DESCRIPTION

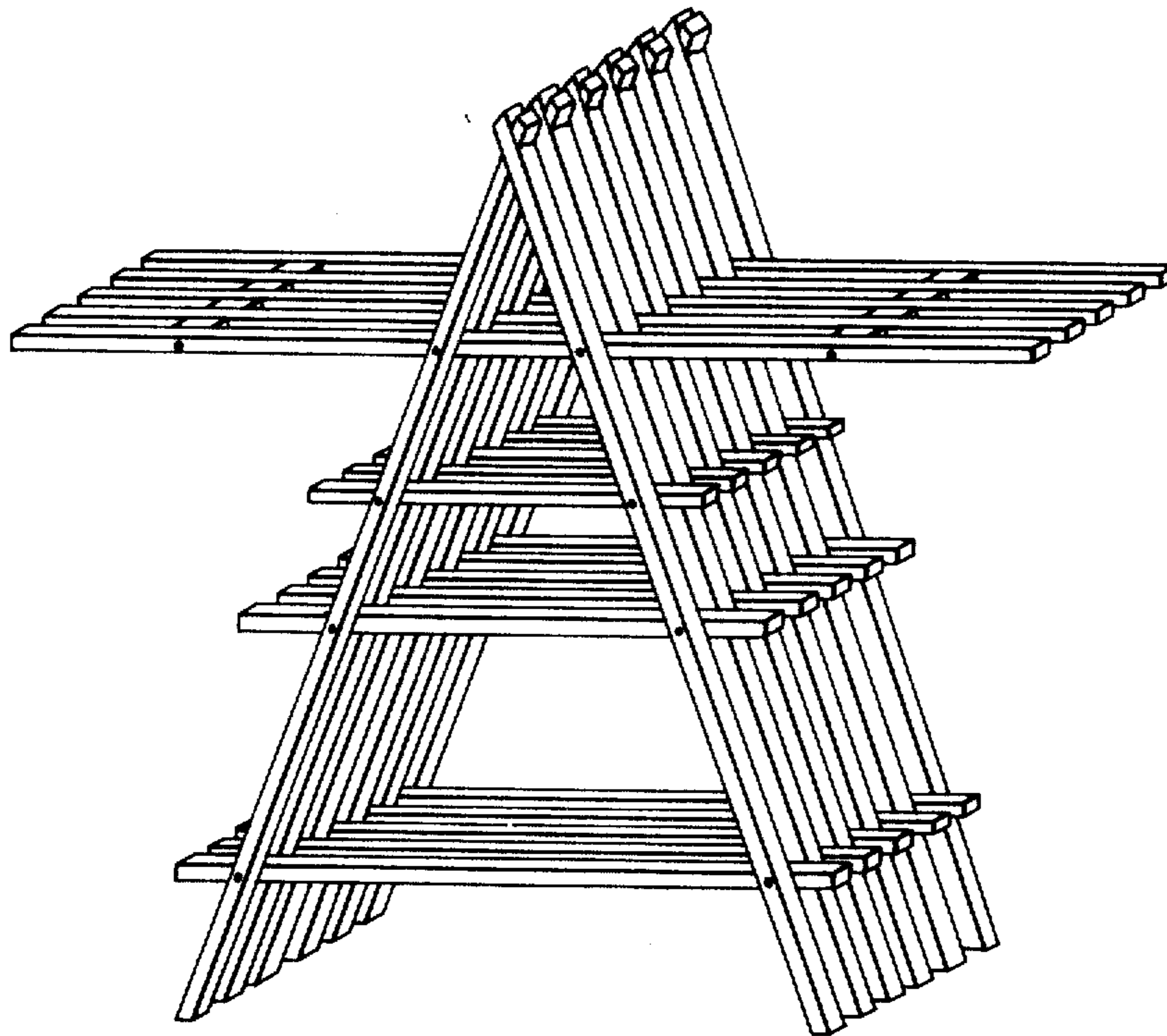
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shelf unit embodying my new design;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof.



