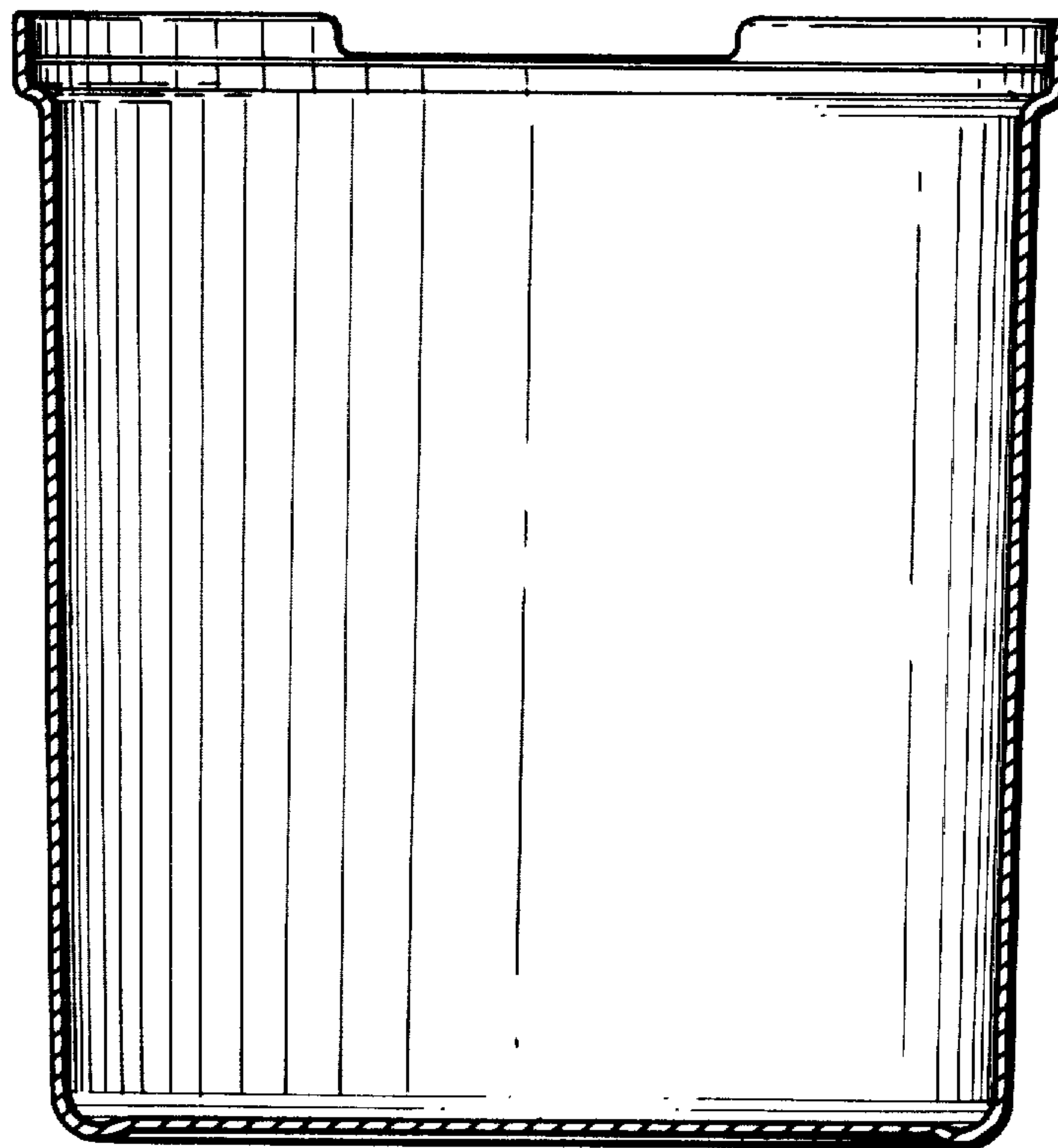

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a canister showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view thereof through the vertical axis;
FIG. 5 is a top perspective view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom perspective view thereof.



