FIG. 5 is a bottom end view.

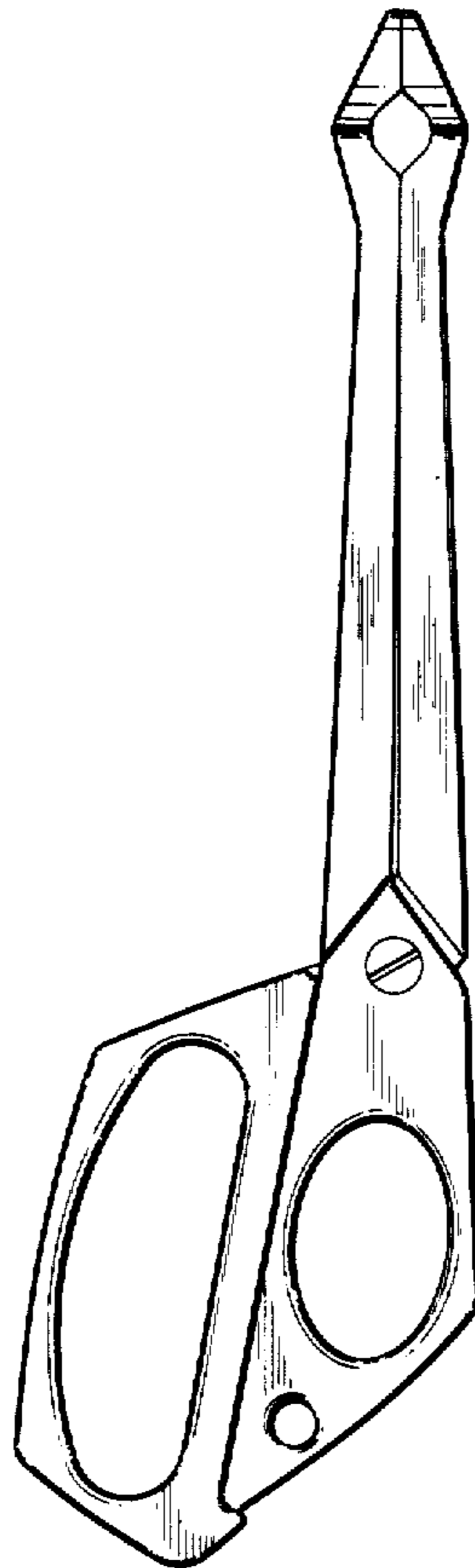

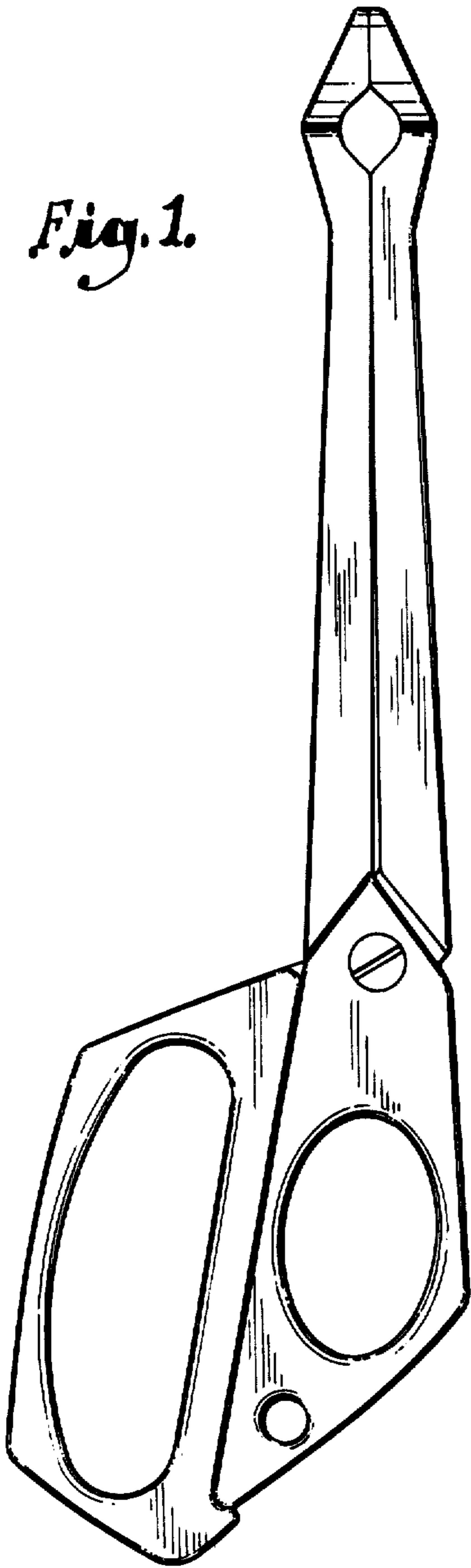

