holder for an automobile showing my new design.

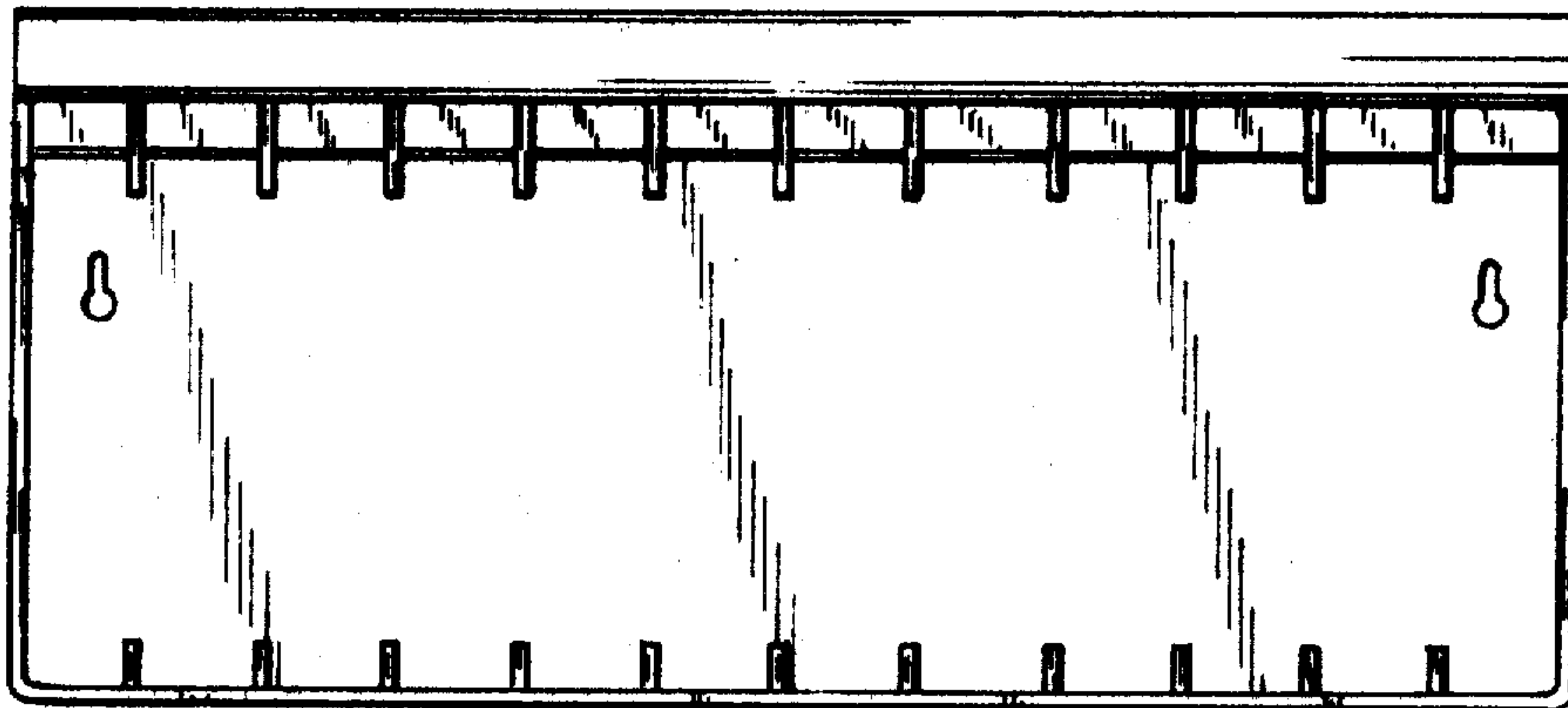
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof.

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof.



