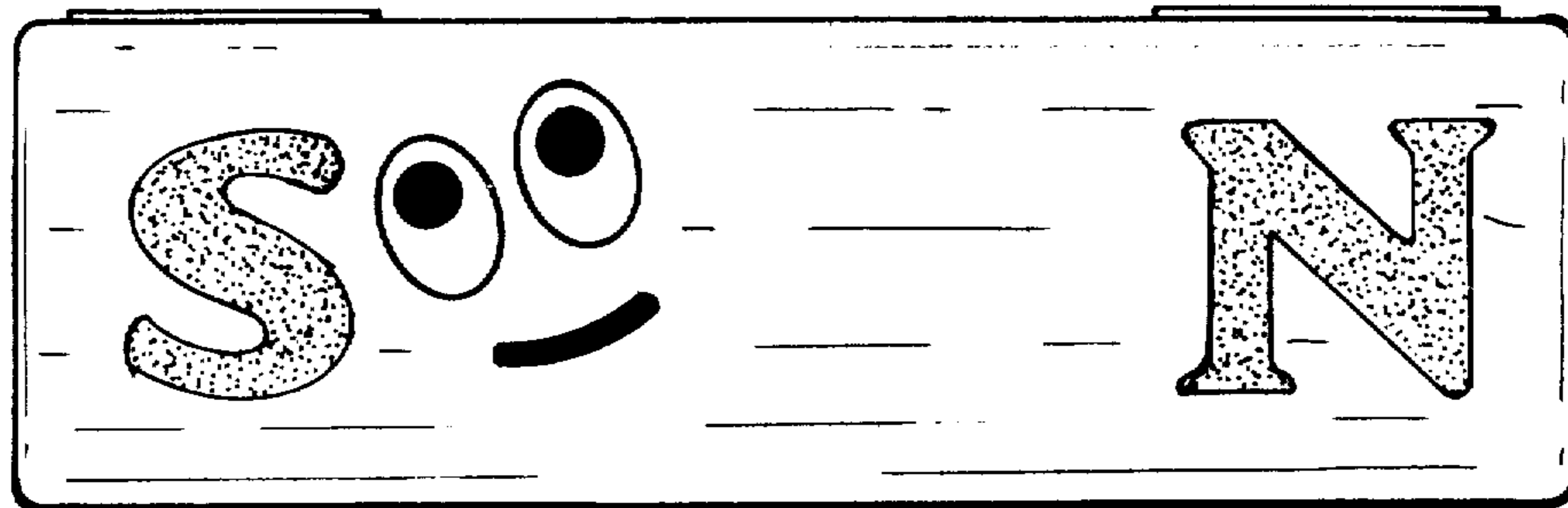

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy bar magnet, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a toy bar magnet showing my new design, the bottom being substantially the same; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof.



