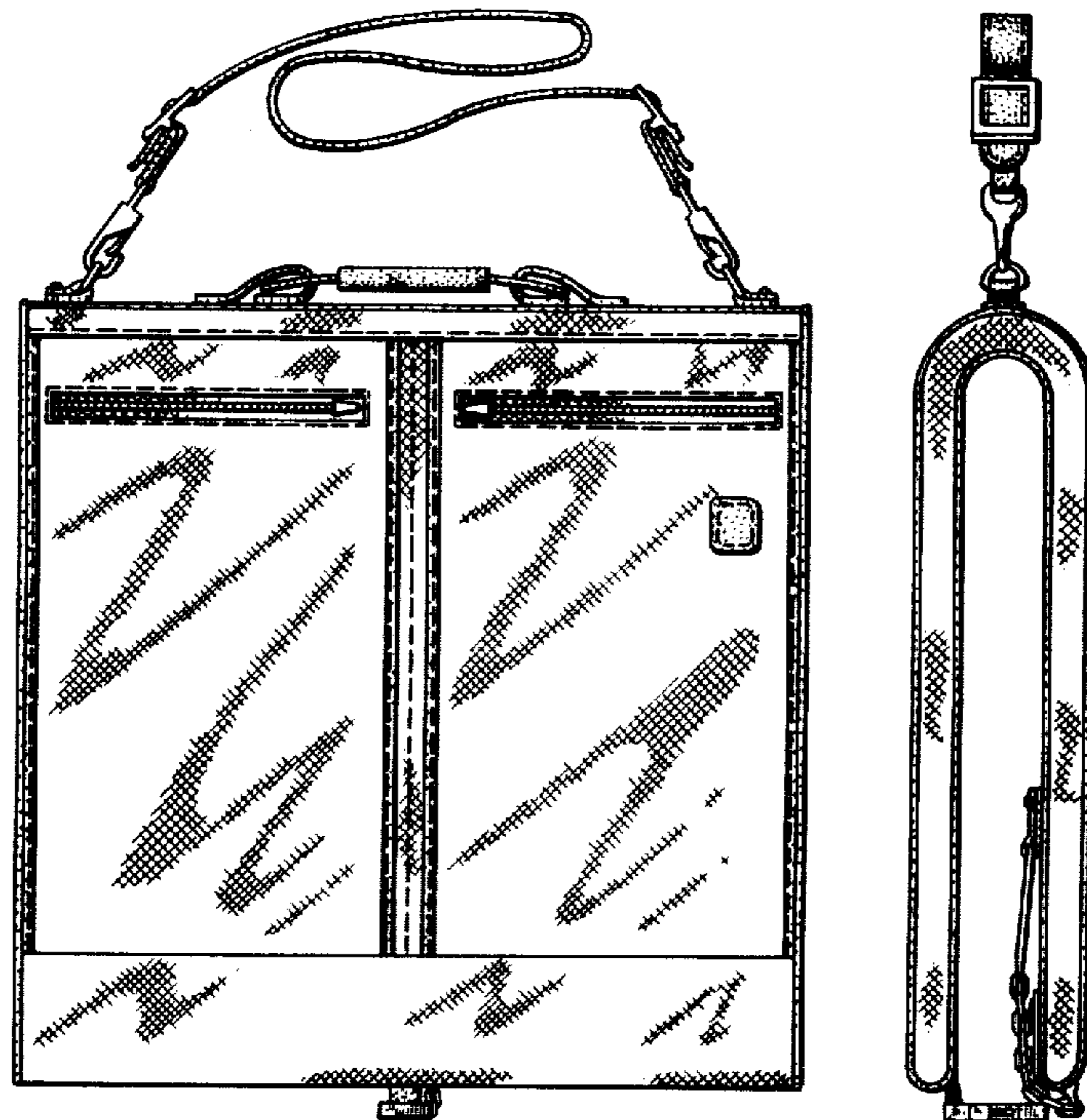

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of luggage showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a reduced scale plan view of the exterior in the unfolded condition; and
FIG. 7 is a reduced scale plan view of the interior in the unfolded condition.