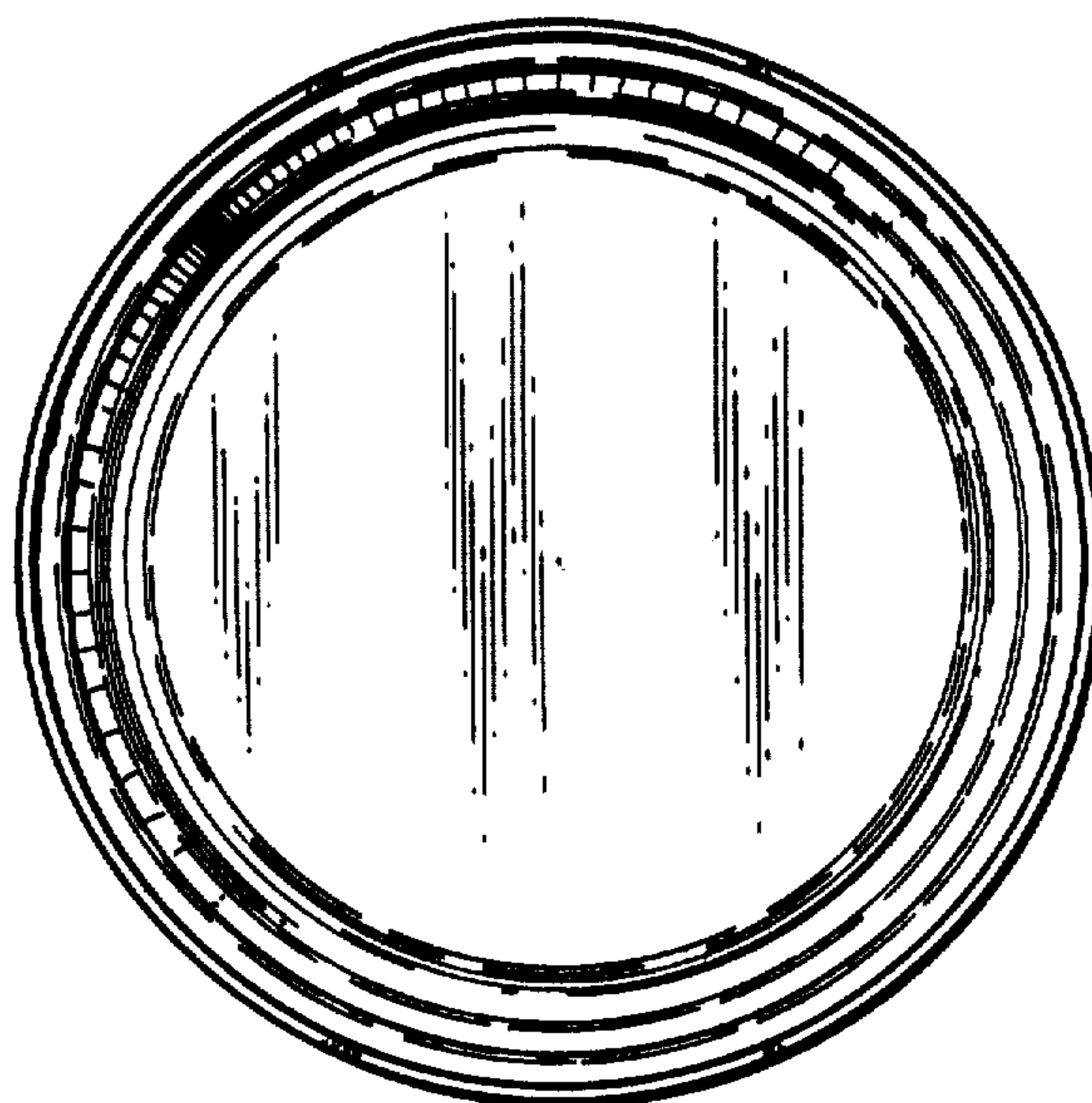

