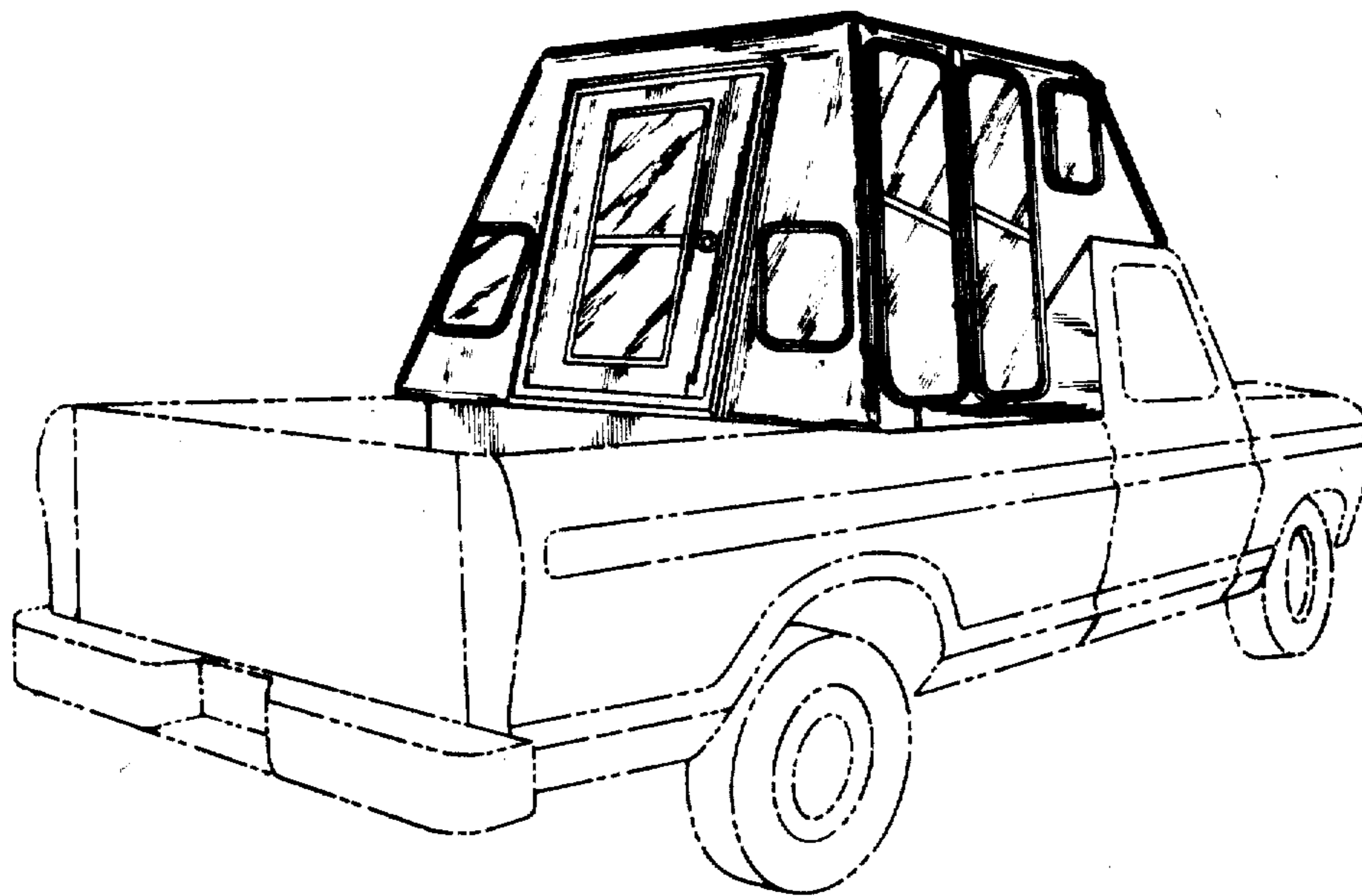

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a shell for mounting in the bed of a pickup truck, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of a recreational shell for mounting in the bed of a pickup truck showing my new design, it being understood that the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof.



