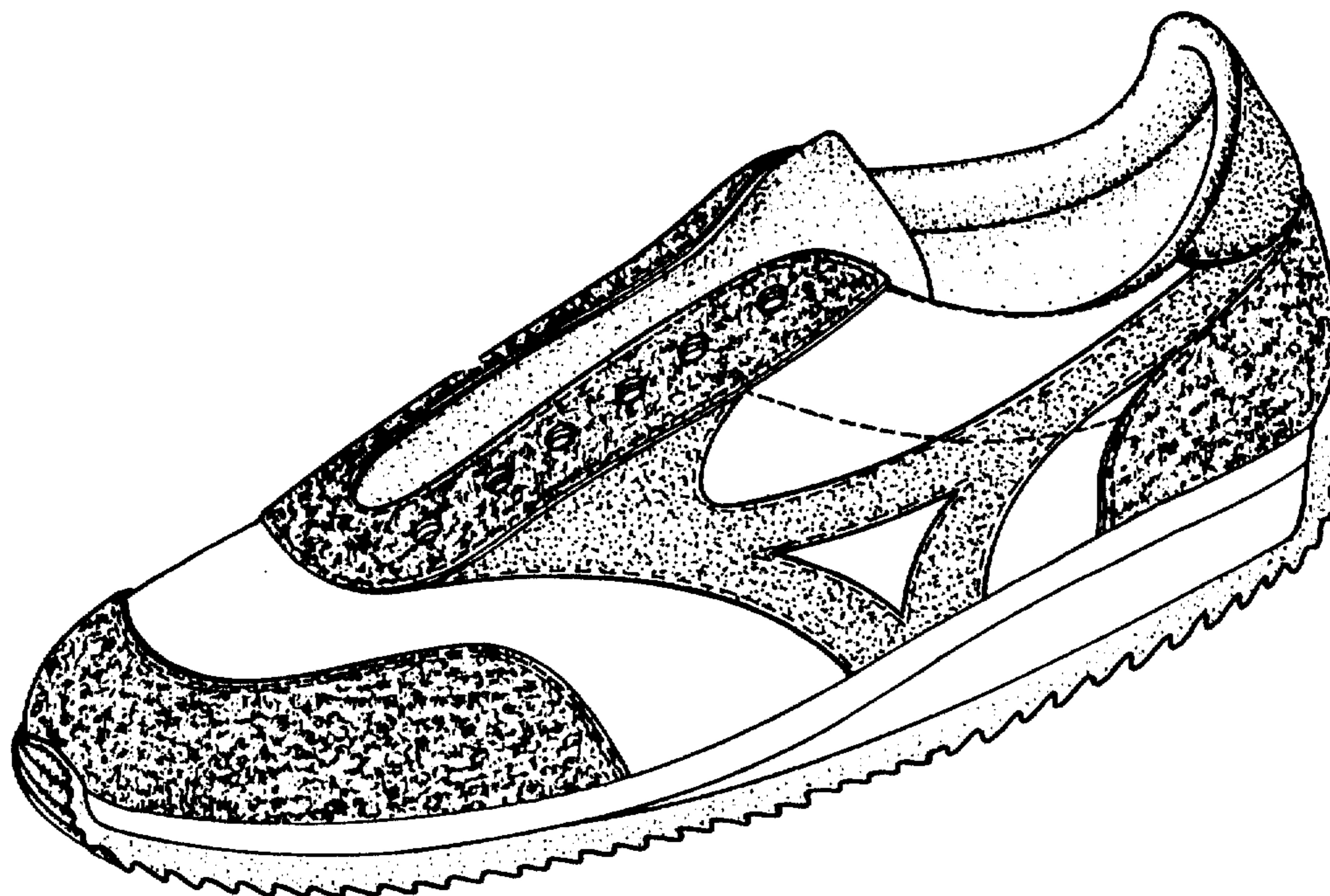

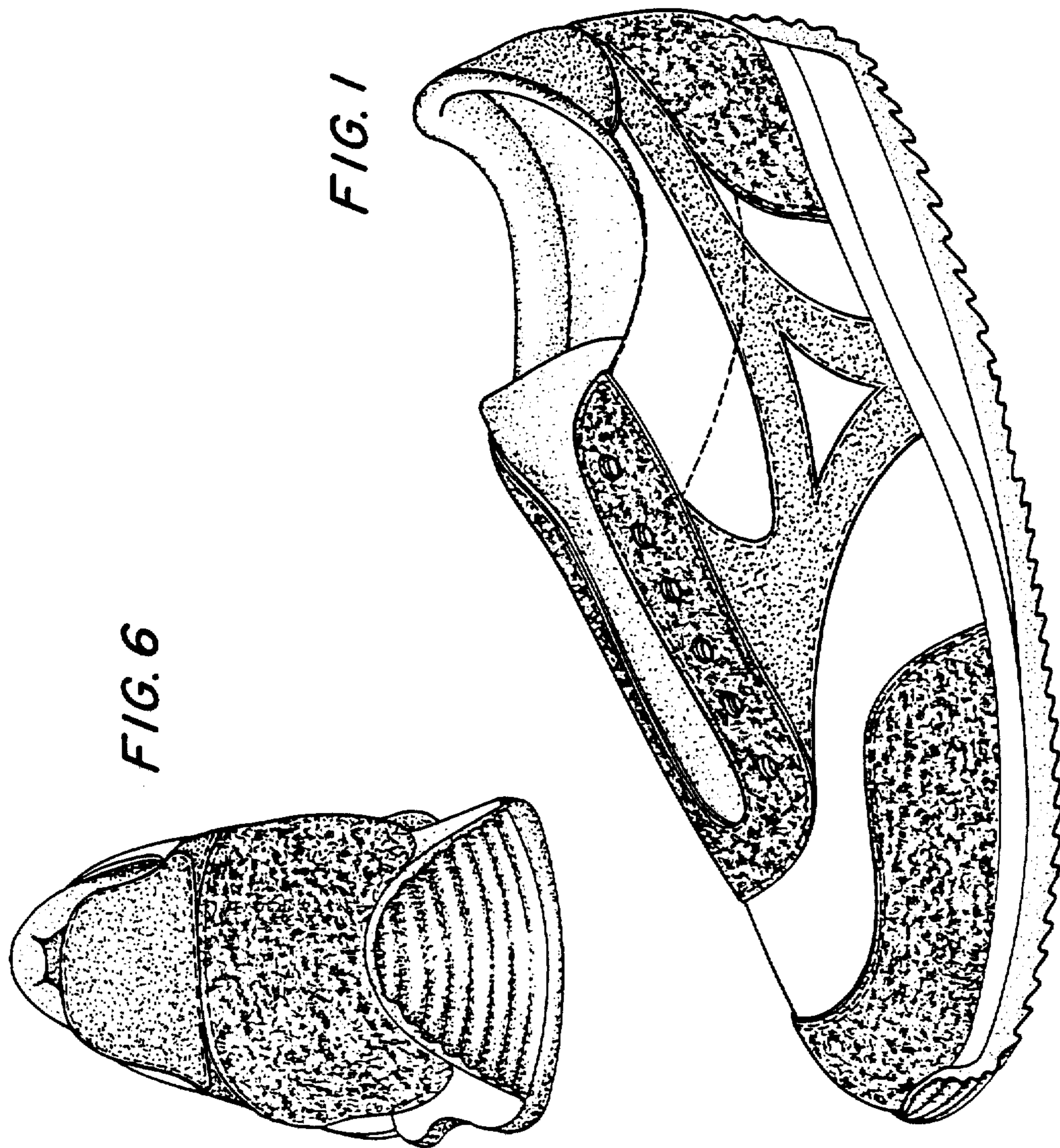
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a sport shoe, substantially as is shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right front perspective view of a sport shoe showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom pattern is substantially continuous as best seen from FIGS. 3 and 6;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.





