The ornamental design for a security system console, as shown and described.

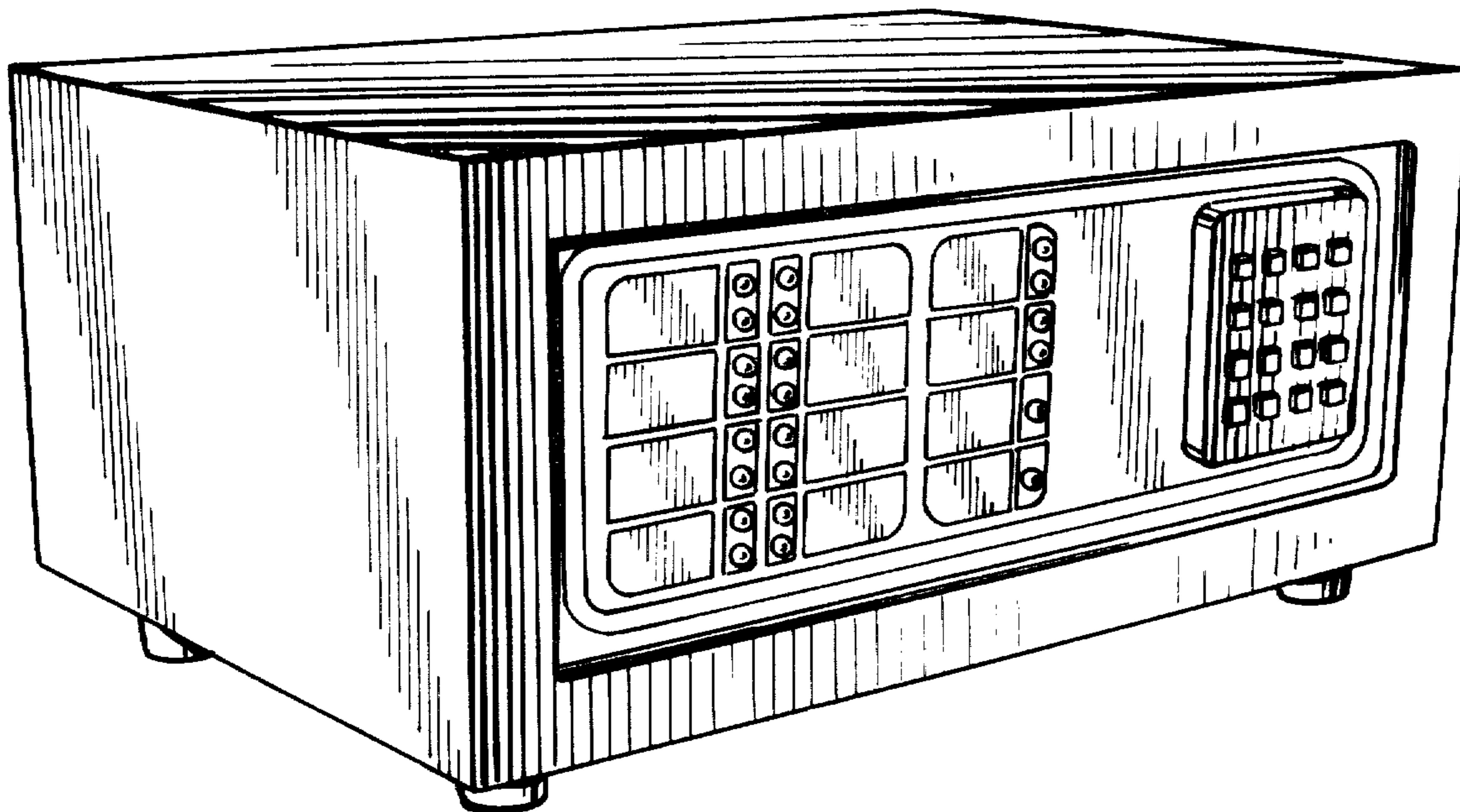
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a fragmentary sectional view taken along line 4-4 of FIG. 3.