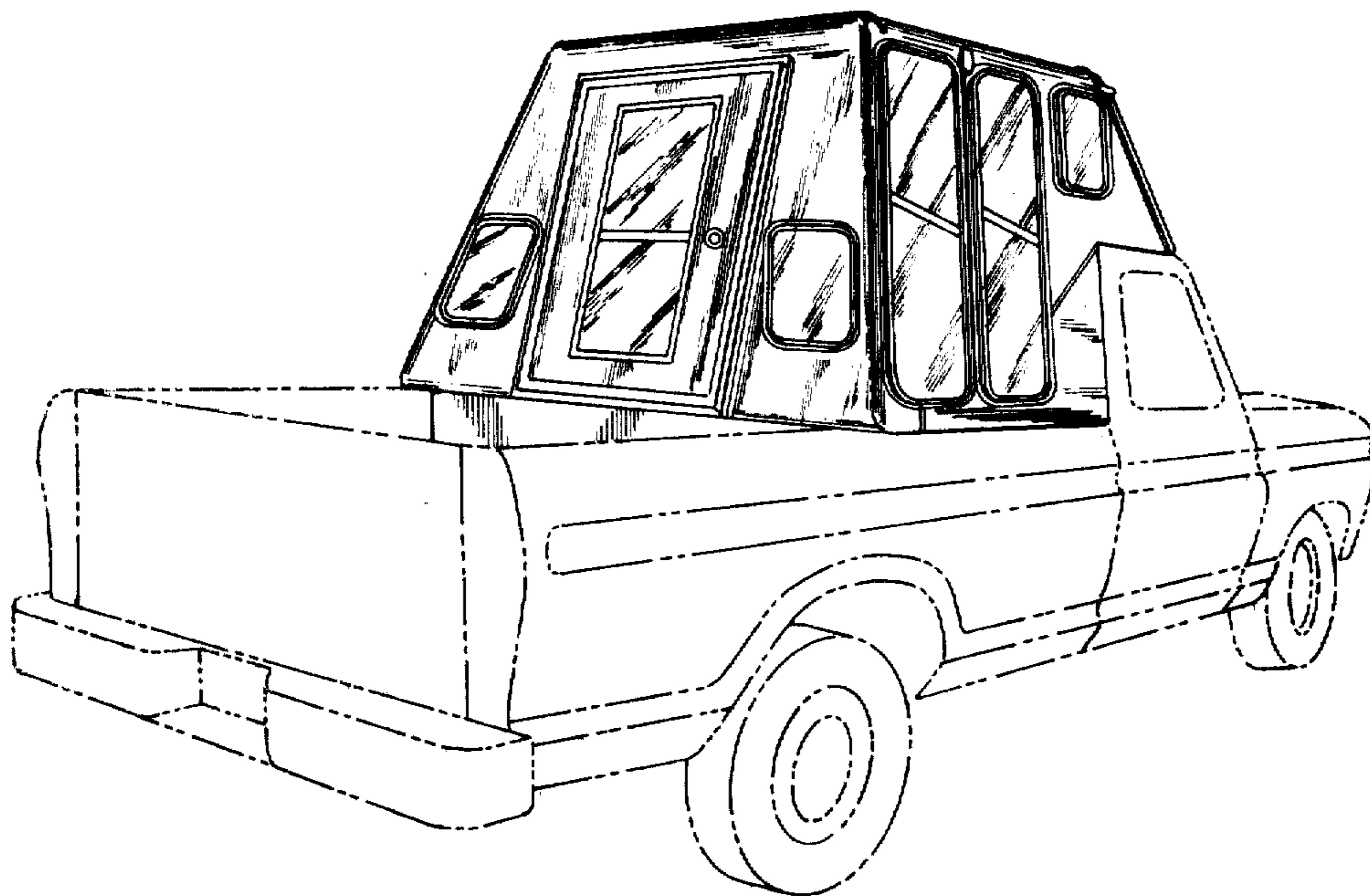

