DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a jar showing my new design, the opposite side being the same in appearance; FIG. 2 is a fragmentary, enlarged sectional view taken on line 2—2 of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a top plan view; and FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

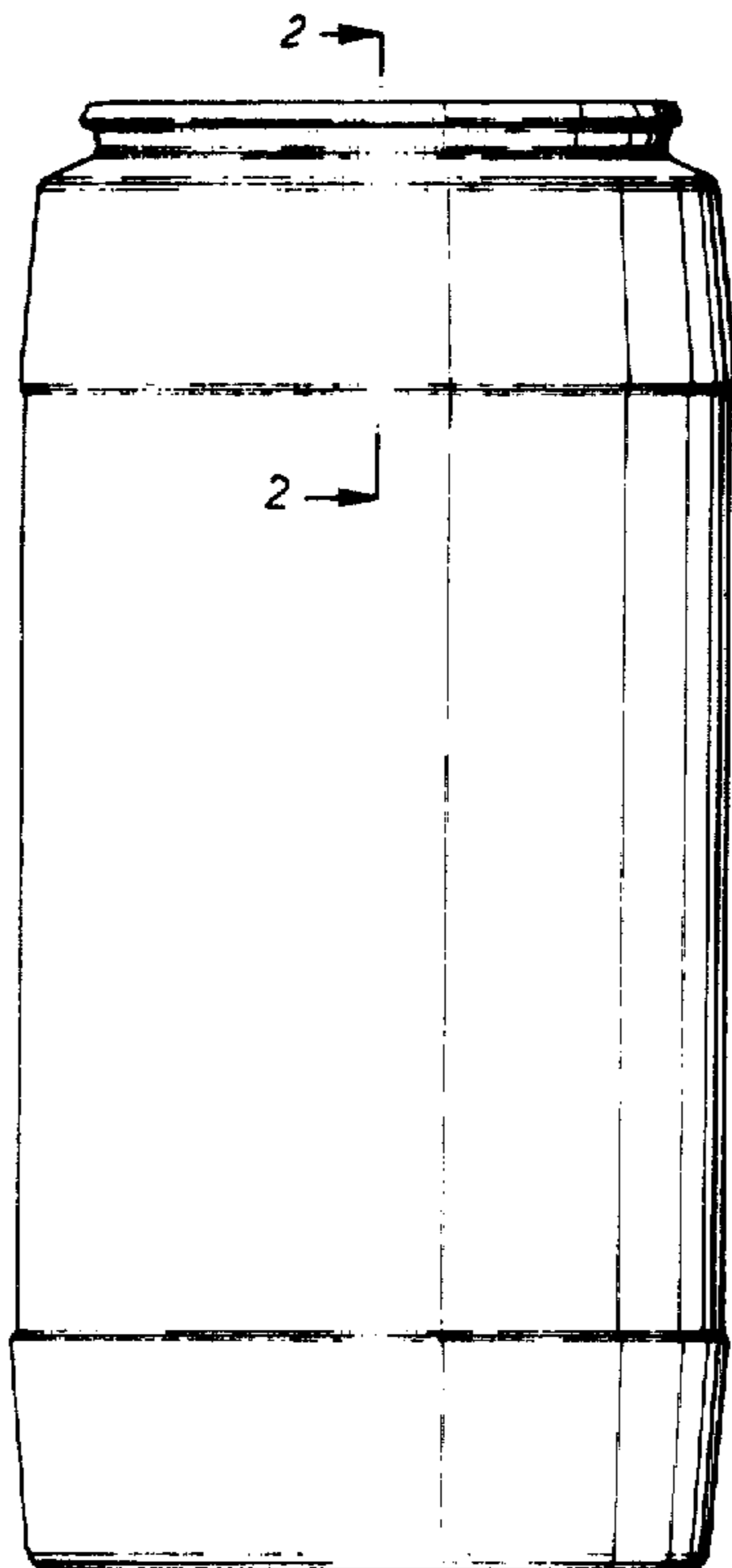

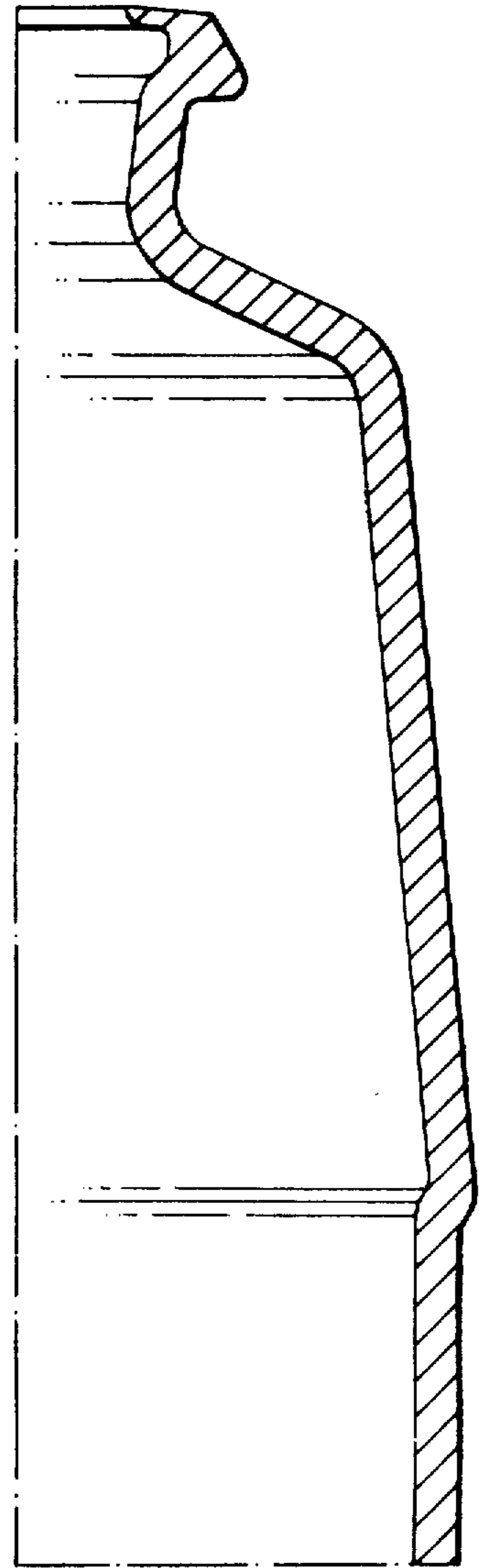
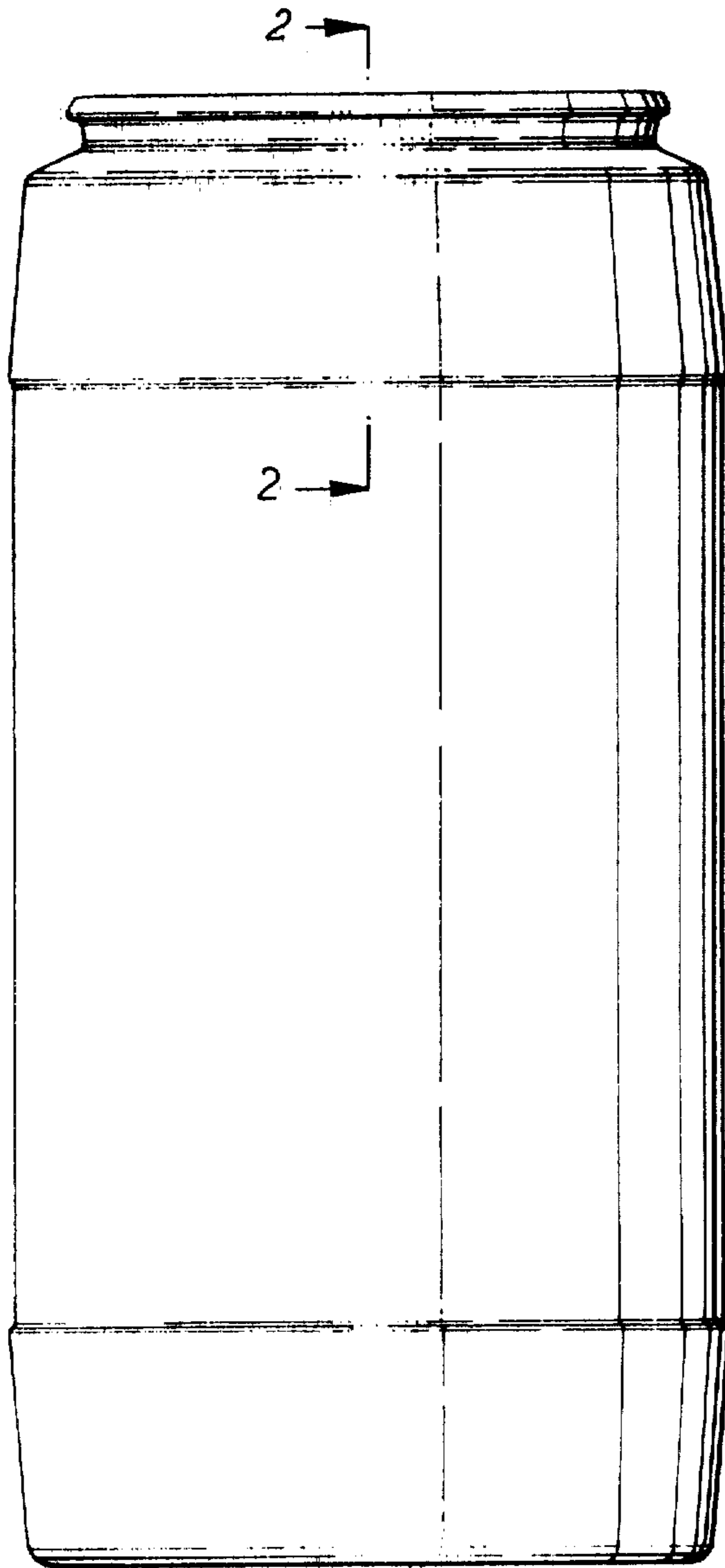

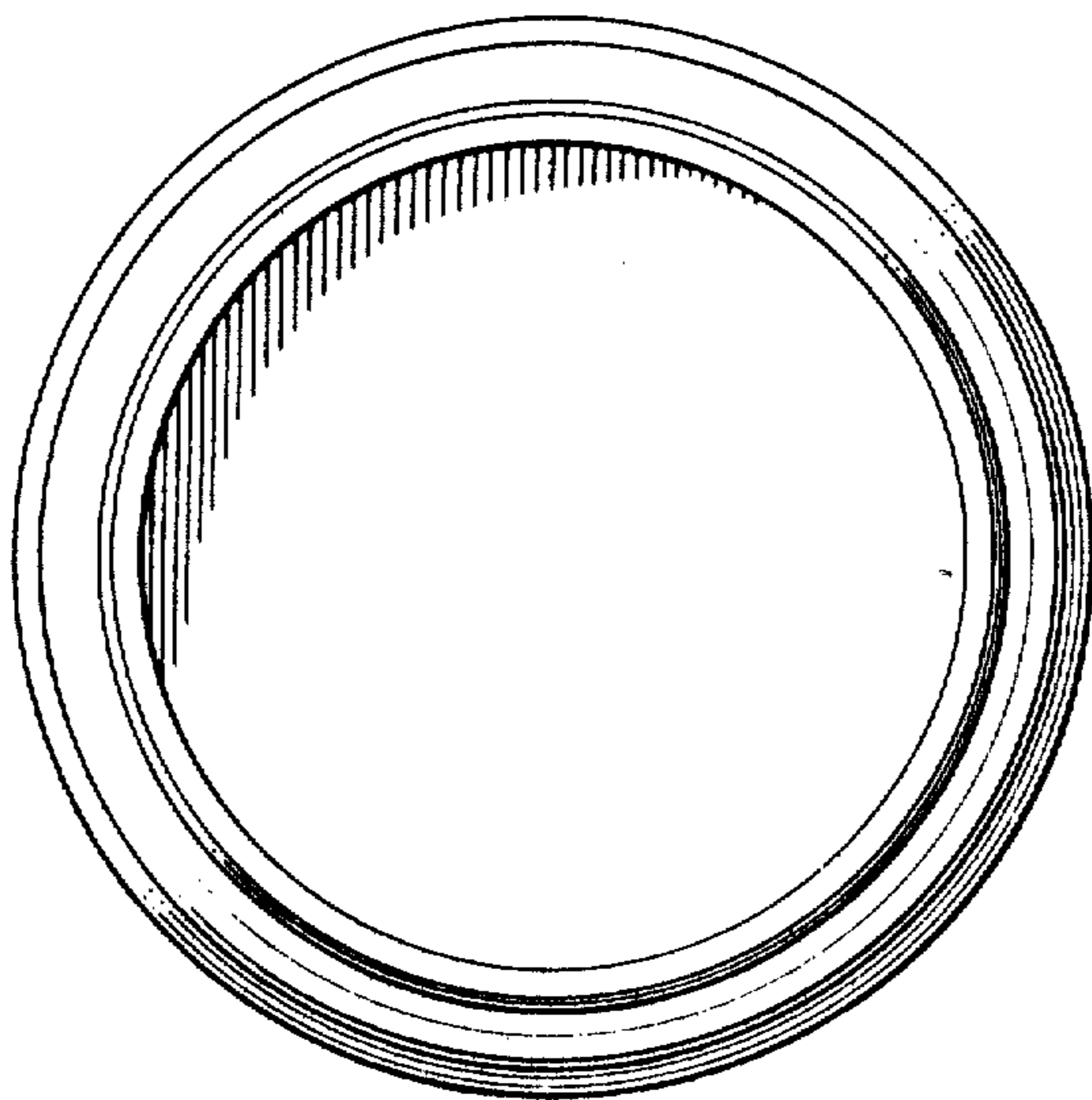