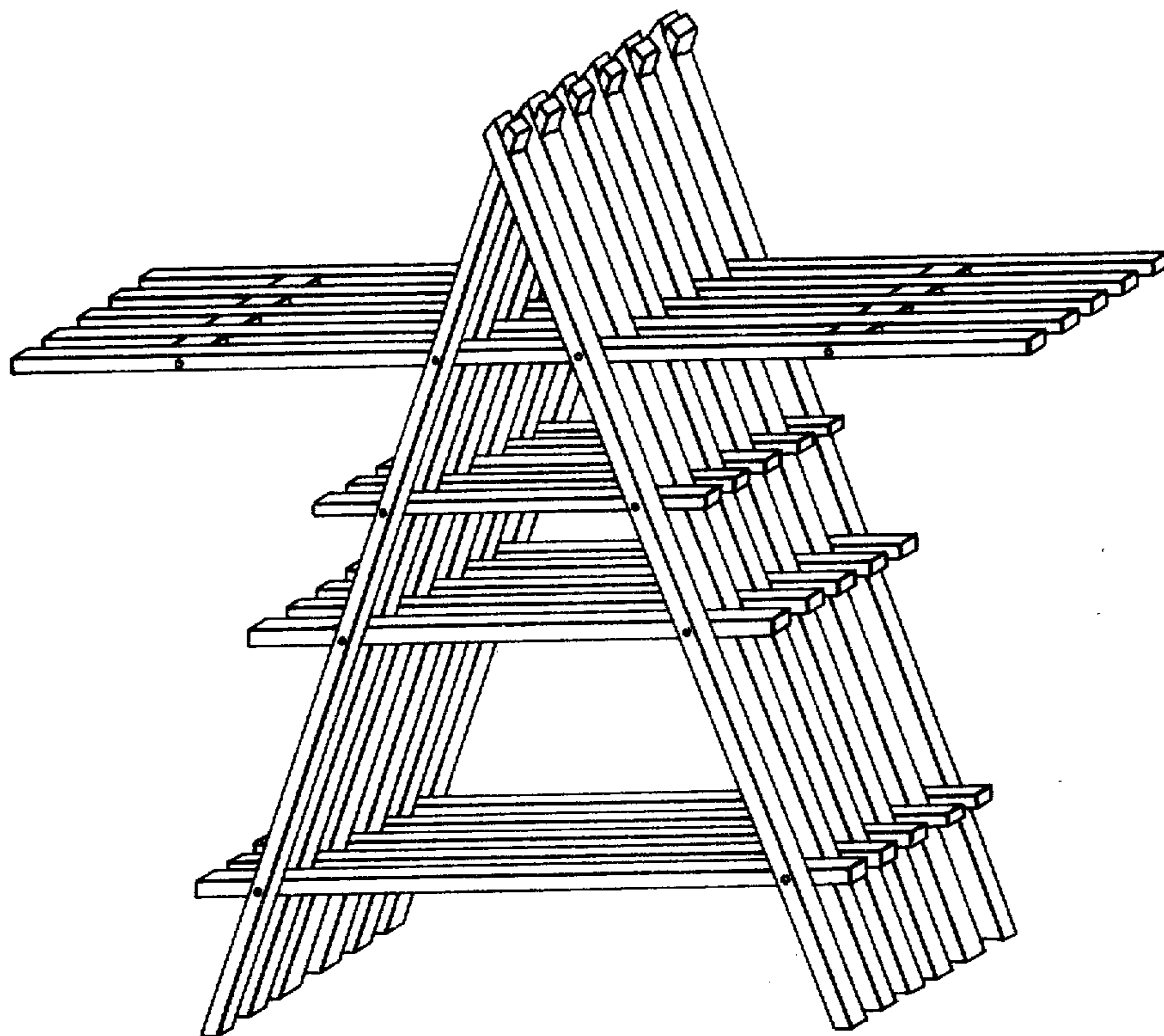

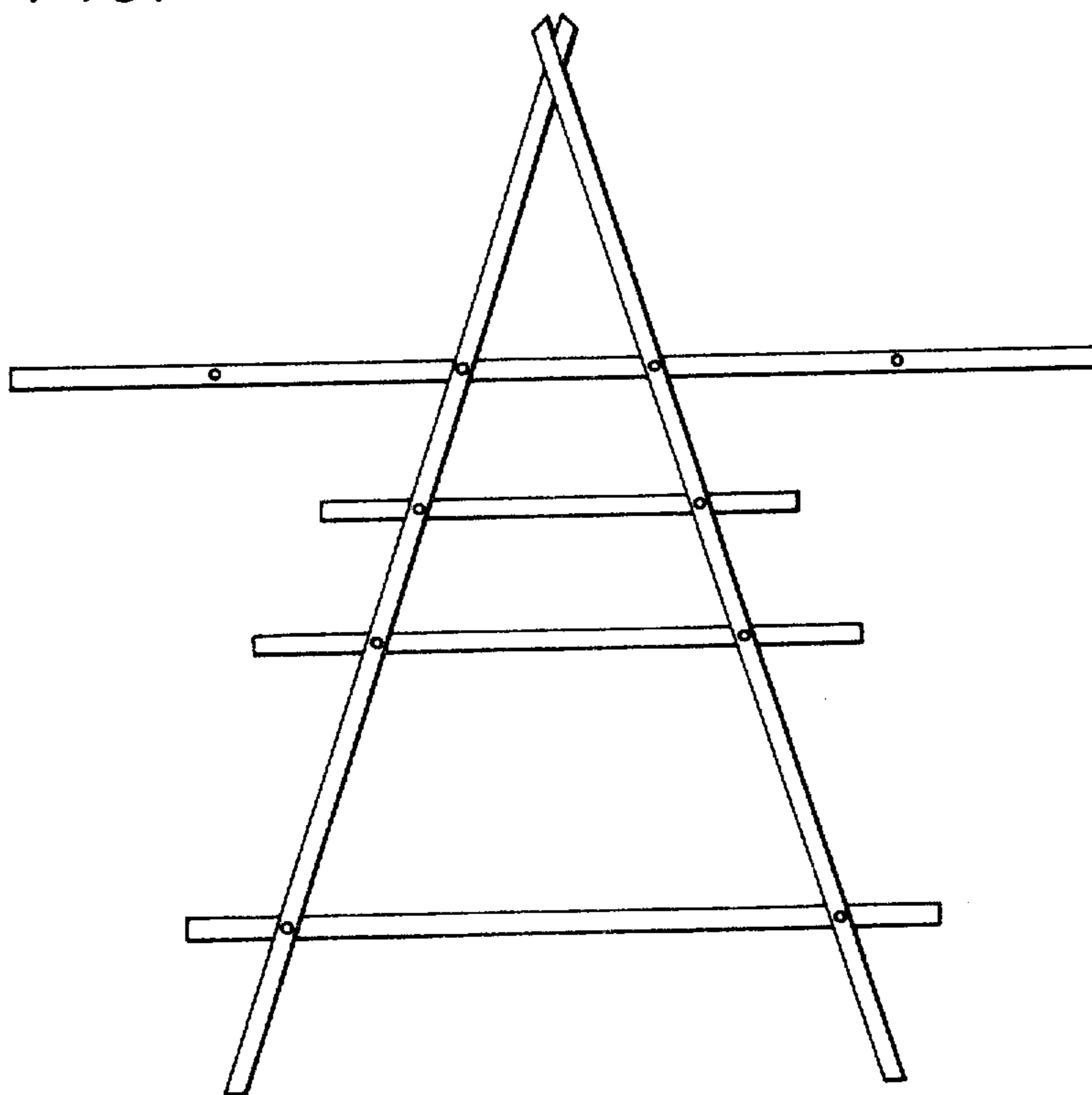

