[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a handle for a toilet seat or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a handle for a toilet seat or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an elevational view taken from the side opposite that shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an elevational view taken from the side shown in FIG. 1;

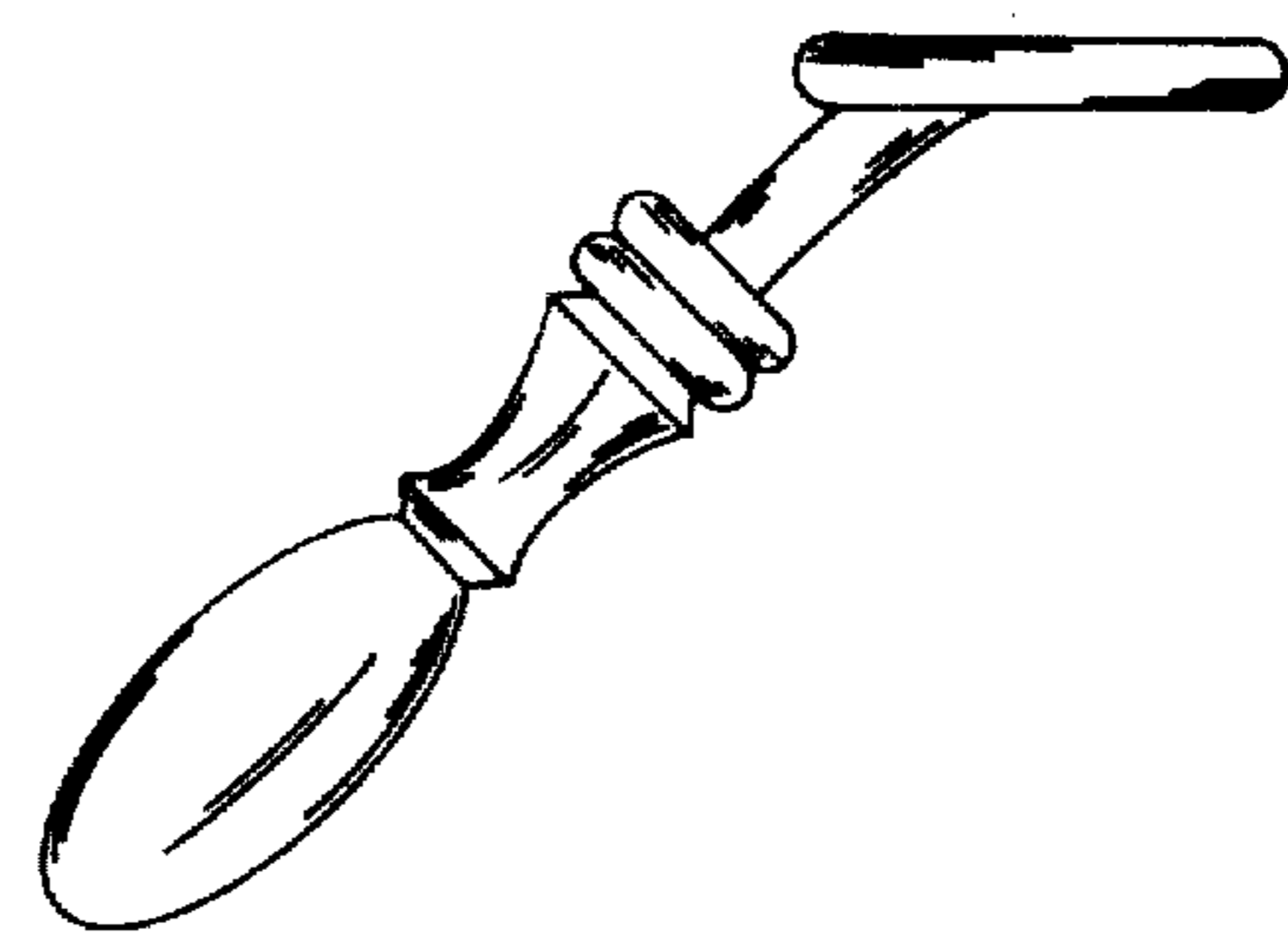
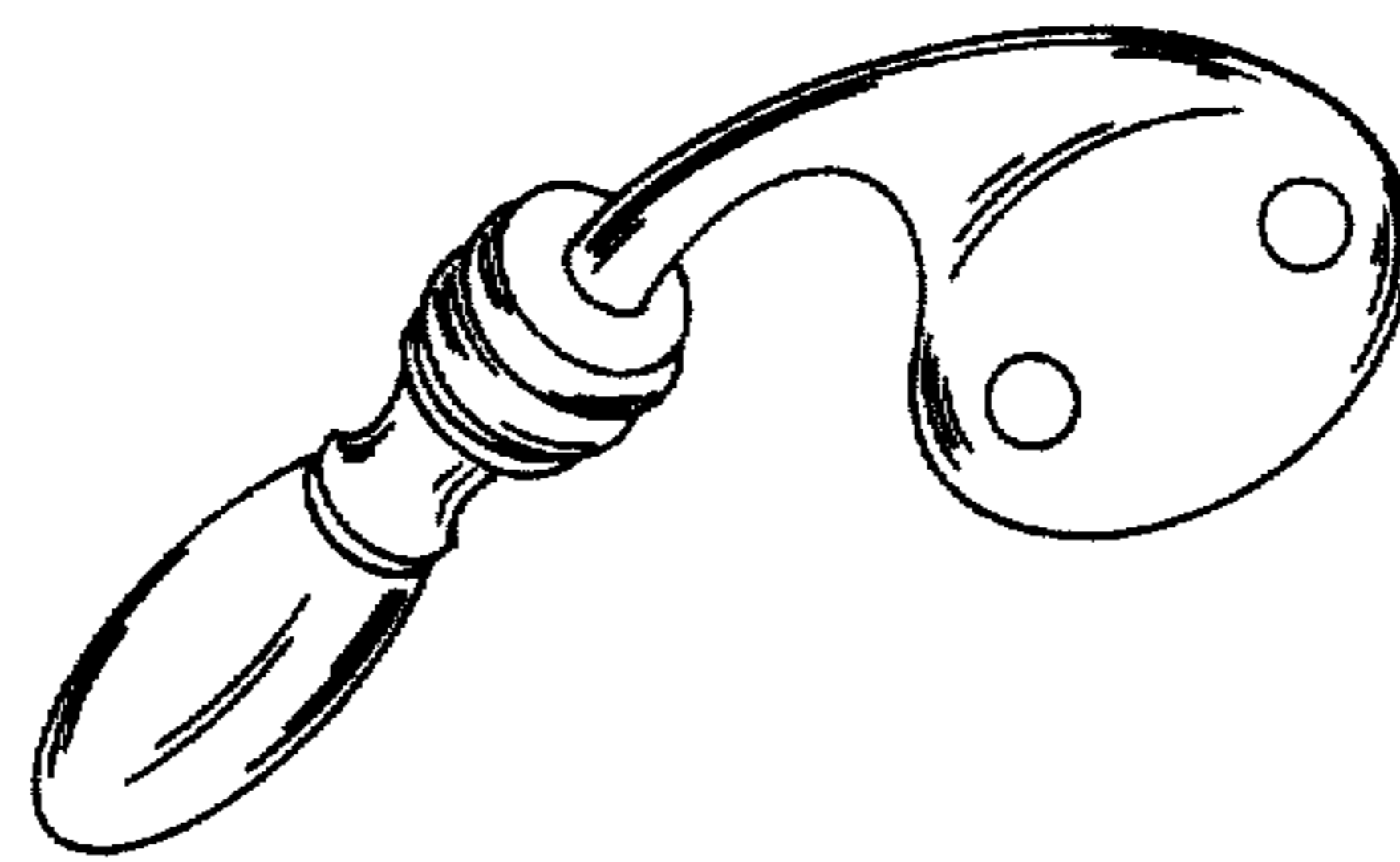
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a