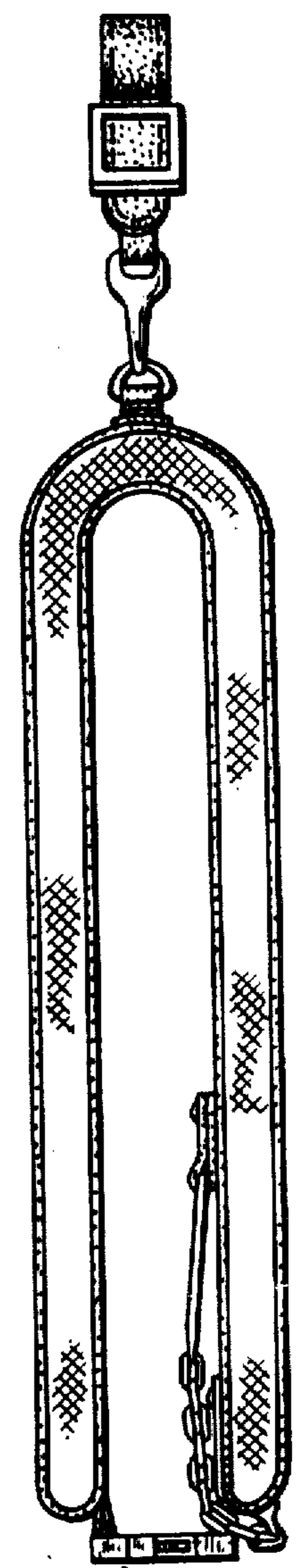
