

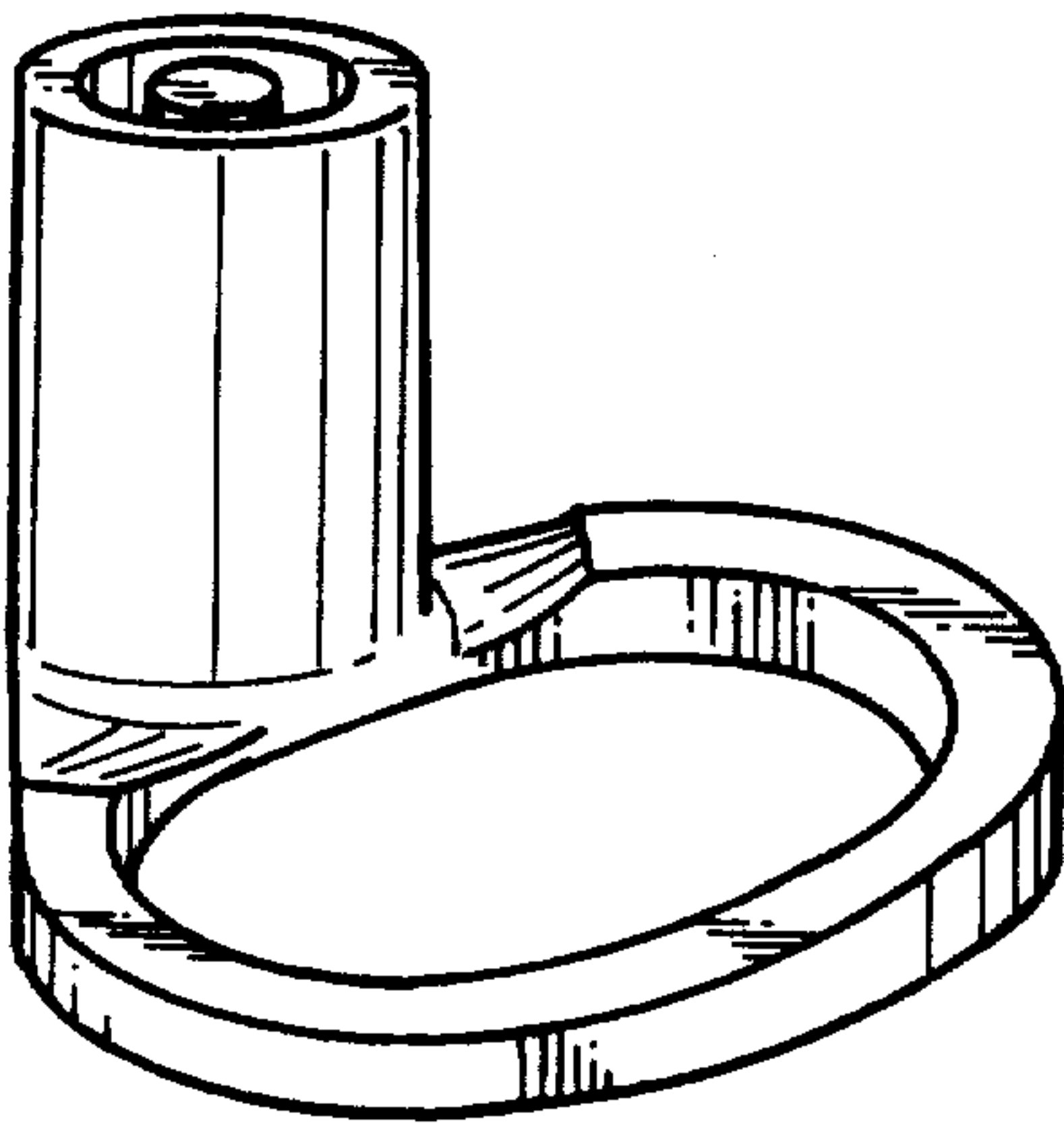

[57] **CLAIM**
The ornamental design for a pull ring port cap for a medical fluid container, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pull ring port cap for a medical fluid container, showing my new design in conjunction with a port for the container;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view; and
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The broken line showing of a flexible container and port in FIG. 1 is for background purposes only.



