## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a seating unit embodying the design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the seating unit of FIG. 1:

FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the seating unit of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of a modified form of seating unit embodying the design;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the seating unit of FIG. 4;

FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the seating unit of FIG. 4; FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of another modified form of a seating unit embodying the design;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of the seating unit of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a bottom view of the seating unit of FIG. 7; FIG. 10 is a side elevational view of still another modified form of a seating unit embodying the design;

FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of the seating unit of FIG. 10;

FIG. 12 is a bottom view of the seating unit of FIG. 10; FIG. 13 is a rear elevational view of the seating unit of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 14 is a rear elevational view of the seating unit of FIG. 7.
