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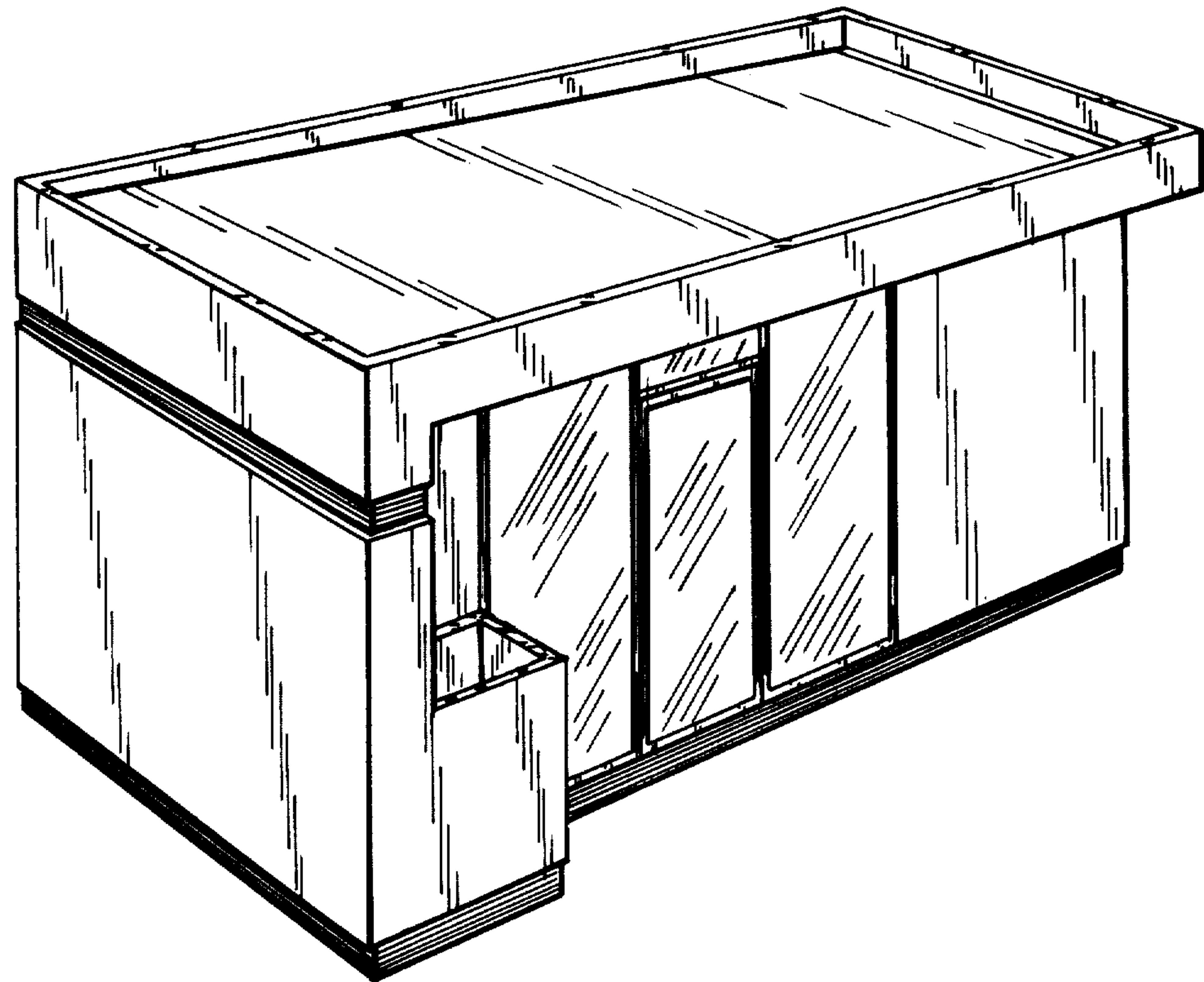

FIG. 6 is a top view of the design of the present invention.



