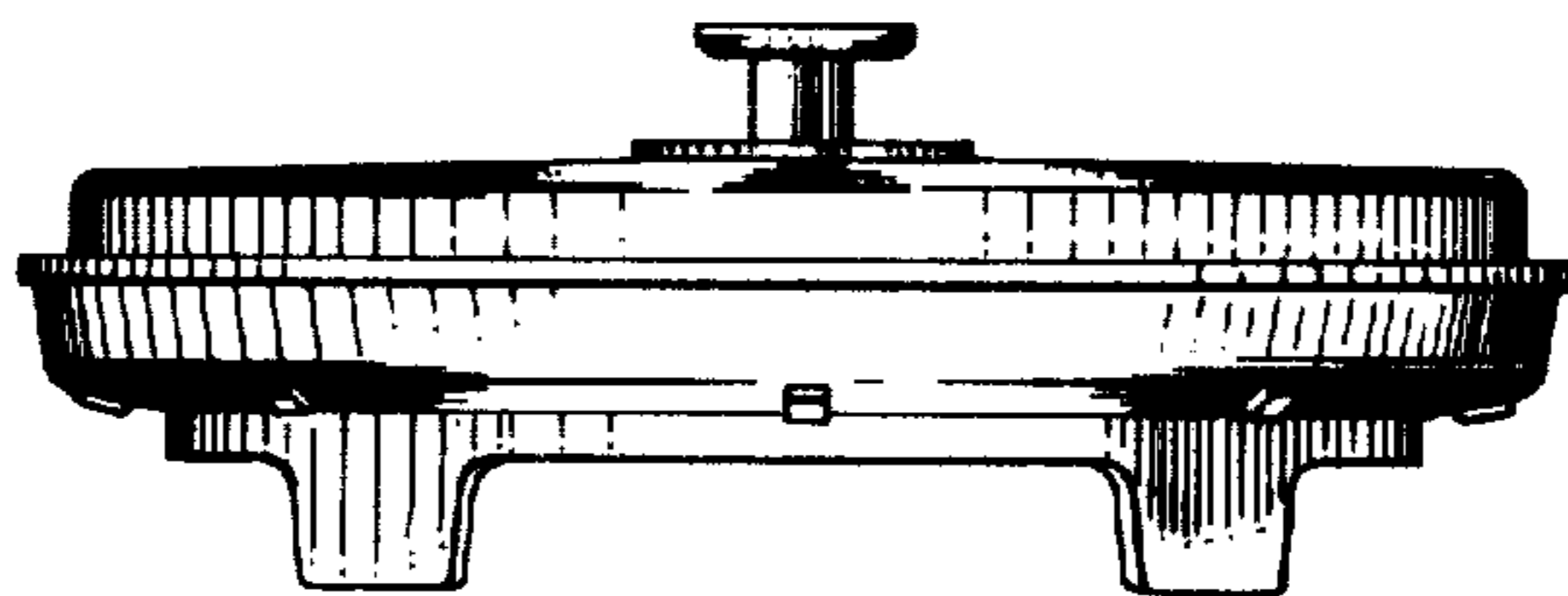
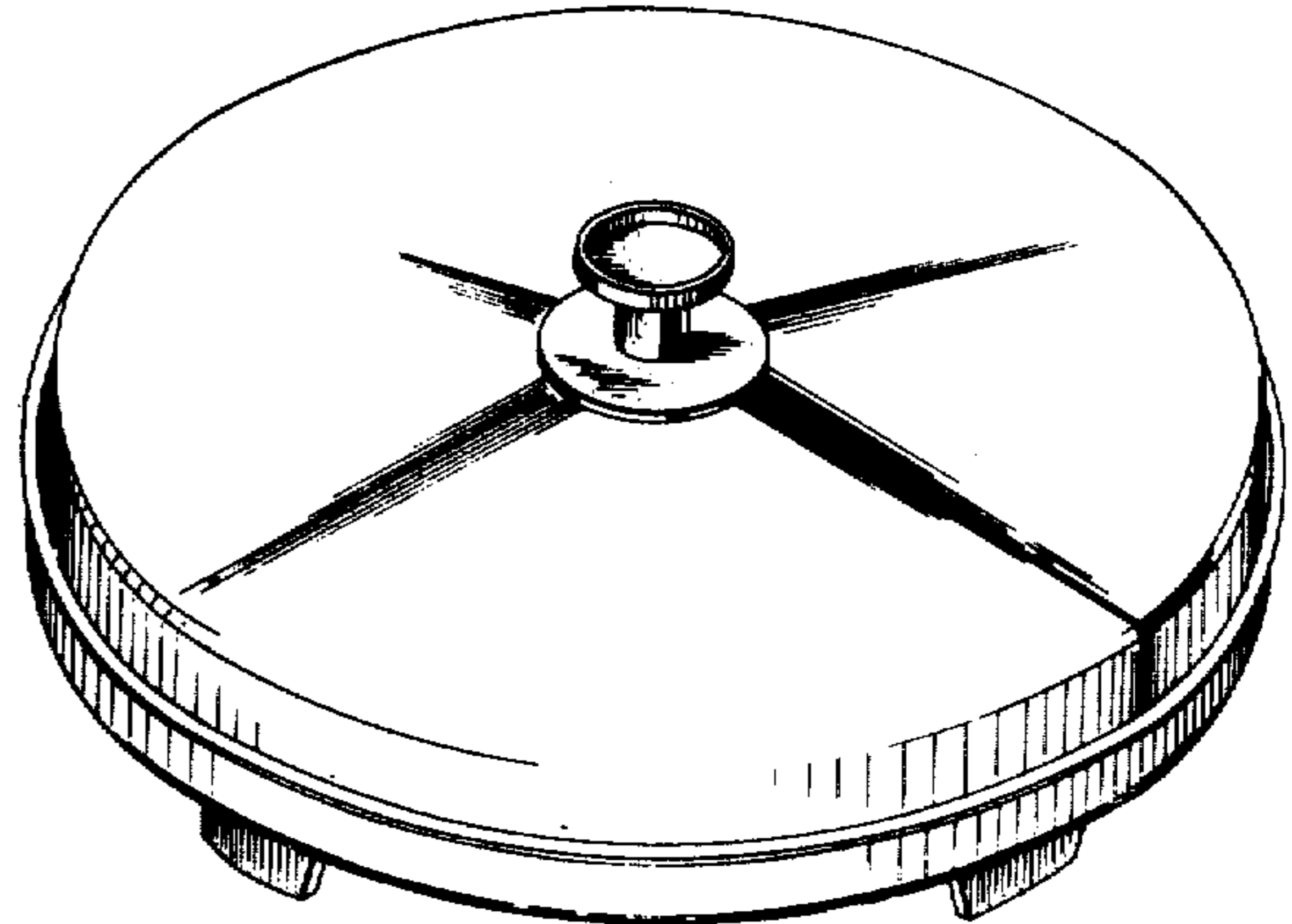