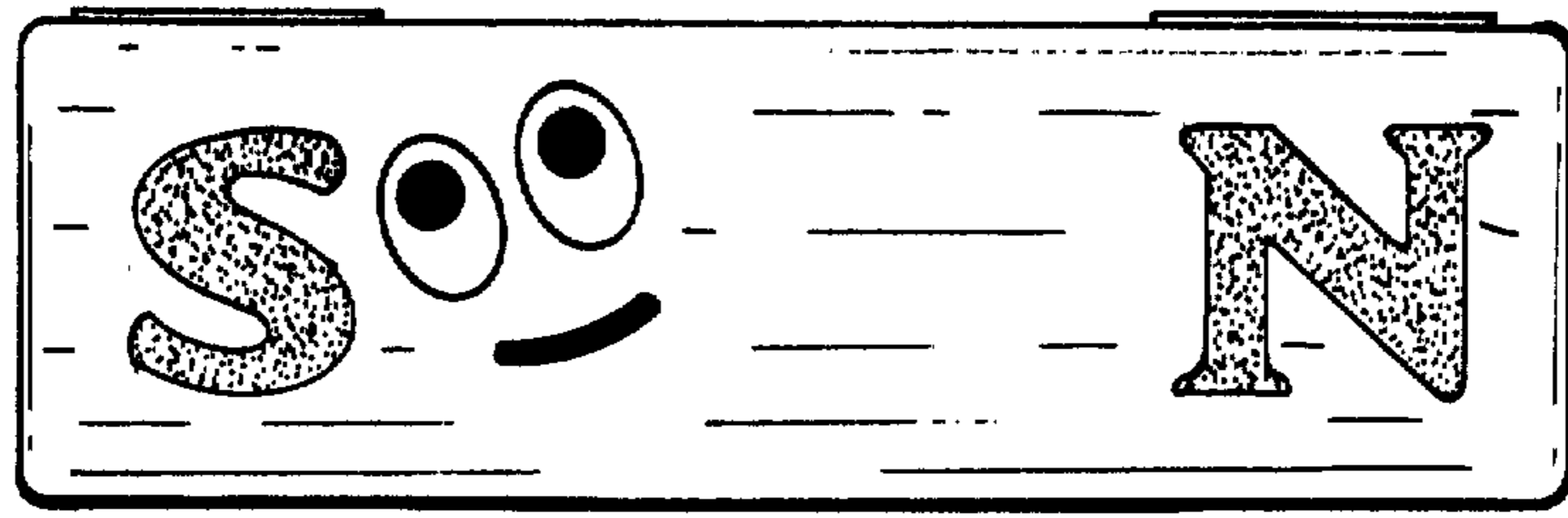

