The ornamental design of a back cabinet for pinball game, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a back cabinet for a pinball game showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.

The fragmentary broken line showing of the lower pinball cabinet and pinball playfield are for purposes of illustration only. The back side of the back cabinet is plain and unornamented.