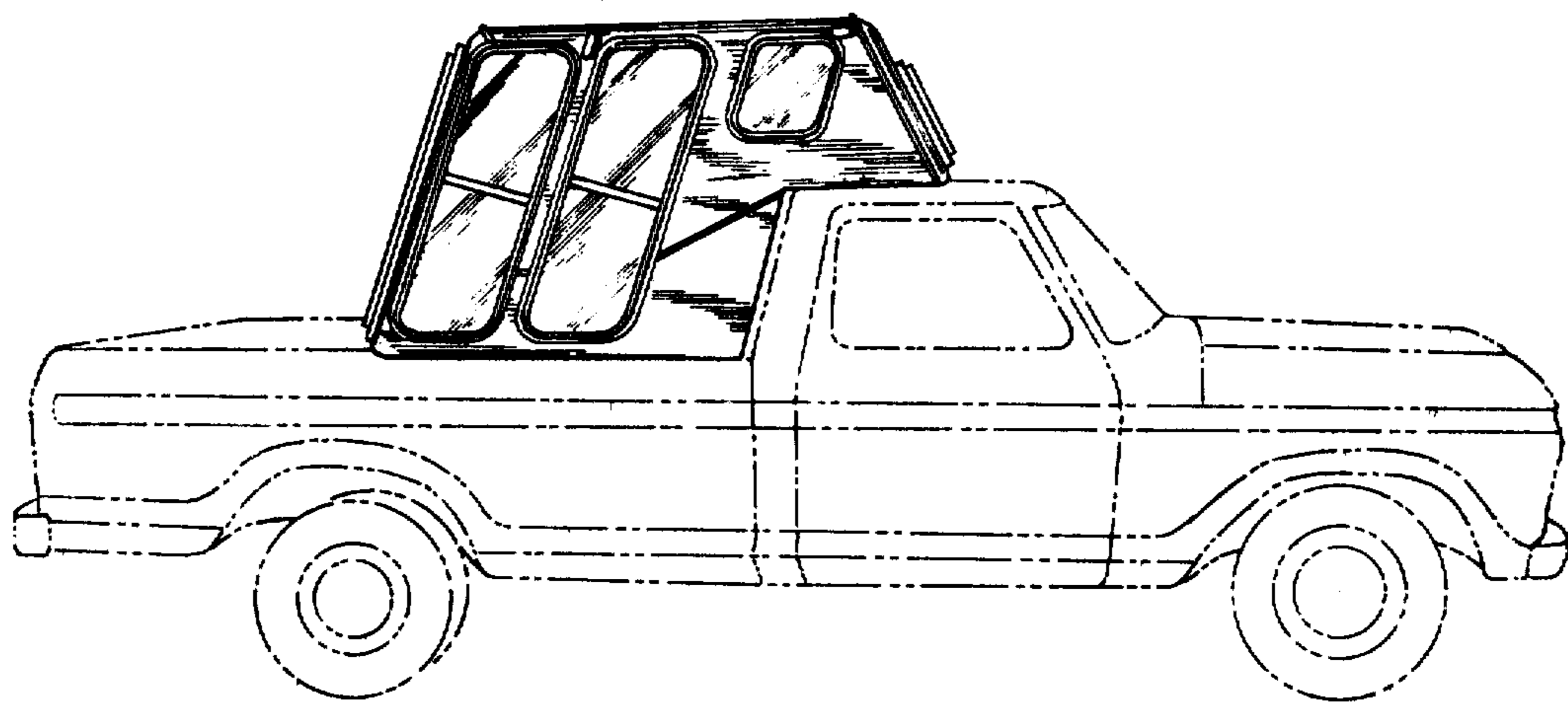
