FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of luggage showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof.

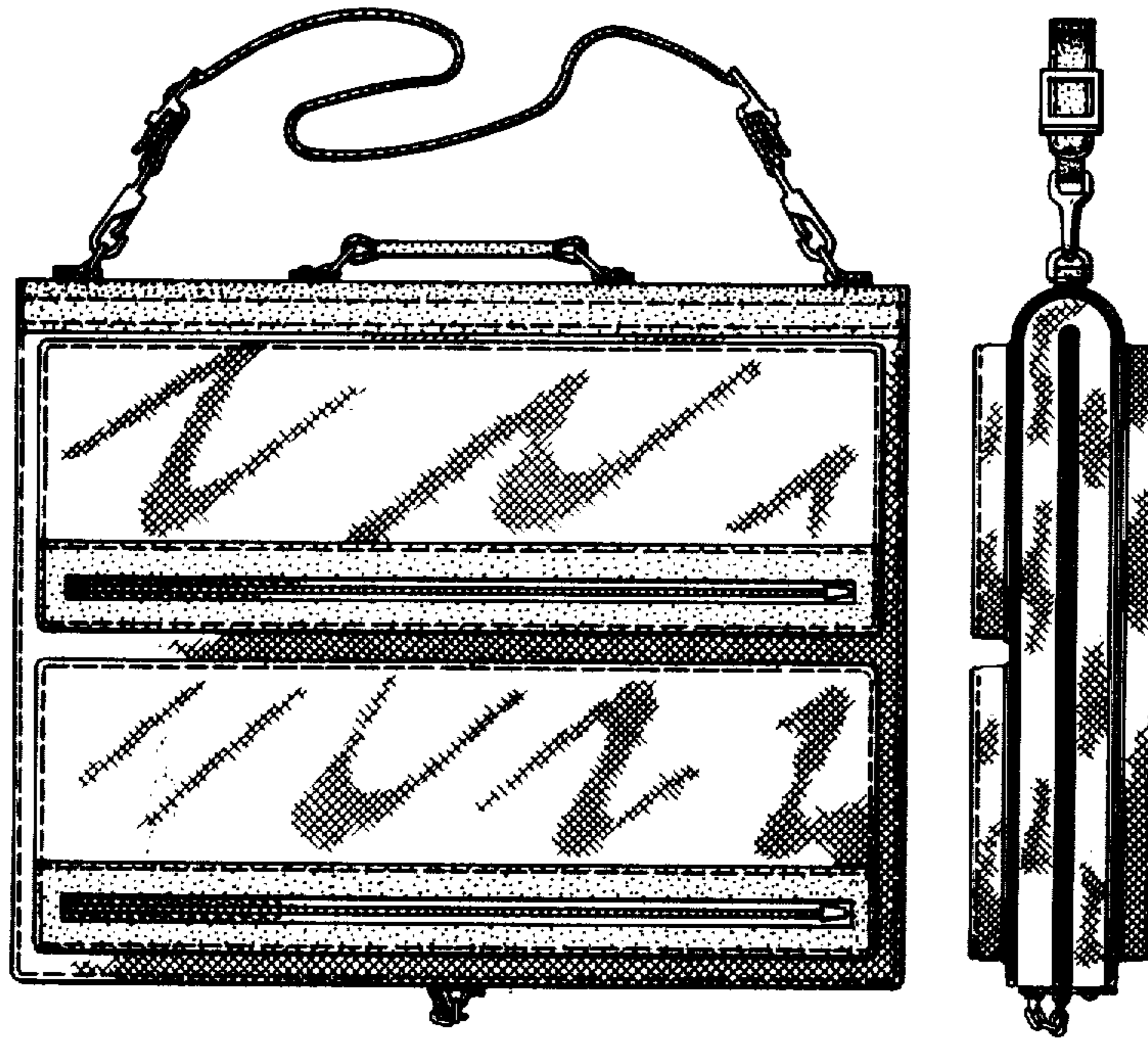
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof.



