[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an electronic teaching and entertainment housing or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an electronic teaching and entertainment housing or similar article, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the housing of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the housing of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the housing of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a right-side elevational view of the housing of FIG. 1.

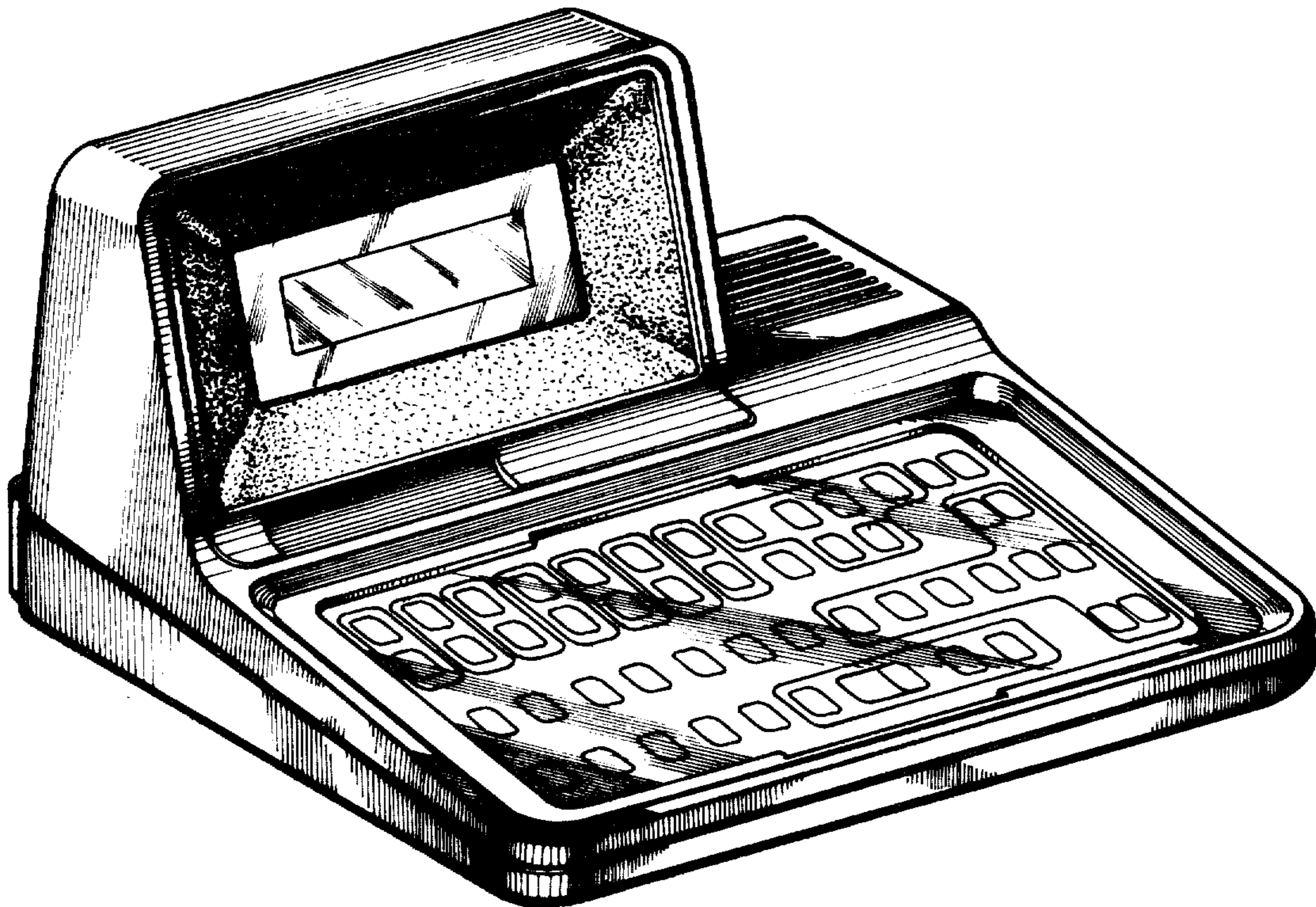

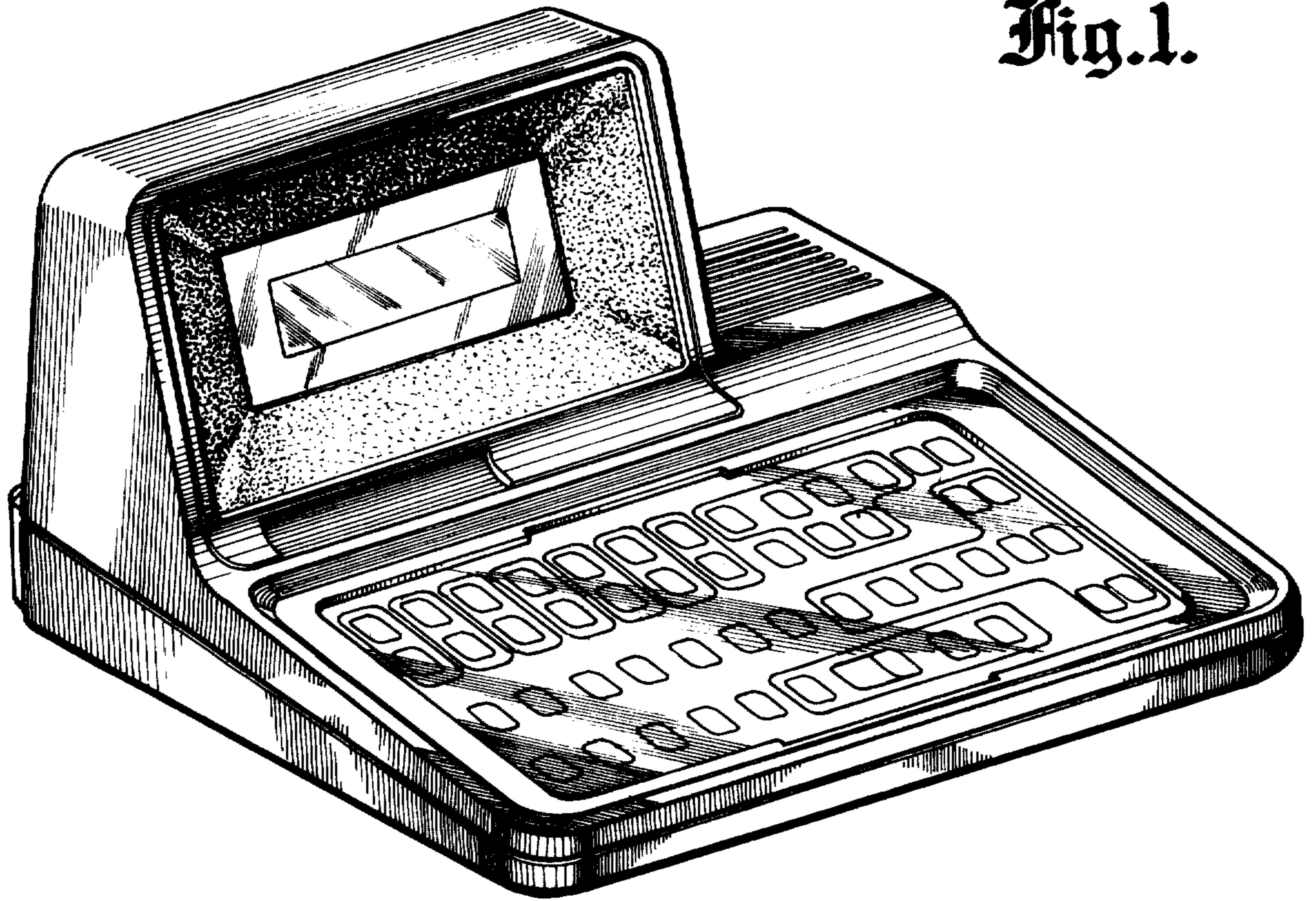
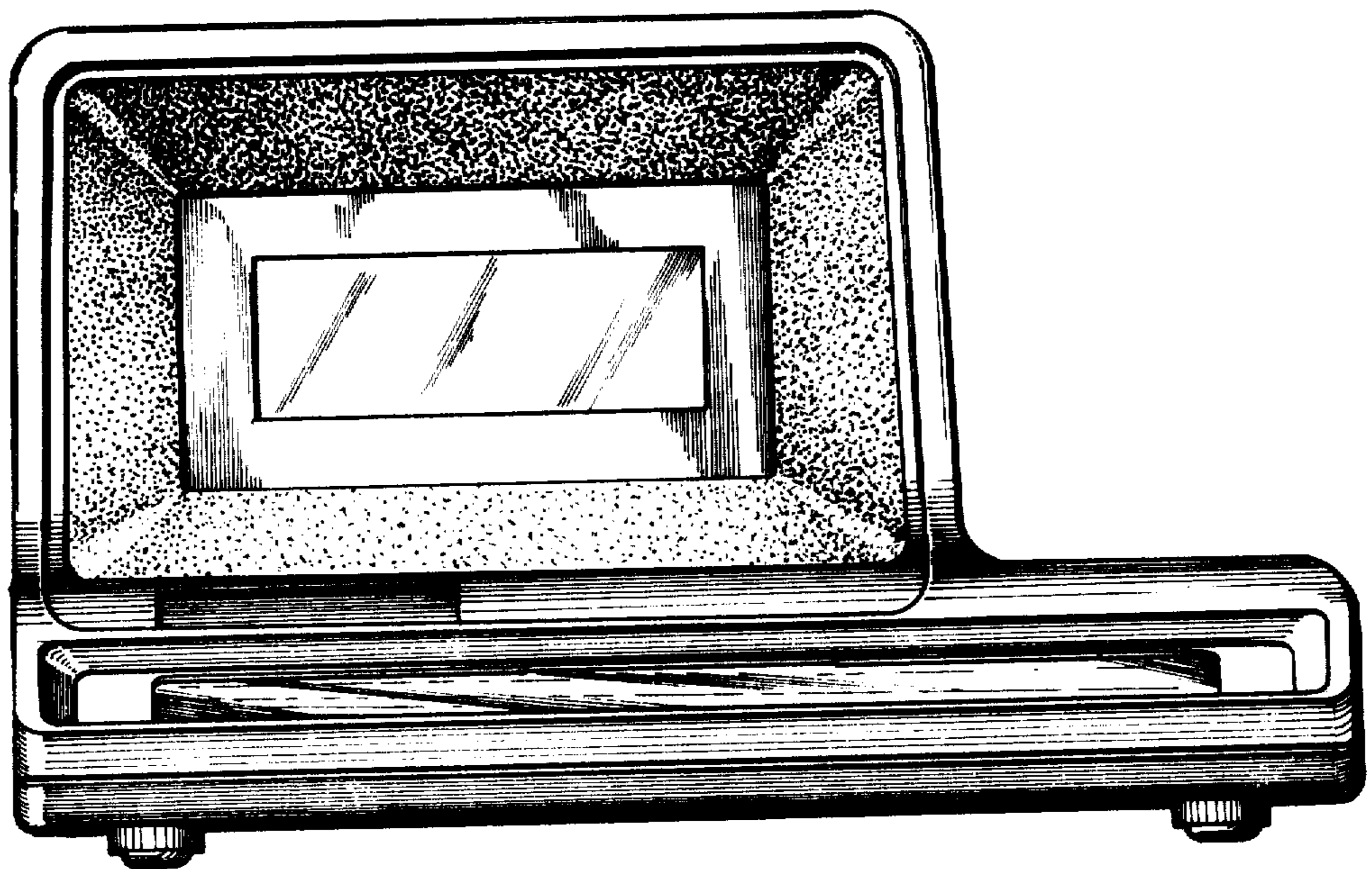