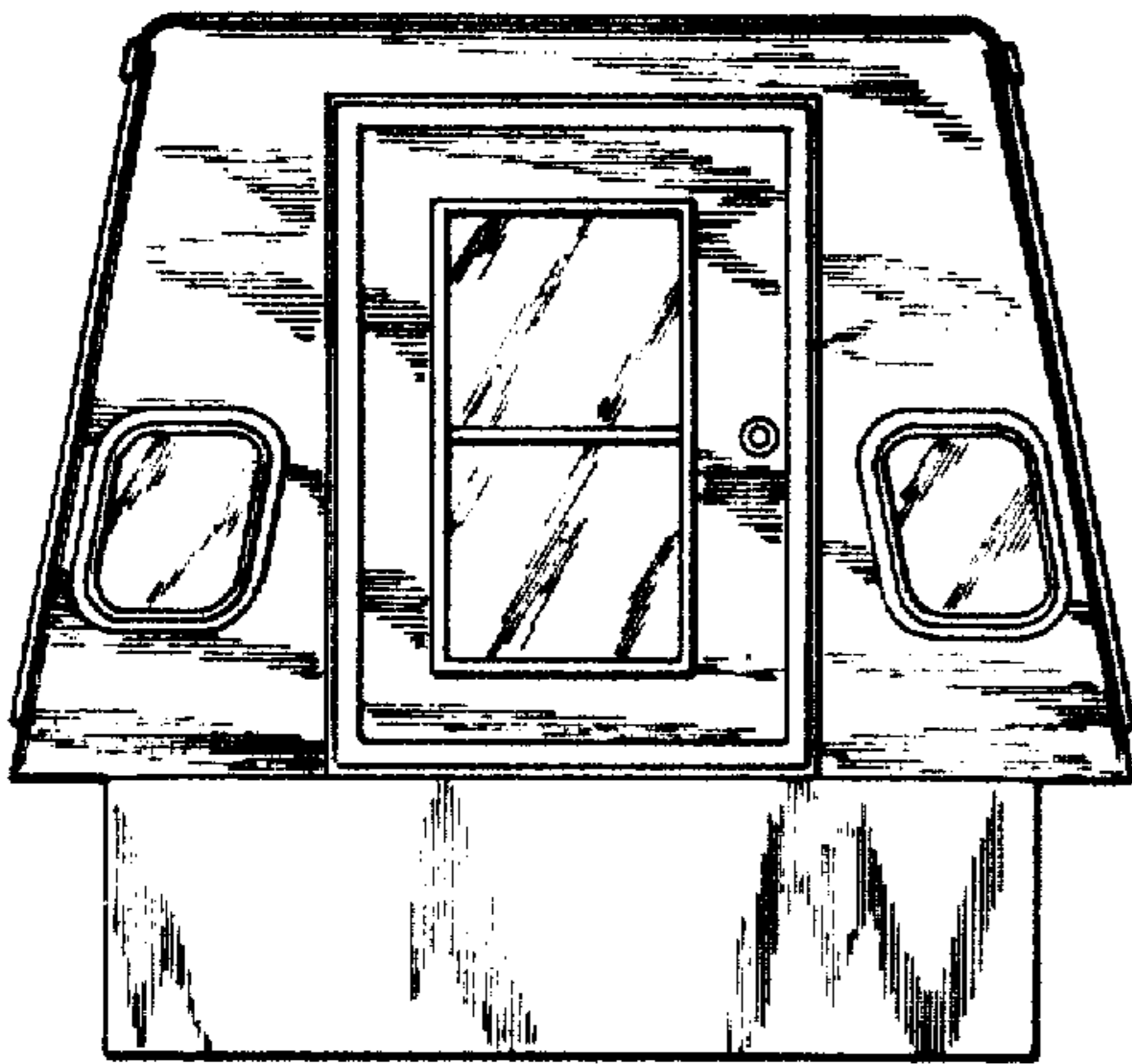
