**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a belt ring showing my new design, the broken line showing of a hand being illustrative of environment.

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the belt ring with the belt end in view showing my new design.

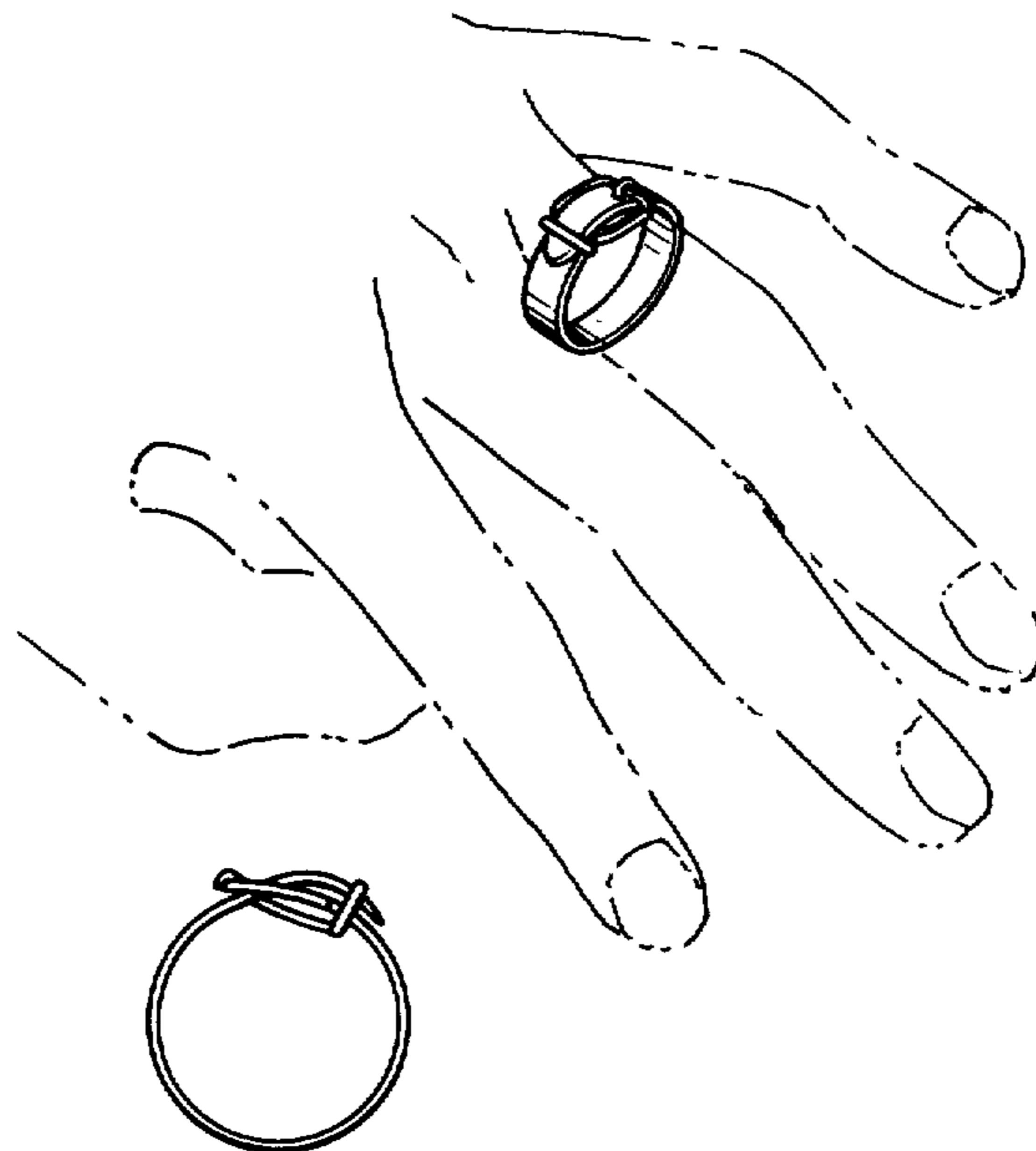
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the belt ring embodying my new design.