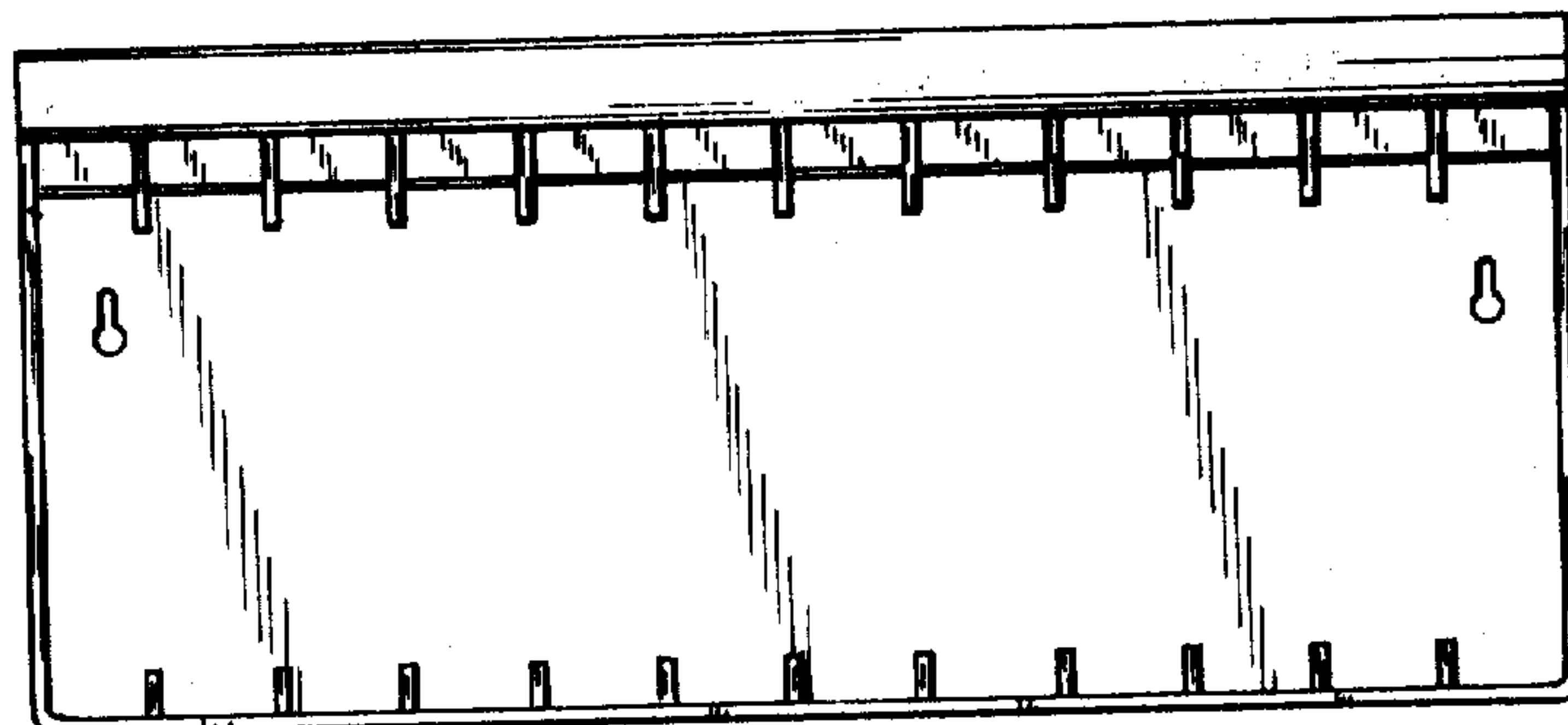