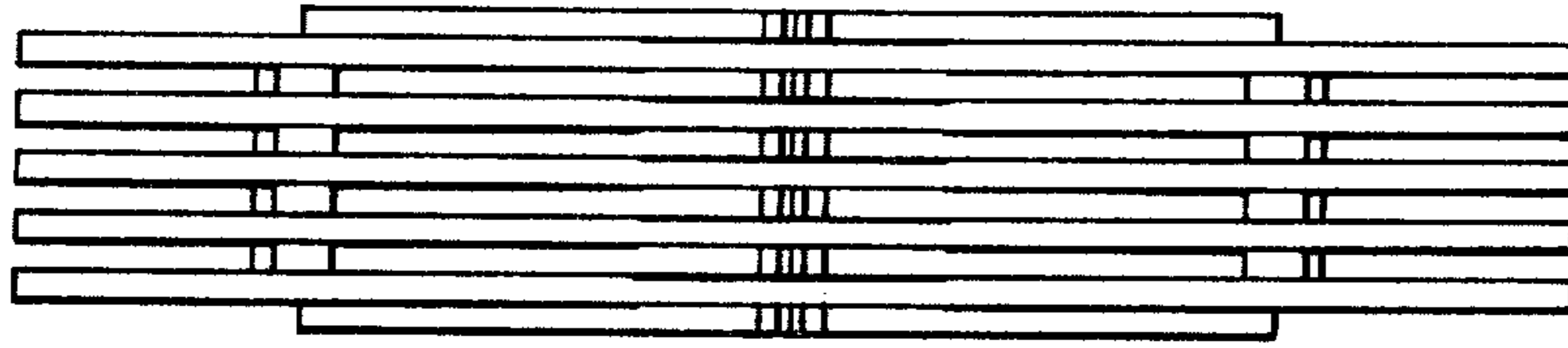