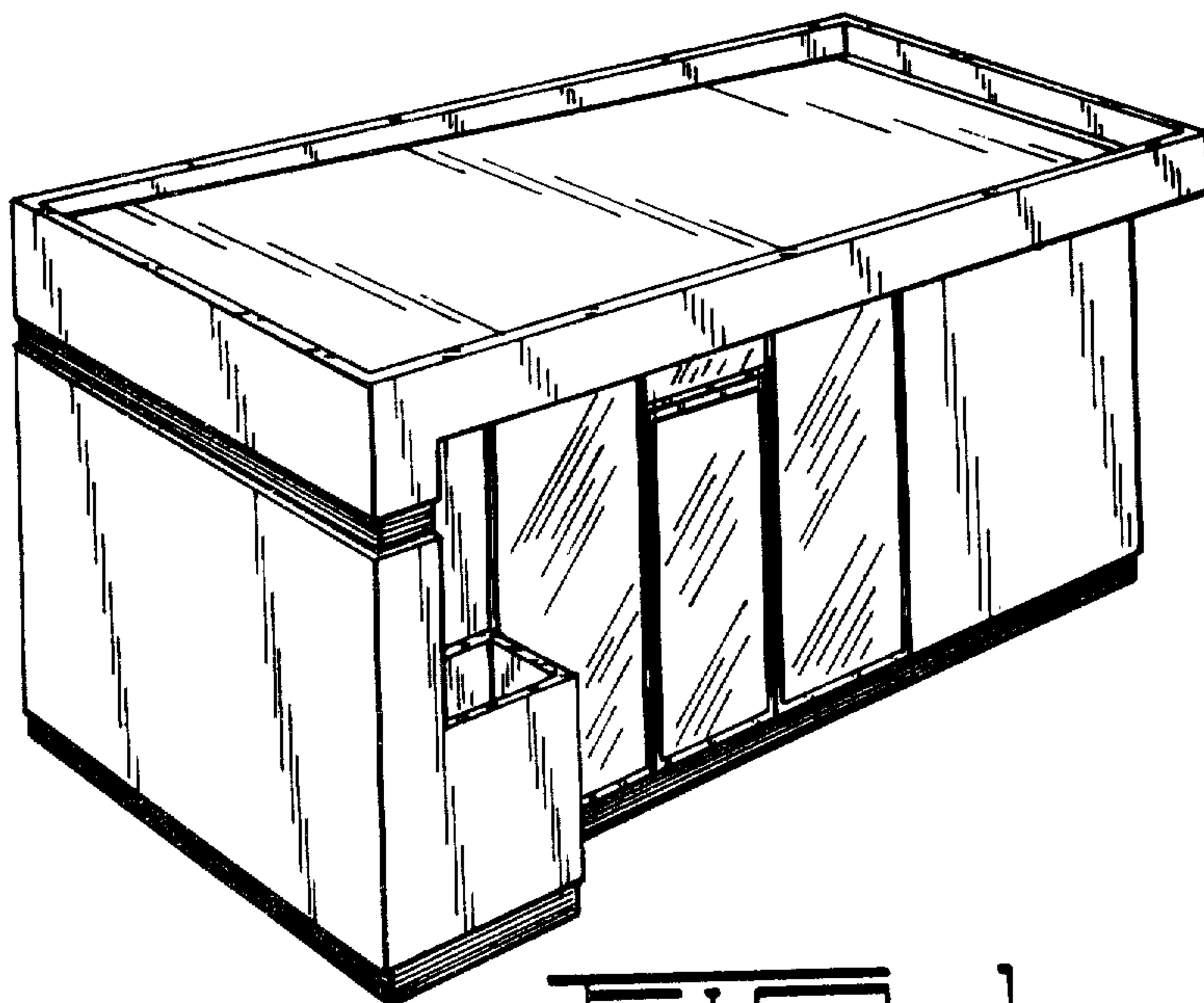

