FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof.

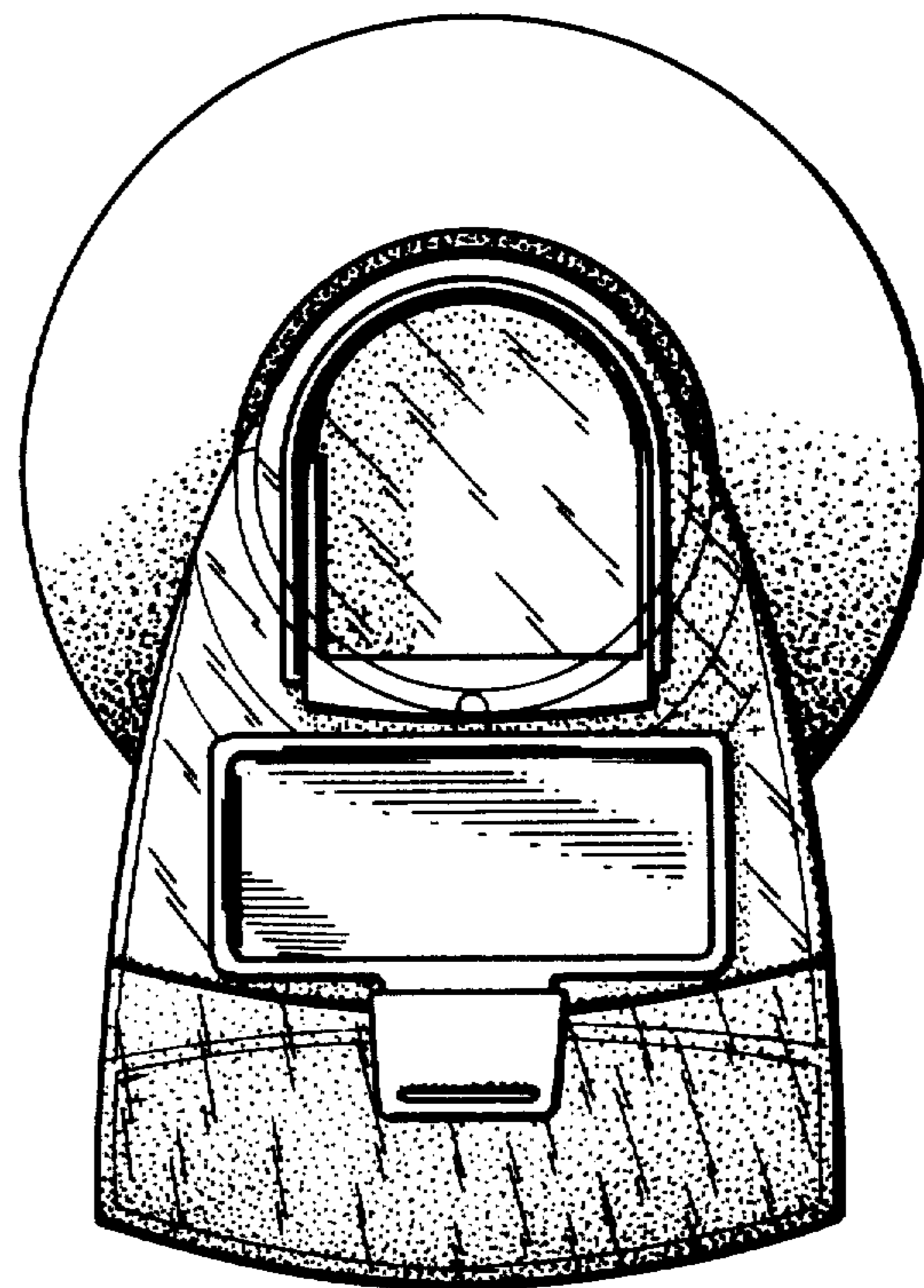
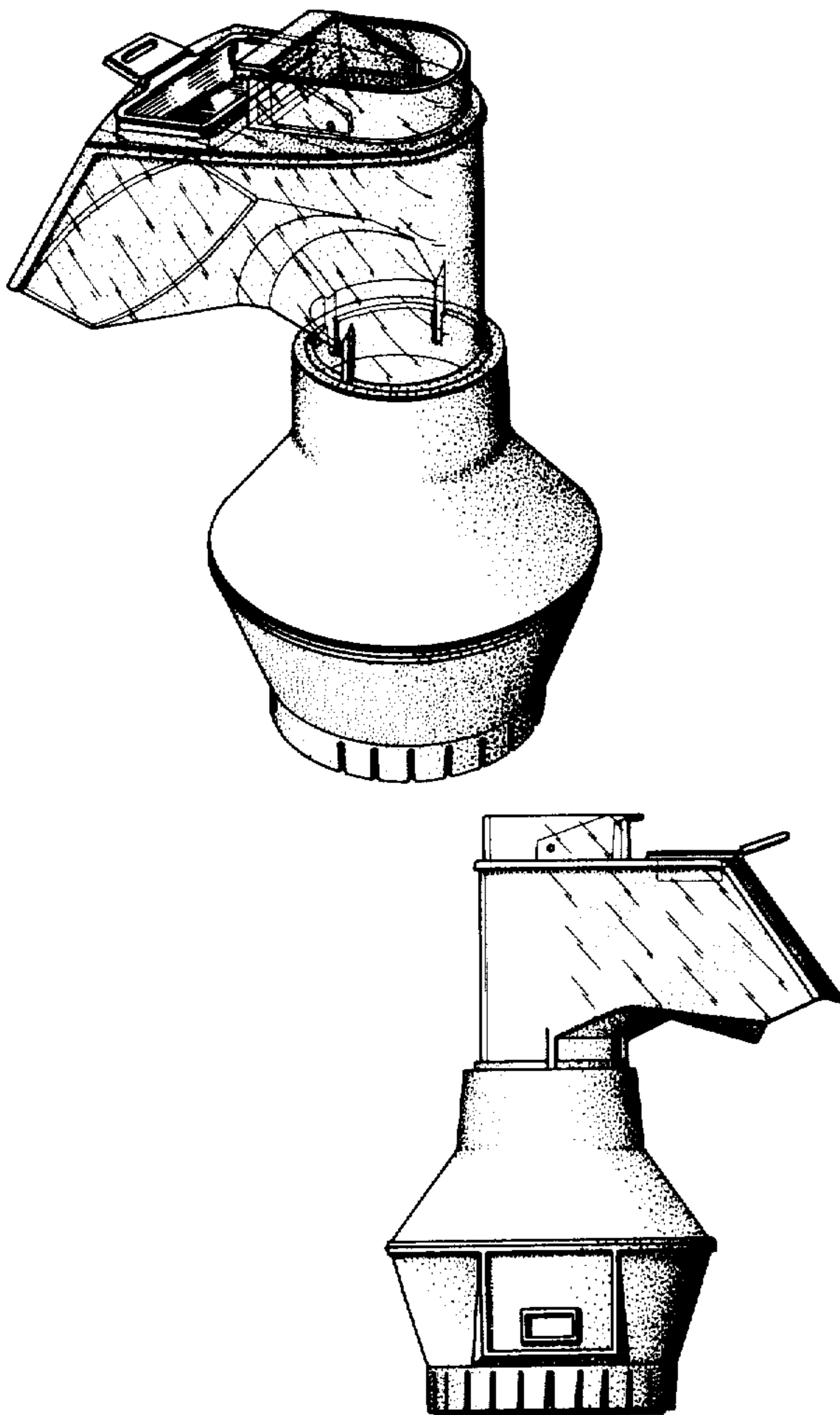