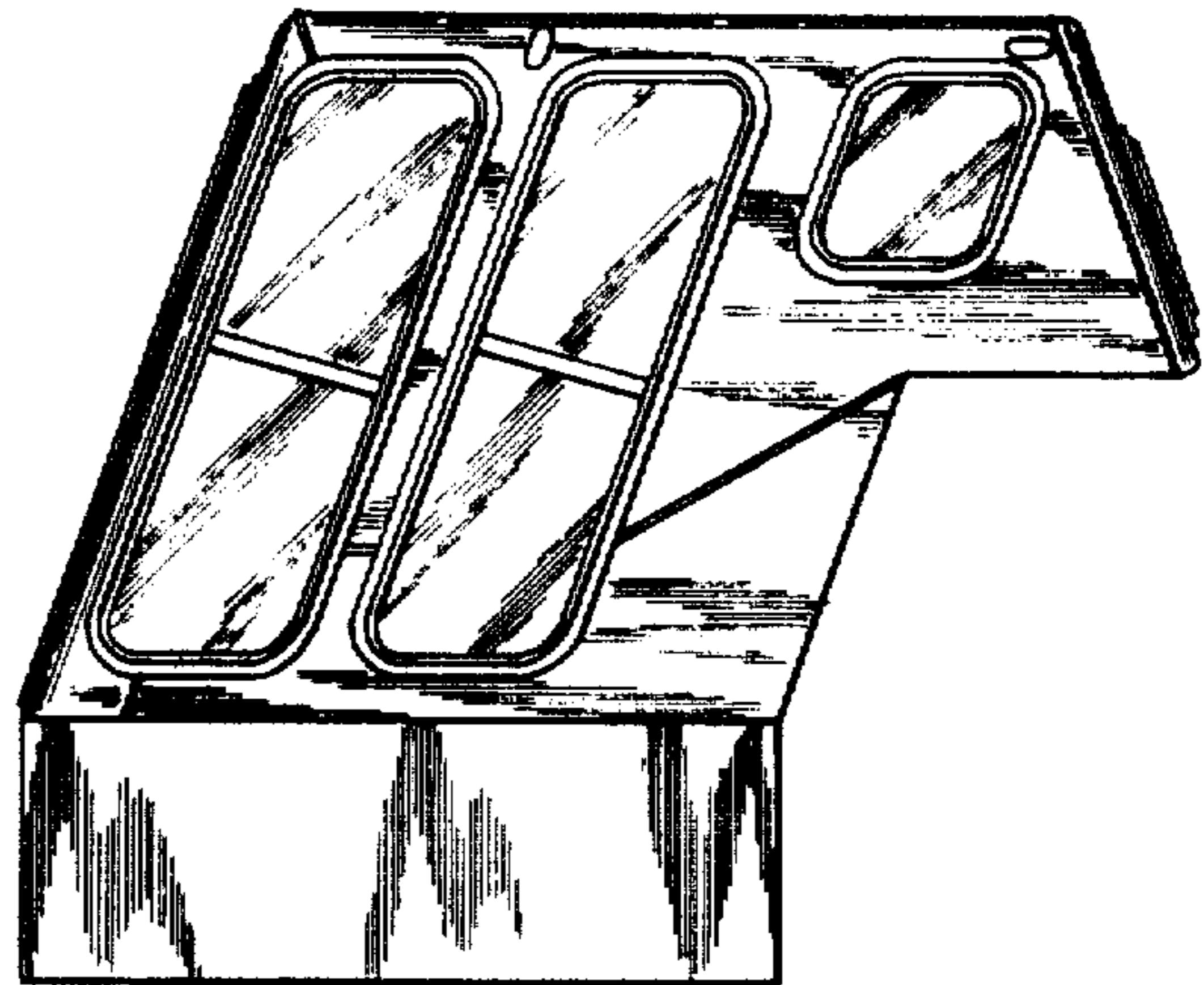