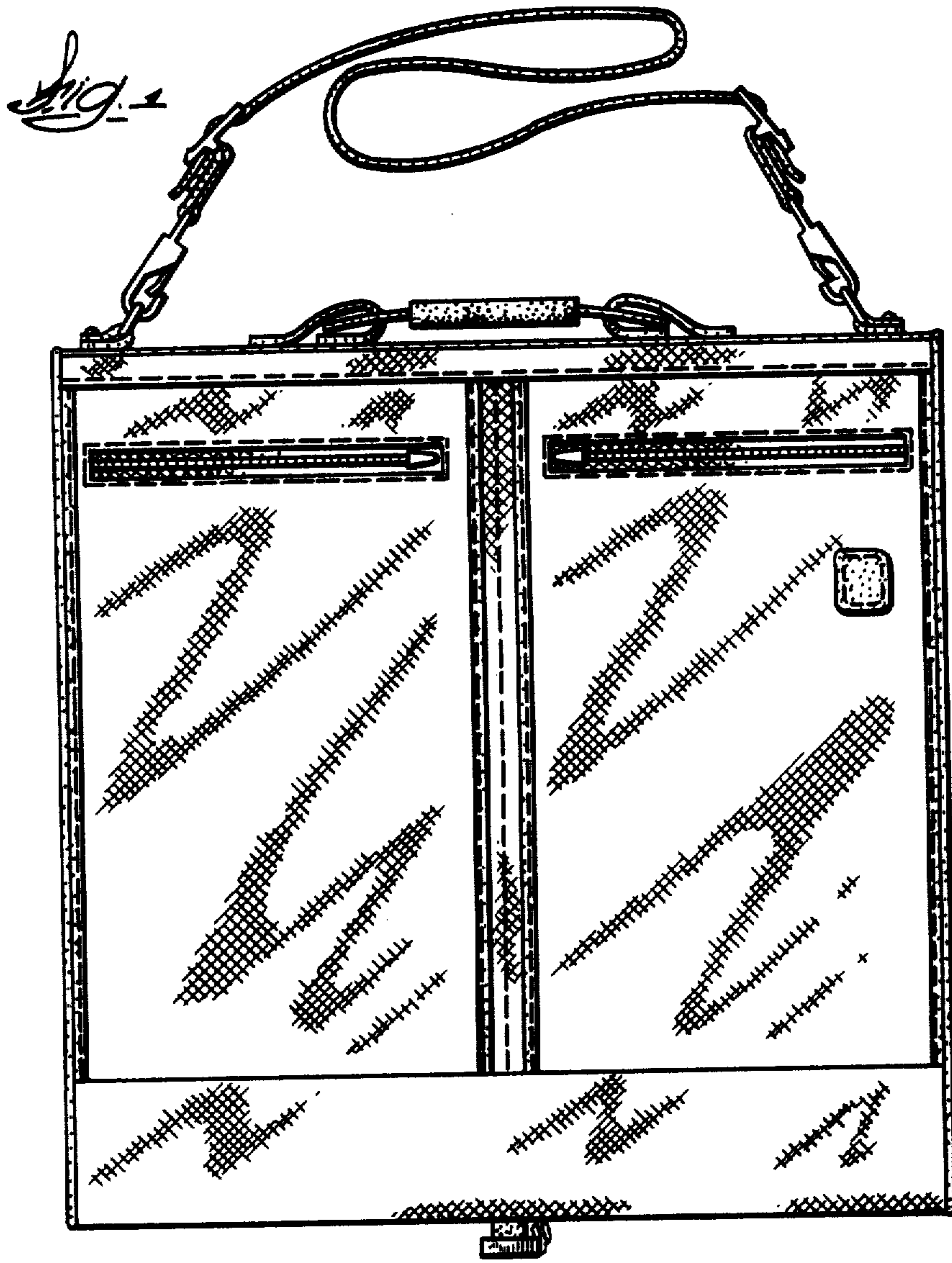

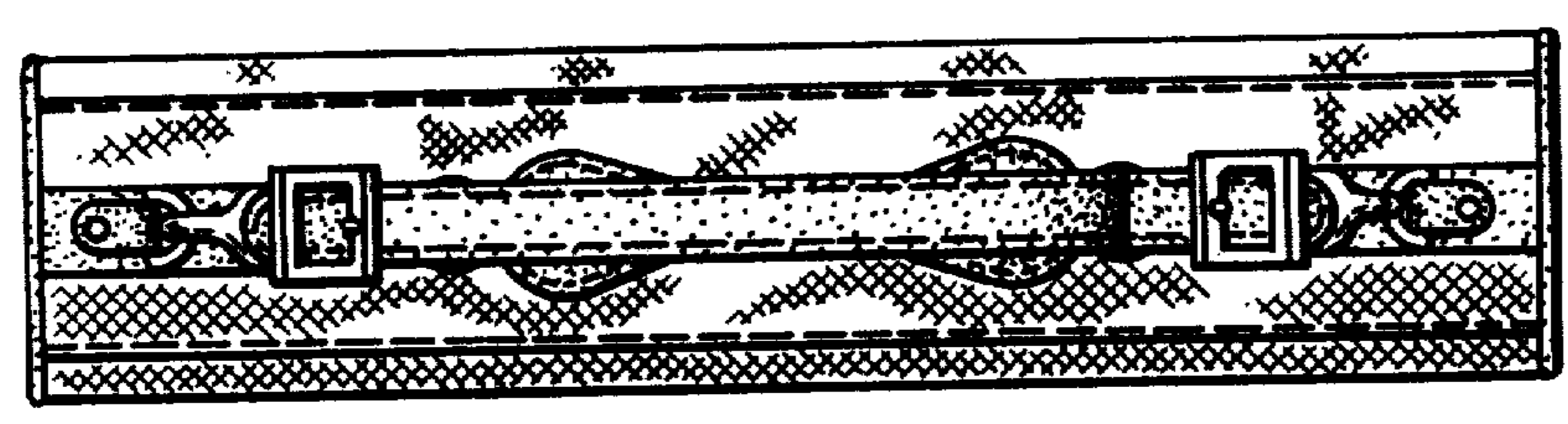