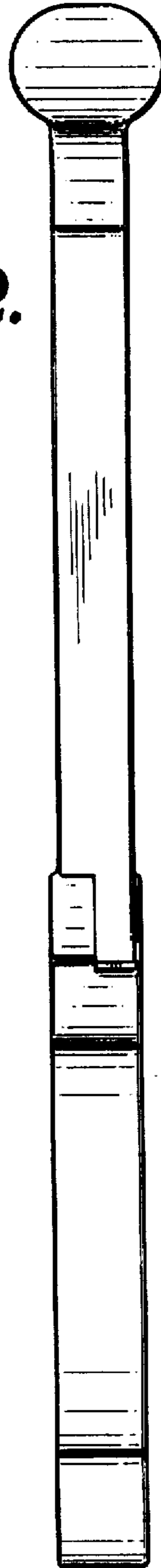

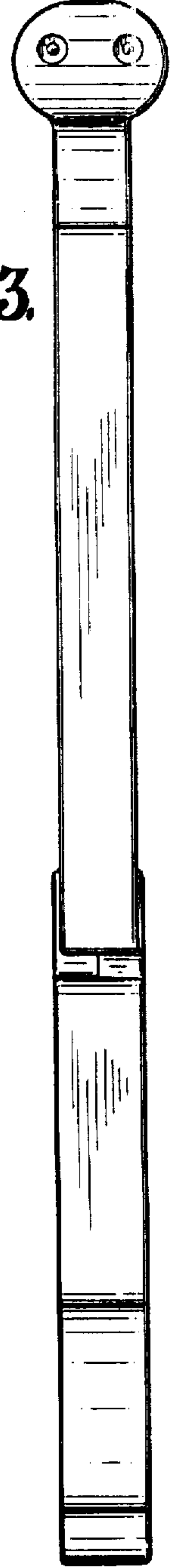

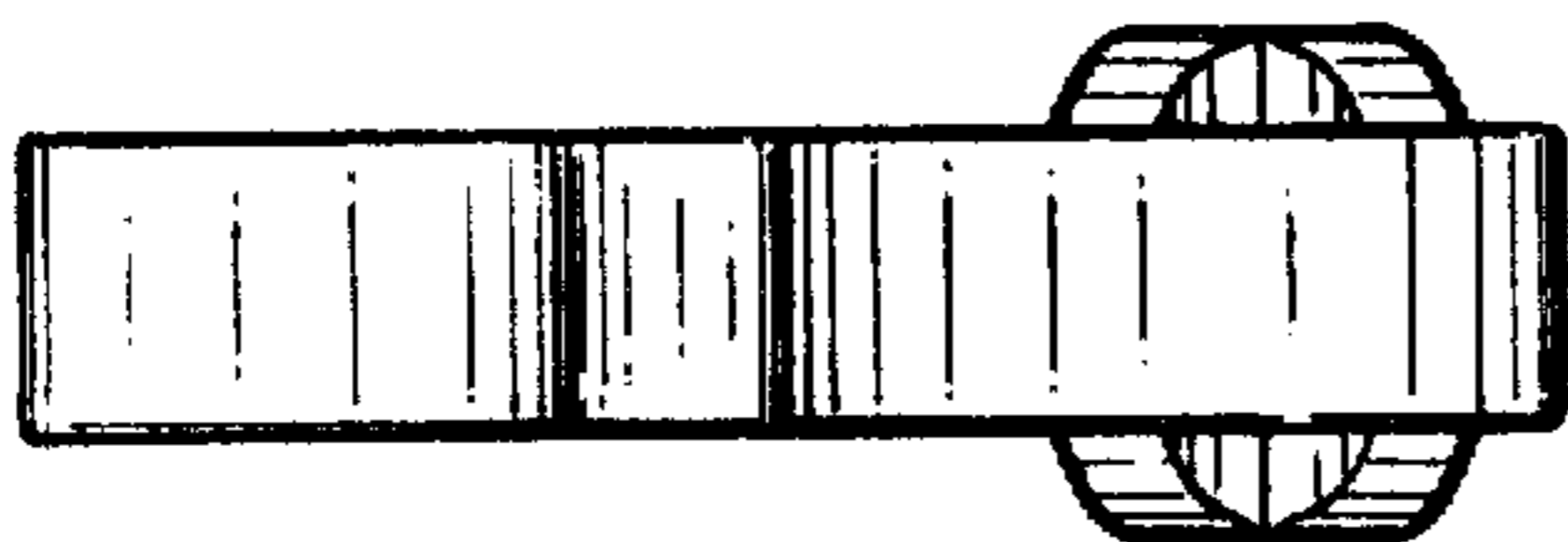