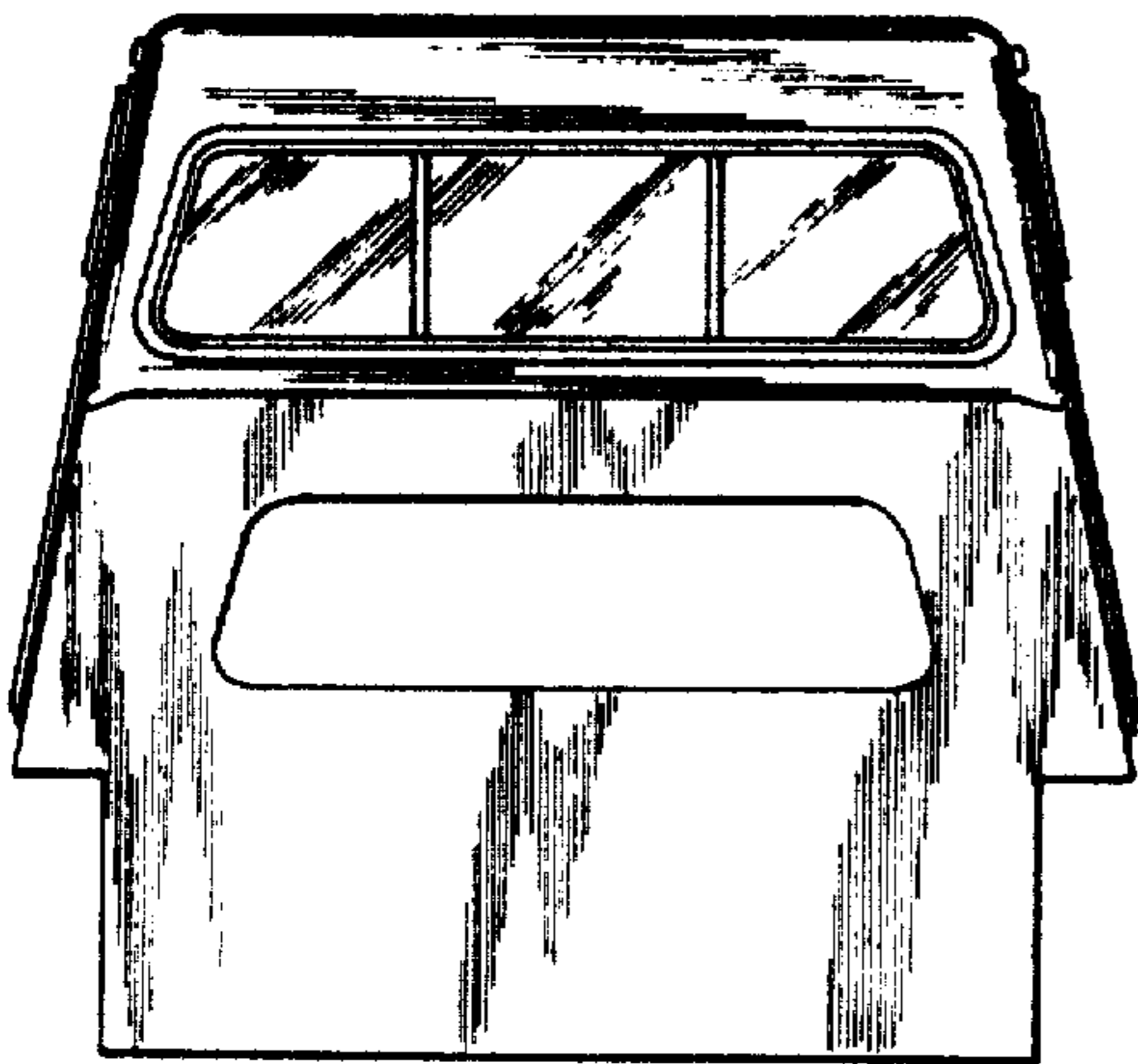

