FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toy slide showing my new design.

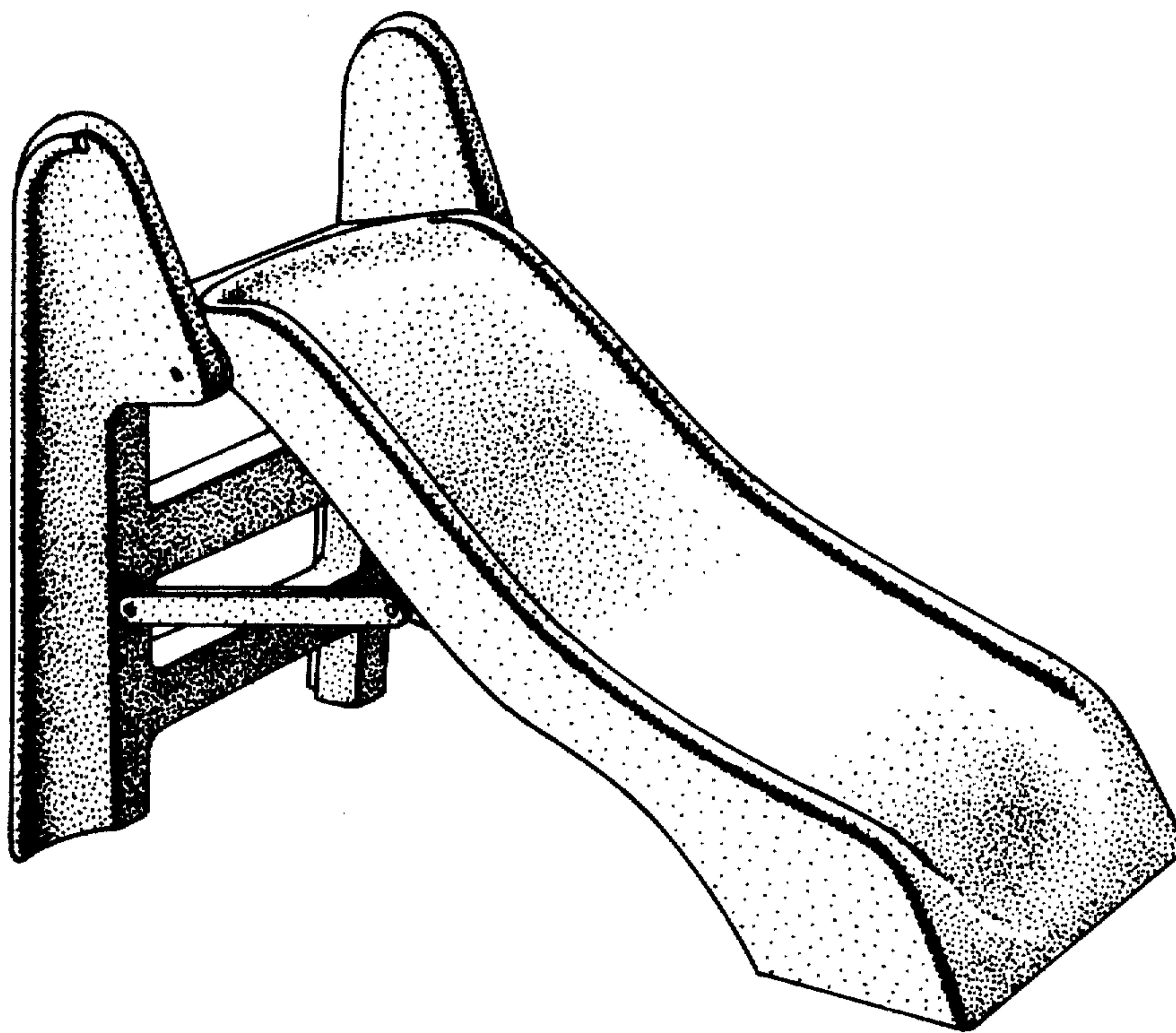
FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the opposite side of the toy slide from that illustrated in FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan thereof.