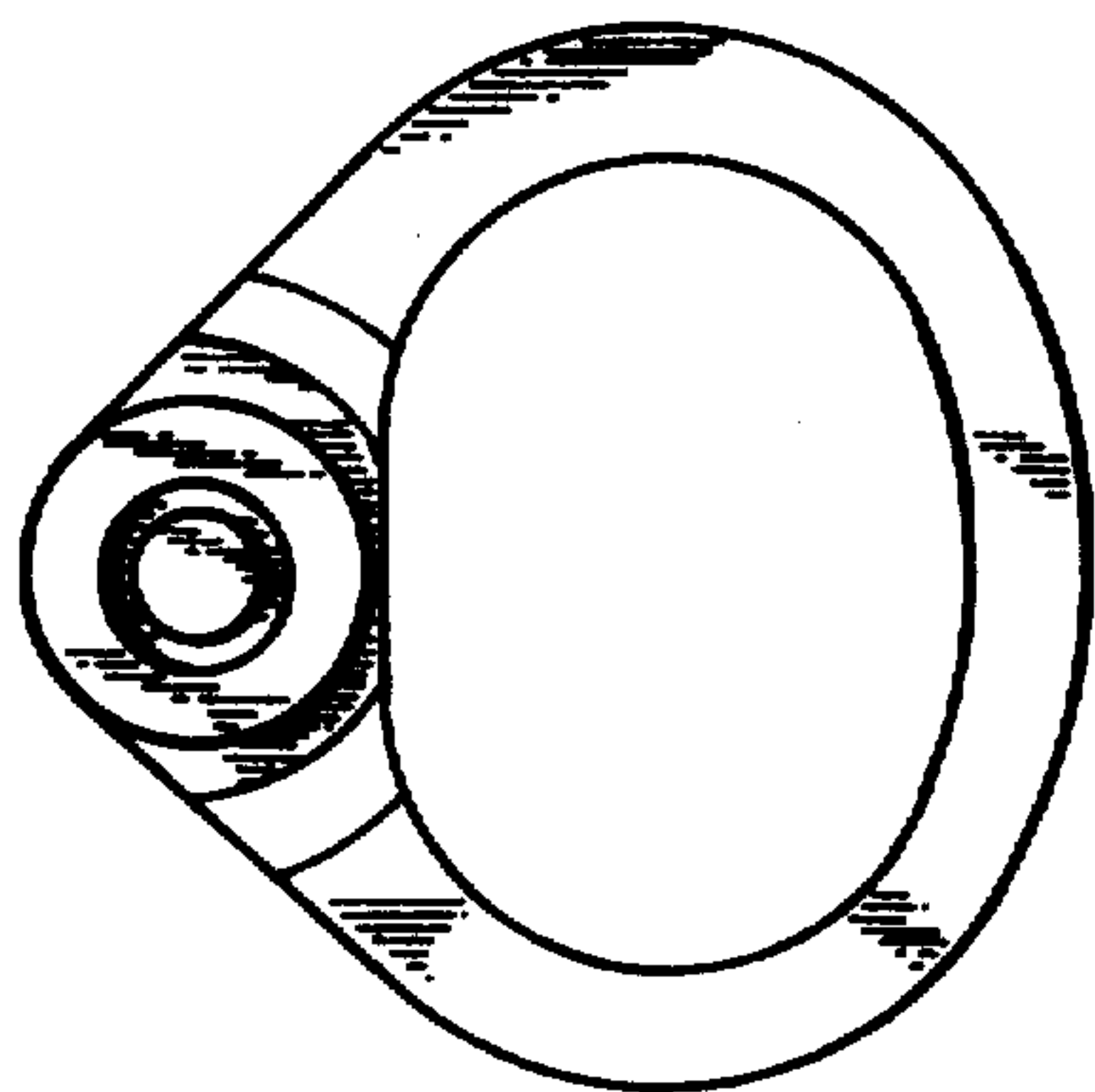