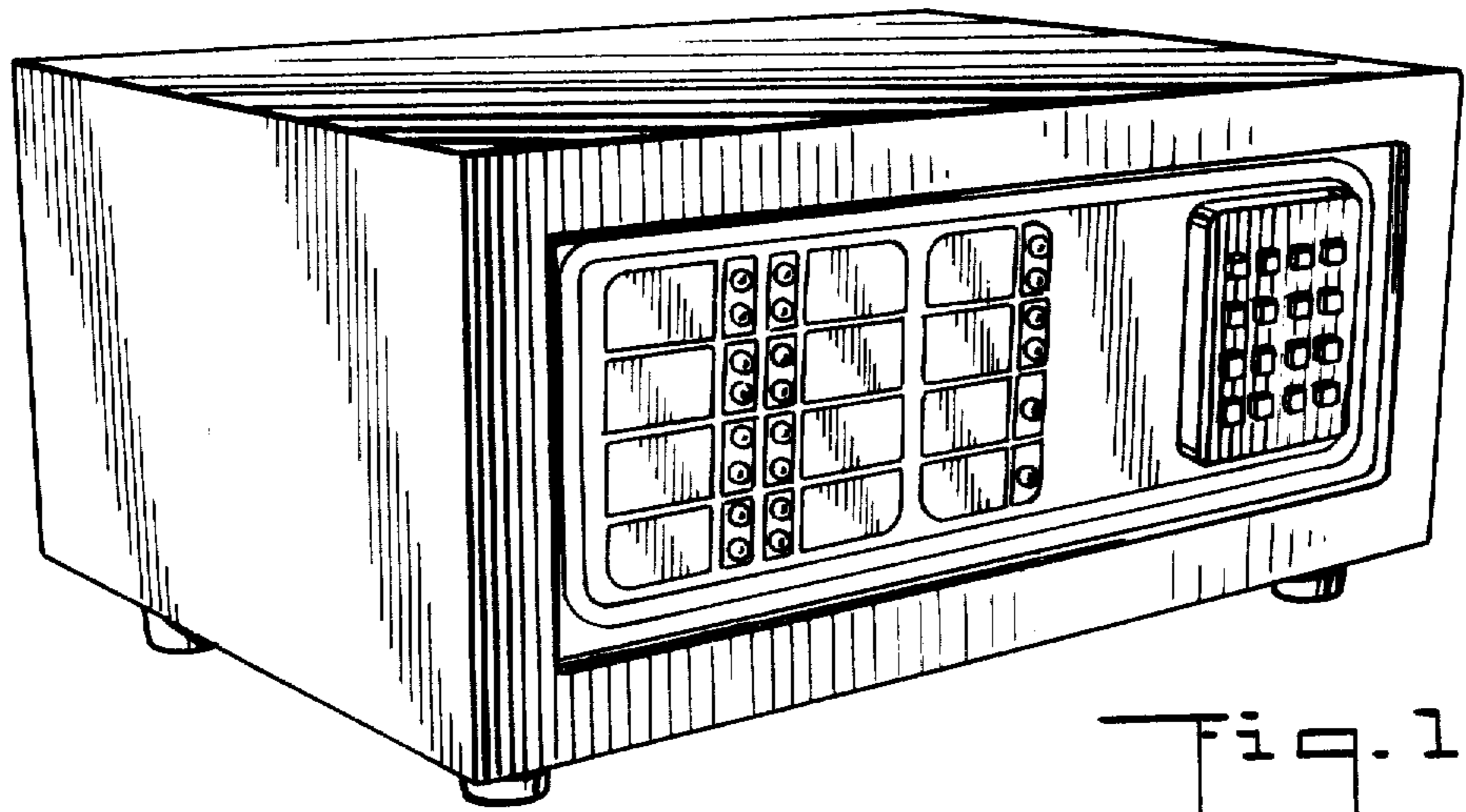

