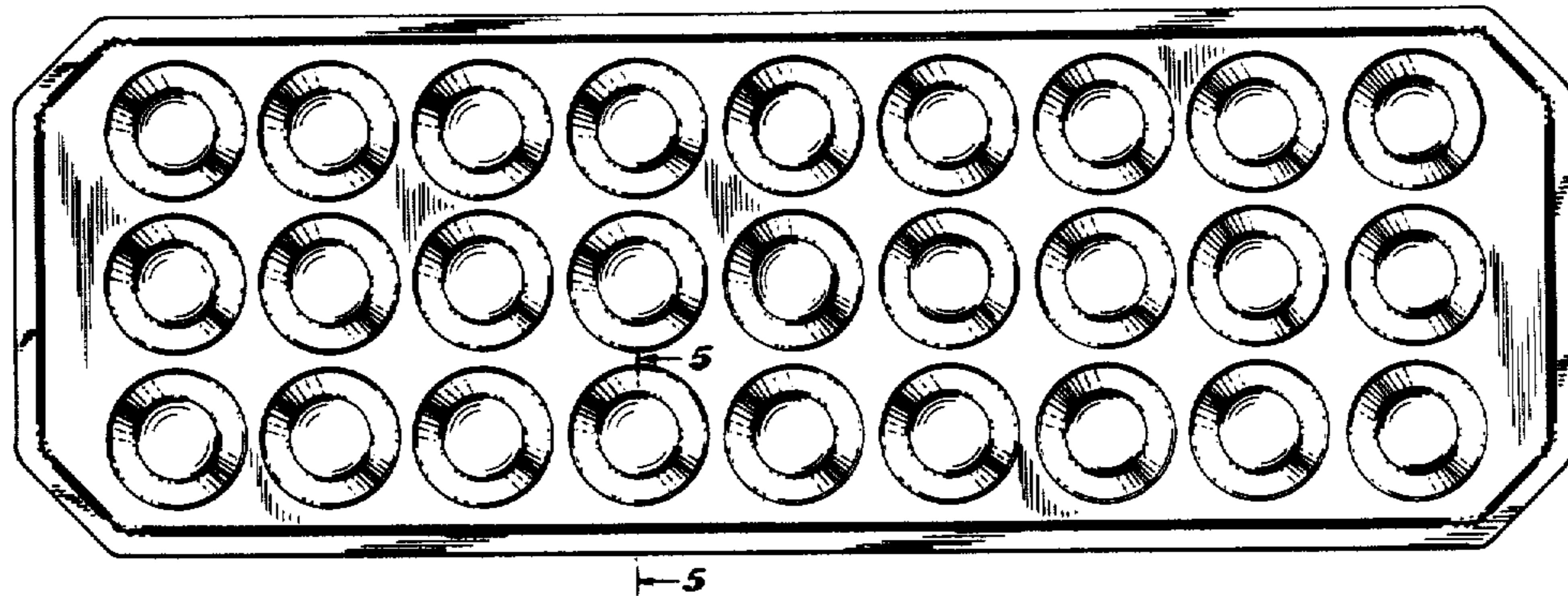

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a packaging tray for wire leads, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a packaging tray for wire leads showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view;  
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view; and  
FIG. 5 is an enlarged sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1 with wire leads being shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.