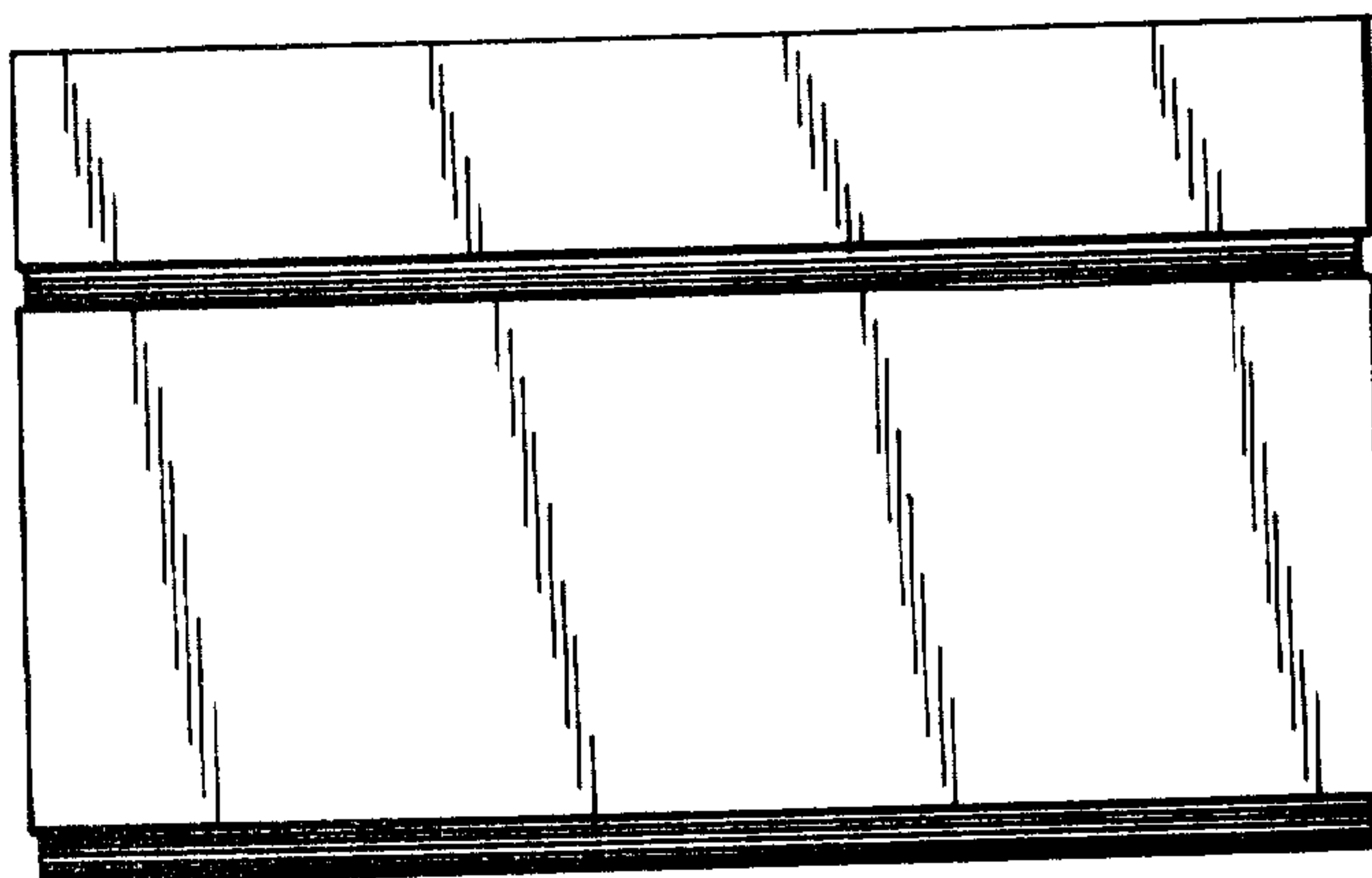

