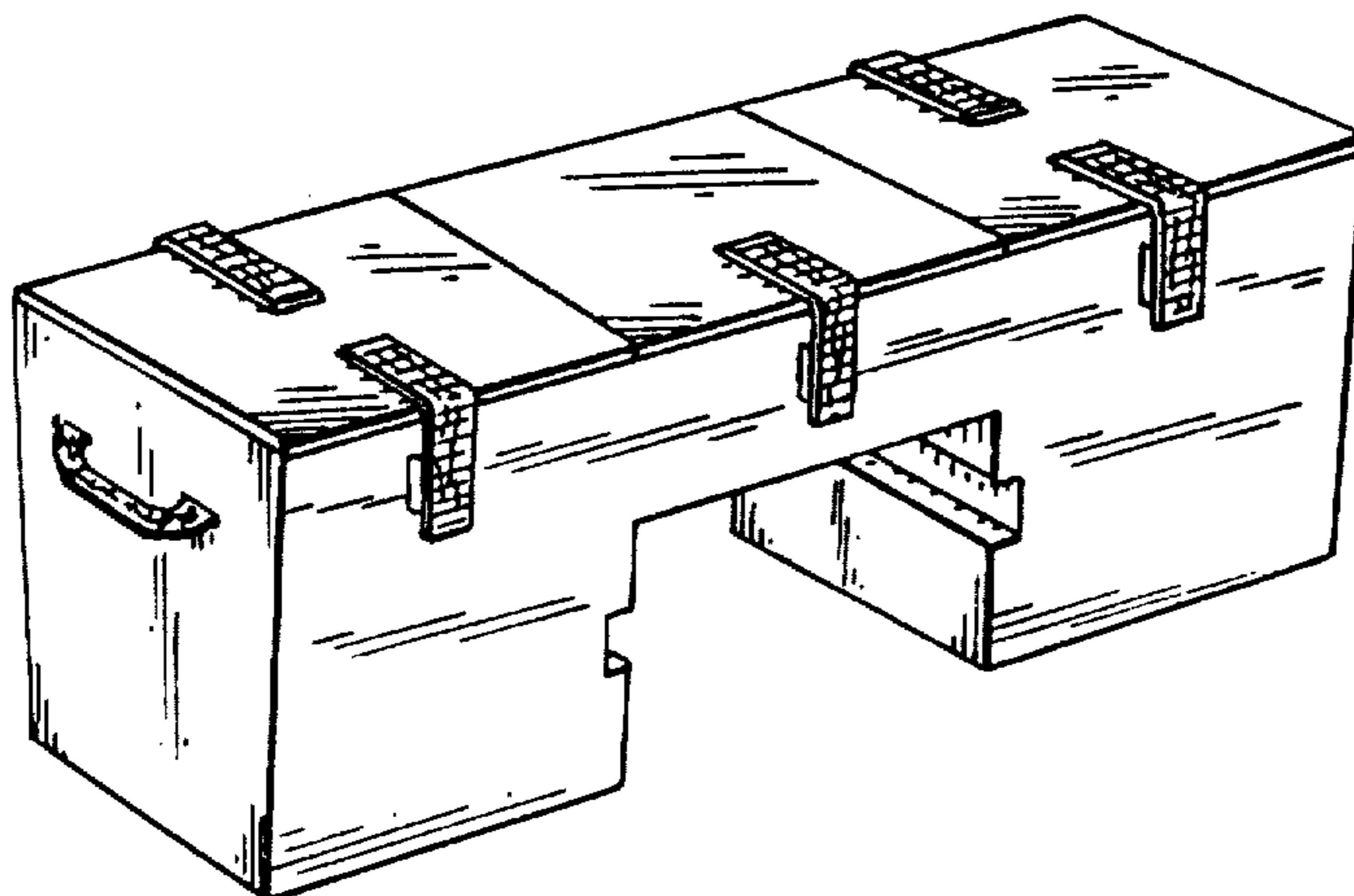

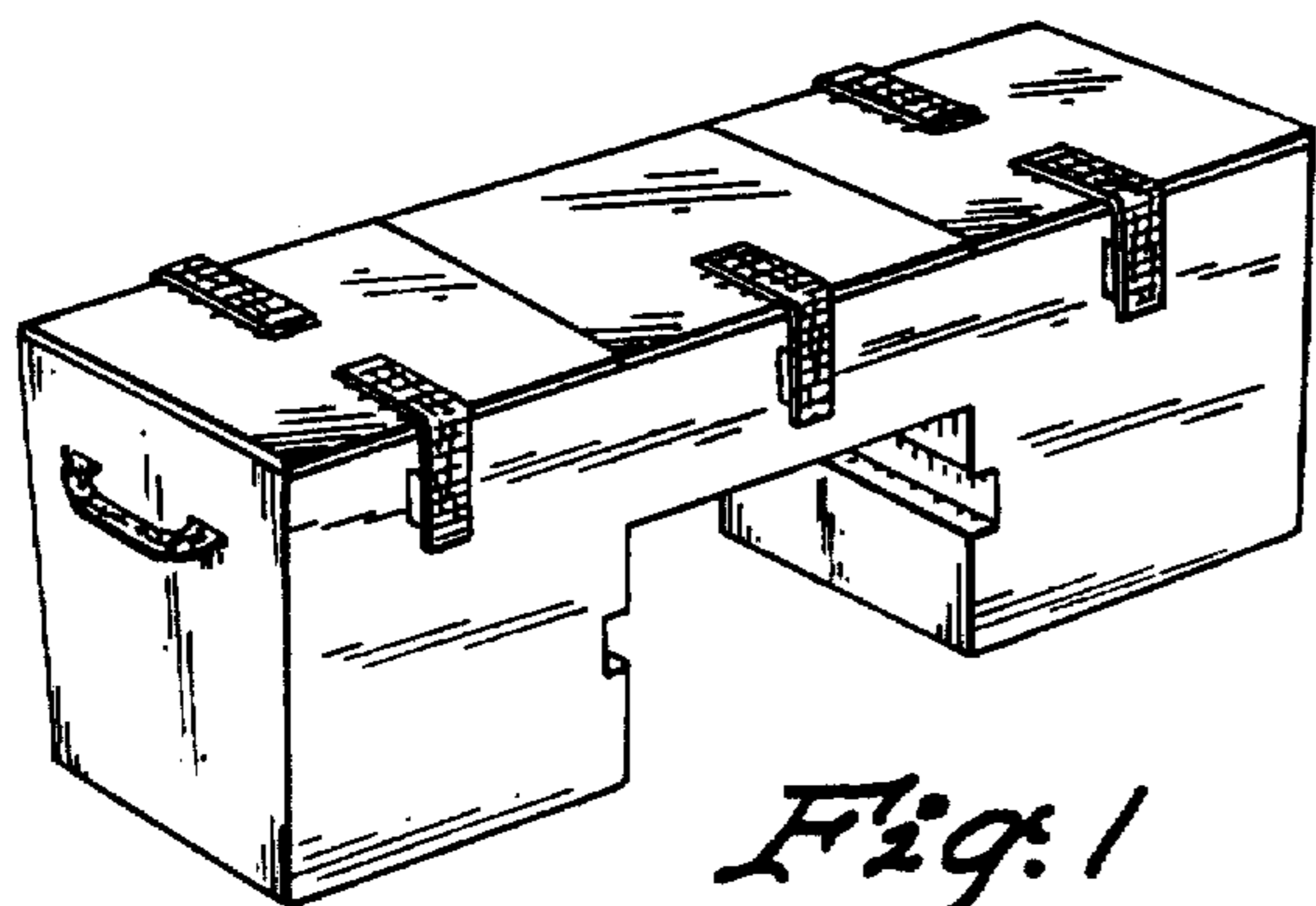