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



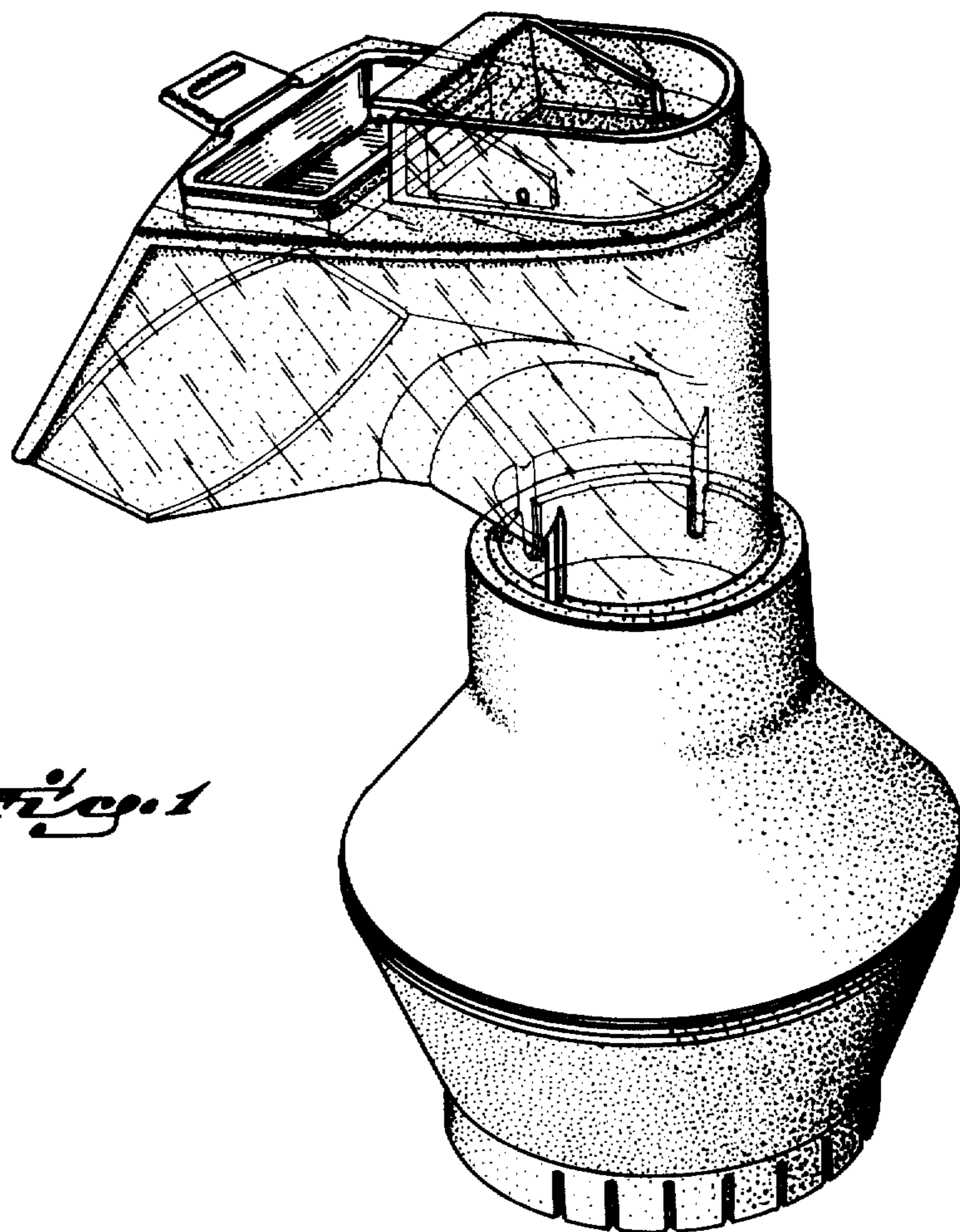