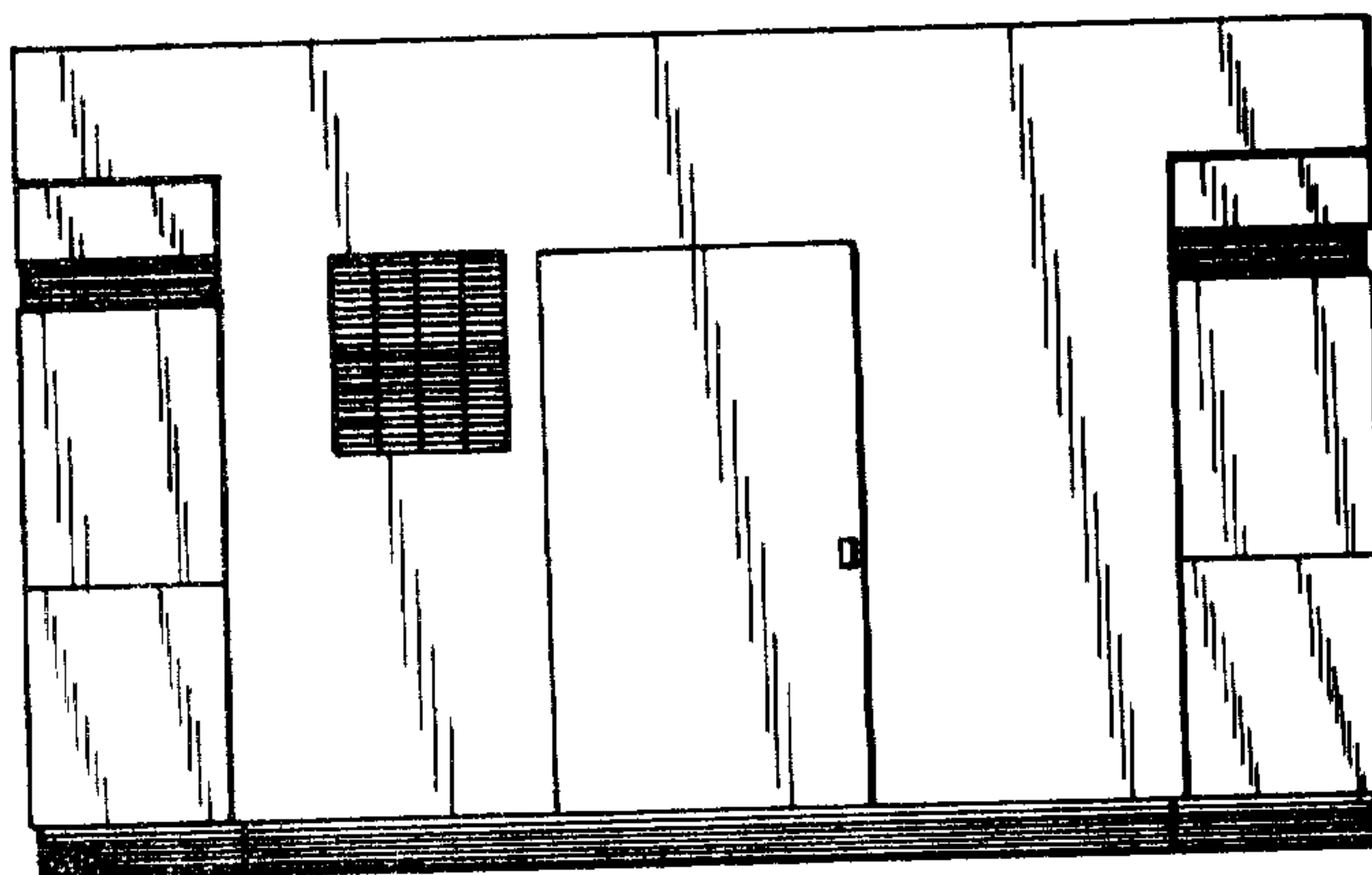