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a boat seat box console showing my new design;

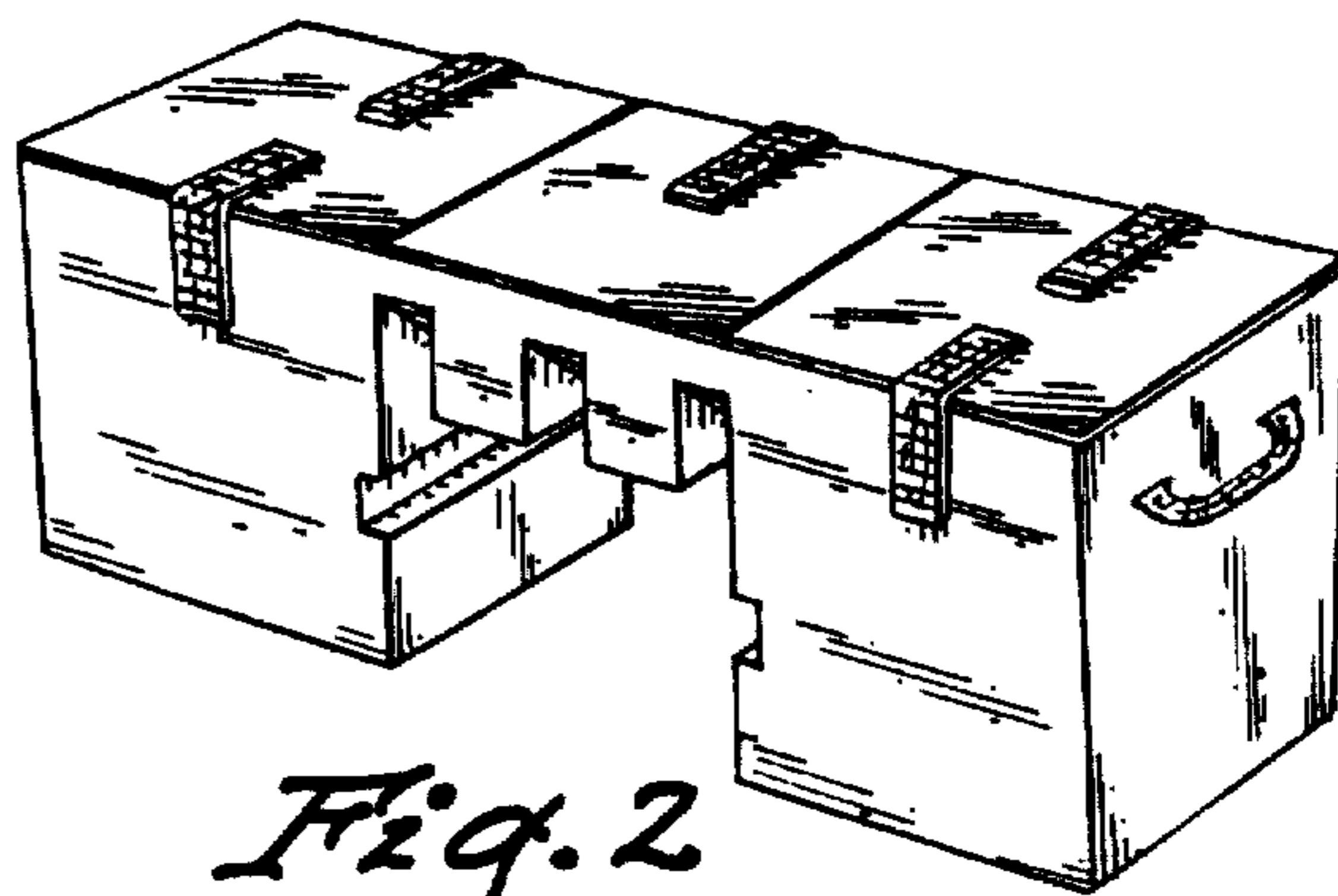