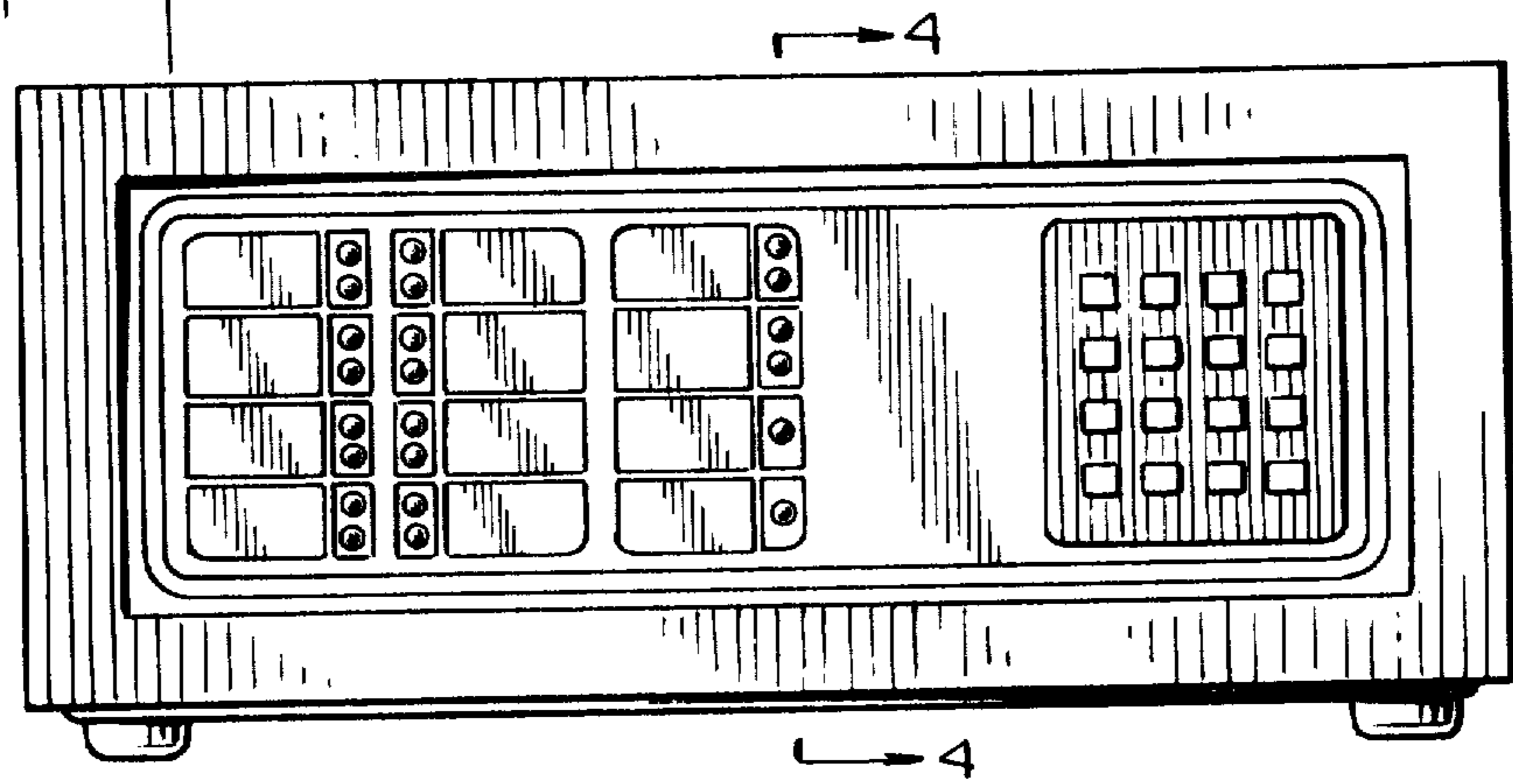