modified form of a handle for a toilet seat or the like shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is an elevational view taken from one side of FIG. 6 the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown;

FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 6.

The fragmentary broken line showing of a toilet and toilet seat and toilet seat cover in FIG. 1 and FIG. 6 is for purposes of illustration only.



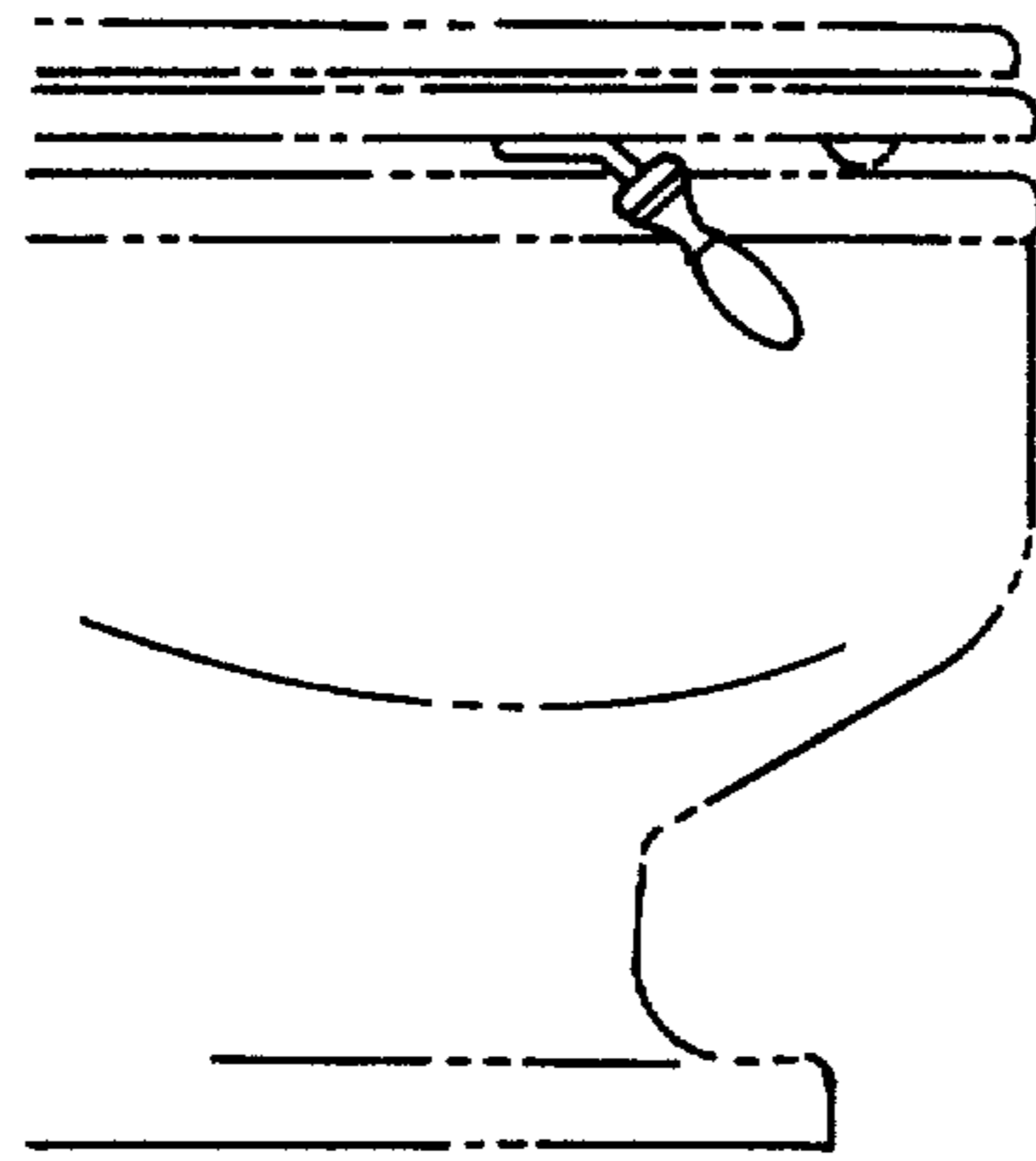

