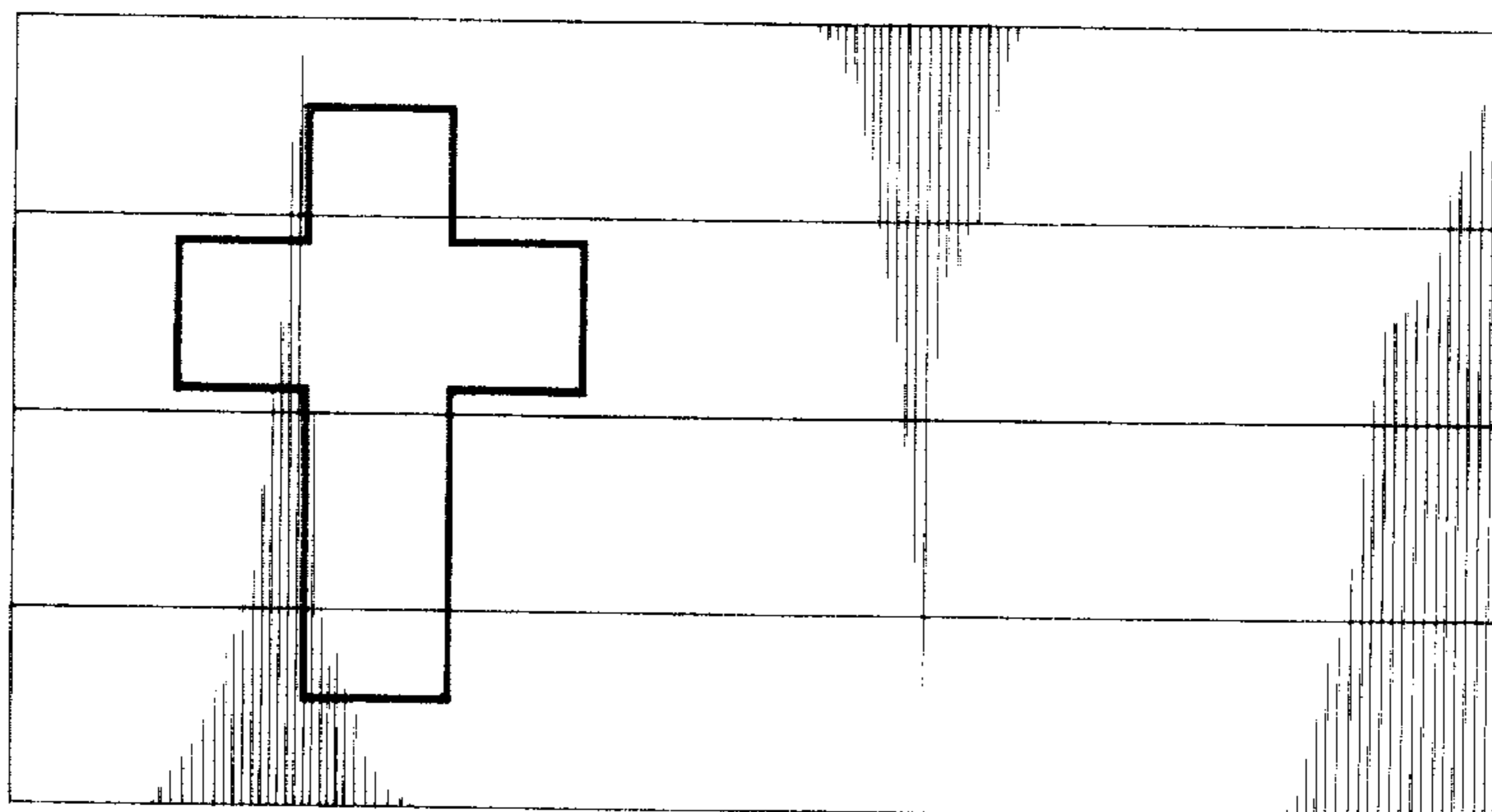
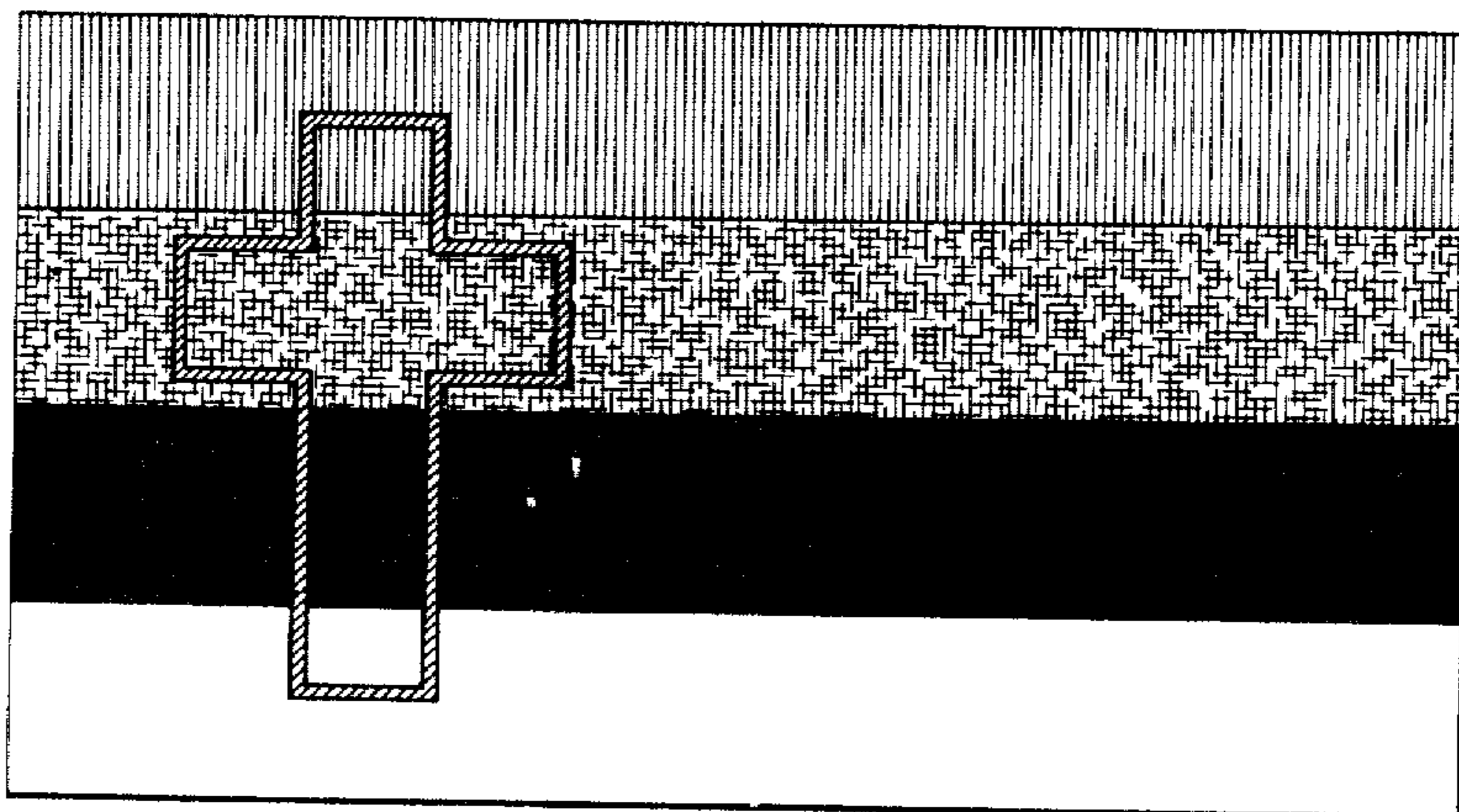
CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a face view of a flag showing my new design, the drawing being shaded to indicate color and the rear being a mirror image; and

FIG. 2 is a face view of a flag showing a modified form of my new design.