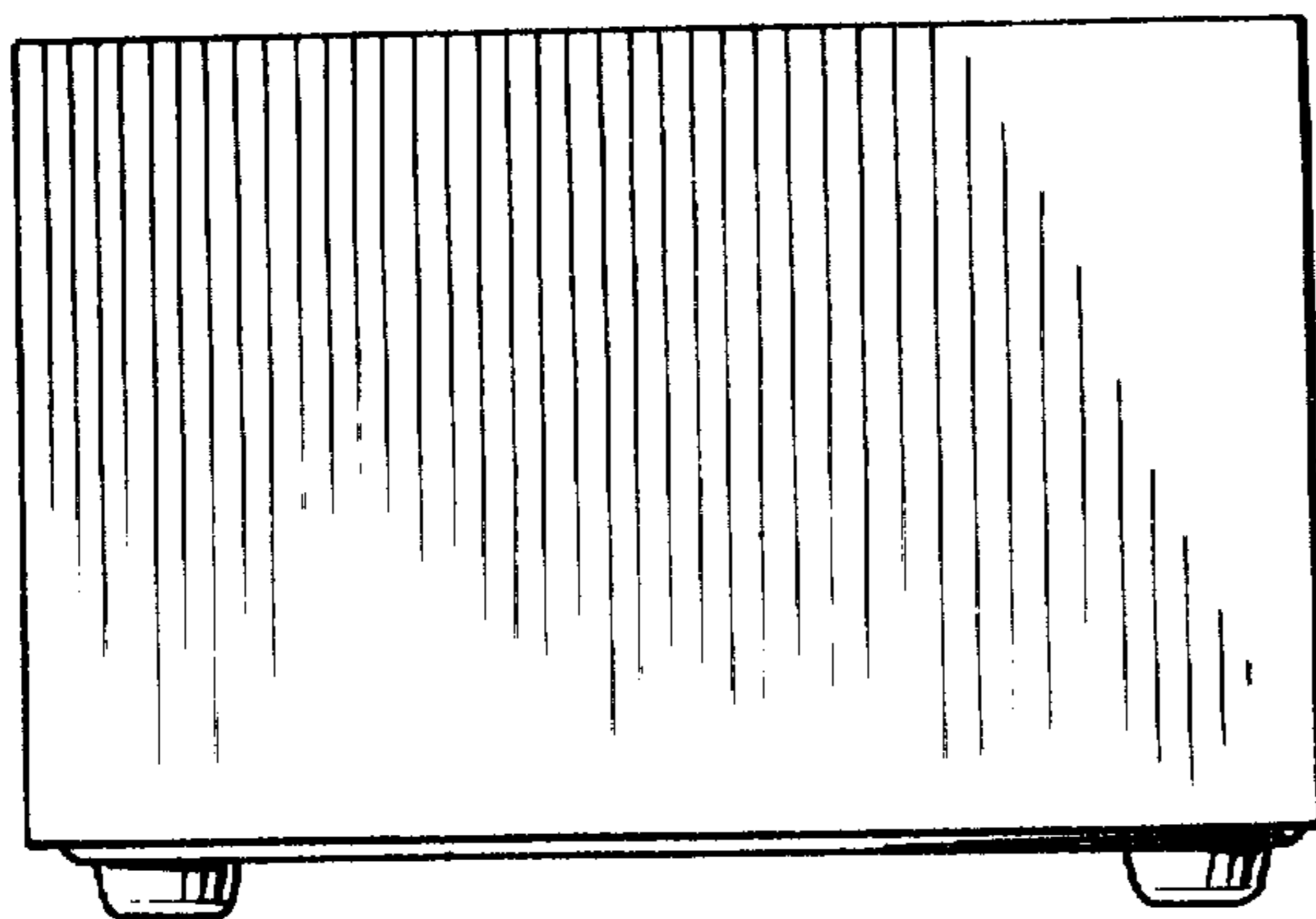
