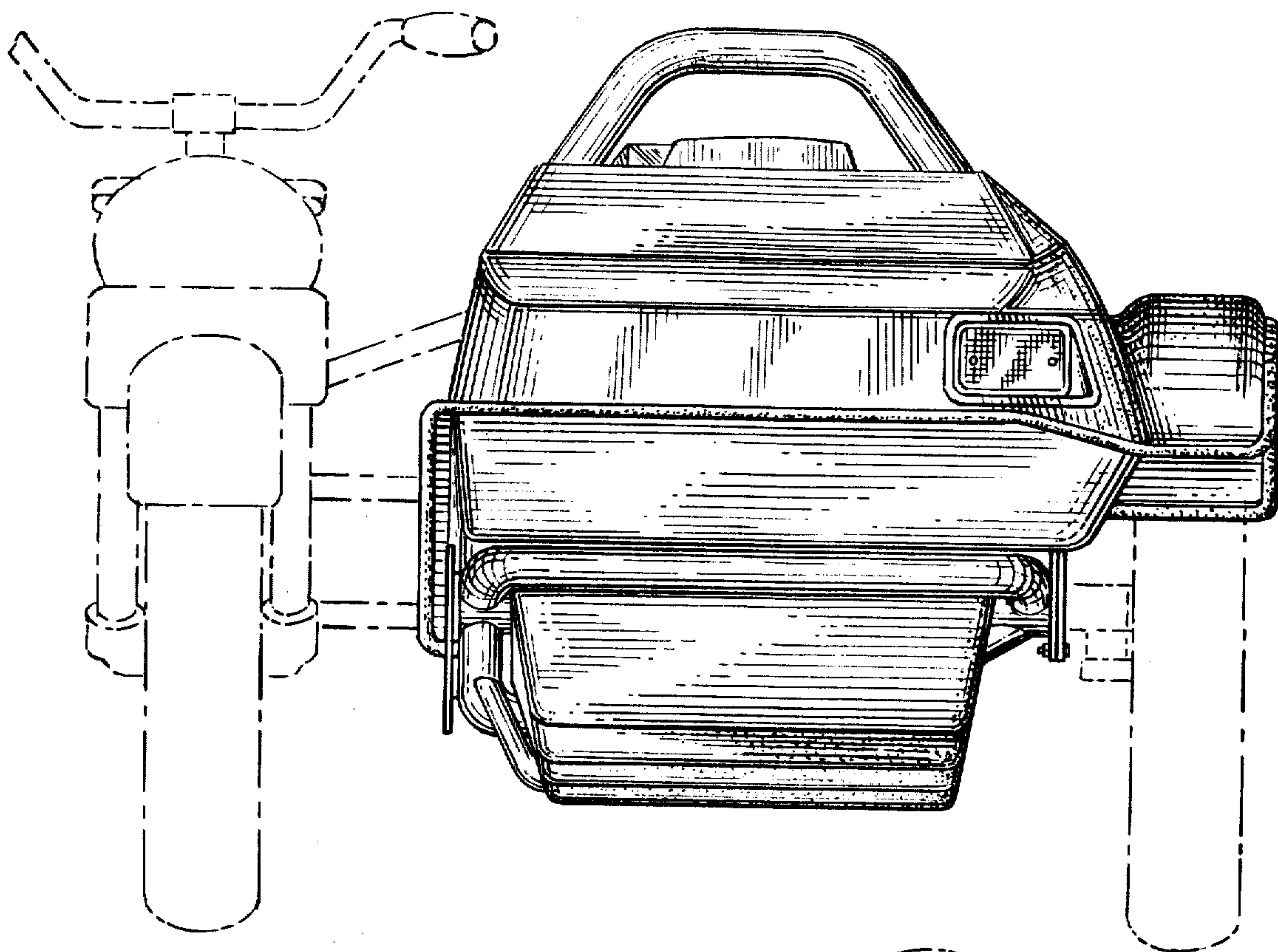