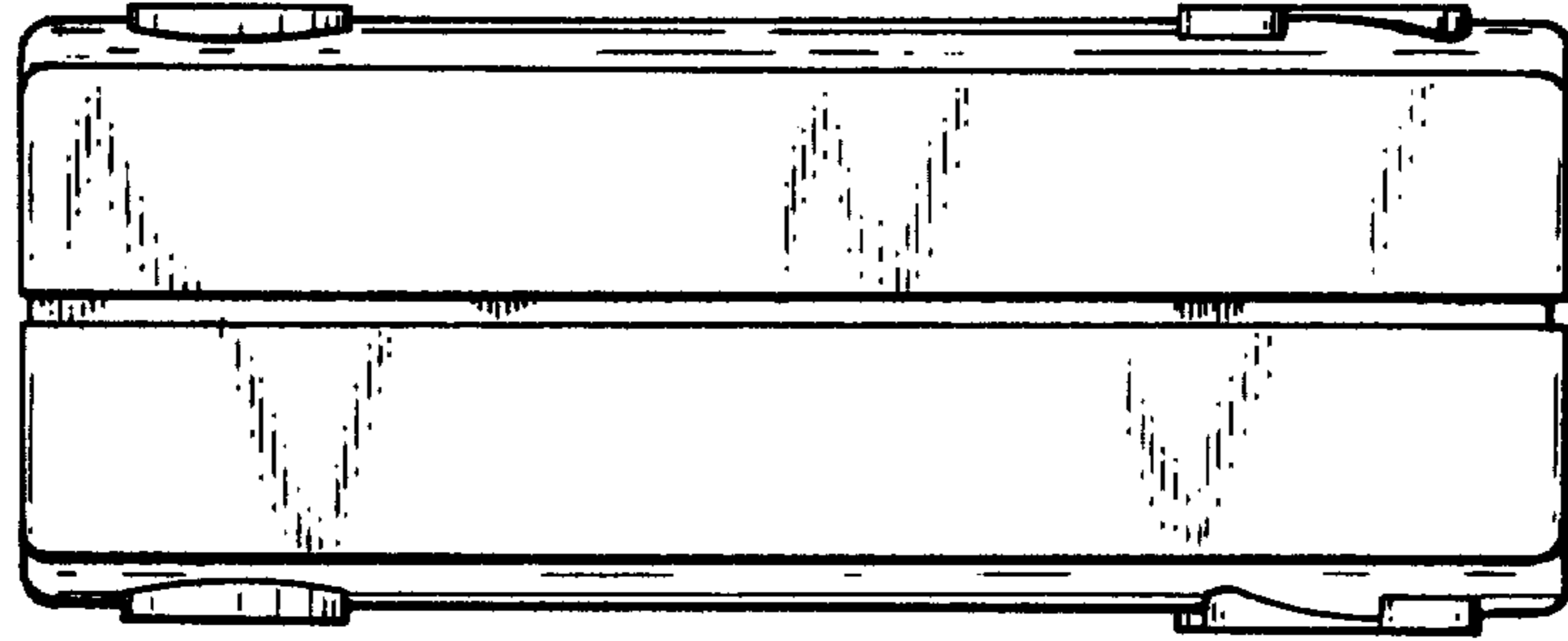