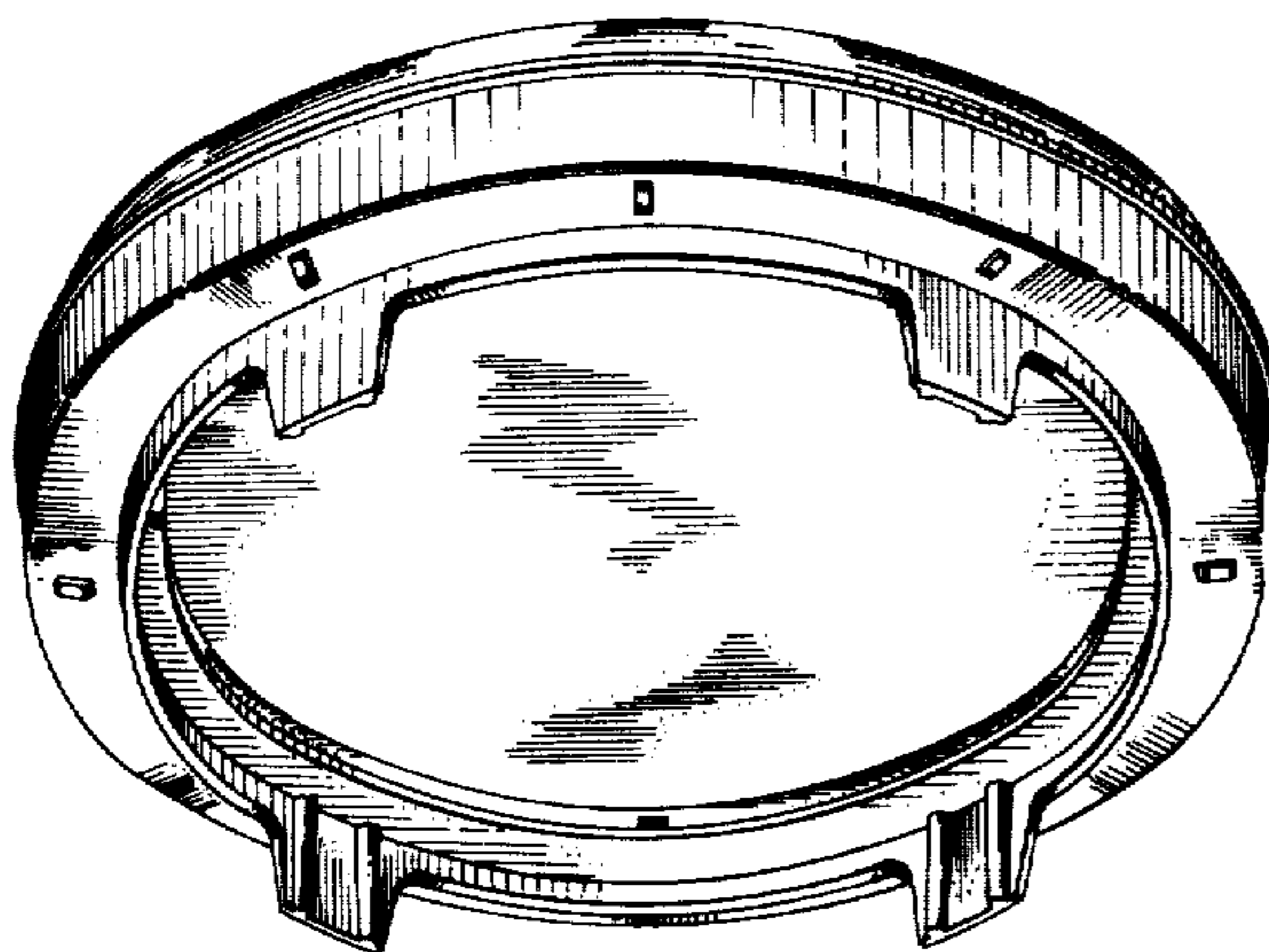

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