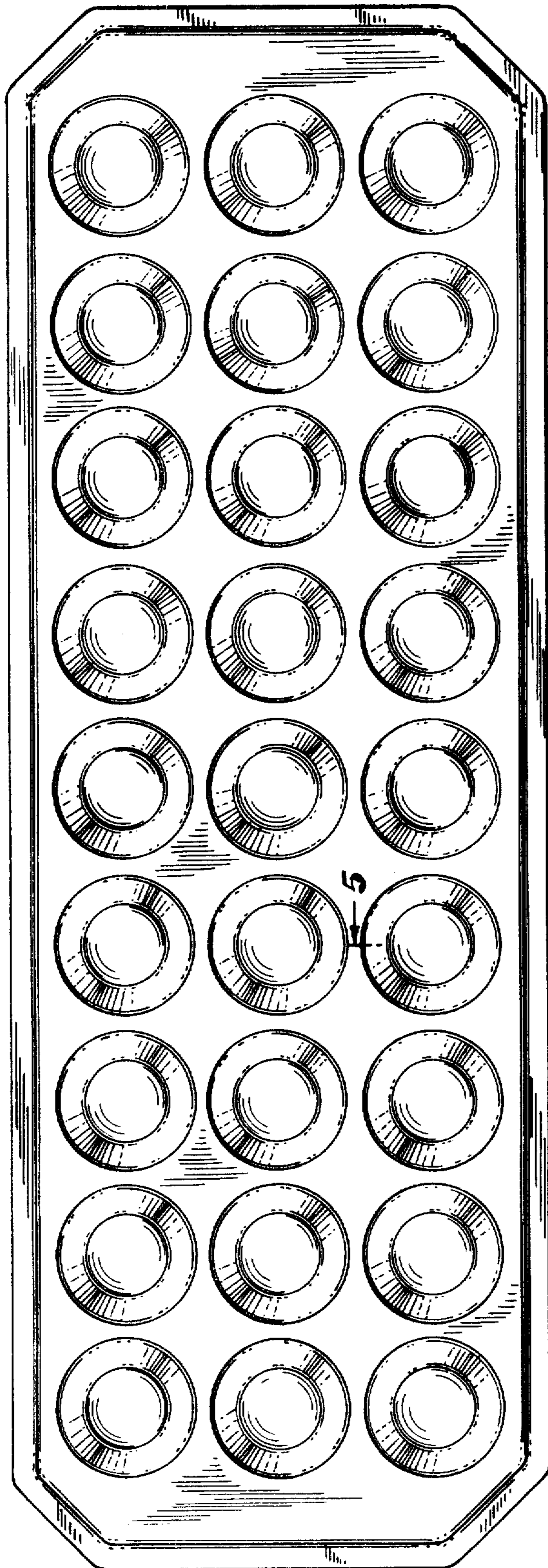
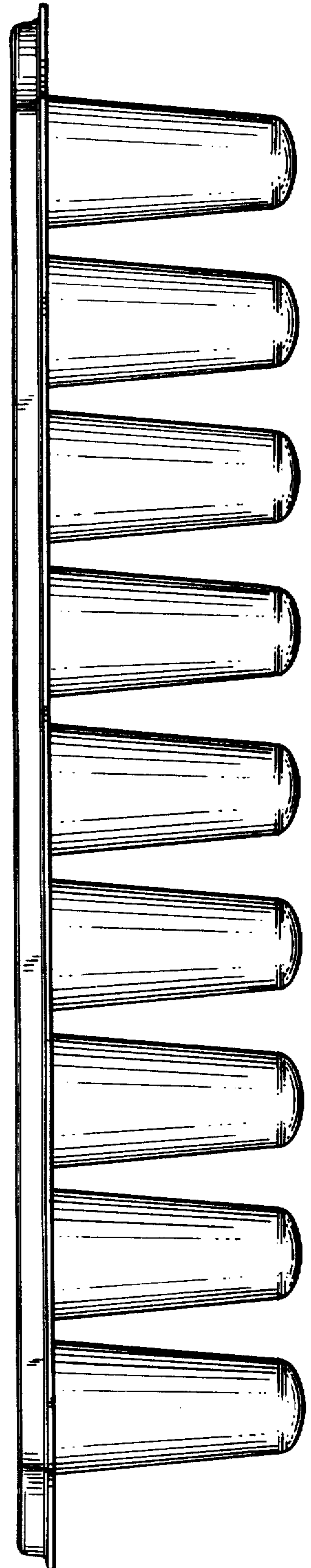

