DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a stackable plastic crate showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view taken from the right of the crate;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view taken from the left of the crate;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof, and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

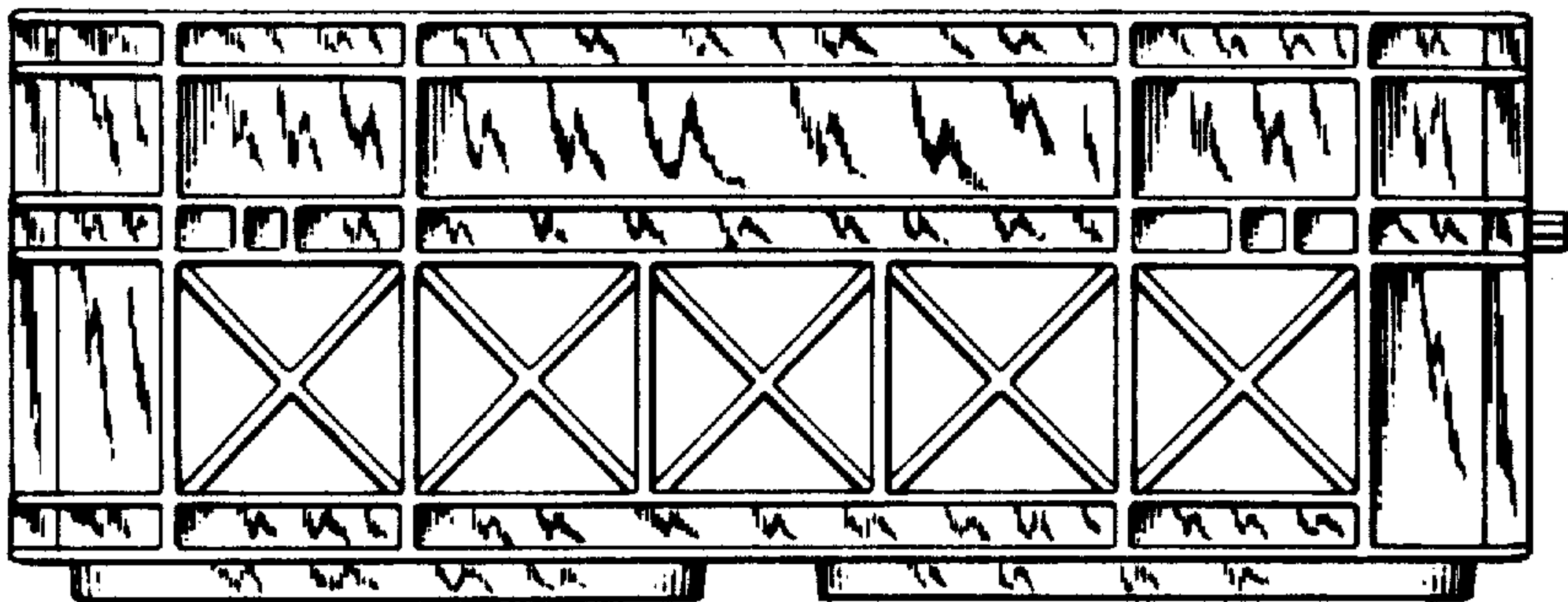

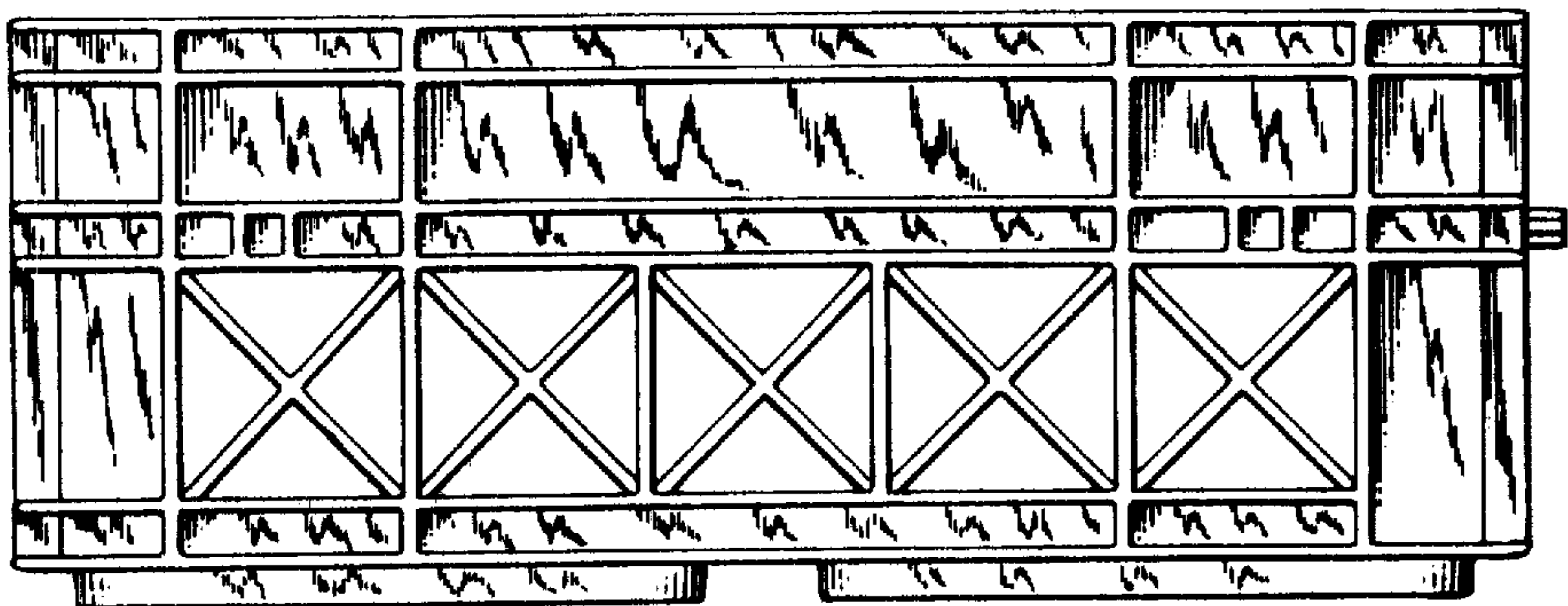

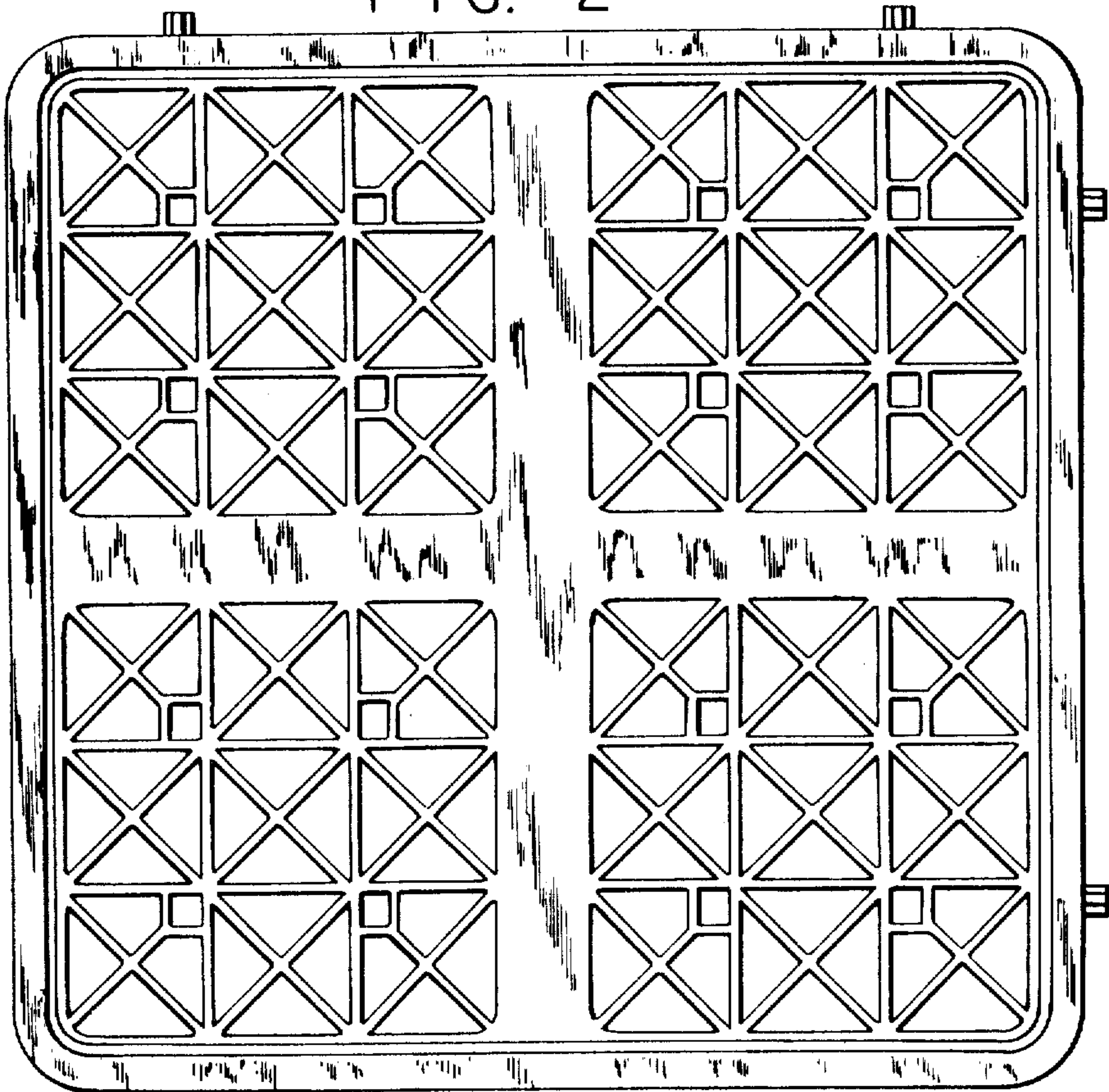

