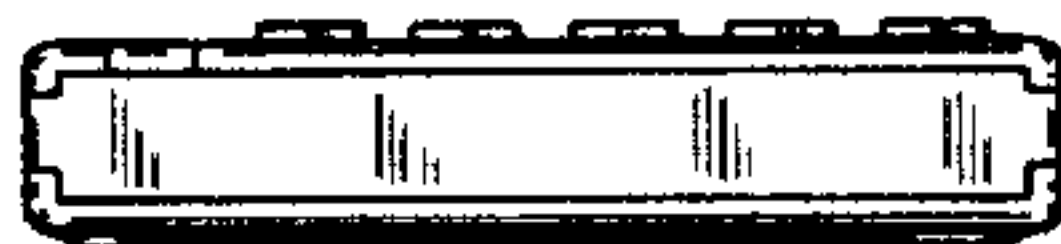
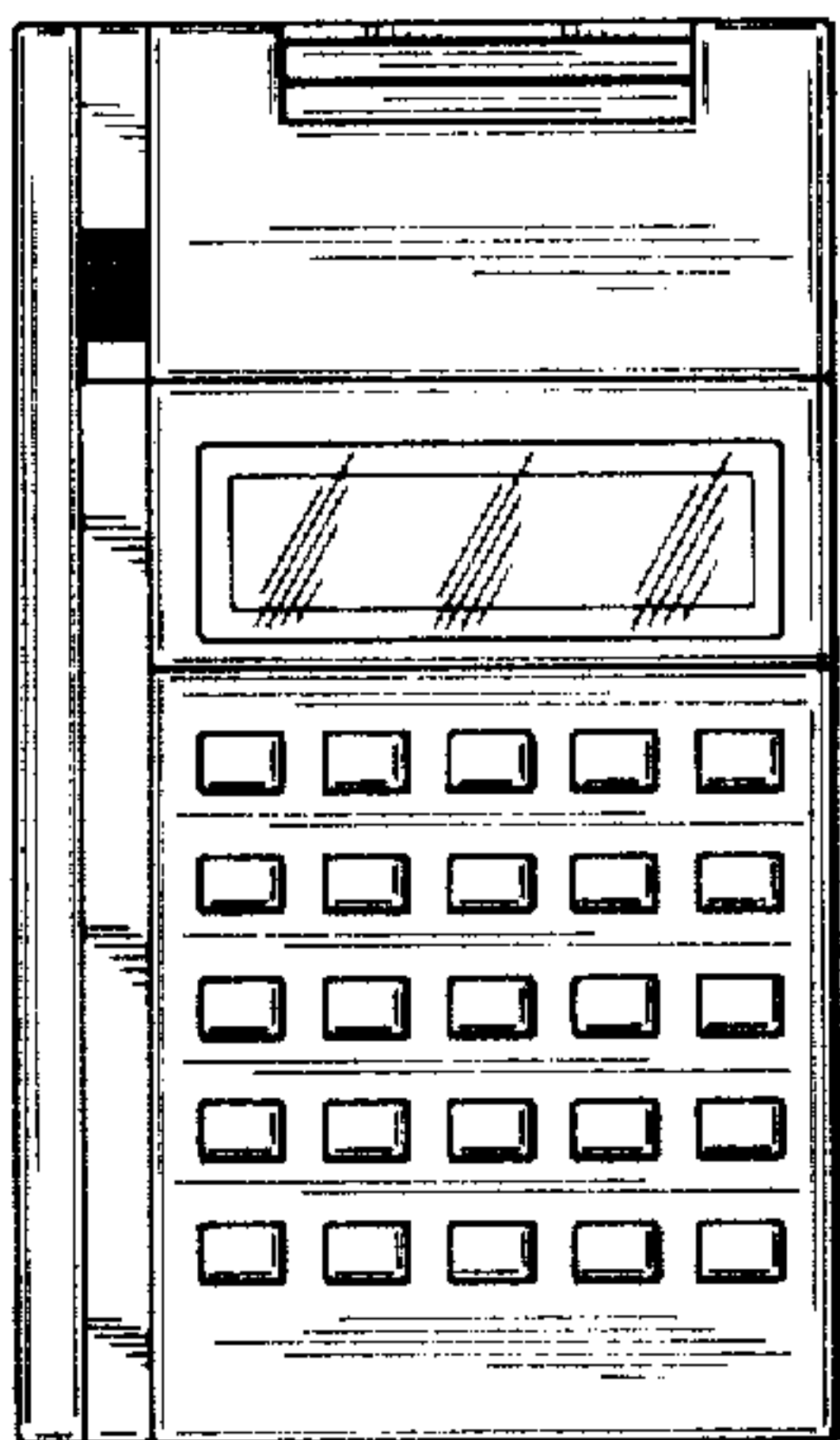