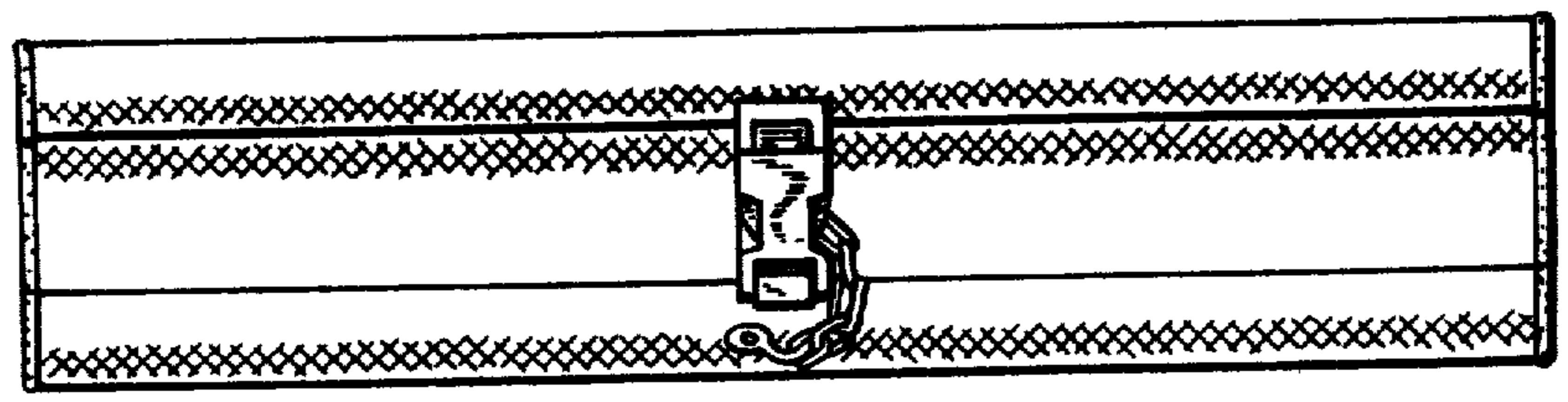