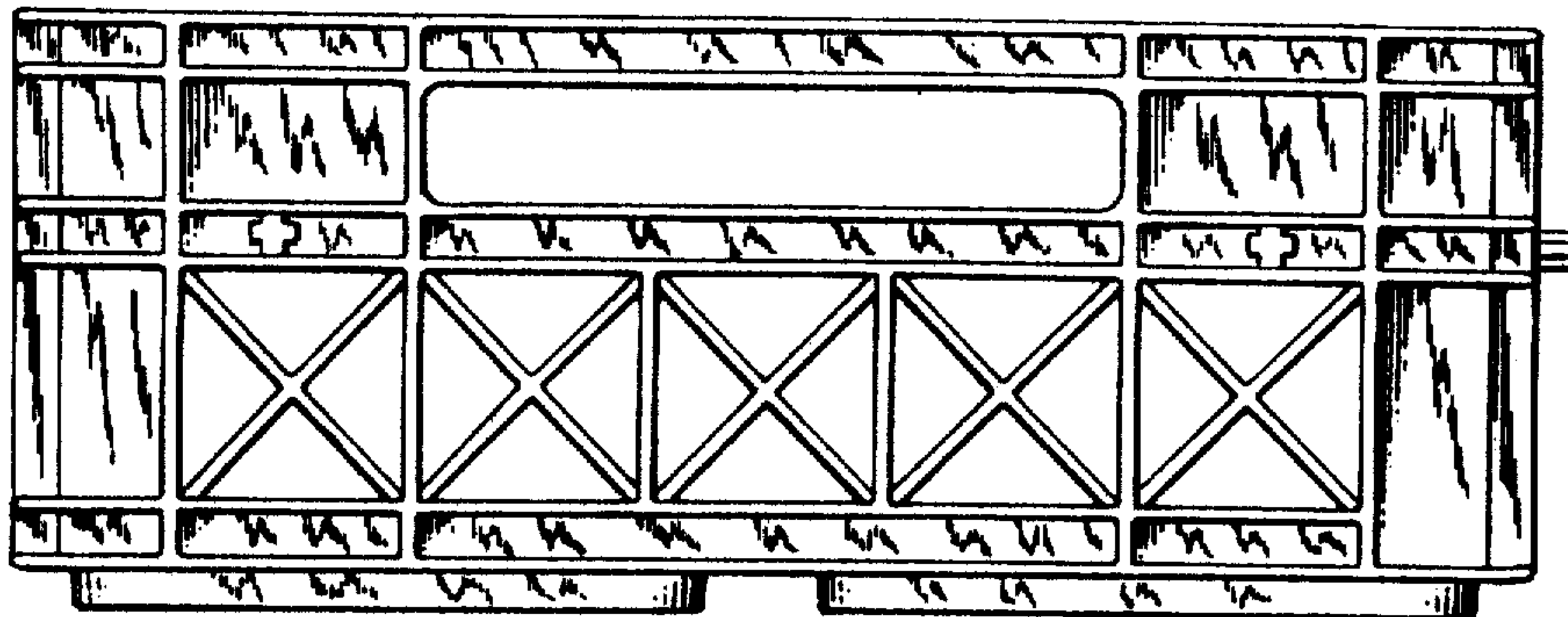

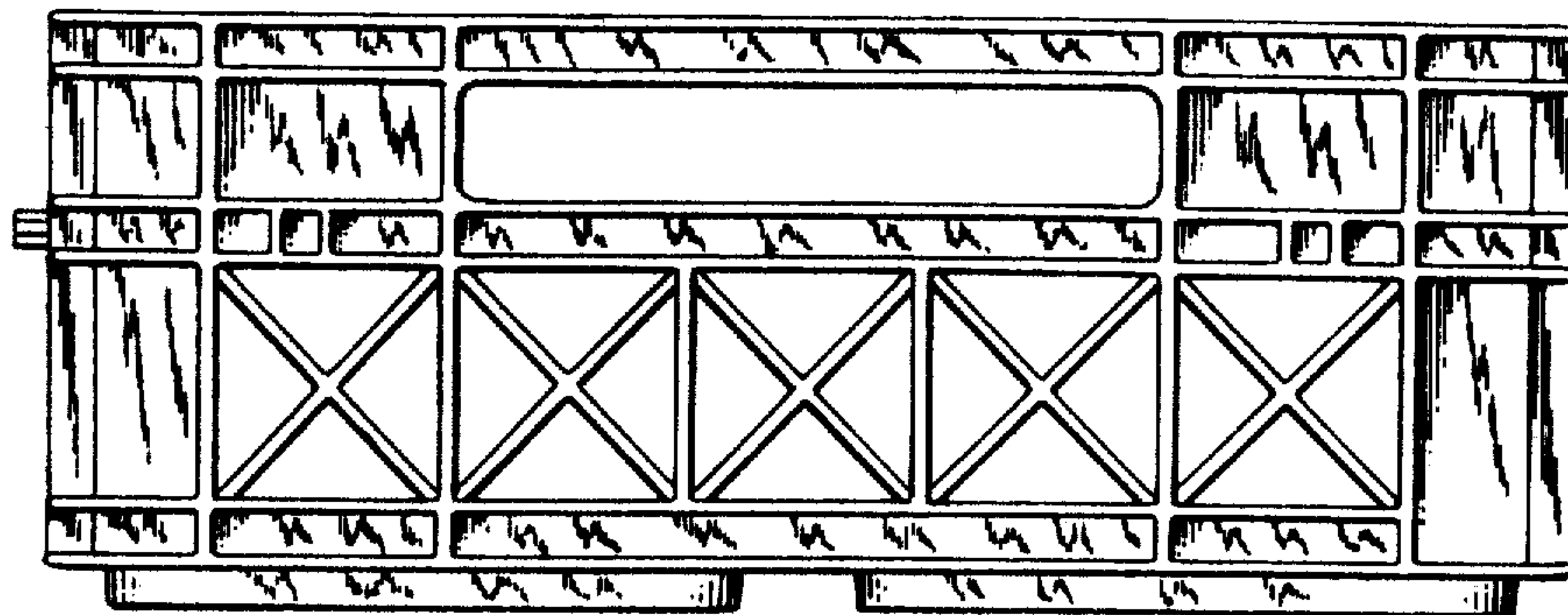

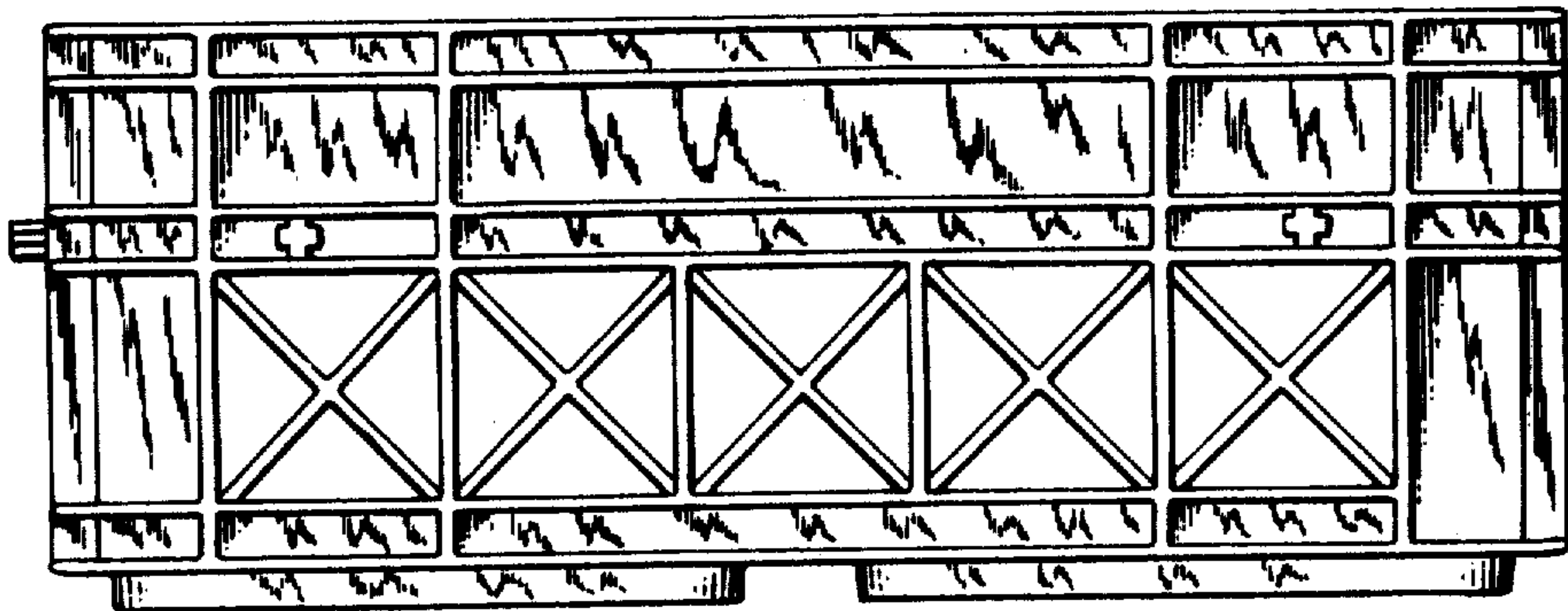