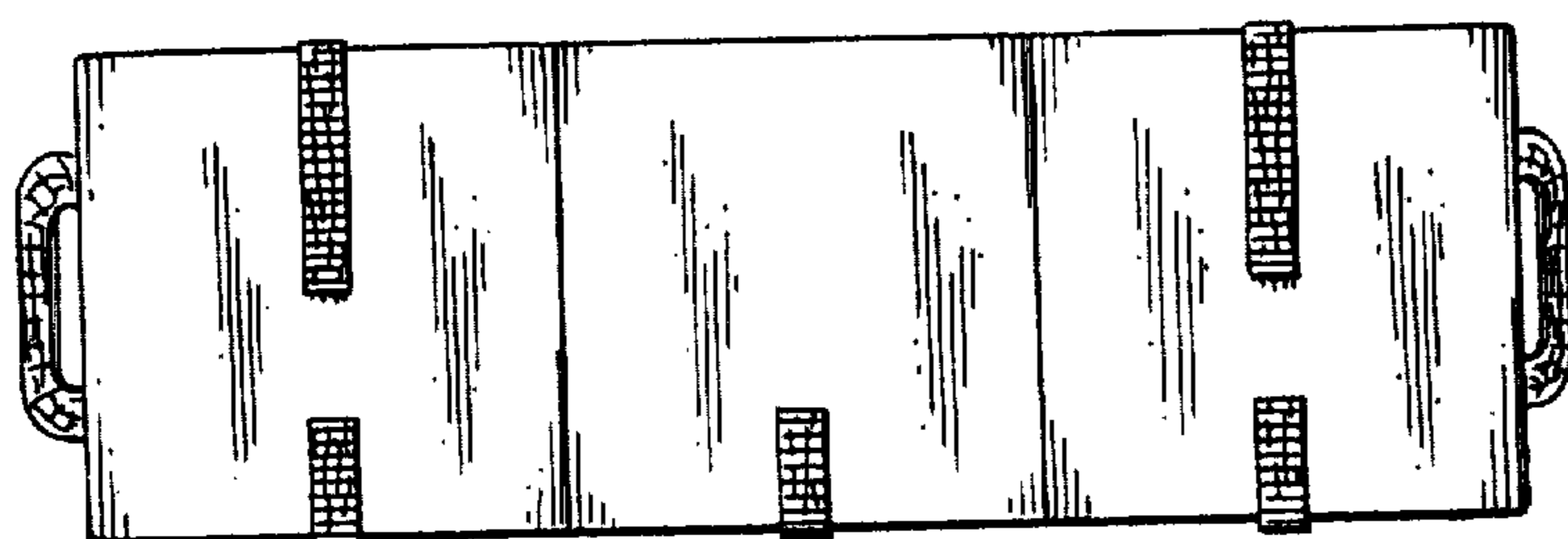




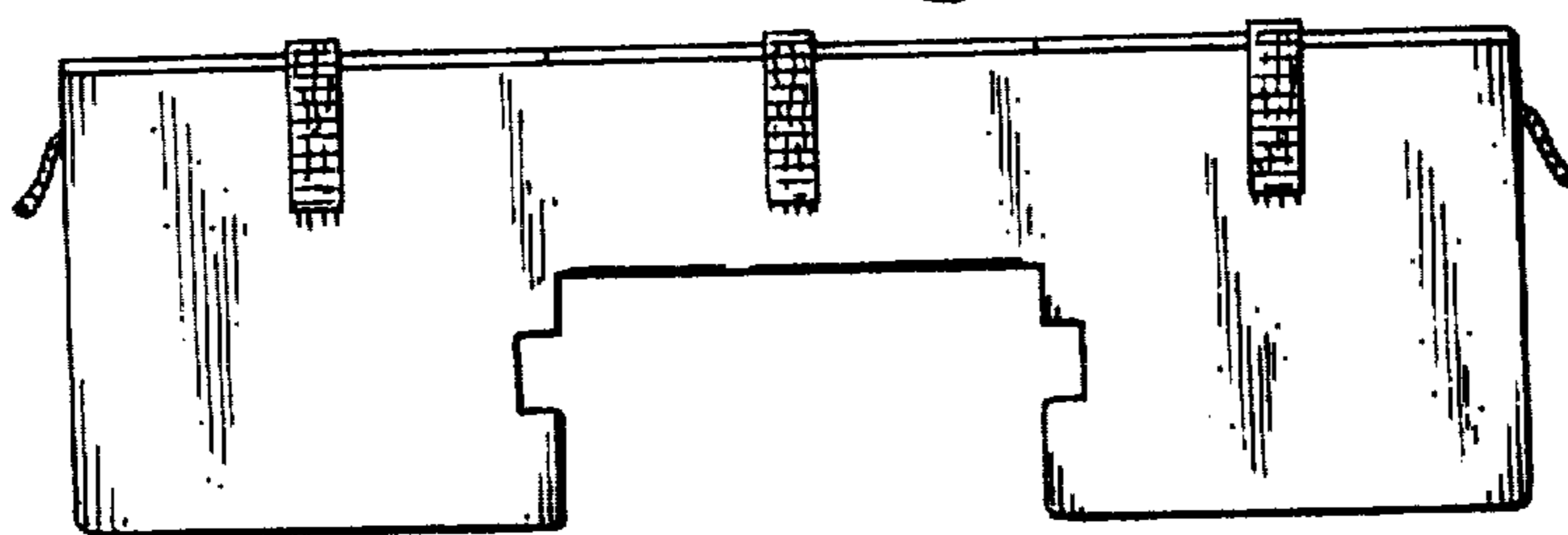