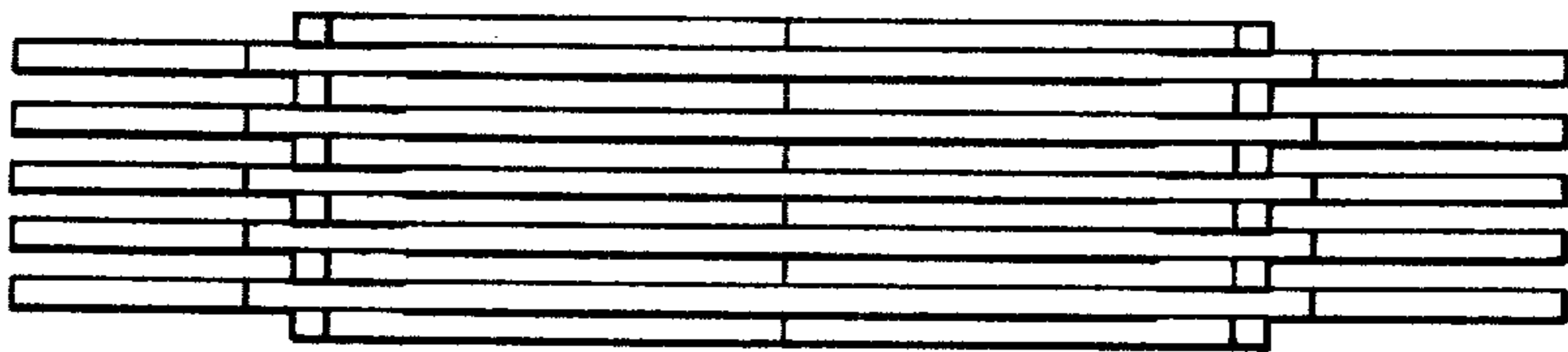

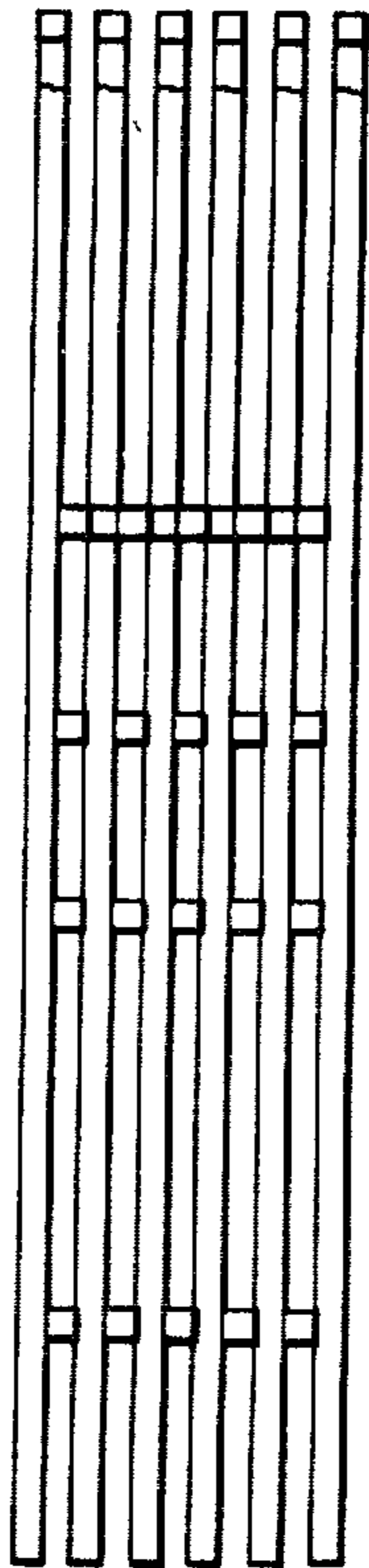