a microwave
pizza maker utensil showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof on a reduced scale;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



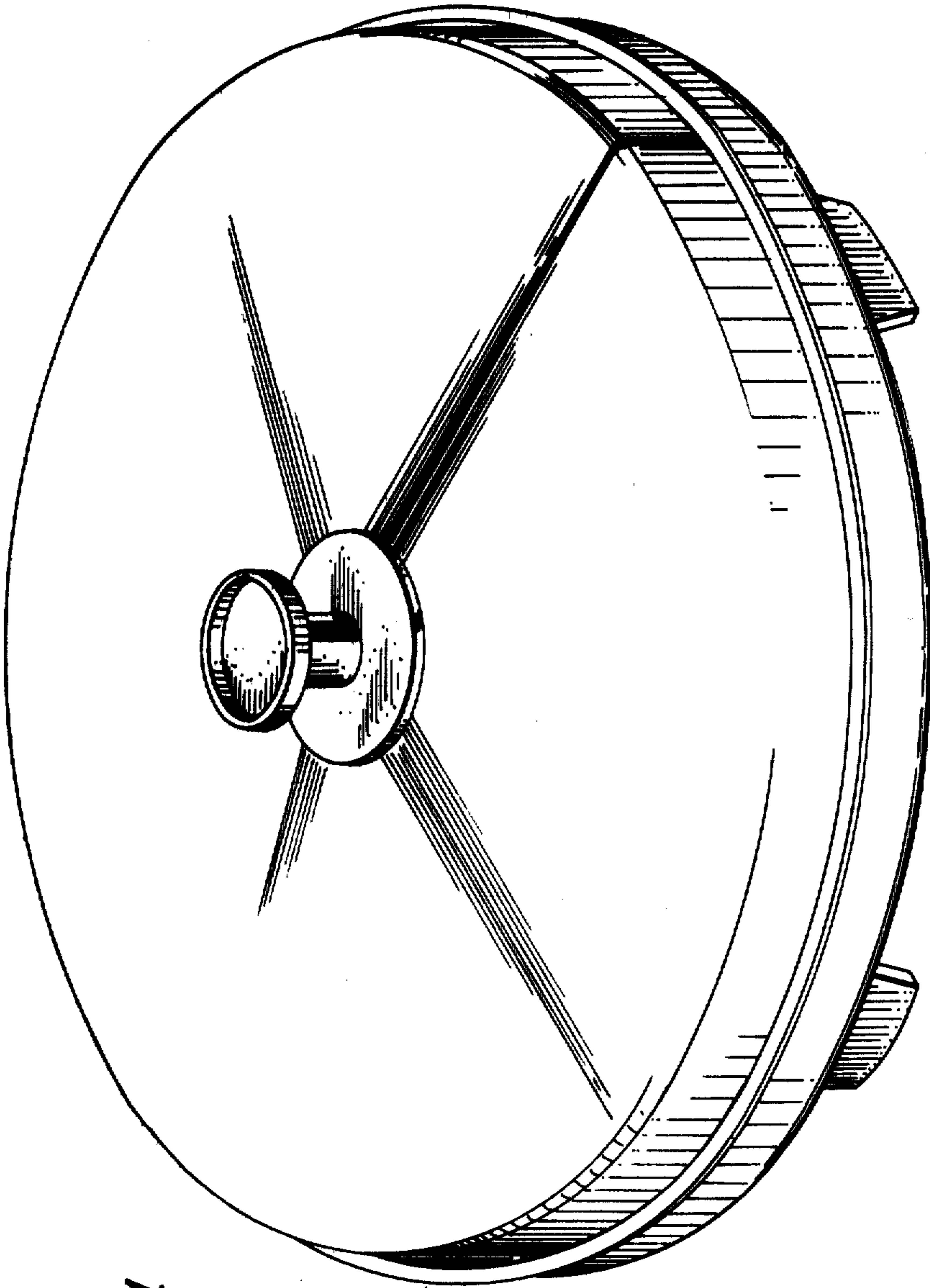