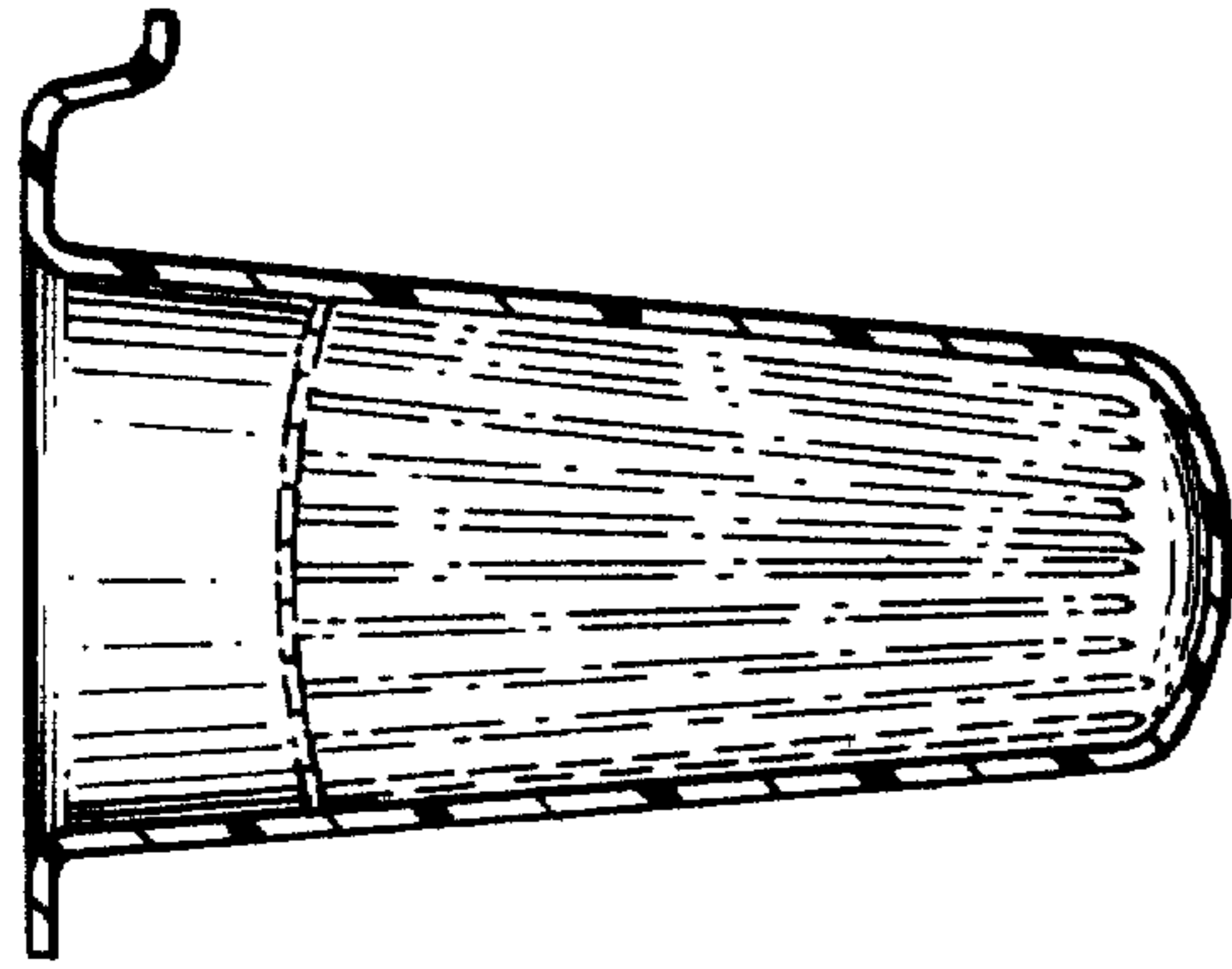