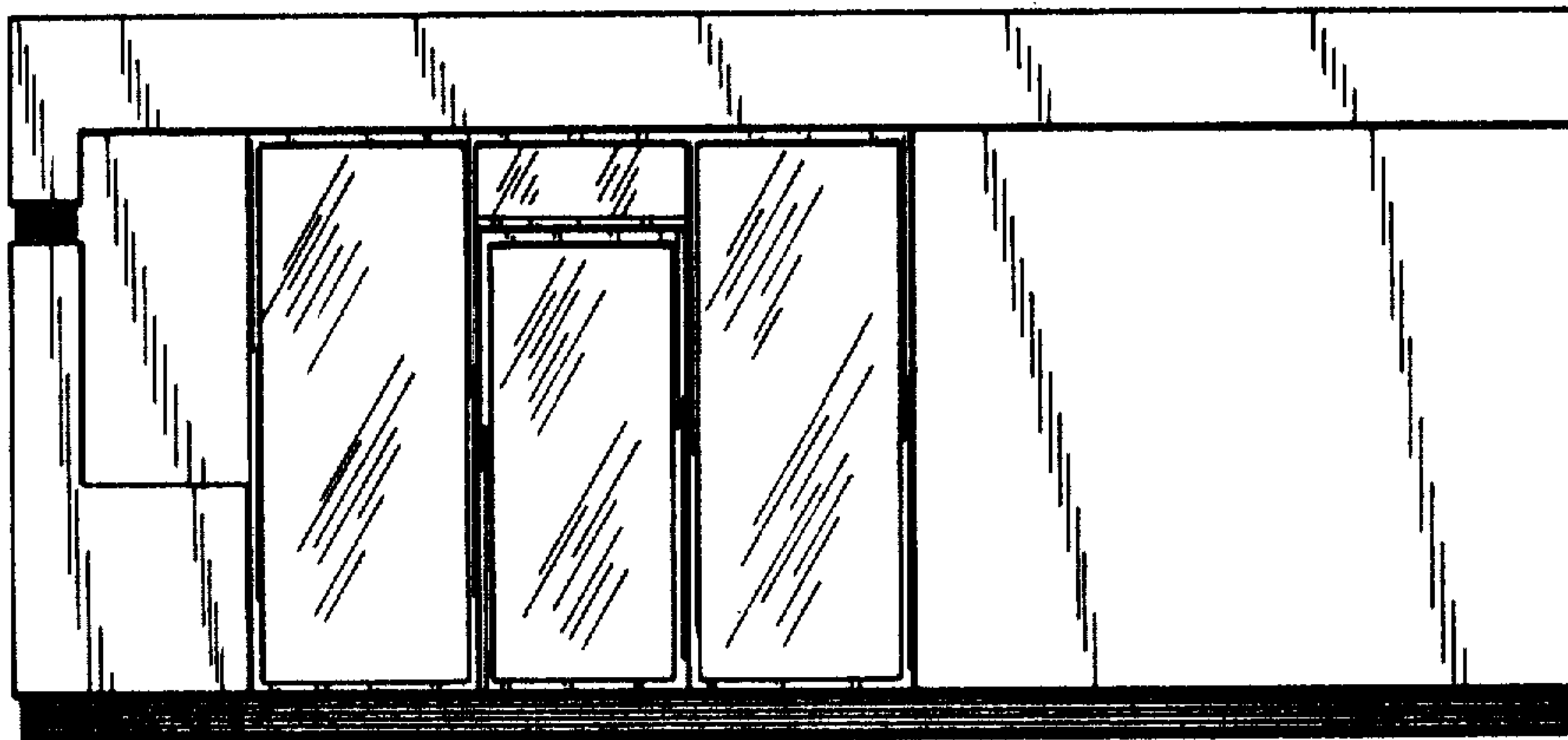