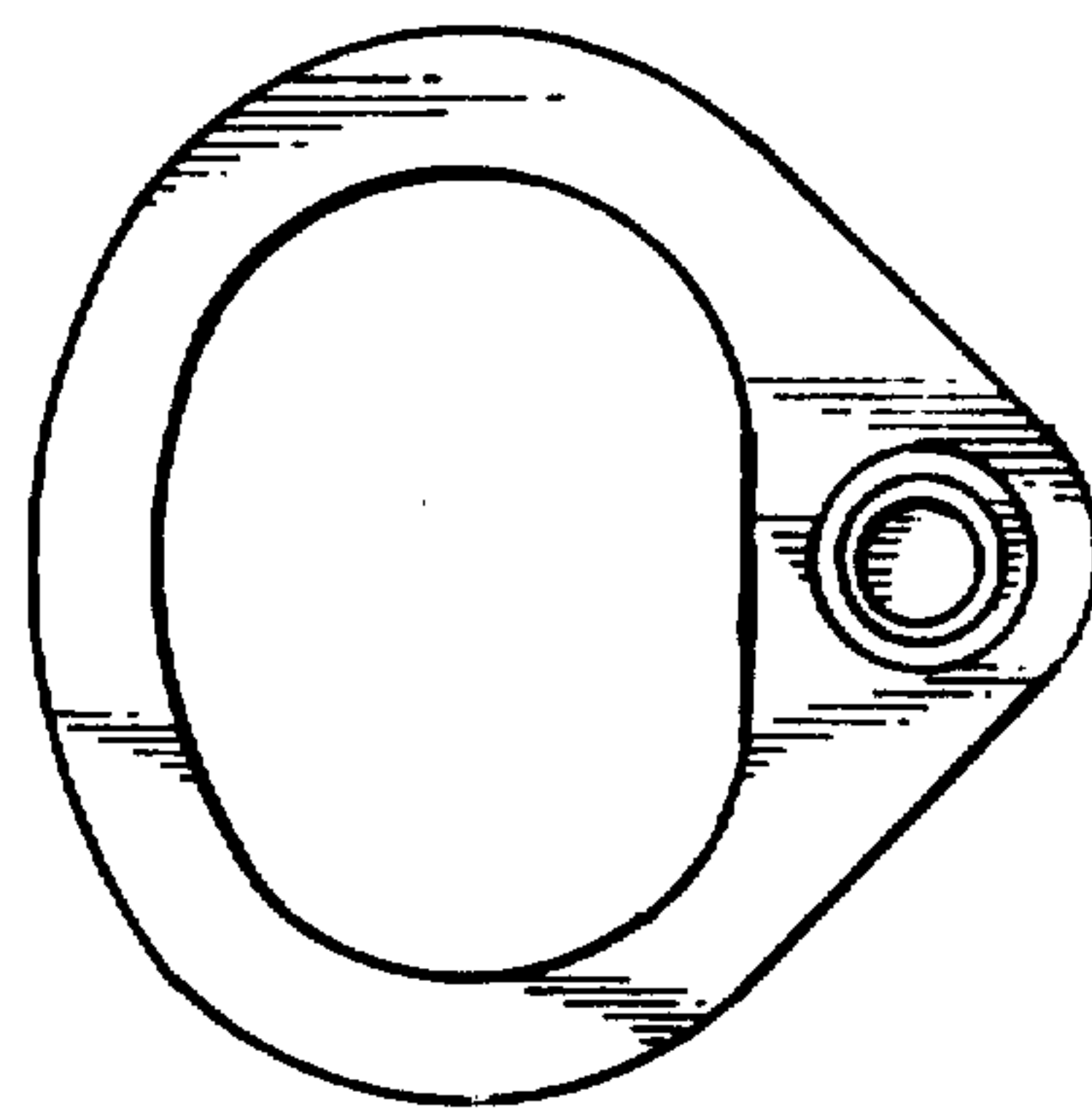