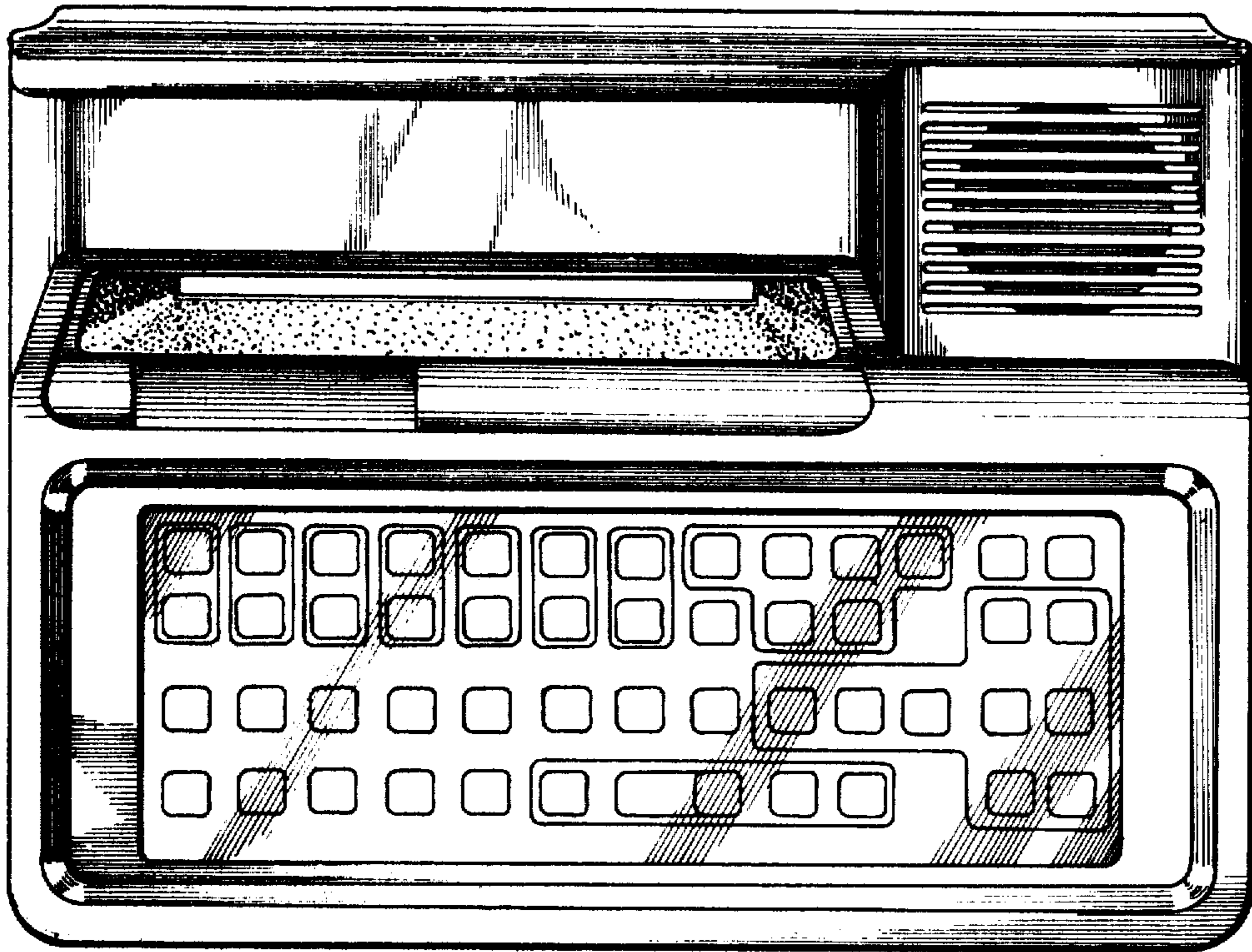
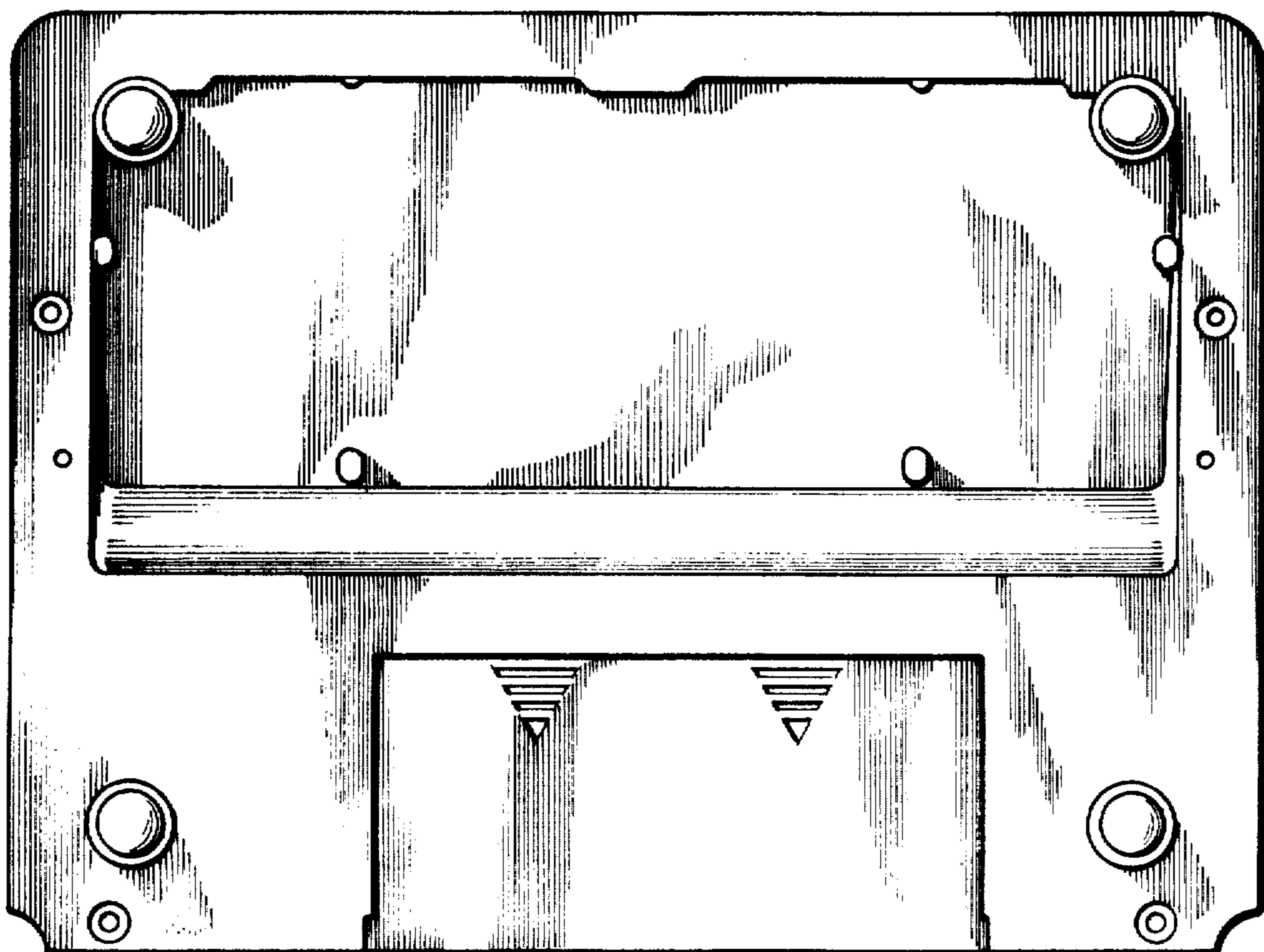