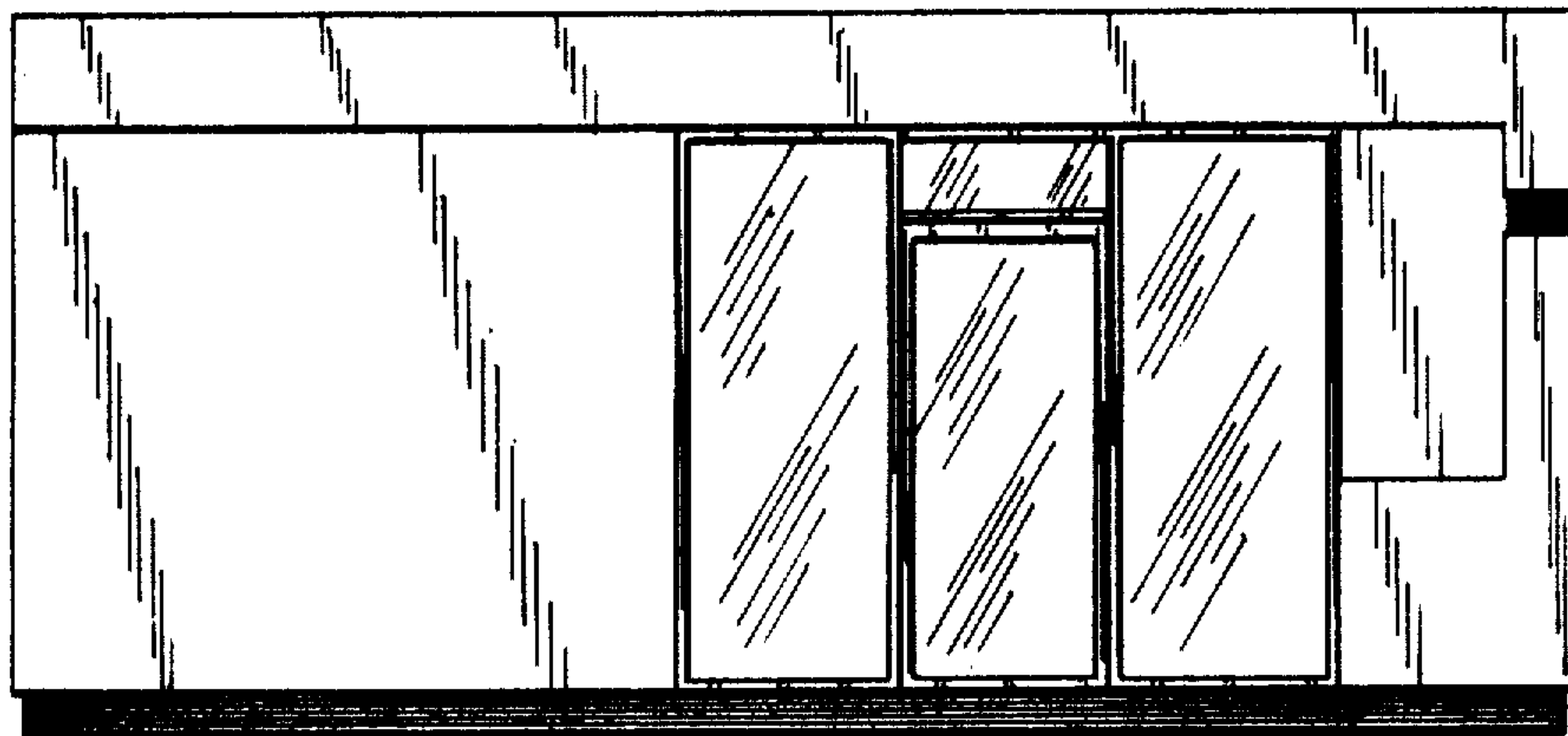