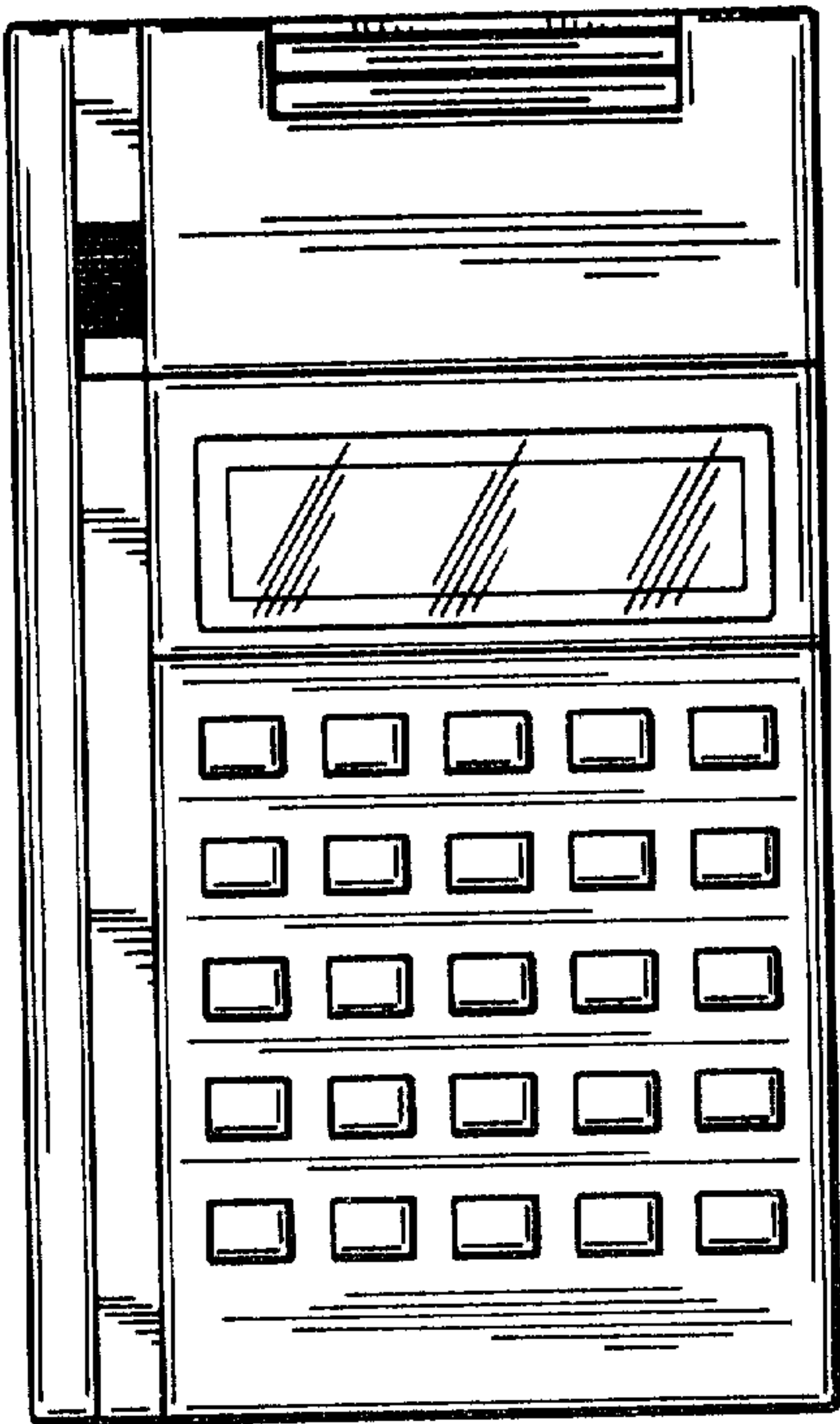

The ornamental design for an electronic calculator, as shown and described.

