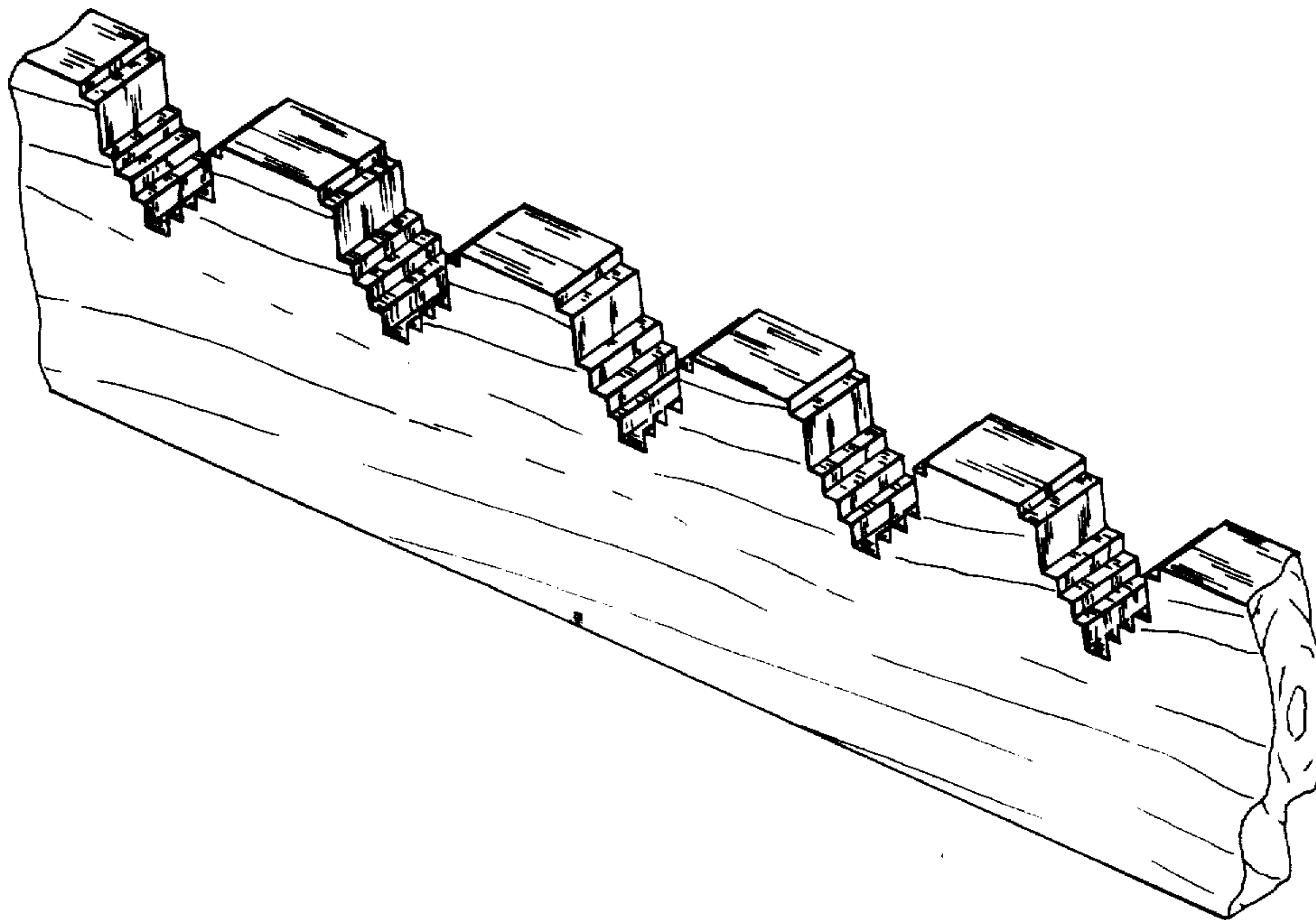

The undisclosed rear is a mirror image of the front view.