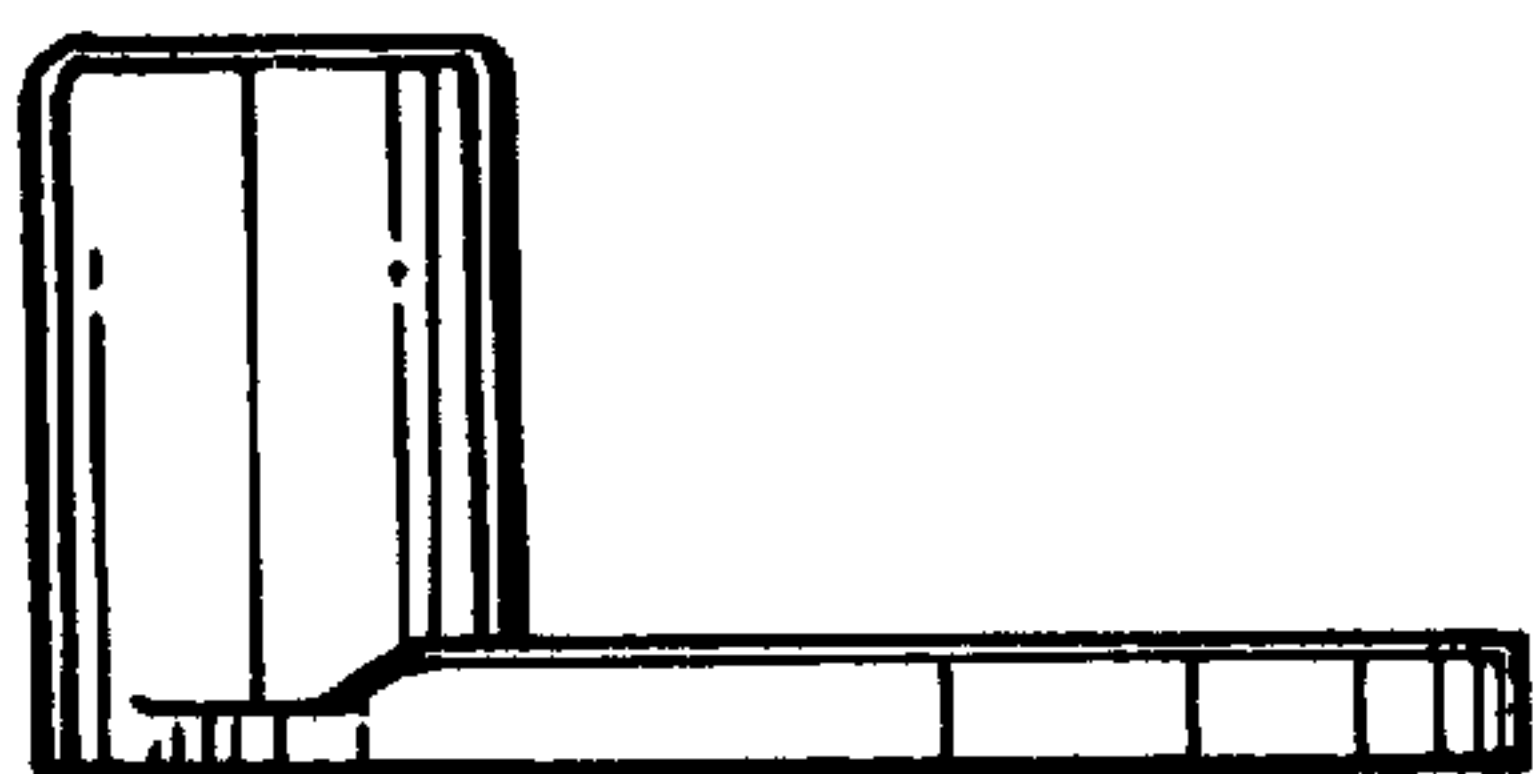