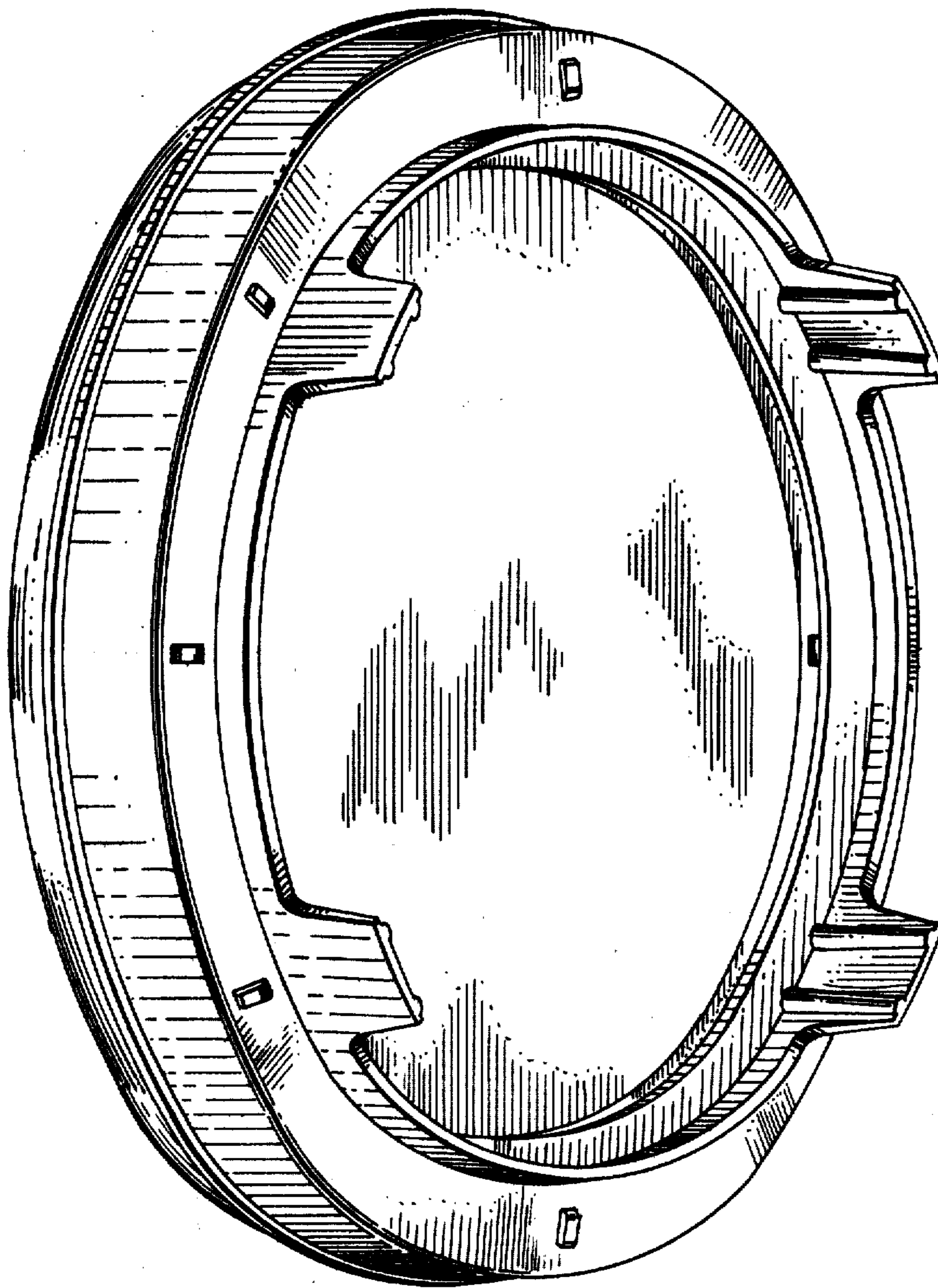

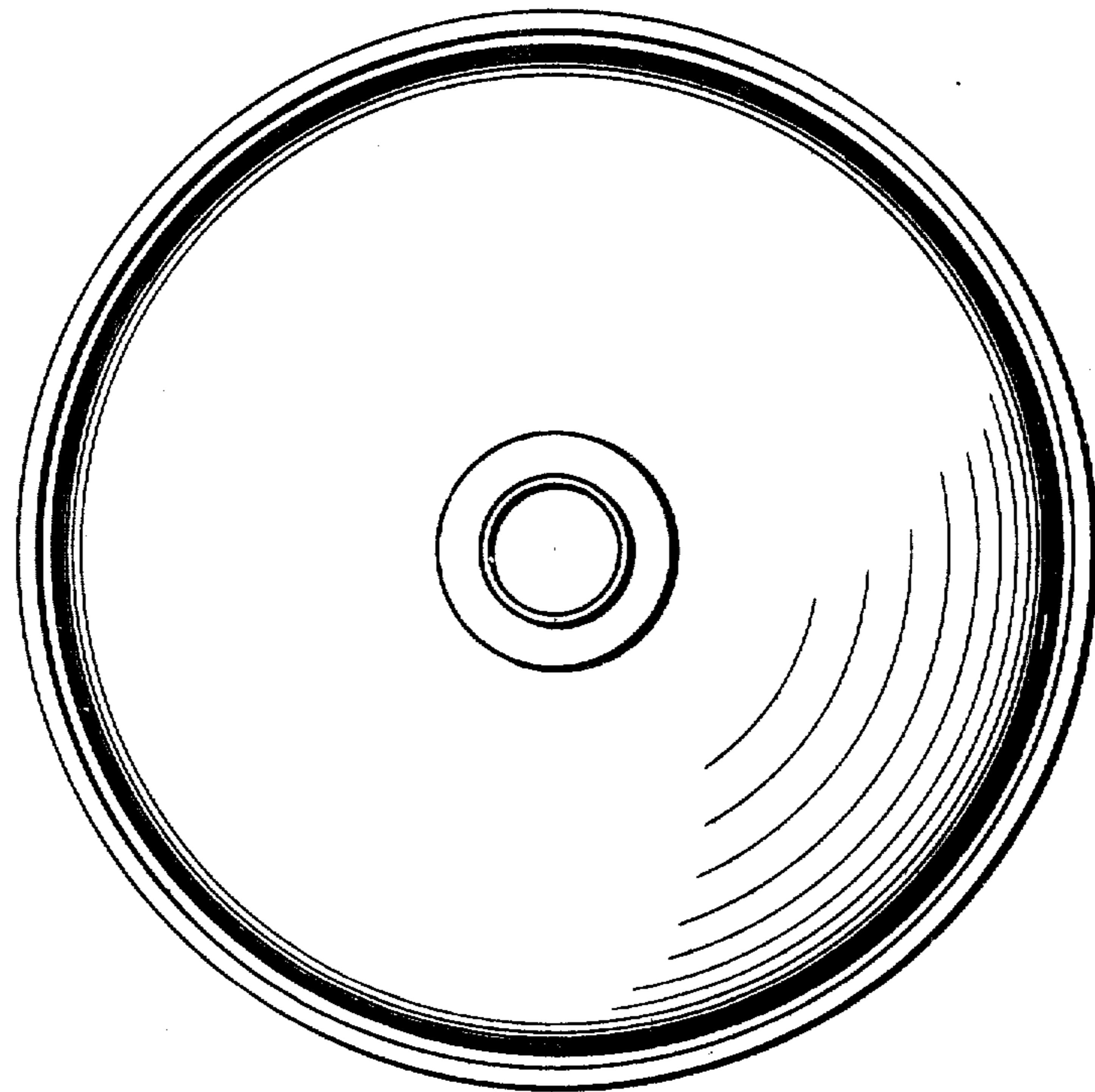