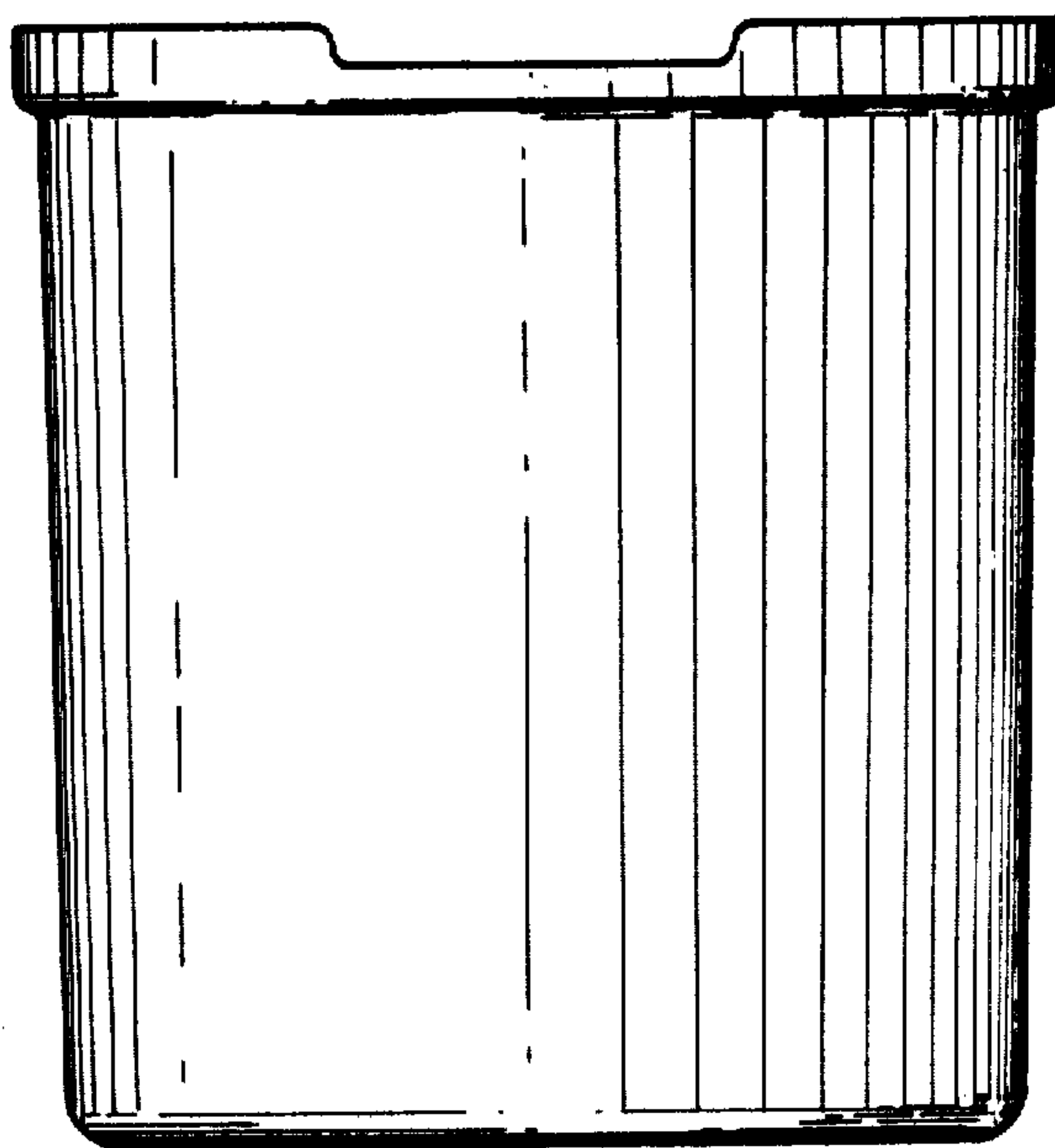