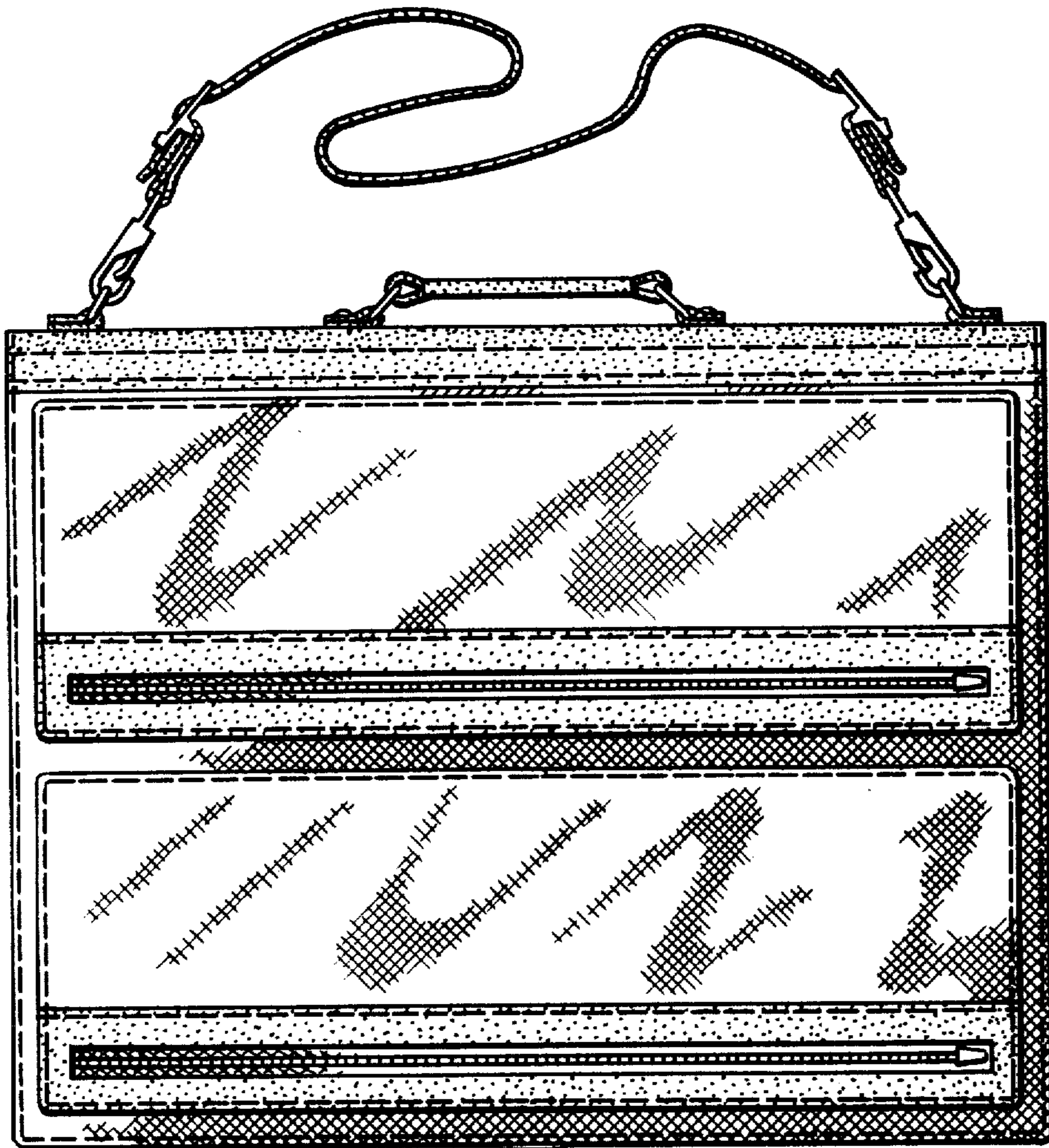

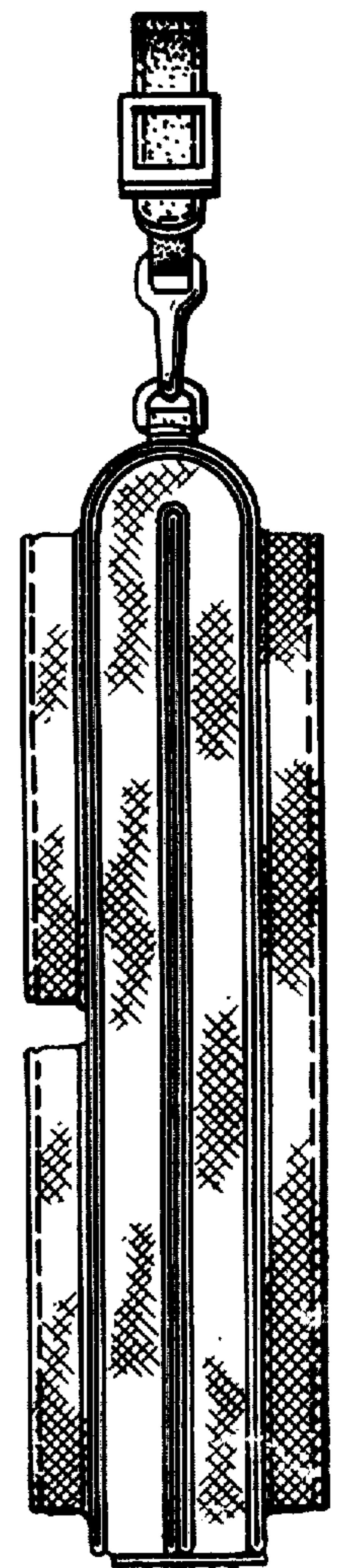