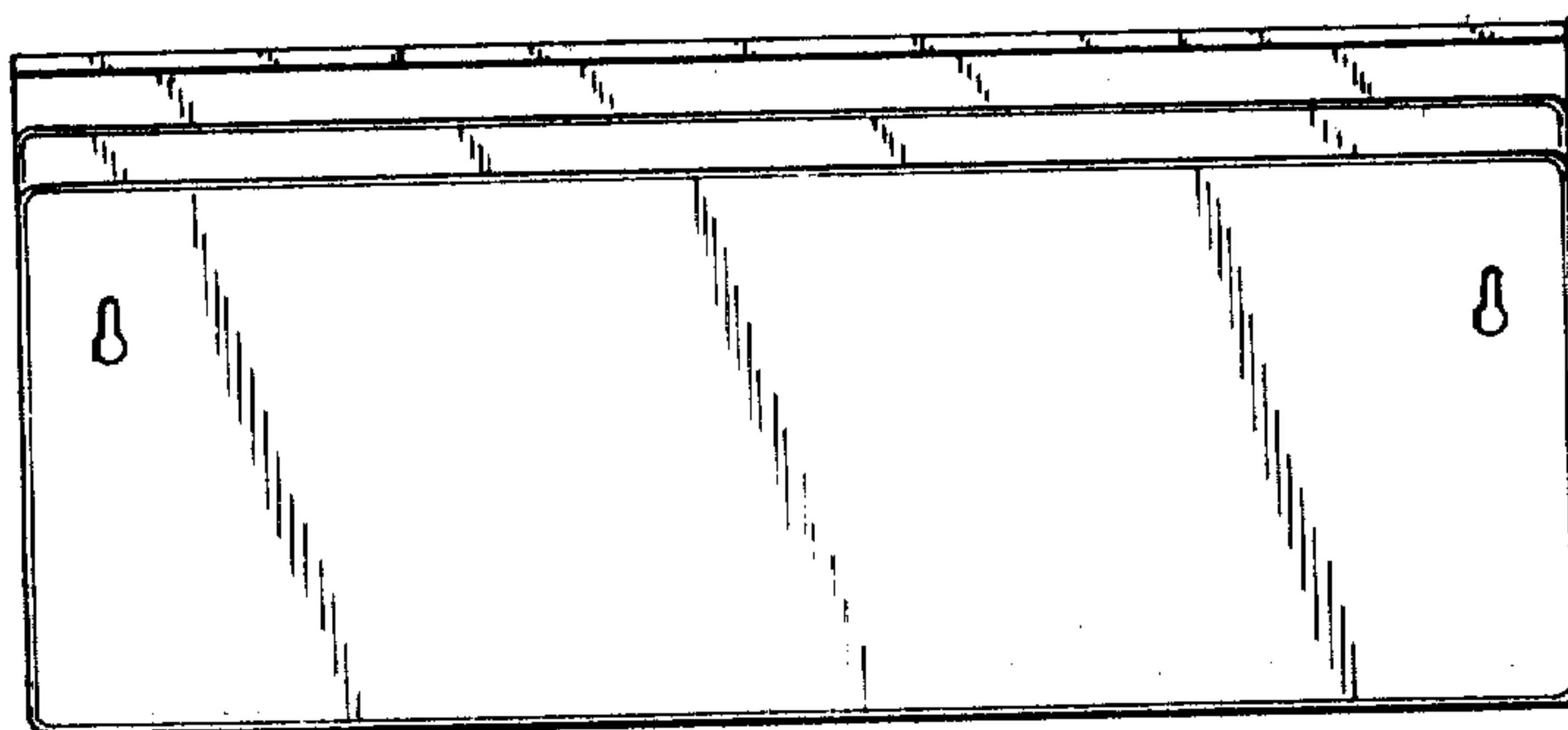