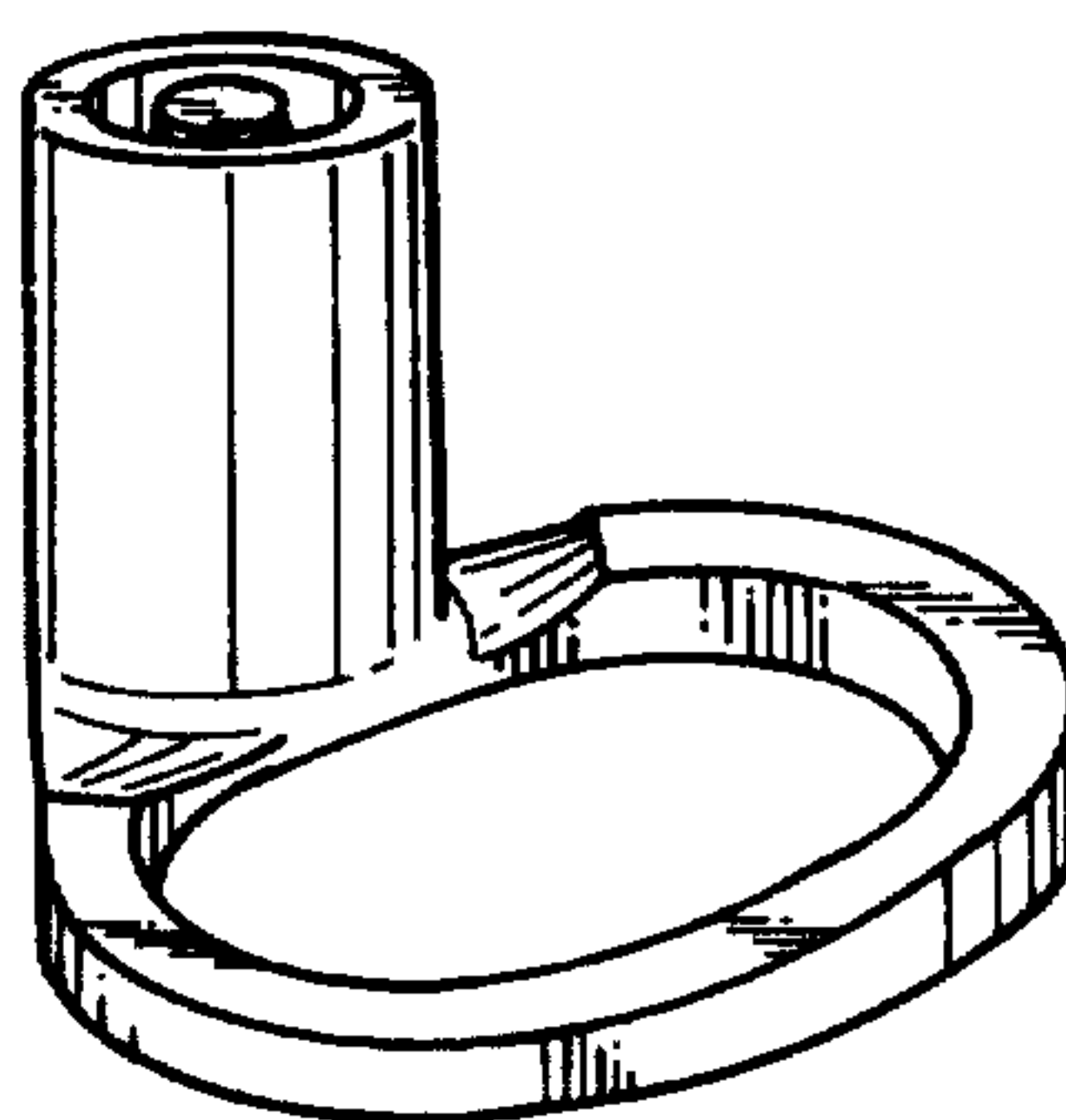