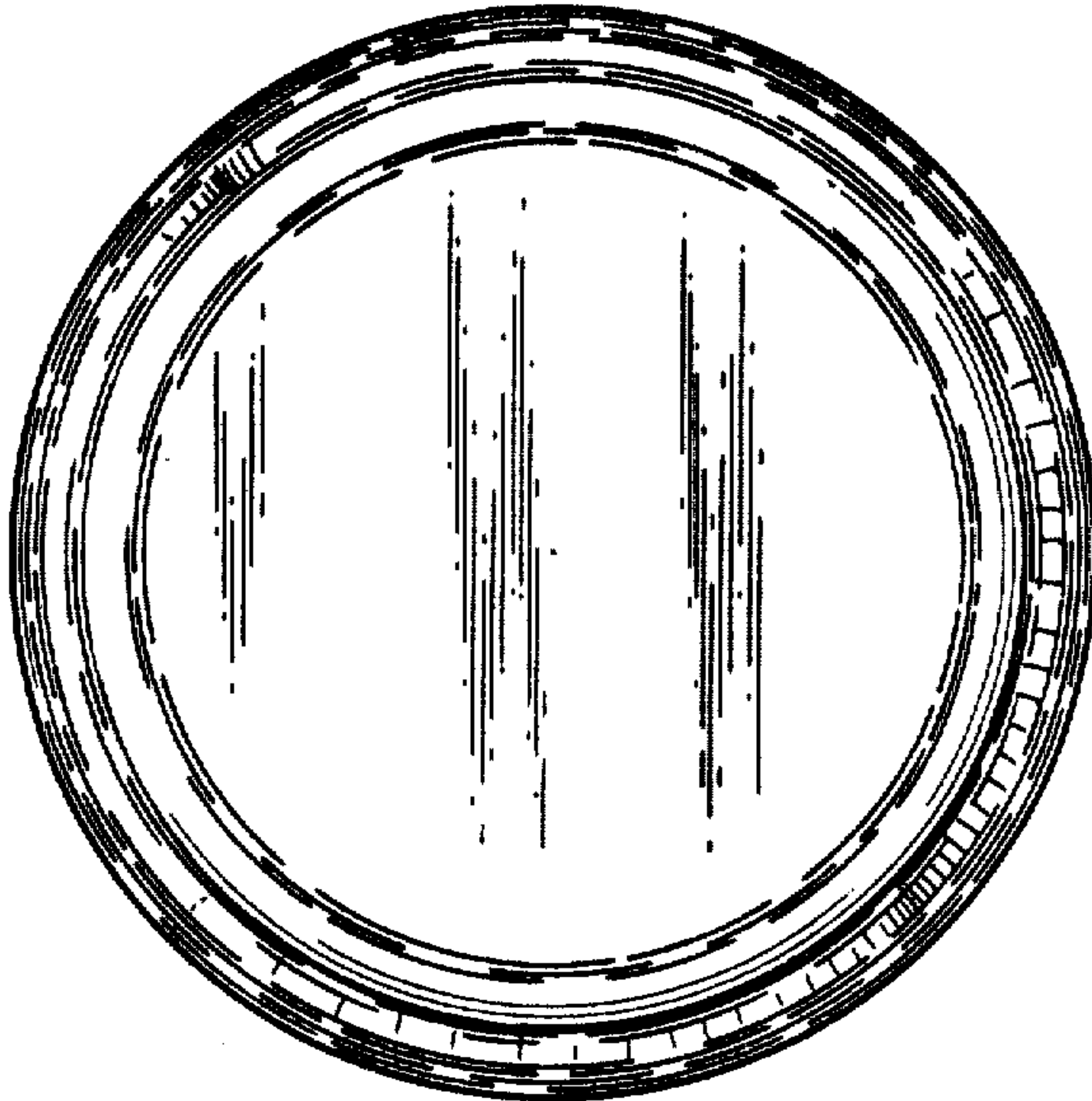