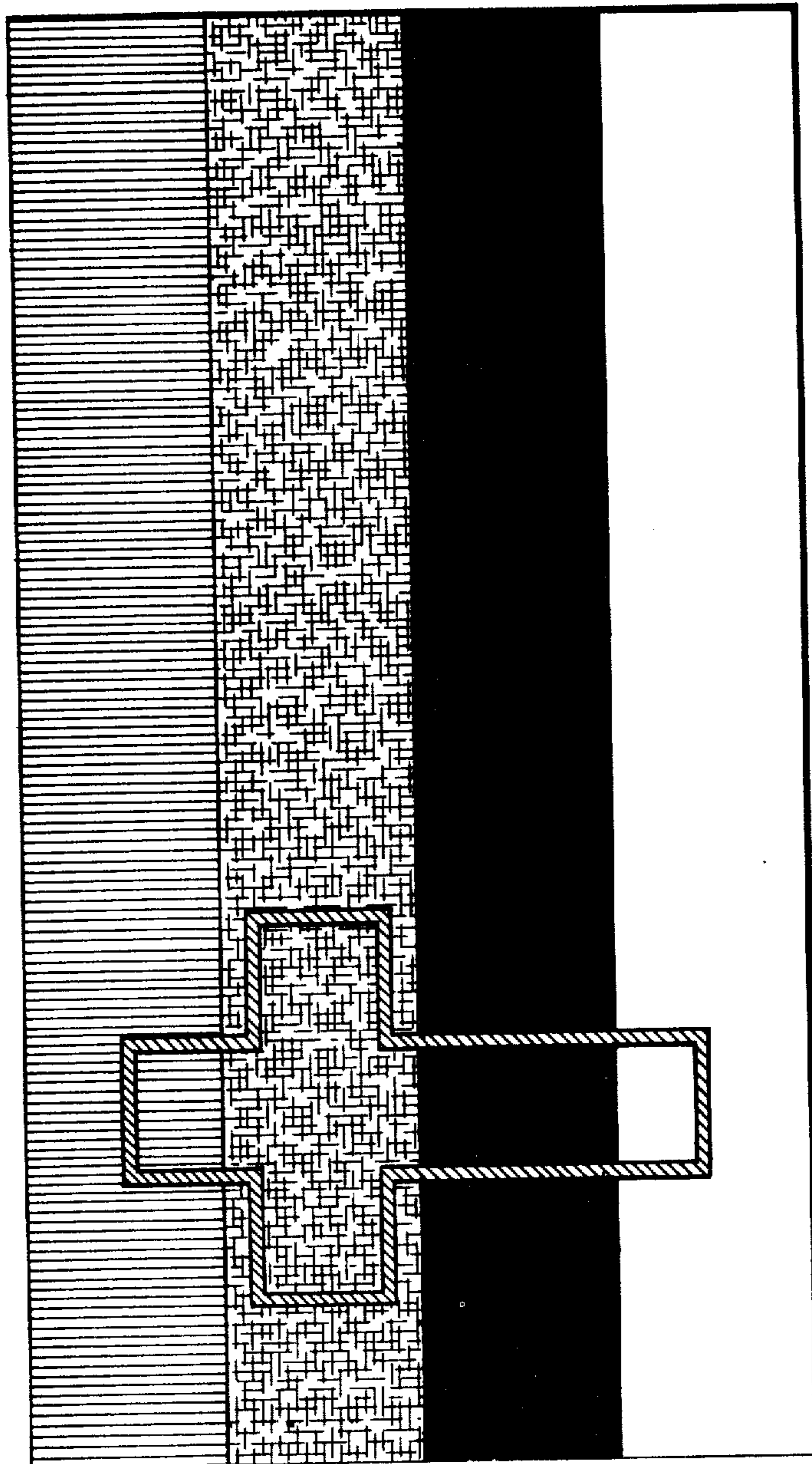