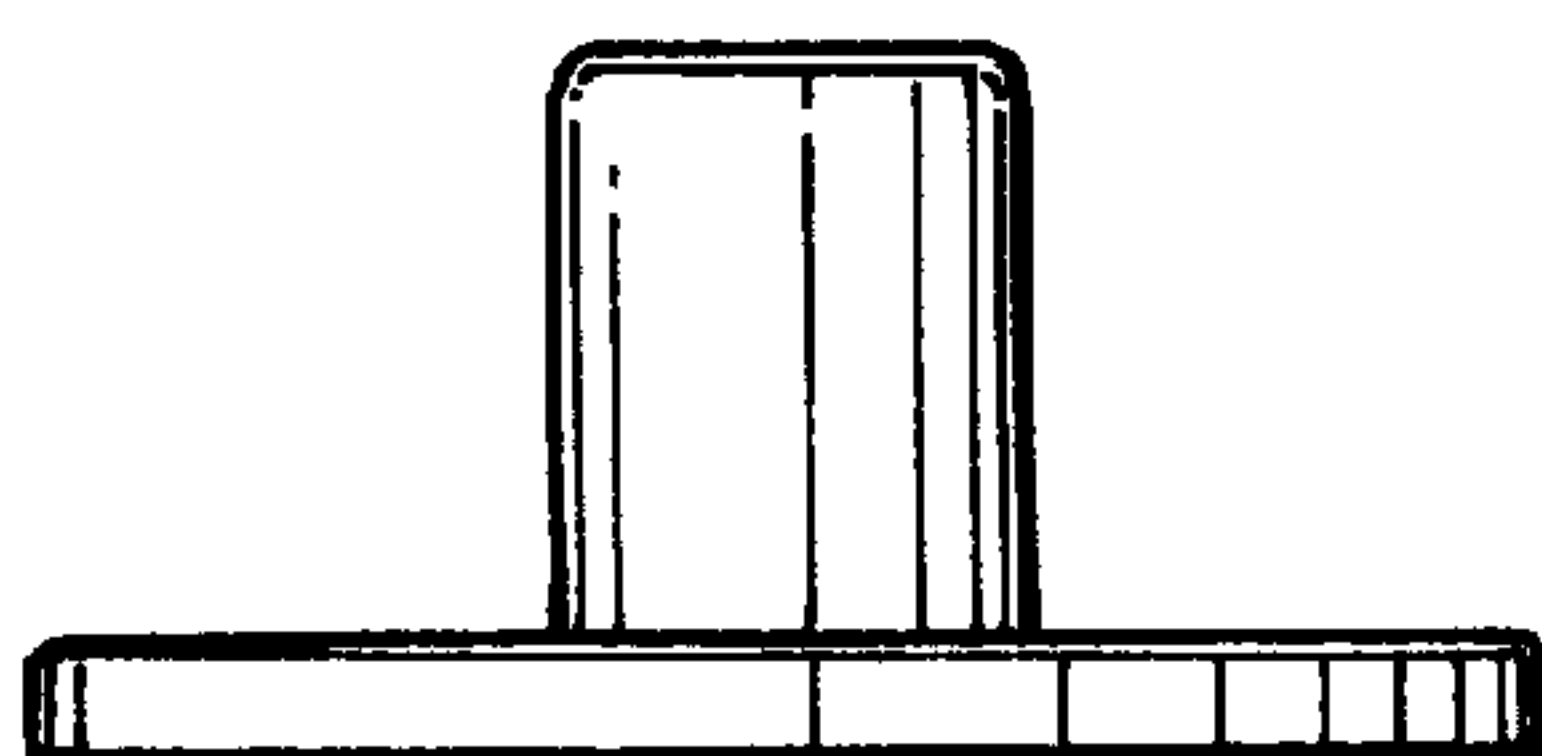