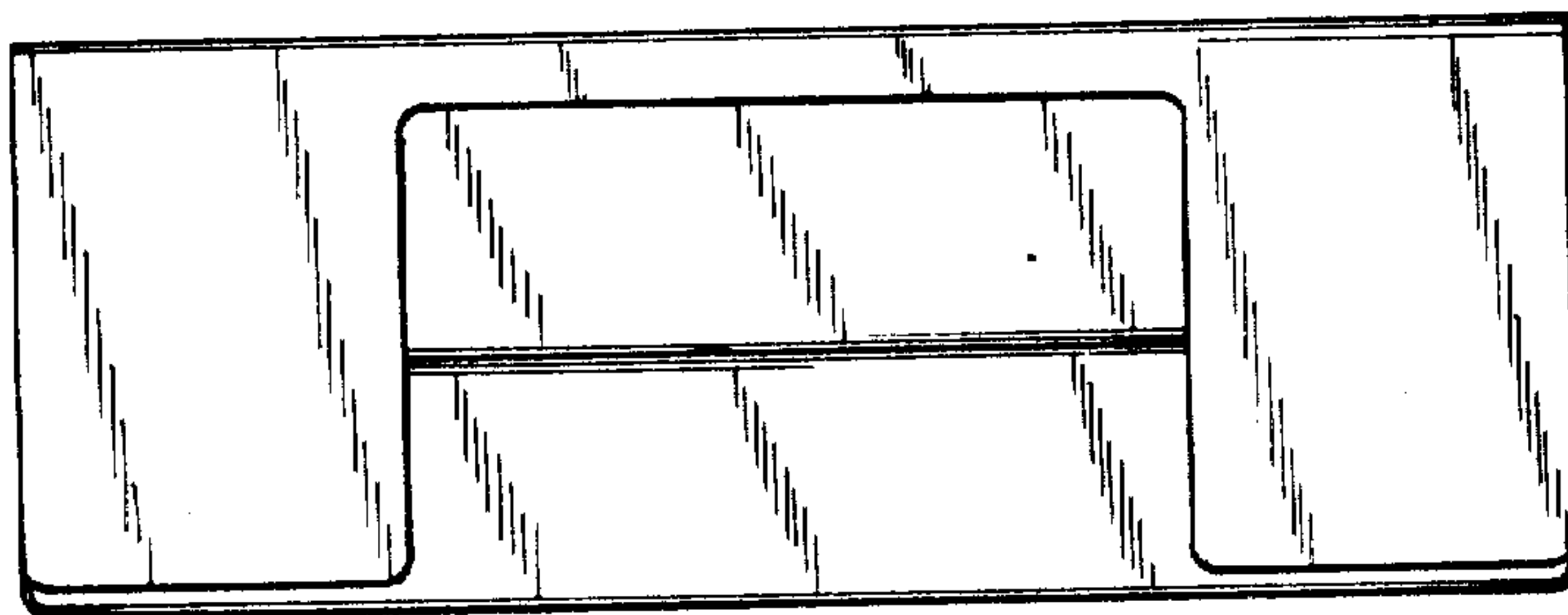

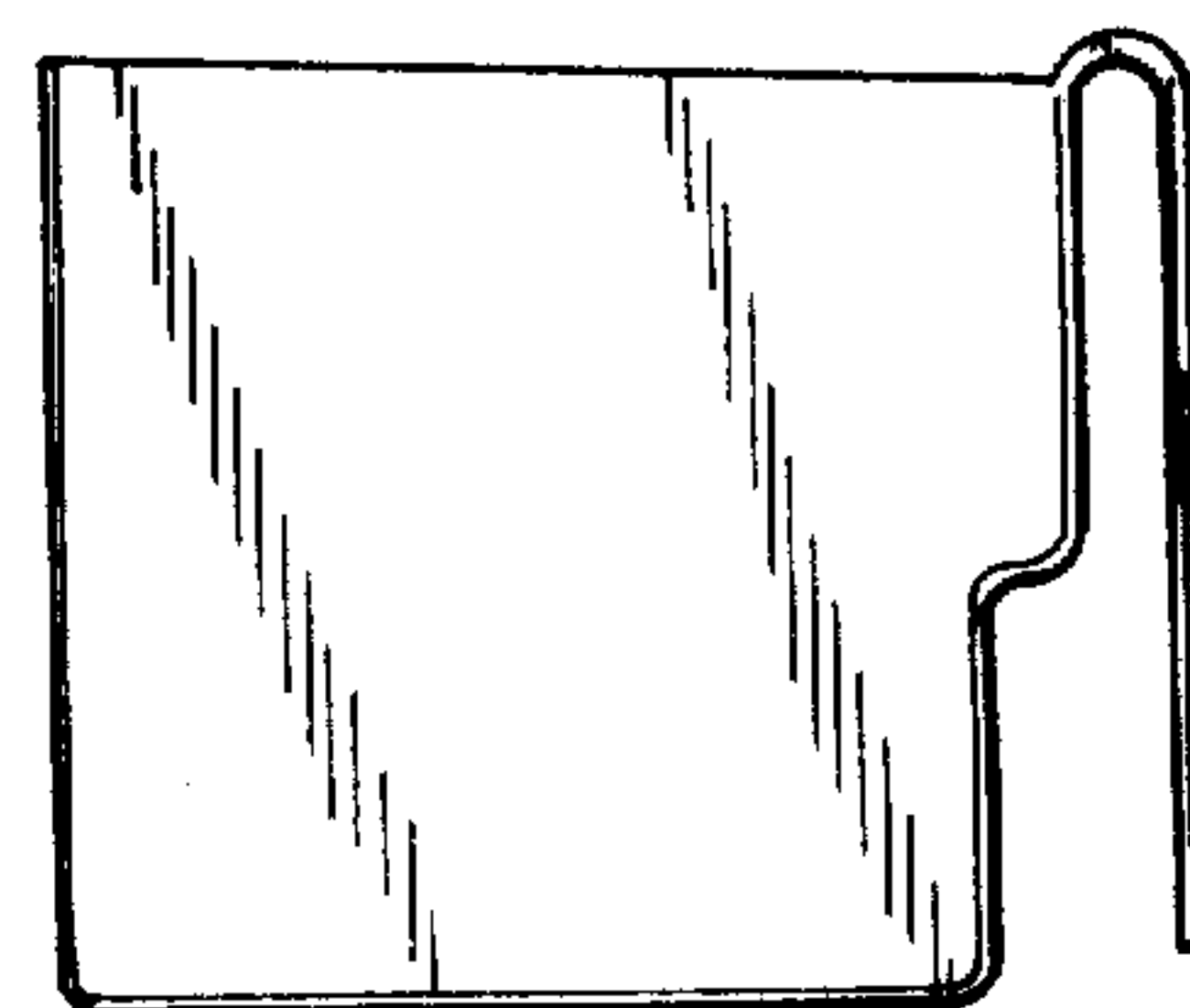