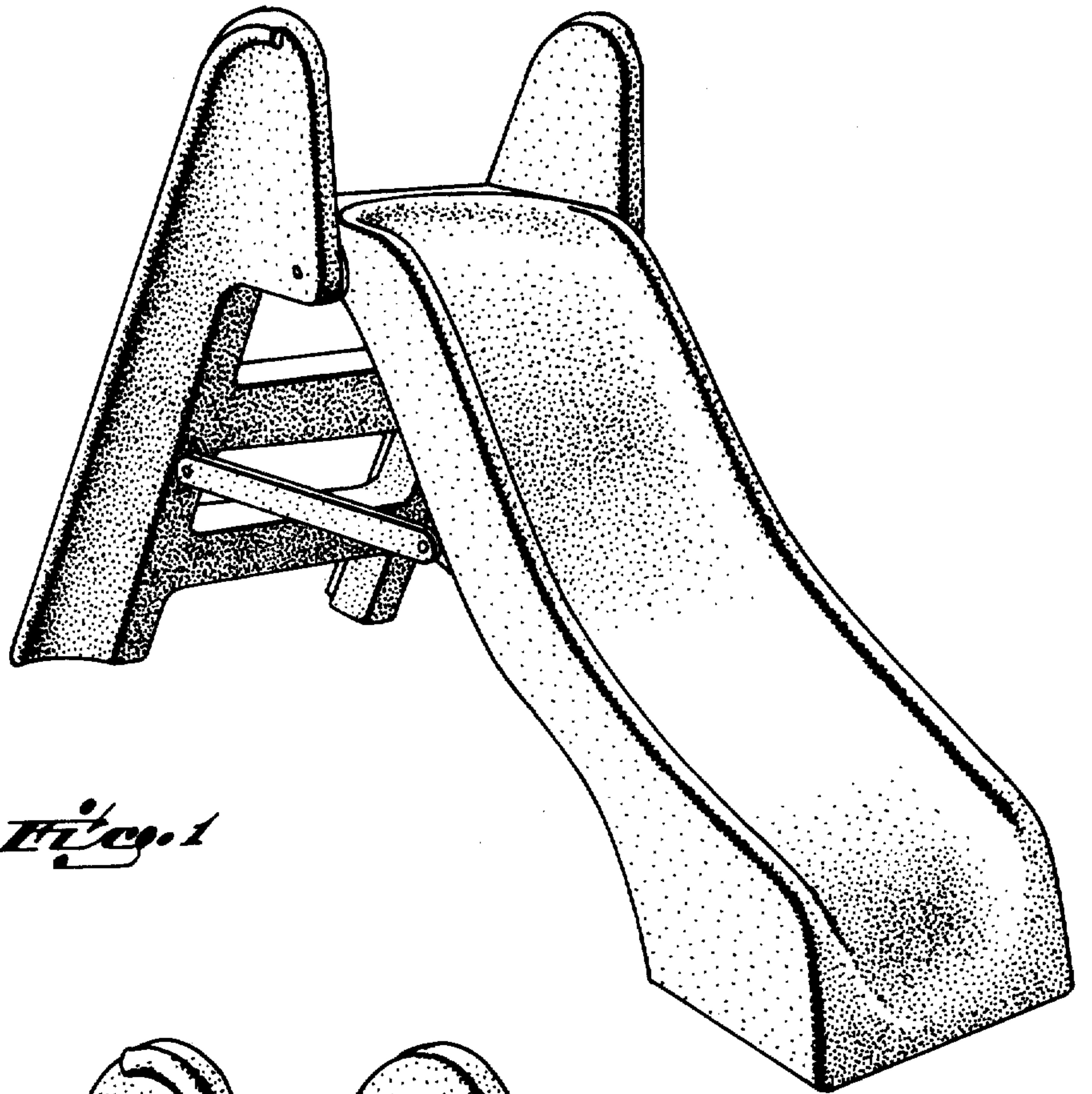