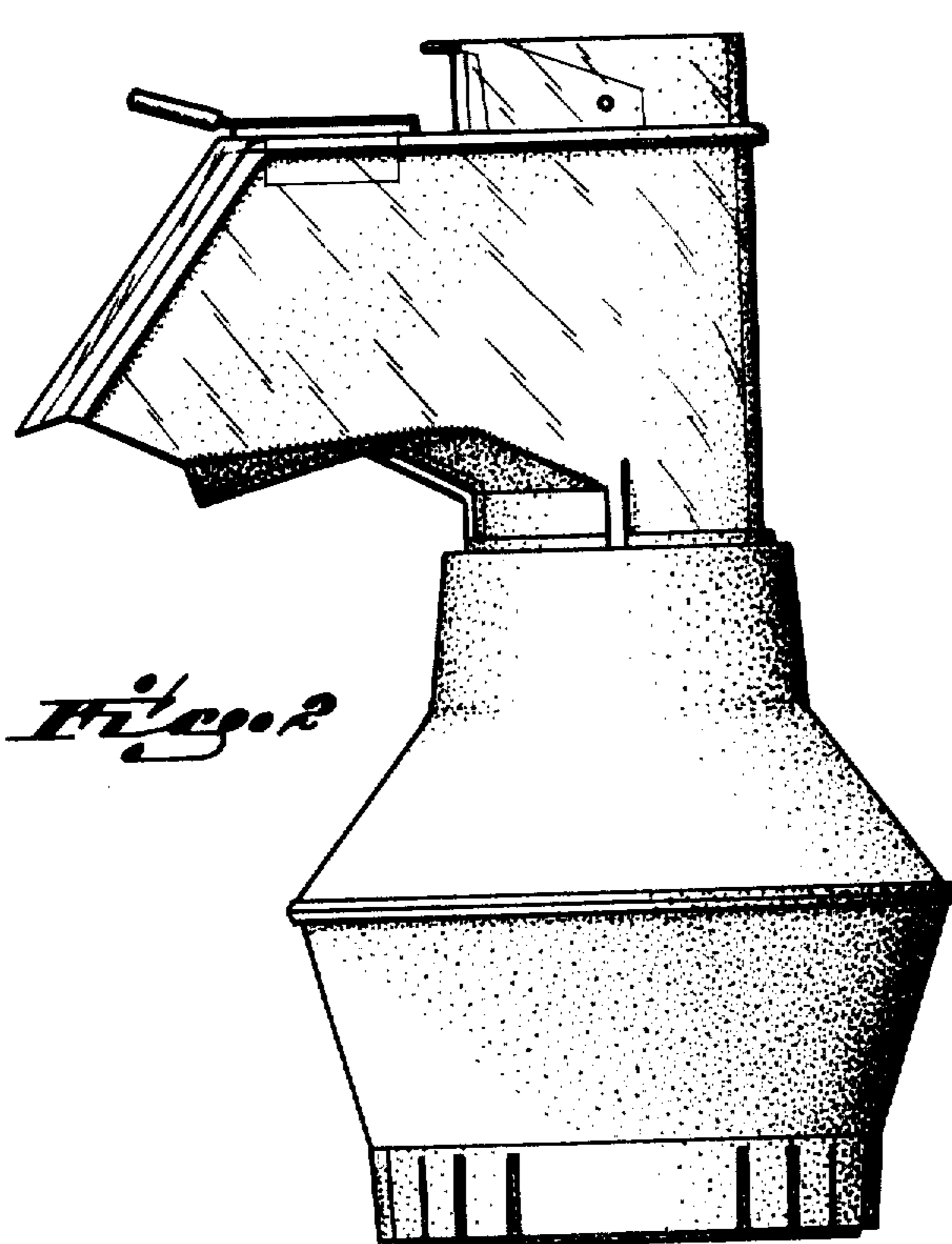

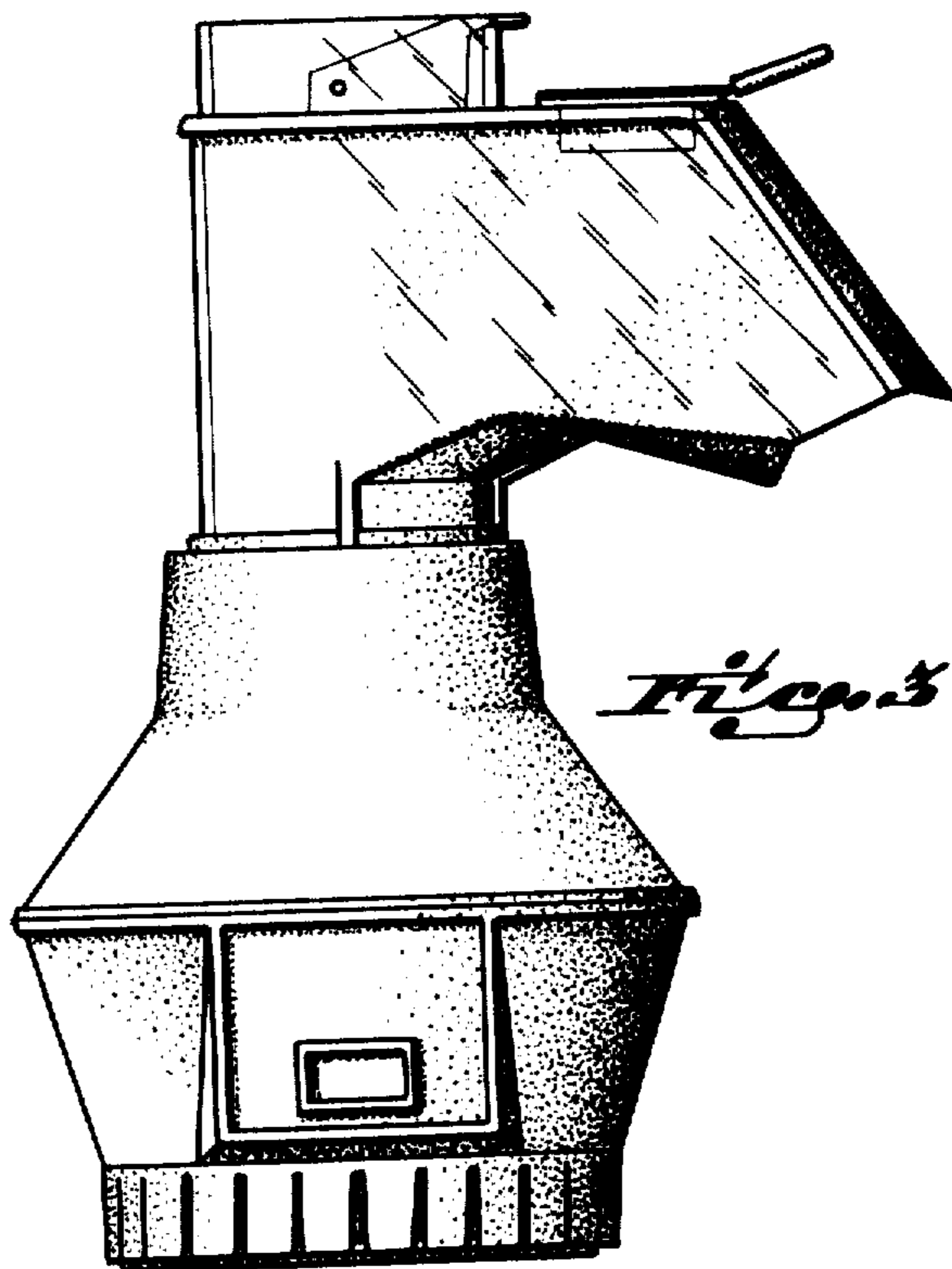