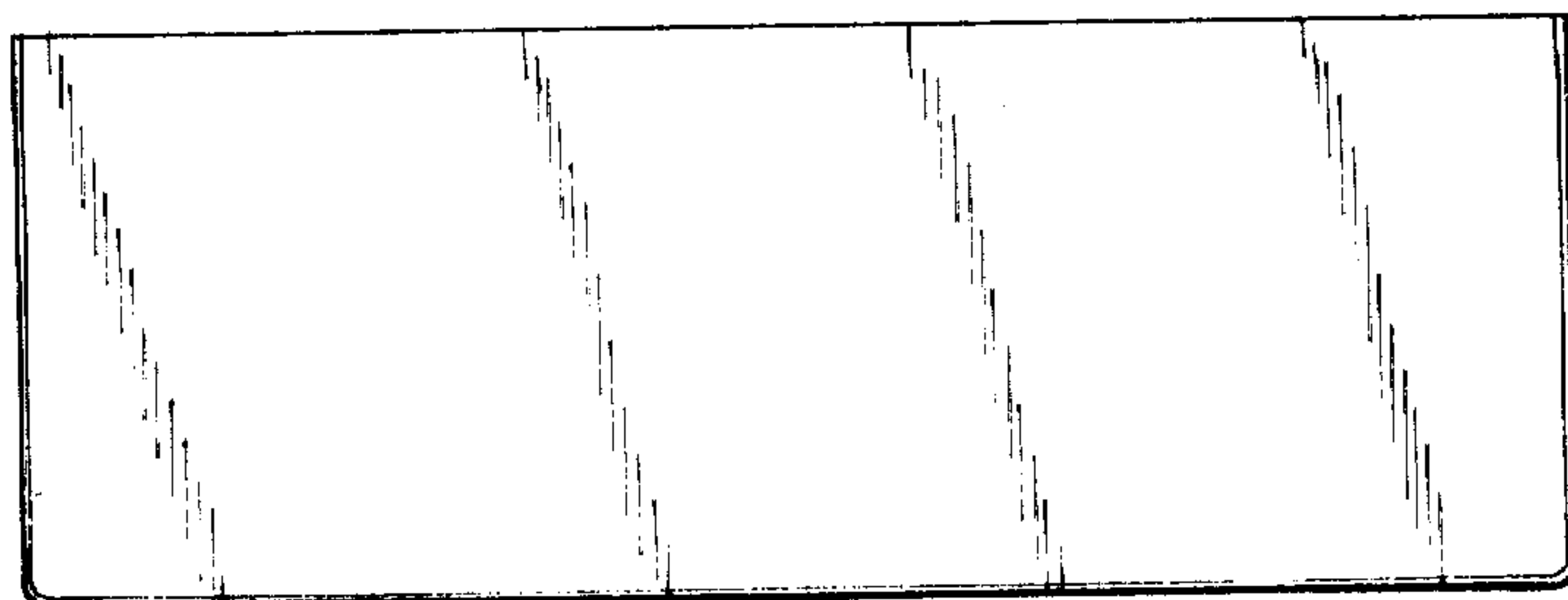

