[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a packaging container for a doll, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a packaging container for a doll showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view; and

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The broken line showing of a doll is for the purpose of showing environmental use only.

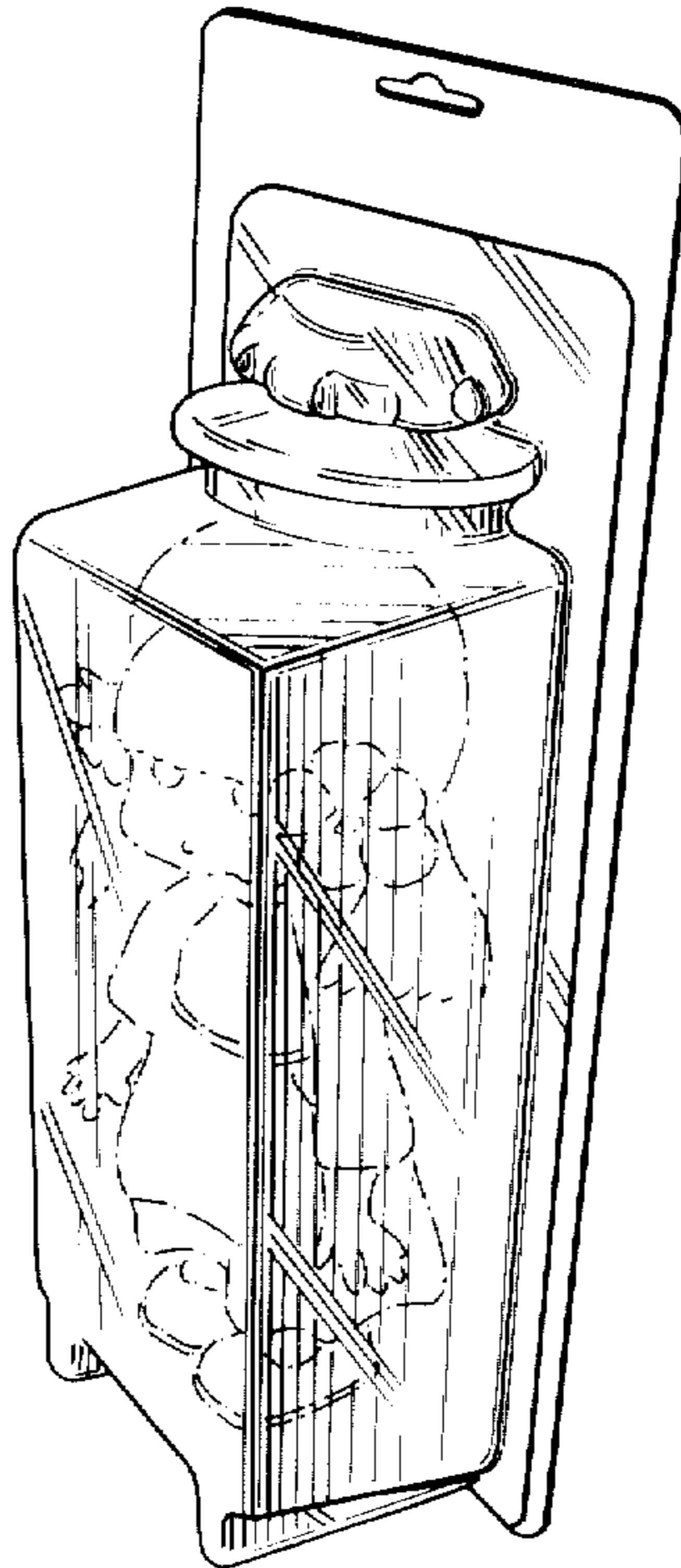