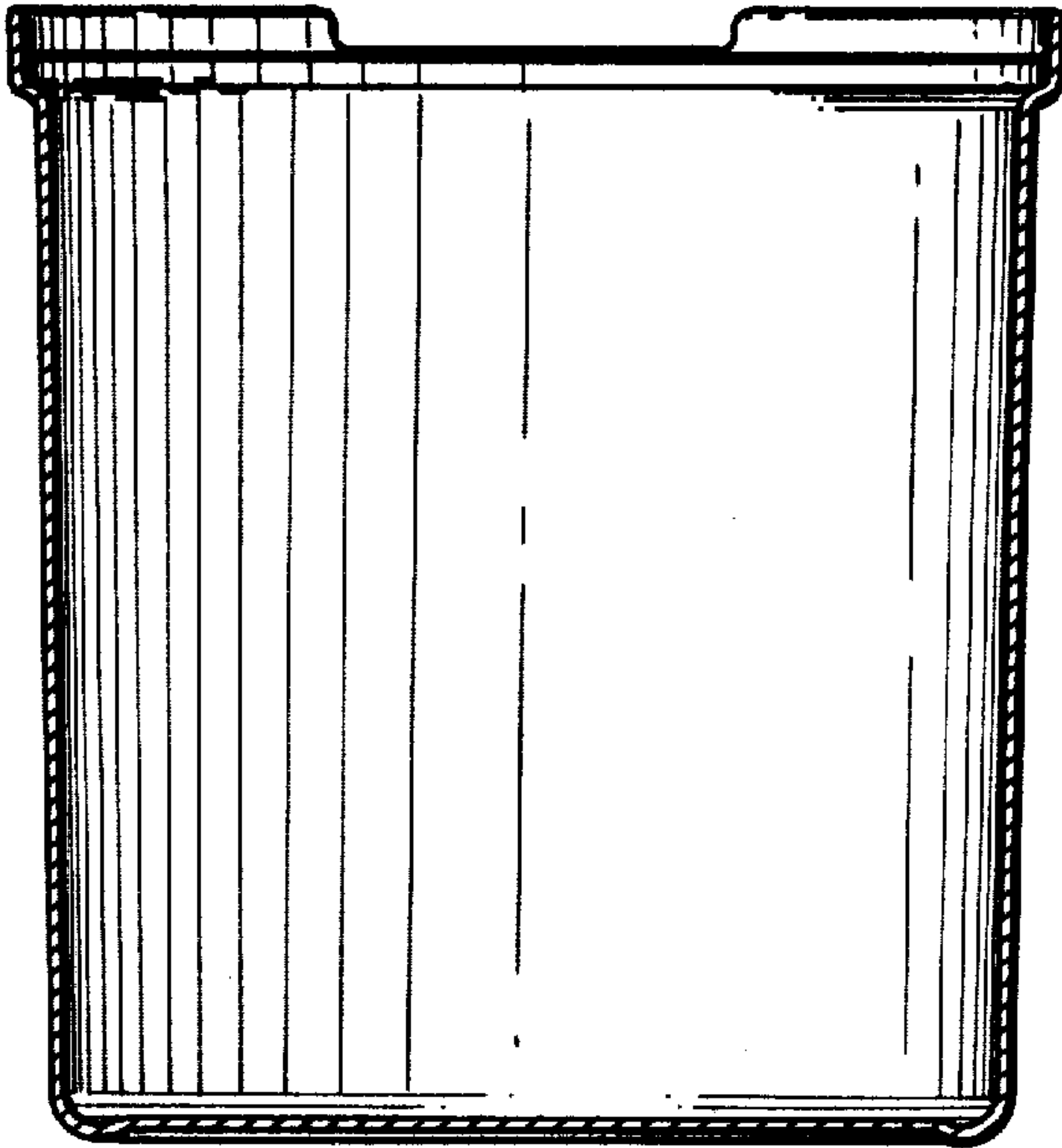