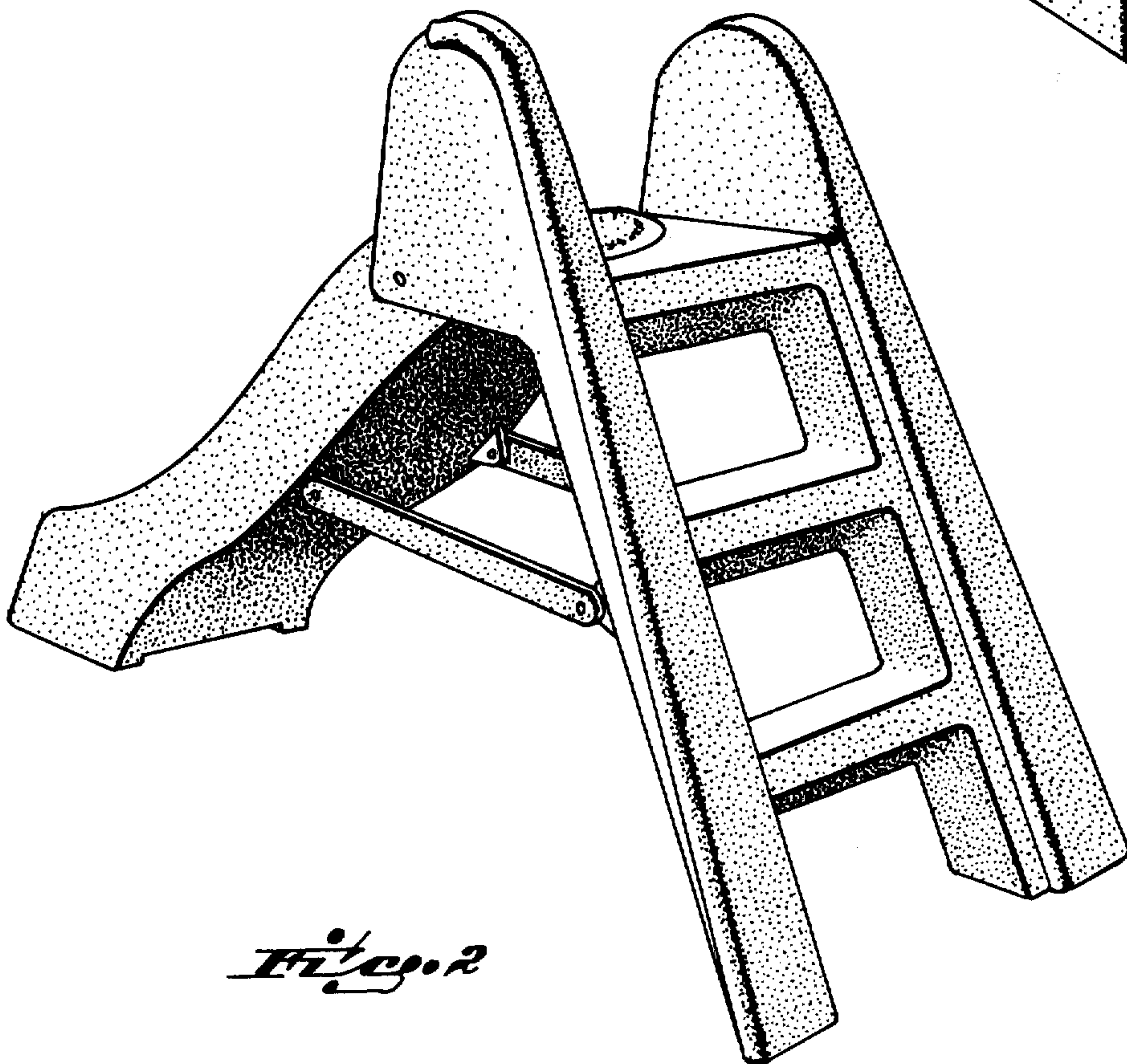