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



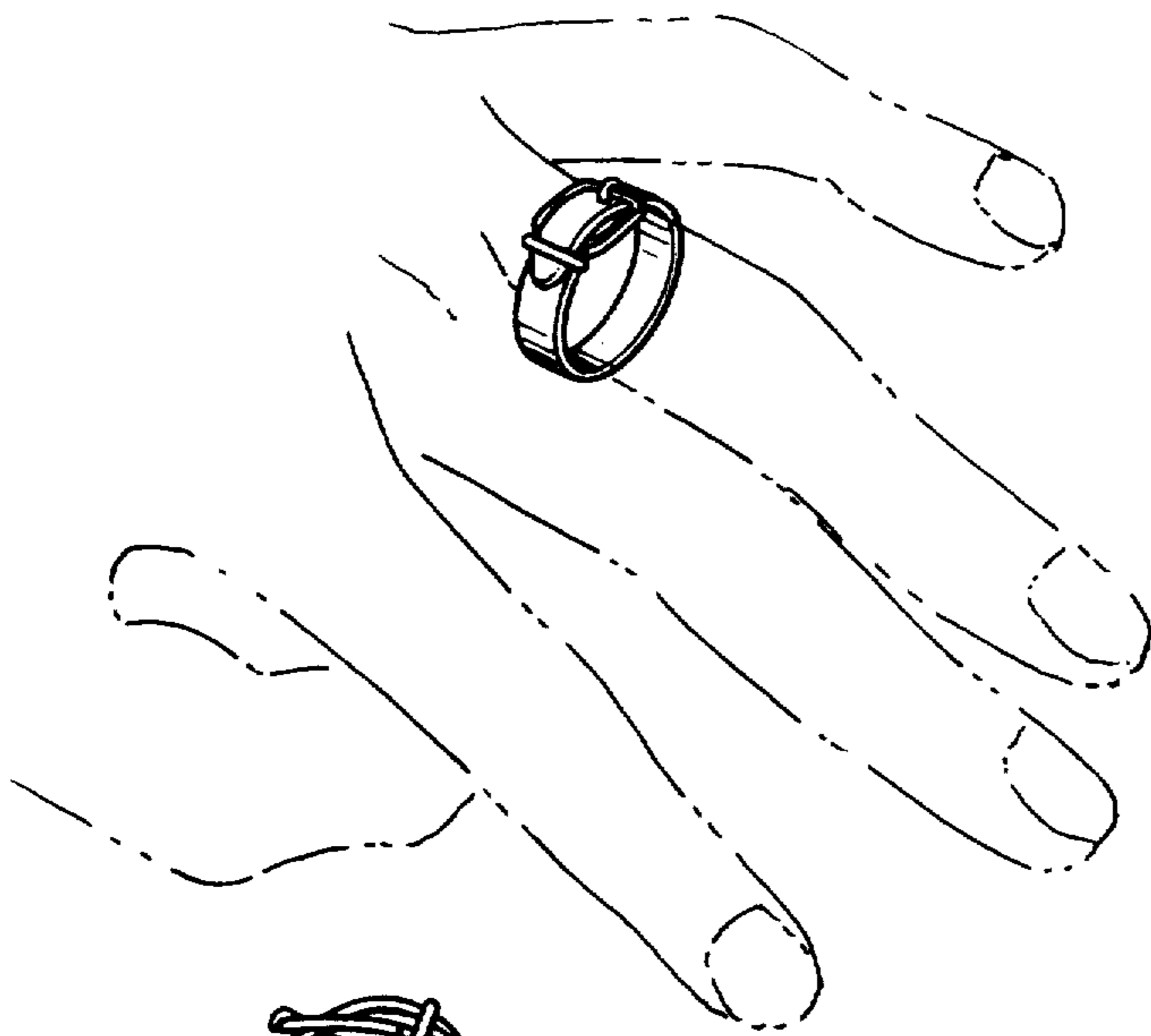

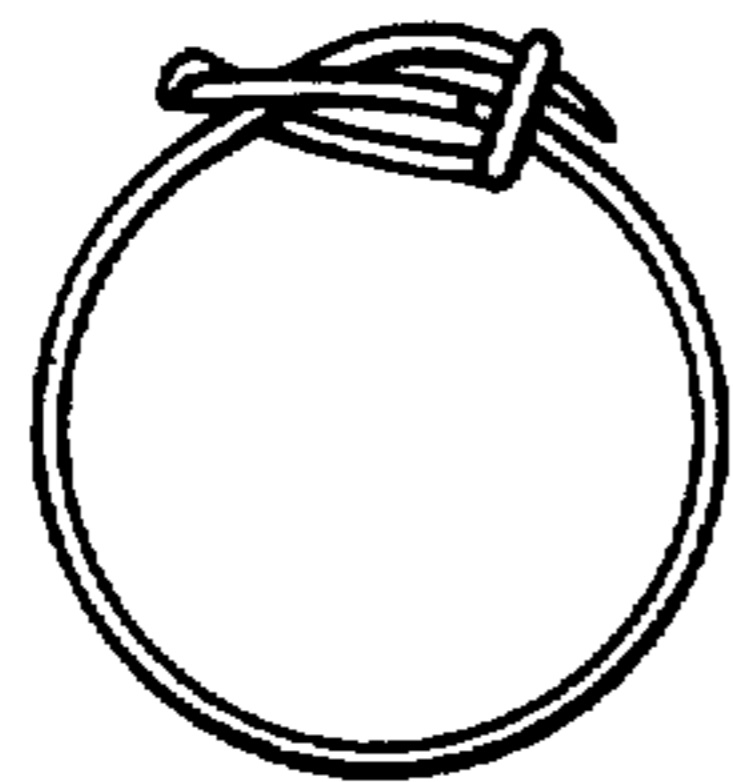