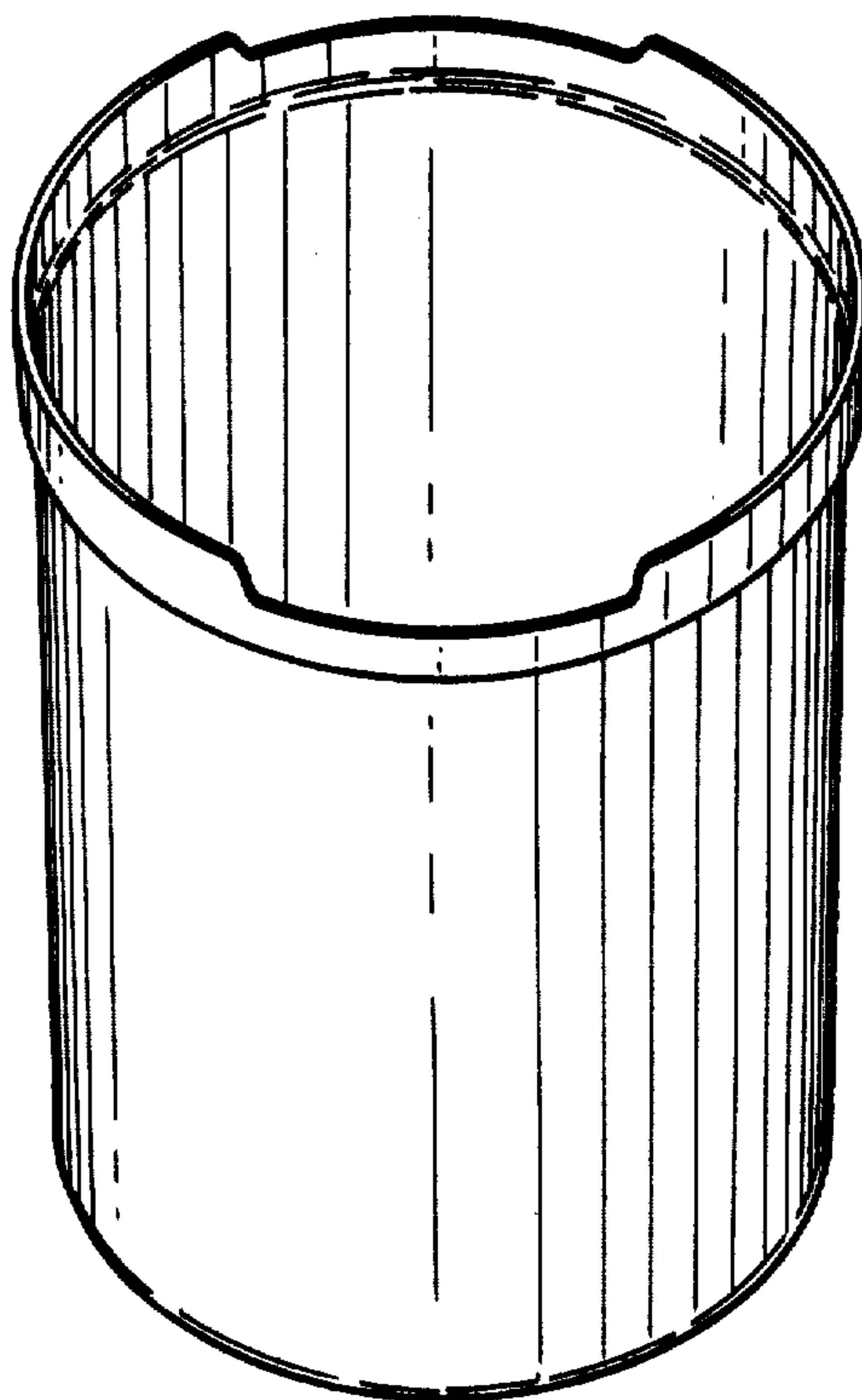