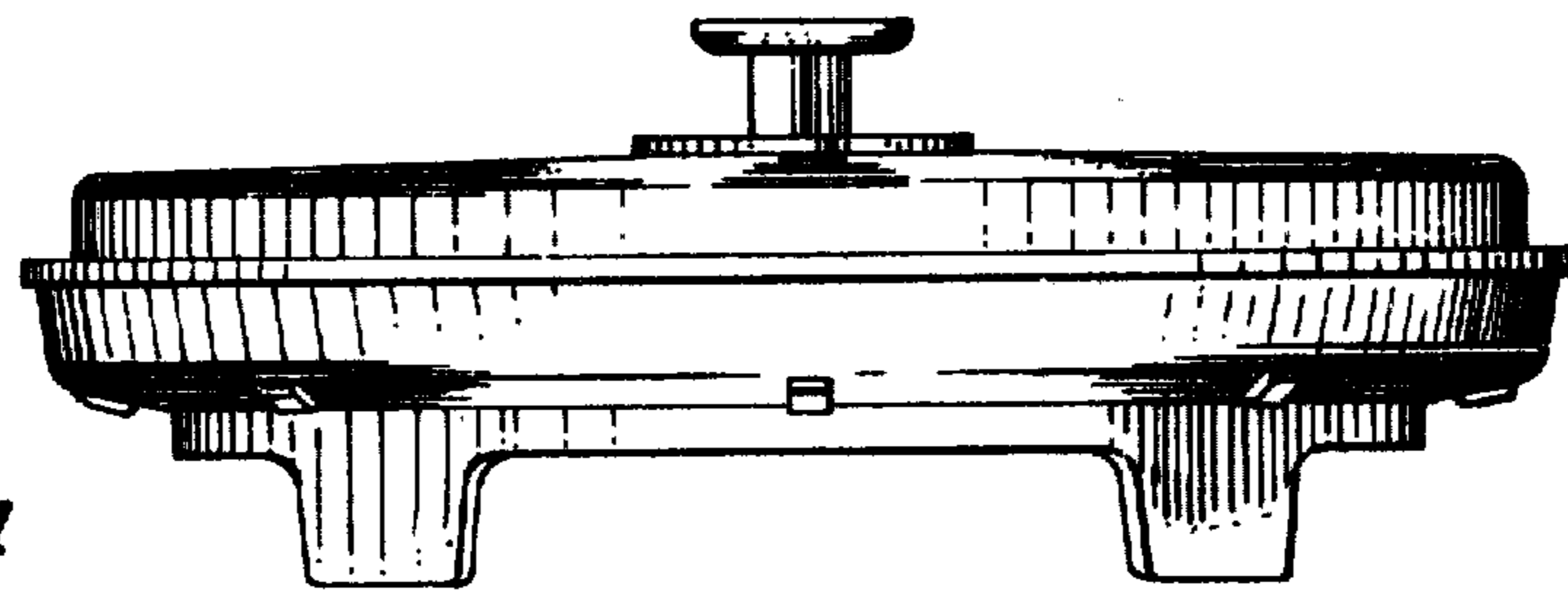

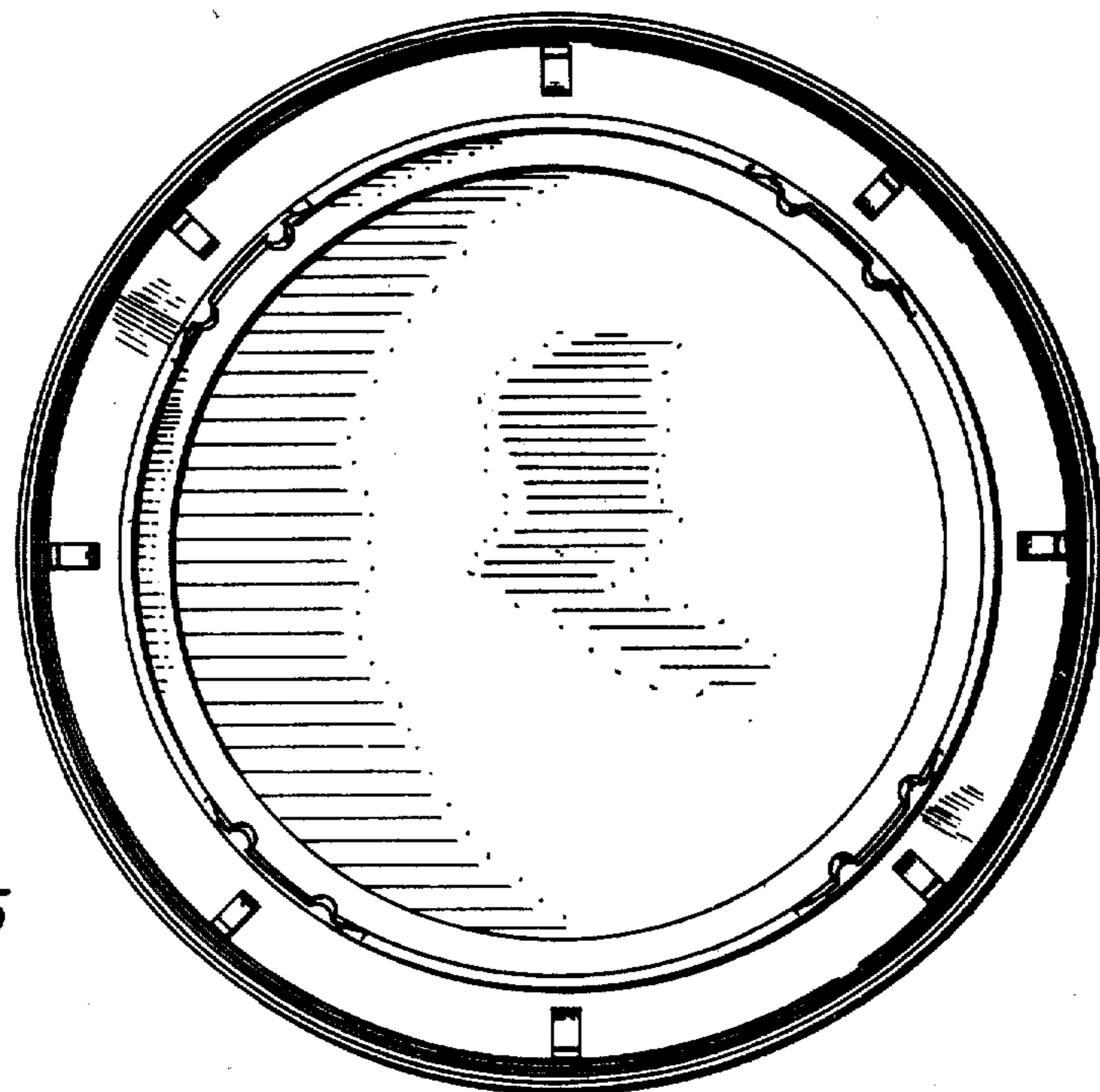
