[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a surgical stapler, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of a surgical stapler being dispensed during use from the left end of the device;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the device;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the device;
FIG. 4 is an end view of the device looking from the left of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is an end view of the device looking from the right of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a perspective view as seen from the front and top of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 7 is a perspective view as seen from the rear and bottom of FIG. 1.

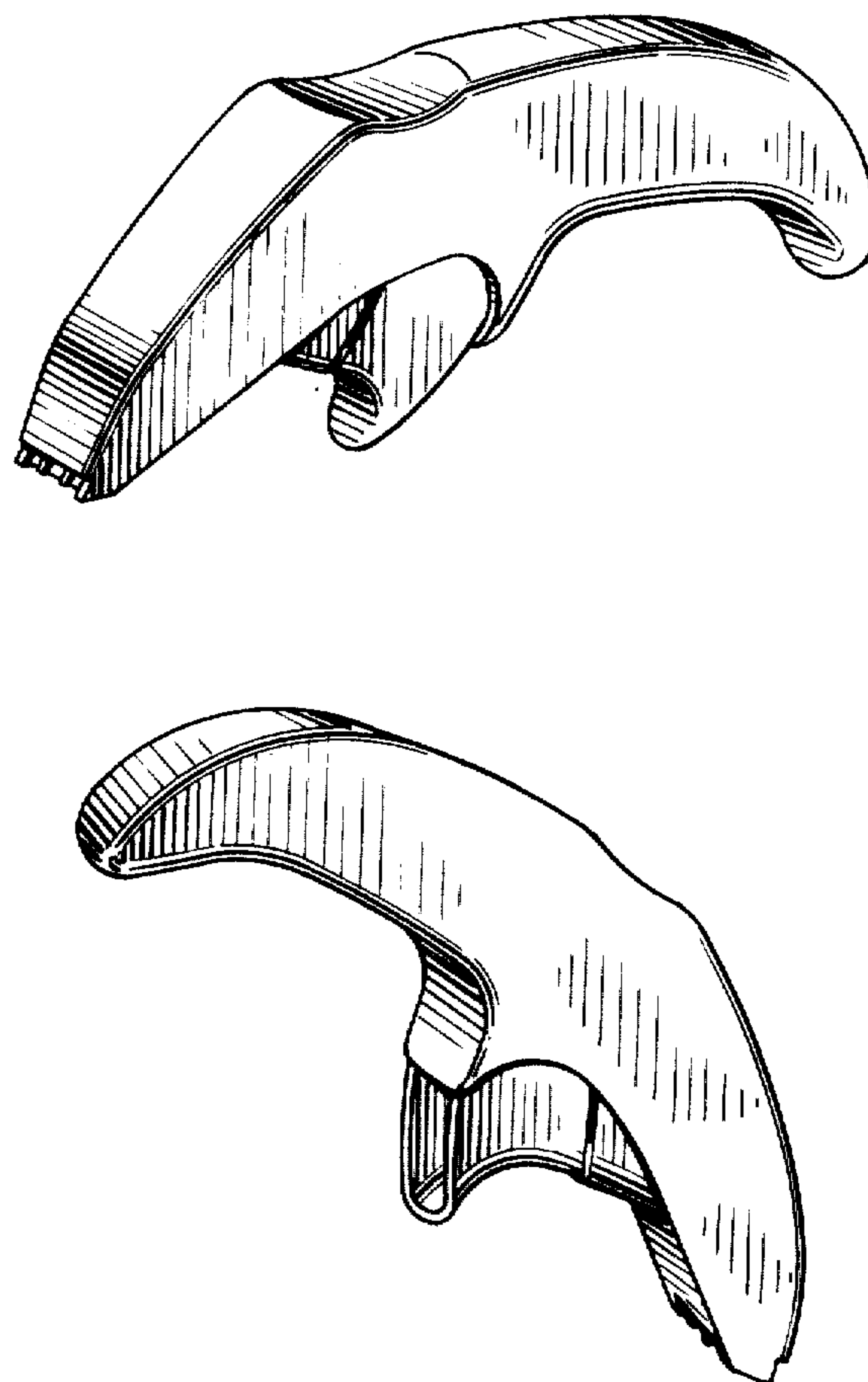

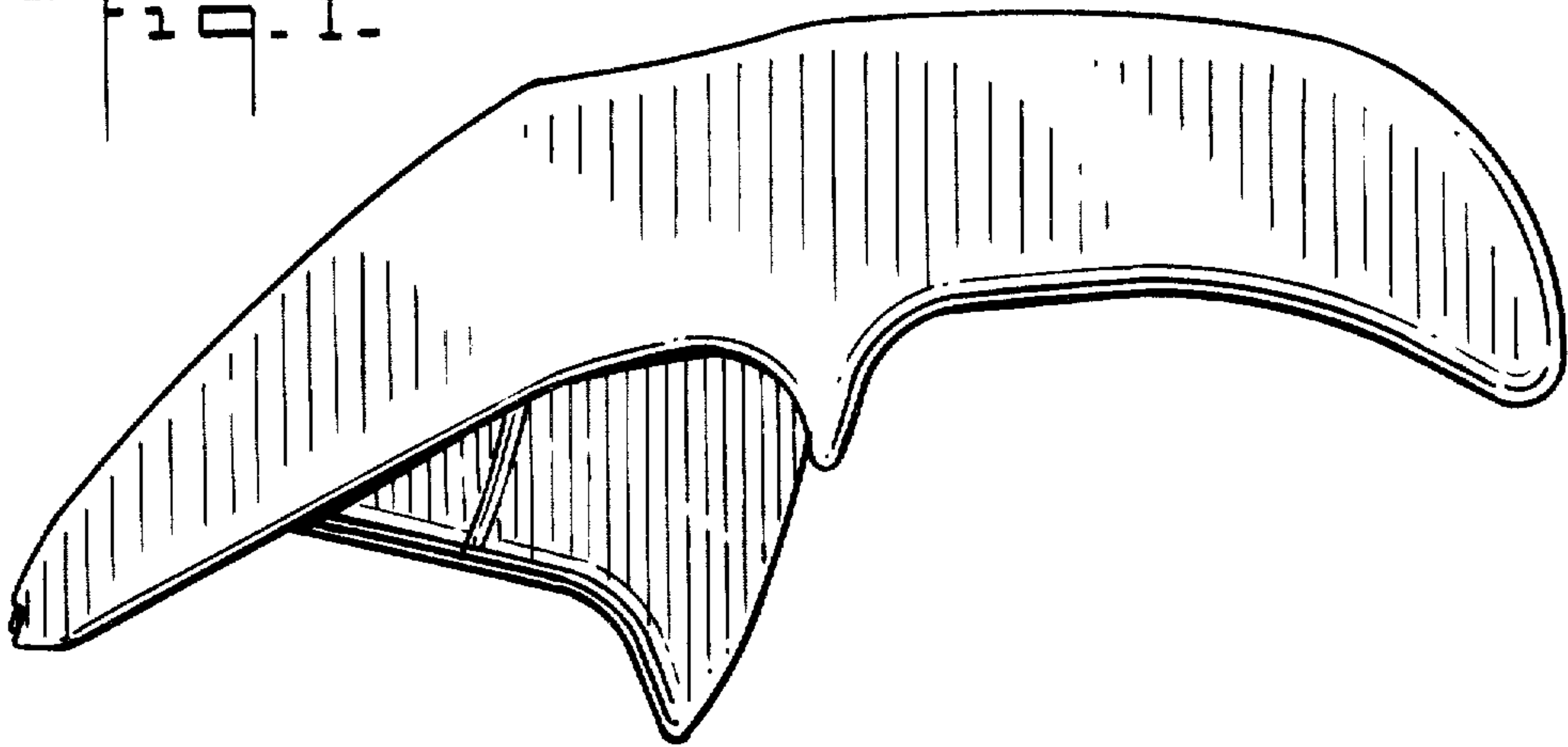

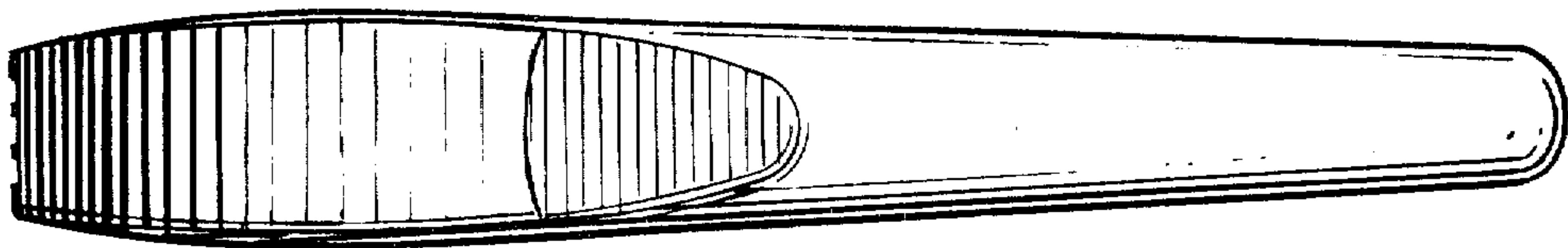