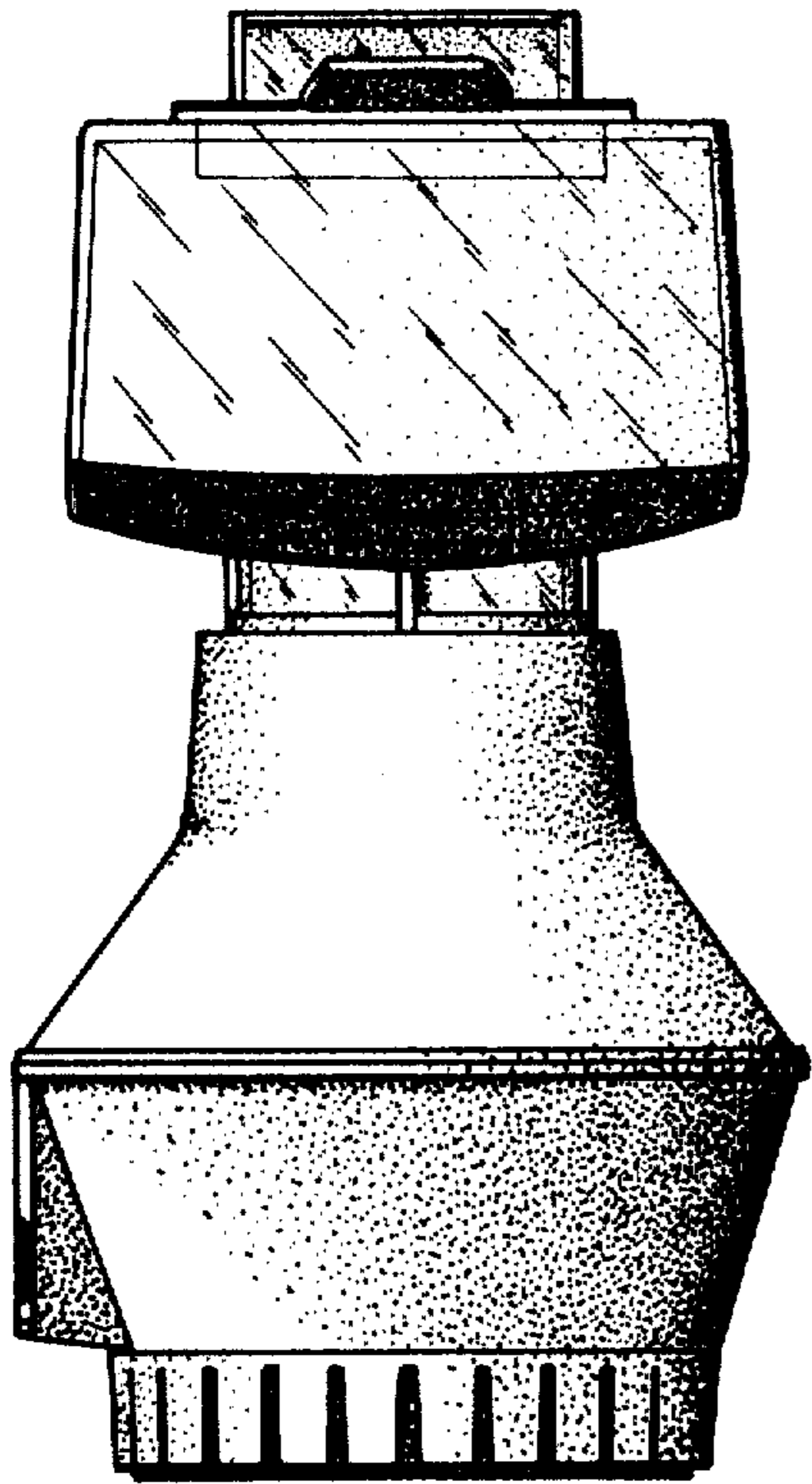