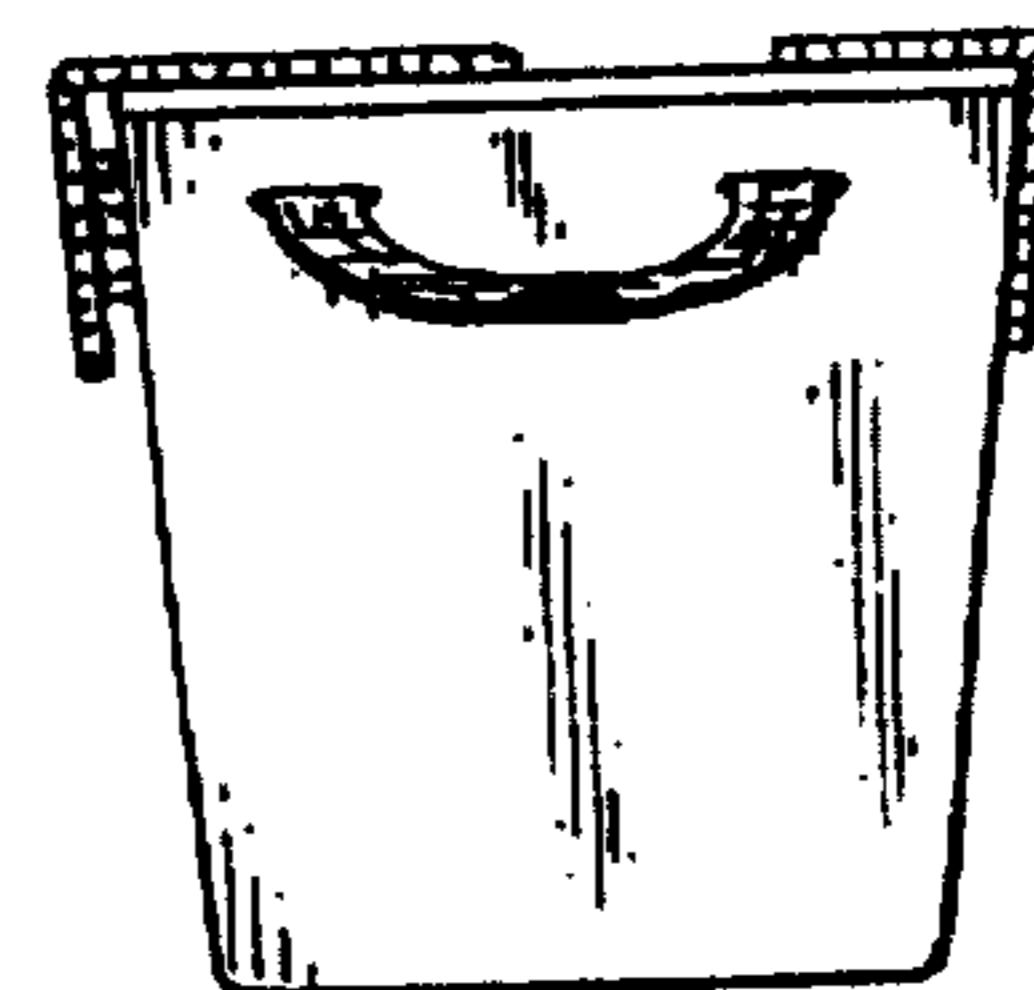