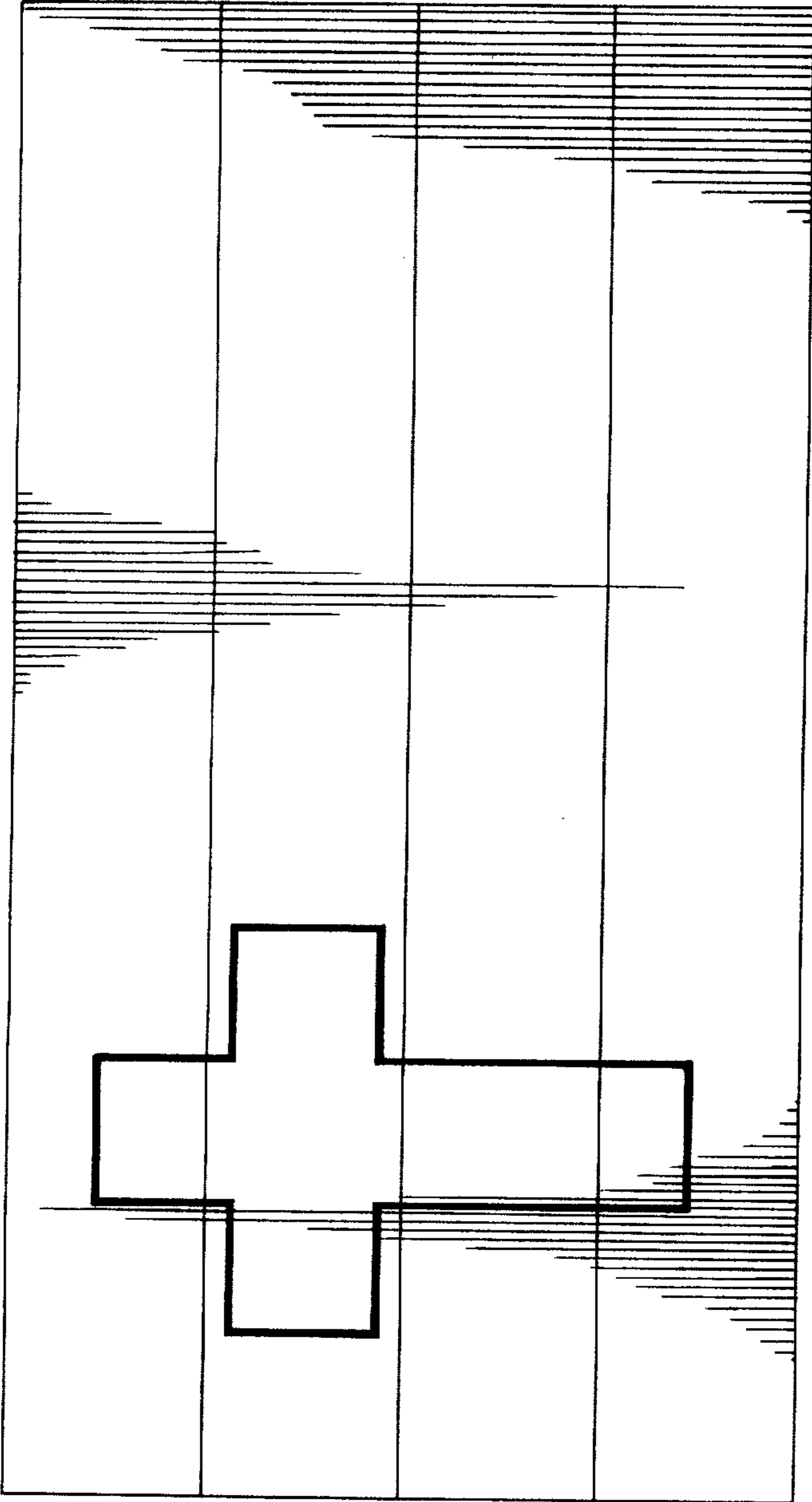
