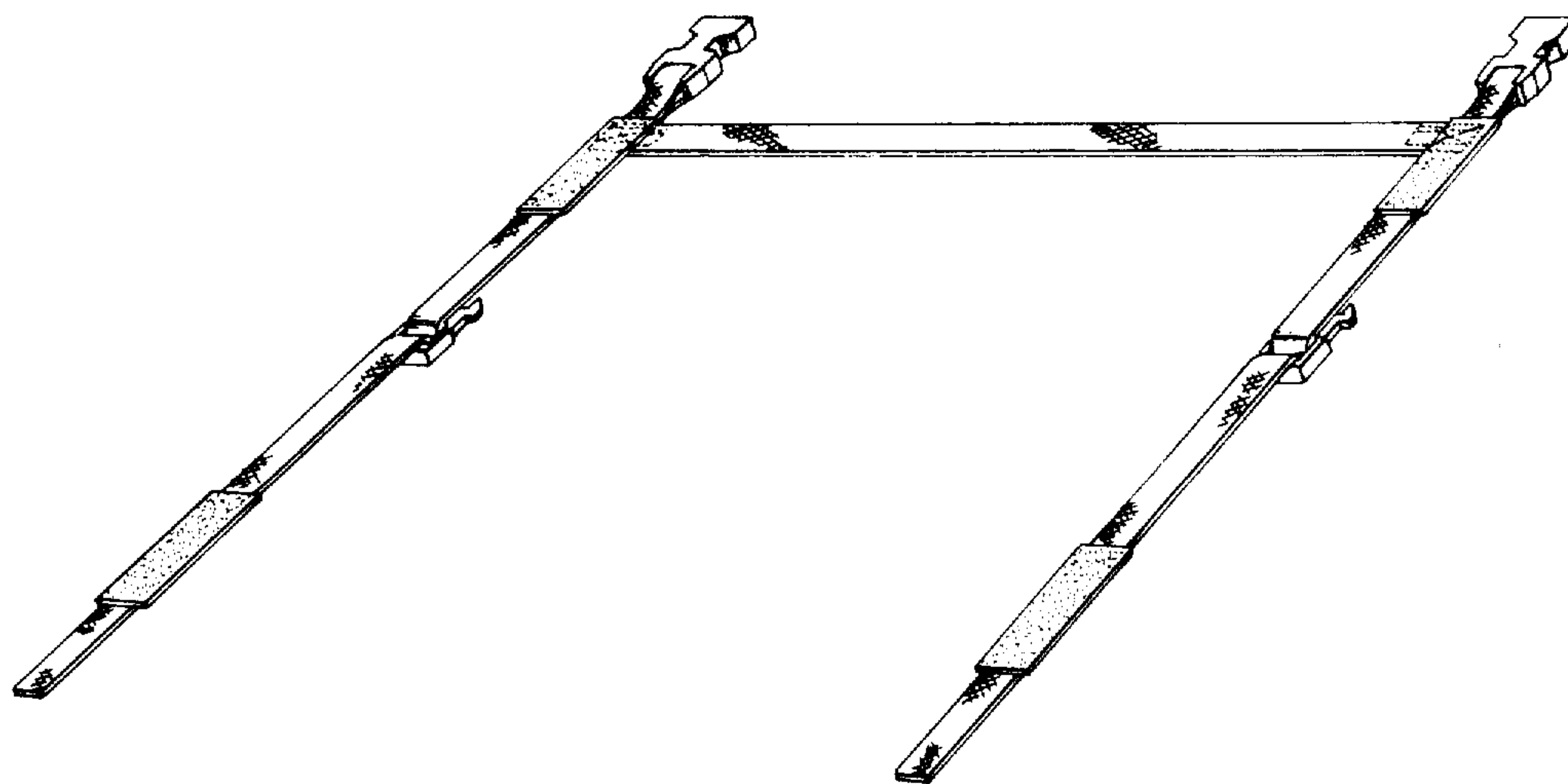

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a ski and ski pole carrier, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a ski and ski pole carrier showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, an intermediate portion of the connecting strap being broken away and omitted for convenience of illustration;
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 2; and
 FIG. 5 is an end elevational view thereof.