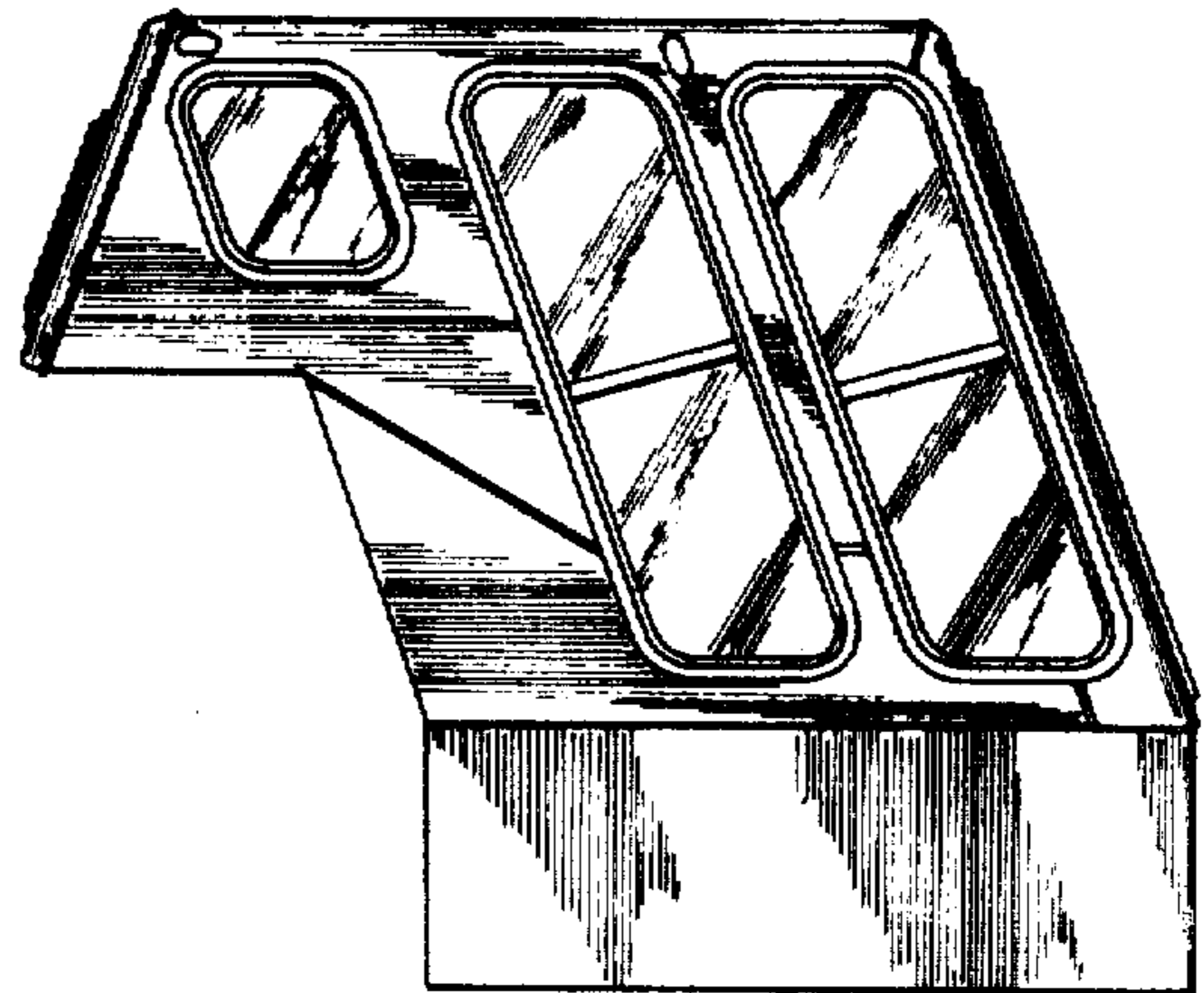