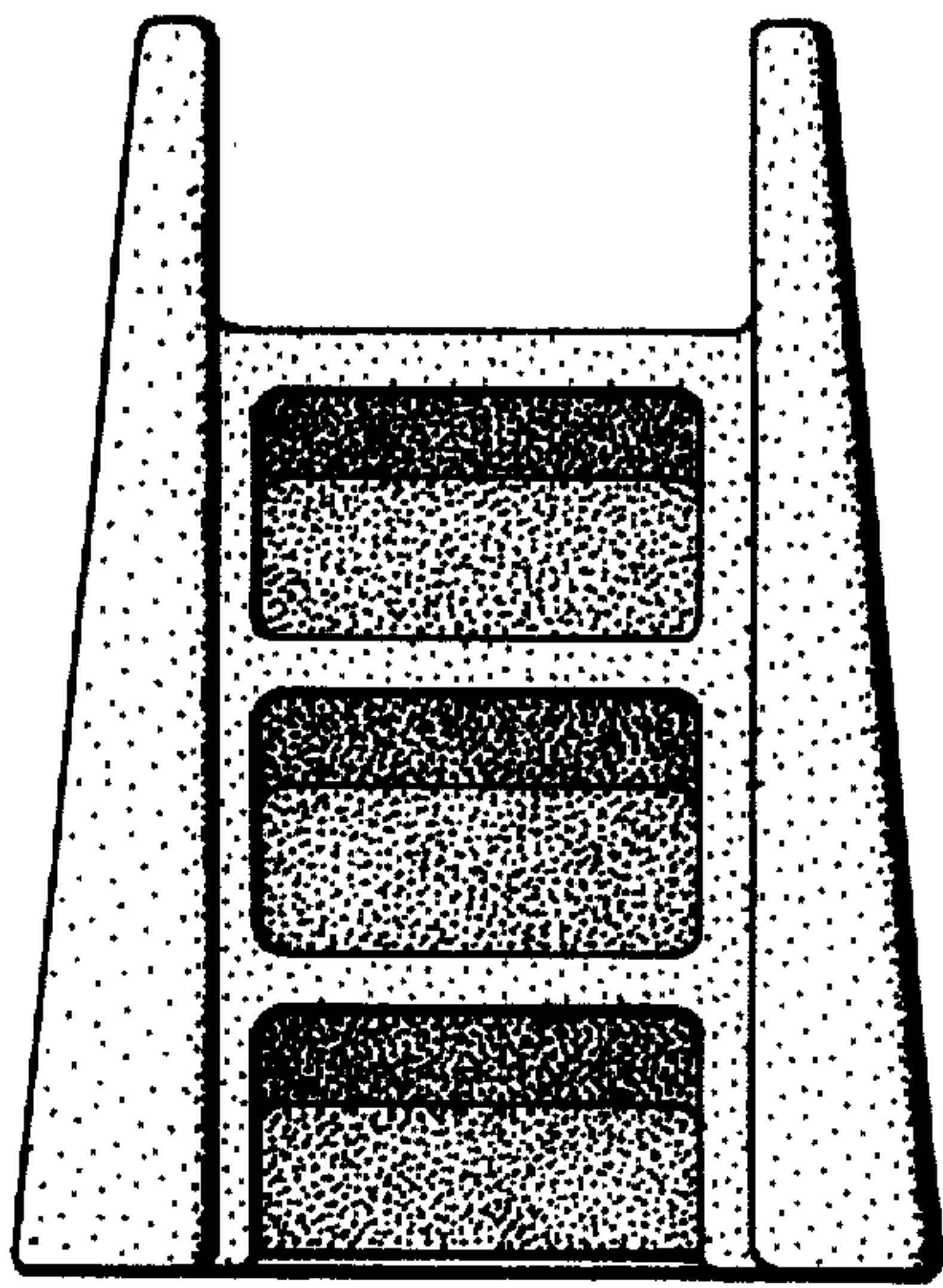