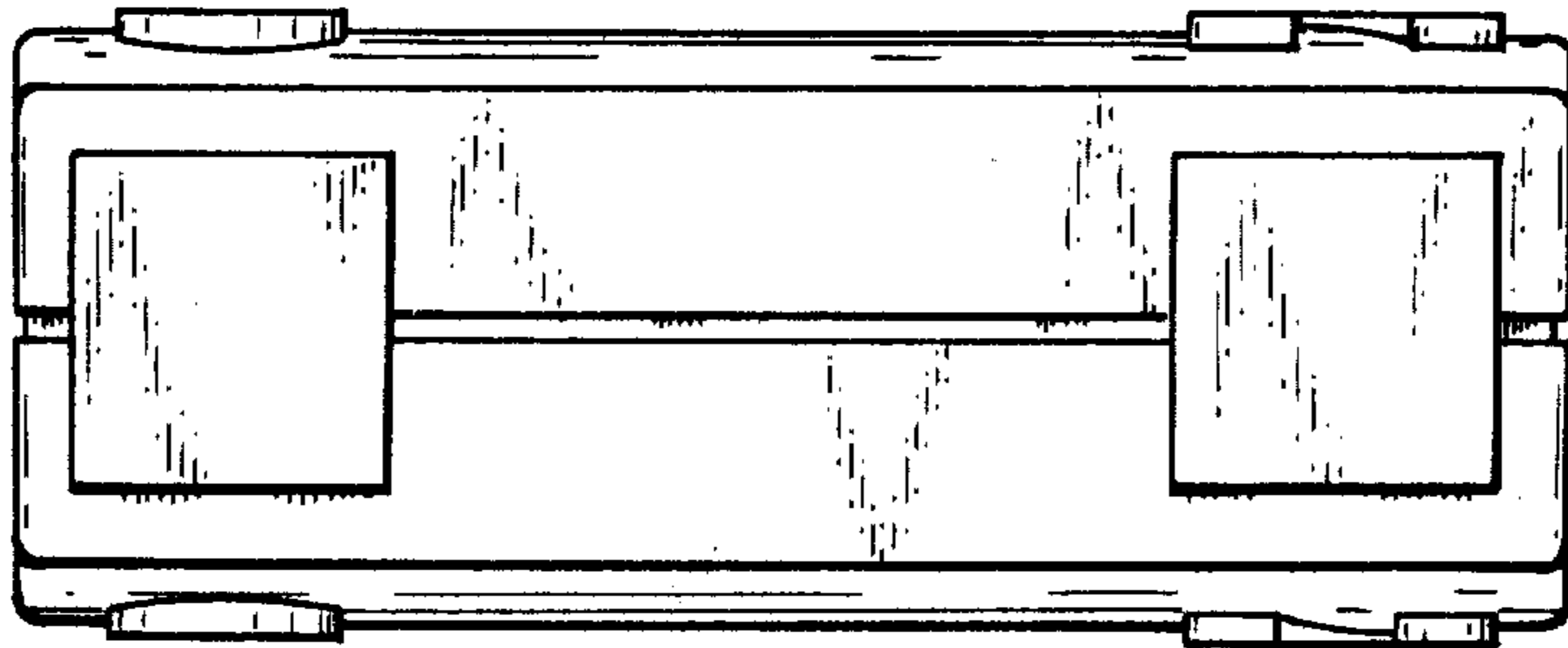

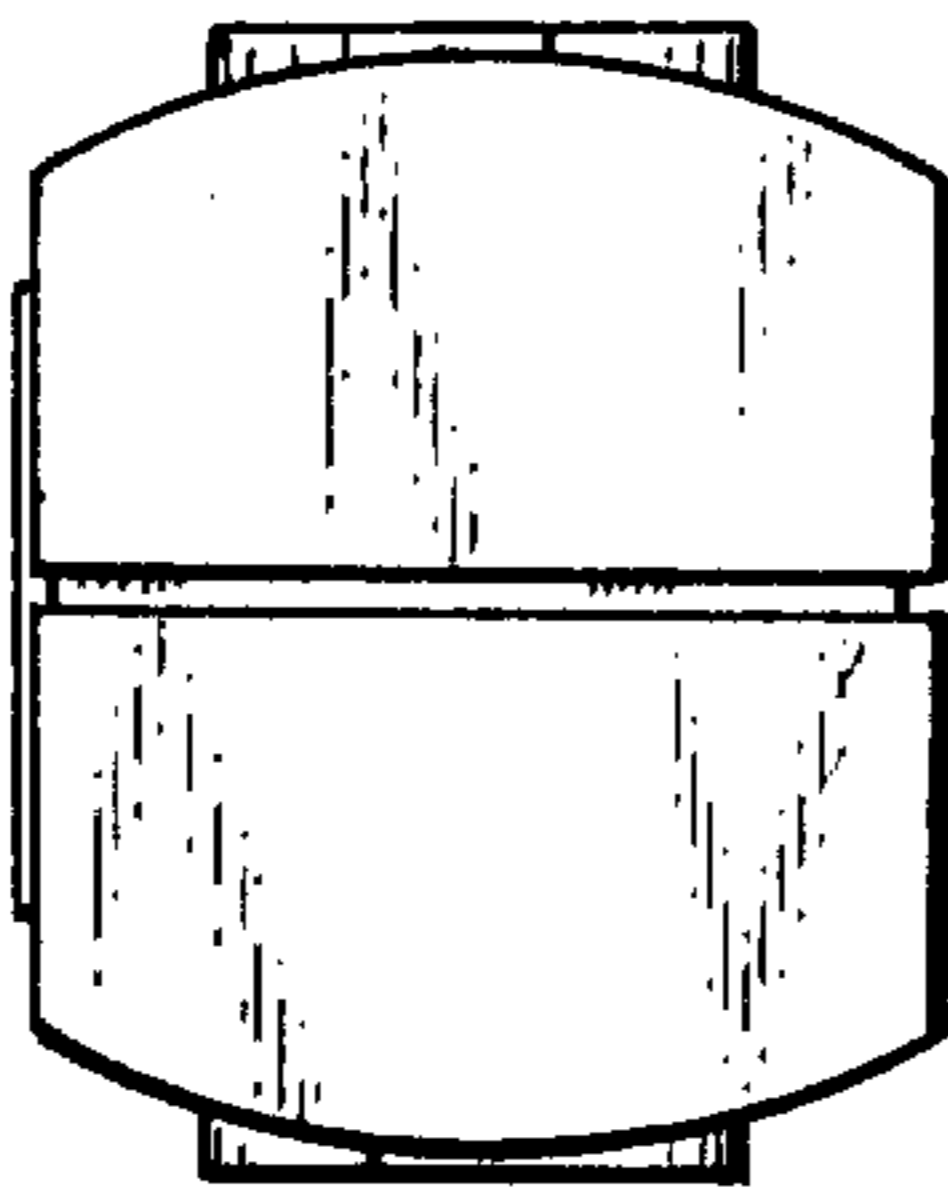