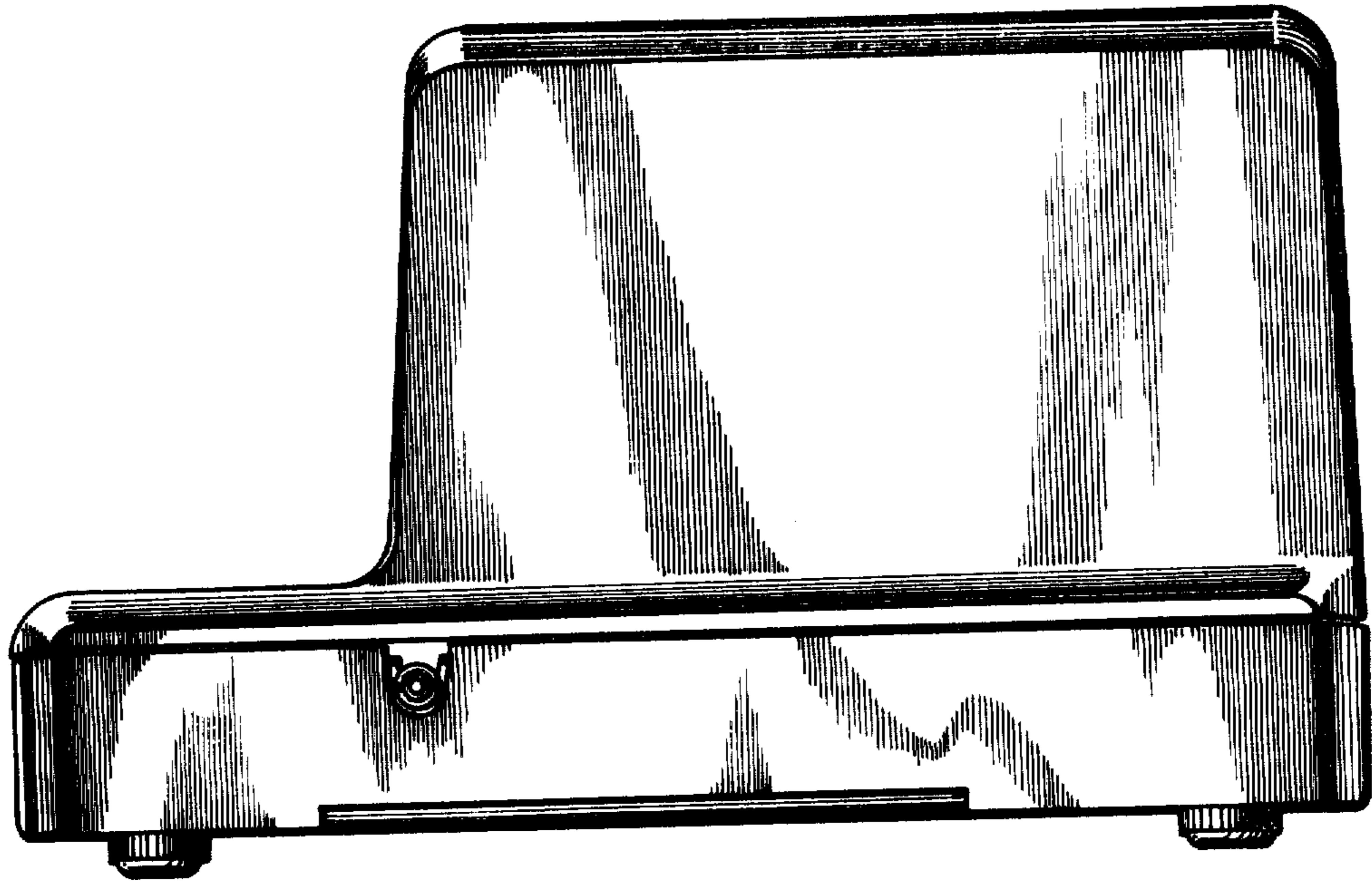

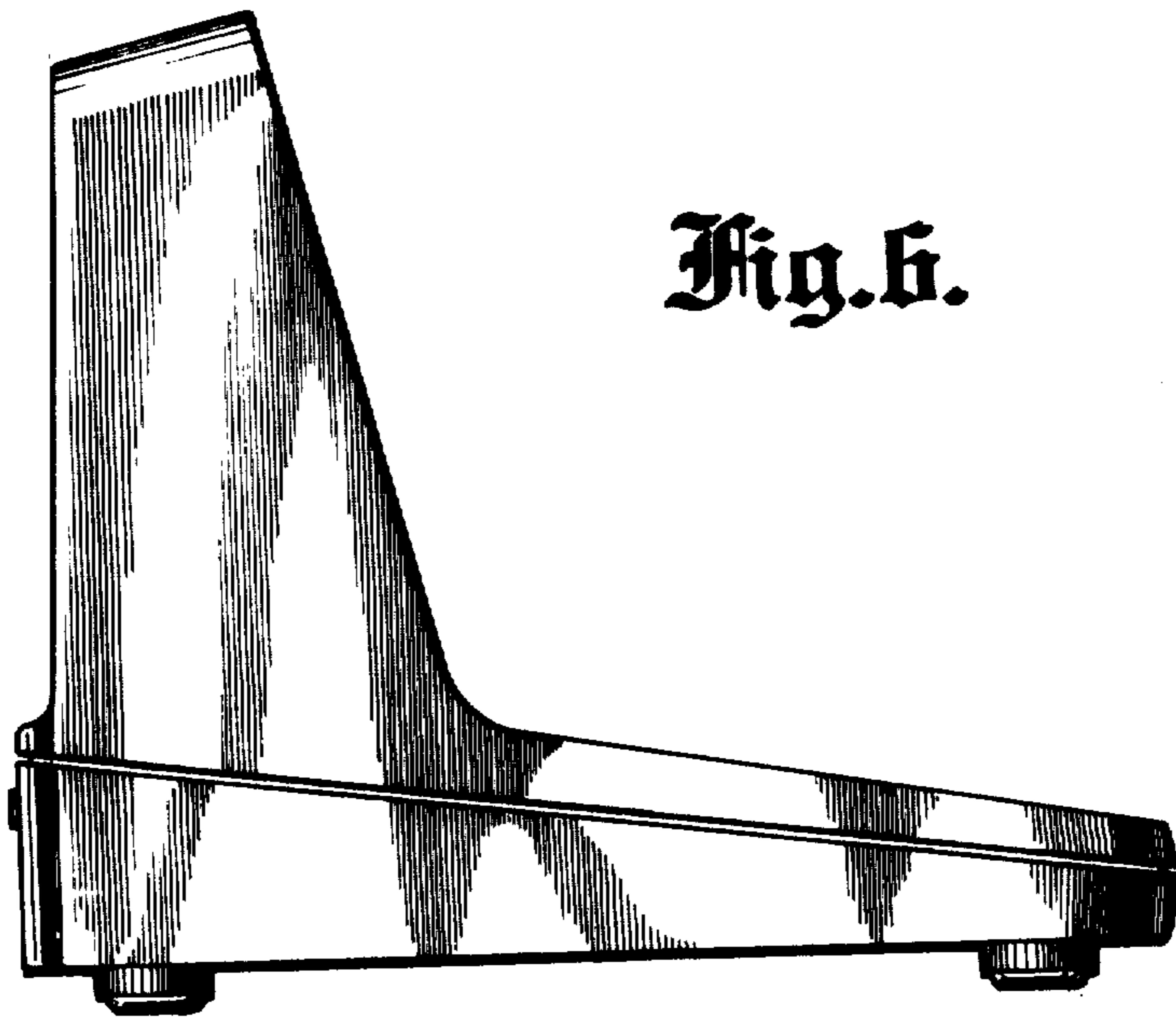

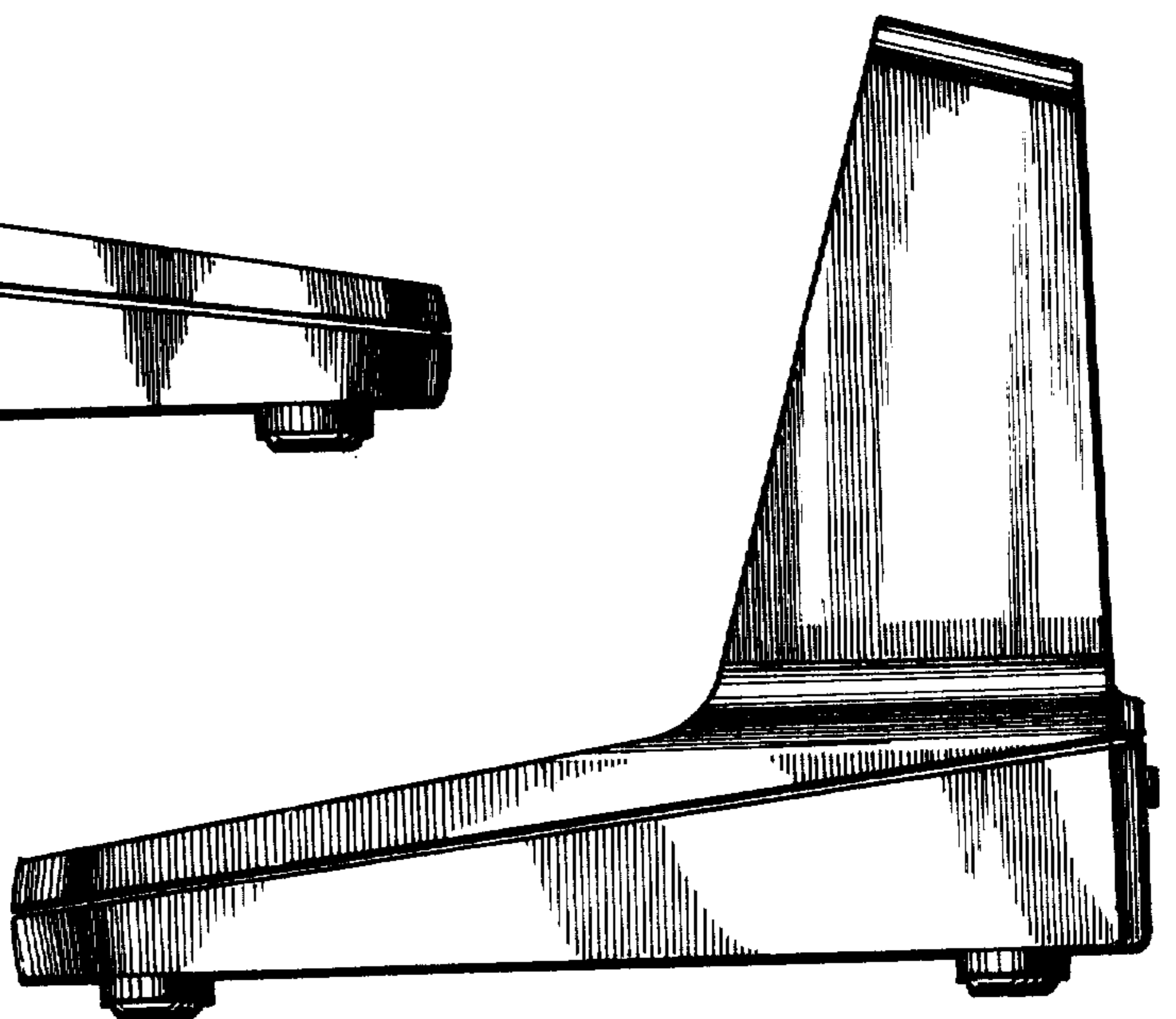