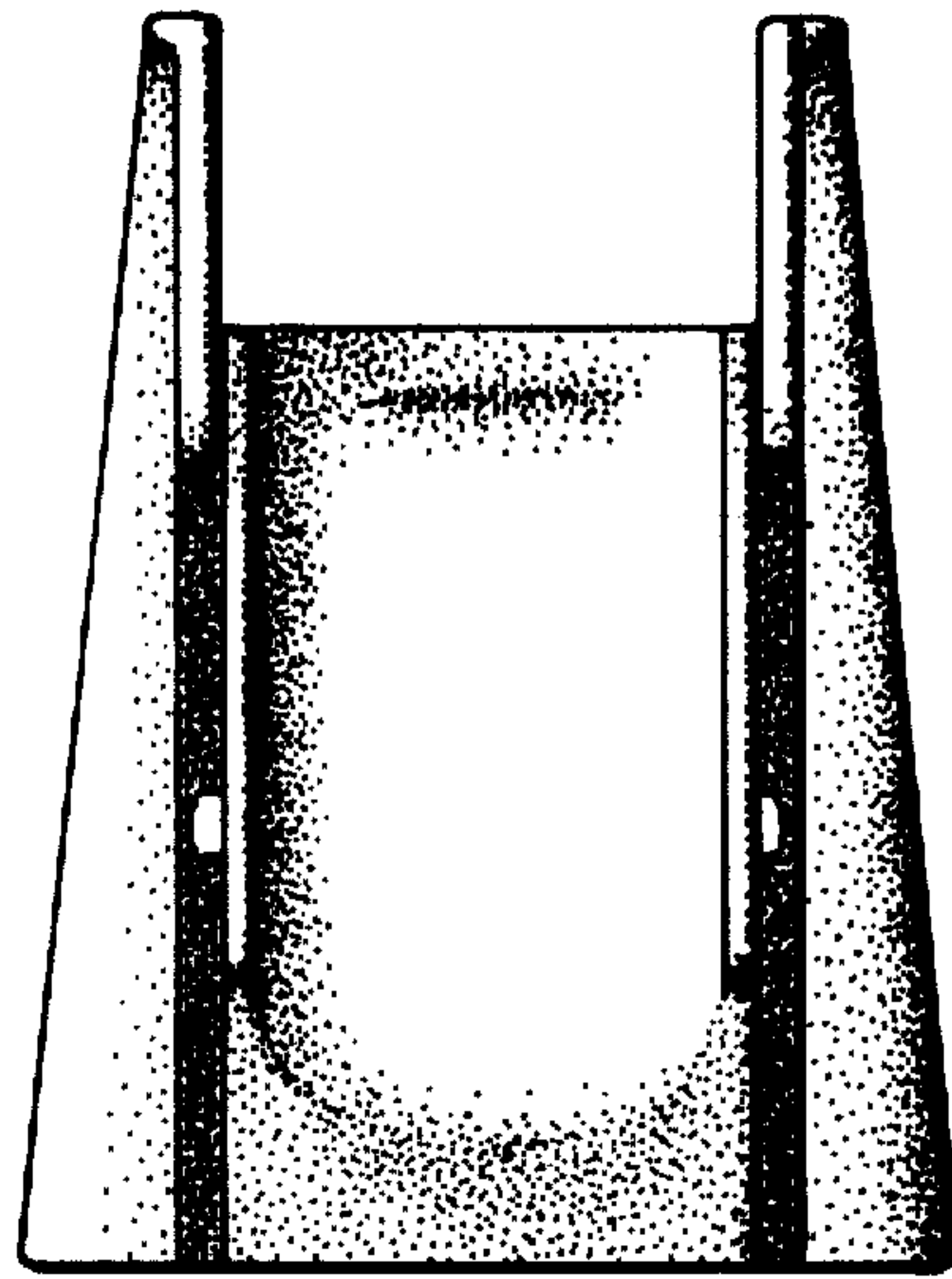