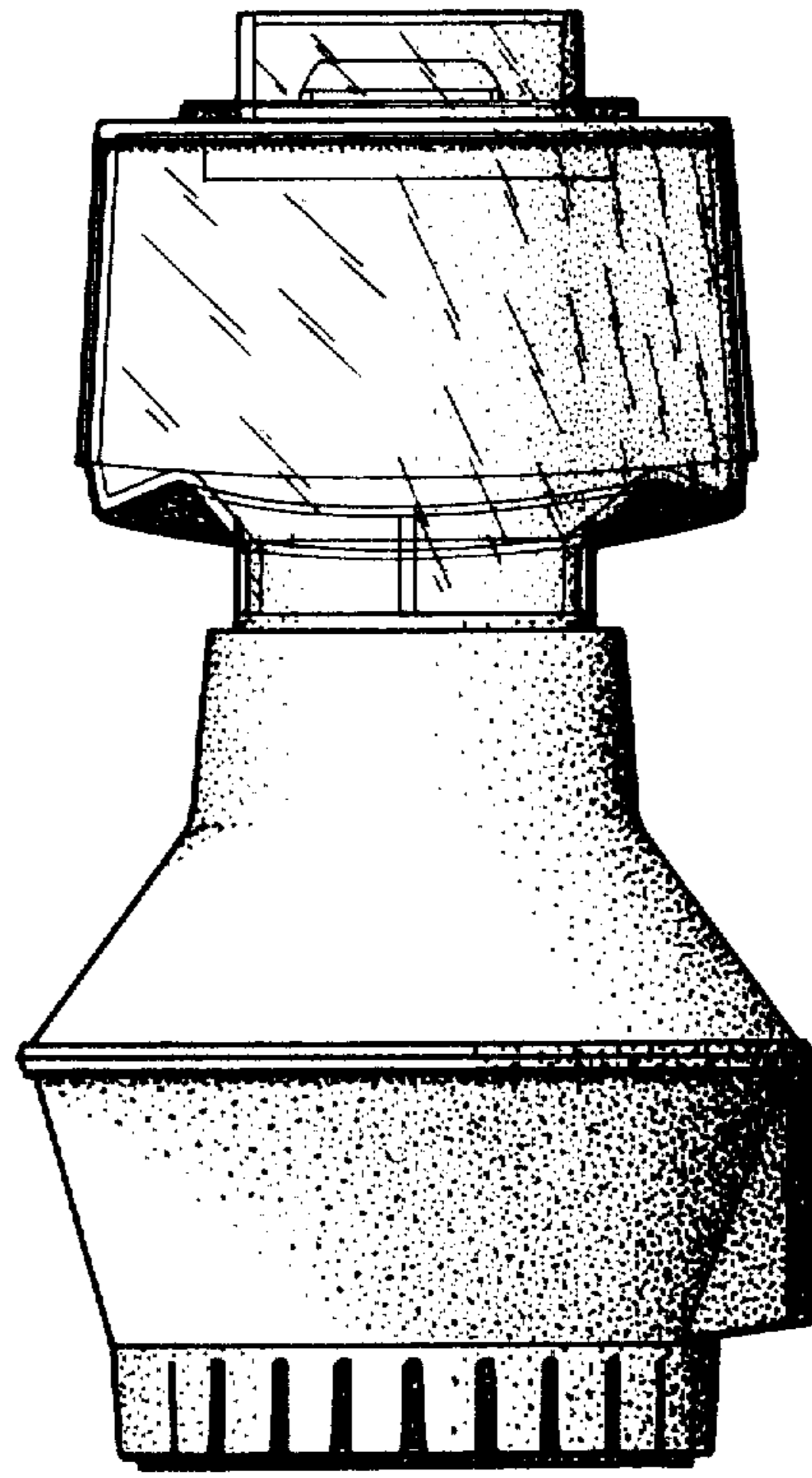

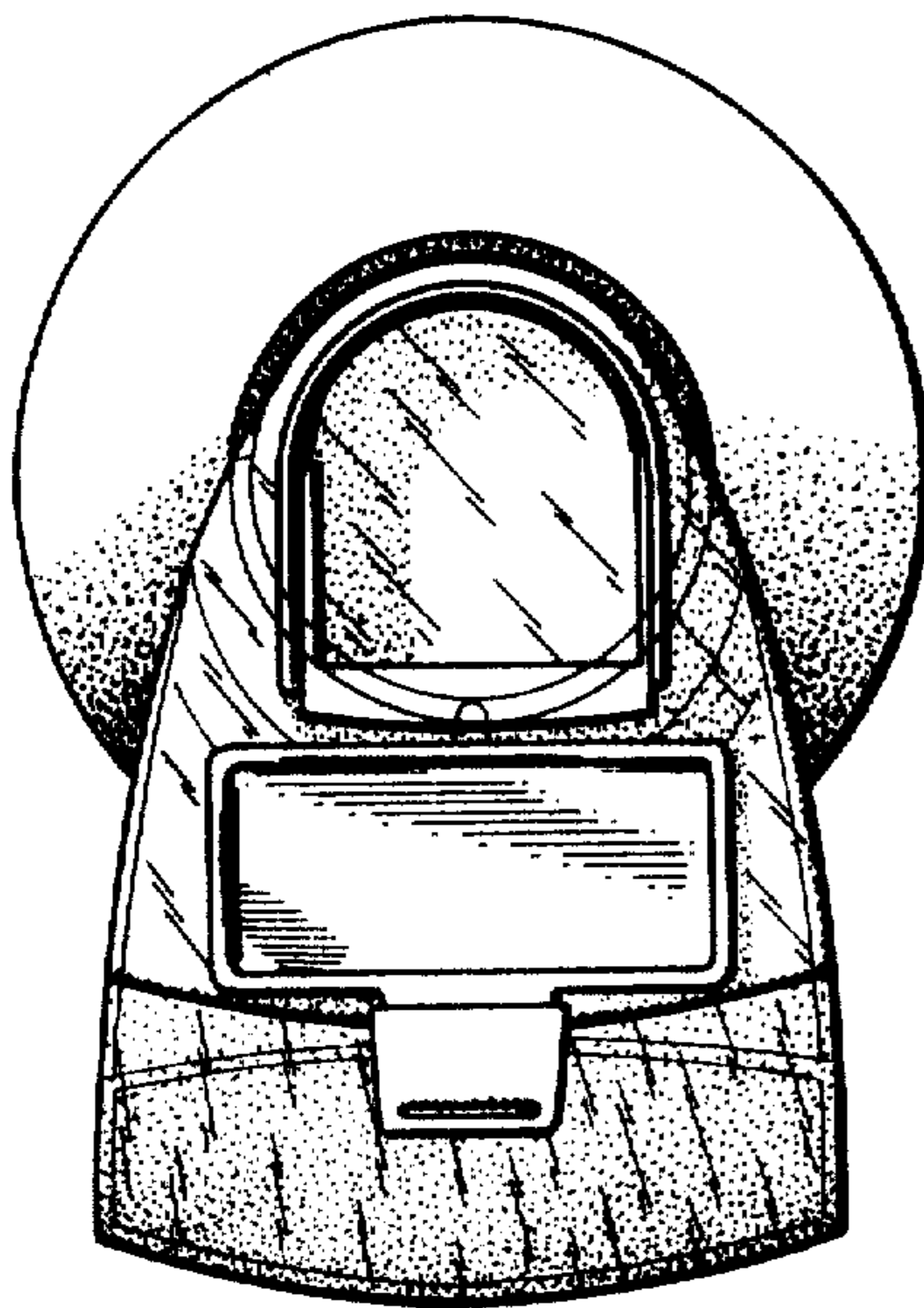