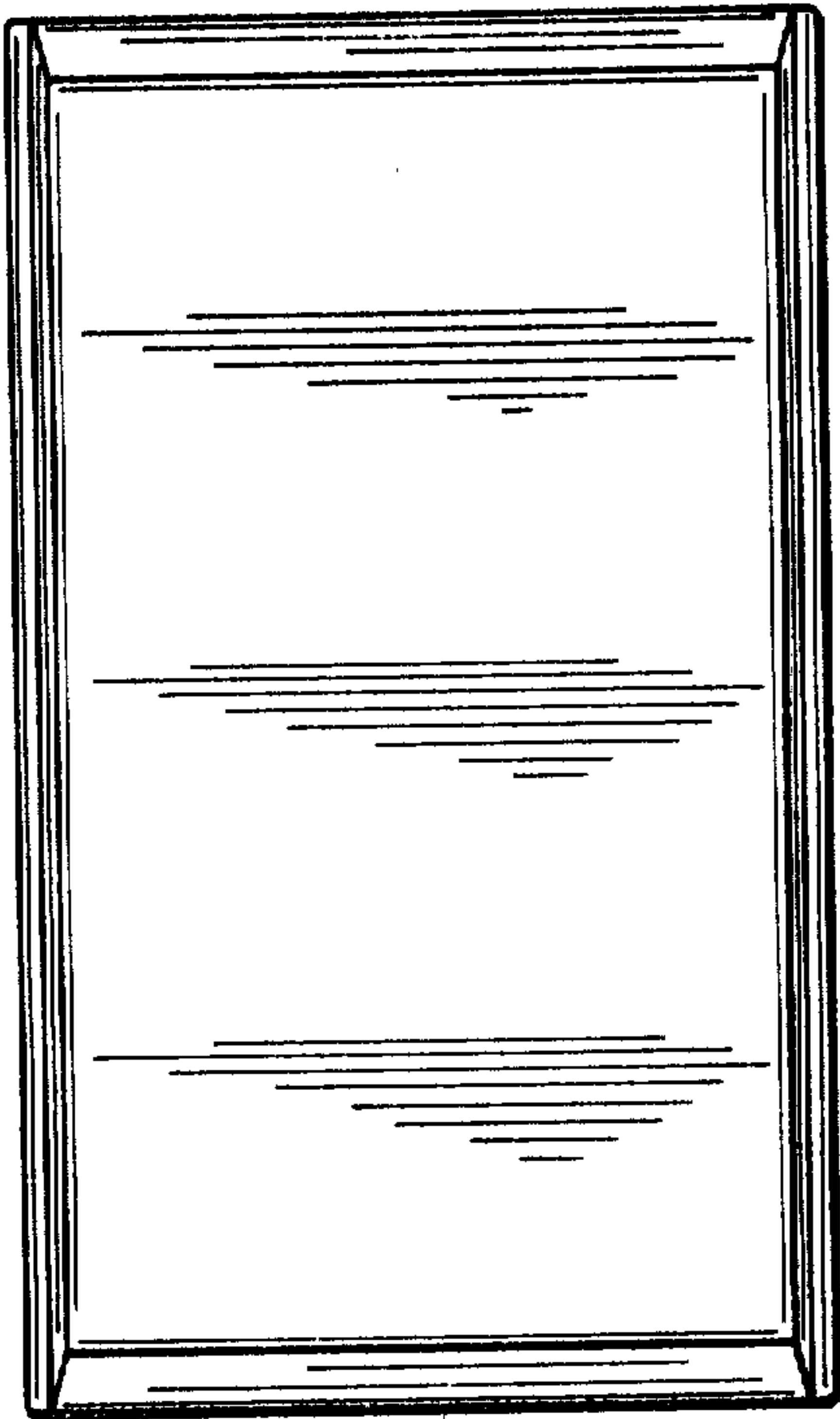
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof.