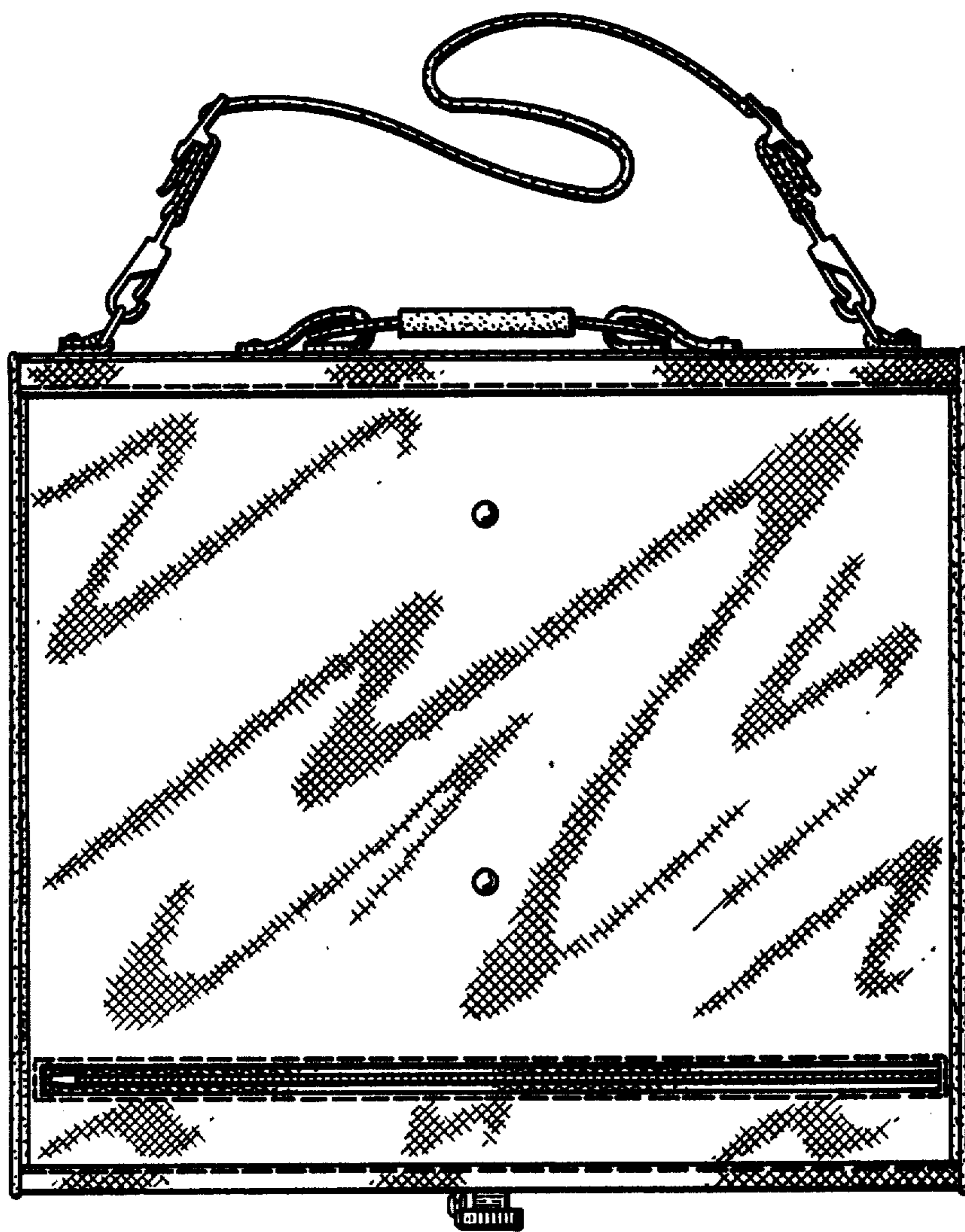

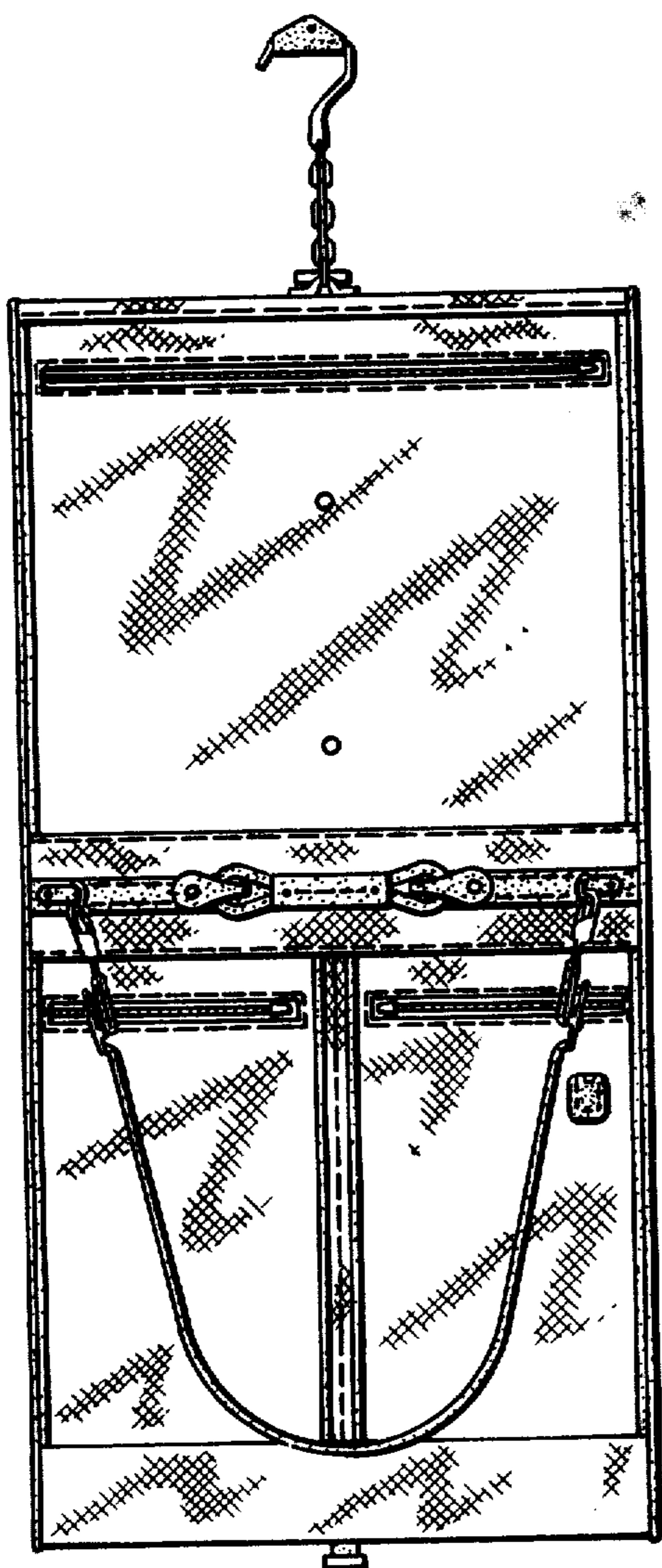