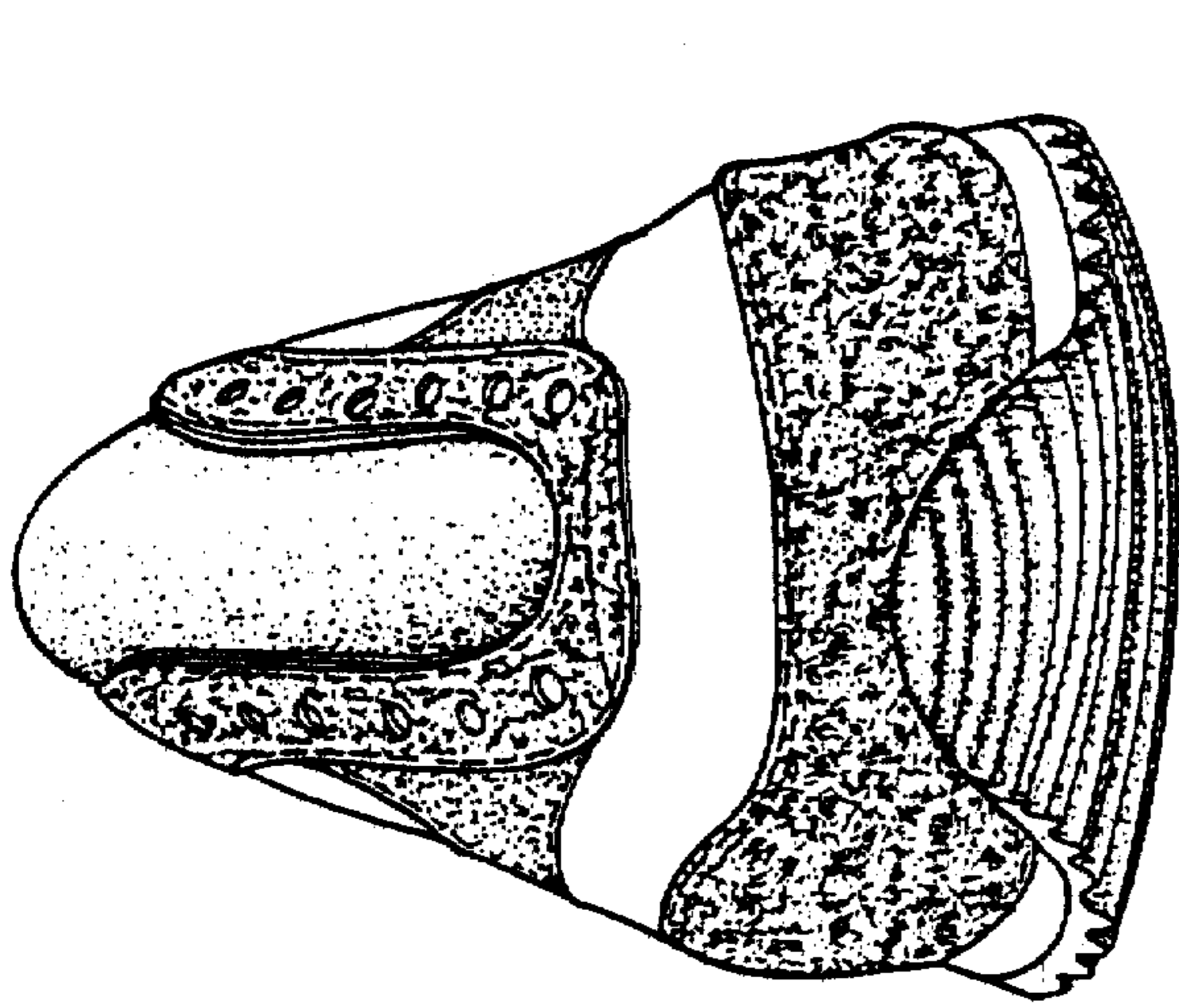

