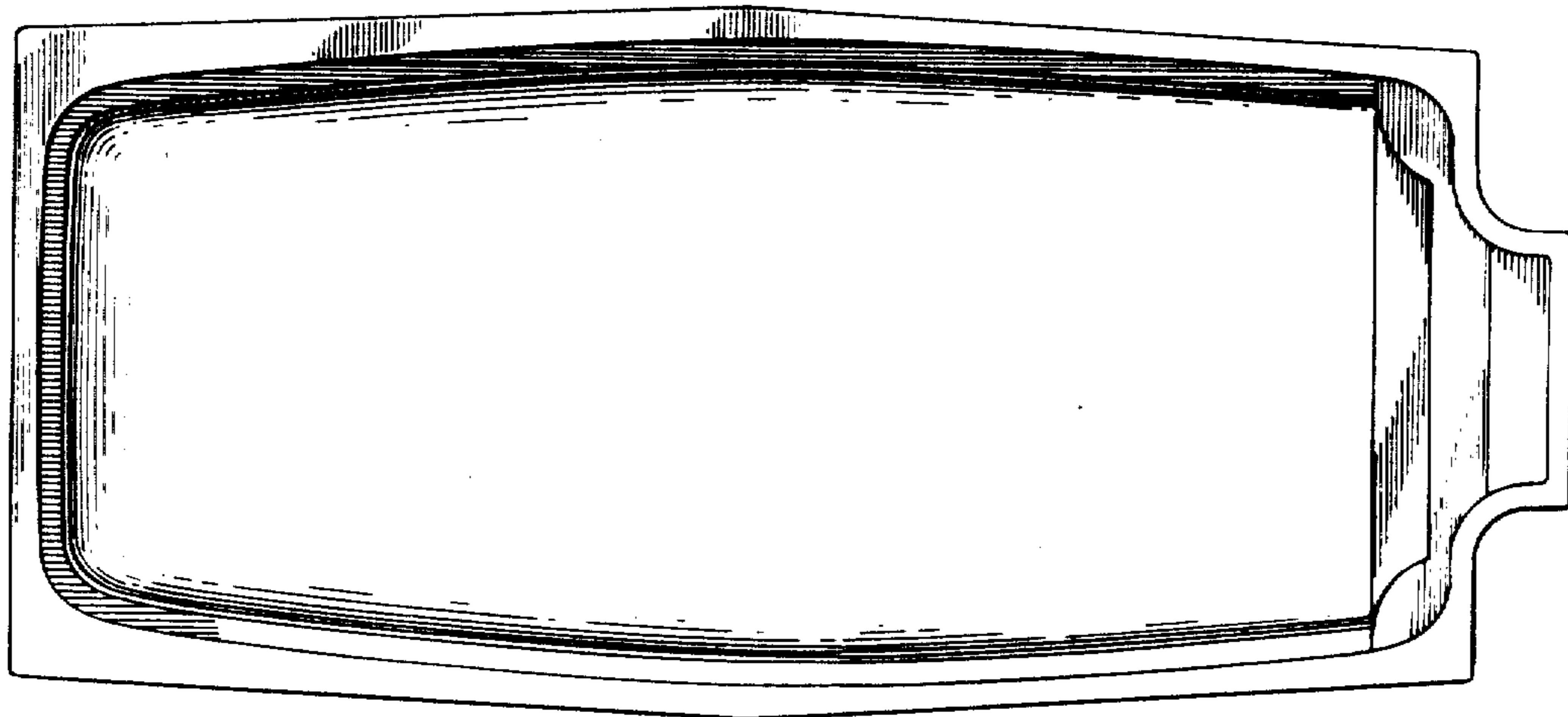

FIG. 1 is a top view of the swimming pool;
FIG. 2 is a longitudinal section of the same;

FIG. 4 is a cross-section through line 4—4 of FIG. 2.



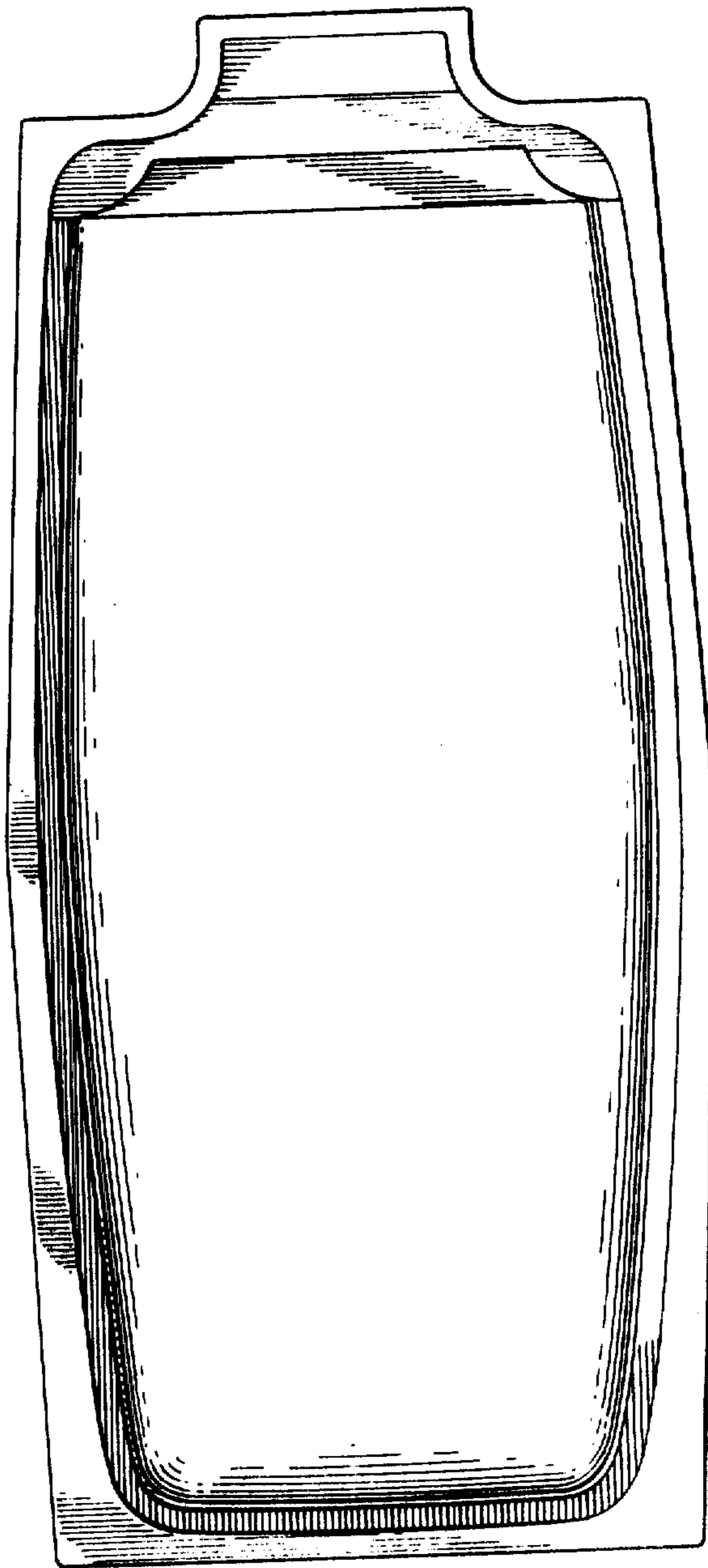