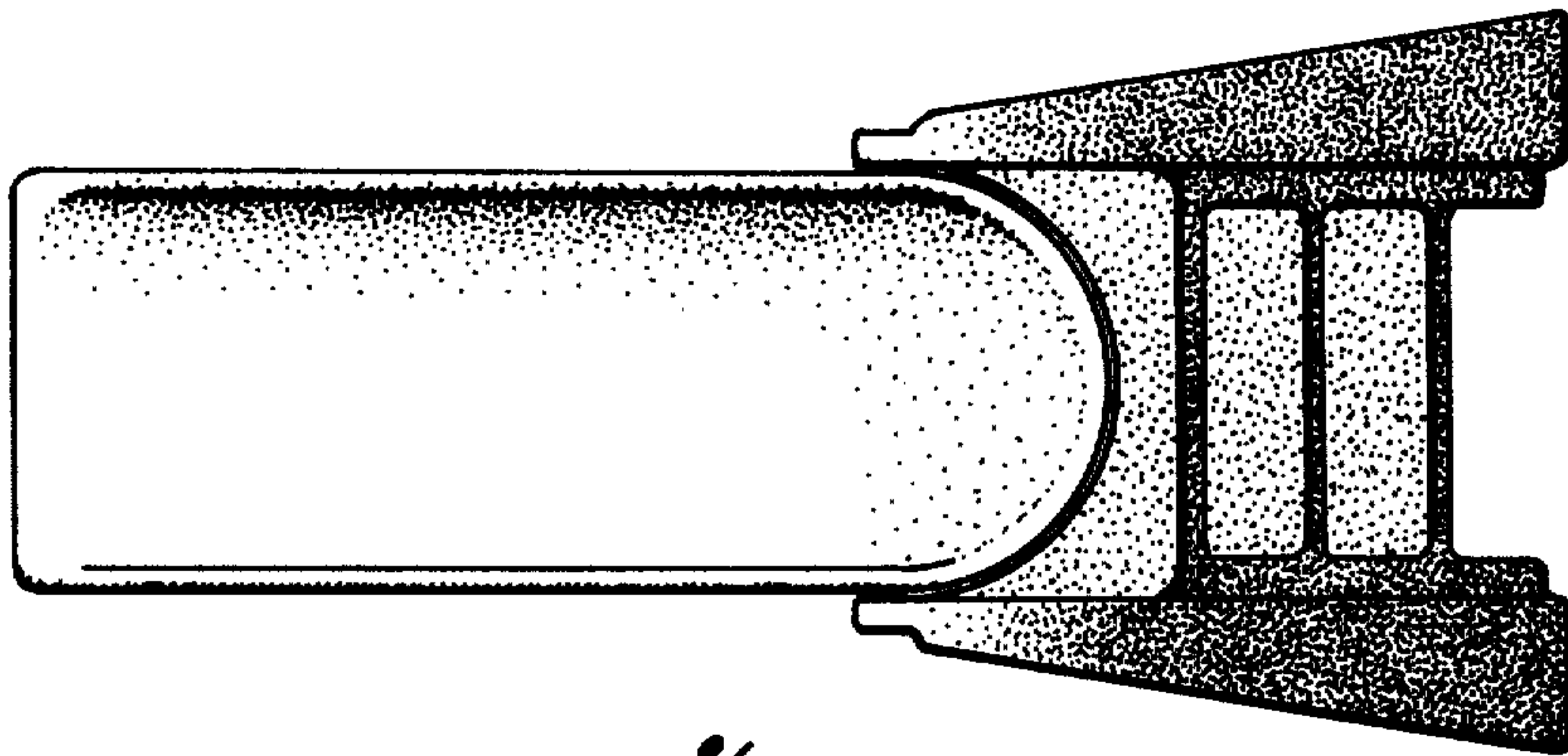