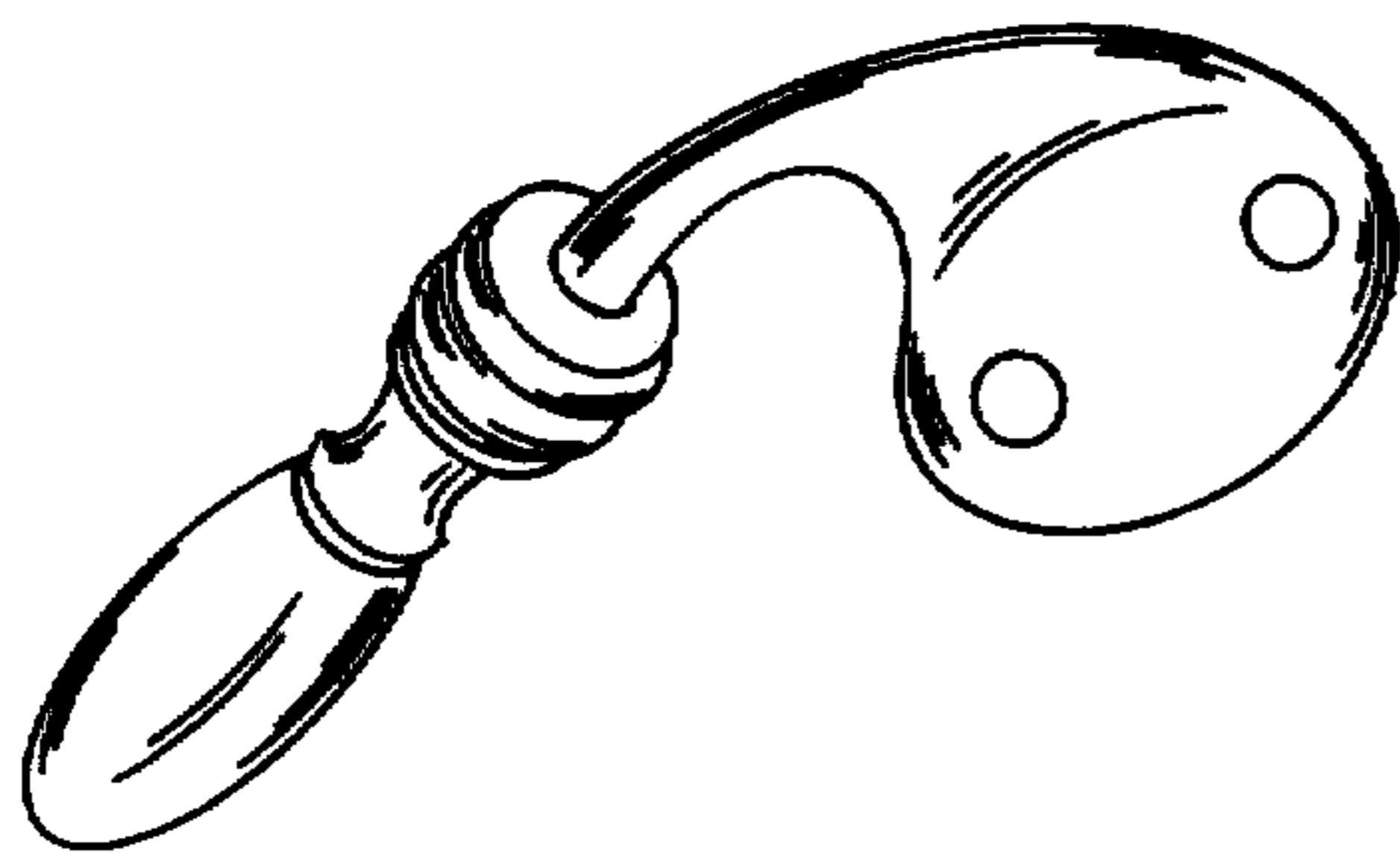

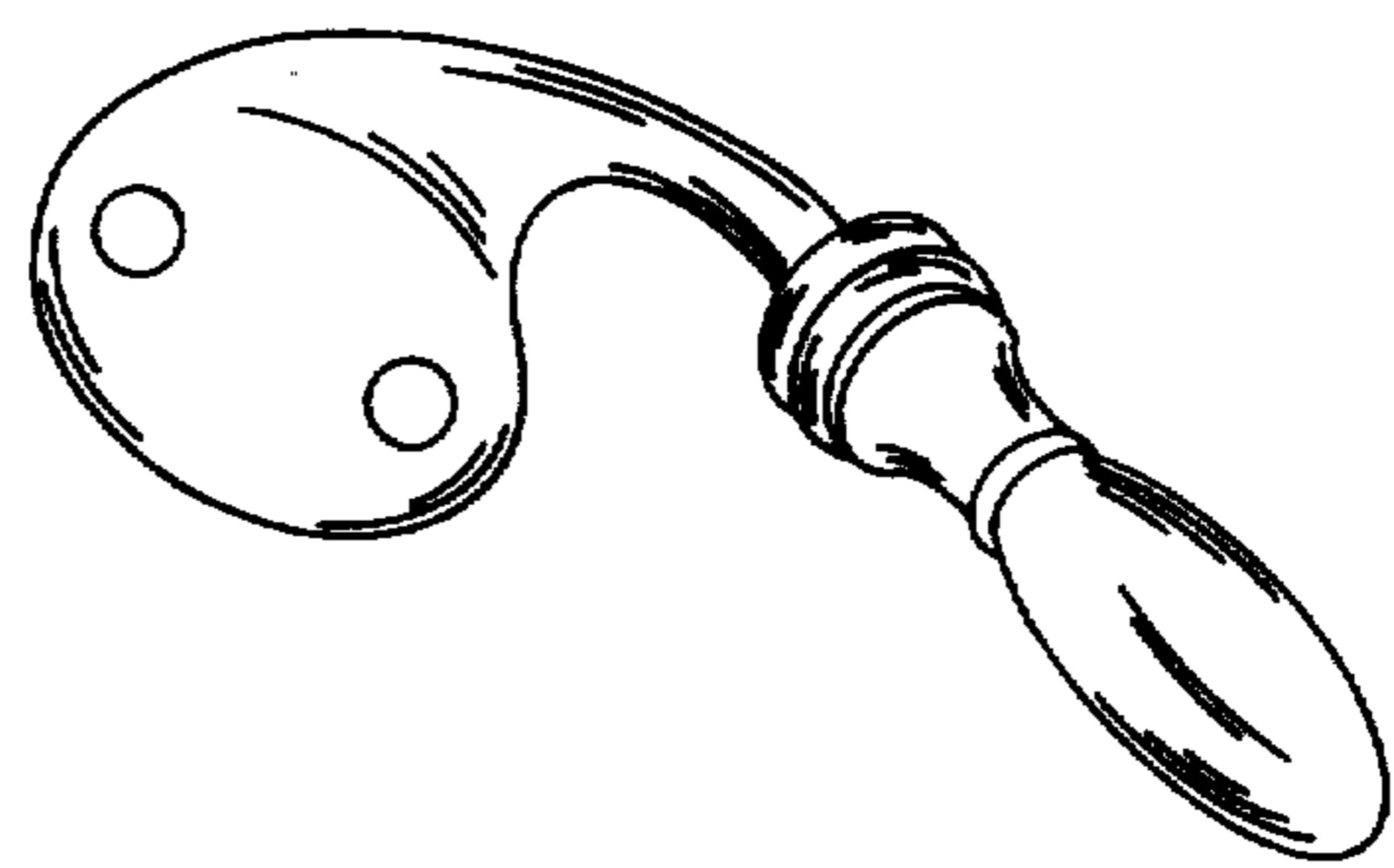

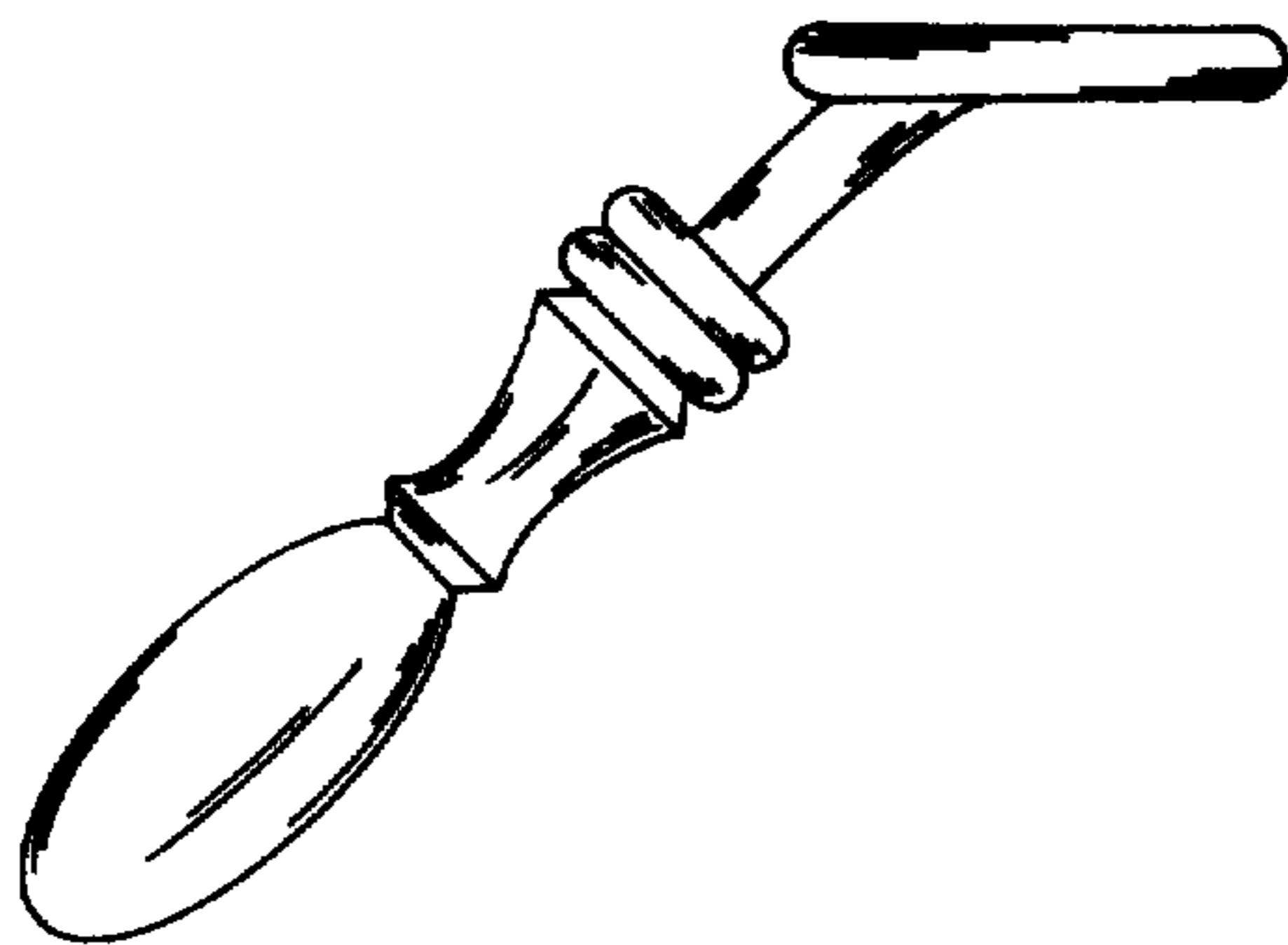

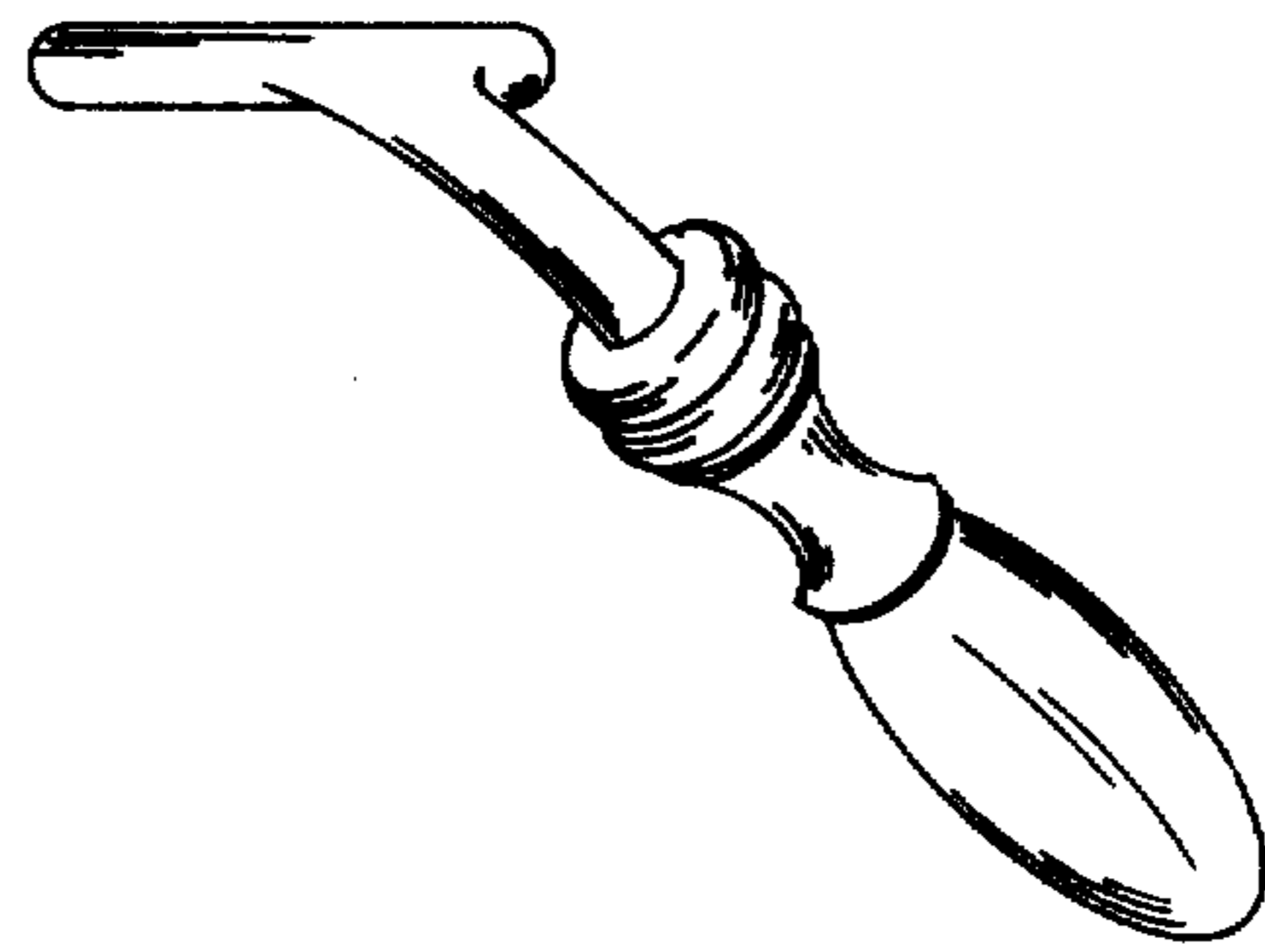