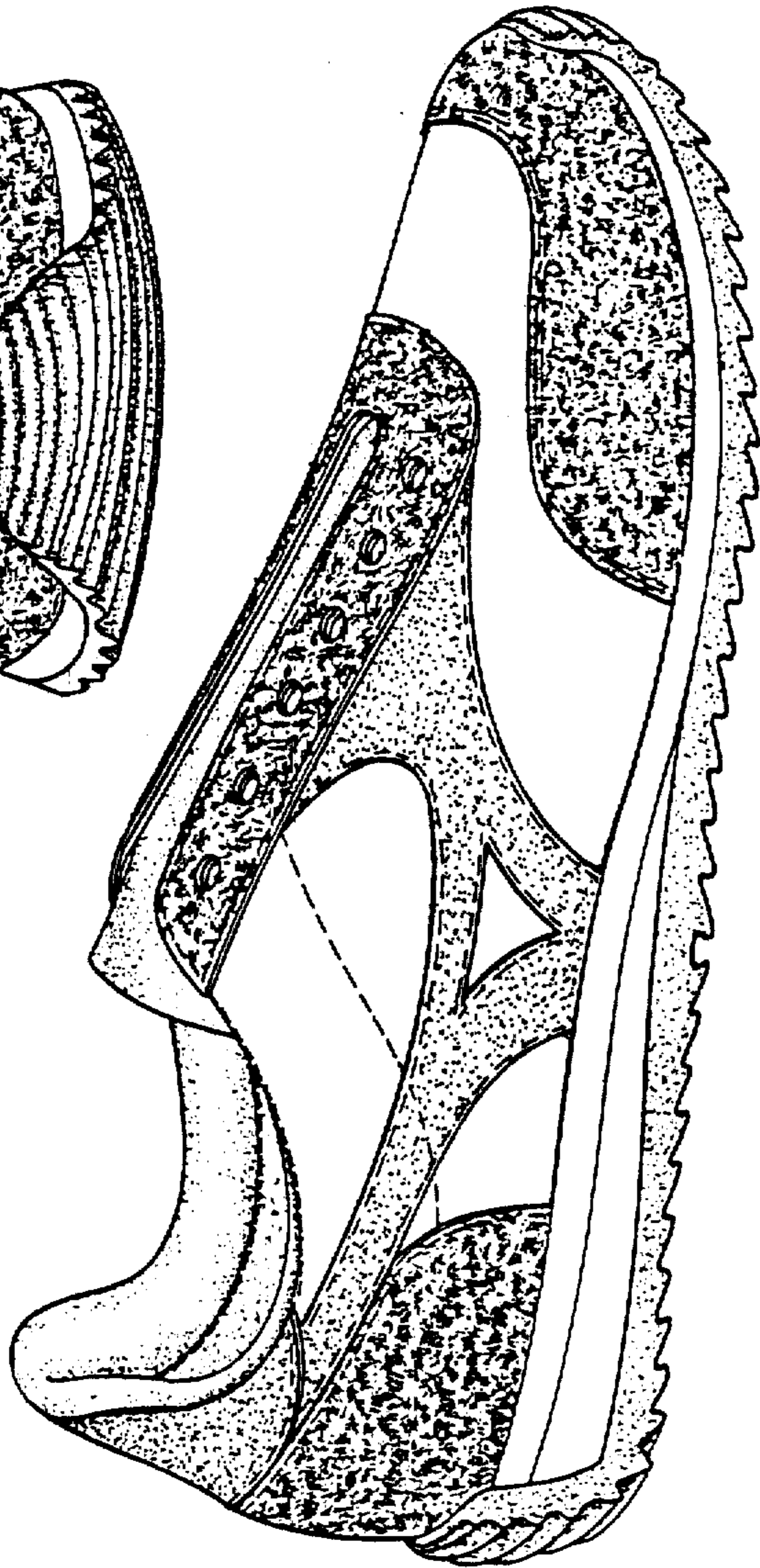