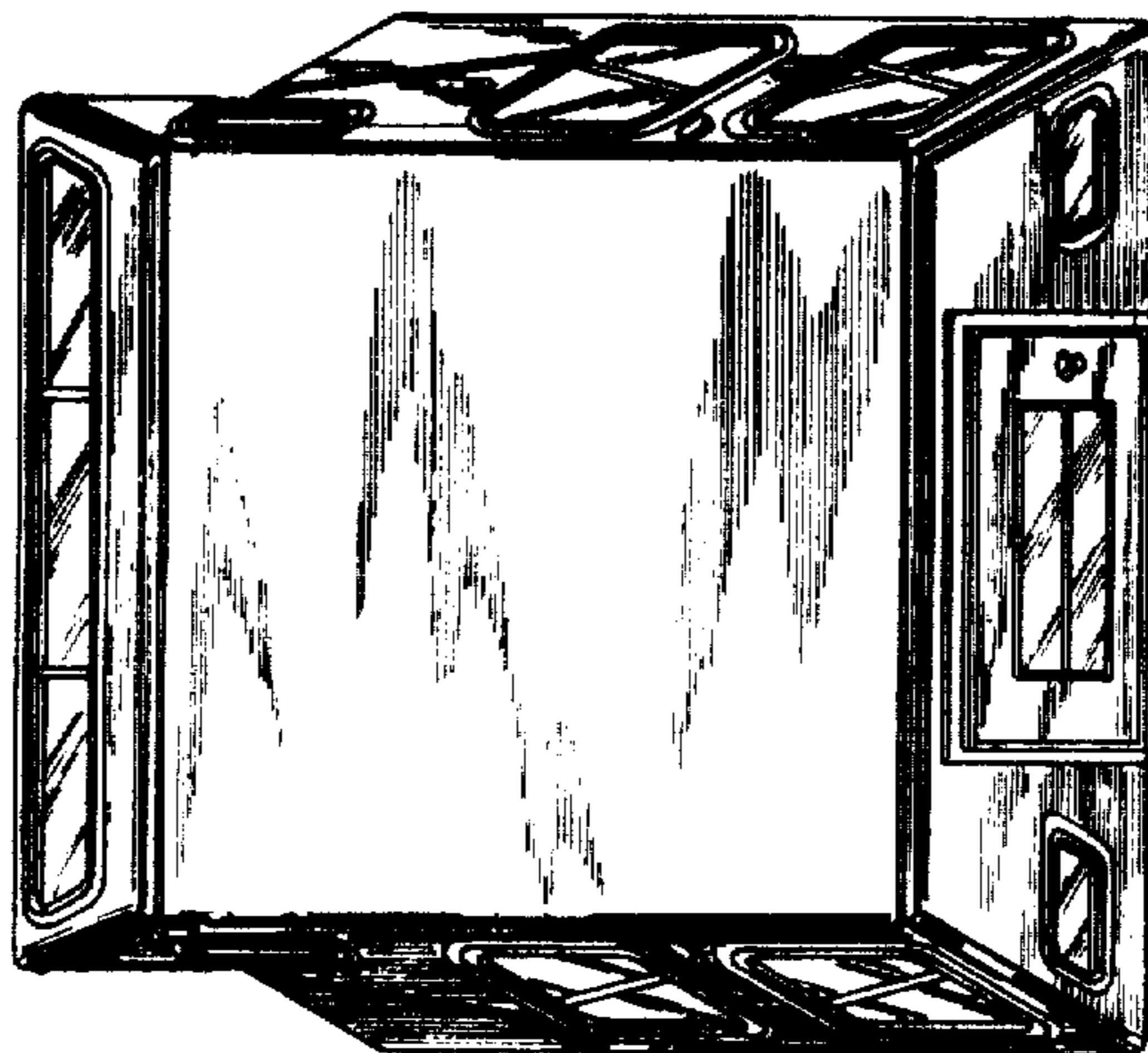