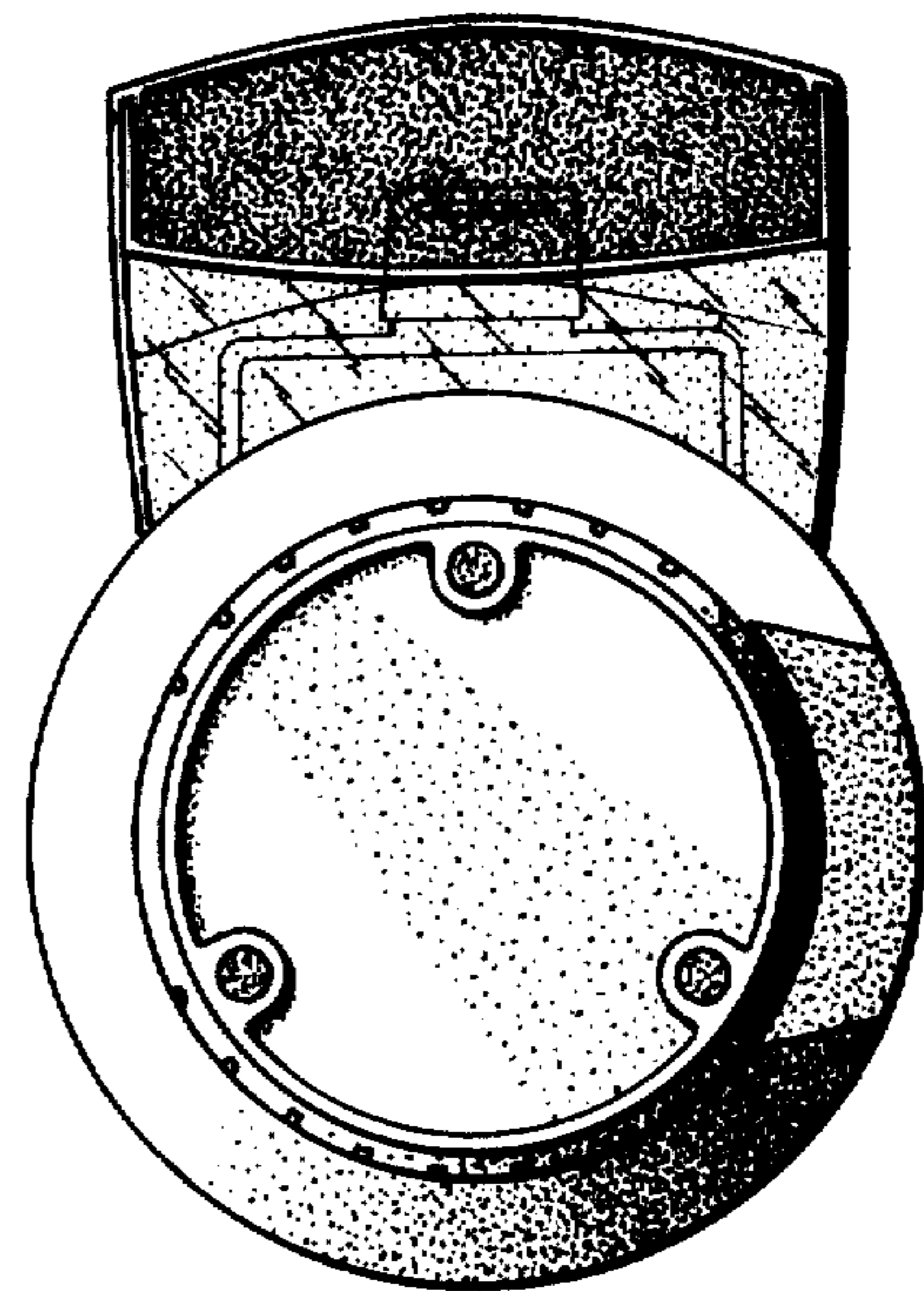