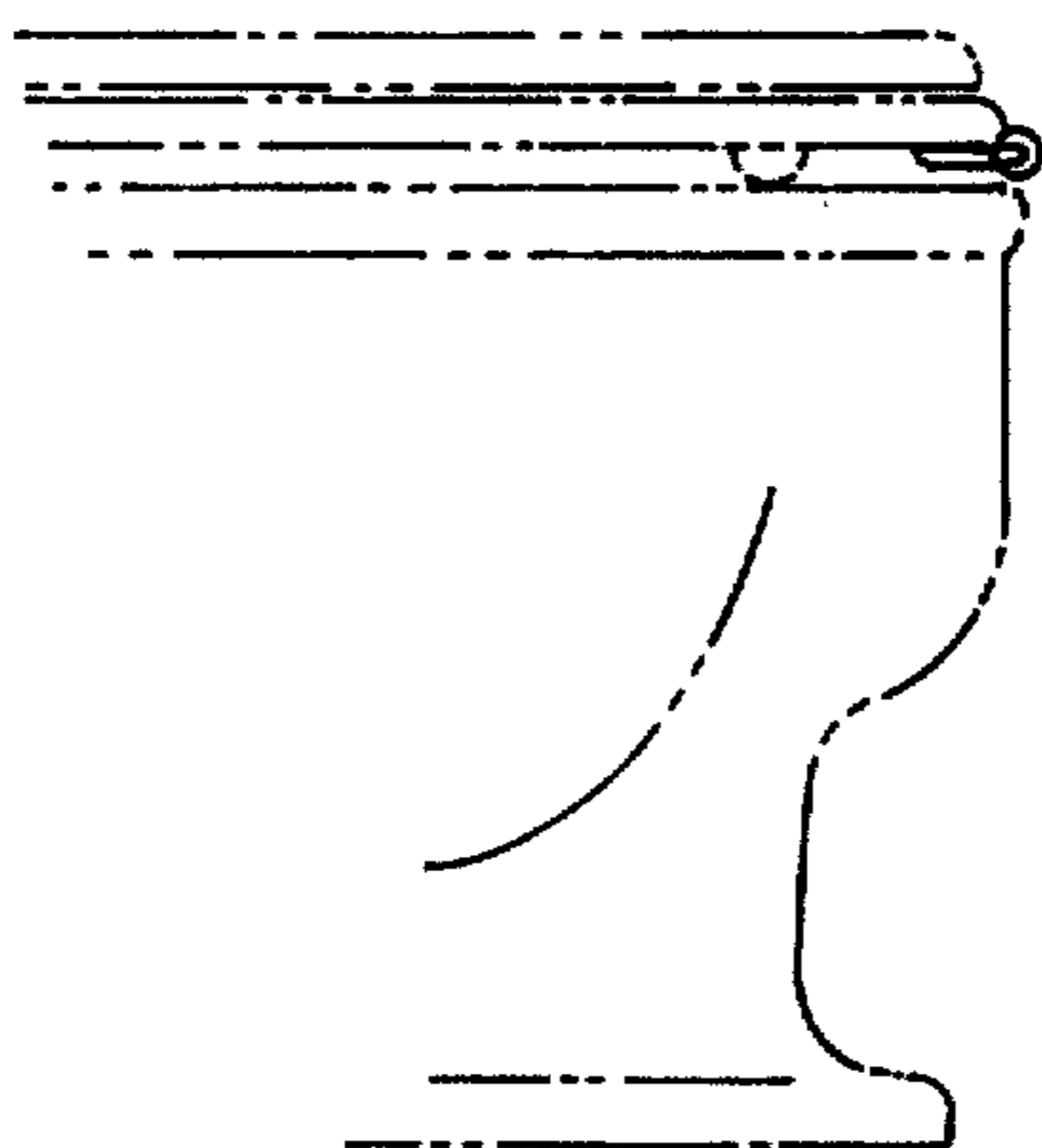

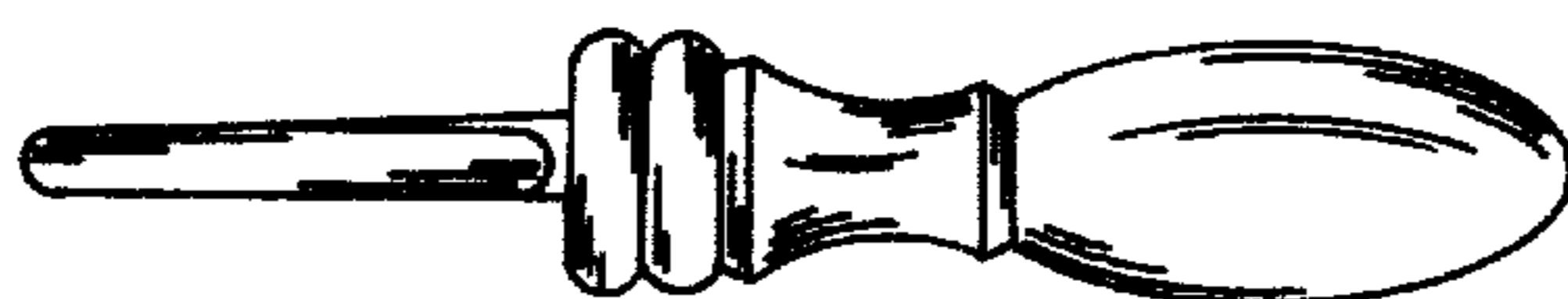

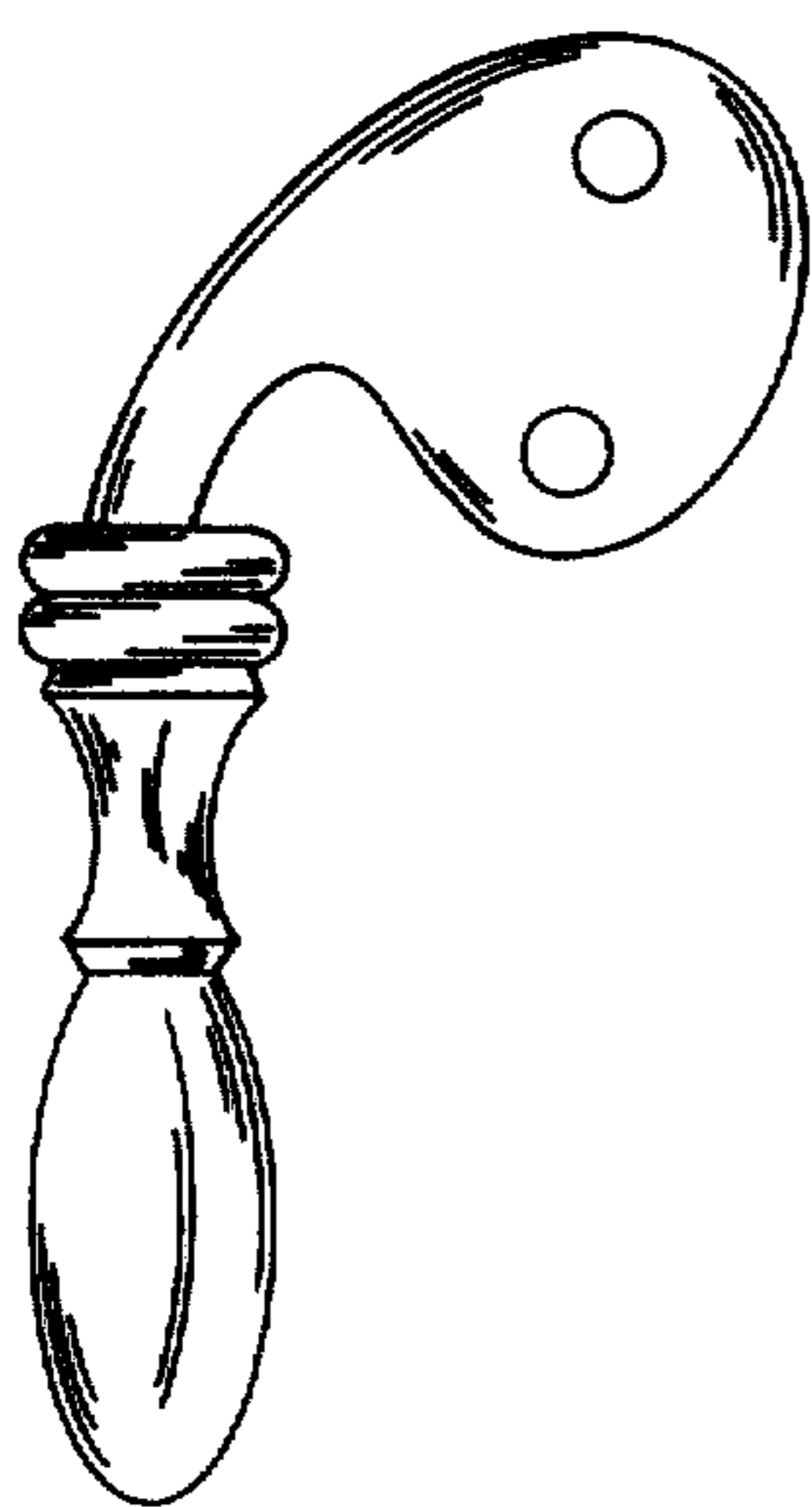

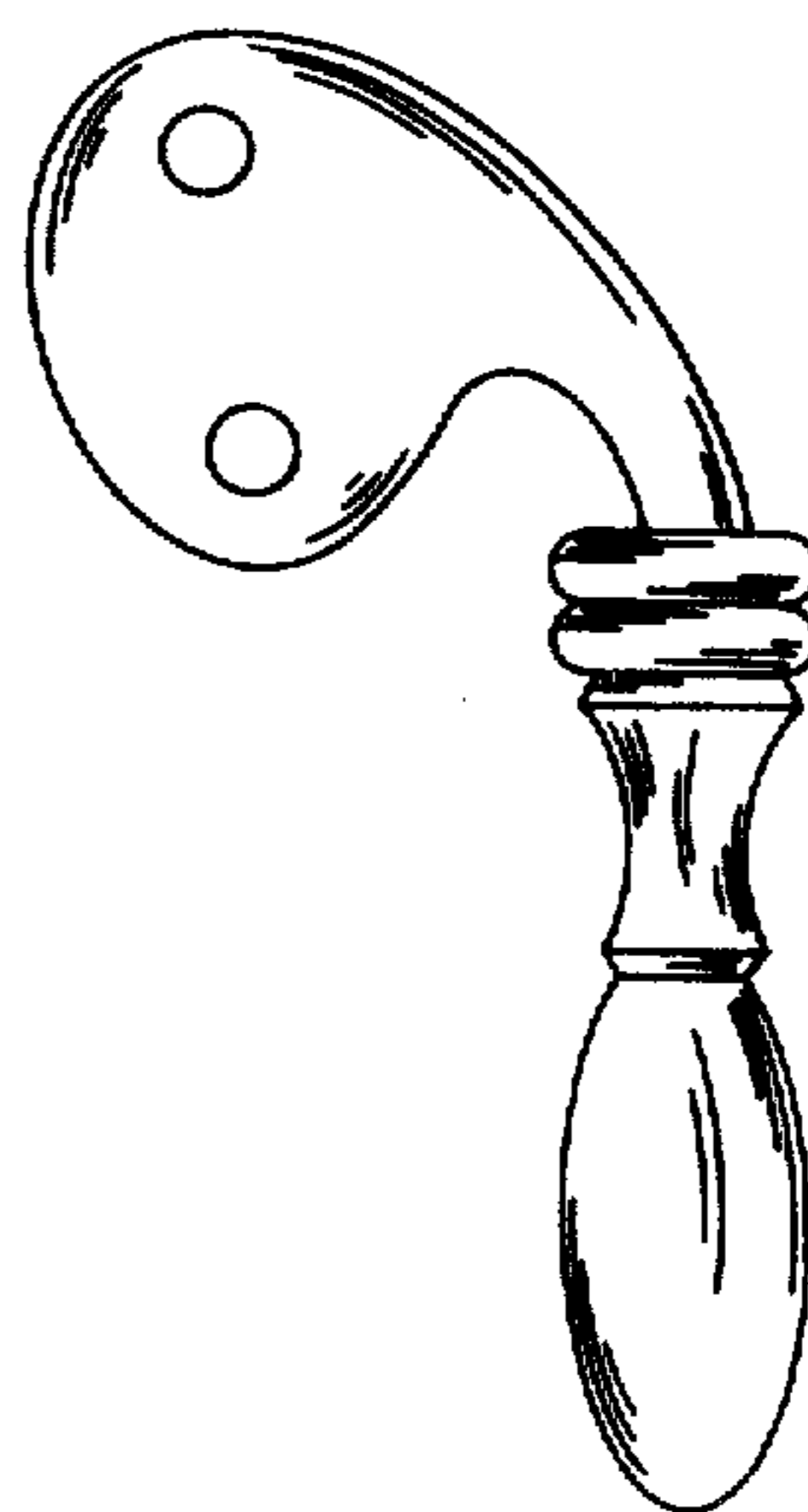