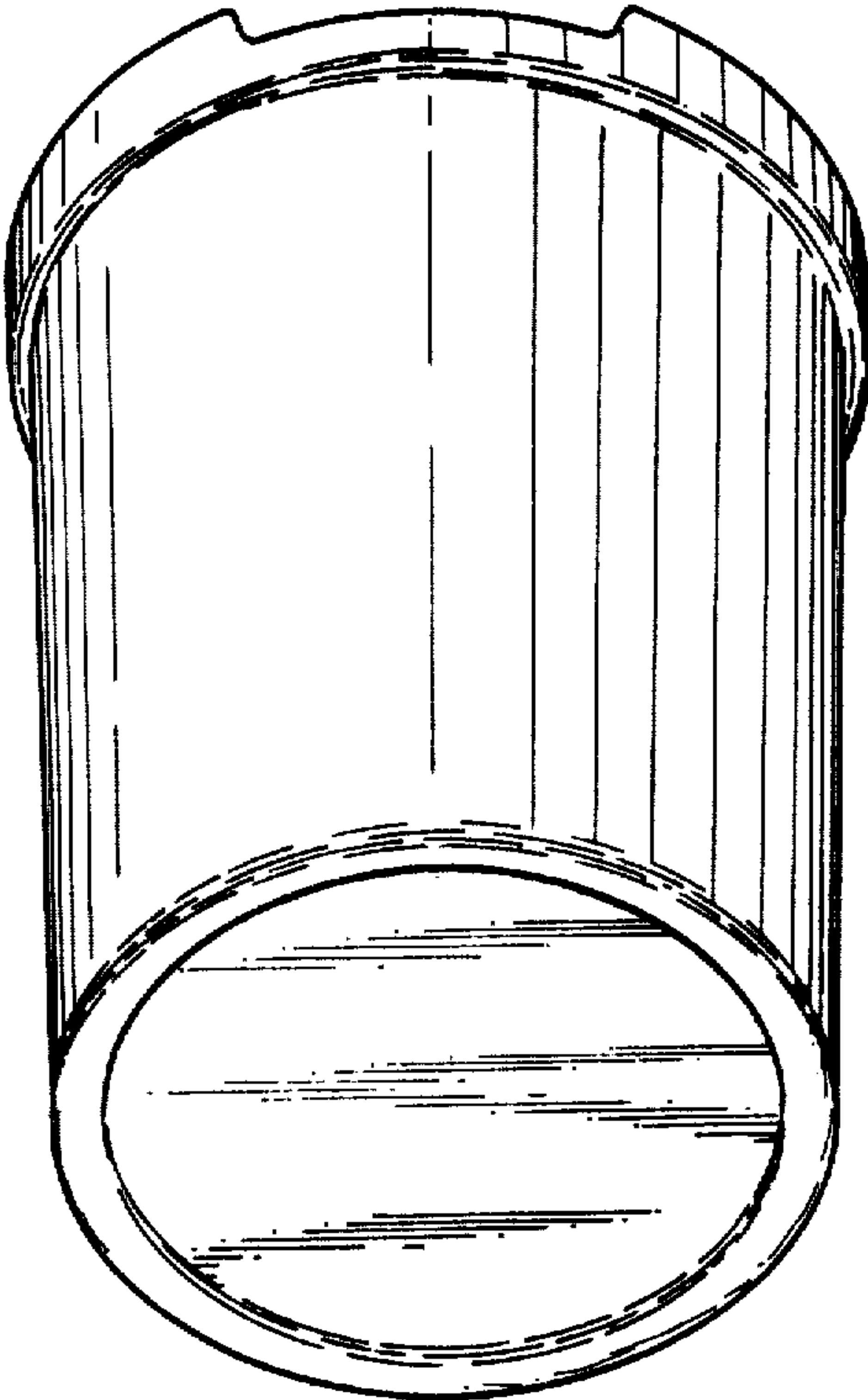
