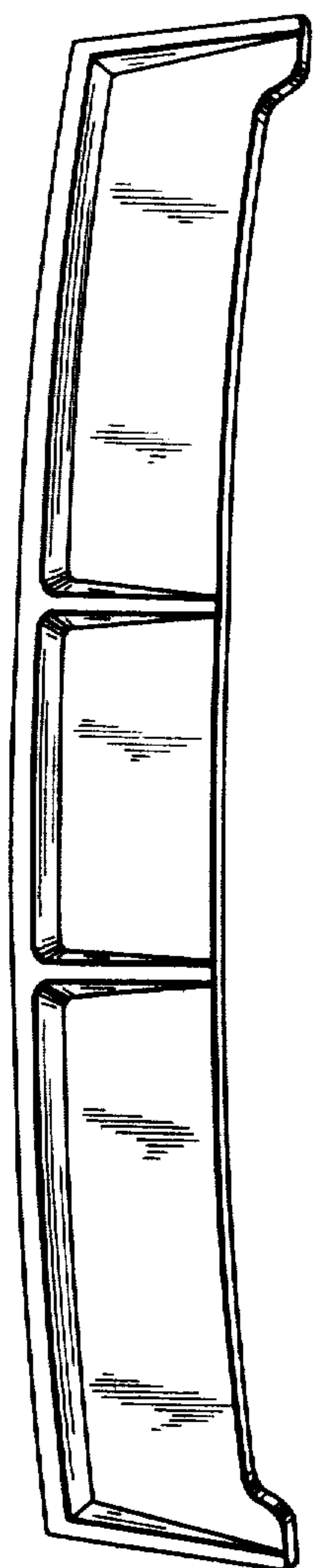

DESCRIPTION

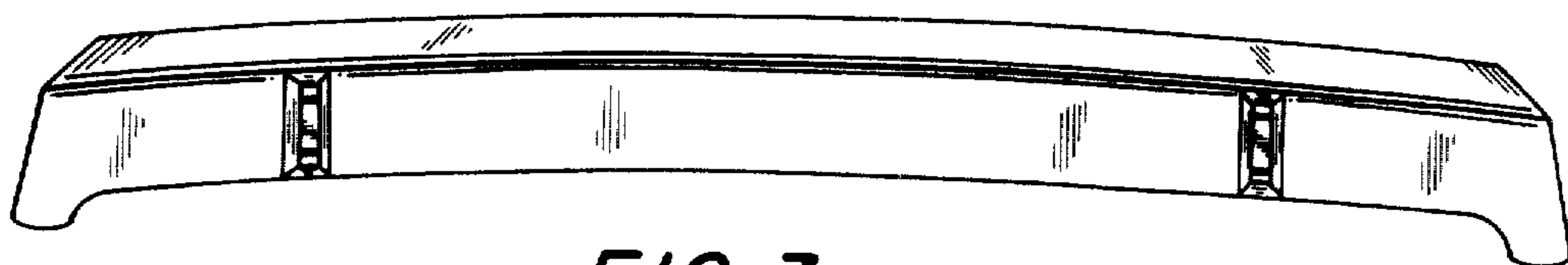
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a spoiler for a vehi-