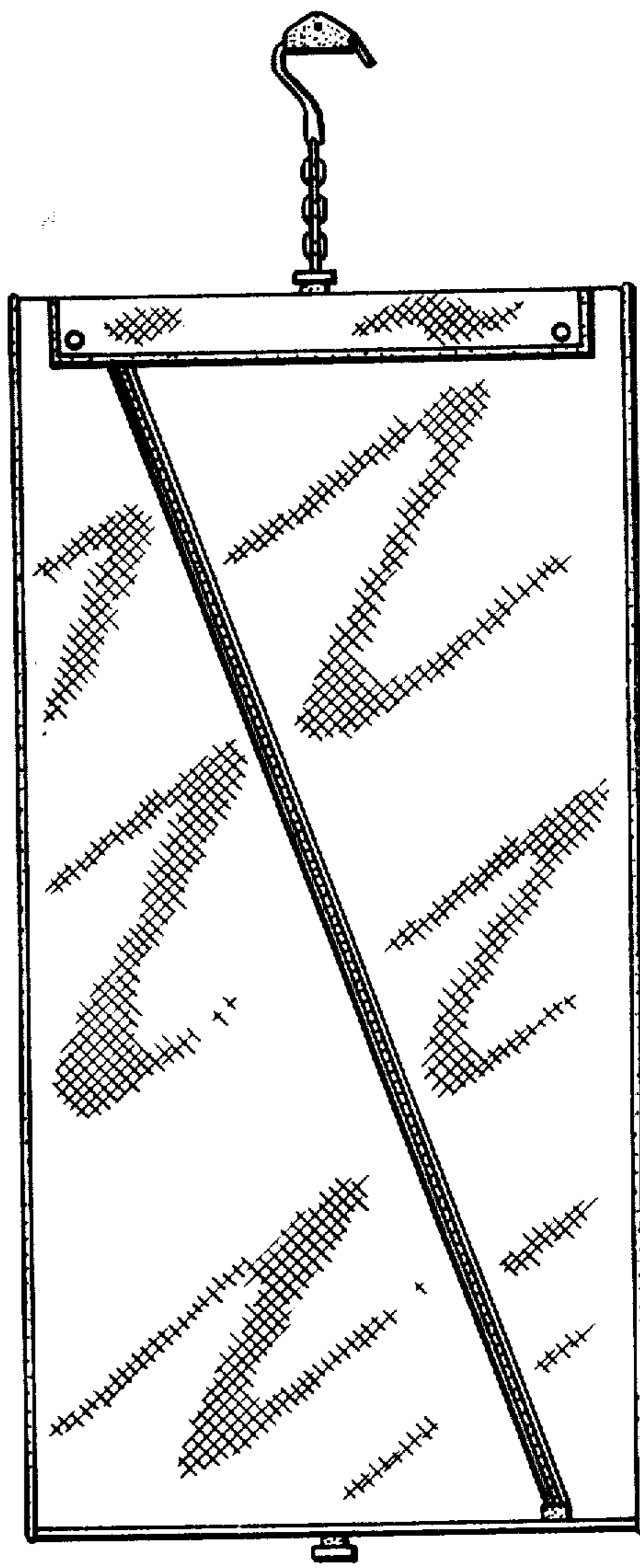