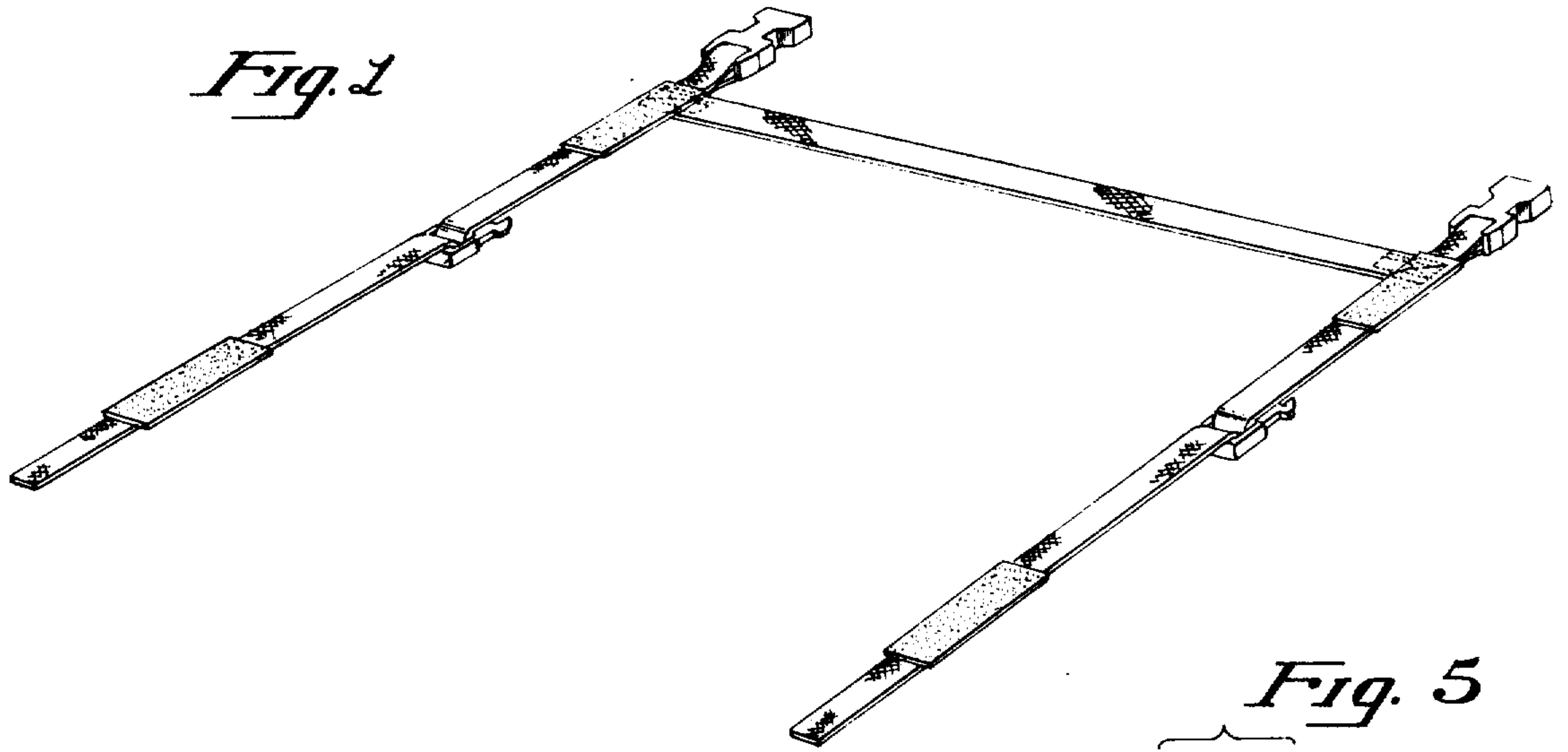