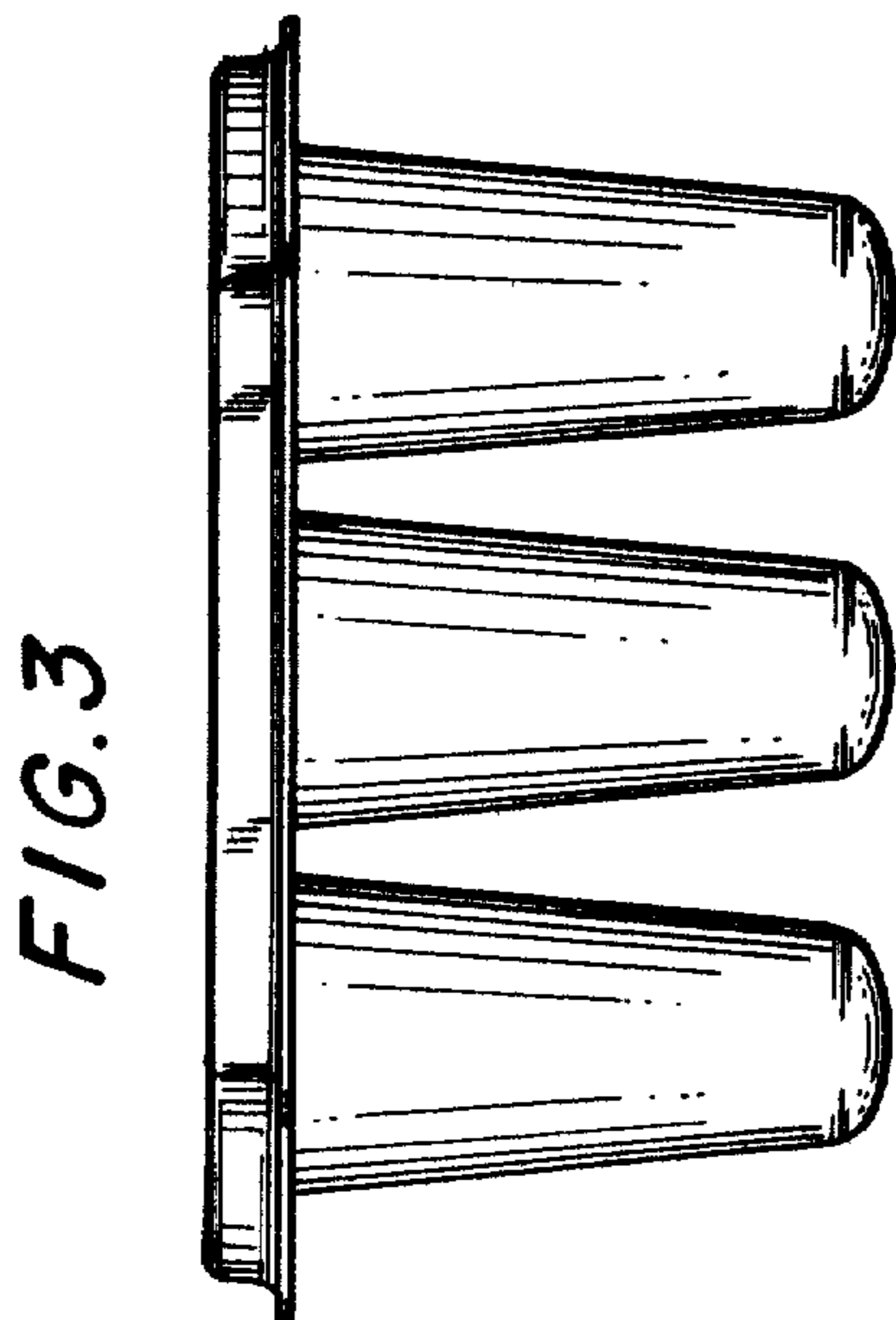

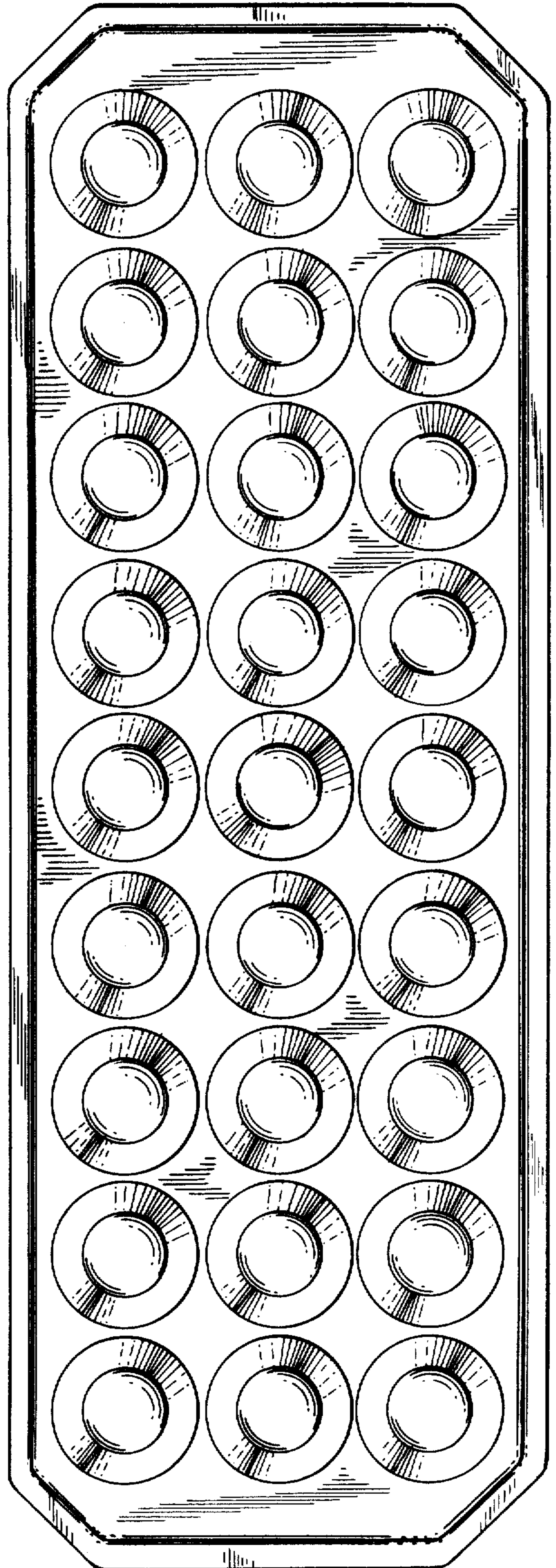