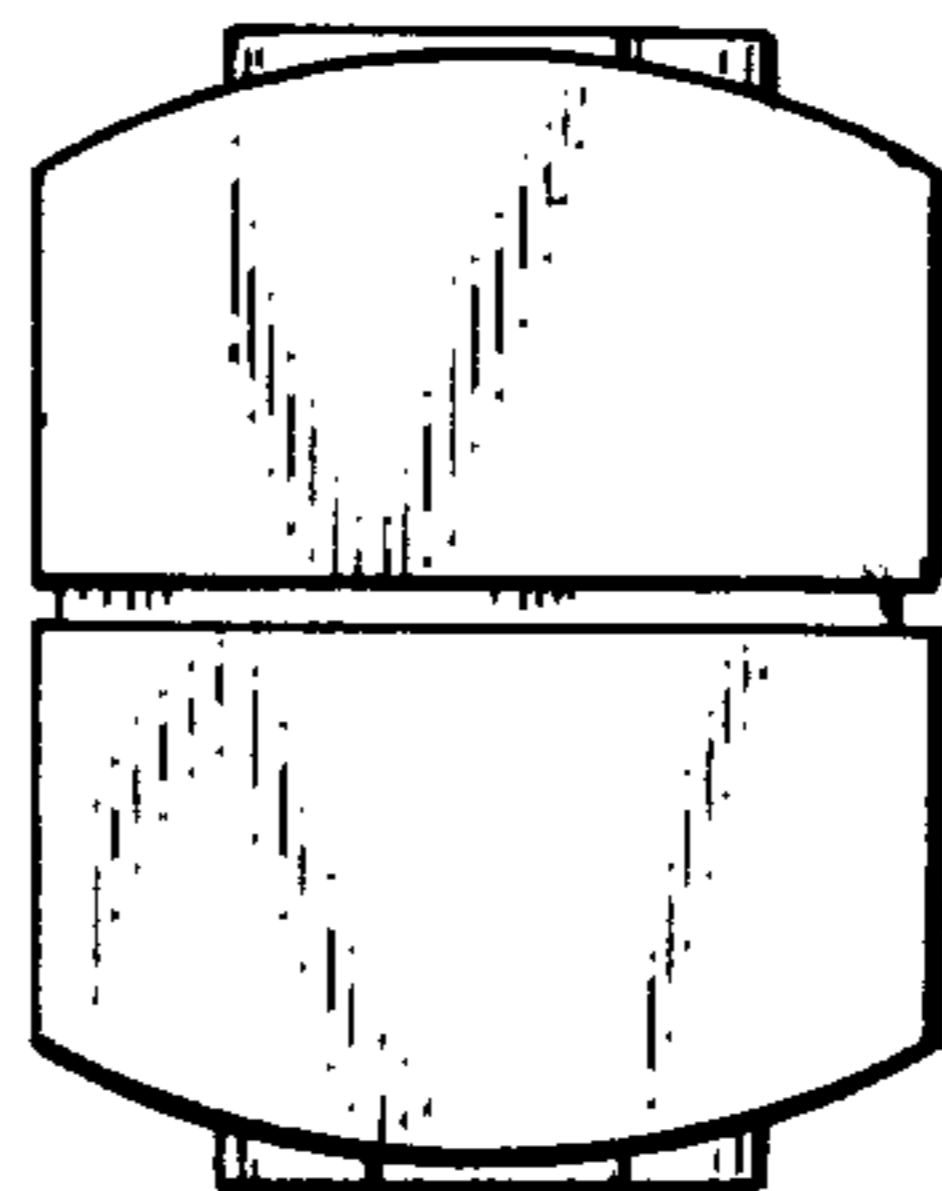