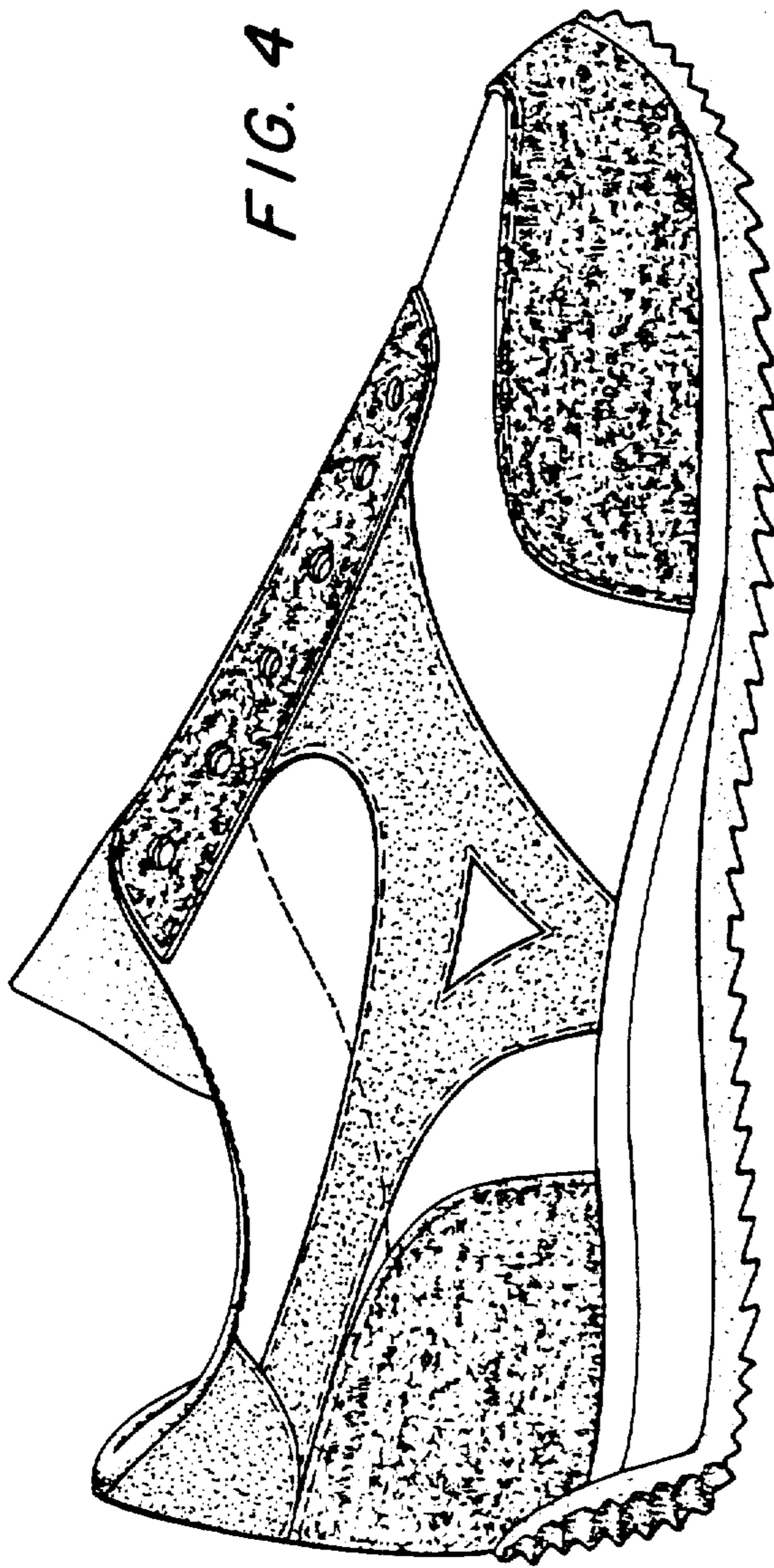