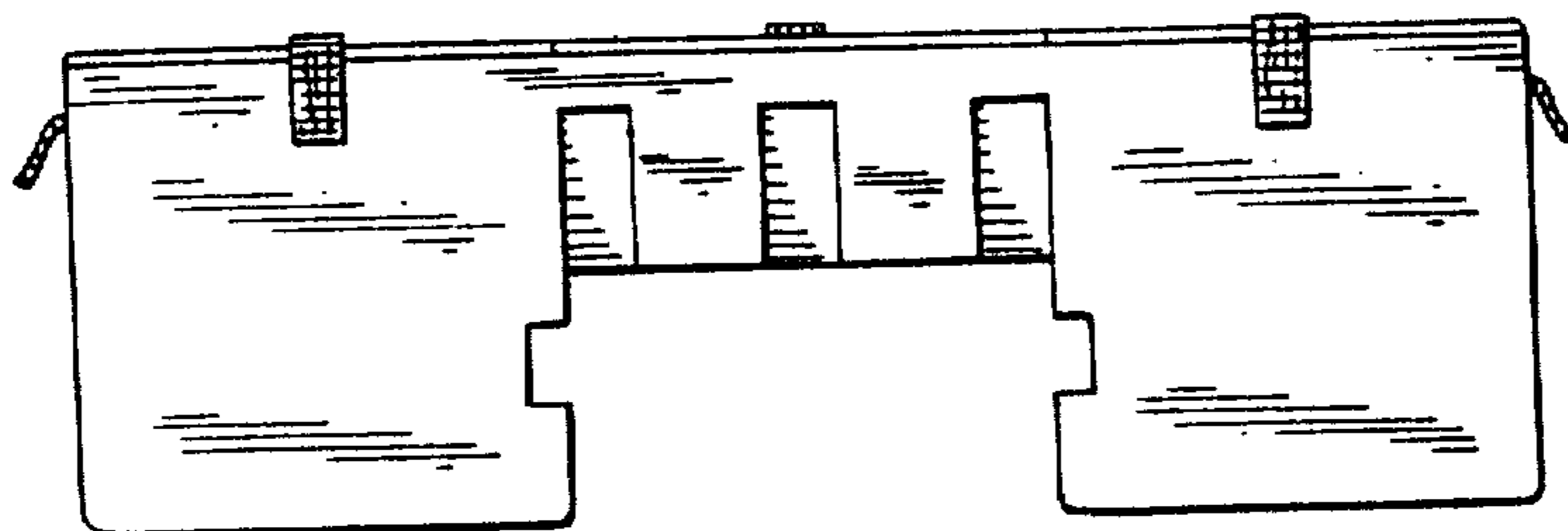

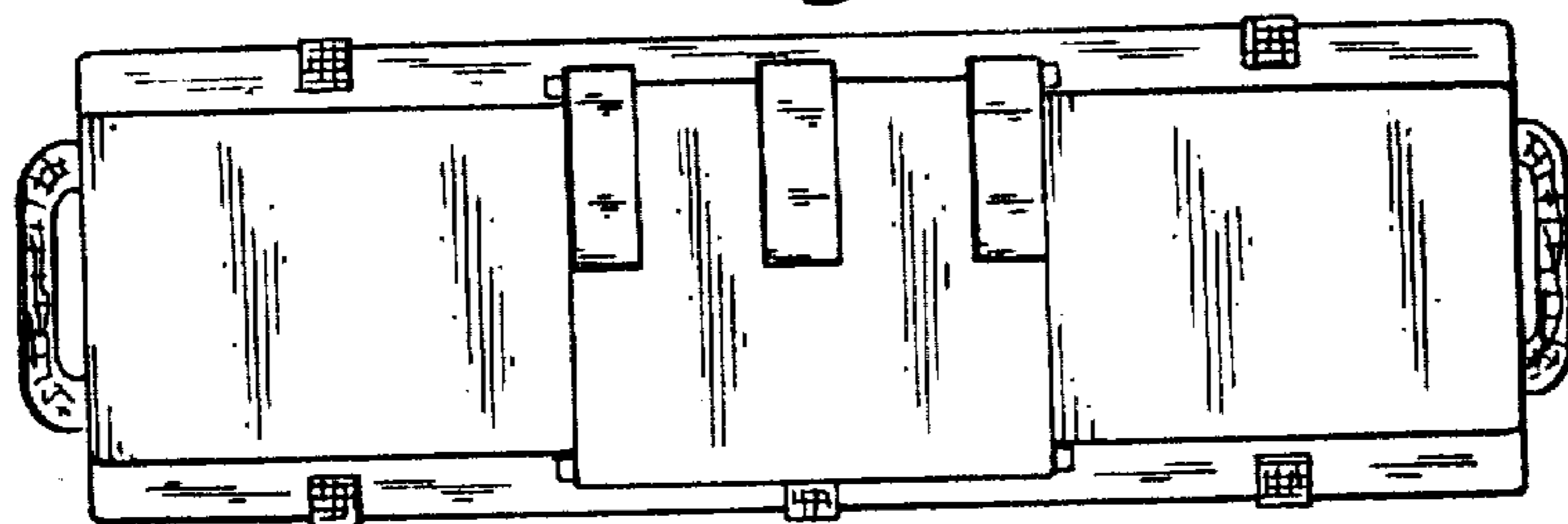