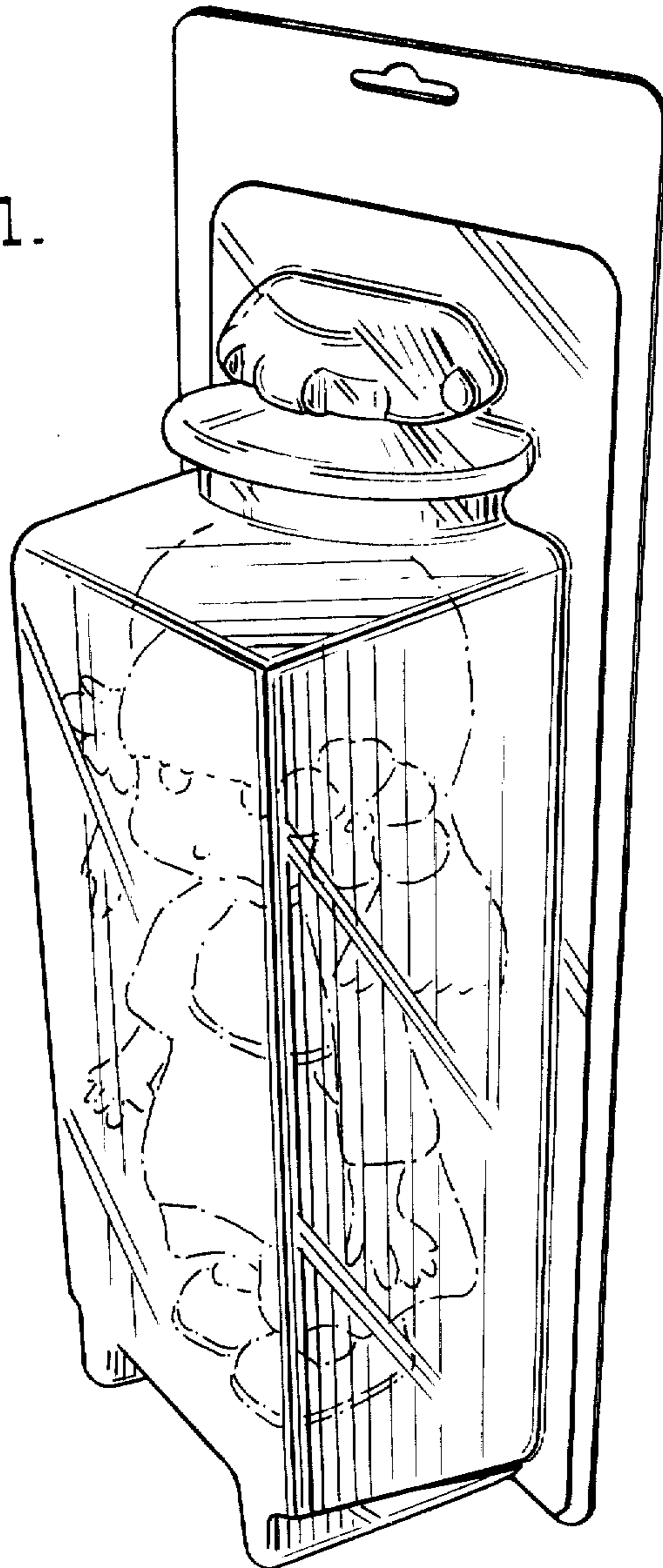

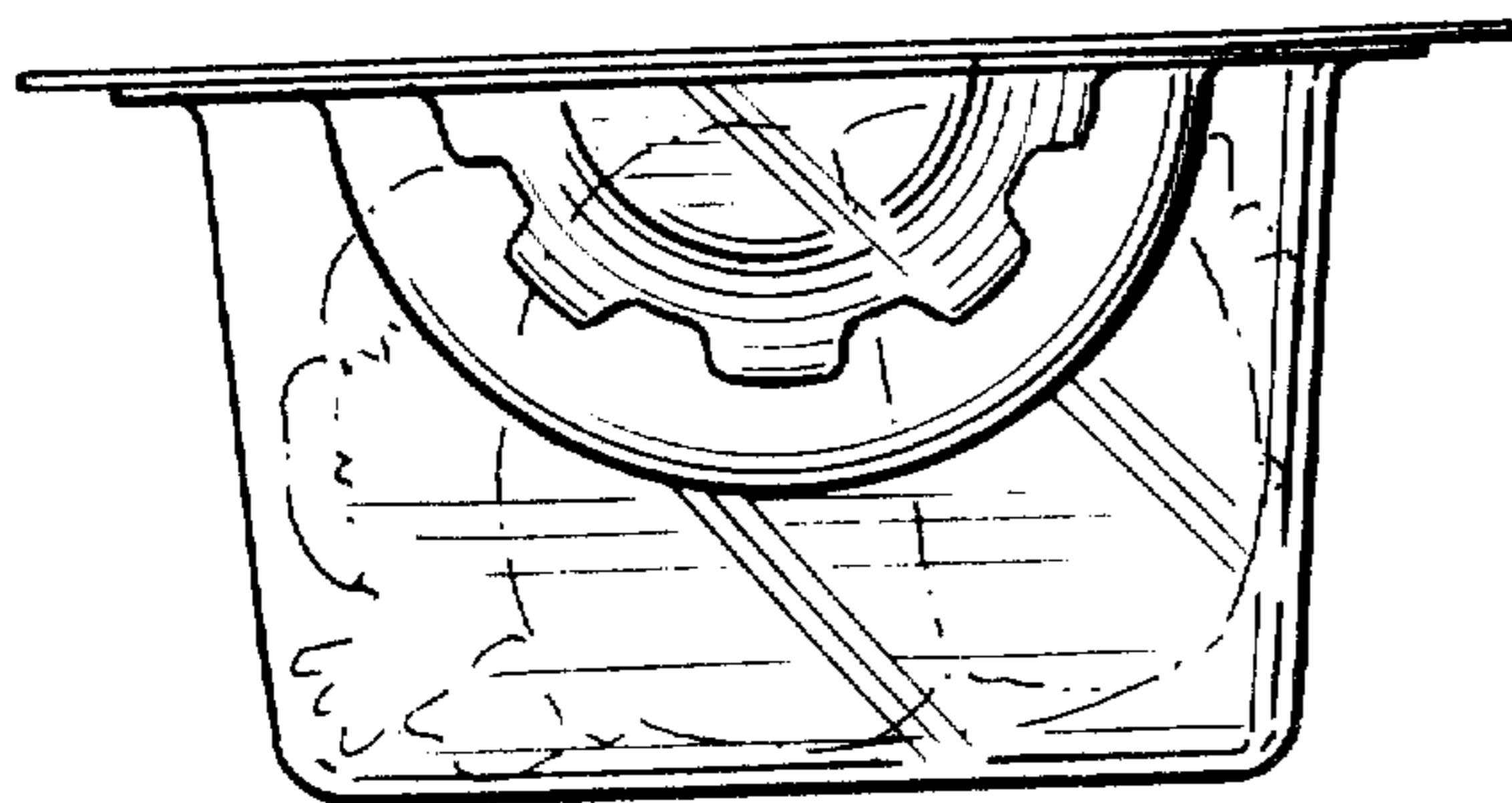

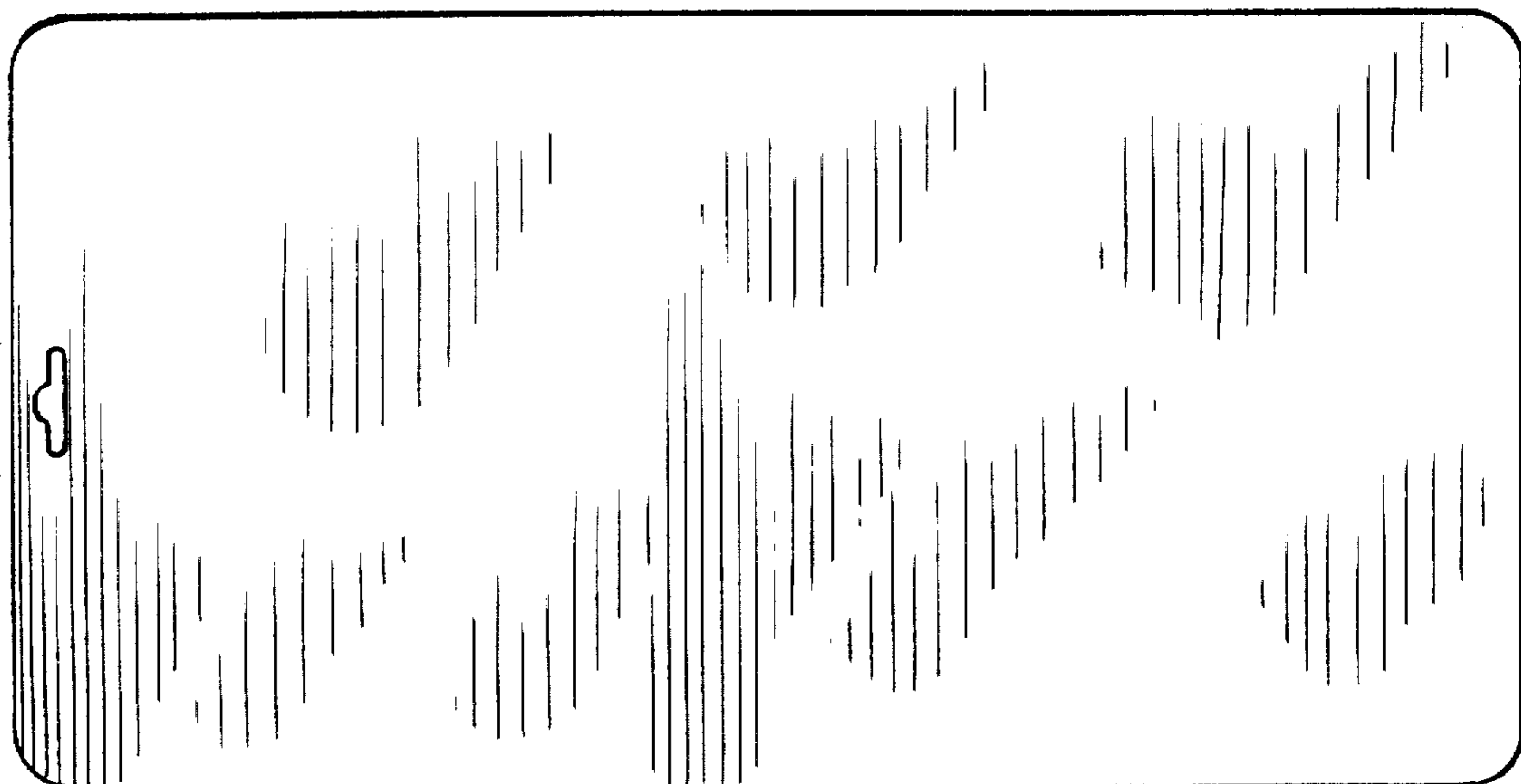

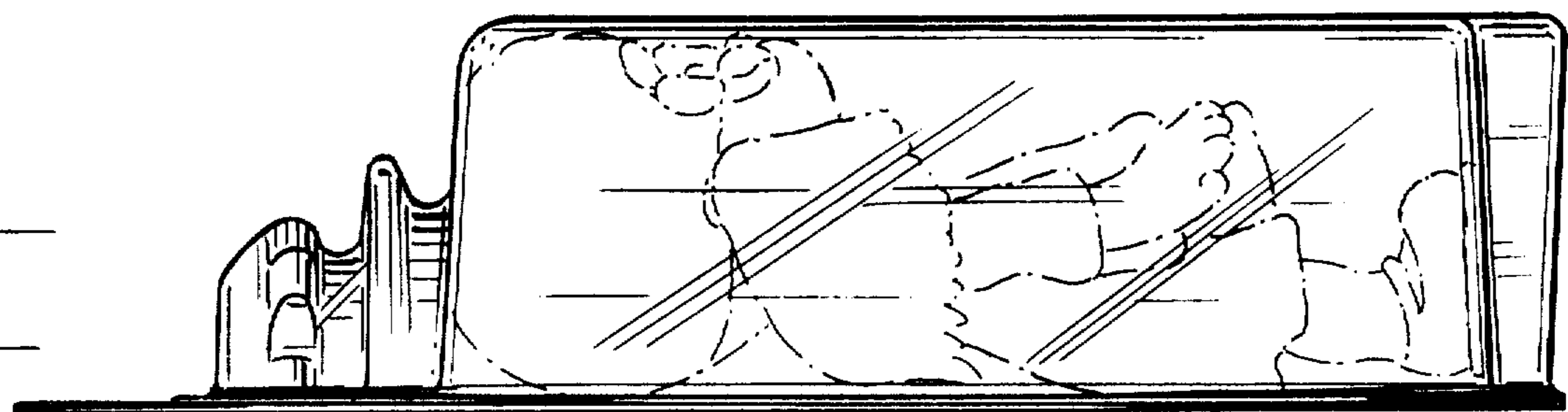