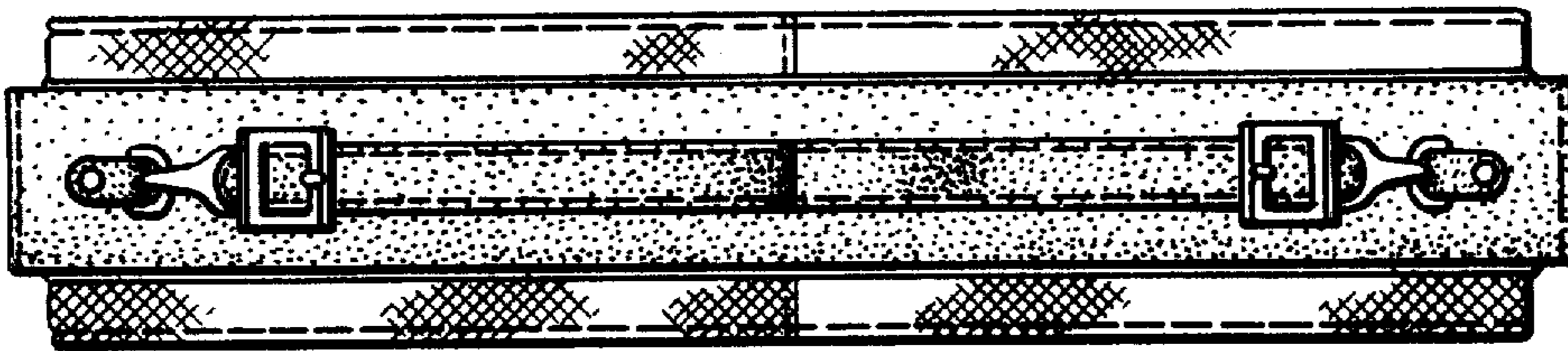