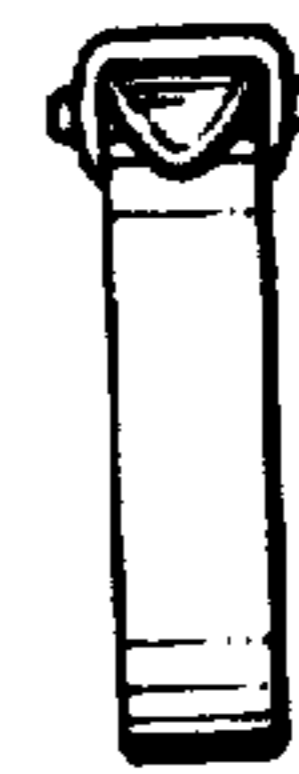

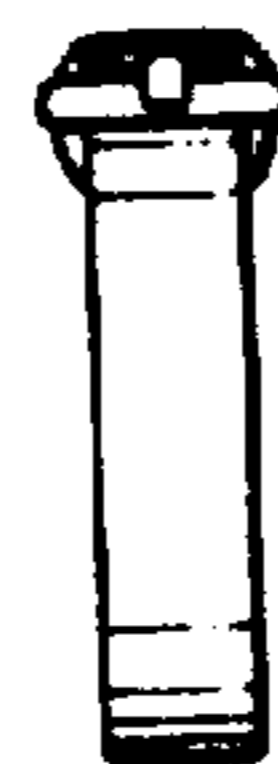

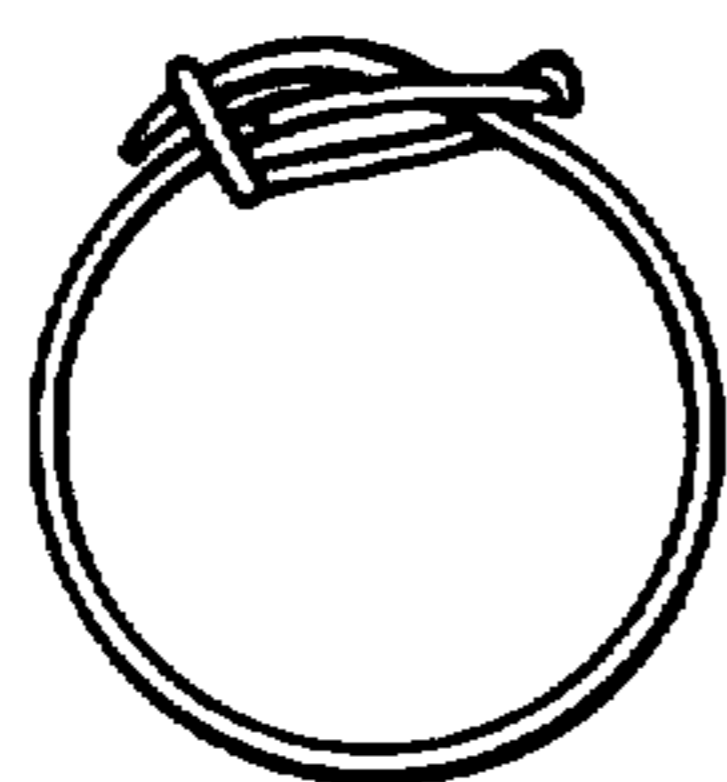

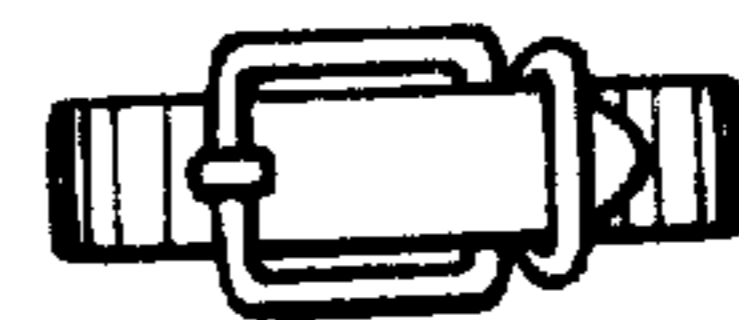