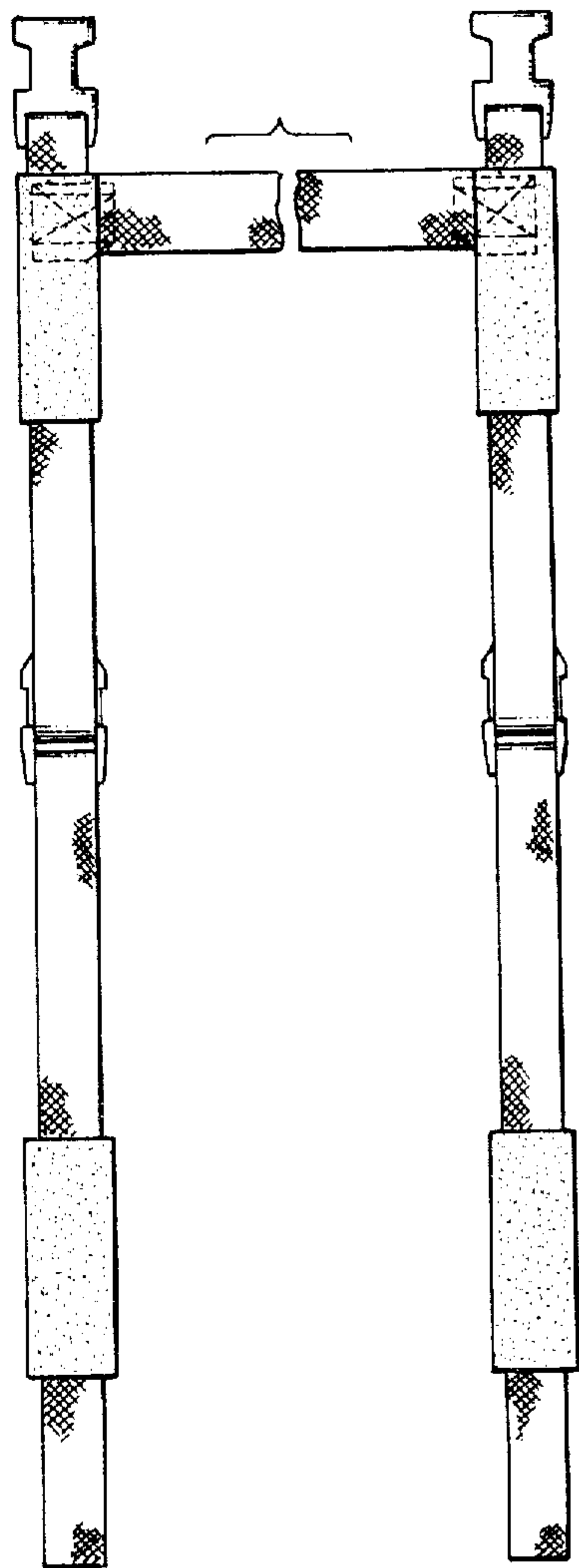

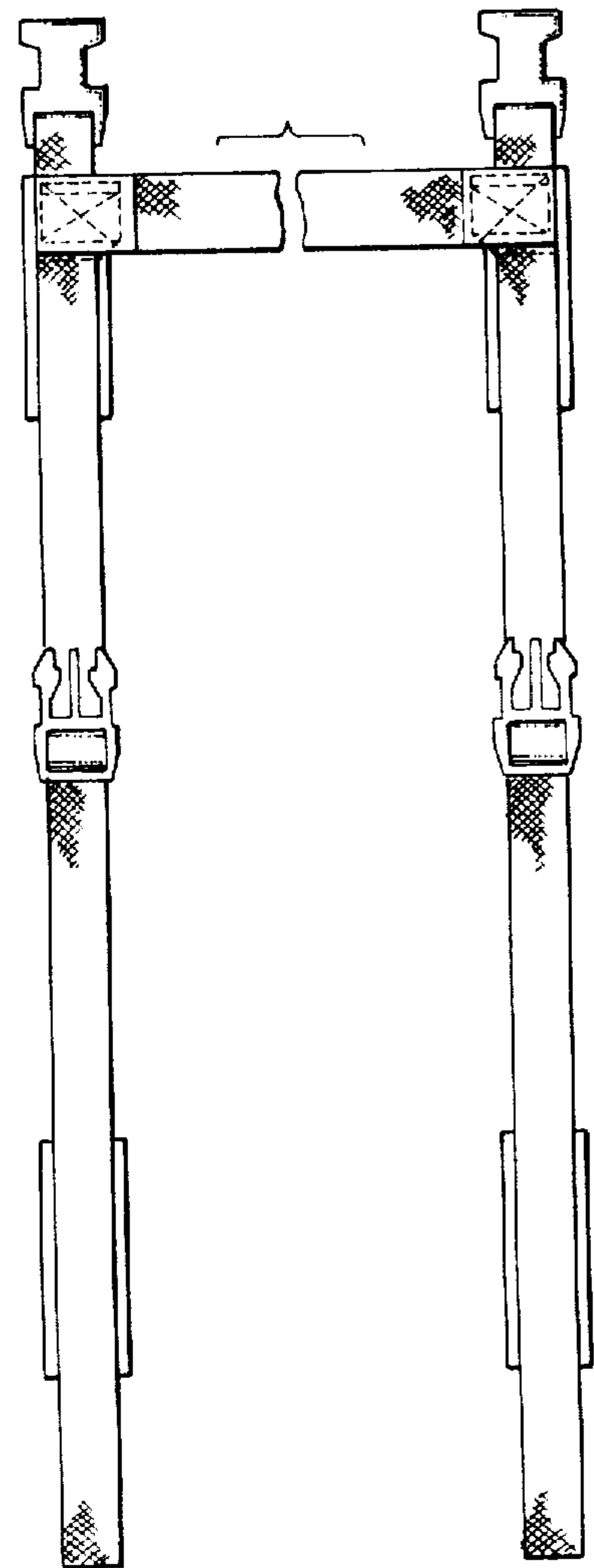