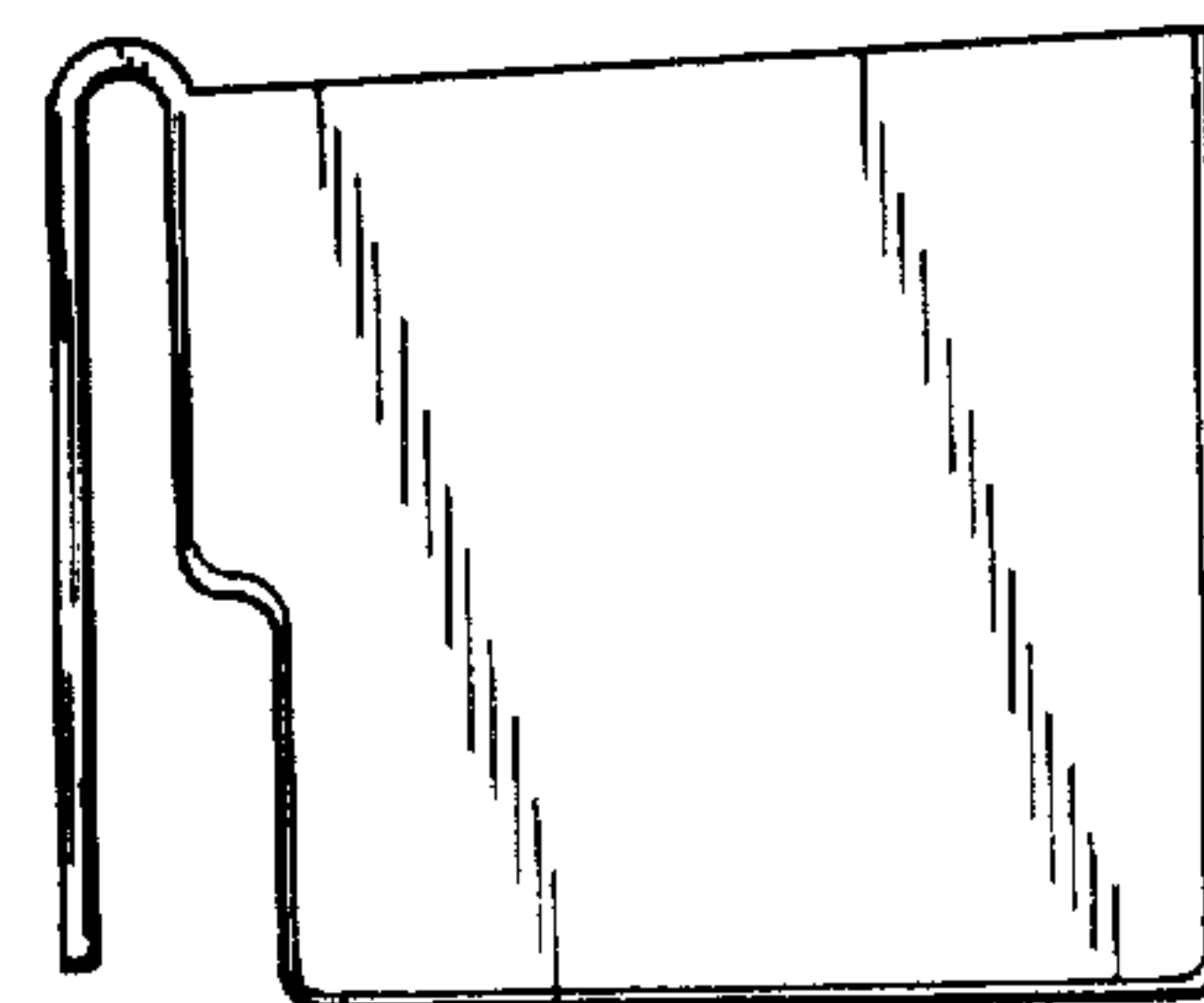