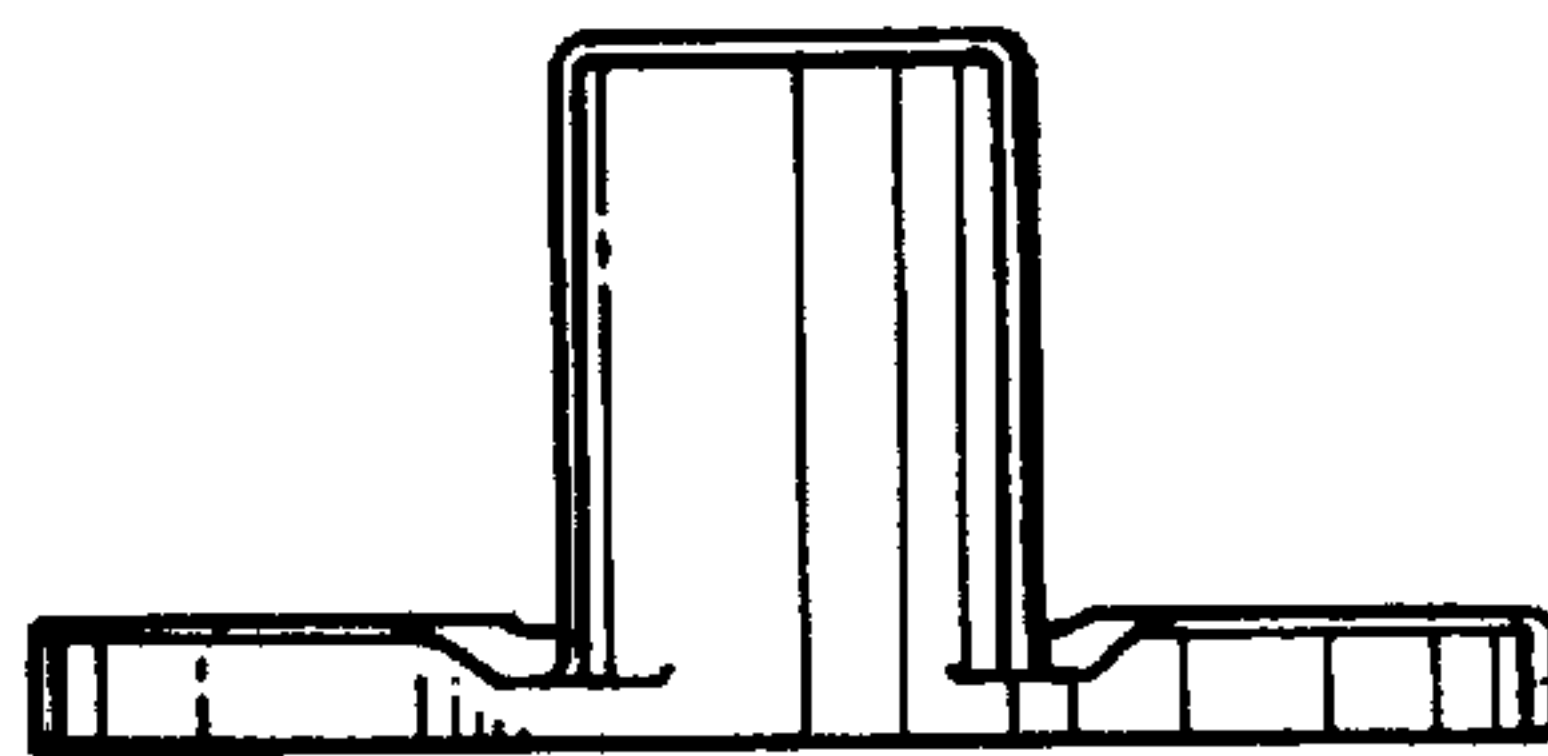