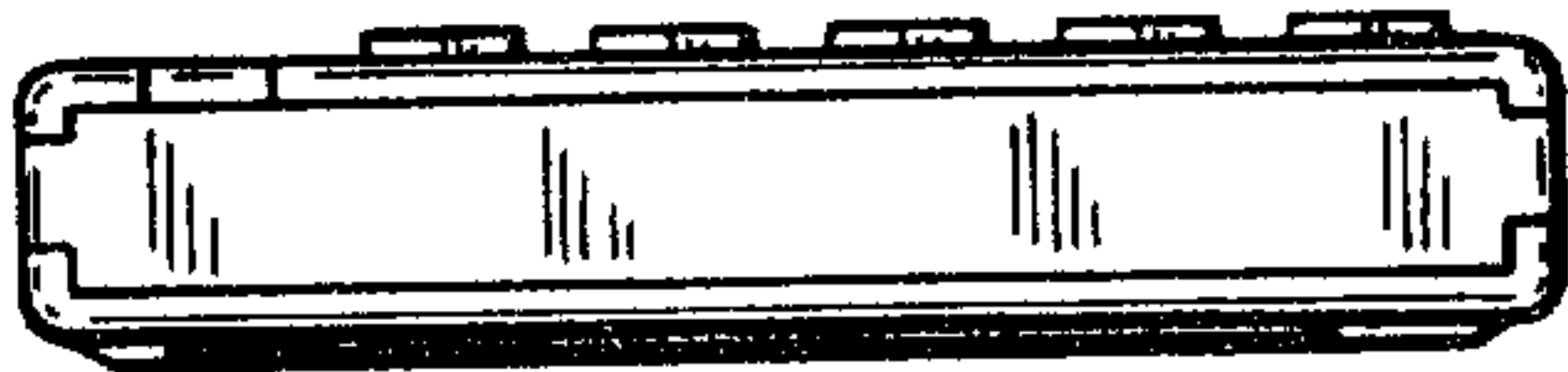




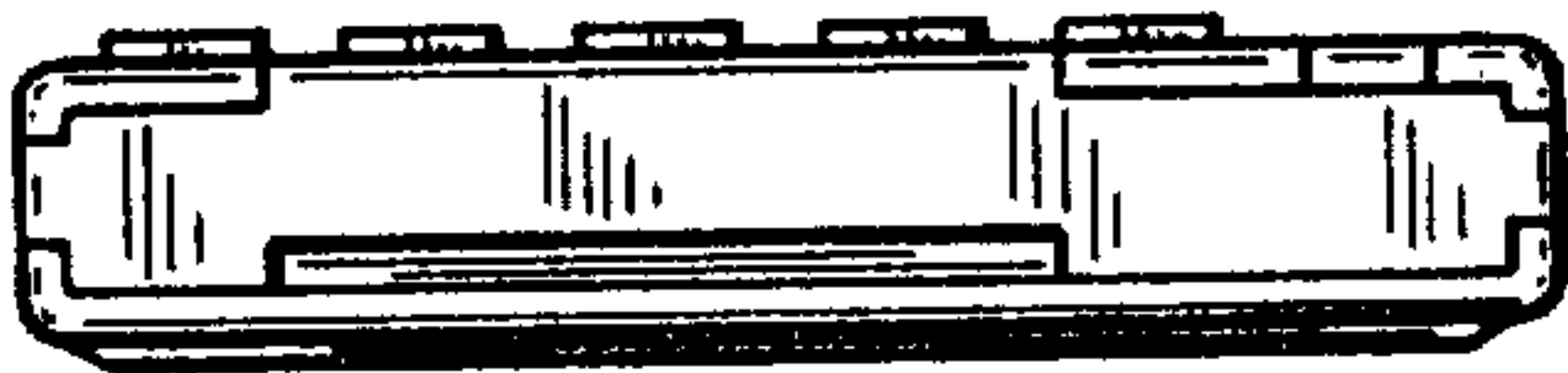

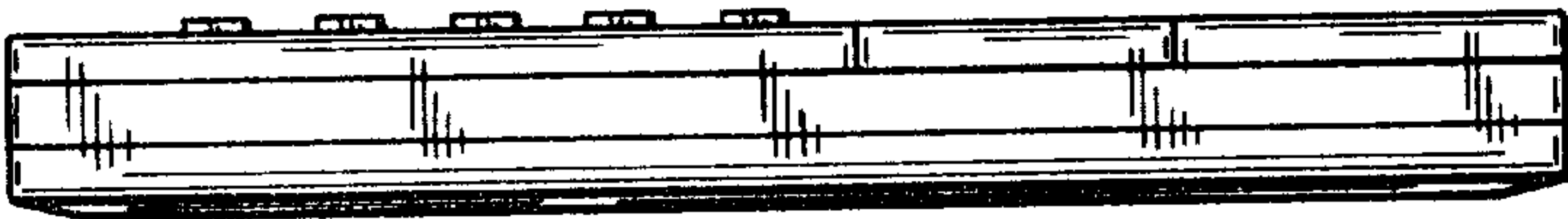