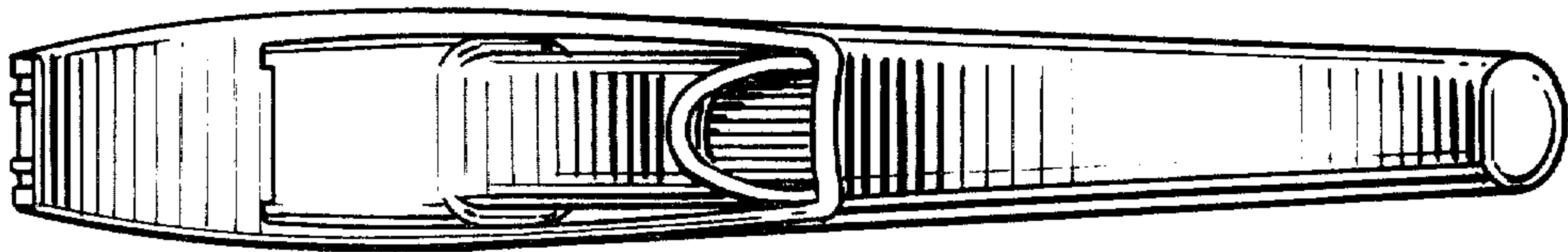

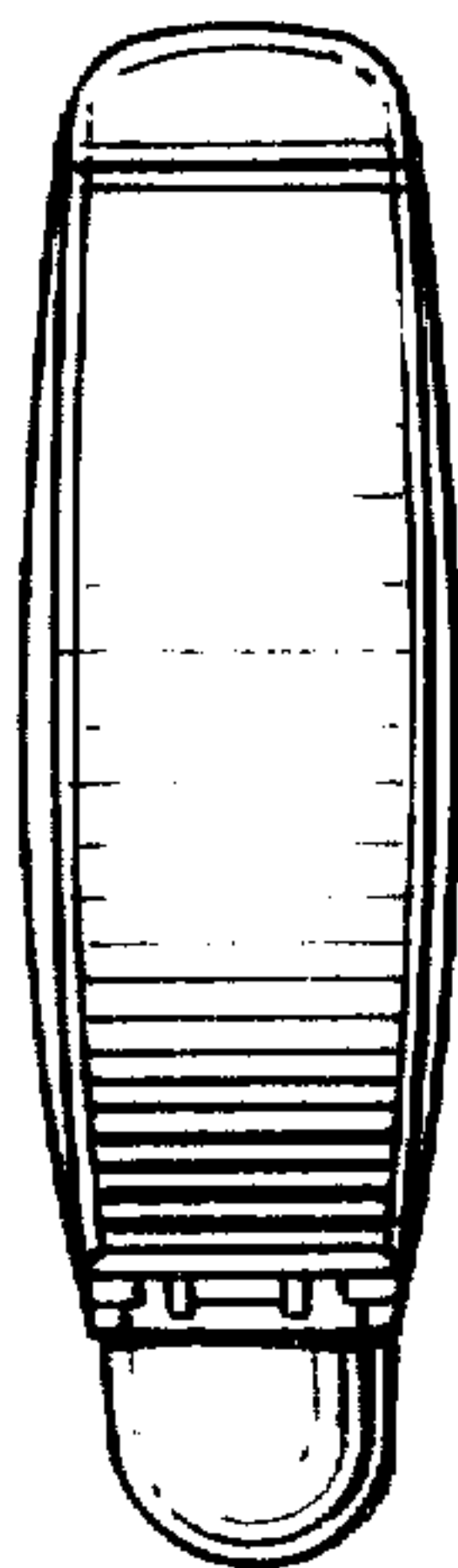
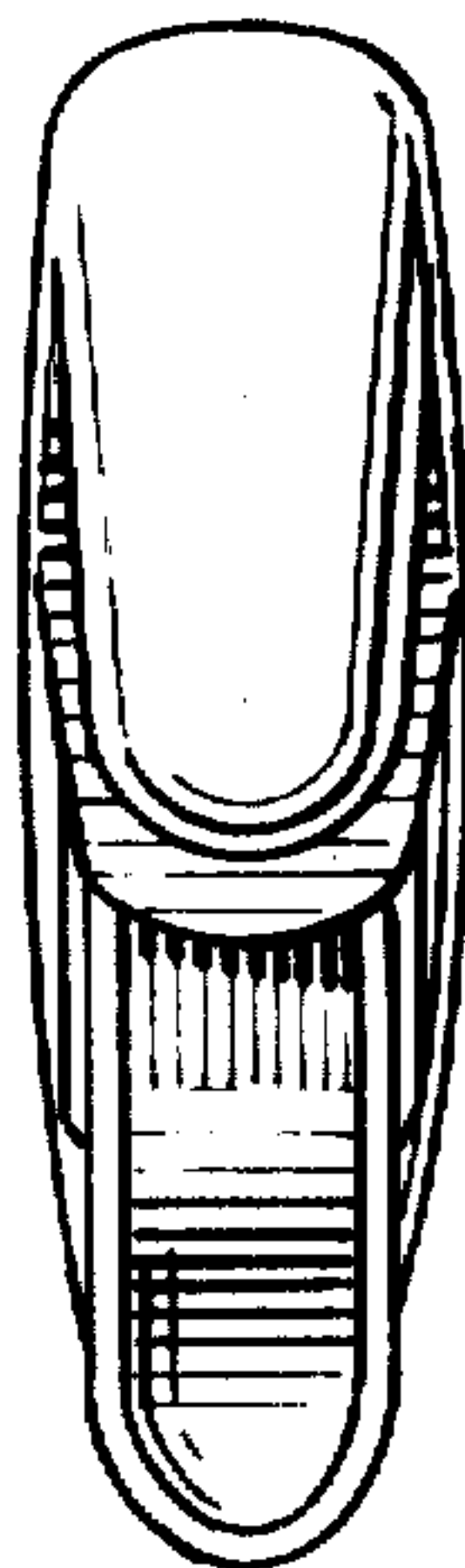

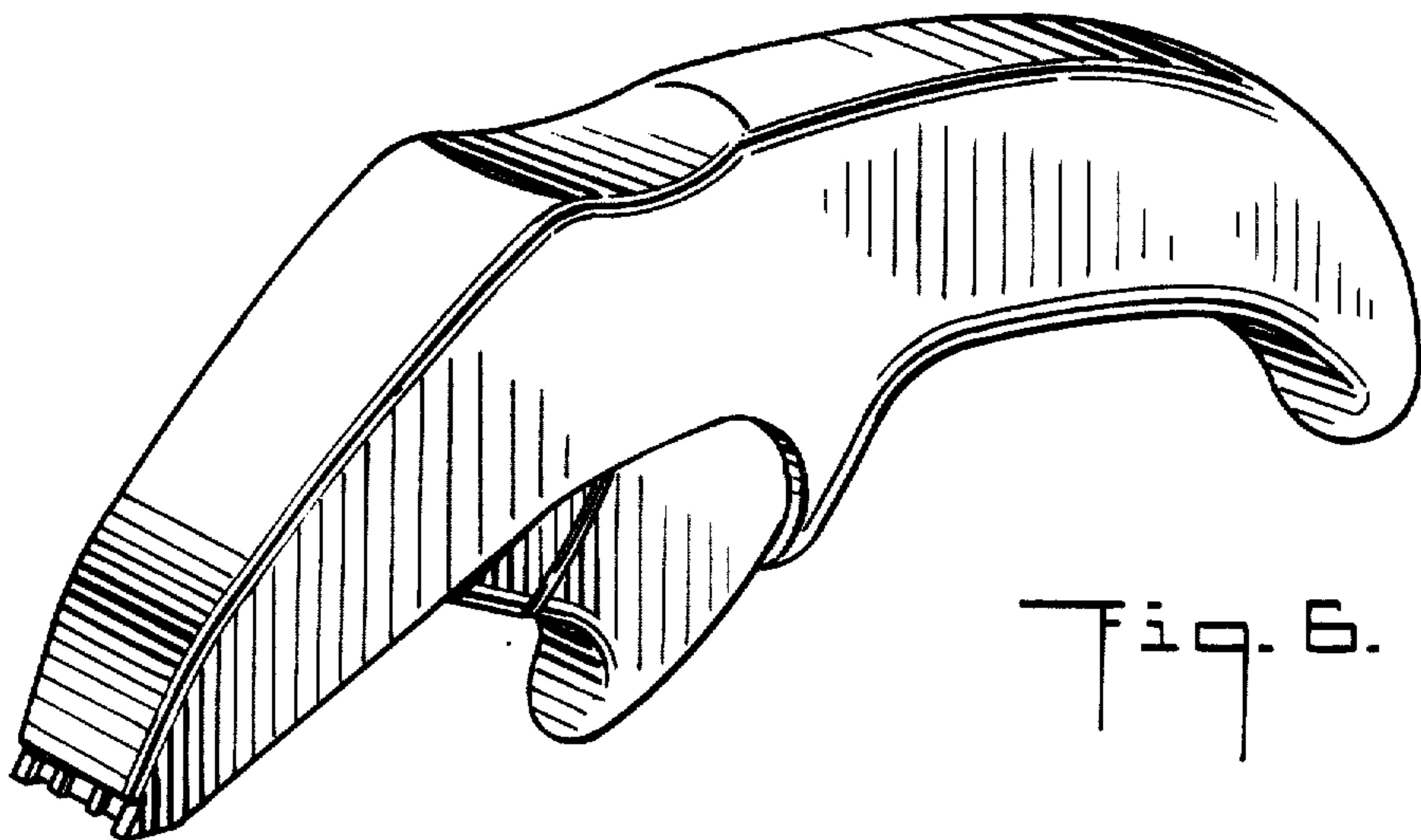

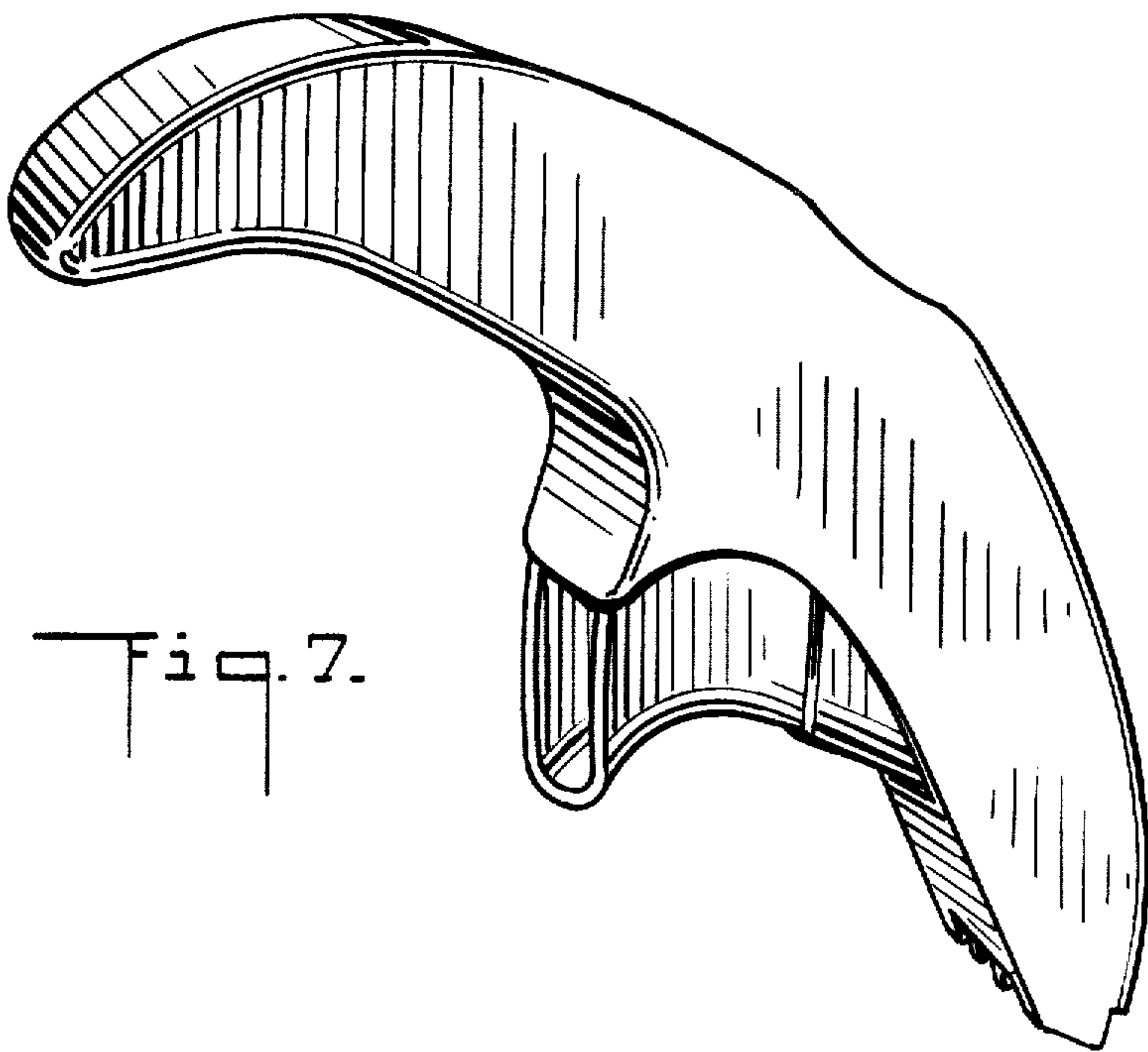