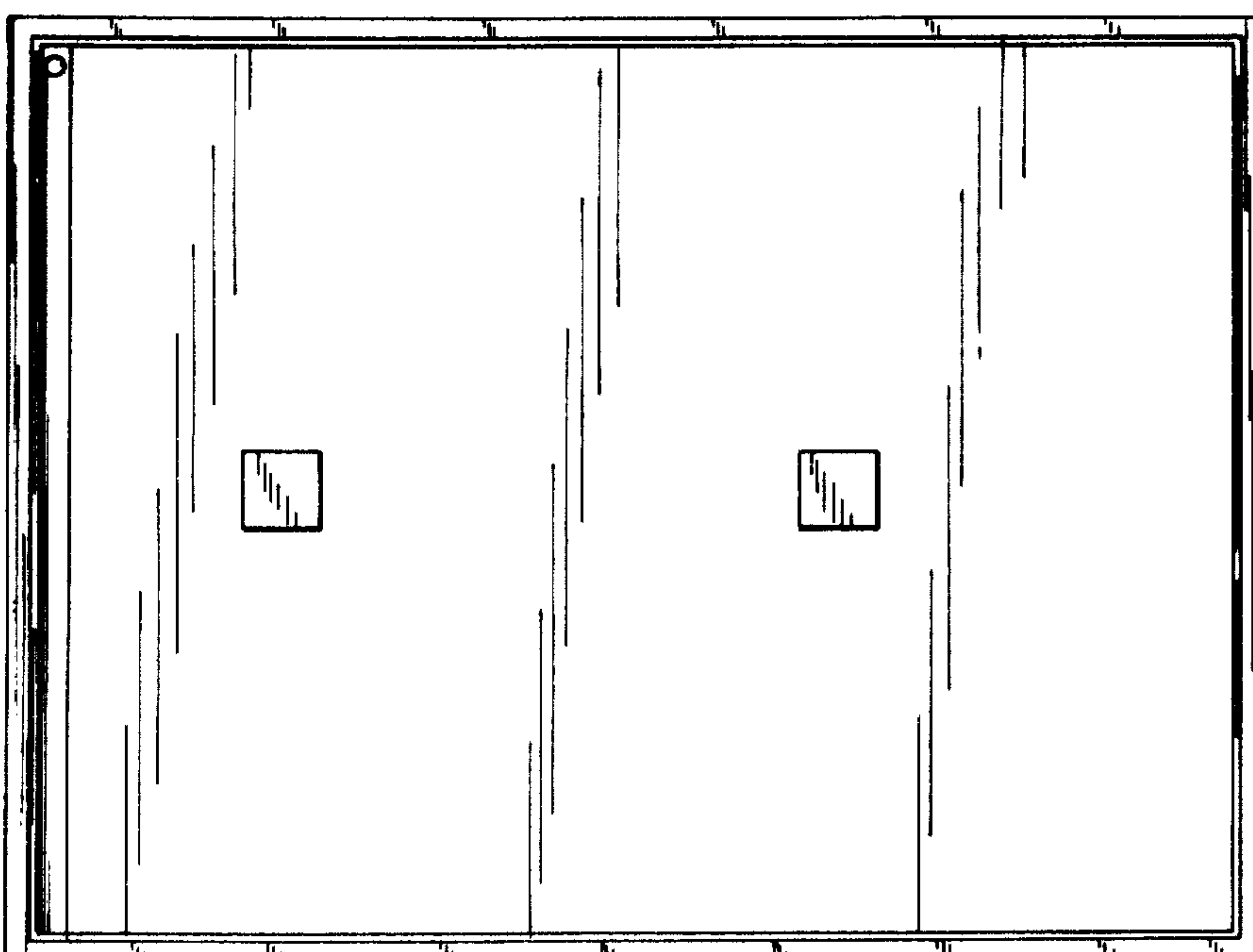
