[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a quilted bedspread, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a quilted bedspread showing my new design, with the broken lines used to form the roses indicating embroidery; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view; FIG. 4 is a top plan view; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view; and FIG. 7 is a fragmentary sectional view taken along arrows 7—7 in FIGS. 1 and 6.

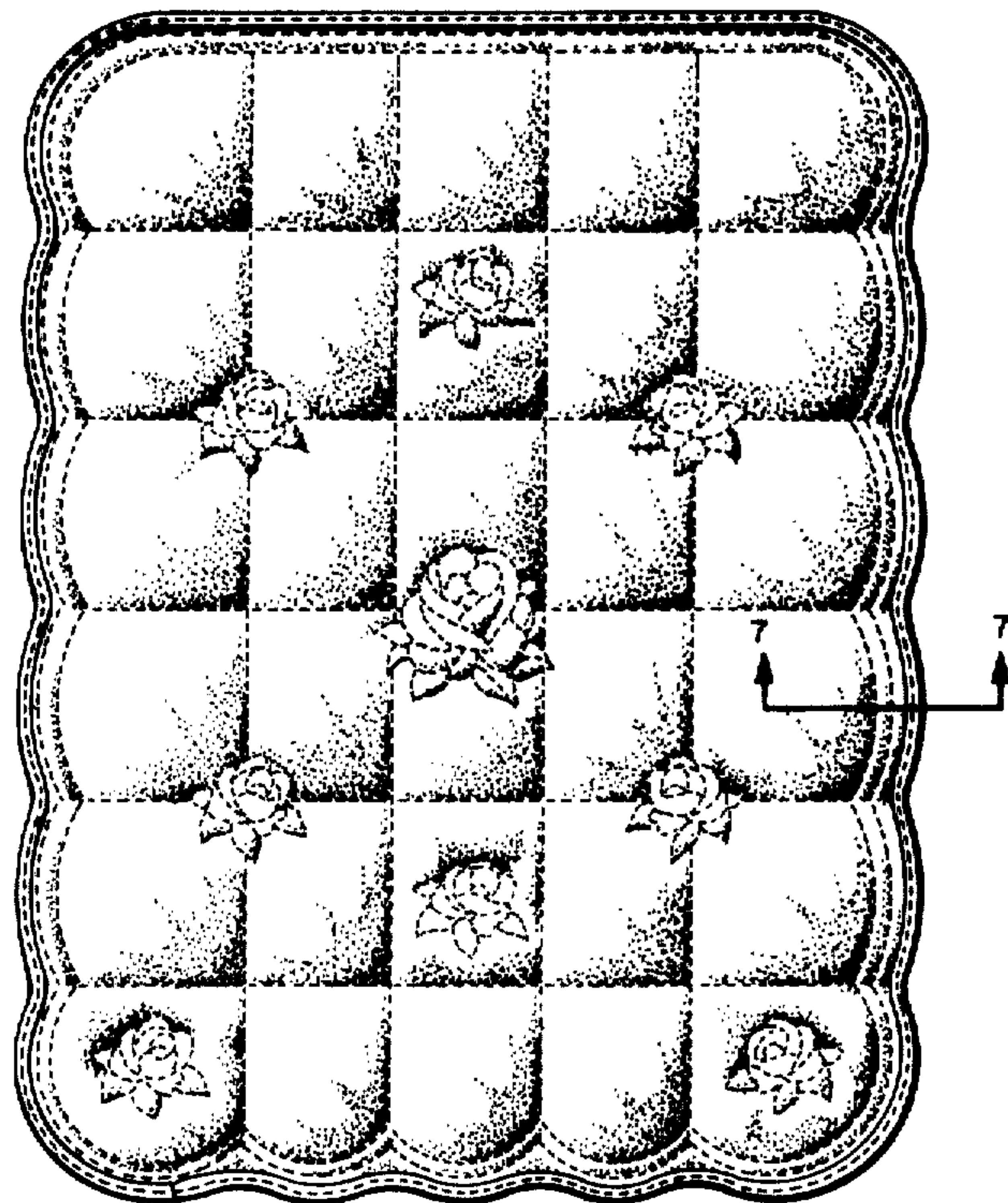

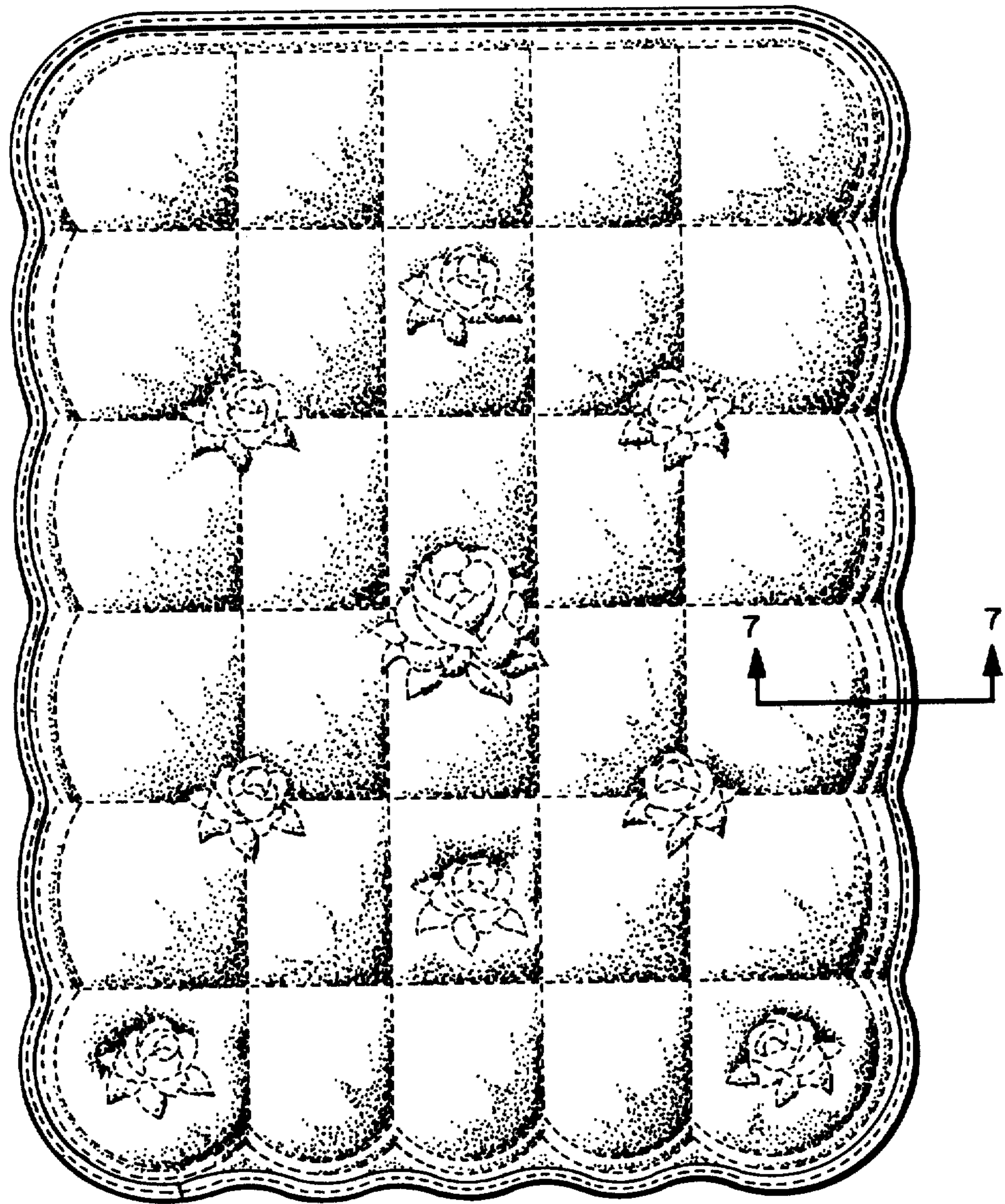

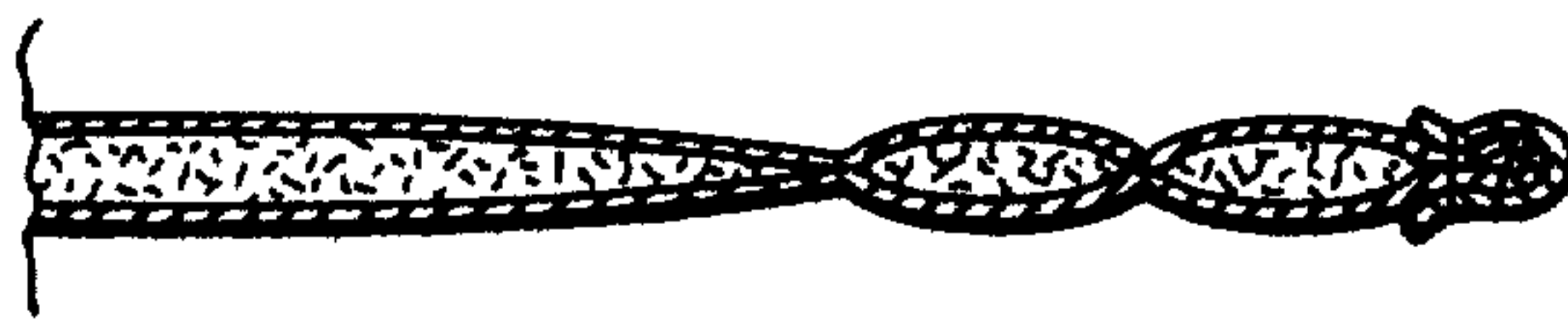