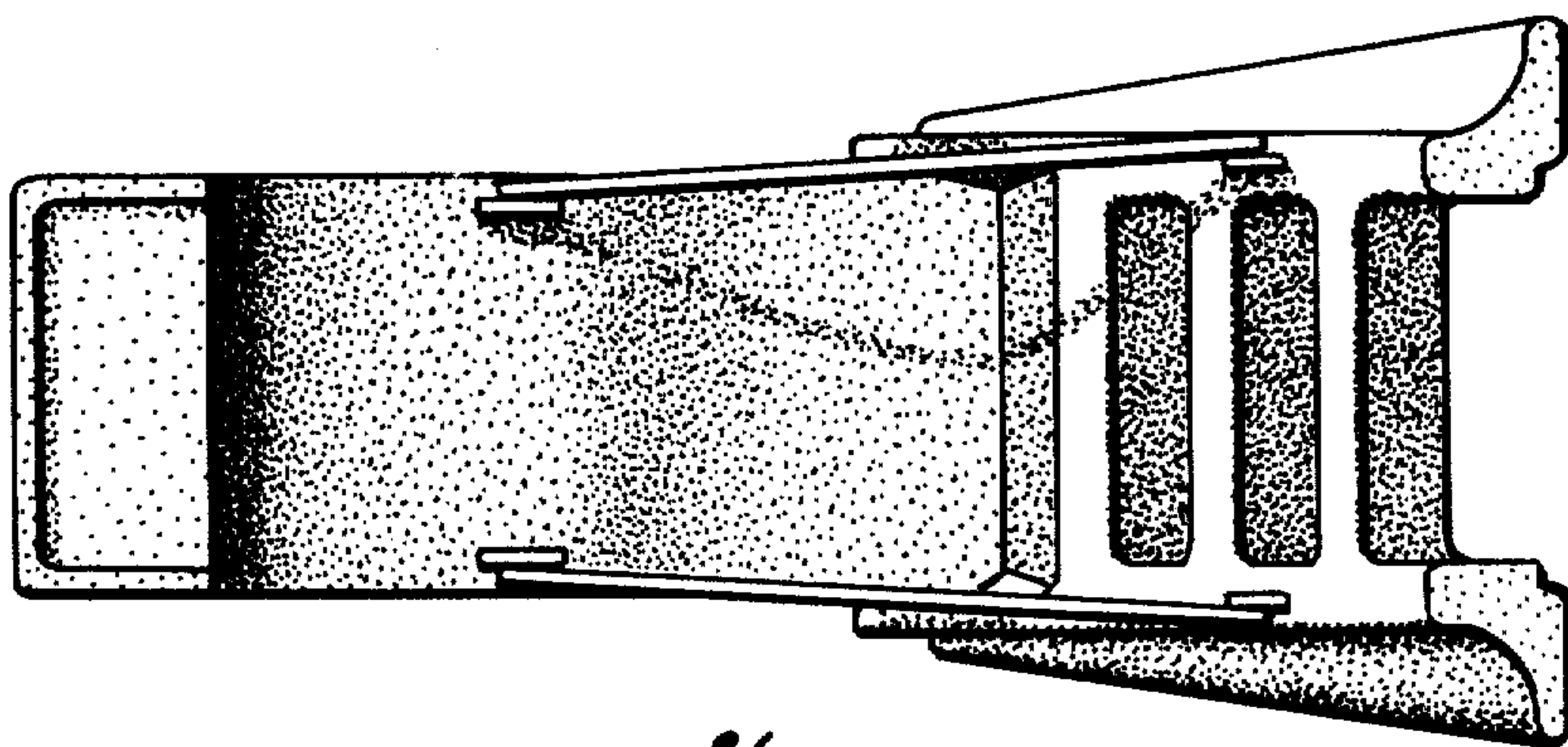