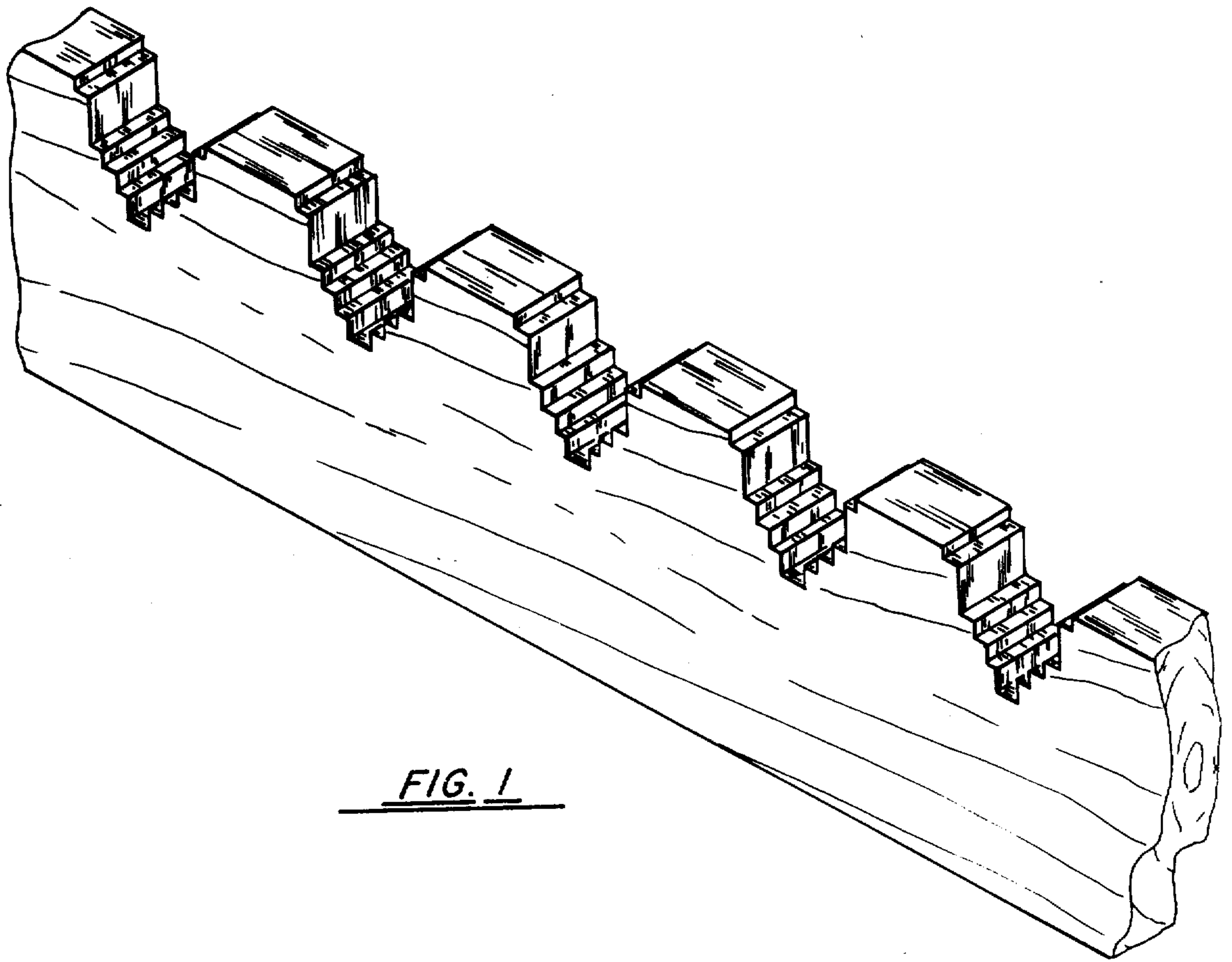

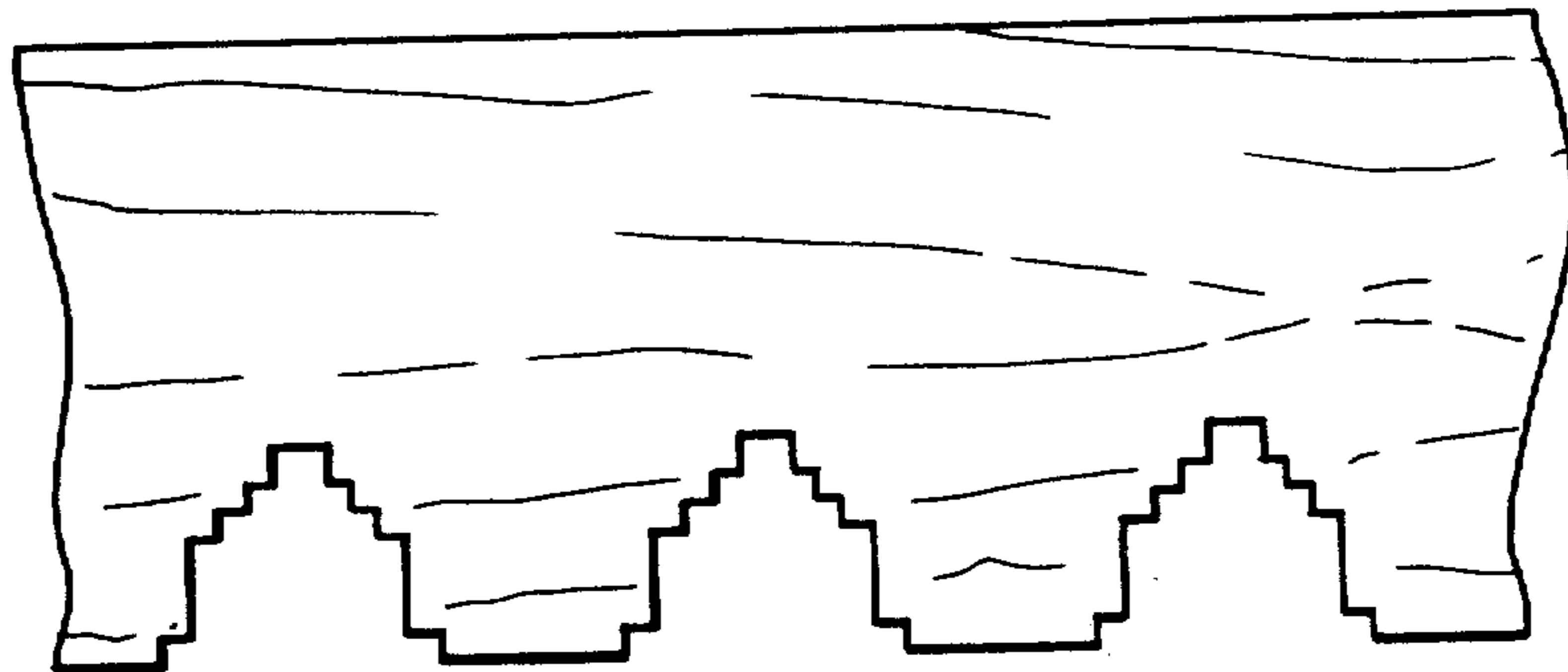