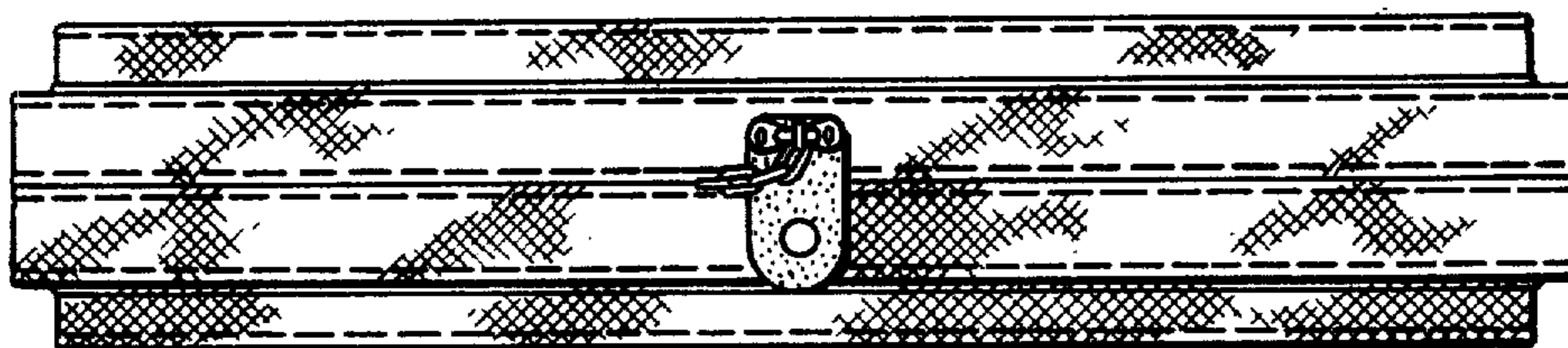
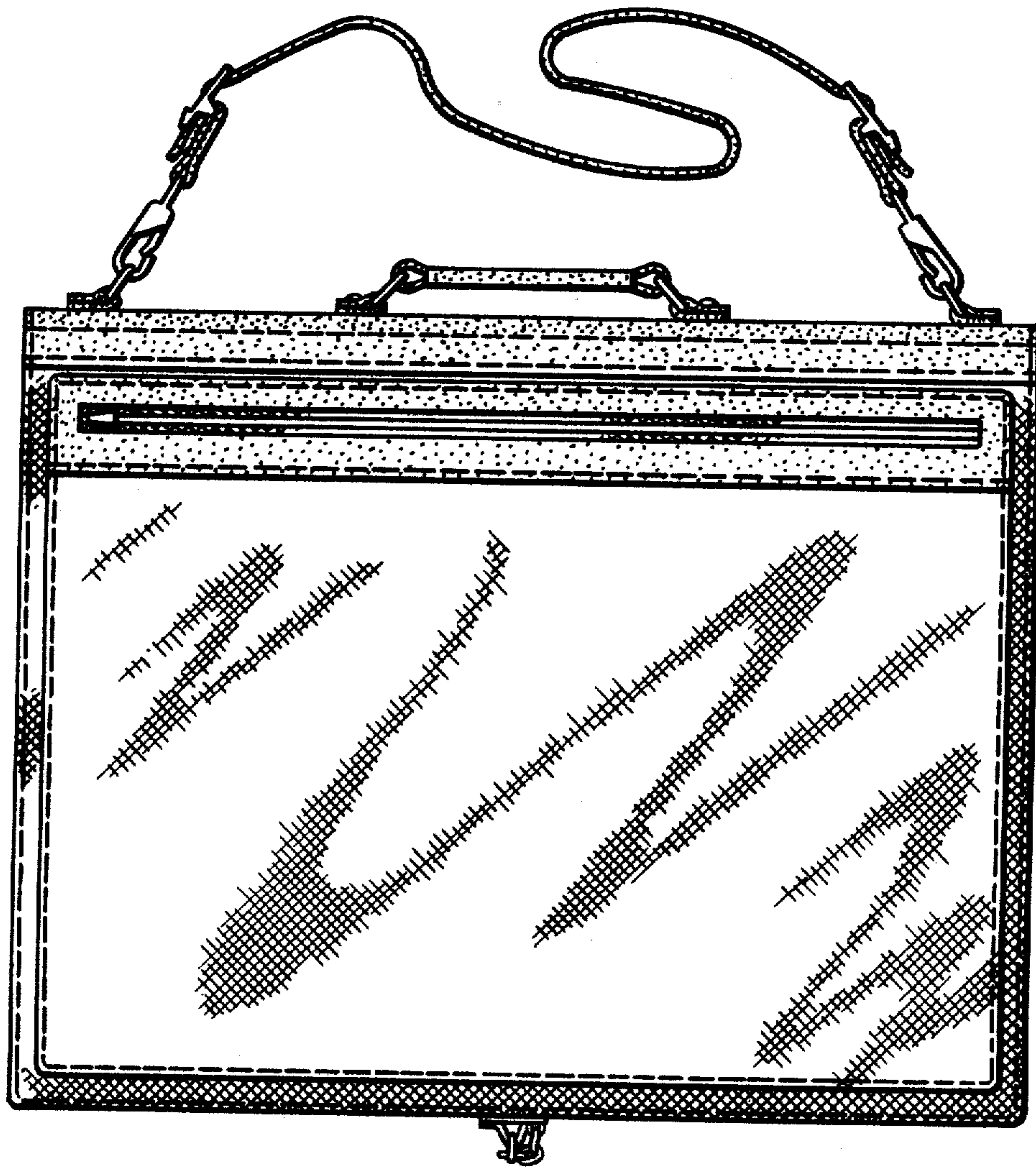
